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ELECTION HANGING IN THE BALANCE?

Polls narrow as Labour enjoys surge of support from the young

THERESA MAY's ability to deliver a landslide majority in Thursday's election was in doubt this week as several opinion polls showed the vote could be much tighter than previously thought.

A poll conducted by Survation for ITV's *Good Morning Britain* program showed May's lead had dropped to 6 percentage points from 9 points a week ago and 18 points two weeks ago.

An ICM poll for the Guardian showed May with a 12-point lead - enough for a big majority of around 100 but down two points from last week and a far cry from the record 22-point lead earlier this month.

"Three weeks ago this was the easiest election to call in history," Martin Boon, ICM's director, told reporters on Tuesday.

"But since the manifestos were launched, there's been a rapid tumbling in the gap between the Conservatives and

Labour," he said, referring to the pre-election pledges of the main parties.

May's poll lead started to contract sharply after she set out plans on May 18 to make some elderly people pay a greater share of their care costs, a proposal dubbed the "dementia tax" by opponents.

social care pledge

As her lead shrank, May was forced to backtrack on the policy at an appearance before the media on Monday at which she appeared flustered and irritated when taking questions from reporters.

The polls so far have been hard to decipher with both the unpopular social care pledge and the May 22 suicide attack in

Manchester influencing voter intentions.

May called the snap election in a bid to strengthen her hand in negotiations on Britain's exit from the European Union, to win more time to deal with the impact of the divorce and to strengthen her grip on the Conservative Party.

But unless she handsomely beats the 12-seat majority her predecessor David

Cameron won in 2015, her electoral gamble will have failed, and her authority could be undermined just as she enters formal Brexit negotiations.

Labour commands a big lead among young Britons, but recent votes show they are the least likely to go to the polling stations.

We shouldn't write off the thought that young people will turn out for

this election (in large numbers) - but I think it's unlikely," Boon said.

Both the Survation and ICM polls were conducted in the aftermath of a suicide bombing which killed 22 people in Manchester.

It is still unclear how much Britain knew about suicide bomber Salman Abedi before he carried out the deadliest militant attack on British soil for 12 years. May

was interior minister from 2010 to 2016.

The ICM poll showed 53 percent of Britons thought May handled the situation well. Only 17 percent disagreed.

The Survation poll found just over half of the 1,009 respondents thought May would make the best prime minister, whilst support for Labour's Jeremy Corbyn stood at just 30 percent.

BBC Debate: Party leaders clash but May sits it out

Jeremy Corbyn has clashed with Home Secretary Amber Rudd over spending cuts in a seven-way BBC TV election debate on Wednesday night.

Mrs Rudd was representing the Conservatives after Theresa May declined to take part.

She repeatedly accused Mr Corbyn of having a "magic money tree" after he highlighted a Tory U-turn on disability benefits and accused the party of plotting five more years of austerity.

Mr Corbyn did not criticize Mrs May's absence from the debate, but Lib Dem leader Tim Farron did take a swipe at the Tory leader, saying: "Where do you think Theresa May is tonight?"

"Take a look out your window. She might be out there sizing up your house to pay for your social care."

Plaid Cymru leader Leanne Wood said Mrs May was not there because "her campaign of soundbites is falling apart."

SNP deputy leader Angus Robertson accused Mrs May of not having the "guts" to attend the debate, in Cambridge, as he launched an attack on Mrs Rudd over cuts to the winter fuel allowance for pensioners in England.

Mr Corbyn and Mr Farron joined in with the

attack, with the Labour leader shouting "what about the triple lock?" - the policy guaranteeing annual increases in the state pension, which the Conservative want to scrap.

Mrs Rudd said: "Theresa May may not be here but I hope to make a good fist of setting out Conservative Party policy."

She said the Conservatives had "made a clear decision to protect the poorest in our society," adding "winter fuel payments won't be available for billionaires" under her party's policy.

She dismissed her rivals' claims as "fanciful," saying they offered nothing but "bluff, bravado and tempting, shiny election promises," compared with Theresa May's "record of delivery".

"The only question to consider is who should be in No 10 to steer Britain to a brighter future? Jeremy Corbyn with his money tree, wish list manifesto and no plan for Brexit or Theresa May with her record of delivery," she told the audience in Cambridge.

But she came under attack over the squeeze on living standards and cuts to welfare as the debate heated up.

Mr Corbyn told her: "Have you been to a food bank? Have you seen

people sleeping around our stations? Have you seen the levels of poverty that exist because of your government's conscious decisions on benefits?"

The Labour leader also highlighted his plans to end the public sector pay cap and introduce a £10 an hour living wage by 2020.

He said Labour would "ensure our manufacturing industry and jobs are protected" and he was "absolutely sure" his spending plans added up.

And he clashed with UKIP leader Paul Nuttall, who accused the Labour leader of wanting to take the country back to the 1970s, to boos from some in the audience at Cambridge.

The panel also clashed over immigration, with the Green Party's co-leader Caroline Lucas saying she wants to "make the case" for freedom of movement across the EU, the ability of people to be able to "live and love" in other countries.

"The Britain I love is a confident outward-looking country," she says, which well knows the "benefits" of migration.

Mr Nuttall denied claims he was demonising immigrants but said "we have to get the population under control".

Shock poll predicts hung Parliament

Britain could be on course for a hung parliament, according to a new projection that suggests the Conservatives could fall 16 seats short of an overall majority.

The seat-by-seat prediction by YouGov for The Times on Wednesday suggested that the Conservatives are on course to win 310 seats at the election - short of an absolute majority of 326 seats needed to form a Government.

Such a result on 9 June would be calamitous for Theresa May, who called the snap election in April, claiming the country needed certainty, stability and strong leadership as it

enters the negotiations to exit the European Union on 19 June.

Ed Miliband, the former Labour leader, who suffered a disastrous result at the 2015 election despite predictions of a hung parliament, replied to the research on Twitter, adding: "The pollsters have been off my Christmas card since 2015 #justsaying".

The Prime Minister would undoubtedly face questions over her leadership if the modelling by YouGov is proved to be accurate in just under a week, especially after she was forced into a humiliating U-turn over a proposed social care reformed dubbed the "dementia tax" by critics.

It also claims Jeremy Corbyn's Labour party could be in line to gain 29 seats on the last election with 257, with the Liberal Democrats on 10 and the SNP down four seats on 50.

Such a result would mean the Labour leader would have to be willing to enter negotiations with other political parties if he wished to enter Downing Street.

But Mr Corbyn has unequivocally ruled out a coalition deal with Nicola Sturgeon's SNP and Tim Farron, the Liberal Democrat leader, said in April that he will do "no deal, no deal with anybody" under any circumstances - unlike his predecessor Nick Clegg.



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BA facing huge compensation claims after IT crash brings holiday misery for thousands

■ Airline faces massive costs in lost revenue and payouts under EU law

British Airways could be facing huge compensation costs after thousands of passengers were stranded by a global IT crash.

Delayed travellers are able to claim compensation under EU law, unless the disruption has been caused by factors outside the airline's control.

Air travel experts say BA is likely to face a massive cost in lost revenue and payouts to customers whose flights were cancelled.

Malcolm Ginsberg, editor in chief at Business Travel News, said: "There is no question - the EU denied-boarding regulations will have to apply.

"They have broken all the rules and they will have to deal with it - it's going to be a very expensive situation for BA."

He added: "The money doesn't really compensate passengers for the situation."

British Airways remains in the dark why a power

surge caused its IT system to fail and take flight, baggage and customer communication systems offline.

British Airways chief executive Alex Cruz said systems at 170 airports in 70 countries were affected, and that a backup system had also failed, adding that about 75,000 passengers had flights cancelled on Saturday and Sunday, though most eventually made it to their destinations.

Mr Cruz said that "once the disruption is over, we will carry out an exhaustive investigation into what caused this incident, and take measures to ensure it never happens again".

The disruption hit British Airways during one of Britain's busiest travel weekends, with a public holiday on Monday and the long Memorial Day break in the US. A power surge early on Saturday knocked out computer systems, affecting the

carrier's operations, call centres and website.

The system outage again puts a globally known airline in the spotlight for IT problems with far-reaching implications affecting hundreds of flights and thousands of passengers. Delta Air Lines in January grounded flights for hours because of a technology outage affecting multiple systems. It followed an August breakdown that led to flight cancellations spurred by an electrical problem that appears similar to what BA experienced.

time consuming

Airlines often struggle with operating a mix of new computer equipment, introduced to ease travel and improve operations, and legacy systems that have been in place for years. The series of malfunctions spurred some airlines to review the resilience of their systems.

"A power supply issue should not bring an airline to its knees," said

Gil Hecht, chief executive of consultancy Continuity Software. Still, he said, recovery could be time consuming because it wasn't always clear where the failure occurred or data had been corrupted.

British Airways said operations were returning to normal early on Tuesday. All long-haul flights should operate at the airline's busy London Heathrow Airport hub, the carrier said, "as our IT systems move closer to full operational capacity".

The airline said it expected to operate 95 per cent of its planned schedule, though some short-haul flights would

be cancelled. British Airways said all flights should operate at Gatwick Airport, south of the capital, where also services were affected when computer systems were knocked offline.

The airline said it would fully meet its obligations under passenger rights rules. Under European Union passenger rights rules, the airline is liable for payments to those whose travel plans were disrupted.

British Airways hasn't given a cost for the disruption. Analysts estimate the cost of the IT outage may be around €82 million (\$124m), or

2.7 per cent of estimated 2017 operating profit, from passenger claims and lost sales.

Mr Cruz has apologised for what was a "horrible time" for customers who have seen vacation plans spoiled and others stranded for long periods on planes.

British Airways, a unit of International Consolidated Airlines Group and the biggest trans-Atlantic carrier on routes between Britain and the US, cancelled about half its services on Saturday, or more than 400 flights, according to FlightAware.com, and an additional 145 on Sunday.

Mosque refuses to bury bomber

One of Manchester's biggest mosques has refused to bury the body of the Manchester terrorist who killed 22 last week.

It is thought his body remains unburied and councils, funeral directors and now the city's mosques, refuse to deal with it.

According to the *Daily Mail*, the bomber's body has been kept in a morgue outside Manchester.

The *Manchester Evening News* has reported that the city's authorities are reportedly doing "everything in their power" to stop him being cremated, buried, or laid

to rest in any way in the Greater Manchester area.

A source told the *Manchester Evening News*: "Just like Ian Brady, every effort is going in to making sure that there is not a chance Abedi can be buried or cremated in Greater Manchester."

Inquest proceedings will soon be heard, and the disposal of his body will be decided by the

coroner.

A source told the *MEN* that his body has never been kept in the same place as his victims. Now, at least one mosque is taking the same course of action as the council.

Manchester Central Mosque, one of Manchester's largest Muslim funeral providers, has said it will have nothing to do with the body.

Camilla opens up over affair 'anguish'

"I couldn't really go anywhere", she said this week.

Leading up to her 70th birthday this July, the *Mail on Sunday's* You Magazine was granted access to Duchess regarding everything from the how her relationship with Prince Charles affected her children to the pressure of marrying into the Royal Family.

media firestorm

Prince Charles and wife Camilla recently celebrated their 12th wedding anniversary, but in a new interview the Duchess of Cornwall opens up about the scandal that ensued when the exposure of her affair with the heir to the British throne (when they were both married) caused a media firestorm that led her to be vilified

in the press – and become a prisoner in her own home. "I couldn't have survived it without my family".

Camilla says she passed the time reading and learning to paint.

And in a candid interview with You, Camilla – who was still married to her first husband Andrew Parker-

Bowles when she started romancing Charles again – declared that her life was hell back then.

The Prince famously cheated on Di with his old flame Camilla, now 69, as their marriage disintegrated before England's eyes.

"I don't think I'm tough but I do think I'm quite a strong character",

she said. Instead, we went to Paris and Florence and learned about life and culture and how to behave with people, how to talk to people. "I sometimes think to myself, 'Who is this woman?'"

"You've got to laugh through most things", she begins. You just have to get on with it."

Bomber bought his own components, say police

Manchester bomber Salman Abedi bought most of the components used to make the bomb himself, police have said.

Many of the suicide attacker's movements and actions were "carried out alone" in the four days prior to the attack, Russ Jackson, head of the North West counter terrorism unit, said.

But police have yet to rule out whether he was part of a wider network.

Officers cordoned off a street in the Rusholme area of Manchester on Wednesday where a property was being searched.

Greater Manchester Police asked members of the public to avoid Banff Road, after the latest in a series of raids linked to their investigation.

Three men arrested over the 22 May attack were released without charge on Tuesday.

Det Ch Supt Jackson said much of the police investigation had been working through Abedi's last movements.

Officers have examined his movements on CCTV and other interactions he had with people as well as phone calls he made.

"Our enquiries show Abedi himself made most of the purchases of the core [bomb] components and what is becoming apparent is that many of his movements and actions have been carried out alone during the four days from him landing in the country and committing this awful attack," said Det Chief Supt Jackson.

However, it was "vital" that police make sure he is not part of a wider network and there were a "number of things" about this behaviour that were a concern, he added.

Det Ch Supt Jackson

said police were keen to find out why Abedi kept going back to the Wilmslow Road area of the city and wanted to find the blue suitcase he used during those trips.

A total of 16 people have been arrested in connection with last Monday's attack. Five have been released without charge while 11 are still in custody.

The police investigation has moved into a different phase, with detectives trying to bring the various strands of information and evidence together to build a case against Salman Abedi's alleged co-conspirators.

Every police force in the UK has assisted in some way since the terror attack in Manchester, according to the National Police Chiefs Council.

Twenty-eight forces, as well as the National Crime Agency, have been helping police in Manchester on their investigation and the response to the bombing.

Det Ch Supt Jackson said police have made "huge progress" in the week since the attack but it will "take considerable time before we fully understand what has happened".

Twenty-two people were killed and many injured after the bomber carried out an attack following an Ariana Grande concert.

The singer will be joined by the likes of Coldplay, Justin Bieber, Katy Perry and Take That at a benefit concert for victims on Sunday.

Meanwhile, Liam Gallagher played his first solo gig in Manchester on Tuesday night, with the proceeds also being donated to the victims of the bombing.

He applauded as heartfelt cries of "Stand up for the 22" rang out from the crowd in reference to those killed.

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Blue Peter icon John Noakes dead at 83

■ **Presenter known for daredevil stunts and his beloved Shep fought long battle with Alzheimer's**

Former Blue Peter presenter John Noakes, who hosted the show in the 1960s and 1970s, has died aged 83.

Noakes was the BBC children's show's longest-serving presenter, appearing for more than 12 years, and was often seen with his dog Shep by his side.

He was also known for his daredevil stunts like climbing Nelson's Column and jumping out of planes - and for his famous encounter with a baby elephant.

A family statement said he had "endured

and suffered from" Alzheimer's disease.

'greatly missed'

"Whilst he will be greatly missed by his wife, family and many friends his release from continuing ill health must be counted as a blessing," it said.

"His many escapades with his faithful companion Shep, during his time with Blue Peter, will live on in many peoples memories. That is how his family would like him remembered."

Noakes joined the show at the end of 1965

after training as an engine fitter for the RAF, and stayed until 1978.

He became a favourite as the show's action man, and continued to play on that image with several series of Go With Noakes, where he travelled around the UK with Shep alongside him.

That led to his

catchphrase "Get down Shep!" - which even became the title of a song by comedy group The Barron Knights.

Noakes appeared on Blue Peter with co-presenters including Christopher Trace, Valerie Singleton, Lesley Judd and Peter Purves.

Purves said that Noakes's death was

"very sad" but added that the Alzheimer's had become "extremely serious" in recent years.

'so much fun'

Remembering his friend, he said: "He was unique. He had qualities that no-one else had and he'll be remembered very fondly by a lot of people, and none more so than

me."

He was "very, very brave" in doing his many stunts and adventures, Purves added.

"We had so much fun together over the years. There were hundreds and hundreds of happy memories. I'll never forget him."

BBC director general Tony Hall described Noakes as "one of the BBC's most loved children's presenters".

In a statement, he said: "He was a warm and engaging presenter who appealed to all ages and provided children's TV with some of its most memorable moments. He will be missed by his many friends and family."

After retiring in the mid-1980s Noakes spent much of his time at the family home on Mallorca in the Spain's Balearic Islands. He was on the island at the time of his death.

Scottish abuse inquiry opens hearing

The first hearing in a Scottish child abuse inquiry has heard apologies from organizations which ran children's homes around the country.

More than 60 institutions, including several top private schools and church bodies, are being investigated.

The inquiry, which is being chaired by the prominent Scottish jurist Lady Smith, is looking in detail at historical abuse of children in residential care.

It is expected to report in late 2019 - four years after it was set up.

The opening session in Edinburgh heard apologies from groups who said they "deplored

that physical sexual abuses could occur".

They included the charities Quarrier's, Daughters of Charity of St Vincent de Paul, Sisters of Nazareth, Good Shepherd Sisters, De La Salle Brothers and Christian Brothers.

Lady Smith began the public hearings by acknowledging that many children in Scotland have been abused in residential care over the years.

The High Court judge revealed the number of survivors who had already spoken to the inquiry team was "very far in excess" of 200.

She said: "They suffered some terrible treatment inflicted by those to whom their care was entrusted.

That is a matter of grave concern.

"It is critically important that our community engages in facing up to the fact that children in care were wronged and failed in the past and to commit to seeing to it that children of today and of the future are safe.

"It's not easy to do that, for many it will be a painful process. But if we are to achieve real, substantial and lasting change for the better it has to be done."

'Cruelly betrayed'

John Scott QC, for the In Care Abuse Survivors group (Incas), said children had been "cruelly betrayed by those supposed to care for them".

He said the inquiry had come too late for those who have already died, but added: "It is not too late for at least some

acknowledgement and accountability, not too late for some compensation, not too late for other survivors to come forward."

The hearings have now been adjourned until Thursday.

The inquiry states its purpose as being "to investigate the nature and extent of abuse of children whilst in care in Scotland", while considering

"the extent to which institutions and bodies with legal responsibility for the care of children failed in their duty", in particular seeking any "systemic failures".

But it does not cover children who were abused while living with their natural or adoptive families, while using sports and leisure clubs or attending faith based organisations on a day to

day basis.

The inquiry will also not examine allegations of children being abused in non-boarding schools, nursery or day-care centres.

Its terms of reference say it covers a time period "within living memory of any person who suffered such abuse", up until the point the inquiry was announced in December 2014.

8. Incredible new foods and dishes to experience. There are over 20,000 species of edible plants in the world. This opens up a whole new world of different healthy foods and exciting recipes.

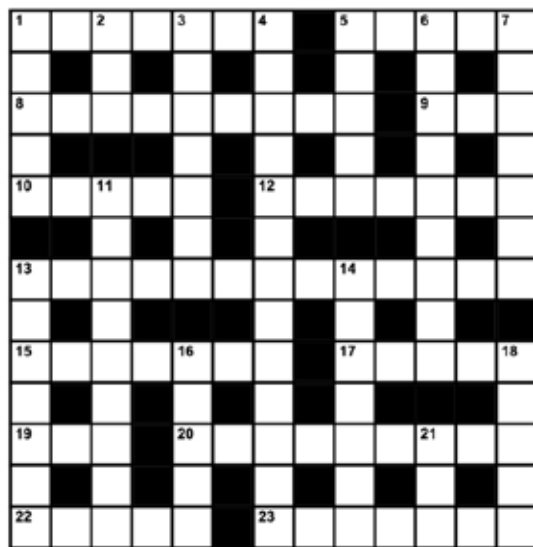
9. Improve your body fat and still get enough protein. Meat and dairy are difficult for the body to digest - they can take up much of your energy and leave you tired. For

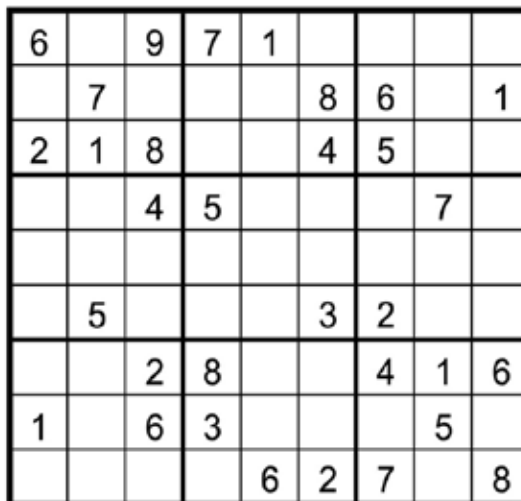

■ The Cat & Fiddle debuts its new location on Highland Avenue after three year hiatus

THERE WAS some very welcome news for the local expat community this week with the re-opening of the Cat & Fiddle pub in Hollywood after a three-year absence.

The revamped eaterie and watering hole held a soft-opening on Memorial Day Monday at its new location on Highland Avenue just north of Melrose in the former space of the Mud Hen Tavern.

Laurel Canyon roots

The original Cat & Fiddle was opened in 1984 on Laurel Canyon by the husband and wife team of Kim and Paula Gardner and found immediate

success with their familiar recipe of British beers, tasty pub grub and friendly banter, - the latter mainly coming from Kim, a renowned rock musician and born performer. The pub's immediate success led to them expanding to larger premises on Sunset Boulevard just west of Cahuenga, where the place enjoyed an almost thirty-year run as the best pub in Hollywood, a favored watering hole of expat Brits, local residents and celebrity rockers alike. In the far-off days when the British Weekly offices were located just around the corner, the place

became an informal canteen for the editorial staff.

Sadly the place closed its doors in 2004 to make way for New York chef April Bloomfield and restaurateur Ken Friedman, according to leading foodie website eaterla.com. In an ironic twist, its former space remains empty to this day.

Tell us about your decision to move to LA:

A Very Psychic Tea....

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Far from foodie heaven

■ New book take a fascinating look at the recipes - and the inventiveness - in British kitchens during WW2

An interesting little book crossed our desks this week, courtesy of London's International War Museum.

Victory in The Kitchen: Wartime Recipes is a highly readable tome providing an absorbing insight into WW2 Britain and the drastic demands which rationing and the war effort put on the home cook. The book is divided like a menu into Starters, Mains and Puddings and also has a section on baking, conversion tables and an enlightening introduction detailing the challenges facing Britain after the outbreak of war in 1939.

As an island nation Britain was heavily dependent on important raw materials and footstuffs. But as German U-boats began to decimate merchant shipping in 1940 the

that not only was it vitally important to make the most of the food that DID arrive, but also of the dire need for Britain to feed itself - and quickly. The resulting push towards cultivating land for food production - the 'Dig for Victory' campaign, saw almost every park, playing field, railway embankment, flower bed and other sliver of land converted into vegetable patches. Soon the Women's Land Army swung into action to replace the male laborers who had gone off to fight.

The government was also acutely aware that Britons needed to feel a sense of shared sacrifice. Between the fall of France and Hitler's invasion of the Soviet Union Britain stood very much alone. Defeatism and talk of accommodation with

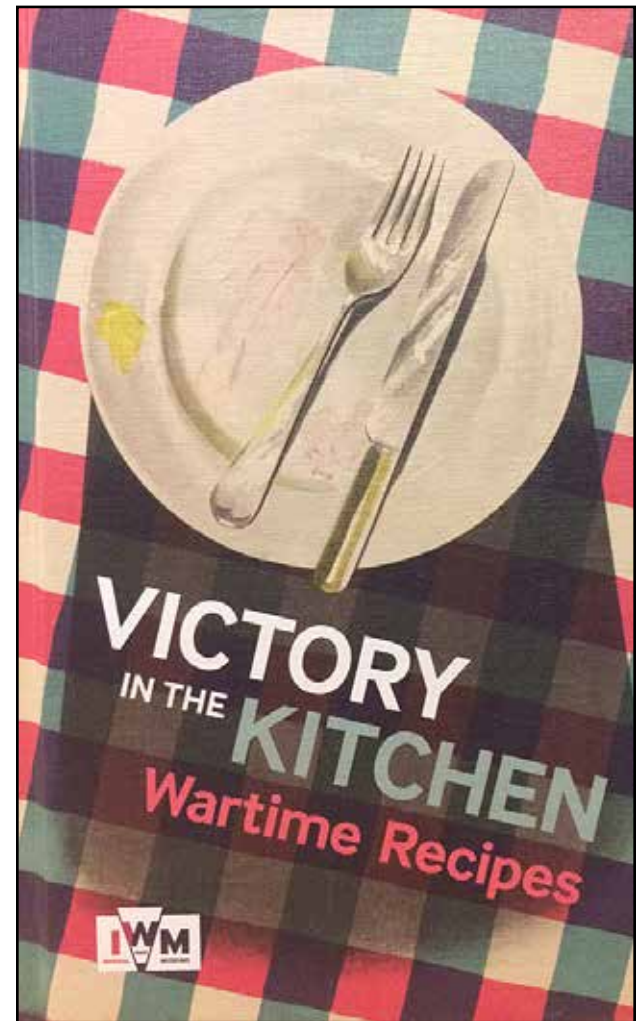
air. The last thing Britain needed was a civil crisis over 'fair shares' and whether the rich had more than the poor. The government took quick action to resurrect the Ministry of Food, which had first begun in WWI. Rationing was introduced, its purpose to distribute food evenly across the population and prevent shortages becoming a critical problem. Weekly allowances and coupon books became part of the nation's landscape. Britons were forced to come up with creative new ways to do without - and this book's recipes reflect that - there are eggless cakes, the innovative use of honey as a sweetener, and 'mock' dishes imitating family favorites. For a population that loved its Sunday roast, non-rationed rabbit suddenly became a favorite. And when the Ministry wasn't advocating new recipes it championed the health benefits of vegetables. So it wasn't all bad...

At first glance it's notable how many WW2 recipes were vegetarian. Root vegetables in particular were staples, with copious suggestions in the book for Swedes (rutabagas), carrots, turnips, parsnips and potatoes. Swede soup, lentil and parsley soup, and mock oyster soup (basically water, fish trimming, leeks and artichokes) catch the eye, but the Scotch egg recipe, using reconstituted dried eggs, is hardly appetizing. Cabbage and fruit salad is barely more appealing, nor are the carrot croquettes, which feature added oatmeal for volume (!). As for the mains, dishes

such as stuffed ox heart or Lancashire hot pot (featuring 6 oz of 'scrag end' mutton), egg and bacon pie and Mock Goose (basically cod with leeks and potatoes) don't sound too bad, but some readers would perhaps rather go to bed hungry than attempt the recipe for lentil cutlets.

Onto dessert. Most of the offerings here are of the stodgy traditional variety, think jam sponge and baked custard made with reconstituted egg. But the wartime chocolate pudding sums up the nation's plight. The recipe calls for flour, carrot, sugar, bicarbonate of soda, baking power, milk, margarine, vanilla essence and ONE heaped tablespoon of cocoa. In other words, not much chocolate to speak of.

Another bonus of this charming little book are the illustrations. Wartime propaganda and bromides about not wasting food are overlaid with upbeat illustrations of cheerful housewives, hardworking land girls and brave troops. Slogans such as "Help Win the War on the



Kitchen Front: Above All Avoid Waste" set the mood perfectly. It all seems a very long time ago.

It's doubtful that many (if any) of the recipes in this book will become staples in a California household of 2017. As the introduction says: "Some are curiosities, and in some cases may even evoke shudders. Some are surprisingly delicious". But what they do is provide an insight

into the inventiveness of the British nation *in extremis* and allow the reader to gain a sense of what culinary triumphs were borne out of sacrifice and hardship.

STAR TURN: Bernardo Silva caught the eye in Monaco's Champions League campaign

City hope Silva proves golden

MANCHESTER CITY took an early lead in the summer transfer derby by completing the £43m acquisition of Monaco midfielder Bernardo Silva last week.

The Portuguese international has been tipped to join United this summer, but Pep Guardiola put a plan in place months ago and accelerated his bid to bring Silva to the Etihad.

The Monaco ace, 22, has been a key part of the club's rise to victory in Ligue 1 this season and their march to the Champions League semi-finals.

Guardiola held talks with Silva's agent Jorge Mendes after their Champions League clash back in March and the City boss also enquired about the availability of Kylian Mbappe.

They then had another meeting after City's 3-1 win over West Brom 10 days ago.

Monaco netted a massive 107 goals this season as they beat rivals Paris Saint-Germain to the title, finishing the season with a very respectable 95 points.

And in a bid to solve their problem between the sticks the club are expected to complete the £33m signing of Benfica goalkeeper Ederson Moraes.

The 23-year-old broke into the Benfica team in March last year and has played 37 games for the Portuguese champions.

After Sunday's 2-1 Portuguese Cup final win over Vitoria Guimaraes, Moraes said it was "probably" his final appearance.

The Brazil under-23 cap is yet to make his full debut, but is in the squad for the upcoming friendlies against Argentina and Australia.

Guardiola has been interested in Moraes for some time and made room in his squad by releasing Willy Caballero on Friday.

The news comes the day after City's England goalkeeper Joe Hart confirmed he would be leaving Torino after a season-long loan.

Ederson's arrival will place more pressure on Claudio Bravo, who has had a torrid time after arriving from Barcelona to take over from Hart as City's number one.

Guardiola is also understood to be interested in Monaco and France full-back Benjamin Mendy, 22.

Rose: we need a marquee signing

Full-back Danny Rose says "one marquee signing" this summer could help Tottenham claim silverware next season.

Spurs were Premier League runners-up this term and lost to Chelsea in the FA Cup semi-finals. They also went out in the Champions League group stages.

But Rose says a big name could enable them to "push forward" and win a first trophy since 2008.

"We have to do a lot better. We just hope we can win some silverware," he told BBC Radio 5 live's Friday Social.

Rose, 26, is one of a number of Spurs players to have been linked with a move this summer, with Kane, Kyle Walker and Dele Alli also the subject of speculation.

Earlier this month, manager Mauricio Pochettino said the club cannot compete with the Premier League's biggest

clubs on wages.

But left-back Rose said that money might not be the only factor when it comes to the future of Spurs' stars.

"I was told a few months ago these next two or three windows are going to be the ones where full-backs are going to go for a lot of money so we'll see," he said.

"There is only so much the club can do; a lot of it has got to be down to the individual."

Kroenke earlier this month, said he was "pleased" Wenger was staying "as he is one of the very best coaches in Europe".

However, Usmanov added it was "of paramount importance that he receives the full support of the board and majority shareholder".

The metals magnate owns 30% of Arsenal's

shares but is not on the board and plays no part in the decision-making at the club.

"If the support is not forthcoming, we stand ready to step in and do everything we can to deliver success on and off the field," he added.

Wenger led the Gunners to three Premier League titles and four FA Cups in his first nine seasons in charge.

In 2003-04, he became the first manager since 1888-89 to lead a team

through an entire top-flight season unbeaten.

But after winning the 2005 FA Cup, they had to wait another nine years - or 3,283 days - for their next silverware. It came as they beat Hull City to win the 2014 FA Cup, before winning the trophy again the following year.

Arsenal have not won the Premier League in 13 years and in 11 of those seasons have finished 10 or more points adrift of the champions.

United eager to keep De Gea



DE GEA: wanted by Real Madrid

Manchester United hope to resist Real Madrid's attempts to sign goalkeeper David de Gea again this summer.

Real, who aim to become the first side to retain the Champions League when they play Juventus in Cardiff on Saturday, agreed a transfer deadline day deal with United for De Gea in 2015.

The £29m transfer collapsed because Real did not submit paperwork in time.

It is anticipated the La Liga winners will renew their efforts to sign the Spain international keeper.

De Gea, 26, was left out of United's Europa League final line-up on 24 May in

favour of Sergio Romero.

United have noted reports in the Spanish media, which tend to be the prelude to a concerted effort to sign a player when a club knows negotiations are not going to be straightforward.

However, the Old Trafford club feel they are in a better position to reject Real than they were two years ago.

In August 2015, De Gea had just entered the final year of his contract.

His current deal lasts until 2019 and he also has the option to extend for an additional season.

Senior United sources also say De Gea has not asked for a move, or expressed any discontent with his present situation.

Also at United, striker Zlatan Ibrahimovic has "had a lot of offers from lots of different clubs and places" but "nothing is decided" on his future, says his agent Mino Raiola.

Ibrahimovic, 35, is contracted to the club until 30 June.

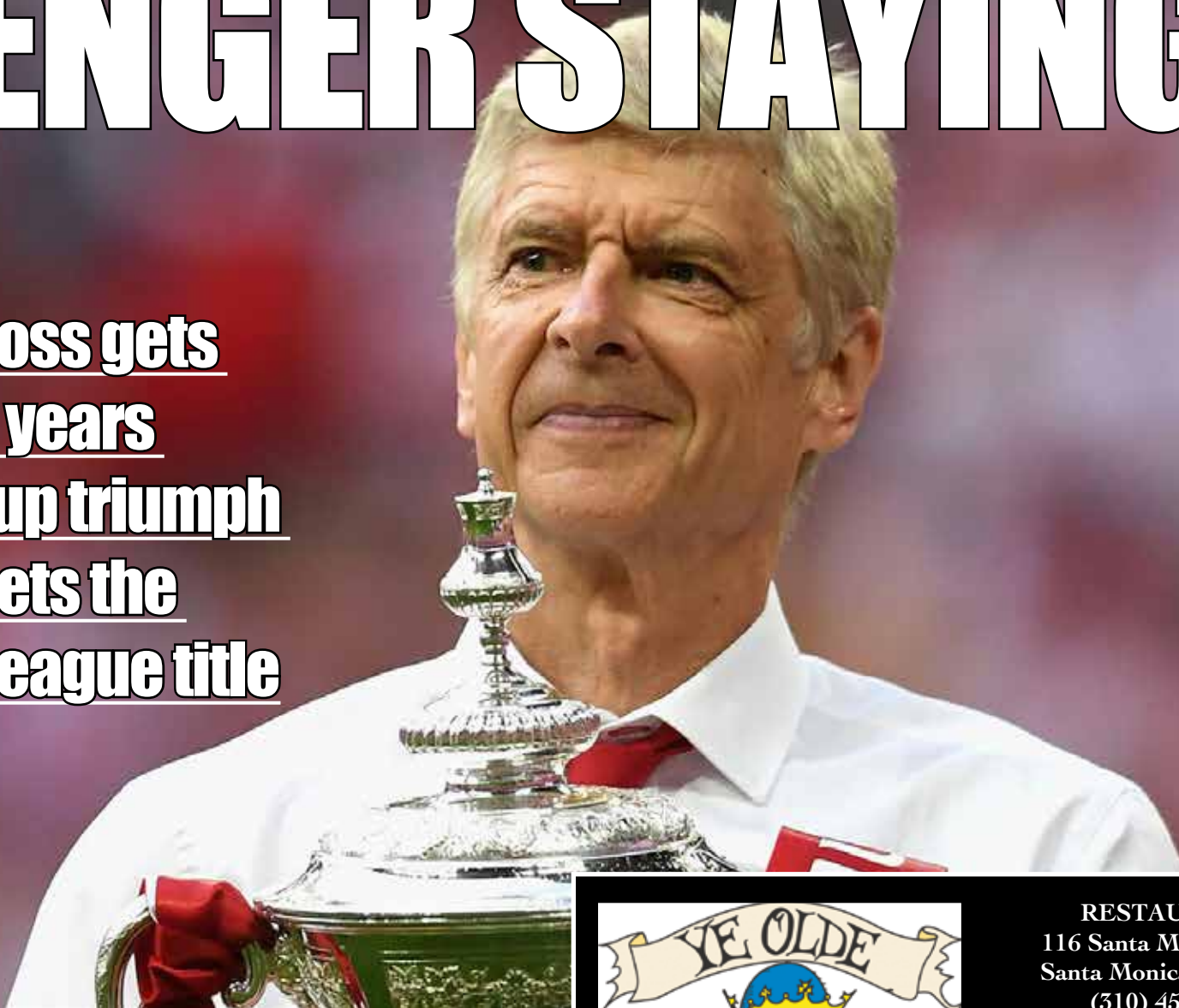
The Swedish striker is yet to agree an extension to his one-year deal.

Raiola said: "It is right that we talk to Manchester United and see what they are thinking and whether he is of value to them."

Ibrahimovic, who joined the club on a free transfer from Paris St-Germain last summer, has been out injured since suffering cruciate knee-ligament damage in April.

WENGER STAYING...

Arsenal boss gets two more years after FA Cup triumph - and targets the Premier League title



Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger is targeting next season's Premier League title after signing a new two-year deal at the club.

The agreement does not include a break clause and, should it be completed, will extend his reign to 23 years.

Neither Arsenal nor Wenger, 67, see this as definitely being his final contract.

"I love this club and I am looking forward to the future with optimism and excitement," said Wenger.

Arsenal are expected to spend at least £100m on new players in the upcoming transfer window - which opens on 1 July - having also spent around that figure last summer.

"This is a strong group of players and with some additions we can be even more successful," Wenger told the club

website.

"We're committed to mounting a sustained league challenge and that will be our focus this summer and next season."

The Gunners finished fifth in the Premier League this season, the first time they have finished outside the top four since the Frenchman joined in 1996.

They finished 18 points behind champions Chelsea, but beat the Blues 2-1 to win the FA Cup at Wembley on Saturday.

Wenger met club owner Stan Kroenke on Monday to determine his future, with the decision relayed to directors at a Tuesday board meeting.

Following Wednesday's official announcement, chief executive Ivan Gazidis said: "There is no complacency anywhere at this club.

"Our goal is to compete for and win trophies here and in Europe. Everything we do is designed to make that happen and we will be working hard on and off the pitch this summer to improve and make a strong challenge next season."

American majority owner Kroenke said the Gunners' ambition was to win the Premier League and "other major trophies in Europe" under Frenchman Wenger.

"It's what the fans, players, staff, manager and board expect and we won't rest until that is achieved - Arsene is the best person to help us make that happen," he added.

Uzbek-born Russian billionaire Alisher Usmanov, who made a £1bn bid to wrest control of the club from

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
