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HILLSBOROUGH: SIX FACING CHARGES

■ Match commander and ex-police chief among those to stand trial over disaster

Hillsborough match commander David Duckenfield, former chief constable Sir Norman Bettison and four other people are to be prosecuted over offences relating to the Hillsborough disaster.

The Crown Prosecution Service announced that Duckenfield is to be charged with the manslaughter by gross negligence of 95 of the 96 Liverpool FC fans who died at the FA Cup semi-final in 1989 and Bettison has been charged with four counts of misconduct in public office. Sue Hemming, head of the CPS's special crime division, said former South Yorkshire Police officers Donald Denton and Alan Foster, as well as force solicitor Peter Metcalf, are charged with doing acts with intent to pervert the course of justice. Former Sheffield Wednesday secretary Graham Mackrell is also charged with three offences relating to health and safety at sports grounds. Families of the victims gathered in Warrington

on Wednesday morning to hear the announcement, which was released to the public in a 3,780-word statement around 20 minutes later. In the House of Commons, Prime Minister Theresa May welcomed the decision by the CPS and praised the "absolutely exemplary" campaign by the Hillsborough families and others. Mrs May said: "I know from working closely with the families when I was Home Secretary that this will be a day of mixed emotions for them. "I welcome the fact that charging decisions have been taken. I think that is an important step forward. But the House will understand that I cannot say anything further on matters that are now subject to a

criminal prosecution." Barry Devonside, whose 18-year-old son Christopher was killed in the disaster, pumped his fist as he emerged from the meeting with the lawyers and other relatives of the 96. He said: "Everybody applauded when it was announced that the most senior police officer on that particular day will have charges presented to him."

Speaking on behalf of some of the families, lawyer Marcia Willis-Stewart said: "The Hillsborough families have waited 28 years for justice. 'beginning of the end' "Some of the truth was exposed by the independent panel and some by the inquest jury on April 26 2016. Now we await the results from the long overdue

process of accountability - accountability being key and at the heart. "The families are sensitive to the issues of fairness and due process and no-one wishes to prejudice or to jeopardise it. "There are of course various legal options open to the families where decisions have been made not to prosecute, in the form of the victim and judicial

review process. As I said, 28 years for justice, now is the time for accountability." Hillsborough Family Support Group chairwoman Margaret Aspinall has said it is the "beginning of the end". She said: "Every time we have been knocked down we have been determined to come back stronger." Trevor Hicks, whose cont. on page 2, col. 1

daughters Sarah and Vicki died in the disaster at the 1989 FA Cup semi-final, said: "This is a success for society at large, not just for us."

Mrs Aspinall, whose 18-year-old son, James, died in the tragedy, said: "No one should have to go through what the families have gone through for 28 years to try and get to the truth and to get accountability. "I think now what has been achieved today will change things for the good of this nation and I think that's the legacy of our 96, that they will have left behind."

Prosecutor Ms Hemming said a further file from the Independent Police Complaints Commission (IPCC)

on the conduct of West Midlands Police still needs "additional investigative work".

She added: "Additionally, just this week, the IPCC has referred two further suspects which are unconnected to the matters sent to us in January; these subjects are subject to ongoing consideration by the CPS. We will announce our decisions in due course."

'appalling tragedy'

"The suspects referred to the CPS included individuals and organisations. Following these thorough investigations and our careful review of the evidence in accordance with the Code for Crown Prosecutors, I have decided there is sufficient evidence to charge six individuals with criminal offences."

All the defendants, except Duckenfield who has not yet been formally charged, will appear at Warrington Magistrates' Court on August 8.

Stephen Watson, the current South Yorkshire Police Chief Constable, said: "Given that criminal proceedings are now active, it would be inappropriate for me to comment further for fear of jeopardising this important process in any way."

"In all of this however, our thoughts are with the Hillsborough families as we reflect on the appalling tragedy that is Hillsborough with the loss of so many innocent lives."

Evelyn McDonnell Mills, whose brother Peter McDonnell, 21, died in the disaster, said: "I'm really happy that we've finally got some charges after 28 years."

"I'm just sad that my brother Gerard, who campaigned for years, died in the first year of the new inquests and never got to see justice."

In April last year, an inquest jury ruled the victims had been unlawfully killed in the tragedy. The deaths were ruled accidental at the end of the original 1991 inquest.

But those verdicts were quashed following the 2012 Hillsborough

Independent Panel report, which concluded that a major cover-up had

taken place in an effort by police and others to avoid the blame for what happened.

The new jury concluded that blunders by the police and ambulance

service on the day had "caused or contributed" to the disaster and that the victims had been unlawfully killed.

After the verdict, South Yorkshire Police

Chief Constable David Crompton said his force "unequivocally" accepted the verdict of unlawful killing and the wider findings reached by the jury.

The spirit of the age...

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Stormont power sharing talks extended again

The timeframe to find a deal to restore a power-sharing government in Northern Ireland has been extended to Monday.

Parties failed to reach a deal before the initial deadline of 16:00 BST on Thursday.

However, a spokesperson for Theresa May said the parties would be given "space to continue the discussions".

If no deal is reached by Monday, Northern Ireland could face the possibility of direct rule from Westminster.

Earlier, two sittings of the assembly, scheduled to elect a first and deputy first minister, were cancelled.

The parties had faced a deadline of 16:00 BST to reach a deal but the Democratic Unionist Party earlier said that the minister would not be appointed to Stormont in that timeframe.

The DUP and Sinn Féin are deadlocked over nationalist demands for an Irish language act.

Either the DUP must drop its opposition to a stand-alone act or Sinn Féin must accept a wider form of legislation - a so-called hybrid model which would also cover the Ulster-Scots language.

The DUP's Edwin Poots said his party would "have a preference for direct rule ministers" because Northern Ireland is in "paralysis".

Sinn Féin said it is "make your mind up time for the DUP".

Conor Murphy, from Sinn Féin, said that there had been sufficient time to strike a deal but criticised the "confidence and supply" deal between the DUP and Conservative Party for making an agreement more difficult.

Susan Boyle repeatedly targeted by local jobs

Britain's Got Talent winner Susan Boyle is being regularly abused and hounded by a gang of up to 15 youths outside her home, it has been claimed.

The singer is considering calling police to ensure her safety after being subjected to intimidation by the gang who are claimed to be threatening other locals as well, a spokesman said.

As well as being verbally abused, the Aspergers sufferer has reportedly had lit paper

thrown at her and stones while travelling on the bus, the Mirror has reported.

She has even been abused at her local shopping centre, the Mill Centre, in Blackburn, West Lothian, where she was called an 'old, ugly b****'.

A witness claimed: 'We were inside the bus and they were throwing stones, screaming and shouting things.'

'Another time 10-15 of them were surrounding and throwing stuff.'

'They lit a piece of

paper and threw it at her face.

'Then I was going inside the Mill Centre, Susan was walking out and they were all standing at the entrance and they said to her 'why don't you get yourself a pair of glasses you ugly, old b****. It's horrendous.'

The 56-year-old lives in the council home she bought after winning Britain's Got Talent in 2009.

She also owns another five-bedroom property at the other end of the town,

which her niece lives in. Neighbours, who have also been abused, have tried to look out for her.

Corbyn fires three frontbenchers after Brexit revolt

Jeremy Corbyn was forced to sack three shadow ministers Thursday night when they joined dozens of Labour MPs rebelling against the party over Brexit.

In a serious blow to Mr Corbyn's authority, 49 Labour MPs defied the party whip to back a Queen's Speech amendment tabled by their backbench colleague Chuka Umunna.

They included the shadow foreign minister Catherine West, shadow housing ministers Ruth Cadbury and Andy Slaughter, all of whom

were sacked by Mr Corbyn, and shadow transport minister Daniel Zeichner, who resigned.

The vote exposed a major rift within Labour over Brexit, as Mr Umunna had called for Britain to stay in the single market, in direct contravention of official Labour policy.

It was a humiliation for Mr Corbyn, who had hoped to defeat the Queen's Speech and force Theresa May's resignation, but instead found himself to be the victim of a revolt.

The Conservatives pounced on the vote to accuse Labour of "total

chaos" over Brexit.

Mr Corbyn's decision to sack three people - as many front benchers as he had sacked in his entire time as Labour leader - indicated the depth of anger felt by Mr Corbyn and his team, who had issued a three-line whip ordering all Labour MPs to abstain from the vote.

It also burst Mr Corbyn's post-election bubble after his party had appeared more unified as a result of its general election gains.

The Labour leader will now be forced to carry out another unintended reshuffle, as he did after shadow ministers were among 47 MPs who defied him by voting

against Article 50 in February. any Tories in favour of a "soft" Brexit.

Mr Umunna's amendment, which was defeated by 322 votes to 101, called for Britain to remain in the single market and the customs union, but failed to tempt Coupled with the passing of the Queen's Speech, it means Mrs May has now come through the first major Parliamentary test of her pact with the DUP.

It wasn't all bad....

A horse in Yorkshire is being trained to become Britain's first "guide horse".

At just seven weeks old, Digby, an American miniature, is being taught by his owner, Katy Smith, to lead visually impaired people and help with household chores - just like a guide dog. He is already capable of walking and guiding with a halter harness. In the US, American miniatures - which grow to be no bigger than large dogs - are already a popular option for guiding, because they are mild-mannered, have excellent eyesight and live

for 30 years on average - twice as long as a dog.

Forget the seven-year itch: the average length of a marriage in England and Wales is now 11.9 years, the second-highest figure on record. At its nadir, in 1985, the median was just 8.9 years, but since then it has steadily increased. The divorce rate is also at an all-time low: there were 8.5 divorces per 1,000 married men and women in 2015, down from a peak of 14.3 in 1993. Experts suggest that as couples now wait longer before getting married, the resulting marriages may be more stable.

Northern Ireland women to get free abortions on NHS

■ Controversial concession heads off Tory revolt

Women from Northern Ireland will be able to get abortions in England, the government has said.

More than 50 MPs from the major parties had backed a Labour-led call for the women to have abortions for free in England - they currently have to pay.

It is widely believed that ministers made the concession because it appeared some Tory MPs might back the call, risking a possible defeat in the House for Theresa May.

Northern Ireland's abortion laws are much stricter than the rest of the UK.

Abortions are only allowed in Northern Ireland if a woman's life is at risk or there is a permanent or serious risk to her physical or mental health. Rape, incest and fatal foetal abnormalities are not circumstances in which they can be performed legally.

Women seeking an abortion can travel to England to have one privately, but had not been allowed to have them free on the NHS - a position that was backed by the UK Supreme Court earlier this month.

An amendment on the issue, co-ordinated by Labour's Stella Creasy, which had cross-party backing, had been selected for inclusion in the Queen's Speech debate - which meant Theresa May's government ran the risk of possible defeat.

Since the election Mrs May no longer has a majority of MPs so has to rely on backing from the 10 DUP MPs - but even then she remains vulnerable to a rebellion from her own Conservative MPs.

The news of the change of policy was welcomed by the British Pregnancy Advisory Service which described it as a "landmark moment: for years the women of

Northern Ireland, despite being UK citizens and taxpayers, have not been entitled to NHS-funded treatment".

Without an overall majority, the Tories were facing a defeat after an impressive campaign by the Labour backbencher Stella Creasy that had garnered support among plenty of Conservatives who looked like they might rebel and vote with her, rather than with their party bosses.

Campaigner Sarah Ewart, who travelled to England for a termination in 2013 after doctors said her unborn child had no chance of survival outside the womb, said of the chancellor's announcement that it was positive news, but it was unfortunate that women from Northern Ireland found themselves in this position in the first place.

The prime minister's official spokeswoman said later the government

had estimated the cost of the decision to be "around £1m a year" and that the government was "prepared to fund in excess of this" if needed. The estimate was based on the 724 women who travelled from Northern Ireland last year to have an abortion.

She added that ministers had "had concerns about the issue and that's why we're taking action".

Following the

concession from the government, Stella Creasy's amendment was withdrawn.

Liberal Democrat deputy leader Jo Swinson congratulated the Labour MP and said: "I'm glad that Justine Greening has acted on this issue, but it is embarrassing that the health secretary had done nothing on this so far and only the threat of a defeat prompted change."

"Women deserve

better than having their rights reliant on House of Commons arithmetic."

The concession on abortion came on the same day Belfast's Court of Appeal ruled abortion law in Northern Ireland should be left to the Stormont Assembly, not judges - effectively overturning an earlier ruling that the current abortion laws were incompatible with human rights laws.

Mum's horror as she opens nappy to find son had been circumcised

■ Procedure ordered by her husband's Muslim parents without her knowledge, Notts woman alleges

A mother has described the distress of discovering her baby son had been circumcised without her consent.

The woman, from Nottingham, said she opened her son's nappy to find him covered in blood - and was so distraught she had to leave the room.

She has battled for four years for authorities to take action.

Three people have now been arrested, including a 61-year-old man - thought to be a doctor - on suspicion of grievous bodily harm with intent.

"I opened the nappy and I ended up having to leave the room because I felt hysterical," said the mother, who did not want to be identified.

"It was just awful really, it wasn't very nice, there was all blood there and stuff."

'Boys not protected'

The boy was circumcised in July 2013 when he was three months old, and apparently staying with his paternal grandparents, who are Muslim.

His mother originally contacted social services, then contacted Nottinghamshire Police on 24 November 2014.

There was an investigation but the force deemed it not to be a criminal matter, and the case was referred to the General Medical Council.

The mother later got help from the anti-circumcision group Men

Do Complain and leading human rights lawyer Saimo Chahal QC, who wrote to Nottinghamshire Police.

According to the British Medical Association, male circumcision in the UK is generally assumed to be lawful provided there is valid consent.

However, the mother believes it amounts to MGM or "male genital mutilation", and should be viewed in the same way as female genital mutilation (FGM).

"It's even illegal to dock dogs' tails. I've come home crying my eyes out thinking a dog has got more rights than my child."

"There's something seriously not right with it all. You can protect a dog,

you can protect a girl, but not a boy."

After the letter from Ms Chahal, police reopened the investigation and arrested three suspects, including the 61-year-old man, on 21 June.

The other two suspects - 44-year-old man and 47-year-old woman believed to be the boy's paternal grandparents - have been arrested on suspicion of conspiracy to

commit grievous bodily harm.

Police said all three suspects had been released pending further investigation.

In the years since the circumcision, the mother said her son has suffered from recurring infections, and his penis regularly becomes inflamed and sore.

She said the circumcision has affected her, as well as

her son.

"I was really upset about it. It didn't really get much better from there, it's just been ongoing really."

"Even a couple of police officers have made remarks like 'Oh my husband is circumcised, I think it's better'. Or 'Oh they are tougher than they look, it will toughen him up'. It's just silly little comments like that. It's just heartbreaking."

'Fake man' sex attacker found guilty

■ Retrial finds woman posed as American man to seduce 'emotionally vulnerable' woman

A woman has been convicted of impersonating a man for more than two years in an "astonishing deception" to trick her female friend into sex.

Gayle Newland, 27, of Willaston, Cheshire, created a "disturbingly complex" online persona to achieve her own "bizarre sexual satisfaction".

A retrial jury at Manchester Crown Court found her guilty of committing sexual

assault by using a prosthetic penis without her victim's consent.

The Recorder of Manchester, Judge David Stockdale QC, granted Newland bail ahead of sentencing but told her the "overwhelming likelihood" was that she would receive "a significant immediate custodial sentence".

Newland was found guilty of three counts of sexual assault and cleared of a fourth count. She was told by the

judge she would have to sign the sex offenders register.

Newland said she created the Facebook profile of Kye Fortune - using an American man's photographs and videos - at the age of 15, because she found it difficult to talk to girls in person.

blindfold

When giving evidence behind a curtain, the "emotionally vulnerable" complainant said Kye told her he was undergoing treatment for cancer and was paranoid about his physical appearance.

She agreed to his demands for her to wear a blindfold, consisting of a sleeping mask and a light scarf, because she was in love, she said.

The complainant, also in her mid 20s, said: "There was no point until the day I took the blindfold off that I thought for one second

that a woman was the person behind this."

She said she received a Facebook friend request from Kye, who shared the same birthday and interests as the defendant.

She said Kye introduced her to Newland as his best friend.

Mr Medland asked her: "To who were you consenting?"

She replied: "With Kye Fortune. The person I knew from the photos, the person I had spoken

to, the person I shared all my dreams with, the person who I thought was half-Filipino half-Latino."

Newland, who graduated from the University of Chester with a degree in marketing and creative writing, told the court the complainant approached her in a nightclub in 2011 and asked her if she was gay.

She said: "I said I was not comfortable with it. She told me she was gay too.

"She was not comfortable with it and no-one knew. There was common ground straightaway."

Newland's version of events was that she then drunkenly told the woman about the Kye Fortune persona and the pair began communicating in character.

The pair finally met up in character in 2013 but the defendant told the court she never dressed as a man and no blindfold was ever used.

Russia mocks Royal Navy's latest flagship as 'large convenient target'

The Russian military has responded to British mockery of an ageing aircraft carrier by declaring that the Royal Navy's new flagship is nothing more than "a large, convenient target".

As a war of words between the two countries continued to escalate, Moscow pointed to the Admiral Kuznetsov's array of missiles and warned HMS Queen Elizabeth should keep its distance.

The clash of naval pride flared after the Defence Secretary earlier this week said Russia would envy HMS Queen Elizabeth because its own carrier was so old and dilapidated.

Apparently stung by the remark, the Russian defence ministry on Thursday derided Sir Michael Fallon and the UK's £3.1bn warship.

Sir Michael had said Russian vessels would be looking at sea trials of the Navy's 65,000 ton warship "with a little bit of envy".

The Russian defence ministry responded that Sir Michael's "rapturous statements ... about the supremacy of the new aircraft carrier's beautiful exterior over the Russian aircraft-carrying cruiser

Admiral Kuznetsov expose Fallon's utter ignorance of naval military science."

The ministry said the Kuznetsov was bristling with anti-ship and anti-submarine missiles, while HMS Queen Elizabeth will have to rely on the weapons of its F-35B aircraft and escort of frigates, destroyers and submarines.

"Like a bee, the British aircraft carrier is only capable of independently releasing planes from its belly closely flanked by a swarm of warships, support ships and submarines to protect it. That is why ... the British aircraft carrier is merely a large convenient naval target."

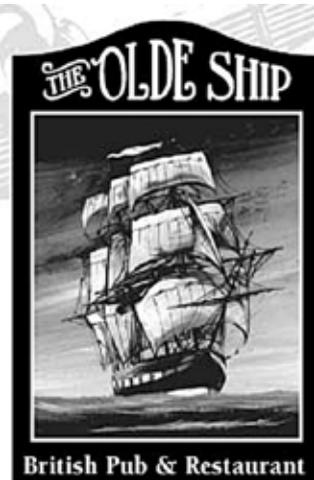
"It is in the interests of the British Royal Navy not to show off the 'beauty' of its aircraft carrier on the high seas any closer than a few hundred miles from its Russian 'distant relative,'" the ministry said.

The Kuznetsov is a Soviet-era carrier and has been plagued by technical troubles.

The HMS Queen Elizabeth began sea trials earlier this week and is not expected to be deployed on operations until 2021.

The summer heat encourages regular water intake and ensures that nobody forgets to hydrate on a regular basis. This improves concentration levels, wellness and helps the body eliminate poisons like alcohol and sugary drinks.

5. You eat more greens and smaller portions.

Most people reduce their food intake in the summer because they are properly hydrated and do not feel the need to eat as much food. Winter months can encourage comfort eating - a quick example would be on a cold day someone may feel very cold, therefore

may try to find a meal which warms them up (this can sometimes be comfort eating).

6. You warm up quicker and save vital time.

When warming up in colder climates, it takes much longer to prepare the body for the exercise that follows. In summer, the body is warm within minutes - therefore, there is no need to spend 10-20 minutes warming up!

7. Less prone to injuries.

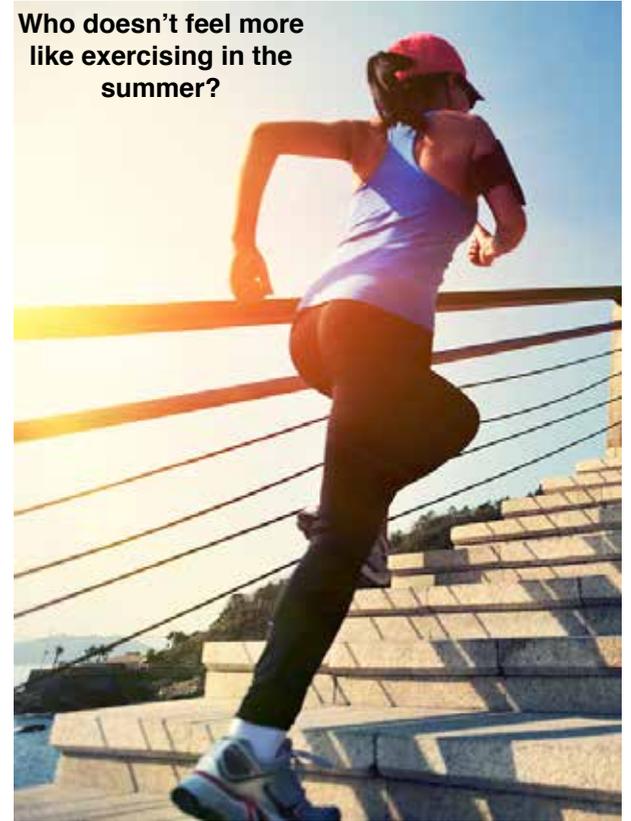
In warm weather, muscles become warmer and more elastic much quicker - therefore the threat of injury is reduced because the muscles are much more softer, prepared and heated to be able to workout.

8. Exercising in completely new environments and areas.

In colder climates, most exercise takes place indoors - mostly inside gymnasiums, due to cooler temperatures outside. In the summer, the bodycamp uses shaded outdoor areas daily to exercise - such as under huge trees for boxing, abs and circuits, under cover of woodlands for hikes, yurts for meditation and water-based workouts every day, like the clear sea and the blue oceans.

9. Increased chance of vitamin D intake.

Who doesn't feel more like exercising in the summer?



With most people deficient in vitamin D due to limited exposure to sunshine, its clear to see that even five minutes a day of a small amount of exposure to sunlight could be of benefit to the skin and the body. In the summer months, this is not a problem because we can limit our exposure to the sun to five minutes or more - if we choose too.

10. Increased happy mood state.

Weather plays a huge part in people's moods and happiness some studies have suggested - therefore

the summer months can maybe bring fun and sunshine to everyone!

11. You play more 80's music.

Enough said!

Enjoy the fun and heat the sun brings to our lives. It has many positive effects on us, especially when we exercise in it in moderate amounts. So keep that warm sunny outlook!

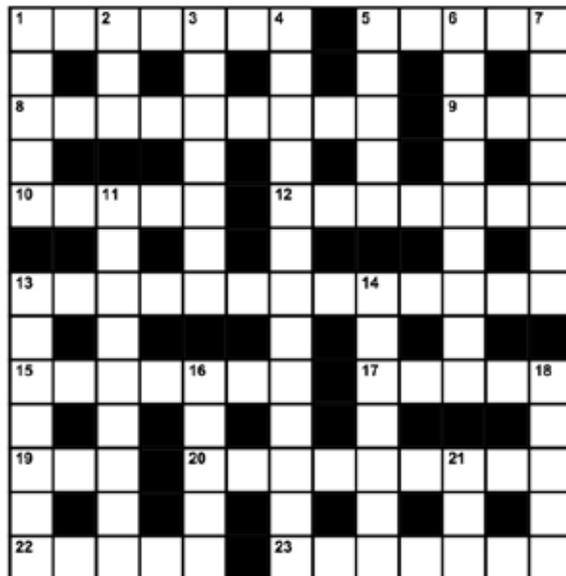

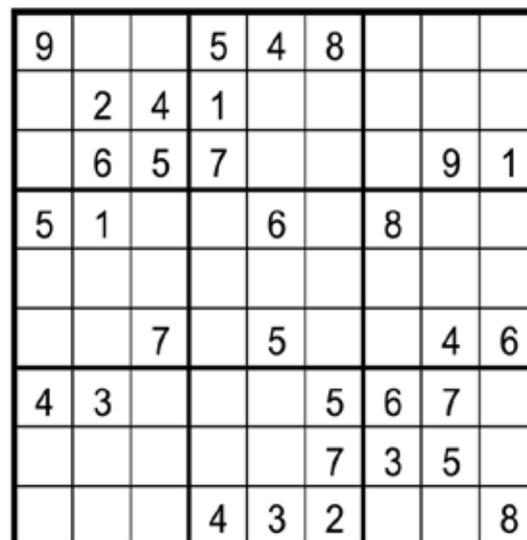

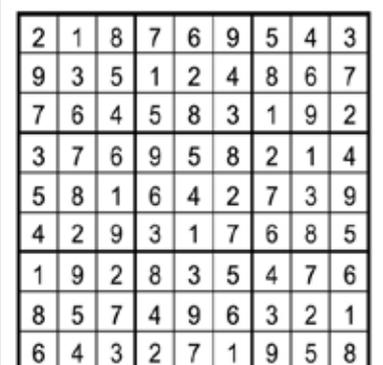

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

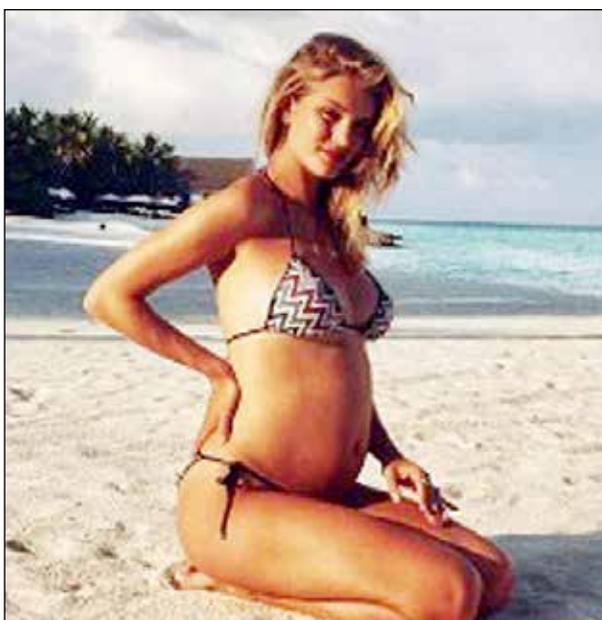
Rosie announced the happy news on Instagram with a snap of her relaxing on a beach in a bikini (right), clearly showing her baby bump.

■ Exclusive interview with author Robinne Lee, discussing her new novel about a mom who finds herself in the tabloids for dating a performer half her age



"Right out of school I'd managed a singing group that was produced by one of the members of the New Kids on the Block," says *The Idea of You* author Robinne Lee (pictured, above).

"I spent a lot of time around them when they were still at the height of their fame. A few years ago, my husband was away on business and I was up late surfing music videos on YouTube when

I came across the face of a boy I'd never seen in a band I'd never paid attention to."

"It was so aesthetically perfect it took me by surprise," says Lee. "It was like...art. I spent a good hour or so Googling and trying to figure out who this kid was. In doing so I discovered that he often dated older women, and so the seed was planted. When my husband returned a couple of days later, I joked with him that I'd found the perfect guy and I was leaving him and our two kids. 'Oh, and by the way, he's half my age.' My husband laughed, and then a moment later said, you know, that would make a great book."

In *The Idea of You*, Solène Marchand is a 39-year-old divorced mother and owner of an art gallery in

Los Angeles. Solène meets her daughter Isabelle's favorite boy band August Moon. Solène is intrigued by band member Hayes Campbell. He's clever and confident. He's also 20 years old, closer to her daughters age than hers. Solène soon finds herself in a relationship with Hayes, and seeing her life and her daughter's exposed in the tabloids.

Keane on verge of Toffees move

Everton are closing in on a £25m deal for England defender Michael Keane from Premier League rivals Burnley.

Keane, 24 (pictured, above), has been a top target for Everton manager Ronald Koeman and he revealed his admiration for the ex-Manchester United player last season.

Talks are continuing and Everton hope to secure a deal before they report back for pre-season training on Monday.

United were at one stage interested in re-signing Keane, who was sold to the Claretts for £2m in 2015.

Keane made his England debut against Germany in Dortmund in March and had an outstanding season for Burnley on their return to the Premier League.

The proposed signing

continues Everton's ambitious summer after their £30m deal for England Under-21 goalkeeper Jordan Pickford from Sunderland and a £24m move for Ajax captain Davy Klaassen.

Everton director of football Steve Walsh is also a big fan of Keane from his time at Leicester City, who the defender spent a successful loan spell with and who had an offer for Keane turned down last summer.

Keane and Pickford were both nominated for the Professional Footballers' Association Young Player Of The Year award in 2017, which was won by Tottenham midfielder Dele Alli.

Everton are still waiting to announce the signing of Malaga striker Sandro Ramirez, who has had a medical and agreed personal terms on

a £5.2m move. He is on duty with Spain Under-21s as they prepare to face Germany in the European Championship final in Poland.

Nigeria striker Henry Onyekuru, 20, confirmed on his Instagram account that he is also moving to Everton in a £7m deal, although the youngster will be loaned to Anderlecht for 12 months. The Toffees are also yet to announce this transfer.

Keane's expected arrival will not be the end of Everton's big spending, with manager Koeman determined to test Swansea City's resolve to keep 27-year-old Iceland midfielder Gylfi Sigurdsson.

The Toffees may also conduct further business with Burnley this summer after reports talks have opened over striker Andre Gray.

Keane's former club United will profit from any deal after inserting a 25% sell-on clause in his initial transfer.

United manager Jose Mourinho ended any pursuit of Keane by opting to sign Sweden defender Victor Lindelof from Benfica for £31m.

Defoe goes back to the Cherries

Sunderland striker Jermain Defoe has resigned for former club Bournemouth on a free transfer.

The 34-year-old England international, who scored 15 league goals last season, has signed a three-year deal.

"It's great to be back," said Defoe, who as a teenager spent the 2000-01 season on loan at Bournemouth from West Ham, scoring in 10 successive matches.

"It was an easy decision, joining a top team with a top manager. The one thing I can guarantee is goals."

The former Tottenham, Portsmouth, West Ham and Charlton player is seventh on the Premier League all-time goals

list with 158 in 468 appearances.

Cherries manager Eddie Howe said Defoe's signing is a "huge moment for the club".

Defoe moved to Sunderland in January 2015 after a brief spell at MLS side Toronto and, after saving the club from relegation in the 2015-16 season with 15 goals, signed a contract extension until 2019.

There was a clause in his contract that allowed him to leave on a free transfer if Sunderland were relegated, which he was able to trigger when the Black Cats finished bottom last season.

Defoe made his England debut in 2004 and played at the 2010 World Cup, but did not feature for

the national side between 2013 and 2017.

His excellent form last season earned him a recall to Gareth Southgate's side, and he scored his 20th international goal against Lithuania in a World Cup qualifier in March.

Defoe is Bournemouth's second signing of the summer, following the arrival of goalkeeper Asmir Begovic from Chelsea.

"We want to bring players here who can have a big impact on our continued rise and we believe Jermain fits that as a natural, proven goalscorer," added Howe.

The Cherries finished ninth in the Premier League last term - their second season in the top flight.

Fifty-something fisticuffs? Nigel Benn and Steve Collins announce third bout

RETIRED BOXERS Nigel Benn and Steve Collins have agreed a rematch - even though neither man has fought since the 1990s and both are over 50.

Benn, 53, and Collins, 52, were once among the biggest names in the super-middleweight division.

Dublin-born Collins has twice beaten Londoner Benn, who retired after their second fight in 1996.

Details of the third fight are yet to be agreed but Benn expects it to take place in October or November.

Benn held the WBO

middleweight title and the WBC super-middleweight belt before retiring as a fighter following his second defeat by Collins at the Manchester Arena in November 1996.

Collins ended Chris Eubank's unbeaten record to win the WBO super-middleweight title in 1995, and successfully defended the title seven times, include twice against Benn.

Benn came into the first fight in July 1996 having lost his WBC World super middleweight title to Thulani Malinga.

Collins stopped his

opponent in the fourth round, with Benn suffering an ankle injury, but the pair then had a rematch just four months later.

The Englishman battled through to the end of round six before retiring in his corner. Collins had two more fights, retaining his WBO title, retiring in July 1997.

If the British Boxing Board of Control refuses to sanction the bout, both fighters have said they would seek a boxing licence from abroad.

"It's about the final chapter," Benn said. "It's about closure."

England lose on penalties yet again

■ U-21 team miss out on final spot as - guess who? - Germans go through after 2-2 semi-final thriller

THERE WAS PENALTY heartbreak yet again for England this week as Aidy Boothroyd's Under-21 team were denied a place in the European Championship final, losing a gripping semi-final against Germany on spot kicks.

Julian Pollersbeck saved Nathan Redmond's spot-kick as the Germans edged through in Tychy, Poland.

Boothroyd's Young Lions had fallen behind when Davie Selke headed home, but Demarai Gray levelled the scores.

Tammy Abraham made

it 2-1 to England with a tap-in but Felix Platte's header took the game to extra time.

Not for the first time, an England team is left to reflect on what might have been after losing a semi-final against Germany on penalties.

It happened at the 1990 World Cup in Italy when Chris Waddle and Stuart Pearce faltered from the spot, and at the 1996 European Championship at Wembley, when Gareth Southgate's penalty was saved.

On Tuesday, Boothroyd's team were 20

minutes from a place in the final when Platte equalised following a corner.

In an action-packed game, Salke had put the Germans ahead when he met Jermeij Toljan's cross, before Leicester's Gray was well placed to equalise after Germany failed to deal with Ward-Prowse's corner.

Will Hughes teed up Abraham to give England the lead and both teams missed chances to secure victory in extra time.

Despite this result, the tournament has provided Boothroyd with plenty of

positives for the future. England drew with Sweden before beating Poland to win their group and set up the semi-final with Germany.

This time last year, English football was reeling after the senior team were humiliated and humbled by Iceland at Euro 2016.

The date - 27 June 2016 - will always be a haunting reminder of arguably

England's worst-ever defeat.

One year later, the Football Association can reflect on genuine shoots of recovery, with the under-17s reaching their Euro finals and the under-20s winning the World Cup in South Korea.

Boothroyd told reporters after the match: "We're absolutely gutted to go out in the way that we did. We might not have been at our best

for long periods but we showed a real British bulldog spirit.

We could have nicked it but that's football. We've practised, practised and practised penalties but the keeper has made two good saves. It was a real effort - a real backs against the wall job at times.

"It's been a long journey. The tournament has been fantastic. I'm sure there will be future senior players in this team."

Gatland's 'last roll of the dice' as Lions seek to level series

British and Irish Lions coach Warren Gatland has made his "last roll of the dice" in picking both Johnny Sexton and Owen Farrell for today's second Test against New Zealand, says former Wales fly-half Jonathan Davies.

Sexton and Farrell have played only 74 minutes together as a 10-12 axis in the eight previous matches on the tour.

Despite being selected in the squad as a fly-half, Farrell replaces Ben Te'o at inside centre, resuming the midfield role he plays for England.

"It is a worry that they have not played together more. I'm surprised," Davies told BBC Sport.

Gatland said the pairing of Ireland playmaker Sexton and Farrell would make the Lions more creative and clinical.

"Both have played well and it gives us that attacking option in the 10-12 channel," Gatland said.
