

# Newcastle child sex ring: 18 facing jail

■ Girls were “vulnerable victims of an organised, cynical, systematic organisation in which they were passed between their abusers.”

**Eighteen people have been convicted of abusing girls who were plied with alcohol and drugs before being forced to have sex in Newcastle.**

The vulnerable victims, some as young as 14, were exploited by a “cynical organisation” and passed between abusers, the court heard.

The 17 men and one woman were convicted of offences including conspiracy to incite prostitution, rape and drugs.

It emerged that police paid a convicted child rapist £10,000 as an informant.

Three of the gang have been jailed. The rest will be sentenced next month.

Northumbria Police set up Operation Sanctuary in December 2013 to investigate claims of sexual abuse against girls and young women, by mostly Asian men.

It led to a series of spin-off operations.

One of these, Operation Shelter, uncovered groups of men in the West End of Newcastle - many of whom were known to

each other - who exploited vulnerable young women and girls over a period from 2010 to 2014.

This eventually led to four separate trials, the first commencing in September 2015, and the final one has only just concluded, allowing previous reporting restrictions to be lifted.

They involved a total of 26 defendants, mostly from Pakistani, Indian and Bangladeshi backgrounds.

Newcastle Crown Court heard that the victim, who were described as vulnerable, were at first flattered by the attention of the men who apparently befriended them, but then lured to parties, known as “sessions”, by the promise of alcohol and drugs - often mephadrone (or M-Kat).

They became - in the words of the prosecution - the “vulnerable victims of an organised, cynical, systematic organisation in

which they were passed between their abusers.”

The parties took place at premises around the west end of Newcastle - including the top floor of a tower block Todd's Nook, where one teenager said she was raped three times.

Alcohol and drugs were freely available, with bags of M-Kat left on workshops and coffee tables for the girls to help

themselves.

#### 'Like a slave'

Some spoke of being “too intoxicated” to defend themselves, others became addicted and had to commit sexual acts in return for drugs.

One victim said she had attended about 60 parties, and another told of going to an address where there were two older men and

a woman, who seemed “frightened and scared, like a slave”.

She said: “They told us what she would do for them for money and drugs or she'd get battered.”

Another victim said: “I knew that if we wanted drugs or alcohol we would have to do something.

“[He] had us too intoxicated to fight him off. One time, [he] locked

the door. I was told I would only be allowed out if I had sex.”

One of the victims was in local authority care at the time, and Newcastle City Council has launched a serious case review.

Pat Ritchie, the council's chief executive, said: “I am so sorry that that happened, I can only apologise - it's one too many.”

# May dismisses £36m Brexit 'divorce bill'

■ Source dismisses report as 'inaccurate speculation' and says such a high bill would be unacceptable to government and public

Downing Street has dismissed the idea of paying a Brexit divorce bill of up to €40bn (£36bn), as leading supporters of leaving the EU said they would not accept handing over such a large sum.

Theresa May was reported to be willing to pay that amount as the price for getting on with trade talks and an exit deal.

The sum would be a compromise, because Brussels has demanded about €60bn. The €40bn figure would still be the equivalent of several years of contributions to the EU budget, which would continue to be paid after Britain leaves the EU in March 2019.

A Downing Street source, however, said the figure, which was mentioned by Brussels sources quoted in the Sunday Telegraph, was "inaccurate speculation", playing down the idea that such a high bill would be acceptable to the government or Brexit voters.

The issue of payments to the EU is a huge

political problem for No 10, partly because the Brexit campaign mentioned recouping £350m a week from Brussels to put towards the NHS.

At the same time, the EU will not progress to the next stage of talks on the future relationship until it deems that "sufficient progress" has been made on the financial settlement.

## harder line

Michel Barnier, the EU's chief Brexit negotiator, told diplomats last month that the next step may be pushed back to December because Britain is stalling on the bill.

May and David Davis, the Brexit secretary, have accepted that an amount will have to be paid, saying they need "to determine a fair settlement of the UK's rights and obligations".

But some Brexit supporters take a much harder line against payments to the EU. Boris Johnson, the foreign secretary, told the House of Commons last month that Brussels could "go whistle".

Others dismissed the idea of handing over

payments to the EU after leaving.

The Conservative MP Jacob Rees-Mogg said there was "no logic to this figure. Legally we owe nothing". His colleague Peter Bone said it would be "very strange" for parliament to vote in favour of such large sums.

"One of the prime reasons the UK voted to leave the EU was to stop sending them billions of pounds per year, so it would be totally bizarre to give the EU any money, let alone £36bn, given also that over the years that we have been in the EU or its predecessor we have given them, net, over £200bn," he said.

"So if there was going to be any transfer of money, then it should be from the EU to the UK.

"I think it would be very strange of parliament to pay billions of pounds to leave an organisation that you have given hundreds of billions of pounds to and got nothing in return. That would be a very strange decision, so I don't think it would happen."

The former cabinet minister John Redwood told LBC Radio it was

ridiculous to suggest the UK would need to pay in order to achieve trade talks.

"Ministers would be quite wrong to be talking about any figures. We don't owe them any money," he said. "It would be silly to be offering something when the EU is still not very willing to talk and is not coming up with anything constructive on its own side. The EU's tactic is very clear. It's

divide and rule to try to get Britain negotiating with herself."

The former Ukip leader Nigel Farage also questioned the need to pay any bill, using a speech in the US to say he may be forced to "throw myself back into the frontline fight of British politics" to stop the Conservatives watering down Brexit. The EU's stance is that trade talks cannot begin until significant

progress has been made on the financial settlement, citizens' rights and Northern Ireland.

It is understood that the government is planning to publish a series of papers on issues such as the customs union and Irish border in the coming weeks, to set out its public position for the first time since May detailed her negotiating strategy at Lancaster House in January.

## Police nick Putney jogger

Police hunting a jogger who knocked a woman into the path of a bus on Putney Bridge have arrested a 50-year-old man on suspicion of causing grievous bodily harm.

The man was arrested at an address in Chelsea Thursday morning.

He was taken to a south London police station before being released under investigation pending further enquiries.

It follows a public appeal to help find the man, with Scotland Yard releasing footage this week in a bid to identify the jogger.

The incident, which occurred on 5 May, shows the 33-year-old victim walking across Putney Bridge when a male jogger knocks her over into the road and into the path of an oncoming bus, which narrowly missed hitting her.

The bus stopped and some passengers got off and rushed to the victim's aid. She received minor injuries from the incident.

About 15 minutes later the jogger came back the other way across the bridge. The victim tried to speak to him but he did not acknowledge her and carried on jogging.

Officers continue to appeal for any witnesses to the incident.

# Abramovich splits from third wife Dasha

## ■ Chelsea boss and art-loving wife married in secret in 2008

Roman Abramovich, the Russian oligarch and owner of Chelsea FC, has separated from his wife of ten years, Dasha Zhukova.

The couple, who have two children, said the split was amicable.

In a joint statement, they said: "After 10 years together, the two of us have made the difficult decision to separate, but we remain close friends, parents and partners in the projects we developed together.

"We are committed to jointly raising our two children. We will also continue to work together as co-founders of the Garage Museum of Contemporary Art in Moscow and the New Holland Island cultural center in Saint Petersburg."

Ms Zhukova, an art collector who is 15 years' Mr Abramovich's junior, the independently wealthy daughter of a Russian oil magnate, was Mr Abramovich's third wife.

The couple were first spotted together in 2005 at a Chelsea-Barcelona game in Spain.

At the time, Mr Abramovich was still married to his second wife, Irina Vyacheslavovna Malandina, and it was thought Ms Zhukova was seeing Lord Freddie Windsor, the son of Prince and Princess Michael of Kent, after splitting from long-time boyfriend, tennis player Marat Safin.

But the friendship deepened and Miss Zhukova and her father, Alexander Zhukov, were invited to Mr Abramovich's New Year party later that year.

Her father is himself an oil, metals and banking tycoon who owns a mansion block in Kensington, west

London, where his daughter lived, as well as homes in New York and Moscow.

The couple secretly married around nine years ago.

Ms Zhukova, 36, had always been referred to as his girlfriend but in 2015, she revealed in a magazine interview that the couple in fact tied the knot during a private ceremony in 2008.

Their first child, Mr Abramovich's sixth, Aaron Alexander, was born in December 2009 and daughter Leah Lou was born in April 2013, both in the United States.

Mr Abramovich, 50, married his first wife, Olga Yurevna Lysova, in December 1987 but was divorced just three years later.

### 'quickie' divorce

He wed Ms Malandina in 1991, before he made his fortune in the Russian privatisation but the couple were said to have been driven apart by his devotion to his business interests and football club, which he bought for £140 million in 2003.

They were given a "quickie" divorce in Moscow in 2007, with the oligarch paying a settlement in the region of £150million, one of the largest ever seen.

Although details have remained hidden under Russia's secretive legal system, it is thought Ms Malandina was given a lump sum as well as four homes, including the £18million Fyning Hill Estate in Petersfield, West Sussex, which was Abramovich's main base in the UK as well as two London properties at Eaton Square and Chester Square.

It was reported at the time that Ms Malandina, a former air stewardess,

had consulted leading British divorce lawyers. Had she chosen to pursue her husband through the British courts she could have been entitled to half his £11 billion fortune.

Mr Abramovich made his money from property, steel and mining since the collapse of communism in Russia.

In 1995 he and fellow oligarch Boris Berezovsky acquired the controlling interest in the oil company Sibneft for a fraction of its real worth.

Mr Abramovich later acquired stakes in several other companies, including the aluminium giant Rusal and the airline Aeroflot. He went on to sell his stakes in

Sibneft and Rusal for billions.

The businessman, whose friendship with Russian president Vladimir Putin has been likened to a father-son relationship, is ranked as No. 139 on Forbes Billionaires List, with a reported \$9.1 billion.

The couple own homes in London, Moscow, Colorado, the Caribbean and the South of France and Mr Abramovich famously owns some of the world's biggest yachts.

Ms Zhukova, who is on the board of the Metropolitan Museum, is thought to have converted the football-loving oligarch to the joy of art and he has quietly

established himself as the world's leading collector of modern and contemporary art.

Ms Zhukova once owned her own fashion label Kova & T and was briefly editor of avant garde fashion magazine, POP.

In 2014, she was pictured sitting on a chair designed to resemble a half-naked black woman.

She later apologised, saying: "I utterly abhor racism, and would like to apologise to anyone who has been offended by this image."

She now owns runs her own magazine, Garage, -as well as an arts centre in Russia which is part-funded by her husband.

## Lawn bowling stunned by heat butt

THE GENTEEL world of lawn bowling was left reeling this week as it emerged that a county final was abandoned following an argument during which a player appeared to headbutt an opponent, who fell and broke a finger.

The Hampshire County Men's Final between Southsea Waverley and Boscombe Cliff was held in Southampton on Sunday.

A Boscombe player squared up to an opponent after a dispute over "bowls etiquette", reports the Bournemouth Echo.

Other Boscombe players then conceded.

It meant Waverley retained the men's county champions title.

Waverley secretary Peter Aldridge said both clubs were "mortified by the behaviour".

### 'Not acceptable'

He said he had been told by members who were present that the player, in his 30s, was hurt after the argument blew up during the final and a headbutt was attempted.

Mr Aldridge said: "Bowls has changed over the years - people do get excited but this was not acceptable.

"It doesn't represent the attitude of Boscombe Cliff and is not representative of the game."

Boscombe Cliff Bowls Club has declined to comment.

The sport's governing body in the county, Bowls Hampshire, said an investigation was underway.

A Hampshire Constabulary spokeswoman said it had not been reported to police.

# Pensioner gets Asbo and £13k court bill for putting up security light to deter car thieves

■ "I shall be paying £2 a week for the rest of my life" - Brian Wales

PUTTING up a security light outside his sheltered home in a bid to beat car vandals has cost a shocked pensioner a staggering £13,500.

Outraged Brian Wales, 74, is being forced to shell out the huge amount after being dragged into court by his local council.

Council bosses have also obtained an anti-social behaviour ruling against Mr Wales after accusing him of being abusive and threatening to neighbours and council officers.

Mr Wales, of Priors Wood Court, Takeley, Essex, set up the light at the front of his sheltered housing block last year after both he and his wife had their cars vandalised.

The fuming retired housing landlord said this week that he just didn't have the cash to pay off £13,500 court costs in one go.

"I shall be paying £2 a week for the rest of my life.

"If I had that sort of money, I wouldn't be living here," snapped hard-up Mr Wales.

"The whole thing is absolutely ridiculous."

The furious OAP said it had cost £2,000 to repair his wife's Peugeot Coupe after it was battered by jobs while other residents had also been targeted by louts.

Mr Wales said he had installed his own security light in an attempt to deter attackers after insisting that the council's CCTV cameras were "inadequate in the dark".

"What I want is for the council to provide adequate lighting around the building," he stormed.

"I am not just going to lie down."

But Saffron Walden-based Uttlesford Council said Mr Wales's light breached his tenancy agreement and was put up without prior consultation.

The authority said neighbours claimed the bright light shone into their homes at night and upset them.

The council said Mr Wales was "dismissive and abusive" to housing

team officers who went to see him.

At a hearing at Chelmsford County Court on July 26, Judge David Vavrecka backed the council and ordered Mr Wales to cough up £13,500 costs.

His conduct was also found to have amounted to "anti-social behaviour".

The injunction bans Mr Wales using threatening, abusive or insulting language towards residents of Priors Wood Court and Priors Wood Road as well as to councillors, staff and contractors for two years.

Cllr Julie Redfern, the district councillor for housing, said: "It is a last resort for us to take this kind of action and not something we do lightly.

"The outcome of this case is satisfying as tenants were brave enough to support the action and give evidence in person."

## Three jailed for 'dirty look' murder

Three men have been jailed for stabbing a student to death near Wembley Stadium over a row about a dirty look.

Djodjo Nsaka collapsed outside his halls of residence in north-west London after being attacked on 20 January.

Donald Davies and Mukeh Kawa, both 21 from Colindale, were found guilty of murder at the Old Bailey and jailed for life with a minimum of 26 years.

Ali Tas, 21, was found guilty of manslaughter and sentenced to seven-and-a-half years in prison. Tas, also from Colindale, was cleared of murder.

Mr Nsaka had returned home with two friends after a night out when they were set upon by Kawa, Davies and Tas.

The jury heard the students were attacked after they had earlier asked a female friend of Kawa's why he had given them a "screw-face" expression when they saw him at

Middlesex University on 18 January.

After one of them told her that Kawa should "be humble", she said she would pass on the message - and the defendants later went in search of the three students.

"It had gone from pulling a face to 'I am going to kill him, bring him outside', within the course of a day," prosecutor William Boyce QC told the court.

Mr Nsaka's friends were able to flee when the group were attacked but the father of one was stabbed in the heart and died in the street.

In an impact statement, Mr Nsaka's father said the 19-year-old's death had "left an enormous void in our lives".

"Every day I get up with a heavy heart and look into the faces of my wife and children and watch as they struggle to get through life without their beloved Djodjo," Tuna Nsaka said.

## £12k payout for flea bite PC

A police officer was handed more than £12,000 in compensation after being bitten by a flea while at work.

The news follows a series of astonishing compensation claims made by officers in recent years, which have included huge payouts for falling off chairs and tripping on kerbs.

The unnamed detective was awarded £12,127 in damages after he successfully sued West Midlands Police, which also had to fork out £4,185 in legal fees in the case.

It was just one of a number of workplace injury claims to the force and, in total, West Midlands Police paid out £61,131 in compensation between April 1 last year and March 31.

This week the payout was branded 'ludicrous' by former Lib Dem leader Tim Farron and a former officer, who said compensation culture was rife in forces across Britain.

Mr Farron said: 'Our cops do an amazing job keeping us safe. Compensation should be paid for injuries at work but some of these claims seem to take the biscuit.'

'It's frankly ludicrous that taxpayers are footing the bill for when someone gets fleas on them.'

'It's utterly barmy and will harm public confidence in the police.'

Chloe Westley, campaign manager for the TaxPayer's Alliance, added: 'At a time when taxpayers are feeling the pinch and departments are having to find necessary savings, these payments will certainly sting.'

'Of course

compensation payouts will sometimes be necessary because accidents can ruin lives, but it still falls on public sector organisations to make sure they are rooting out anyone making spurious claims with taxpayers' cash.'

A Freedom of Information request revealed the West Midlands Police was sued by 14 serving police officers and various other staff members for a range of other bizarre work place injuries.

Last year a Freedom of Information request from a leading daily newspaper revealed the astronomical cost that forces across the country were paying out in compensation claims by officers.

These included an officer in Durham who pocketed £25,000 for injuring his left knee falling over in a police station corridor, a Hertfordshire PC who was given £16,000 after they injured themselves tripping on the covering of a plug socket and a West Yorkshire police dog handler who was awarded £17,000 after his dog bit him.

Former West Midlands Police officer Ray Egan, who served on the force from 1967 to 1993, said the payouts 'beggar belief'.

'It's absolutely baffling,' he said. 'I was a policeman for over 20 years, and I can't even imagine what would have happened if I'd gone to my senior officer and started moaning because I'd been bitten by a flea.'

'I'd have been kicked out the office with a clipping round the ear, I'd have thought.'

Five men charged over the Hillsborough disaster and its aftermath have appeared in court.

The men, including ex-South Yorkshire Police (SYP) chief inspector Sir Norman Bettison, attended Warrington Magistrates' Court in Cheshire on Wednesday.

No formal pleas were given for four of the men but former Sheffield Wednesday club secretary Graham Mackrell pleaded not guilty to health and safety charges.

They were all bailed until next month.

The court was told Sir Norman Bettison, who went on to become chief constable of Merseyside Police, Peter Metcalf, who was a solicitor for SYP, former Ch Supt Donald Denton and former Det Ch Insp Alan Foster, will plead not guilty when their cases reach crown court on 6 September.

Former Ch Supt David Duckenfield, who is also facing charges over the 1989 disaster, was not required to attend.

He was prosecuted privately in 1999 and the CPS is applying to the

High Court to lift a court order imposed, which must be removed before Mr Duckenfield can be charged.

Mr Duckenfield was match commander at the FA Cup semi-final when 96 Liverpool fans were fatally injured in a crush.

The defendants walked past family members of the 96 victims of the disaster who had gathered at the entrance of the court.

Speaking outside court, Evelyn Mills, whose brother Peter McDonnell, 21, died in the 1989 tragedy, said: "This is the beginning

of another milestone in the history of Hillsborough."

Christine Burke, whose father Henry, 47, was among the 96 victims, said: "There is still a long journey but we will see it through."

Last year, new inquests into the disaster at the Liverpool v Nottingham Forest match, held at Sheffield Wednesday's ground, concluded the fans had been unlawfully killed.

The inquests found that Liverpool supporters were not responsible for the dangerous situation at the

Leppings Lane turnstiles.

The Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) brought charges following referrals from the Operation Resolve investigation into the causes of the disaster and the Independent Police Complaints Commission (IPCC) probe.

Last month the CPS said there would be no manslaughter prosecution over the death of the 96th casualty, Anthony Bland, as he died almost four years later, and under the law in 1989 his death is now "out of time" to be prosecuted.

# CHLOE AYLING: The strange case of the glamour model, a kidnapping and the dark web

■ Italian media cast doubt on 'victim's' bizarre tale

A BRITISH GLAMOUR model has shone a light on the so-called 'Dark Web' after claiming she was drugged and abducted in Italy after reportedly being duped into attending a bogus photoshoot.

Italian police say Chloe Ayling was snatched last month by at least two men who claim to be part of the dark web group Black Death, who say they sell women as sex slaves online.

Miss Ayling was allegedly drugged and transported in a bag to an isolated village near Turin, where she was held for six days as her captors tried to auction her online.

She described how she was drugged, handcuffed, gagged and put in a bag in the boot of a car by kidnappers

before being driven off to the farmhouse where she was held captive.

"A person wearing black gloves came from behind and put one hand on my neck and one on my mouth to stop me from screaming," she said in her statement.

"A second person wearing a black balaclava gave me an injection in my right forearm. I think I lost consciousness. When I woke up I was wearing a pink bodysuit and the socks I am wearing now.

"I realised I was in the boot of a car with my wrists and ankles handcuffed, adhesive tape on my mouth. I was inside a bag and was only able to breathe through a small hole."

As she screamed for help she was driven 120 miles to the tiny hamlet

of Borgial near the French border where they forced her to lie on the floor next to a chest of drawers and handcuffed her hands and feet to the legs, leaving her "totally immobilised".

She was kept handcuffed to furniture in the village of Borgial but was freed after six days and taken to the British Consulate in Milan, despite the ransom not being paid, police said.

They had taken photographs of her whilst she was unconscious which were posted on the dark web with the view to auctioning her off.

According to Ms Ayling, one of her kidnappers confessed to her that they had made a mistake seizing her because she was the mother of a young child.

He said it was against

the "rules" of his organisation and his superiors were angry. Afterwards they removed the cuffs from her feet and allowed her to move around the farmhouse, she said.

Polish national Lukasz Pawel Herba was arrested as he dropped the model off at the British Consulate in Milan on July 17.

Under questioning by police, he claimed he became part of the kidnapping gang because he was suffering from leukemia and desperately needed to raise half a million pounds for treatment.

He could provide no medical proof of having the illness.

The Black Death group operates on the Dark

Web and allegedly sells kidnapped women as sex slaves in online auctions.

The group was investigated in 2016 amid fears that they were selling a 15-year-old British girl in an online auction.

But the Italia media has raised doubts over Ms Aylig's account after it was revealed the model went shoe shopping with her captor.

Newspaper *La Repubblica* claimed Ms Ayling burst into tears when police investigators asked her about the trip.

The newspaper reported: "That the kidnapping was real or that she was doped with ketamine is not put into question by the investigators."

"But it is also tremendously true that many details do not add up.

"Starting with a question that the police investigators suddenly asked Chloe, causing her to cry, 'But don't you think it is strange to go and buy shoes with your kidnapper?"

But her lawyer has called people who raised these questions "evil", defending his client's shoe shopping trip.

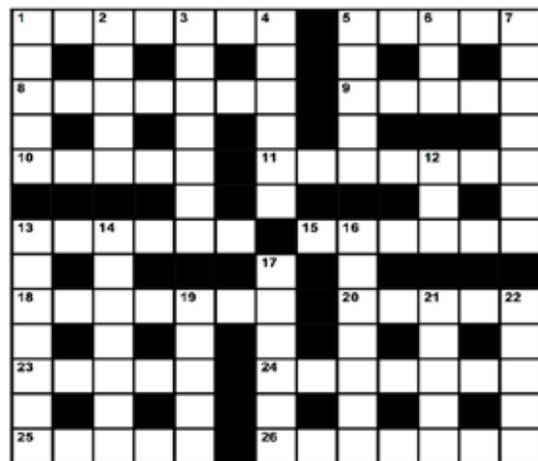
He told Radio 4's Today programme: "She was told that she was going to be sold to somebody in the Middle East for sex.

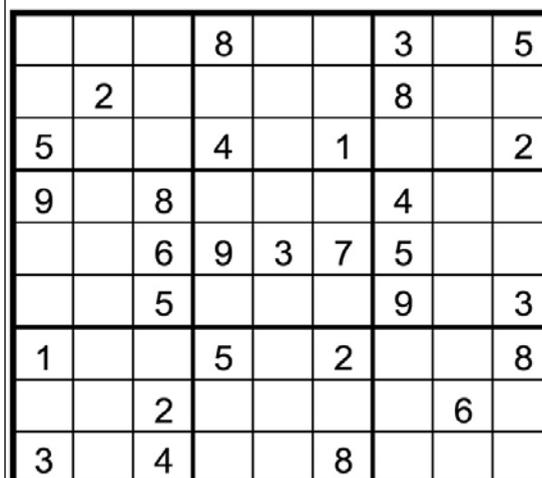

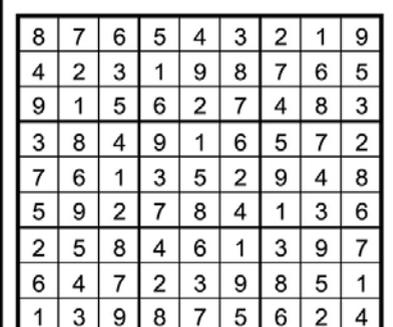

# The Wardrobe Mistress: all the threads neatly tied up

## ■ Exclusive interview with author Natalie Meg Evans on her new novel of post-war London fashions



"I love clothes," says **The Wardrobe Mistress** author Natalie Meg Evans.

"Or, more accurately, I love textiles and their place in history. "Book ideas don't spring fully formed from my mind, but expand like bread dough. At a certain point, I thump the mix, kneed it and bake it. As a teenager, I read a book called *The Swish of the Curtain*, about seven children's creating a theatre in a culturally bereft town. It's

still available, with a fan following on Goodreads. That could have been the inspiration. Or, it could have been a mind-blowing exhibition of costumes and textiles at the New York Met that I saw during a trip there in 2015."

It's London, 1945. The war is over. Vanessa Kingcourt, a young widow and victim of the war, boards a train to start a new life and job. Her husband's oldest friend, Alistair, has hired her to be a wardrobe mistress. She must create elaborate and beautiful costumes. She has no experience. And, no budget. Supplies...fabric, buttons, ribbons, hooks and thread, are scarce. What does her future hold?

"I have a library of reference books," says Evans. "Yet, research is only the start. I immerse myself in an imaginary

world and weave the materials I find within. Historical fiction is not a history hand-book. It is an imagined reality, a what if. I cannot pass a second-hand book store. Old letters hold delicious surprises as do the reminiscences and diaries that lurk under the lid of the Internet."

"An ex-Navy friend tutored me through the naval aspect of *The Wardrobe Mistress*," says Evans. "I interviewed a 96-year-old former actress and the present wardrobe mistress of Glyndebourne opera."

"Here's a story I heard as a very small child," says Evans. "My great-aunt Naomi, born in 1895, sewed a blouse with fabric bought from her first wage packet. Instead of the usual high-collar neck, the neckline was a modest 'V'. Her brother Bill ordered her to take it off as it was

indecent. See? A whole social history crammed into one fashion error. Imagine a museum of gowns from the 18th century, through Regency muslins, throttled Victorian waistlines to the ridiculous hobble skirts of the 1910s, giving way to fluid, un-corseted shapes following the Great War. It's female history in a pot."

*The Dress Thief* was Evans' first novel. She also wrote *The Milliner's Secret* and *A Gown of Thorns*. Evans received a Rita nomination from Romance Writers of America. She says the big win for her was *The Harry Bowling* prize in 2012. "That got me my agent and publishing contract," says Evans. "Oh, and long ago, I won a set of Le Creuset pans daily."

Kathryn Taussig at Quercus UK and Claire Bord at Bookouture are Evans' editors. Taussig for the UK, Europe and Commonwealth, and Bord handles US and Canada.

"Working with my editors...honestly, it's not challenging," says Evans. "They're both highly professional, friendly and supportive people. Ours is a can-do relationship."

Evans is researching her next novels and about to start writing book five.

Evans lives in a village in the East Anglian countryside of England. "I've always been a country girl at heart," says Evans, "though I lived in London for ten years and still love brief forays there, and to Paris and New York." She was born in Zimbabwe, emigrating with her parents as a baby while it was still under

my processed food intake. I think I mentioned a few months ago how I was experiencing a few health problems (I was diagnosed as anemic), but I am delighted to let you know that I managed to overcome this and it was mainly through changing my diet - my mate Marmite played a big role and is actually commonly used to help fight iron deficiencies. I also found that herbs and spices were easy to incorporate and many are least as high in iron as Popeye's favourite

vegetable.

As we know, Los Angeles is a multifaceted town - a combination of highs and lows, healthy living and over indulgence, mixed in with glamour and an awful lot of poverty. But when it comes to choosing healthier foods we are fortunate to have many options available to us - even Whole Paycheck (aka Whole Foods) offer sales and coupons, so if you shop wisely you too can afford that air-chilled, local, free-range organic chicken that the nutrition gurus are often touting. And often for less than the price of the factory-farmed, chlorine washed, antibiotic-filled poultry that we think we are resigned to buy (which supposedly will be arriving on British shores soon...).

My personal preference is to shop local and Ralphs even has a 'local' section - but the best choice is to pay a visit to your local farmers market. Below are just a few of my favourites, one for every day of the week!

**WEDNESDAY** - Santa Monica Farmers Market - Arizona Avenue

**THURSDAY** - Central Avenue Farmers Market - Downtown LA

**FRIDAY** - Echo Park Farmers Market

**SATURDAY** - Burbank Farmers Market

**SUNDAY** - Hollywood Farmers Market (on Ivar)

I mustn't forget to include LA hot spot **Yamashiro Farmers Market** in Hollywood- which is on a Wednesday throughout the summer - this is an evening event which runs from 5pm-10pm and has one of the best views in Los Angeles - they have a Happy Hour and street food too if you want to make a night of it.

Shopping at a market is probably the easiest way to find out where your groceries are from, as you get to chat to the seller

- I am a big proponent of buying local seasonal produce, it's how I used to shop with my mum as a kid, as there wasn't half as much choice when I was growing up. But if you really want something out of season the next best thing (in my opinion) is organic frozen produce.

I was born and raised in a small farming town in Lincolnshire. My family

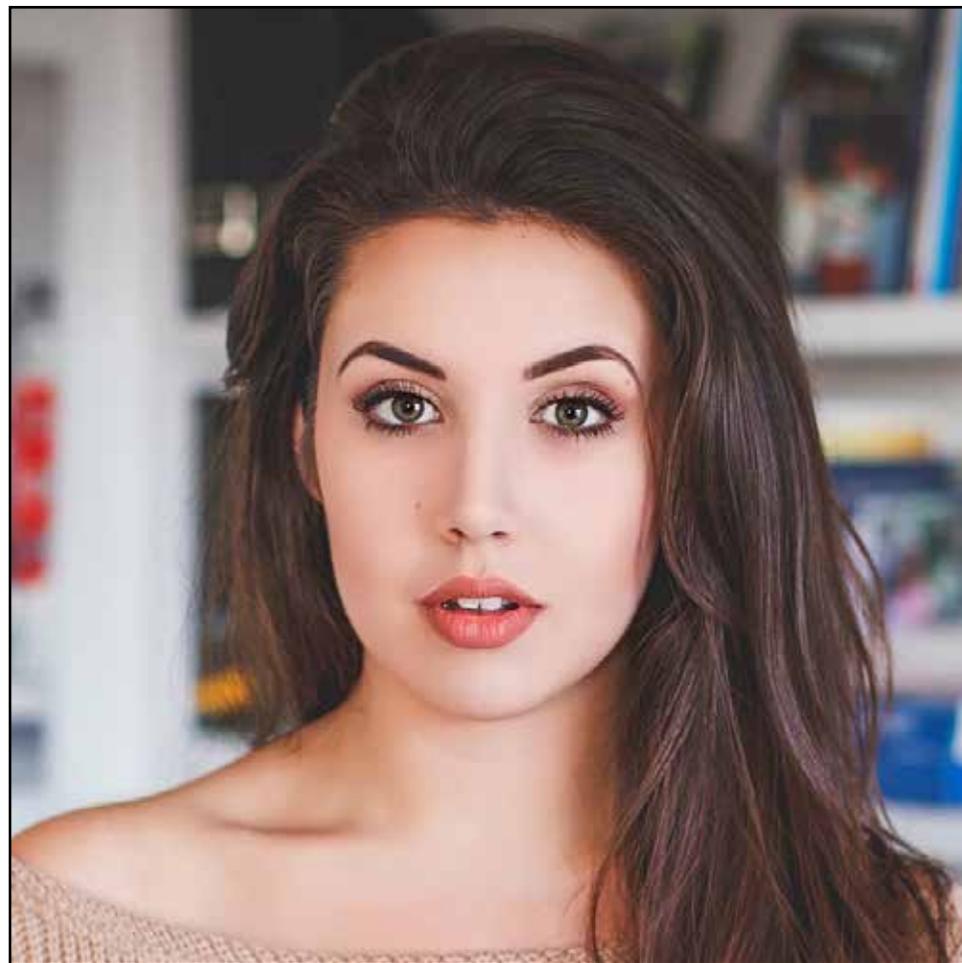

## Ali the star as England wrap up Fourth Test victory

*Fourth Investec Test, Old Trafford  
England 362 & 243 (69.1 overs): Moeen 75\*, Morkel 4-41 South Africa 226 & 202 (62.5 overs): Amla 83, Moeen 5-69. England won by 177 runs; win series 3-1*

**Moeen Ali claimed five wickets as England completed a 177-run win over South Africa in the fourth Test at Old Trafford to seal a 3-1 series victory this week.**

The Proteas, chasing an unlikely 380, were bowled out for 202, with James Anderson also picking up 3-16. England were held up by Hashim Amla, who made 83, but after he was dismissed they lost their last seven wickets for 39 runs.

It is England's first home Test series win against South Africa since 1998.

It also ends a run of three series without a win and gives Joe Root success in his first as captain.

England climb to third in the International Cricket Council's Test rankings, above Australia, who they meet in defence of the Ashes this winter.

Their next assignment is a three-Test series against West Indies, which begins with the first day-night match in this country at Edgbaston on 17 August.

More Moeen magic Moeen had blasted a thrilling 67 on the third evening and was left unbeaten on 75 as England lost their final two wickets to be bowled out in their second innings for 243.

After Anderson, Stuart Broad and Toby Roland-Jones took a wicket apiece, Moeen was asked to wheel away with his off-spin, only to be thwarted by the imperious Amla.

But, when he switched ends, he trapped Amla leg before and worked through the rest of the South Africa line-up.

Quinton de Kock played a loose drive to slash to gully and Theinus de Bruyn tamely edged to slip.

Moeen ended the third Test at The Oval with a hat-trick and closed this match with two wickets in two balls - Morne Morkel holed out to mid-off and Duanne Olivier nicked to slip.

Moeen is the first man to take 25 wickets and score more than 250 runs in a four-match Test series.

Meanwhile, former South African captain Amla endured a mixed series, averaging 35 before this knock, but the 34-year-old gave a reminder of his excellence in what his likely to be his last Test innings in the UK.

On an increasingly uneven surface and faced with some testing England new-ball bowling, South Africa found themselves 40-3, with Amla needing 19 balls to get off the mark.

But, after lunch, the right-hander played classy front and back-foot drives off the seamers, as well as reverse-sweeping Moeen and hitting the spinner for a straight six.

He added 123 with skipper Faf du Plessis, who made a gritty 61. While they were

together, the prospect of the game reaching a fifth day seemed real.

But, when Amla tried to work Moeen to the leg side, he was hit in front of the stumps.

The initial appeal reprieved him, but the review sealed his fate and the rest followed quickly.

Though England have ultimately won this series by a comfortable margin, they are still no closer to solving the problems that existed beforehand.

Opener Keaton Jennings has averaged only 15 and looks set to be replaced, while Tom Westley and Dawid Malan - given opportunities at three and five respectively - have not yet proven they belong at this level.

In a series where matches have been won by huge margins, England have triumphed in the Tests in which they won the toss and batted first. But they remain vulnerable when batting second.

**Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain is open to the idea of joining Arsenal's London rivals Chelsea this summer, with Antonio Conte ready to sanction a £35million bid for his services.**

Blues boss Conte is a huge admirer of the 23-year-old England international and hopes to complete a deal before the window closes.

The Arsenal star was heavily linked with a move to Liverpool earlier in the summer after his contract talks with Arsenal broke down.

The versatile midfielder has just one year remaining on his current contract at the Emirates and is still no nearer to agreeing terms over an extension.

Reports in The Daily Star and Metro this week claim Premier League champions Chelsea are ready to step up their interest in Oxlade-Chamberlain and table a £35m offer.

Arsene Wenger has made it clear that he intends to keep hold of the former Southampton man but it is claimed the player himself is attracted to the

idea of a switch to west London.

The report suggests Chelsea's presence in the Champions League - along with a potential pay-rise at Stamford Bridge - could be two key factors as Oxlade-Chamberlain weighs up his future move.

Speaking ahead of Arsenal's first game of the new season against Leicester City, Wenger said of Oxlade-Chamberlain: 'I think in his career he had some bad moments because he had some small injuries. Last year he was much more stable.'

# Tottenham 'sure to add players soon' says Poch

Tottenham have been slow to make summer signings because their "circumstances are different to other clubs", says manager Mauricio Pochettino.

Amid concerns over a lack of transfer activity, the Argentine said Spurs are "working hard to deliver our plan".

Full-back Danny Rose has questioned why the squad has not been strengthened.

But Pochettino told BBC Radio 5 live: "It's not easy to find the right profile but I'm sure we'll add some players in the next few weeks."

In an interview with the Sun on Thursday, Rose, who joined from Leeds in 2007, said he would "love to see two or three well-known players" arrive, adding: "And not players you have to Google and say 'Who's that?'"

He also said he would consider moving "back up north" but specified: "I'm not saying I want out, but if something came to me that was concrete, I'd have no qualms about voicing my opinions to anyone at

the club."

Kyle Walker's £45m departure to Manchester City aside, Spurs have retained the same squad that finished second to Chelsea in the league last season.

In late July, chairman Daniel Levy defended the club's lack of signings and railed against "unsustainable" spending in the Premier League.

He described the £750m redevelopment of White Hart Lane as "a challenge" but said: "I can honestly say it is not impacting our transfer activity because we are yet to find a player who we want to buy but cannot afford."

When asked about Levy's comments, Pochettino said: "My knowledge of business is very low, and of course I respect his opinion. For me he is one of the most important businessmen in this country, I am sure he has many reasons to say that.

"It is true maybe our circumstances are maybe a bit different to other clubs but you need to wait and be sure you get that right, get the right player

to help you.

"We want to strengthen in different areas, in all areas. Maybe three or four players, in offensive and defensive positions. We need one in each line."

Liverpool have rejected a bid of 100 million euros (£90m) from Barcelona for Brazil playmaker Philippe Coutinho.

Barca's second bid for the 25-year-old, which was rejected immediately, comprised an initial 85m euros (£76.8m) plus 15m euros (£13.5m) in additions.

Liverpool have reiterated that Coutinho - who joined them from Inter Milan for £8.5m in 2013 - is not for sale.

Barcelona sold Brazil

forward Neymar to Paris St-Germain for a world record transfer of £200m last week.

Coutinho who scored 14 goals last term and spent six weeks out with an ankle injury, signed a new five-year deal in January, which did not include a release clause.

Manager Jurgen Klopp said the Reds were not "a selling club" when Barca's previous £72m offer was rejected in July, and Liverpool consider the matter closed.

Watford have signed striker Andre Gray from Burnley for an undisclosed club record fee - thought to be about £18.5m.

The 26-year-old has signed a five-year deal with the Hornets, who previously had two offers

rejected. Gray was in the final 12 months of his contract with Burnley and had turned down a new deal at Turf Moor.

■ Southampton stand firm on wantaway defender

**SOUTHAMPTON would rather leave Virgil van Dijk to rot in the stands than sell the unsettled star to Liverpool.**

Van Dijk has put in a transfer request to force through his dream move to Anfield having been made to train alone

after telling Saints boss Mauricio Pellegrino he wants to leave.

But the club are still fuming with Liverpool for 'tapping up' their skipper and are determined not to do business with the Merseysiders even if it means missing out on a

£60m pay-day.

They are also conscious of not being made to look weak in the eyes of their supporters by being bullied into a deal with the Reds.

A club insider said: "We do not want to sell Virgil to Liverpool and will happily let him sit

in the stands all season if we have to.

"Most of the fans would back the club in this after everything that has gone on."

With van Dijk, 25, now a hate figure with Saints followers after launching a scathing attack on club bosses in a strongly-worded statement, it is unlikely he will ever pull on a Saints shirt again.

Having only signed a bumper six-year contract

last summer making him their highest paid player, Saints are confident his transfer value will not drop if they maintain their hardline stance.

The Dutchman's only hope of an escape from St Mary's could be Chelsea coming in with a late beat-the-transfer-deadline bid.

Blues boss Antonio Conte is a big admirer of the former Celtic centre-back and is desperate to

bring in new players to help his Premier League title defence.

Chelsea are yet to formally contact Saints but it is understood they have been keeping a close eye on the Van Dijk saga.

The Southampton star believes he was set to complete a move to Anfield before Saints accused Liverpool of making an illegal approach.

## Real too hot for United

**Manchester United were outclassed as Spanish and European champions Real Madrid retained the Uefa Super Cup with victory in a sweltering Skopje Tuesday night.**

Madrid dominated from the start and led when Casemiro - who earlier hit the bar - slid in a half volley.

They doubled their lead when Isco calmly slotted in from eight yards after a neat one-two with Gareth Bale, who started ahead of Cristiano Ronaldo.

New £75m striker Romelu Lukaku tapped in before Marcus Rashford scuffed wide.

The Europa League

winners were given encouragement by Lukaku's strike, despite rarely threatening the Madrid goal in the previous hour, and could have scored a barely deserved equaliser through half-time substitute Rashford with nine minutes left.

United were unable to create another clear-cut chance as Madrid became the first team to retain the Super Cup since 1990.

With temperatures over 30C in the Macedonian capital, the match was twice stopped for scheduled cooling breaks implemented by governing body Uefa.

The Red Devils have spent £146m this summer on Everton striker Lukaku (£75m), Chelsea midfielder

Nemanja Matic (£40m) and Benfica defender Victor Lindelof (£31m) as they look to improve on a disappointing sixth-placed finish in the Premier League last season.

All three new signings started as Mourinho named a strong side against the European champions.

Only Ronaldo was missing from the Madrid team which started their victory against Juventus in the Champions League final, providing a stern test for Mourinho's new-look side.

But United struggled against the continent's best, particularly in the first half, as Madrid controlled the tempo with their crisp and purposeful passing.
