Tearful goodbye to tragic Charlie

Parents pay tribute to stricken child, telling the High Court 'we will let our son go and be with the angels.'

TRAGIC Charlie Gard's parents praised him as 'too special for this cruel world' on Monday as their court battle to save his life came to a heartbreaking end.

Tearful Connie Yates and Chris Gard said time had run out for their 'sweet, gorgeous, innocent little boy' in his fight against a devastating disease.

They admitted Charlie will not live to see his first birthday on August 4th after allowing doctors to withdraw life support treatment so he can 'die with dignity'.

Charlie's mother read

their statement to a hushed High Court hearing in which they withdrew a bid to take him for experimental treatment in America.

They were swayed by new medical scans which showed the youngster's energy-sapping mitochondrial disease has caused irreparable muscle damage.

Charlie's mother told the

court: "This is one of the hardest things that we will ever have to say and we are about to do the hardest thing that we'll ever have to do which is to let our beautiful little Charlie go.

"Put simply, this is about a sweet, gorgeous, innocent little boy who was born with a rare disease, who had a real, genuine chance at life and a family who love him so very dearly and that's why we fought so hard for him."

After the most recent scan of his muscles, she said: "As Charlie's devoted and loving parents we have decided that it's no longer in Charlie's best interests to pursue treatment and we will let our son go and be with the angels."

Great Ormond Street Hospital has long argued that Charlie should be allowed to die in dignity because the experimental therapy would not help

him.

Until Monday's change of heart, Charlie's parents had begged to take Charlie home to die. But they have now agreed to take him to a hospice for his final days.

The children's hospital had suggested that Charlie should go to a hospice because his ventilator cannot be used at the family's London home.

The court case went back to the High Court after new evidence emerged over treatment that might have been able to help Charlie.

But Charlie Gard's parents' lawyer said it is now "too late" for Charlie because the damage has already been done.

Earlier this month Donald Trump offered to his support to his parents after the Vatican said the Pope was following the case "with affection and sadness".

Mr Trump tweeted: "If we can help little #CharlieGard, as per our friends in the UK and the Pope, we would be delighted to do so."

Charlie has a rare

genetic condition called mitochondrial depletion syndrome, which saps energy from vital organs and causes progressive muscle weakness.

His parents from Bedfont, west London, desperately wanted their baby Charlie to undergo a therapy trial in America.

But their final plea was rejected by European court judges in Strasbourg after a 10-month legal battle that saw Charlie's parents lose cases in the High Court, the Court of Appeal and the Supreme Court.

End of the road for petrol and diesel?

- Sales of new fossil-fuel powered cars banned by 2040
- Gove announces "comprehensive clean-air strategy"

NO new petrol or diesel cars will be sold in Britain by 2040 in a Government drive to cut emissions, it was announced on Wednesday.

Under plans outlined by Michael Gove, the environment secretary, dozens of councils with roads breaching legal limits for NO₂ (Nitrogen Dioxide) will be required to publish initial plans to cut emissions by the end of March and final proposals by the end of next year.

Councils will also be allowed to ban diesel vehicles in some polluted areas, Mr Gove said.

Ministers will leave it to councils to decide how to tackle the problem, which has angered air-quality campaigners who say that the only effective measure is to require cities to impose entry fees on diesel drivers.

Removing speed humps, reprogramming traffic lights and changing road layouts are among other measures available to town halls, Mr Gove added.

Councils will be allowed to introduce charging zones if no other

measure will cut pollution by the required amount but the government will guide them away from penalizing diesel drivers.

Mr Gove said that charges were a "blunt instrument". He told the Today programme on Radio 4: "I would prefer to use a series of surgical interventions because I think that's fairer to drivers, but also likely to be more effective, more quickly, in the areas that count."

The plan includes a commitment to hold a consultation on a scrappage scheme for older diesel vehicles, though will offer few details on how it might be funded. Mr Gove will announce that a "comprehensive clean-air strategy to tackle the full range of pollutants" will be published next year.

The High Court ordered the government to publish the plan after ruling that a previous version failed to comply with an EU directive to reduce emissions in the "shortest possible time".

A report by the Royal College of Physicians last year estimated that

air pollution - linked to cancer, asthma, stroke and heart disease, diabetes, obesity and dementia - caused 40,000 premature deaths a year.

The announcement comes two weeks after French president Emmanuel Macron pledged to outlaw the sale of vehicles that use an internal combustion engine from 2040. The government's commitment to a similar ban is a strengthening of its previous position. The Conservative manifesto stated: "We want almost every car and van to be zero-emission by 2050."

Two weeks ago the government said that, for this target to be achieved, sales of new petrol and diesel cars would need to stop in 2040.

The air-quality plan is part of a £3 billion programme, of which £2.7 billion had already been revealed, including £1 billion in grants for electric cars. The plan will state that poor air quality is the biggest environmental risk to public health in Britain and cost the country up to £2.7 billion in lost productivity in 2012.

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Dynamite...Diana tapes lift lid on sex life with Charles

INTIMATE footage of Princess Diana speaking candidly about her sex life and marriage to Prince Charles is to be broadcast for the first time.

The “dynamite” films, recorded by Diana’s speech coach David Settelen, show a “relaxed, off-duty princess” in a Channel 4 documentary marking the 20th anniversary of her death next month. In conversations aimed at helping the princess overcome shyness and improve her public speaking, Diana claimed she had met Prince Charles just 13 times before they wed in 1981. She said he only wanted to make love once every three weeks after the marriage, and suggests the Queen did nothing to help when she went to her complaining about his affair with Camilla.

The Princess also claims a police protection officer, Barry Mannakee, with whom she allegedly had an affair in 1985, was deliberately killed when he died two years later in a road accident riding pillion on a motorbike.

Mr Settelen, 65, an actor who appeared in the Second World War movie *A Bridge Too Far*, recorded 16 tapes of Diana talking at home in Kensington Palace in 1992 and 1993. The broadcaster said *Diana: In Her Own Words* shows the Princess hired Mr Settelen to help her prepare to present her own account of events and reinvent her public persona as her marriage broke down. It was preparation that began in 1991 when she

recorded conversations with her friend Dr James Colthurst. These were passed to Andrew Morton to write his biography of her and culminated in her infamous 1995 Panorama interview with Martin Bashir.

Dr Colthurst and Diana’s ballet teacher Anne Allan are among those appearing in the documentary produced for Channel 4 by Kaboom Film & TV which will air early next month. Director Kevin Sim, who worked on a similar project for the BBC that was never screened, said: “The tapes, which show a relaxed and off-duty Diana, are hugely illuminating about her personality, humour and charm.”

Mr Sim suggested

the BBC had dropped the project after it got exclusive access to Prince Charles for a film marking his 60th birthday and feared he would withdraw co-operation. He said: “All of those recordings took place in Kensington Palace and by the end of (the project) we had a considerable amount of taped interviews with Diana, not terribly high quality technically – but in terms of giving you the key to Diana the woman, these were dynamite.”

‘historical record’

He added: “This film gives Diana a voice and places it in front and centre at a time when the nation will be reflecting on her life and death. It is her account of events

both private and public and is an important contribution to the historical record.”

After the tapes were found at the home of Diana’s former butler Paul Burrell, Mr Settelen fought a long legal battle with Diana’s family for ownership and then sold them to the US network NBC,

which screened extracts in a 2004 documentary. The BBC also bought the tapes with a view to using them in a 2007 film to mark the 10th anniversary of her death in a Paris car crash. But the corporation dropped the programme, claiming a year later it had added nothing new to the story. In 2015,

however, it emerged the BBC initially decided to postpone the programme for fear of upsetting the Royal Family. That decision came after it had been forced to apologize for editing a video to give a misleading impression that the Queen had stormed out of a photo session.



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Sons of TV's Lynda slam stepdad in feud over her £5m estate

Bellingham was under her husband's control, claim siblings who received just one tenth of their famous mother's estate

THE sons of "Oxo mum" Lynda Bellingham have accused her third husband of keeping her £5million estate to himself and giving them a derisory sum.

Actress and novelist Lynda, who starred in the 1980s television adverts, died of cancer three years ago. Michael and Robbie Peluso, her sons from her second marriage, launched an appeal after learning that she had left everything to third husband Michael Pattemore, 61, who she married in 2008. They believed that their mother was under her husband's control. "She was scared of him," said Michael, an actor.

"Unfortunately, she was very trusting and her self-esteem was low." Now, after reaching

a settlement with their stepfather, they say they will get just £50,000 each from her fortune. When Lynda died her earnings from Loose Women, touring with a production of Calendar Girls, panto and writing were all in investments and property. Her sons Michael, 34, and Robbie, 29, were expecting

money put in trust for them. Instead, the will said that when Mr Pattemore died, the first £1million of the couple's property portfolio should be divided between her sons. Mr Pattemore said that the brothers had received a £750,000 flat but they said because of conditions attached to

it and after paying their legal bill, they will walk away with less than £50,000 each after sale.

Son Michael said: "Our mum trusted him to look after us and that hasn't happened. At least we're finally nearer to the point where we can have nothing more to do with him."

Mr Pattemore's

behaviour after their mother's death horrified the brothers. Within months, he had a hair transplant, spent thousands on exotic holidays and bought a new Chevrolet Corvette. On ITV's This Morning last week, Mr Pattemore tearfully described his "18 months of hell" over the will.

Mr Pattemore said: "It is wrong and hurtful to suggest she was afraid of me, or that I controlled her in any way." But son Michael said: "It's a kick in the teeth when he's sitting on £5million of property, much of which was bought with our mum's money. None of mum's friends or family will speak to him now."

Expelled aged 5, the boy who attacked teacher with hockey stick

A FIVE-year-old boy who allegedly attacked a teacher with a hockey stick and touched her breasts has become one of the youngest children to be permanently excluded from school.

Luke Hoare was told to leave school last autumn at the start of Year 1. The incident followed a number of outbursts that had scared other children. Even Luke's mother Caroline Hoare, 35, said she did not blame school staff for giving up on him. Confirming what she described as the "attack", she said: "I think they tried their hardest with him. They tried different strategies. He got too much for them."

Luke, who is the fourth of five children aged from two to 12, and lives with Ms Hoare, his stepfather and siblings,

has been diagnosed with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder. He started showing difficult behaviour at two. Soon after he enrolled in a reception class, aged four, teachers began regularly phoning home with complaints.

Ms Hoare said: "Luke was hurting people – spitting, swearing. They put him on half-days in reception and half-days in Year 1. "I'm worried about the future for him. It's scary because I don't know what will happen. I don't know where he will be in five years' time. I hope he can lead a normal life."

Luke, who was excluded from North Denes Primary School, in Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, now attends Brooklands School in nearby Gorleston. It is one of nine "alternative provision" schools for

excluded children run by the Engage Trust which specialises in the education of children with behaviour problems.

Chief executive Des Reynolds said: "Like all our children Luke is just a little boy, a lovely, sweet, funny, cute little boy. He is not a monster. "He wants love and care. We are successful because we give it to him. Excluding is massively damaging for very young children."

The aim was to return him to a mainstream primary. North Denes School said: "Exclusion is a last resort. However, we have to ensure the safety and welfare of our other pupils and our staff, as well as considering the impact on other children's learning."

Figures released last week by the Department for Education show that the

total number of permanent exclusions from all state-funded primary, secondary and special schools in England in 2015/16 has risen for a second year to 6,685 pupils. More than 1,000 were from primary

schools, which represents a rise for the third year running. Of those almost half were seven or under – including 50 four-year-olds. The figures are the equivalent to 35 children being excluded every

school day. The number of fixed-period exclusions, where a pupil is excluded for a set period of time but allowed to return, across all state schools was also up at 339,360 last year from 302,975 the previous year.

Super Sunday! Froome and England's women cricket stars clinch global glory

WHILE BRITISH hopes at the Open golf tournament may have been dashed on Sunday, there was still plenty to cheer about for cycling and cricket fans, who savored a remarkable sporting double for British sport.

Celebrations began when Chris Froome cycled over the cobblestones of the Champs-Elysees to take his fourth Tour de France title. The Team Sky rider raised a glass of champagne as he completed the final stage of the iconic race, which he won by 54 seconds.

'amazing feeling'

The clearly emotional 32-year-old made straight for his wife Michelle and 19-month-old son Kellan seconds after finishing the gruelling 2,200-mile race. He said: "It is an amazing feeling, there is something magical about the Champs-Elysees when you have spent

three weeks thinking about being here in this moment.

"Each time I have won has been so unique, such a different battle to get to this moment. They are all so special but this will be remembered as the closest and most hard-fought battle. A celebration is definitely overdue."

thrilling final

He had earlier admitted that to win three tours in a row, and four in all, "was beyond my wildest dreams".

The victory ensures that Chris, who was made an OBE in 2016, joins the pantheon of cycling greats.

Meanwhile, cricket fans were jubilant after England won the Women's World Cup in a thrilling final against India at Lord's. As excitement reached fever-pitch, the team snatched an unlikely victory in front of a crowd of 30,000 at the packed ground.

The women's team were staring at defeat but staged a stunning fightback to win by nine runs.

Captain Heather Knight, 26, said: "I can't stop smiling – the girls have been outstanding."

Praising England's Anya Shrubsole, 25, who bowled the team to victory with six wickets, she said: "Anya Shrubsole, what a hero. What a day. They were batting brilliantly. The girls really held their nerve."

A delighted Anya added: "I'm lost for words. For a while it looked like we were out of it, but that's the beauty of this team. We never give up. It's been a fitting final for what has been a brilliant World Cup. I didn't even imagine I'd be here, it's a dream you never think comes true."

Top brass back transgender troops

UK Armed Forces will not follow Trump's lead

Commanders from British armed forces have opposed any ban on transgender people serving in the military.

It comes after Donald Trump said that transgender people would not be allowed in the US military due to "tremendous" medical costs and disruption.

But British officials have supported people serving in the Army, Royal Navy and Royal Air Force.

Commander of UK Maritime Forces Rear Admiral Alex Burton tweeted: "I am so glad we are not going this way."

The Obama administration decided last year to allow

transgender people to serve openly in the US military.

But in June, Defence Secretary James Mattis agreed to a six-month delay in the recruitment of transgender people.

Now President Trump has posted a series of tweets saying: "After consultation with my generals and military experts, please be advised that the United States government will not accept or allow transgender individuals to serve in any capacity in the US military."

"Our military must be focused on decisive and overwhelming victory and cannot be burdened with the

tremendous medical costs and disruption that transgender in the military would entail."

'Bringing diversity'

In response, Rear Admiral Burton of the Royal Navy tweeted: "As a Royal Navy LGBT champion and senior warfighter I am so glad we are not going this way."

And Second Sea Lord Vice Admiral Jonathan Woodcock tweeted: "So proud of our transgender personnel. They bring diversity to our Royal Navy and I will always support their desire to serve their country."

"I suspect many who doubt the abilities of our diverse service personnel

might be more reluctant to serve than they are to comment."

In February, the Army's LGBT champion, Lieutenant General Patrick Sanders said: "Only if individuals are free to be themselves can we release the genie of their potential."

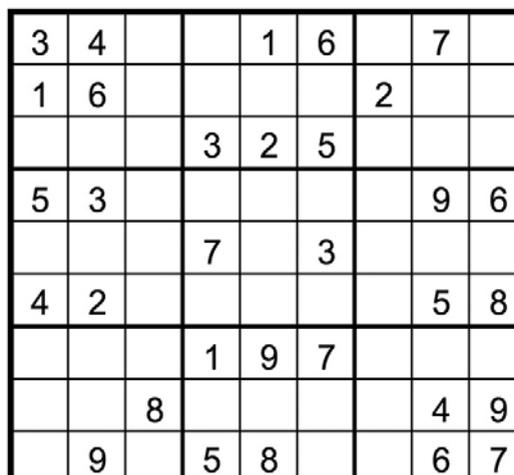

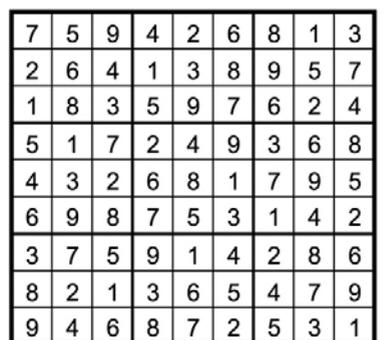

Reproducing Holmes spawns distaff detective?

Exclusive interview with author Leonard Goldberg about his new mystery series based around the daughter of fiction's most famous detective



"I actually got the idea from a critic who happened to give me a fine review on an earlier novel," says *The Daughter of Sherlock Holmes* author Leonard Goldberg.

"He stated that the story, 'seemed to fly along on the Holmesian wings of Joanna Blalock.' That was the moment I connected the forensic pathologist Joanna Blalock to Sherlock Holmes. I knew that someday I would tie

Joanna to Sherlock in a stand-alone novel."

The book opens in 1914. Joanna Blalock is a skilled forensic nurse. She and her ten-year-old son sees a man fall to his death. Dr. John Watson and his son, Dr. John Watson Jr. come to see her to talk about the death they have witnessed. As they investigate they are pulled into a mystery that spans the Second Afghan War of 1878 to 1880 with hidden treasure and murders. Joanna has a mystery of her own. Her mother is Irene Adler, the only criminal to outwit Holmes. Could her father be Sherlock Holmes?

"The Joanna Blalock in *The Daughter of Sherlock Holmes* is the long-ago grandmother of the modern day forensic pathologist who carries the same name," says Goldberg. "The idea, of

course, is that the modern day forensic pathologist has inherited some of Sherlock Holmes's genes...her remarkable deductive abilities."

Goldberg did a lot of research on Victorian England. "There were a variety of seemingly small matters that had to be looked into in order to assure accuracy in the novel," says Goldberg. "For example, when did automobiles appear in numbers on the streets of London and horse-drawn carriages begin to disappear? And more importantly, what positions in medicine were available to women in that era, particularly those with high intellect?"

Knowing the streets of London presented no problem. During her sabbatical leave from UCLA, Goldberg lived in London for a year

and did research at St. Bartholomew's Hospital, featured in the novel. Goldberg's flat was located near the Marble Arch, a 15-minute walk to Sherlock Holmes's rooms at 221b Baker Street.

Goldberg also wrote the bestselling Joanna Blalock medical mystery series. His novels have been translated into a dozen languages.

Goldberg had a long career with the UCLA Medical Center as a Clinical Professor of Medicine. "There is one rather curious aspect to being a physician and writing medical mysteries," says Goldberg. "My colleagues always seem to see themselves in some of my fictional characters."

Scott Mendel is Goldberg's agent.

"As you may know,

good agents are difficult to come by, particularly for first-time authors," says Goldberg. "While finishing my initial novel, *Transplant*, I happened to be reading *LA Magazine* and saw an article that featured the five most promising, up-and-coming literary agents in Los Angeles. At the top of the list was Jane Jordan Browne, who loved my work and became my wonderful agent for twenty years. When Jane passed away, Scott Mendel, a terrific agent who worked with Jane in her Chicago office and now has offices in Manhattan, was good enough to take me on."

Goldberg's contract with St. Martin's Press calls for a series of three novels featuring the daughter of Sherlock Holmes. Goldberg is currently writing the

Barkley "100%" to leave Toffees - Koeman



Everton midfielder Ross Barkley is "looking for a new challenge" and the club "100%" expect him to leave, says manager Ronald Koeman.

Barkley, 23, (above) has one year left on his contract but has failed to sign a new deal.

"We made a good offer of a contract. He declined," said Koeman.

Koeman also said he is still interested in Swansea City midfielder Gylfi Sigurdsson after the Welsh club rejected a £40m bid from the Toffees.

The Swans want £50m for the 27-year-old, who scored nine goals last season.

Meanwhile, Everton want around £50m for Barkley but that figure could fall before the transfer window closes on 31 August as he would be a free agent in 12 months' time.

The academy graduate has played 150 times for Everton in the Premier League, scoring 21 times, since making his debut six years ago.

"Ross told me at the end of the season he wanted

another challenge," added Koeman before Everton's Europa League third qualifying round first leg tie with Slovakia's Ruzomberok at Goodison Park on Thursday (20:05 BST).

"His personal situation is really not so difficult. My priority is not Ross, with respect, it is his decision. I look more to other players. I knew this at the end of the season.

"Everyone knows what the situation is and that's enough, I don't talk any more about this."

Stalemate for Celtic in CL qualifer

Celtic and Rosenborg remain goalless after the first leg of their Champions League third qualifying round tie after a frustrating encounter Wednesday night in Glasgow.

Vegar Eggen Hedenstad's free-kick tested Celtic goalkeeper Craig Gordon and Rosenborg's Yann-Erik de Lanlay fired over from close range.

James Forrest and Stuart Armstrong threatened for Celtic but they struggled to create openings.

And Gordon was called upon to make another save late on, denying substitute Matthias Vilhjalmsson.

The sides meet again in Trondheim next Wednesday to decide which team progresses to the play-off round, with the loser dropping into the Europa League play-off round.

Celtic were stymied by their lack of a central striker, Moussa Dembele out injured until September and Leigh Griffiths suspended and also carrying a knock.

As a consequence they lacked presence up front. They had, for an hour, midfielder Tom Rogic as a de facto front man but he never looked comfortable. Celtic were denied

space and chances by a smothering Rosenborg, who played deep and snuffed out Celtic's dangerous runners. Scott Sinclair barely got a kick. Fellow wide man Forrest looked hesitant for large parts of the night.

Brendan Rodgers' team had most of the ball but opportunities were thin on the ground. Forrest had a couple of weak shots blocked and then a header easily cleared. He should have had more of those moments.

In between, Milan Jevtovic and Anders Konradsen reminded their hosts that though they

City squad in Los Angeles and, after completing a medical, signed a five-year contract. City denied there were any add-ons involved in the deal with Monaco.

Voted into the French Ligue 1 team of the year and regarded as one of the best left-backs in Europe, Mendy impressed Guardiola when Monaco ended City's Champions League hopes in two thrilling last-16 legs, winning on away

goals after drawing 6-6 on aggregate.

As with Kyle Walker on the right side of the defence, Mendy has been recruited because Guardiola wants pacy full-backs who can attack and create chances at one end but can also track back and defend. The former Le Havre and Marseille player was also wanted by Liverpool but said his mind was always made up to join City. He is determined to live up to his huge fee – a world record for a full-back if the add-ons to the Kyle Walker deal are not taken into account.

"This is what I wanted from the very beginning," he said. "To play at full-back and provide assists for the strikers. Every year I want to improve. And this year must be better than last year. "And I always considered the Premier League to be the best in Europe. I like the intensity. There is always an attacking mindset with a team like this one, which is always playing with the ball."

Mendy compared Guardiola to his former coach at Marseille, Marcelo Bielsa. "Pep likes to motivate and improve his players, he is in the same mould as Marcelo," he said. "They belong to the same football family and I think that can only be beneficial for me and

the rest of the team as well."

City's eye-watering spending spree tops the £174m Guardiola splashed out on his arrival in Manchester last summer. So far they have recouped only £42.7m from sales and loan fees and they are hoping to bring in £25m from Leicester for striker Kelechi Iheanacho. But they are likely to have to lower their asking prices to off-load Samir Nasri, Wilfried Bony, Eliaquim Mangala, Fabian Delph and Jason Denayer.

And Nasri in particular was in the spotlight this week after appearing to become an outcast in the City squad on their pre-season American tour.

The French player spent last season on loan with Sevilla after being told he was no longer wanted at the Etihad. Club bosses are desperate to get the £170,000-a-week midfielder off the wage bill and manager Pep Guardiola is using the trip Stateside to put him in the shop window. But sources close to the City camp claim Nasri has become an unpopular and even divisive figure. A source said: "Some of the players don't understand why Nasri is even here. He has an arrogant attitude and doesn't appear to care. The club can't wait to get rid of him."

Coutinho headed to Barca?

Brazilian reportedly agrees terms with Catalan giants, but Klopp insists key playmaker is not for sale

Barcelona have reportedly made a significant step in their pursuit of Philippe Coutinho as the Brazilian has "agreed terms" with the Catalans over a move to the Camp Nou.

According to Catalan radio station RAC1 Barca will now make an improved offer to Liverpool for the playmaker having seen an initial €80 million (£72 million) bid rejected.

The Spanish club fear Liverpool may hold out for as much as €100 million (£89.5 million), while it is hoped that signing Coutinho will

help to persuade his fellow Brazilian Neymar to remain at Barcelona.

Neymar has been very vocal in the past about his desire for Coutinho, 25, to join him at the Camp Nou, according to insiders close the star, and with Neymar heavily linked with a surprise move to Paris Saint-Germain, the powers that be inside the Catalan giants are desperate to keep him happy.

It will be a surprise if Coutinho does end up at Barca this summer, though, as he only signed a new contract with Liverpool to 2022 back in January.

Reds manager Jurgen Klopp has also insisted he is not for sale.

Coutinho has been at Liverpool since 2013, when he signed from Inter Milan for £8.5 million, and he has been arguably the club's most important player over the last four seasons—in which he has netted 31 goals and provided 24 assists in the Premier League.

The Anfield outfit are improving under Klopp and should return to the UEFA Champions League group stages next term assuming they get through their play-off clash next month.

Mendy deal clinched as City's summer spending tops £200m

PEP GUARDIOLA has taken his spending this summer to more than £200 million – a Premier League record for a single transfer window – by finally completing the deal for Benjamin Mendy.

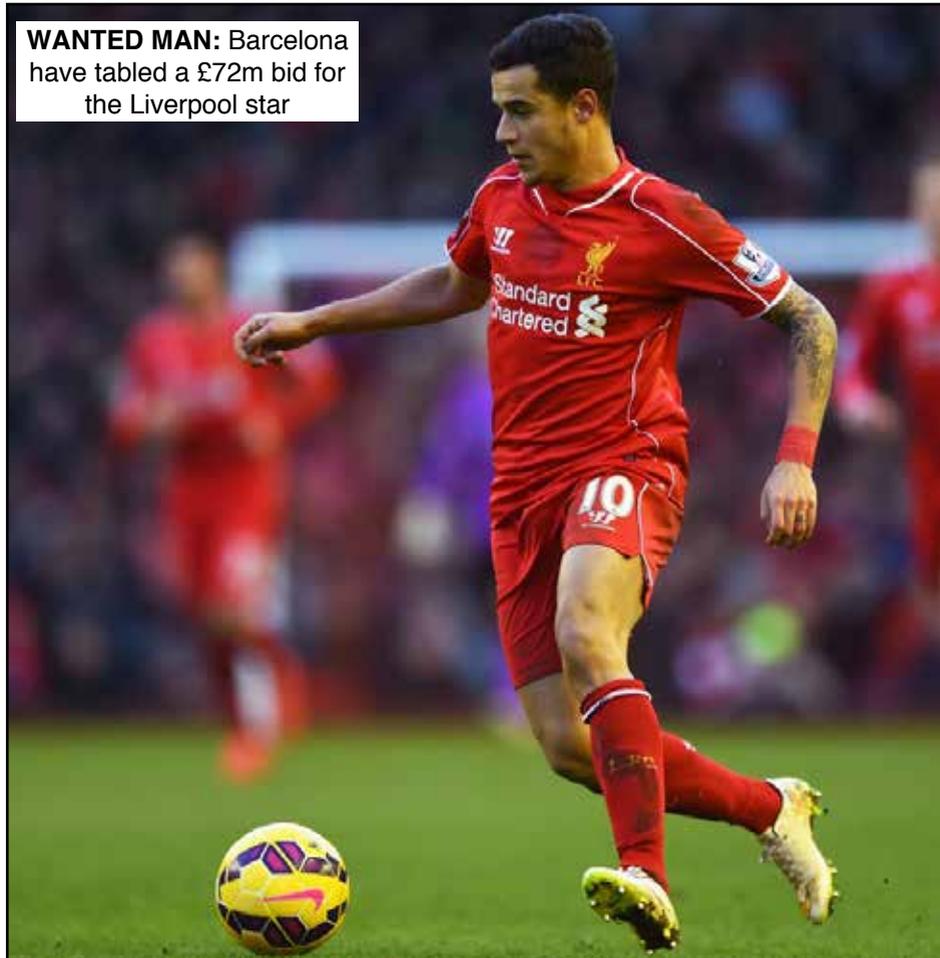
Mendy, 23, has signed for £49.2m and follows Monaco team-mate Bernardo Silva to the Etihad after the Ligue 1 side knocked City out of the Champions

League last season. French international left-back Mendy becomes Guardiola's sixth signing and third new full-back of a whirlwind summer spree which saw him splashing out £54m for Kyle Walker from Spurs and £27 for Danilo from Real Madrid. And the Manchester City manager has not stopped yet. He is searching for a striker and a central defender and has not given up hope

of luring Alexis Sanchez away from Arsenal. That is in spite of Arsene Wenger's determination to keep the Chilean.

Guardiola has thus embarked on the biggest squad overhaul in the club's history. As well as the six new players, 13 have left and six more are likely to follow before the transfer window closes on August 31. Mendy flew out on Sunday to join the **cont. on page 19, col. 4**
