"Their royal highnesses the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge are very pleased to announce that the Duchess of Cambridge is expecting their third child. The Queen and members of both families are delighted with the news.

"As with her previous two pregnancies, the duchess is suffering from hyperemesis gravidarum. Her royal highness will no longer carry out her planned engagement at the Hornsey Road children's centre in London today. The duchess is being cared for at Kensington Palace."

The announcement comes in the same week the couple's eldest child, four-year-old Prince George is to start school at Thomas's Battersea, south London. His sister, Princess Charlotte, is two. Hyperemesis gravidarum can be so acute that it requires supplementary hydration, medication and nutrients. Kate, 35, was admitted to hospital because of morning sickness during her first pregnancy.

Scottish cities to fine polluting drivers

■ £30-a-day penalties in Edinburgh, Glasgow, Dundee and Aberdeen by 2020

Motorists who drive heavily polluting vehicles are likely to face automatic fines for entering Scotland's major cities just three years from now, ministers have said.

Under the changes, which have been championed by the first minister, low-emission zones will be created in the four biggest cities, in effect barring such vehicles from the centres of Glasgow, Edinburgh, Dundee and Aberdeen by 2020.

However, one of the cities involved, possibly Glasgow, could have its low-emission zone up and running as early as next year, ministers said.

Motorists in London with the worst exhaust emissions will face a £10 charge from next month with a more stringent ultra-low emission zone due to be brought in by 2020.

The Scottish government has decided to introduce fines rather than charges and while the amount will be set by councils, they are likely to be higher than the London charges, possibly with fines of £20 or £30 for each polluting motorist

per day.

Number-plate recognition cameras will record the details of any motorist breaking the low-emission zone rules and they will be notified of fines through the post. The penalty could rise for those who fail to pay promptly.

The zones are part of a package of measures designed to persuade drivers to give up vehicles powered by fossil fuels, a campaign that Nicola Sturgeon hopes will culminate in the removal of all petrol and diesel vehicles from Scotland by 2032 - eight years before the rest of the UK.

The first minister said: "Some of the changes that will be involved for a low-emission zone . . . do involve behavioural change, they do involve things that can be difficult for people. But the scale of this challenge and the importance of this challenge means we've got to do these things."

She added: "There will be difficult things in here, that's inevitable, but there's lots of wins for us as well if we do this properly."

Environmental

campaigners have welcomed the initiative, saying there was clear evidence that pollution from vehicles was linked to poor health.

Speaking in the Scottish parliament, Patrick Harvie, for the Greens, said: "For some time we have been calling for more than the one pilot low-emission zone that the Scottish government has supported, so I welcome the commitment to have four such zones."

But motoring organisations and opposition politicians said that the plan represented yet another attack on motorists.

Nicholas Lyes, spokesman for the RAC, said motorists would be "reeling" from the news that they could be fined from as early as next year.

He said: "Nobody doubts the need for bold decisions being made to tackle Scotland's pollution issue in its biggest cities. However, the outlined measures could have serious financial and practical impacts on those living and working in and around these cities."

We can win border poll in five years, says Adams

■ Unionists rally against 'divisive' demands

Sinn Féin have called for a referendum on a united Ireland within five years, a move denounced as "divisive and destabilising" by unionists.

Gerry Adams, the party's leader, told colleagues on Wednesday that Brexit had re-energised the debate about a united Ireland.

Arlene Foster, the Democratic Unionist Party leader, immediately dismissed the notion of a border poll.

The public spat threatens to derail talks about the restoration of power-sharing. Simon Coveney, the foreign affairs minister, met representatives from Stormont's five main parties in Belfast this week to ascertain whether the appetite was there for further negotiations.

'new approach'

"Brexit has re-energised and reshaped the debate about a united Ireland," Mr Adams said, opening Sinn Féin's two-day think-in at the CityNorth hotel in Co Meath.

"That demands a new approach aimed at unlocking Unionist opposition to a new future by reminding them of the positive contribution they have made to society on this island. Instead of concentrating on the negative aspects of our four centuries of shared history I suggest that we embrace the areas of agreement and of co-operation; of good neighbourliness and the common good," he said.

He added that Sinn Féin would seek the support of all parties in the Oireachtas for a committee on Irish unity and pledged to bring forward a legislative white paper on the matter.

"We want to see a referendum on unity

in the next five years. We believe that this is achievable and winnable. We also believe that this should be government policy," Mr Adams said.

He described Brexit as the most serious social, economic and political threat to the island of Ireland for a generation.

"The people of the North voted against Brexit. The Irish government has a responsibility to defend that vote and to act in the best interests of all the people of this island," he said.

In response to his call for a border poll Ms Foster dismissed the idea, claiming it was not sensible.

"Northern Ireland needs stability," she said. "That means we need a functioning government to make vital decisions. We do not need a divisive and destabilising border poll."

Under the terms of the 1998 Good Friday Agreement, the Northern Ireland secretary has the power to trigger a poll on unity, but only if he or she believes there has been a shift in public opinion in favour of changing the constitutional position.

As part of its confidence-and-supply agreement with Theresa May's Conservative Party the DUP extracted a commitment that a referendum would not

take place without the consent of the Irish people. Ms Foster described the call as a "narrow political project".

"There is no evidence of overwhelming support for a united Ireland. Holding, or indeed even just proposing, a border-poll within five years is not sensible," she said.

'wishful thinking'

"It will propel Northern Ireland into a cycle of referenda. This is nothing short of wishful thinking by Gerry Adams. It is time he and those around him lifted their eyes and considered the damage recent instability is having upon everyone in Northern Ireland."

While all party leaders agree on the need for devolution, Ms Foster's offer of proposals to address the Irish language and other cultural issues has been rejected by Sinn Féin, which is demanding a standalone Irish language act to enshrine the rights of Irish speakers in Northern Ireland.

Power-sharing has been suspended since early this year when Martin McGuinness, the late Sinn Féin deputy first minister, resigned in protest at the DUP's handling of a botched green energy scheme, which risks landing the taxpayer with millions of pounds of debt.

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Confidence, leadership, humility - but no best friends: what George's new school hopes to instill in the future king

- Firstday at school for William and Kate's eldest child
- South London school both progressive and exclusive

THIS WAS very big week for little Prince George. Not only did he learn he would soon be getting a new sibling, but on Thursday morning came that momentous first step which every small child must take: he started school.

A severe bout of morning sickness upended plans for both the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge to accompany their firstborn on his scholastic debut, leaving Prince William to do the school run solo. Father and son arrived shortly before 8.50am and was driven through a side entrance of the swanky but progressive Thomas's Battersea school, where £18,000 a year ensures a working security gate, which closed firmly behind the royal car.

The school prospectus promises to teach its young charges to "be kind", acquire "confidence, leadership and humility" and not have a best friend to prevent other children having hurt feelings.

Holding his dad's hand and looking a little apprehensive, George

walked from the car and then had a formal handshake with Helen Haslem, head of lower school.

All in all it was a very a low-key arrival... certainly unlike William's first day, which was witnessed by a bank of photographers. The fiercely-protective Cambridges stipulated only one TV camera and one photographer would be there to capture the moment.

'precious early years'

The newest and most famous pupil, who will be known as George Cambridge, was escorted into the reception class. Kitted out in his John Lewis uniform (also available at Peter Jones in Sloane Square) – winter and summer uniforms, red art smock, and PE kit including black ballet shoes total more than £365 – the young prince can look forward to a broad education.

Along with maths, English and science, the curriculum includes classes in "understanding the world", "expressive arts and design" and

"communication and language". Art, ballet, drama, ICT, French, music, and PE are all taught from day one.

If, like his great-uncle Edward, he inclines towards thespianism, the school performs eight different productions a year, and has its own sound and lighting crew. Any musical leanings will be encouraged enthusiastically through weekly concerts and summer and winter galas.

He may, of course, prefer to just charge around the rooftop playground, with climbing frames and stunning views across the river Thames and Battersea Park.

Ben Thomas, principal of Thomas's London Day School, who was headteacher at Thomas's Battersea for 18 years, said he hoped George would learn to be himself.

"The whole aim of these precious early years of education is to give children that confidence in who they are. So we are not going to try and mould him into any kind

of particular person and we wouldn't do that with any of our pupils.

"I hope he will have the confidence to be himself with all his quirks and his idiosyncrasies and characteristics."

The choice of Thomas's Battersea makes him the first direct royal heir to be educated south of the river, but then he is only the third-generation heir to attend public school.

Morning snacks include organic milk, freshly baked pain aux raisins (raisin croissant

to the rest of us) and wholewheat breadsticks. For lunch, pupils are promised freshly cooked meals which, whenever possible, include organic meat, vegetables and dairy, all of which grandpapa Charles will undoubtedly approve.

According to the Good Schools Guide, it has a wide-ranging mix of international parents, with 19 different foreign languages spoken at home. Competitive and oversubscribed, it is looking for children

who "have a measure of confidence, are responsive, sociable, and with a light in their eyes".

Society bible Tatler advises to get children's names down at birth. According to the society magazine, new headmaster Simon O'Malley, who, like George, starts this September, is a "silver fox" whose previously stated mission is for pupils to leave school "confident and comfortable, the sort of people others turn to".

in line to the throne – bumping William's brother, Prince Harry, down to sixth place. Until recently, if the Cambridge's new baby was a boy it would have leapfrogged Charlotte in the line of succession. Under the rules of male primogeniture, royal sons took precedence over female siblings.

A radical shake-up, before the birth of Prince George and affecting babies born after 28 October 2011, removed discriminatory male bias. It meant the Cambridge's first child, regardless of gender, would be destined as monarch.

It is likely Kate will choose to have her baby in the Lindo wing of St Mary's hospital, Paddington, where she has already experienced two deliveries. The couple have a live-in nanny.

'fantastic news'

The duchess is understood to be less than 12 weeks pregnant, with Kensington Palace announcing the news earlier than perhaps the couple desired due to morning sickness affecting her diary.

Prince Harry gave a thumbs up when asked about the baby as he arrived for an engagement in Manchester. "Fantastic. Great. Very, very happy for them." On how the duchess was, he replied: "I haven't seen her for a while but I think she's

OK."

Clarence House said the Prince of Wales and Duchess of Cornwall were "delighted at the news".

A Downing Street spokesperson, asked for prime minister Theresa May's response, said: "It is fantastic news and she passes on her congratulations to the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge."

Having chosen traditional royal names for their first two children, bookies' odds are likely to be short on Alice or Alexandra for a girl, and James or Philip for a boy.

Royal observers had indicated it was likely that the couple would have three children. Kate is one of three, with a sister, Pippa Matthews, and brother, James Middleton. On a royal tour of Poland in July 2017, she joked about having a third after being given a present designed for newborns, turning to William and saying: "We will just have to have more babies."

William, 35, who is one of two siblings, may not initially have been convinced. On an overseas tour of Singapore in 2012, when asked by a group of teenagers how many children he would like to have, he said he was "thinking about having two".

He recently gave up his part-time job as an air ambulance helicopter pilot for East Anglian air ambulance to take up full-time royal duties as the Duke of Edinburgh stepped down from his royal work.

Kate gets £92k damages for topless pix

■ Royal couple had sought £1.5m for shots published in French magazine

The Duke and Duchess of Cambridge have been awarded 100,000 euros (£92,000) in damages after a French magazine printed topless pictures of Catherine.

A French court ruled the images used by Closer - taken as the couple holidayed in Provence five years ago - had been an invasion of their privacy.

The royals will donate the funds to charity, according to multiple media reports.

The judge fined Closer magazine's editor and owner 45,000 euros - the maximum amount allowed.

The damages - 50,000 euros to each royal - fall short of the 1.6 million euros (£1.5m) sought by lawyers for Prince William and Catherine.

'Unjustified intrusion'

Long-lens images of Catherine sunbathing on a terrace were published on the front and inside pages of the Closer publication - which is separate to the UK's

Presiding judge Florence Lasserre-Jeannin also instructed regional newspaper La Provence, which printed images of the duchess in her swimwear, to pay 3,000 euros in damages during the hearing at the Tribunal de Grande Instance de Nanterre.

A statement from Kensington Palace said: "This incident was a serious breach of privacy, and their Royal Highnesses felt it essential to pursue all legal remedies.

"They wished to make the point strongly that this kind of unjustified intrusion should not happen."

The judgement follows the trial of six people, including photographers and the former editor of Closer, which began in May.

All six defendants were convicted of charges relating to the taking and publication of the images.

A statement from Prince William was read at the trial in May.

The duke said: "The clandestine way in which these photographs were

taken was particularly shocking to us as it breached our privacy."

The invasion of privacy was "all the more painful" given the experience of his mother, Princess Diana, with the paparazzi, he added.

Ernesto Mauri, 70, chief executive of publishing group Mondadori, which produces Closer, and Laurence Pieau, 51, editor of the magazine in France, were fined 45,000 euros each for their role in the invasion of privacy.

Agency photographers Cyril Moreau and Dominique Jacovides, who had denied taking the topless photographs, were told to each pay 10,000 euros.

Marc Auburtin, 57, who was La Provence's publishing director at the time, and the paper's photographer, Valerie Suau, 53, were each given suspended fines.

The duke and duchess launched their legal proceedings in 2012 and a court in Paris banned Closer from printing any further images.

But rather than show any remorse, Rooney allegedly blamed his drinking on Coleen taking so many vacations, and is believed to have told her he will become teetotal if she cuts back on the number of holidays.

Friends have claimed their marriage is on the rocks but the Everton striker is refusing to remove his wedding ring, but it is not clear if Coleen is still wearing her's.

Mrs Rooney has been on 10 trips this year and

her husband has accused her of spending too much time away from the family home.

Already this year she has visited Amsterdam, Madrid, Mallorca, Ibiza, Las Vegas, Barbados and Portugal.

A leading British tabloid, quoting a source 'close' to the footballer, said: 'He's pointed the finger at her over the number of holidays she takes and she raised questions about his nights out with the lads.'

'Coleen's still furious

with Wayne and is threatening all sorts. Wayne's just hoping she'll calm down.

'He's told her he is willing to stop going out if that means she will stay with him. But he hasn't totally held back himself.

'In the end it'll need some give-and-take on both sides to get everything back to normal.'

As for Ms. Simpson, she seems to be enjoying her moment of fame, gushing to a tabloid reporter that she was "swept away"

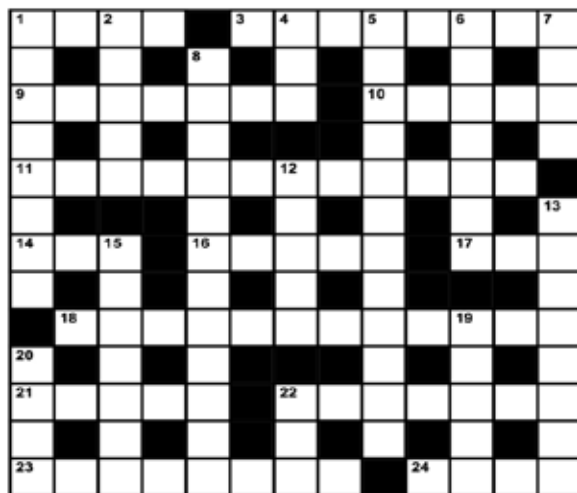

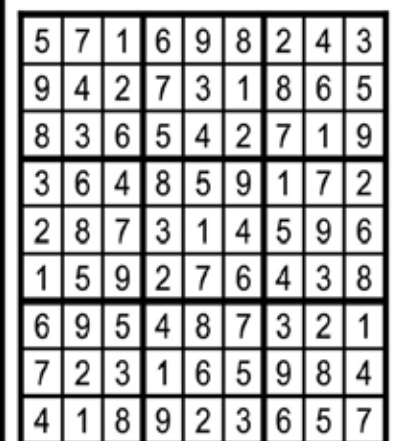

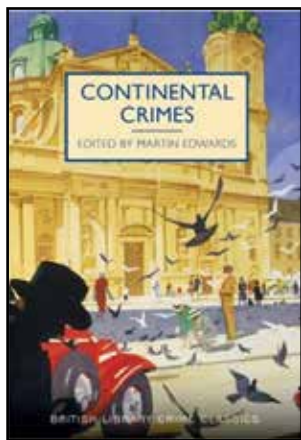
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Continental Crimes: they do it differently over there

Exclusive interview with editor Martin Edwards, discussing his latest classic crime story anthology



"From a reader's perspective, it's great to read the old favourites," says *Continental Crimes* editor Martin Edwards.

"But, one of the special joys of an anthology is the chance to discover interesting writers for the very first time. I've edited several anthologies of classic crime stories for the British Library as part of their highly successful Crime Classics series. Each of the anthologies has a different unifying theme. I'd published collections featuring

London mysteries, holiday mysteries, country house mysteries, rural mysteries, and so on, and I was casting around for a fresh idea. It struck me that it would be fun to gather crime stories written by British authors but set in continental Europe."

In this collection are forgotten stories by classic writers including Agatha Christie, Arthur Conan Doyle, G.K. Chesterton and J. Jefferson Farjeon. Some of these vintage crime tales are set in cities, some in small hamlets and others in castles that have seen better days.

"The challenge then was to find the right mix of stories," says Edwards. "I like to blend familiar authors with those who are less well known, although highly talented. So Arthur Conan Doyle, G.K. Chesterton, and Agatha Christie make an appearance, and so do H. C. Bailey, Josephine

Bell and Fryn Tennyson Jesse, fine writers who are more or less forgotten nowadays. But even with stories by the stellar names, I aim for the unexpected."

"So for example, Doyle's story doesn't feature Sherlock Holmes," says Edwards. "Christie's features her relatively forgotten character Parker Pyne. I'm also keen to blend different types of crime stories, and different styles of writing. E. Phillips Oppenheim, for instance, approached his craft in a very different way to Michael Gilbert.

The final ingredient which I hope supplies a pleasing element of variety is that the stories are set in different periods, ranging from the late nineteenth century to the 1950s."

Edwards read old magazines and anthologies to find stories that offered the right mix

of diversity and quality. Edwards also wrote *The Story of Classic Crime in 100 Books*, a non-fiction book which traces the development of the crime story over the first half of the twentieth century, from *The Hound of the Baskervilles* to *Strangers on a Train*.

"One of my aims is to introduce readers, even those who are lifelong crime fans, to novels and authors they may not have encountered before," says Edwards.

Edwards has published eighteen crime novels, including seven contemporary whodunits in the *Lake District Mysteries* series, and most recently *The Dungeon House*. He's written over 60 short stories and has published eight other non-fiction books and many articles. *The Golden Age of Murder* won the Edgar, Agatha, and Macavity awards and the HRF Keating

Award. He recently received the Poirot award for my contribution to the traditional mystery, and in the UK won the Short Story Dagger and the CWA Margery Allingham Prize. Many of his novels and *The Golden Age of Murder* have been optioned for TV, but so far none has been produced.

Edwards edited *Continental Crimes* on his own, consulting with friends who made suggestions about stories to consider.

"I'm lucky in my publishers both in Britain and the U.S.," says Edwards. "The British Library team are great to work with. Poisoned Pen Press in the U.S. are long-term friends...hugely supportive of my work."

Edwards is currently writing a novel set during the era of classic crime, in 1930. "It's not a pastiche Golden Age whodunit," says Edwards. "It's a thriller." After that, he's

Two victories keep Welsh hopes alive

Wales left it late to beat lowly Moldova in midweek as goals from Hal Robson-Kanu and Aaron Ramsey gave them a second win in four days to keep alive their hopes of qualifying for the 2018 World Cup in midweek.

Despite a gulf of 141 places between the two in the Fifa world rankings, the game was goalless at half-time thanks to a combination of stubborn Moldovan defending and a dearth of quality in the Welsh attack.

Just as their desperate search for a winning goal seemed destined for crushing disappointment, the visitors were again left to cherish the impact of Ben Woodburn - their match-winner against Austria on Saturday - as the 17-year-old's superb run and cross set up Robson-Kanu's diving header.

Ramsey's deflected strike in injury time sealed victory for Wales, who are now up to second place in Group D but remain four points behind leaders Serbia, who beat the Republic of Ireland in Dublin.

With only two matches

left, that means the play-offs look like Wales' likeliest route to next year's tournament in Russia.

The play-off places will be filled by the eight best runners-up in the nine qualifying groups, excluding their results against the bottom side.

As things stand, Wales' chances of qualifying automatically as group winners are all but over, their victory against Moldova at least means they have stolen a march on the Republic of Ireland in the race for second spot.

The biggest story of the past week surrounding the Welsh team has been the emergence of Woodburn, who, former Wales and Liverpool great Ian Rush has warned, must be handled carefully despite his eye-catching international debut.

"You don't want to put too much pressure on him," Rush told 5 live.

"He's done really well but when you compare him to Gareth Bale and Aaron Ramsey there's still a long way to go."

Results boost our appeal, says N. Ireland boss

Manager Michael O'Neill believes his team's recent success will make it easier to persuade young players to represent Northern Ireland.

With his side on the verge of a place in the World Cup play-offs, O'Neill says the mood in the Northern Ireland camp is more positive than in the past.

"At one time, we had boys who dreaded coming to play for us in Belfast, now they relish it," said O'Neill.

Northern Ireland's win over the Czech Republic on Monday means they are guaranteed a top two finish in Group C qualifying.

With the world champions topping the group, O'Neill's men are likely to be one of the eight countries taking part in the play-offs to determine the last four European qualifiers.

That success is making it easier for Northern Ireland to attract young players who have the option of playing their international football elsewhere, O'Neill argued on Radio 5 live.

"It was very difficult in the early years because we didn't have a lot to sell," said O'Neill who took over as NI boss in December 2011.

"The ground was

dilapidated and the results were not positive, so to convince a young player to come and play for Northern Ireland was not an easy thing to do.

"If you look at someone like Oliver Norwood, for example, who played for us at Under-17. He is a Burnley boy and his father is from Northern Ireland, Ollie is touching 50 caps now for us."

The NI manager said he was concerned at the way players have had to make important decisions on their international careers at a young age.

"The thing I don't like to see happen, and it happens a lot to us, is when a young player is put in a position where he has to switch his international allegiance between the ages of 17 and 21," O'Neill added.

"It is only one choice you get, and we have lost too many young players to the Republic of Ireland on that basis whose international careers have floundered rather than flourished because of that decision. It is a big decision for any young player to have to make."

Strachan remains upbeat

Head coach Gordon Strachan said he is happy that Scotland's World Cup qualifying fate is in their own hands after a 2-0 win over Malta at Hampden this week.

Scotland dropped a place to fourth in Group F, level on points with Slovenia and a point behind Slovakia. England are five points clear at the top.

Wins over both in their final two games next month will secure second place and a play-off spot for Scotland.

"I'm all right with that," said Strachan.

"We tried to make up for bad performances or low-key performances by doing the best we can.

"They had the belief when things weren't going well to pick themselves up and go again. It showed that no matter what the belief would be elsewhere, they had a belief in themselves.

"We've put ourselves in a position now that we go into the final couple of

games still with a chance of getting to the play-offs.

Christophe Berra's header in the first half was followed by Leigh Griffiths' close-range strike after the interval for Scotland, who won 3-0 in Lithuania on Friday.

"Twenty-five attempts at goal - that says it all," said Strachan.

"Forty-eight for the last two games, so that's good enough to win games of football, if you make that amount of chances. You don't make those chances all the time at international level.

"I don't know the last time we had 25 attempts at goal. We could have scored more goals tonight but maybe they were a wee bit tired after Friday. That was more than enough tonight.

"It's been a good eight days for the players."

Transfer window to close ahead of season opening

Premier League clubs have voted to close next summer's transfer window before the 2018-19 season starts.

Managers have complained that signing players once the season is under way causes disruption to their squads and preparations.

From next season, the window will close at 17:00 BST on the Thursday

before the Premier League campaign begins.

The vote was not unanimous and clubs will still be able to sell players until the end of the normal window.

Fourteen Premier League clubs voted in favour of the amendment, which was the minimum total needed for the plans to be approved. Manchester

United, Manchester City, Watford, Swansea and Crystal Palace voted against the proposal while Burnley abstained.

The window across Europe runs until 31 August. The Premier League's move means while clubs will be able to sell until that date, buying activity will cease on 9 August for the 2018-19 season.

England edge closer

England survived a scare as they came from behind to beat Slovakia 2-1 at Wembley on Monday and take a giant stride towards qualification for next summer's World Cup in Russia.

Stanislav Lobotka took advantage of sloppy defensive work to put Slovakia ahead after just three minutes - the start of a shoddy first-half display by Gareth Southgate's side.

Marcus Rashford was culpable in conceding possession for the goal but recovered superbly to inspire England to a win that leaves them five

points clear at the top of Group F with just two rounds of games to play.

Rashford's clever near-post corner was swept in by Eric Dier eight minutes before half-time, and the Manchester United teenager was England's match-winner as he powered a superb shot past Slovakia keeper Martin Dubravka from outside the box after 59 minutes.

England can confirm their place in Russia with victory against Slovenia at Wembley in their next qualifier on 5 October.

Speaking after the game, England manager Gareth Southgate said:

"We didn't start the game well but I was pleased with the way the players reacted on the field. They got themselves into better positions. We were stretched in the first 15 minutes or so.

"Great credit to the players for staying in the game and then in the second half we were in control. We didn't give them space to play."
