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May rebuffs Sturgeon on second Scottish referendum

NOW IS NOT THE TIME!

Theresa May has formally rejected Nicola Sturgeon's timetable for a second independence referendum, saying "now is not the time".

The Prime Minister ruled out Ms Sturgeon's demand for another vote between autumn 2018 and spring 2019, saying that it would be "unfair" on Scots to vote then as it would be too early to pass judgement on Brexit. However, she did not rule out a second referendum indefinitely.

She accused the SNP of jeopardising the UK's negotiations with the EU with talk of a second referendum and said "working together" was the best chance for Scotland and for the rest

of the UK to get the best deal in the wake of the Brexit vote.

'unfair to Scotland'

Mrs May told ITV News: "My message is very clear - now is not the time. I've explained the reasons why. I think we should be working to get the right deal for Scotland and the UK with our future partnership with the European Union.

"It would be unfair to Scotland, the people of Scotland at the moment that they would be being

asked to make a crucial decision without the information they need to make that decision."

The Prime Minister added: "Just at this point, all our energies should be focused on our negotiations with the European Union about our future relationship. To be talking about an independence referendum will make it more difficult for us to be able to get the right deal for Scotland, and the right deal for the UK.

"And more than that,

I think it wouldn't be fair to the people of Scotland because they're being asked to make a crucial decision without all the necessary information - without knowing what the future partnership would be, or what the alternative of an independent Scotland would look like."

Union 'very precious'

Mrs May also said: This Union we have is very precious. We've been joined together for over 300 years. We've had a great history together - I believe we have a great future together.

"Together, we should put our energies into making sure we get the

right deal for Scotland and for the whole of the UK.

Mrs May's decision will not be impacted by the outcome of a vote at the Scottish Parliament next Wednesday on giving Ms Sturgeon authorisation to ask the Prime Minister for the power to stage another referendum.

The powers would be transferred using a legal mechanism called a Section 30 order.

Her rejection is expected to prompt a furious reaction from Ms Sturgeon, who argued that Holyrood - which has a nationalist majority when SNP and Green MSPs are combined - must

have control over the referendum's timing.

However, the arrangements for the 2014 vote were the result of a consensus deal reached by both the UK governments. Although Alex Salmond was given the power to set the specific date, David Cameron set a cut-off point of the end of 2014.

The 90-year-old monarch was accompanied by Prince Philip, Prince Charles, Camilla, Prince Harry, Prince Andrew and Prince Edward for the annual service to celebrate Commonwealth Day.

It was attended by 2,000 people, including Theresa May whose hat gave her a look that reminded some guests of former premier Lady Thatcher.

Skiing holiday

But there were two notable absentees from the service – the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge.

Prince William, who hopes to become head of the Commonwealth when he is King, was on a skiing holiday with friends including nightclub owner Guy Pelly in the Swiss resort of Verbier.

It is understood Kate, 35, did not go on the holiday and was with their children.

declined to discuss their absence, although a source close to them insisted that not every member of the Royal Family was expected to attend every major royal occasion.

"They have attended the service before and will attend it on many occasions in the future," the source said.

William, said to have partied Sunday night away in a bar, took Kate and their children skiing in France this time last year. The second-in-line to the throne faced accusations he was workshy last year.

But this year, he, Kate and Harry have all

stepped up their royal duties. William and Kate will be on duty in Paris this weekend.

Singer Annie Lennox and former Spice Girl Geri Halliwell, who gave birth to her second child, a son, named Montague in January, were in the congregation.

In a keynote address Malta's prime minister Joseph Muscat, C o m m o n w e a l t h chair-in-office, gave a damning verdict on world affairs, attacking the rise of intolerant populism and the threat of terrorism. There was, he said, on the one hand, "terrorism, embedded in perverse

distortions of religious belief, on the other hand, the emergence of an intolerant populism that feeds on the lack of knowledge and on racism.

"Both of them shun reason, promote fanaticism and actively commit or indirectly incite violence."

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Despite May's rebuff, Sturgeon vows to press ahead with new independence vote

Scotland's first minister said she remained "determined" to have an independence referendum on her timescale despite Theresa May saying that "now is not the time".

Nicola Sturgeon told BBC Scotland on Thursday it would be "anti-democratic" for the UK government to block a referendum.

And she said she would consider her options if the will of the Scottish Parliament "is not respected".

Mrs May said the focus should be on securing the best possible Brexit deal.

She added that it would not be fair for the people of Scotland to be asked to make a decision on independence before the terms of Brexit were clear.

Speaking shortly after the prime minister, Scottish Secretary David Mundell clarified that the UK government "will not be entering into discussions or negotiations" about referendum, and that "any request at this time will be declined".

Ms Sturgeon wants a referendum to be held in the autumn of next year or the spring of 2019, to coincide with the expected conclusion of the UK's negotiations with the EU.

'consider my options'

In an interview with BBC Scotland's Jackie Bird, she said she had an "unequivocal mandate" to hold a referendum, and that a majority of MSPs at Holyrood were likely to back her call in a vote next Wednesday.

Ms Sturgeon added: "You are asking me to accept that a Conservative prime

minister who has one MP in Scotland has the right to lay down the law to Scotland's democratically elected parliament. That is unacceptable".

She went on to say that she would "consider my options and what I should do" if a formal Scottish Parliament request to hold a referendum is turned down.

Ms Sturgeon added: "I am determined that I will have one on my timescale, because the will of the Scottish Parliament will be respected.

"I accept that the prime minister has said what she has said today. What I don't accept is that that position is an acceptable one, a democratic one or a sustainable one."

The first minister said Mrs May appeared to be suggesting that a vote on independence could not be held until "long, long after" the UK had left the EU.

She said this would mean that the "damage of Brexit will have started to be done" and it would be "too late for Scotland, without suffering that damage, to choose a different path".

Ms Sturgeon claimed that the UK government had "sunk the Brexit ship" and was now seeking to "puncture Scotland's lifeboat", and that it was like "going back to the bad old days of Margaret Thatcher".

But referring to the UK government's u-turn over national insurance contributions on Wednesday, Ms Sturgeon said that the prime minister was "not the Iron Lady" and had shown she was capable of changing her mind in the face of public opinion.

With Brexit looming, Sinn Fein see their chance for Irish unity vote

■ Majority of voters in Northern Ireland voted for Remain

Sinn Féin this week seized on the Scottish first minister's shock announcement that she intends to hold a second referendum on independence by the spring of 2019 as indicative of the need for a border poll in Northern Ireland.

The majority of voters in both Scotland and Northern Ireland voted against Brexit.

The timing of the first minister's announcement - before Mrs May has triggered formal Brexit talks - as well as the scope of her demands took opponents at Westminster and Holyrood by surprise, and although Irish Taoiseach Enda Kenny quickly rejected the notion that a second, possibly successful, Scottish independence referendum would have any impact on Ireland.

'not appropriate'

But Michelle O'Neill, Sinn Féin's leader in Northern Ireland, called for a referendum on Irish unification, adding that the majority of the Northern Irish electorate had voted to stay in the European Union.

"Brexit will be a disaster for the economy, and a disaster for the people of Ireland. A referendum on Irish unity has to happen as soon as possible," Ms O'Neill said.

She added that the British government "are continuing to refuse to listen to the [Northern Irish] majority view and they are refusing to honour their commitments and agreements."

But speaking during his St Patrick's Day trip to the US, Mr Kenny dismissed the idea of any knock-on effect on Irish relations.

"The question of Scottish independence is a matter which is internal

to the UK and Scotland. It is not appropriate for us to speculate about any possible scenarios around it," Mr Kenny said in a statement.

"The Good Friday agreement sets out the basis on which [Irish] unification could arise by peaceful and democratic means. Our primary objective is to ensure that all aspects of the Good

Friday agreement are fully protected under Brexit."

Charlie Flanagan, the foreign affairs minister, said that calls for a border poll were "premature" and that the focus must be on restoring power-sharing to Northern Ireland.

"I don't think there is an area from here to the Baltic Sea, or from there to the Black Sea, or from

there to the Mediterranean Sea, that is as potentially adversely affected by the withdrawal of the UK from the EU as is here in Northern Ireland and I think it is important therefore that we have a fully functioning executive up and running to deal with this challenge at the earliest opportunity — this day fortnight," he said.

Former chancellor Norman Lamont slammed the policy as going against "the entire grain of Conservative policy since 1979".

Horror of landlady who saw cannibal killer eating girl

■ Schizophrenic Matthew Williams released from jail with 'no medication or supervision' shortly before grisly killing of 22 year-old Cerys Yemm

A TRAUMATISED landlady cried: "He's eating her" in a 999 call after seeing a cannibal killer attack a young woman in her hotel, an inquest heard on Monday.

The hearing was told crazed Matthew Williams killed shop worker Cerys Yemm before committing an act of cannibalism on her body.

Mandy Miles said she saw the face of Miss Yemm being cut open with a screwdriver before being chewed by the schizophrenic, who was

released from jail two weeks before.

In the call played to the jury Mrs Miles, 50, said: "He's shoving a screwdriver in her face. He's actually chewing her face. He's been locked in room seven. I don't know who he's hurting. There's a lad in the room. He's actually eating her. It's awful. His name is Matthew Williams."

The tape hears Mrs Miles sobbing as she says: "There was screaming and screaming. Oh my God. It's awful. I went into the room and he's

killed her. Oh my God. Is this real?"

"There's blood everywhere and it looks like a horror film. He was using the screwdriver and stabbing."

voices in his head

Police arrived 14 minutes later but Williams, 34, died after being Tasered at the "halfway house" Sirhowy Arms Hotel at Argoed, near Caerphilly, South Wales. Miss Yemm, 22, was found covered in blood lying under Williams - who had

binged on drink and drugs in the days before the killing in November 2014.

He served two and a half years in jail for attacking a girlfriend but - despite being sectioned and complaining of voices in his head - he was given no medication or supervision.

His mother Sally Ann Williams told the inquest in Newport his mental health "deteriorated" after he split up from the mother of his son three years before he killed Miss Yemm. He was diagnosed with drug-induced schizophrenia after claiming he was a tree and his food was poisoned.

Mrs Williams said: "There was no mental health support whatsoever. He told me he'd been released without any medication." She said her son complained of the voices in the days before the killing.

"He told me his head wasn't right," she said.

The inquest continues.

British deckhand, 18, dies after fall from luxury yacht

A Denbighshire teenager who left Wales to sail around the world with her family 10 years ago has fallen to her death in Jamaica.

Bethany Smith, 18, was working as a deckhand on a luxury schooner.

She fell while working high up a mast of the 196 ft (60m) vessel Germania Nova which was berthed

in the Jamaican town of Port Antonio, Portland.

Her mother Sarah is in Trinidad, whilst her father David is working in the Netherlands.

The teenager spent her early years in Glyndyfrdwy, Corwen, but her parents set sail from Aberystwyth in April 2007 in their yacht "Cape" along with her younger brother Bryn.

After spending three years cruising around the Mediterranean, the family sailed on to the Canary Islands and west Africa where they spent a further two years before crossing the Atlantic in March 2012.

They have since toured the Caribbean islands extensively, writing about their travels online.

Writing in a blog last year, Ms Smith's mother said the family was delighted she had got a job as a trainee on the Germania Nova.

She joined the crew of

the schooner in February last year, later crossing the Atlantic on the vessel for the summer charter season in the Mediterranean.

Jamaican police said Ms Smith was cleaning the schooner's mast on Tuesday afternoon when the ropes became undone and she fell on to the deck.

She died later in hospital from multiple injuries.

A family friend who started an online campaign to help the family meet the costs of the tragedy said Ms Smith would be remembered for being "a generous person and a ray of sunshine who brought laughter and music into the lives of those she met".

The memorial fund has so far raised more than £6,183 (US \$7,600) to help her family pay for the travel and funeral costs.

Ms Smith wrote her own blog of her adventures called which

talked of her passion for sailing, her experiences as a humanitarian worker in Dominica and her trips home to see family and friends in Wales.

A Foreign Office spokesman said: "We are in contact with the authorities in Jamaica following the death of a British national in Portland and are supporting their family at this very difficult time."

IT was a bad week for The Forestry Commission, which sparked a row by saying that dog owners could "stick and flick" dog poo, instead of bagging and binning it. The Kennel Club insists that owners should always "bag and bin". But Tory MP Anne Main said that too many people "bag and hang", and that the "stick and flick" advice was a pragmatic solution to the blight of "dog poo baubles".

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Rangers boss 'breached city financial rules'

The Rangers chairman Dave King has been judged to have breached financial rules when he seized control of the Glasgow football club.

The South Africa-based businessman (pictured, above) took over at Ibrox in March 2015 after a boardroom battle with representatives of Mike Ashley, the sportswear billionaire.

The City of London's takeover appeal board ruled on Monday that Mr King had breached the City code on takeovers and mergers by "acting in concert" with the so-called Three Bears in acquiring a stake equalling more than 30 per cent of the total shareholding in Rangers International Football Club plc.

In its ruling, the watchdog found that Mr King co-ordinated the purchase of the share block with the "bears" - George Letham, George Taylor and Douglas Park - meaning that they avoided having to offer to buy all the remaining shares in the club.

The appeal board said that an email chain between Mr King and Mr Letham, coupled with their involvement in two previous buyout

attempts, provided "overwhelming" evidence that they had acted in concert. Mr King will now have to offer to buy shares from other shareholders for the 20p price he bought in at.

The City regulatory body concluded: "Over the last two years Mr King has had ample opportunity to disclose documents and to provide other evidence to rebut any presumption or inference from the evidence that he was acting in concert with Messrs Letham, Taylor and Park. He has not done so."

Mr King had appealed against the initial findings of the takeover panel last year, arguing that he was separate from New Oasis Asset Limited, a British Virgin Islands company which acquired his 14.5 per cent shareholding in Rangers from institutional investors in 2015. The appeal board found that New Oasis was ultimately owned by Mr King for "the benefit of himself and members of his family" through a Guernsey-based trust. It also criticised the businessman for a "lack of co-operation" in its investigation.

Back pain alert for women in skinny jeans

WOMEN are putting fashion ahead of their health by wearing skinny jeans and high heels which can cause back pain, a study shows.

Experts say the jeans restrict movement in the hips and knees, affecting posture.

Almost half of women in a poll blamed their back pain on skinny jeans. Nearly as many said slinging a bag on one shoulder caused injuries, with high heels also a culprit. Large fluffy hoods and backless shoes are also blamed for stressing the body.

'hidden health impact'

British Chiropractic Association, which carried out the study, said fashion choices bring strain on the back, neck and shoulders.

Back pain is the main cause of sick days and the second biggest reason for going to the doctor.

The amputee driver of the Ford lost control when his prosthetic limb came loose and was jammed under the brake pedal.

No one was badly

injured in the crash but both cars were written off.

Chris was giving his student, who does not want to be named, a lesson in Stoke-on-

Trent. Chris, who has been an instructor for 12 years, said: "It was unbelievable. Initially I just thought the other driver was straying

across the centre line on the road and would correct it - but he didn't stop. Anticipating what might happen, myself and the learner braked and managed to stop.

"I was stunned when I found out what had happened.

"It is an incredibly dangerous situation when somebody's false leg comes off in transit.

"The learner went to A&E with whiplash and I have some swelling to my right hand from where I tried to grab the steering wheel as the airbag went off."

The amputee driver was spoken to by police but not arrested.

Britbox: a stream of British TV classics

GOOD NEWS this week for those who just can't enough of British telly.

BBC Worldwide has teamed up with U.K. broadcaster ITV and AMC Networks to launch a new streaming service called BritBox, which aims to bring the best of British TV to American audiences.

The service promises to deliver the largest subscription video-on-demand library of British television anywhere on the market today, and it will be streamed ad-free, the companies said.

BritBox will bring a number of programs that have never been available in the U.S.

before, ranging from dramas to soaps and other series. Some will even be online as soon as 24 hours after their U.K. broadcast, including Eastenders, Emmerdale and Holby City. Other titles which may be new to U.S. viewers include New Blood, Tutankhamun, The Moonstone, In The Dark, Cold Feet and Silent Witness.

The service will also be filled out with classics like period dramas Brideshead Revisited, Pride and Prejudice, and Upstairs Downstairs; the political thriller State of Play; murder mystery series Inspector Morse and Rosemary

and Thyme; and sitcoms like Keeping Up Appearances and Fawlty Towers, among others.

"The BBC and ITV are the two most prolific content producers and broadcasters in British television - both known for their unrivaled, groundbreaking shows," said Ann Sarnoff, president, BBC Worldwide North America, in a statement.

"BritBox will offer a streaming experience like no other, with thousands of hours of programs across a wide variety of genres - some of which will be available right after their UK broadcast. This will be a must-have service for lovers of British television."

According to the companies' announcement, BritBox will be available on the web, mobile web, iOS, Android, Roku, AppleTV and





Chromecast at launch. While the U.S. will be the debut market for BritBox, the goal is to eventually take the service worldwide.

The service currently offers a month free which then can be continued at \$6.99 per month.

BritBox will be competing with Acorn TV, which has been offering access to a wide range of British TV shows for the lower price of \$4.99/month or \$49.99/year for several years now and is well established in the North American market.







Meet A Member: Ken Adam


Meet Ken Adam from Fulham in London, who moved to Los Angeles 41 years ago to pursue working with teams and players in the old North American Soccer League.

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

George Best was playing for the L.A. Aztecs and I was his manager at the time, along with many other British players. After the Aztec games, the players and fans would all go to a bar in Hermosa. Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?



Greetings from Maui, an easy 5 1/2 hour plane ride from LAX. An island that is full of spotty WiFi. Which in reality is a blessing for those of us who are constantly switched on. At first it caused a little anxiety in my party, but after day one I realized it was a gift. A few family members were over to this side of the pond to celebrate my Mum turning 70.

She arrived in style on Air New Zealand with my auntie Sue taking a bit of a turn on the plane and being rushed to a hospital in Marina Del Rey. She stayed over night and had suffered a bout of dehydration (so remember when flying to drink LOTS of water.) Luckily she had insurance

or that one night stay may have turned into a \$70,000 price tag. (And I thought I was the only drama queen in the family). The Maui trip was a surprise for them. So clearly we had to spoil it so we could all get her out of the hospital and rush her back on a plane where a bottle of water never left her hand. Upon landing my fiancé Michael got them all lei'd (a flowered necklace that is a Hawaiian tradition of welcome). We stayed at the house of my friends Shane and Silvio near Paia. 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
The Enemies of Versailles: malice at the palace

■ Exclusive interview with author Sally Christie on her novel about the life of Comtesse du Barry, official mistress of king Louis XV

"I got the idea for the first book in the trilogy, *The Sisters of Versailles*, as I was trawling the web one night," says *The Enemies of Versailles* author Sally Christie.


"I stumbled upon a picture of Louise, the eldest Nesle sister, and read her Wikipedia page. I was like... Whoa, this is a crazy story. Four sisters, all mistresses of the same king, both concurrently and sequentially. I was really surprised I had never heard of their story, as I knew quite a bit of French history. And, while I knew about Louis XV's more famous mistresses, I had never heard of these sisters and their early entanglements with this king."

In the third and last book of Christie's Versailles trilogy, Jeanne Becu, a woman of humble birth, but very beautiful, rises from the streets of Paris to the palace of Versailles. She becomes the Comtesse du Barry, and the king's official mistress. The king's daughters are



horrified by the influence that du Barry has on their father. They want her away from the palace. The princesses use the dauphiness Marie Antoinette against du Barry. Little do they realize how the world is changing, that the French Revolution is almost upon them.

"After I submitted my manuscript, the very first question my soon-to-be agent asked me was, 'Do you have any ideas for books set around the same time period?' Basically, publishers aren't keen to invest in a new author with just one book. These days it's all about series



and building characters and worlds. I wasn't originally thinking about the Marquise de Pompadour and the Comtesse du Barry as potential subjects, since I figured they had been written about to death. One of the key attractions of the sisters story [of book one] was that it is not very widely known in the English-speaking world. But, then I discovered there was no English-language fiction about either of them."

During her writing process, Christie made several research trips to France. She got a backstage tour of the palace of Versailles,

away from the grand state rooms open to the public. She got to see some of the back alleys of the palace and the rooms where several of her characters had actually lived. She also visited Jeanne du Barry's chateau in Louveciennes. "The chateau still exists, in private hands," says Christie. "It was such a treat to walk in her footsteps and imagine her inside the elegant rooms."

Christie did a lot of her research online. "Google has a plan to put every single book ever written, that's out of copyright, on the Internet," says Christie. "They have done a wonderful job. Lots of obscure 18th century memoirs and biographies were available at the click of a mouse. So, I was able to do 90% of my research on my couch. Luckily, I am fluent in French, which I think was crucial for researching. I had to do a lot of digging and many of the sources have not been translated."

The Mistresses of Versailles trilogy are Christie's first books. She was nominated

for a Kobo Award for *The Sisters of Versailles*. Kobo is the Canadian Kindle, and being nominated is based on quantifiable data, such as, what percentage of readers finished the book; how fast readers finished it, and how many pages they read per hour. The series has yet to be optioned for film or TV. The French BBC series *Versailles* is set in the reign of Louis XIV, the great-grandfather of king Louis XV. "If the producers decide to continue the story, and I think they should, into the next century and the next king, my books will be waiting for them," says Christie.

Christie says that after three years of very intense writing for three books she's taking a step back and thinking about my next project, but it will definitely be something historical.

The news brings to an end his three-and-a-half year tenure, having joined the club in November 2013.

Karanka guided Middlesbrough to promotion last summer as they finished second in the Championship, a year after narrowly missing out by losing in the playoff

final to Norwich.

However, his team have struggled in the Premier League this season, currently sitting 19th with just four wins from 27 games. Their last league win came against Swansea on December 17.

He had remained confident of easing Boro back to safety in the remaining 11 games of the season and was encouraged by his team's display in Saturday's

2-0 FA Cup quarter-final defeat by Manchester City.

However, he did not get the chance as his reign came to an end after three years and four months.

A statement on the club website read: "Middlesbrough Football Club can today confirm the departure of Head Coach Aitor Karanka. Following discussions, both parties have agreed that it is in the best interests of the club to

make this change. "The club would like to thank Aitor for all his hard work over the past three-and-a-half years and for the success we've had during that time. We wish him all the best for the future.

"Aitor Karanka said: "I'd like to thank Middlesbrough for a wonderful opportunity and the players, staff and all the people at the club who I have worked with. I'd also like to thank the fans for their support. This club will always hold a special place for me and I place for me and I wish everyone connected with Middlesbrough Football Club the very best for the future."

■ With Kane hobbled, veteran striker gets surprise England call-up

Sunderland striker Jermain Defoe has been recalled to the England squad.

The 34-year-old won the most recent of his 55 England caps against Chile in November 2013.

Uncapped Southampton duo Nathan Redmond and James Ward-Prowse are also selected, as is 19-year-old Manchester United striker Marcus Rashford.

Gareth Southgate's side face Germany away in a friendly on 22 March before a World Cup qualifier against Lithuania at Wembley on 26 March.

West Brom midfielder Jake Livermore, who made his sole international appearance against Italy in 2012, returns to the squad.

Burnley defender Michael Keane and West Ham winger Michail Antonio - both of whom

are uncapped - are also selected.

Southgate has also called up Manchester United left-back Luke Shaw, who has made two appearances since December, and Everton midfielder Ross Barkley.

Defoe has scored 14 Premier League goals this season, the second most by any English player behind Tottenham striker Harry Kane (19).

He has scored 19 times for England since making his debut against Sweden in 2004.

"You can have the young players who are hungry and the old players who are hungry as well," Southgate told the England website.

"I think we can't just look at young players all the time. I think we have to get results now and also plan for the future."

Kane is missing after injuring his ankle against Millwall on Sunday,

while captain Wayne Rooney is absent with a leg injury.

Southgate said there was "a chance" Rooney would be fit for Manchester United's Premier League game against Middlesbrough on Sunday.

"The injury, coupled with the fact he's not really had a lot of game time recently and others have, has sort of determined my decision on that one," he added.

Liverpool striker Daniel Sturridge is also absent through injury, while Arsenal forward Theo Walcott has not been selected.

"Theo has a really valid claim for being included," said

Southgate. "I didn't see him featuring in the games this week and I needed to look at one or two other players that I don't know too much about."
