STURGEON: 'ridiculous' flag story 'fake news'

■ SNP leader insists she did not order Union flag removed from government buildings

Scottish First Minister Nicola Sturgeon has hit back at reports that she ordered the Union flag not to be flown from government buildings during Royal events.

Several newspapers on Wednesday had stories alleging Ms Sturgeon had changed policy at Holyrood so the flag would only be flown on Remembrance Day this year, rather than Royal occasions such as birthdays, anniversaries, and the wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle.

The story was pounced upon by Scottish Conservatives leader Ruth Davidson, prompting Ms Sturgeon to accuse her of "peddling fake news".

And in a lengthy thread of posts on Twitter, the First Minister attempted to clarify the Scottish Government's stance on which flags fly when.

"Since the truth doesn't seem to matter very much to some, let me set out the facts on this ridiculous story," she began.

"There are two essential elements to this story. One, that @scotgov has recently changed its practice on what flags to fly from government buildings on Royal occasions; and two,

that I ordered that change. Both are wrong."

She continued: "Since 2010, the Lion Rampant has flown on Royal occasions - entirely appropriately. Since the Lion Rampant is the Royal Banner, it is not clear to me why anyone would object to that. However, the key point is that there has been no change to this since 2010.

"Yes, the civil service recently decided to update the published guidance, but simply to ensure that it accurately reflected the long standing practice -

the underlying policy has not changed. And why would it?

'complete piffle'

"As for the claim that I ordered the change, I have issued no instructions, orders, authorisations - or even expressed an opinion - about changing flag policy. The update of the guidance was an administrative step - albeit a sensible one - and not done at my request.

Ms Sturgeon's tweets were backed up by an official Scottish Government statement,

which said no change to the policy had been made.

"The current Scottish Government policy on the flying of flags, including the flying of flags on Royal occasions, was established in 2010," it said.

"In line with this policy, the Scottish Government,

by Royal Assent, has flown the Royal Banner (the Lion Rampant) and the Saltire on Royal Occasions since 2010. The current First Minister has made no change to the policy."

Earlier the former First Minister Alex Salmond had waded into the row, insisting it was he

who changed the policy at Holyrood in 2010 following a conversation with the Queen at Balmoral the year before.

He said reports that Ms Sturgeon had made the policy change, which left the Union flag flying only on Remembrance Sunday and Armed Forces Day, were "complete piffle".

UKIP leader remains defiant, vowing to 'drain the swamp' within his party

■ Bolton clings to party leadership despite no confidence vote from NEC

Henry Bolton has insisted he will not quit as UKIP leader, saying it is "time to drain the swamp" of malcontents within the party.

He said UKIP's national executive committee, which passed a vote of no confidence in him, was "not fit for purpose" and must be reformed.

Speaking in Folkestone, he urged UKIP to put an end to factional infighting.

Former UKIP leader Nigel Farage said Mr Bolton had been "pretty stupid" in the way he had handled the media over claims about his private life.

But he said he was "very pleased" that the leader was pushing for changes to the party's constitution and the national executive committee, which he said were long overdue.

"If UKIP doesn't change it will not exist in 18 months time," he said on his LBC radio show.

He said he will "wait to see" Henry Bolton's proposals to reform UKIP, before deciding whether to back him staying on as leader.

In an interview with Mr Farage, Mr Bolton hit out at those who had quit, saying: "If they had any interest in the party they would be continuing their jobs - their resignations achieve nothing in that respect."

Asked how he was coping with the media attention, Mr Bolton said: "In some ways I am enjoying navigating through all this."

UKIP's local government, education, trade and immigration spokesmen have all resigned as Mr Bolton defied growing calls to quit over offensive texts sent by his ex-girlfriend.

Ex-education spokesman David Kurten said he believed Mr Bolton had "no chance of surviving" a vote of party

members, saying he did not know what the leader "hoped to achieve" by staying on.

In a statement to the media, Mr Bolton said he "respected" the party's constitutional process, which will see party members decide his future in the coming weeks.

But he said the decision to force a vote was a "distraction" from what should be the party's focus on May's local elections and achieving "true independence" for the UK after Brexit.

"I repeat I shall not be resigning as party leader."

He said he had lost confidence in the NEC, which he said was unable to take the party forward and whose shortcomings he suggested had been recognised by previous leaders.

"The NEC requires significant and urgent reform. To that end, again

during the coming weeks, I shall be proposing a new party constitution, with a newly constituted and reformed NEC.

"Likewise, it is now time to put an end to the factional in-fighting within the party and to remove those who have been a part of that. In a single phrase, it is time to 'Drain the Swamp'."

Mr Bolton, who has been under pressure over some of his former girlfriend's comments, has said another leadership contest could be financially ruinous for the party, which has staged three contests in the last 18 months.

He has also said he has ended the "romantic element" of his relationship with Jo Marney after it emerged that in the past she had sent a text saying Prince Harry's fiancée Meghan Markle would "taint" the Royal Family, leading to accusations of racism.



HENRY BOLTON: he won't go

A team of British soldiers have become the first all-female group to ski across Antarctica using muscle power alone. The Ice Maiden expedition reached Hercules Inlet this week, having covered 1,000 miles in 62 days. Led by Major Nics Wetherill and Major Natalie Taylor, of the Royal Army Medical Corps, the six women had walked for up to 27 miles a day in temperatures as low as -40°C, while pulling sledges that weighed more than 12 stone.

British milkmen are profiting from the war on plastic. Dairy companies say they have recently had a surge of inquiries about doorstep deliveries of milk in old-fashioned glass bottles, from householders anxious to cut back on their plastic waste.

Putin ready for war, insists Army boss

THE prospect of war with Russia was raised this week by the head of the Army as a Whitehall battle over defence funding intensifies.

General Sir Nick Carter stressed that he did not think Russia wants to go to war in the "traditional" sense. But he warned: "Russia could initiate hostilities sooner than we expect and a lot earlier than we would in similar circumstances."

Russia, he said, "represents the most complex and capable state-based threat to our country since the end of the Cold War". It is "the arch exponent" at "exploiting the seams

between peace and war" with tactics such as "bribes, corrupt business practices, cyber attacks, assassination, fake news, propaganda and military intimidation".

'credible deterrence'

He revealed that he is reconsidering a plan to bring all British troops back from Germany and instead keep fuel, ammunition and tanks in position at bases there.

He addressed the Royal United Services Institute as Defence Secretary Gavin Williamson comes under increased Treasury pressure for cuts. Sir Nick said: "Our generation has become

used to wars of choice since the end of the Cold War but we may not have a choice about conflict with Russia.

"We have to be prepared to fight the war we might have to fight, with a sporting chance we will avoid it."

He also warned that Britain is falling behind and showed a Russian video boasting about its armed forces' burgeoning capabilities. In a clear message to the Treasury he added: "Credible deterrence must be underpinned by genuine capability and genuine equipment that earns the respect of potential opponents."



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'Barman' with links to kings and toffs

JACK BROOKSBANK is the former waiter who bagged a Princess.

But, although he was once nicknamed "Barman Jack", his origins are not quite as humble. Educated at £35,595-a-year Stowe School in Buckinghamshire, the 31-year-old wine merchant turned down university and a job in the City to start work in the hospitality trade.

In 2013 he said: "I want to create a chain of pubs. It has been my dream since I was 18."

'perfectly matched'

He is the son of Old Etonian chartered accountant George Brooksbank and his wife Nicola. His ancestors include Stamp Brooksbank, Governor of the Bank of England in the 18th century, and a long line of aristocrats, among them Princess Diana's Spencer family. The Brooksbanks can trace their roots to at least two kings, Edward III of England and James II of Scotland. After leaving school, Jack worked as a waiter and joined the staff at the Admiral Codrington gastropub in Chelsea before moving to the Markham Inn in Chelsea, where he met Prince Harry.

He also managed one of the younger royals' favourite hang-outs, the Mahiki nightclub in Mayfair, but left 18 months ago to work for Casamigos, a tequila firm set up by actor George Clooney. Jack, who is reportedly 'adored' by the Duke and Duchess of York, and Eugenie were introduced by friends seven years ago on a skiing holiday in Verbier, Switzerland. Friends say the couple are 'perfectly matched.'

■ Royal Wedding expected to take place in September

PRINCESS Eugenie revealed this week that she cried tears of joy after her long-term boyfriend Jack Brooksbank proposed to her beside a lake near a volcano in Nicaragua.

Prince Andrew's younger daughter said she was taken by surprise when wine merchant Jack popped the question during a holiday in Central America earlier this month.

Eugenie, 27, and Jack, 31, will wed in the autumn at St George's Chapel in Windsor Castle. It will be the second royal wedding of 2018. Prince Harry and Meghan Markle are due to get married at the same venue on May 19.

Although the date has yet to be announced royal insiders said that the busy schedules of all the royals means they are unlikely to find a date before September.

The couple will move into three-bedroom Ivy Cottage in the grounds of Kensington Palace, just along from Nottingham Cottage, where Harry, 33, and Meghan, 36, have

set up home. Jack is not expected to be given a title when they are married.

In an interview with the BBC's One Show, the couple described the romantic scene when he proposed. Jack said: "We had a beautiful volcano, the sun was setting, birds were flying, as we would say."

'complete surprise'

Eugenie, a director at London art gallery Hauser & Wirth, said: "The lake was so beautiful. The light was just a special light that I had never seen.

"Then he popped the question, which was really surprising even though we've been together seven years. So I was over the moon crying."

Her fiancé confirmed he had got down on bended knee.

"I did get down on one knee. I love Eugenie so much," he said.

His proposal amazed Eugenie. She said: "[It was a] Complete surprise, but it was the perfect moment. We couldn't be happier because we knew it was

going to end up this way."

Earlier, Eugenie, wearing a colourful dress by Erdem and Jimmy Choo shoes, showed off her engagement ring during official photographs in the Picture Gallery at Buckingham Palace. Her ring – an oval padparadscha sapphire surrounded by diamonds, set on a gold band – is strikingly similar in shape and design to her mother Sarah, Duchess of York's engagement ring. Eugenie's ring, named after the colour of a Lotus blossom, is a pink sapphire, the rarest of all sapphires, which usually comes from Sri Lanka.

Andrew and Fergie, who wed in 1986 but split in 1992 and divorced in 1995, spoke of their happiness after making the announcement.

Andrew, 57, said: "I'm just completely overjoyed for them and wish them every happiness.

"Jack is an absolutely outstanding young man and Eugenie and he have got to know each other over a number of years, and I'm really thrilled for them."

Both families will now turn to the planning of the wedding but Andrew said: "We can't fix a date

Fergie, 58, described her joy in a Tweet: "We love Jack and I am so excited to have a son, a brother, and a best friend."

The Queen and Prince Philip also expressed their delight. Eugenie

said: "Granny knew at the beginning. She was very happy, as was my grandfather."

Jack's parents, Nicola and George Brooksbank, said: "We could not be more delighted with the news of the engagement. We are over the moon."

Furious Fergie doubles lawsuit against Murdoch

■ Duchess sues tycoon for £40m over news sting which 'destroyed her career'

THE Duchess of York has doubled a compensation claim against media mogul Rupert Murdoch over a "humiliating" cash-for-access sting to more than £40million, it emerged this week.

Sarah Ferguson claims her career was destroyed by Mazher Mahmood, the "fake sheikh", when he taped her apparently offering access to her former husband Prince Andrew for £500,000. In 2010 the Duchess told Mahmood, a News of the World reporter, that she could get him access to Prince Andrew – then a trade envoy – for money. She was secretly taped saying: "That opens up everything you could ever wish for."

On Monday a new lawsuit was laid bare as the Duchess demanded £40million in lost income

from Mr Murdoch's newspaper company as a result of the sting. The claim includes £4.8million for lost personal appearances, which are alleged to have dried up, and £22million for plans for two TV shows which were said to have been put on hold. One of the shows was an animation series, known as Fergie's Farm which, along with DVD sales and merchandise could have earned her millions, according to her claims.

'humiliation'

Also in the papers lodged with the High Court this month is a claim for £8.6million in health product merchandising which included appearances on the QVC shopping channel. Another claim is for loss of fashion and film commissions

which she claims cost her £5.8million.

The Duchess is also said to have had plans for a series of "higher end" books titled Madame Pantaloon which she claims were scuppered, costing her £766,000 in lost earnings. She originally launched a writ in 2016 claiming Mahmood, who has since been disgraced, "used deceit" to induce her to make "unguarded statements".

She said that the publication of her comments had caused her "serious embarrassment, humiliation, distress and reputational damage" as well as the extraordinary financial losses. The claim added: "The Duchess's ability to generate income from a variety of businesses was seriously damaged."

Newspapers said the story was "in the public interest" and lawyers for Mr Murdoch have reportedly branded her case "embarrassing and defective".

The Duchess married Prince Andrew in 1986 and they divorced in 1996. She became an ambassador for WeightWatchers in a multimillion pound deal but was reported to have debt problems by 2010. Despite the success of her children's books about Budgie The Helicopter, bids to re-invent herself

as a TV host, filmmaker and the US face of WeightWatchers, she ran up huge debts. The Duchess also faced criticism of her extravagant lifestyle amid the allegations that she had tried to cash in on her royal connections. Her fluctuating financial fortunes recently featured in the leaked Panama Papers. Documents suggested she set up a British Virgin Islands firm to manage some of her business ventures. But a year later she had no idea who the firm's

directors and beneficial owners were and had to get lawyers to find out. Since her divorce she has made up to £2million a year from her roles with organizations such as WeightWatchers but is reported to have lost money from the collapse of Hartmoor, her US lifestyle company. She told one interviewer that she had "little understanding" of money, adding: "I'm not just emotionally bankrupt, I'm continually on the verge of financial bankruptcy."

Former husband of F1 heiress 'lost £90m' in Belgravia raid

■ Bullion dealer Stunt 'devastated', blasts rumors heist was a fraud

IN WHAT is believed to be Britain's biggest ever robbery, burglars stole a valuables worth a staggering £90million from socialite Petra Ecclestone's billionaire former husband, it has emerged.

Bullion dealer James Stunt was "devastated" after thieves snatched gold, gems and cash from a safe at his home in London's Belgravia. If the value of the stolen goods is confirmed at £90million, it would be Britain's biggest burglary. The previous record was the £25million Hatton Garden jewellery heist in 2015.

Mr Stunt, 35, had just moved into the mansion following his divorce from Petra, 29, daughter of former Formula One chief Bernie Ecclestone, 87. It is understood he

had not had time to install CCTV cameras at the property. The playboy businessman was asleep when the burglars made off with the haul last month.

Flying Squad detectives are hunting the thieves. Scotland Yard said a man in his 20s had been arrested in connection with the theft. He was later released but is still under investigation.

Mr Stunt and Petra, who have three children, were granted a divorce last October. Lawyers for the couple had come to agreement over a split of the couple's rumoured £5.5billion fortune. In a statement issued shortly afterwards Mr Stunt said: "I am devastated that my marriage has broken down. I love Petra and our children."

He married Ms

Ecclestone in a lavish £12million ceremony at Odescalchi Castle near Rome in 2011. Mr Stunt is often accompanied by bodyguards when he travels around London. But he appeared to have stepped up his security on Saturday night when he was surrounded by nine minders for a trip to a fashionable Italian restaurant. He enjoyed a meal at the C London establishment in London's Mayfair with a group of women friends.

Scotland Yard said in a statement: "Police were called at approximately 7.45am on December 14, 2017, by a man reporting the burglary of jewellery from a house in Westminster."

"The police investigation is being led by officers from the Flying Squad. A man, aged in

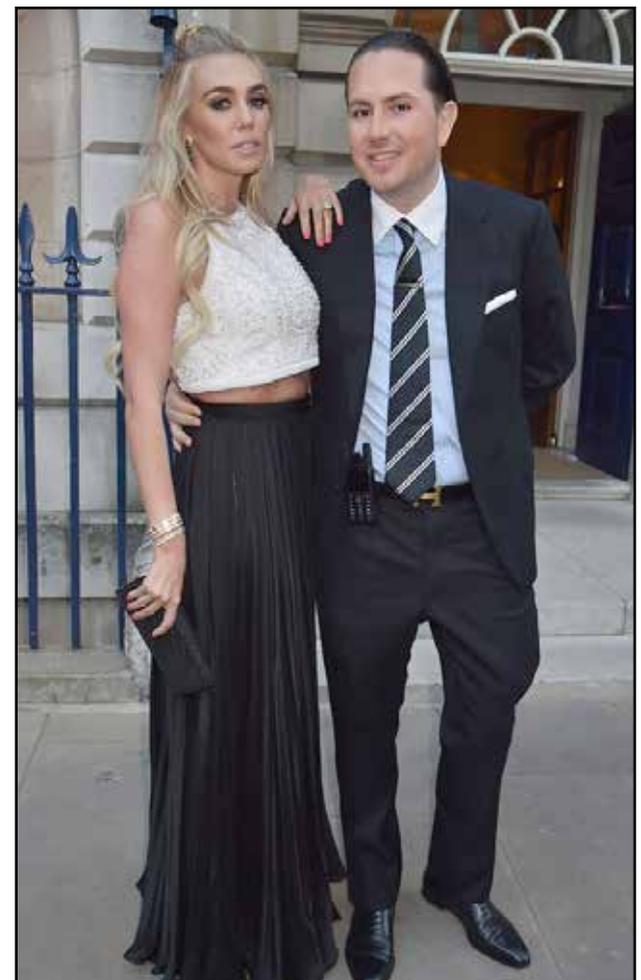
his 20s, was arrested in December in connection with the investigation. He has been released and our inquiries continue."

But as the story unfolded during the week, rumors grew that Stunt had faked the robbery as part of an elaborate insurance scam.

When asked about the allegations Stunt insisted: "I've nothing to hide. I'm a victim with no upside to this embarrassment of having no insurance."

"It's disgusting how people are commenting that I'm a criminal. It's not true or fair. I just want whoever did this arrested and my things back."

He went on to say that his dead brother's watch was among the items that were stolen and said he 'wished he had insurance' in a strong condemnation of the claims that the robbery was a con.

Scotland bans shock collars for dogs

Electric "shock" collars for dogs are to be banned in Scotland with immediate effect, amid concerns that they are "cruel and ineffective", the Scottish Government has announced.

The collars are used to train dogs through the use of small shocks, but have come under fire from animal rights activists and opposition politicians. MSPs are Holyrood were scheduled to debate proposed new laws by Tory MSP Maurice Golden on Thursday which had been drawn up to introduce a ban, but environment secretary Roseanna Cunningham pre-empted the debate on Tuesday by announcing she had decided to act immediately after hearing concerns on the issue.

"After carefully considering the concerns raised by stakeholders and the public about electronic training collars for dogs, particularly the ready availability on the internet of cheap devices which can be bought by anyone and used to deliver painful electric shocks, I have decided to take steps to effectively and promptly ban their use in Scotland," Ms Cunningham said.

"Causing pain to dogs by inappropriate training methods is clearly completely unacceptable and I want there to be no doubt that painful or unpleasant training for dogs will not be tolerated."

The ban was welcomed by Harry Huyton, director of animal charity OneKind. He said: "Electric shock collars are cruel, unnecessary and ineffective."

The Fall's Mark E Smith dead at 60

■ Famously irritable post punk musician enjoyed long career without achieving major chart success

Mark E Smith, leader of The Fall and one of the most famously bad-tempered musicians of the post-punk era, has died following a long illness.

Born in Salford in 1957, Smith formed the Fall with friends Martin Bramah and Tony Friel as a teenager. From their 1976 debut to their 2017 release, *New Facts Emerge*, Smith was the band's only continuous member. But despite producing a prodigious body of work, the band's lineup was constantly changing, usually due to bust-ups with their

proudly irascible leader.

The band's output included 11 top 40 albums, including 1993's *The Infotainment Scan*, which reached No 9. Smith has also collaborated with artists including Gorillaz, Inspiral Carpets and Elastica. His autobiography, *Renegade: The Lives and Tales of Mark E Smith*, was published in 2008.

In 1983, Smith married Fall member Brix Smith; they divorced in 1989. He subsequently married Saffron Prior, who ran The Fall's fan club. He has been

married to his current wife, Eleni Poulou – who was a member of the Fall between 2002 and 2016 – since 2001.

Among the tributes paid to Smith were from writer and Hacienda DJ Dave Haslam who said: "The death of Mark E Smith is news I'd been dreading. One of my heroes, and a man I was proud to call a friend."

BBC Radio 6 Music's Lauren Laverne described him as: "One of my biggest heroes. Had a nightmare interviewing him (of course) but then he put me in a song. So sharp, clever and

untouchably cool."

Pete Wylie, stalwart of the indie scene as the many incarnations of The Mighty Wah!, said: "Known him a long time and had the usual mixture of madness and

monkey business with him. Love The Fall. So many tales."

His death was previously wrongly announced by the BBC in March last year, on his 60th birthday, of 60.

Tributes flow for Jimmy Armfield

■ Former England international enjoyed long second career as BBC football broadcaster and analyst

TRIBUTES flowed in this week for England football legend "gentleman" Jimmy Armfield, who died Monday morning after a brave battle with cancer, aged 82.

Armfield played 569 times as right back for Blackpool in a one-club career and later moved into the media, working for the Daily Express and becoming a star BBC radio broadcaster. Armfield also won 43 England caps and captained his country 15 times. He played in the 1962 World Cup in Chile, where he was acclaimed as the "best right back in the world".

Although part of the 1966 squad, a toe injury kept him on the sidelines as England famously beat West Germany in the final at Wembley. After retiring from playing he managed Bolton, winning promotion from

the old Third Division in 1973. He then led Leeds United to the 1975 European Cup Final against Bayern Munich, losing 2-0.

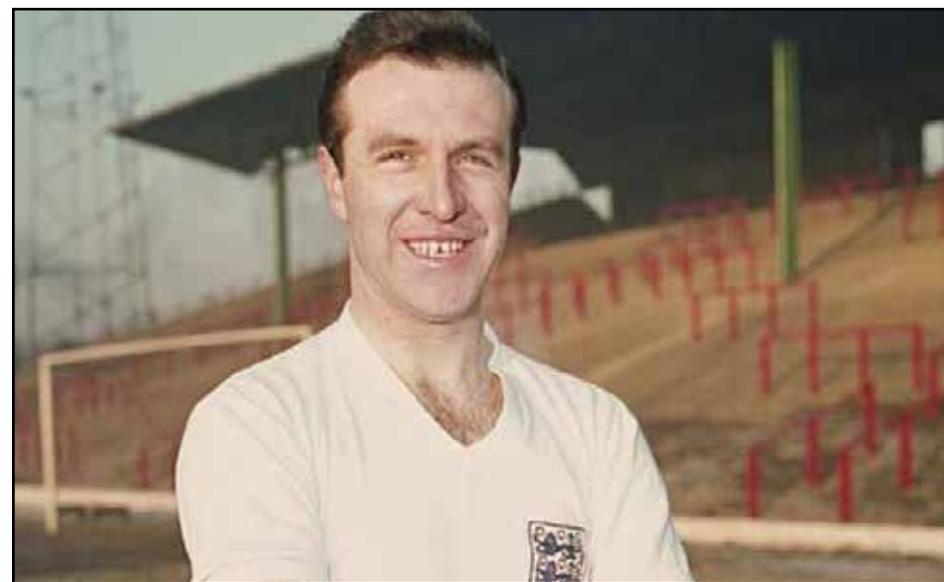
Armfield left club management in 1979 and joined the Daily Express as a journalist. He also then embarked on a 35-year career as an analyst and match summariser for the BBC.

'honest and genuine'

His family revealed he had died in the early hours of Monday morning in Blackpool's Trinity Hospice.

A statement said: "After a long and courageous battle, our beloved husband, father, grandfather and father-in-law Jimmy Armfield has passed away peacefully surrounded by his immediate family.

"We have many wonderful messages of love and support, for which we are grateful,

and moved by all the kind words."

The family also praised the hospice and its staff.

Blackpool FC tweeted: "Club deeply saddened to learn of the passing of its record appearance holder and vice-president Jimmy Armfield."

England team-mate Sir Bobby Charlton, said: "He was one of the most honest and genuine gentlemen I had the good fortune to meet."

League Managers Association chairman

Howard Wilkinson said: "Jimmy's contribution to the game at so many levels is immeasurable."

"Despite the pressures, success at any price never became an option for Jimmy. He epitomised the beautiful game in thought and deed."

Born in Denton, Greater Manchester, Armfield's family moved to Blackpool, where he started a 17-year playing career in 1954. He received only

one caution in that time, making his final appearance in May 1971. He was made a freeman of Blackpool in 2003. He won an OBE in 2000 and was named a CBE in 2010.

While at the BBC, Armfield missed only a short stint in 2007 while fighting non-Hodgkin lymphoma, which returned in 2016. He is survived by his wife Anne, a nurse, who he married in 1958, and their sons John and Duncan.

Bloodstains with Brontë



Exclusive interview with author Kathrine Bolger Hyde, discussing her new novel where a Brontë murder mystery party turns into a real murder

"For the last twelve years I've spent a week every summer at a writing retreat in Rockaway Beach," says *Bloodstains with Brontë* author Kathrine Bolger Hyde.

"A fictionalized version of that town seemed like the perfect setting for a mystery series. With the tiny permanent population, who would all know each other well, plus the transient holiday people, who would provide plenty of options for killers and victims. Also, the weather there can get pretty wild in the colder months. That seemed perfect for a book based

on the Brontës."

The book opens as Emily and Katie host a murder mystery dinner on Halloween night to benefit the local clinic. Emily inherited Windy Corner on the wildly beautiful Oregon coast in the first book in the series, *Arsenic with Austin*. Emily is remodeling, preparing to host writer's retreats. Sheriff Luke Richards is the love of Emily's life.

Emily's housekeeper Katie is a young single mother. The murder mystery dinner turns into a real murder mystery when Katie is found standing over a body with a bloody knife in her hand. Emily doesn't believe Katie killed anyone, although the sheriff does. To save Katie, Emily must find the real killer. All through the book Emily is reading books by the

Brontës.

"The inspiration for the Crime with the Classics series as a whole came through a combination of factors," says Hyde. "A big one was the setting on the Oregon coast. As for the specifics of this book, I started out by thinking about the themes, mood, and characters that are common to all the Brontë sisters' books and tried to come up with parallel elements for my story. I wanted it to be somewhat dark and brooding, with a lot of wild passion in the air to match the violence of the weather."

Bloodstains with Brontë is the second book in a series that inhabits a different classic author in each book. The series titles proceed alphabetically, first Austen then Brontë. Hyde wants to use women authors as much

as possible.

"The Brontës were a natural choice," says Hyde. "I've always loved their work and been fascinated by them as people. In fact, it was reading a biography of Charlotte Brontë that inspired me to pull my old dream of writing novels off the shelf, after years of working and child-rearing, and finally get started. Charlotte's dedication and perseverance in the face of nearly overwhelming obstacles helped me believe that I could overcome the much smaller obstacles in my own life."

Hyde's favorite Brontë novel is *Jane Eyre*. "It's a groundbreaking book in terms of its heroine, a woman who appears conventionally meek and mild on the surface but underneath is independent, strong-minded, and determined

to make a better life for herself. I also love the fact that she has strong principles that she won't sacrifice, even for the sake of an overpowering love. And the scene where Jane hears Mr. Rochester calling to her across the many miles that divide them is one of the most powerful in all literature. It gives me shivers just to think about it."

Besides the Classics series, Hydes has two picture books: *Lucia, Saint of Light*, Ancient Faith Publishing, 2009, and *Everything Tells Us about God*, AFP, 2018. Her children's fantasy novel *The Dome-Singer of Falenda* is currently out of print.

Hyde is currently writing a dark, standalone mystery about an abused wife. Hyde has written three unpublished mainstream contemporary novels.

"I am not going to be touring anymore, apart from the last tour, which is going to start in September of this year, and will be a global tour," John said at the press conference.

"And it's the last time that I will be touring, and traveling the world. Because my priorities have changed, in my life.

"Ten years ago, if you'd have said I'm going to stop touring, I would have said, 'No, no. I'm a working musician. I always play.'



But we have children, and I changed our lives. And in 2015, (husband) David (Furnish) and I sat down with a school schedule, and I thought, 'I don't want to miss too much of this.' You know, I've had an amazing life. I've had an amazing career. I've been so incredibly lucky. And my life has changed."

The singer added: "The priorities in my life have changed. My priorities now are my children, and my husband, and my family. And I've been touring since I was 17, with various bands, and as Elton John in 1969. And I thought the time is right to say thank you to all my fans around the world. ... That doesn't mean to say I'm still not going to be

creative. But I'm not going to travel anymore."

It will take about three years, he said, to do the tour the way he wants to.

"To go around the world properly," he said, "and to say goodbye to everybody in the countries that I'm popular in, it will take three years, probably. ...

Being Elton John, he promised the upcoming tour will be a lavish production.

"It's a way of going out with a bang," he said. "I don't want to go out with a whimper. I want to go out with a big bang ... and say thank you, and leave people thinking, 'I saw the last tour, and it was fantastic.'"

THE ENGLAND Test side may have been humbled this winter in Australia but it has been a different story for the one-day team, as they swept asides their hosts three times in succession to go 3-0 up and clinch the five game series.

One day captain Eoin Morgan heaped praise on his one-day side as they beat Australia by five wickets in Melbourne, four wickets in Brisbane and by 16 runs on Sunday in Sydney. It was also their fifth successive ODI series win, with a home World Cup just over 16 months away. On Sunday in Sydney Jos Buttler hit a brilliant, unbeaten 83-

ball hundred as he and Chris Woakes smashed 113 in only 11.5 overs to set Australia 303 to win at the SCG. They ended on 286-6.

Morgan said: "It was, I think, our best performance as a group to date, definitely throughout the last two years. To have a guy with Jos's capabilities

and talent in our team, we are very privileged. "We have seen him do that before but against one of the best sides in the world it is great to watch. It was a huge contribution."

Australia skipper Steve Smith completed a disastrous night having had to field questions about video footage on social media that suggested he might be illegally rubbing lip balm on the ball. Smith said: "My lips are pretty dry. It's just the way I get some spit into the side of my mouth and get it on to the ball. There's nothing in it."

Smith was honest about his team's series defeat and recent poor record in ODIs. He said

he needed to improve his own performances as well as those of the team. "Five wins out of the last 18 games – that's just not good enough," he said.

"Looking at this game the first 44 overs was really good and then Jos played particularly well at the end and Woakesy played well as well.

"But I don't think we executed well. We probably just needed to bowl some good balls at the top of the stumps and try to get them swinging across the line.

"We probably should have been chasing somewhere around 270 or 280 and then if we do that things might have been a lot different."

EDMUND: semi finalist in Australian Open

Surprise success Edmund has 'caught the bug' for Grand Slams

Britain's Kyle Edmund said he "had caught the bug" for competing in big Grand Slam matches after his thrilling Australian Open run ended in the semi-finals.

The 23-year-old was beaten 6-2 7-6 (7-4) 6-2 by Croatian sixth seed Marin Cilic in Melbourne on Wednesday. Edmund refused to blame a hip injury that required treatment, preferring to focus on two weeks that saw him make his major semi-final debut.

"I definitely go away from the whole week feeling positive," said Edmund.

"This type of tournament just gives you the bug to want more. Once you get a taste, it's like, 'Yeah, I want more of this.'"

Cilic, 29, dominated the semi-final after saving break points in the opening game, and Edmund's hopes were clearly damaged by the hip problem which required a medical timeout at the end of the first set.

However, the Yorkshireman was keen to play down the extent of the injury.

"There's something, but whatever. It's unfortunate it happens," he said.

"I'm definitely disappointed about it, but it's one of those things where I have to look at the whole week.

"Making semi-finals

of a Grand Slam is definitely something that I can be very happy with and really take that forward."

Despite the toll it clearly took to win five matches at a Slam for the first time, Edmund said he had relished the "battle".

"There's nothing better than winning best-of-five-set matches in tennis tournaments," he said.

"Best-of-five sets should always stay in the men's game. It's a true test of quality and grit. You know, it's a battle."

Edmund's ranking will rise from 49th to around 25th next week, and his career earnings of £1.5m will be boosted to the tune of £500,000.

He will not be embarking on a spending spree, however.

"It's obviously a nice chunk of money, but there's nothing I need," said Edmund. "I have stuff in place, so I'm very happy with what I have around me."

Asked about the increased attention he has experienced during the last 11 days in Melbourne, he said it "comes with the territory", adding: "If you embrace it, I think you cope with it better."

"The top guys like Roger [Federer] and that, they have been doing it their whole life. They crack on and embrace it. It's good to learn from them."

30 – but they are willing to bend their own rules to secure the Bosnian and are expected to offer him a contract through to at least 2020. Dzeko was named in the Roma side who faced Sampdoria on Wednesday night, with the club's sporting director Monchi confirming that he has yet to agree personal terms.

"Roma, like every club in the world, listen to the offers that arrive for their players, not just for Edin, but anyone in the squad," he said. "We are ready to listen and then we decide. Now Dzeko is here and the rest doesn't matter, which means the offer that arrived is not interesting. "I don't know what personal terms were offered to the player, as I am not his agent. I am talking about Roma: an offer arrives, we look at it and then decide."

Chelsea have been looking for a striker to ease the workload for Álvaro Morata. The Premier League champions made an inquiry for West Ham's Andy Carroll last week only for the striker to injure an ankle.

Antonio Conte, Chelsea's manager, is an admirer of Dzeko, who scored twice against Chelsea this season as Roma drew 3-3 at Stamford Bridge in the Champions League, and is desperate to add to his strikeforce for the second half of the season.

Dzeko, who played for Manchester City between 2011 and 2016 before joining the Serie A side, won Serie A's Golden Boot last season and has nine goals in 19 games this campaign. Palmieri is a Brazilian left-back who joined Roma in 2015, initially on loan. The Italian champions, Juventus, had also been interested in signing the 23-year-old. Palmieri is being brought in as back-up to Marcos Alonso at Stamford Bridge.

Chelsea have offered Michy Batshuayi on loan as part of the deal but Roma are exploring other possibilities to replace Dzeko should he leave in this window.

Borussia Dortmund, however, view Batshuayi as a possible replacement for Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang if the Gabon international joins Arsenal and Sevilla are also interested in signing the Belgian.

Mou inks new deal

Manchester United manager Jose Mourinho has signed a contract extension until 2020, with the option of a further year.

The 54-year-old's previous deal at Old Trafford was due to expire in 2019.

Mourinho said he was "delighted" that United "feel and trust that I am the right manager for this great club for the foreseeable future".

He added: "I would like to say a big thank you to the owners and to [chief executive] Ed Woodward."

The Portuguese, appointed as Louis van Gaal's successor in May 2016, won the EFL Cup and Europa League in his first season.

This season United are second in the Premier League, behind runaway leaders Manchester City, with the club still in the Champions League and FA Cup.

"We have set very high standards - winning three trophies in one season - but those are the standards I expect my teams to aim for," Mourinho added.

"We are creating the conditions for a brilliant and successful future for Manchester United. I love my players and it is a pleasure to know that we are going to be together for at least the next three years."

Woodward praised Mourinho for his "exceptional work rate and professionalism", as well as for "embracing the club's desire to promote top-quality young players".

He added: "He has brought an energy and a sense of purpose to everything that he does and I am sure that will continue to bring results for the fans and the club."

Speaking at his news conference earlier on Thursday - before his new contract was announced - Mourinho hailed the club's recent signing of Alexis Sanchez from Arsenal.

He said the Chilean had moved from a "fantastic club to a giant club" in the swap deal that saw Armenia midfielder Henrikh Mkhitaryan head the other way.

Mourinho said it was "a great deal for everybody".

Hasty Hornets swing axe yet again - but will Gracia prove golden choice to replace Silva?

Watford named Javi Gracia as their new head coach within hours of sacking Marco Silva on Monday.

Spaniard Gracia (pictured, right), who has signed an 18-month contract at Vicarage Road, has been out of work since leaving Russian club Rubin Kazan last June.

The 47-year-old previously spent two seasons with Spanish La Liga side Malaga, and also worked in Greece.

Gracia is the 10th manager to work for Watford under the Pozzo family since 2012.

He says restoring confidence will be one of his first tasks.

"The team has played some good matches this season and I think they can do it again," he told the club website.

"It's not easy arriving in the middle of the season, but you must be ready and I am grateful and have plenty of energy to win the rest of the matches.

"It is a big challenge, but it is also a dream."

Watford said Everton's approach for Silva in November was the "catalyst" for their decision to sack him. After a bright start to his tenure at Vicarage Road when he was tipped as one of the best young managers in Europe, Silva lost the



board's confidence when he seemed to be angling for a move to Merseyside. He also seemed to have lost the confidence of some in the dressing room as results began to worsen. Although the Hornets are currently mid table, they are only four

places off the relegation zone.

Silva was the eighth Premier League manager to lose his job this season, following changes at Crystal Palace, Everton, Leicester City, Stoke, Swansea, West Brom and West Ham.

Sanchez hits back at critics

■ Chilean branded 'a mercenary' by some pundits for Old Trafford move
 ■ Deal finally closes, brings straight swap for Mkhitarjan with Gunners

Alexis Sanchez sealed his move from Arsenal to Manchester United and then hit back at former Gunners players who have criticised him.

One of the most high-profile swap deals ever was finally completed on Monday as Sanchez and Henrikh Mkhitarjan, both 29, traded places.

Upon becoming a member of Jose Mourinho's squad, Chilean forward Sanchez, who had been a target for United's rivals Manchester City both in the summer and earlier this window, said: "I am thrilled to be joining the biggest club in the world."

Last week ex-Arsenal defender Martin Keown had branded Sanchez "the biggest mercenary in football", while Keown's old team-mate Ian Wright claimed he had "clocked off" in December.

Though he did not directly reference anyone in particular, Sanchez took aim at his critics in part

of a farewell Instagram post that read: "There are people (former club players) who have spoken with no knowledge of what happens inside the club and cause damage."

"I must say I always gave 100%, until the last day, when I asked to the Mister (Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger) to be in the team, because I wanted to be a contribution."

Sanchez claimed he had spoken to another former Arsenal player Thierry Henry and remarked how his departure was similar to the one the Frenchman made when leaving for Barcelona in 2007.

"I remember today, a conversation I had with Henry, a historic Arsenal player, who changed club for the same reason and today is my turn," he added.

Premier League leaders Manchester City had tried to sign Sanchez in the summer and were expected to be the front runners to land him this month when it became apparent he

wanted to leave ahead of his Arsenal contract expiring in the summer.

However, Pep Guardiola's club were reluctant to pay both the £35m asking price and the wages Sanchez was requesting.

That allowed United to swoop and the fact they were able to offer Mkhitarjan in return meant the deal could be done as a straight swap.

"Since I was a young lad I've always said that my dream was to play for Manchester United, and I'm not just saying that because I'm here now and today it's come true," Sanchez told MUTV.

"I always said as a kid that I'd like to play for United and I once spoke to Sir Alex Ferguson about it. We chatted for around 20 minutes. And I told him that my dream was to come here to Manchester United."

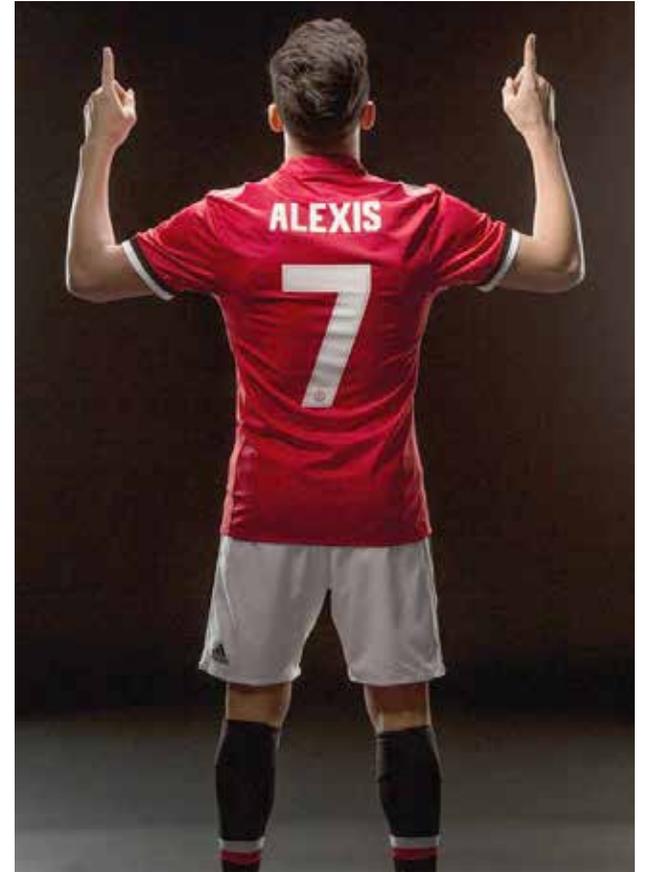
"It really is a massive club, very powerful, and so now when I got the opportunity to come here I looked at the badge

and my hairs just stood up on end because it's a powerful club and the biggest in England."

United's latest signing also revealed boss Mourinho had a big influence in him deciding he wanted a switch to Old Trafford.

"He indicated it is important for the club for me to be here," Sanchez added of Mourinho.

"Players sometimes need to feel important and loved by the club. That was one of the things that attracted me to come here, along with the manager, who is a person who won everything in Italy, the same as he did in Spain, and he's a manager who likes to win."

Blues land Roma pair

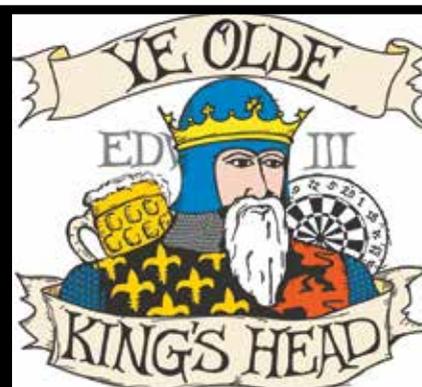
