IT'S BOOM TIME FOR BRITAIN!

■ UK enjoying higher wages, lower unemployment and cheapest-ever mortgages

BRITAIN is powering out of recession with employment soaring, wages rising and the cheapest ever home loans, new figures showed this week.

David Cameron and George Osborne hailed the data as proof that their plans are working.

The figures show that unemployment has fallen by 167,000 – the biggest reduction since 1997.

Average earnings are rising while inflation drops and Government borrowing is down by £2.1 billion.

The Bank of England, meanwhile, said it saw “no immediate need” to raise interest rates.

In the Commons, a delighted Prime Minister taunted Ed Miliband that Labour was miserable about the upturn and that most people were better off this year thanks to Coalition tax cuts boosting take-home pay.

The positive data came a day after the International Monetary Fund sharply raised its

growth forecasts for Britain in 2014 to 2.4 per cent, outpacing European rivals including Germany and France.

The Government hopes Office for National Statistics figures next week will confirm that the UK economy maintained its momentum throughout the final three months of 2013.

On Wednesday it announced that after a 167,000 fall in the three months to November, unemployment stands at a near five-year low of 2.32 million.

The number of people claiming Jobseeker’s Allowance in December fell for a 14th month in a row, by 24,000 to 1.25 million, also the lowest for nearly five years.

It took the proportion of working age people who

Scottish unemployment falls to five-year low

SCOTLAND'S economic recovery was this week bolstered by figures showing unemployment falling to its lowest level in almost five years.

The jobless total fell by 25,000 between September and November last year and now stands at 176,000.

The unemployment rate fell by 0.9 per cent over the quarter to 6.4 per cent - its lowest level since January - March 2009.

This is below the average of 7.1 per cent for the whole of the UK which also witnessed a fall of 167,000 in

unemployment over the same period.

It comes just days after figures showed the country's economy grew by 0.7 per cent in the third quarter of last year.

The number of Scots in work has also gone up by 10,000 and now stands at 2.55 million, the latest Office for National Statistics figures showed.

Over the past year, the number of employed women has risen by 62,000 - the largest annual increase on record.

The number of people claiming Job Seeker's Allowance (JSA), fell by

1,900 from November to 113,800 in December - down by 24,100 on December 2012.

Scottish Secretary Alistair Carmichael said the "figures reflect how well Scotland is doing as part of the UK".

He said: "It is extremely encouraging to see unemployment in Scotland at its lowest level in nearly five years and employment increasing by 90,000 over the past year.

"The number of people in work in Scotland is close to the record highs seen before the recession and there has been a big fall in the

number of people claiming Jobseeker's Allowance.

"Every new job created and every person getting back into work is to be welcomed."

Finance Secretary John Swinney said: "Today's labour market figures provide more positive news for the Scottish economy, with the number of people in employment in Scotland continuing to increase, following on from last week's strong GDP results.

"Scotland has a higher employment rate and lower unemployment rate than England, Wales

or Northern Ireland.

"Consistent increases in employment levels show that the policies of the Scottish government to create jobs and boost the economy are making progress."

He added: "With the limited powers over the

economy that we have at our disposal, Scotland's economic health is improving but without the full powers of independence we cannot secure the greater levels of growth and employment that we need."

are unemployed down to 7.1 per cent - just 0.1 above the level at which the Bank of England had said it would consider finally raising its historic low 0.5 per cent interest rate.

But there was reassurance in the minutes of the Bank rate-setting panel's January meeting, published this week.

They showed that with inflation falling back and the effects of the financial crisis still being felt it "saw no immediate need" to raise rates. And economist Howard Archer, of City forecasters IHS Global

Insight, said: "We believe the odds remain strongly in favour of interest rates staying at 0.50 per cent all through 2014.

"While rates will probably start rising in 2015, this may not happen until around the middle of the year."

According to a survey by loans company UKMortgages, rates being charged to homeowners have fallen by as much as 32 per cent in the last 12 months.

The reduction would knock £1,200 a year off the cost of servicing the average £150,000 loan.

The Conservatives are likely to claim vindication of their tough welfare curbs from the Bank

rate-setting meeting's minutes. These note, on falling unemployment, that "a tightening in the eligibility requirements for some state benefits might have led to an intensification of job search".

According to the ONS, the number of workers reached a record 30.15 million in the latest quarter, up a record 280,000, of which 220,000 were full-time.

David Tinsley, of the BNP Paribas bank, said the jobs figures were "staggeringly strong".

The Prime Minister tweeted: "More jobs means more security, peace of mind and opportunity for the British

people."

The ONS found that average weekly wages rose 0.9 per cent in the year to November, unchanged from the previous month. Inflation fell back in December to two per cent.

At Prime Minister's Questions, Mr Miliband claimed average wages had tumbled £1,600 a year since the 2010 election and more than half the 13 million people in poverty were in working households.

But Mr Cameron said wage growth was bound to be slow after the longest recession "in living memory".

He added: "Because you keep quoting the

figure without the tax cuts we have put in place, you are not recognising that this year people are better off because we have controlled spending and cut taxes.

"What you cannot face is the fact that the economy is improving."

There was further cheer when official figures showed Government borrowing last month at £12.1 billion was £2.1 billion down from the year before, thanks to record December revenues.

What Harry REALLY did at the South Pole....

- Prince 'drank champagne out of a prosthetic leg and told filthy jokes while others danced naked'
- Hollywood star Dominic West reveals what happened during the young royal's Walking With the Wounded adventure

Prince Harry told some 'eye-wateringly rude jokes' and drank champagne out of a prosthetic leg at the end of a marathon polar challenge, actor Dominic West has revealed.

The Wire actor, who was part of the Commonwealth team walking with Harry as part of the Walking With The Wounded trip, described him as a 'fantastically nice chap' and revealed a few of the prince's hidden talents - including building the team latrines.

The 29-year-old royal appeared at the 'welcome home' press conference in London this week minus the increasingly famous beard he grew during the charity trek.

At the event, West described the prince as 'a really cool guy, very much part of the team'.

'a great guy'

He said: 'He would often reach the meeting point before the rest of his men and would build these incredibly lavish, castellated latrines, with battlements and loo roll holders. It must have taken him 40 minutes at least to build, they were just fabulous. I would often sit on the latrine thinking "this is a royal flush in every way!"'

'Harry also massively helped me out when I was struggling with my skis at first. He was a great guy.'

West also lifted the lid on some of the group's celebrations on reaching the South Pole.

He said: 'Two of the Aussie guys stripped naked and ran round the pole but most of us, Harry included, just went on a two-day bender with the Icelandic truck drivers who had brought some lethal home brew with them. There was a lot of liquor drunk.'

'We all drank champagne out of Duncan's (Slater, a double amputee injured in Afghanistan in 2009, who was on the British team) favourite prosthetic legs.'

And Harry's greatest talent? 'Well he told some eye-wateringly rude jokes which for a non-soldier like me was pretty shocking!' West revealed.

The prince appeared at an official event for the first time since the challenge looking fresh-faced and clean-shaven.

Speaking at the press conference to mark the charity trek, the prince's

enthusiasm for the cause was clear.

He said: 'Inspiring others is one of the cornerstones of this charity. To demonstrate to those who have suffered lifechanging injuries that anything is still possible.'

'That this truly unbelievable achievement by everyone behind me... will remind everybody that they can

achieve anything they want to. Our wounded, injured and sick [servicemen] they simply want to be treated the same way as before they were injured. With respect.

'For some the journey may be more of a challenge and it is up to us to make it as easy for them as we can. We can do that with training, with employment, or even with adventure.'

'real team player'

The royal was full of praise for his teammates during the trip, all of whom have suffered terrible injuries fighting for their country, including one soldier who lost both his legs in Afghanistan.

'If anyone has the ability to give these guys and girls a stepping stone as regards employment, then please do. You won't regret it.'

His teammate Duncan Slater added: 'Harry was a real team player. There

was always something to instigating it. There were so many wind ups. He probably spread himself quite thin. He would spend time with each team every day. He was always making sure he mixed, bringing everyone to the fore. It was very nice as he was as tired as everybody else.'

Referring to the team's post trek champagne antics, he said: 'We decided to use my legs as a primitive ice bucket. I don't know why we did it, but we did!'

The fourth-in-line-to-the-throne started to grow his beard after being unable to shave during his three weeks on the ice but decided to keep it even when he returned to the UK just before Christmas.

On Christmas day his ginger whiskers were just as much of a draw at Sandringham as the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge and sparked an outbreak of 'pogonomania' (an obsession with seeing men with beards) on social media.

Millions are trapped in 'Benefits Street' ghettos, claims IDS

MILLIONS of benefit claimants have been trapped in a "twilight world" of addiction to state handouts by the failed welfare system, Tory Work and Pensions Secretary Iain Duncan Smith said on Thursday.

The former Tory leader used a keynote speech to sound the alarm about jobless "ghettos" around Britain like that depicted in the Channel 4 documentary series Benefits Street, which has sparked a national debate about government handouts.

Duncan Smith also

warned that in the worst cases, welfare dependency is breeding a new generation of criminals.

He told an audience in London: "Our welfare system has become distorted, no longer the safety net it was intended to be.

"Too often it is an entrapment - as it has been for a million people left on incapacity benefits for a decade or more, or the more than four million abandoned on out-of-work benefits even before the recession.

"At its very worst, the present system makes criminals out of those trapped in its clutches. Too many end up in the shadow economy or working cash in hand."

Mr Duncan Smith's speech is seen by many commentators as part of a new government offensive against the welfare system left by the last Labour government. The Conservatives are known to be concerned about the rise of the UK Independence Party and is desperate not to get outflanked on it's right

wing.

The speech marked the 10th anniversary of the Centre for Social Justice, the think-tank Duncan Smith founded to investigate the causes of poverty and worklessness in Britain.

He spoke of the shock that many people feel when "confronted with the reality" of benefit dependency.

"We would have wanted to reform the welfare state, even if we had no deficit. As Conservatives, we should hate the idea of people with unfulfilled

potential languishing on welfare." of allowing the level of "income equality" to become "the worst for a

He also accused the last Labour government generation."

Police called in after near-riot following half price sale at 99p store

Police were called to a discount store in Wales this week to calm angry shoppers chasing 50p bargains in a closing down sale.

The 99p Stores in Wrexham was temporarily closed after crowds of shoppers flocked to a half-price sale which was advertised until 28 January.

However, many became angry and refused to leave when staff put prices back up to the full 99p price.

The company

apologised for any misunderstanding over pricing and said the shop and 30 jobs were now safe.

Nathan Rowden, chief reporter for the Wrexham Leader, witnessed the incident on Monday and said the store was "chock-a-block" with people, some of whom had queued for two hours.

He said many reacted with "outrage" when they were told the goods had risen to full price.

He told BBC Radio

Wales: "I could see through the windows there were customers remonstrating with staff."

At one point he said about 50 people were outside the store trying to get in, but were prevented from entering.

He added: "They were letting people out but not in. People were coming out shouting, visibly very angry about it."

'Very crowded'

Mr Rowden said the company's chief operating officer had told

him the store was due to close on 28 January, so prices were reduced to clear stock.

However, a new lease was negotiated with the landlord on Monday

morning and the sale ended at midday. posters that advertised products at 50p".

The retailer has apologised for the "unfortunate" misunderstanding in relation to closure sale. The company confirmed the store had been scheduled to close before a new lease was agreed.

HIS GLITTERING career saw him hobnobbing with the rich and famous in some of the world's most glamorous cities.

But David Beckham this week returned to his less-than-posh roots, appearing as a guest in a special *Only Fools And Horses* sketch reuniting Del Boy and Rodney for the first time in a decade.

The show is famously set in the blighted London

borough of Peckham - just a few miles from where Goldenball himself grew up. And the photo above captures Becks in a Peckham greasy spoon alongside series stalwarts David Jason and Nicholas Lyndhurst.

The retired football star will appear in the film to be screened as part of BBC1's Sport Relief night in March.

The former Manchester United and England idol

has taken part in previous broadcasts for the charity night, including a 2012 spoof in which he and James Corden cuddled up in bed as best pals, as well as sharing a bath.

The *Only Fools* sketch sees David Jason and Nicholas Lyndhurst reviving their roles as the wheeler-dealer Trotter brothers for the first time since a Christmas special in 2003.

UKiP named UK's favorite party

IN A SHOCKING blow to the political establishment, the anti-European Union UK Independence Party (UKiP) were chosen as Britain's favourite political party in a poll on Sunday, dealing a setback to British Prime Minister David Cameron ahead of

elections to the European Parliament. The survey came days after another poll showed the Conservatives are set to finish behind UKiP in the May election, meaning they are on course to finish third in a nationwide vote for the first time.

The UKiP's ability to

outflank Cameron on the right has prompted Tory backbenchers to adopt a tougher anti-EU stance, something he has balked at, raising the possibility of a damaging internal rift of the kind that contributed to the downfall of the last two Conservative prime ministers.

New royal babe named on Twitter

THE LATEST ROYAL baby has been introduced to the world via social media, with Mike and Zara Tindall revealing the name of their new child on Twitter.

Mia Grace Tindall, who is 16th in line to the throne, was born at the Gloucestershire Royal Hospital last week weighing 7lbs 12oz (3.5kg).

Mr and Mrs Tindall were married at Canongate Kirk in Edinburgh in July 2011.

The baby girl follows Zara's brother Peter Phillips' two children and Prince George to become the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh's fourth great-grandchild.

Mrs Tindall, 32, does not hold a royal title and is not referred to as Her Royal Highness -Mia

will be known as Miss Tindall.

The new parents met during England's Rugby World Cup-winning campaign in Australia in 2003.

Mr Tindall, 34, a former England rugby star, is now a player-coach at Gloucester.

His wife has achieved sporting success in her own right - where she still competes under the name Zara Phillips - winning individual gold in three-day eventing at the World

Equestrian Games in Germany in 2006.

The title helped her become BBC Sports Personality of the Year later that year, following in the footsteps of her mother, Princess Anne, who won the award in 1971.

As a member of the Great Britain eventing team she won a silver medal at the London 2012 Olympics.

She is planning to take part in the next Olympic Games, which will be held in Rio in 2016.

999 caller reports 'crime' as United lose League cup semi-final

The drunken football fan called emergency services at 10.30pm Wednesday night just after Manchester United were knocked out of the League Cup at home 2-1 on penalties by Sunderland.

The supporter said he wanted to "report a crime" and that the Red Devils were "completely knackered" in their stunning loss at Old Trafford.

Audio of the conversation was released by Greater Manchester Police who dealt with the call.

In it the Manchester United fan is asked if he wants to report a crime and he responded: "The crime is that Manchester United, Manchester United were absolutely knackered."

The club currently lie seventh in the top tier of English football and also were knocked out of the FA Cup by Swansea in the Third Round.

During Sir Alex's 26 years at Manchester United the club won 38 trophies including 13 Premier League titles and two UEFA Champion League titles.

Greater Manchester Police (GMP) released a statement on their Facebook page which said saying the man called in a drunken state.

'Great Briton' Chris Chataway succumbs to cancer at 82

David Cameron has led tributes to record-breaking athlete and Tory former minister Sir Christopher Chataway, describing him as "one of a kind" and a "great Briton".

Sir Christopher, who acted as a pacemaker to help Sir Roger Bannister become the first man to break the four-minute mile barrier in 1954, died aged 82.

He passed away at around 7am on Sunday St John's Hospice in north west London having suffered from cancer for two and a half years, his son Mark Chataway said.

Mr Cameron said: "Chris was a rare

politician in that he enjoyed such extensive, wide-ranging and successful careers both before and after he served in Parliament."

Sir Christopher won the very first BBC Sports Personality of the Year in 1954 and later pursued a successful career in politics and business.

The Prime Minister said: "In politics, he held a number of influential positions and as the Government Minister responsible for introducing local commercial radio, left a lasting legacy millions continue to enjoy today.

"And after politics, Chris continued to hold senior positions with

organisations as diverse as BT Systems, Laker Airways, and Bletchley Park.

"Chris was one of a kind; throwing himself into every project and achieving so much in so many fields. We have lost a great Briton, a true Conservative and a man of many talents.

"My thoughts and prayers are with Chris's family."

Mr Chataway, 53,

described his father as a "very compassionate and wise man" who had the "ability to put other people's needs first".

"We were, especially in these last few years, struck by his amazing qualities of humility and strength," he said.

Mr Chataway said he and his siblings "grew up with him as a person, not as a runner", adding: "Of course we all thought it was remarkable. We all

saw the old footage, but I think as a child that's not what you focus on in a parent."

Sir Christopher kept his passion for running alive even when he was approaching 80 years of age.

"He kept running almost until the end of his life. He ran with a couple of my brothers in the Great North Run about three years ago now," Mr Chataway said.

William Roache trial: star 'shocked by rape arrest'

Coronation Street star William Roache told police he was "absolutely surprised" and "amazed" when he was first arrested, a jury has heard.

The actor appeared "visibly shocked and broke into a sweat" as he was detained on suspicion of rape, his trial heard.

During police interview, he said it was "against my nature, I'm a very peaceful person", Preston Crown Court was told.

Mr Roache, 81, from

Wilmslow, Cheshire, denies two rapes and five indecent assaults between 1965 and 1971.

The charges relate to five women who were aged 16 and under between those dates.

Mr Roache, who plays Ken Barlow in the ITV soap, was arrested and cautioned at his home on 1 May last year.

He was then taken in an unmarked vehicle to a police station where the circumstances of the allegations were outlined.

The actor told officers he would "never do anything like that" and when the rape allegation was put to him said: "I totally deny that."

The jury heard Mr Roache told police he did not remember the girl who had accused him of raping her.

The court heard he told them: "It didn't happen because I'd remember it if it had."

Mr Roache told police he had "no recollection" of inviting the girl to his then house in Haslingden, Lancashire.

'Flirty comment'

The jury was told Mr Roache also denied having "any kind" of relationships with any girls during that period.

When asked in the police interview whether he could remember whether any young girls would "come on to you", the actor said women would but young girls were just "excited children".

Mr Roache said there may have been a "flirty comment" in getting an autograph "but not in a sustained way", the court heard.

Police asked Mr Roache why the woman may have made the allegation.

The court heard he said: "A lot of people are coming out and accusing celebrities of these things for various

reasons."

He told police the woman may want a "moment of fame", adding there was "some hope of selling articles to the newspaper".

He also told police: "I was always polite and friendly with the viewers and people in the street. I have no idea why she would come up with this."

"I don't know what the motivation might be I'm absolutely horrified at the whole thing," Mr Roache said in the interview.

The jury previously heard one of the women alleged she

was sexually propositioned by former Coronation Street actor Neville Buswell, who played Ray Langton.

She claimed it happened when he and Mr Roache got her passes into Granada studios in Manchester.

Lancashire police had contacted Mr Buswell, who was now an American resident and lived in Las Vegas, about the claims, the court heard.

He declined an invitation to come to the UK to speak about the allegations, the jury was told.

The trial continues.

Dave Lee Travis trial: DJ 'touched reporter's breasts'

■ Travis assault 'caused years of hell'

■ DJ Travis 'groped woman at dance'

A woman has told a jury that former BBC DJ Dave Lee Travis groped her breasts when she went to his house to interview him for a national magazine.

He told her he was a photographer and suggested she pose in a bikini after she noticed a "provocative" photo of a pop star on his wall, the jury heard.

The woman told Southwark Crown Court she felt "embarrassed" and "taken aback" but did not say much.

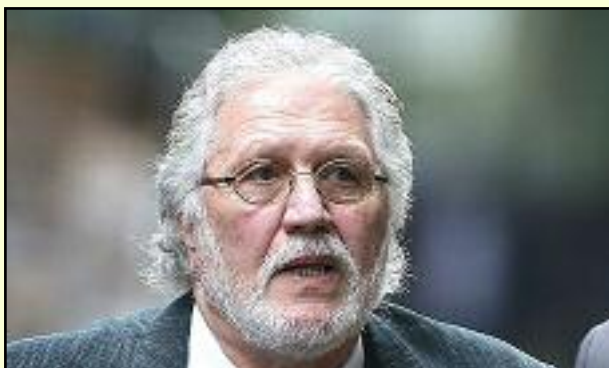
The 68-year-old denies sexual assault and 13 counts of indecent assault.

The woman said the incident took place when she went to Mr Travis's home to interview him about a photograph of him and Jimmy Savile alongside a number of other DJs.

'Arms out'

Mr Travis - who is being tried under his real name of David Griffin - told her he was a photographer as well as a DJ, and twice offered to take her picture, the court heard.

The woman, who cannot be identified for legal reasons, said she felt as though she was in an "enclosed space" as they spoke face to face in his kitchen.

"He raised his arms out because I thought that photography and said 'He didn't say anything, there was a split second where neither of us said anything and then suddenly he put his arms out and put his hands on my breasts and then quizzically put his head to the side as if he was judging himself - whether they were big aren't big enough' because I thought that would put him off."

"The fact that he raised it again, I almost felt like I had to justify myself. I burst out 'No - and anyway, my boobs aren't big enough'

The woman said she thought Mr Travis left his hands there for a "couple of seconds".

She went on: "It felt to me like he knew that this was an opportunity. In hindsight I see that he was looking for an opportunity and he took it. I did not invite him to touch me."

"The picture was very obviously about a young girl in a bikini showing her cleavage. I knew what he meant when he said I had a good figure. He wanted me to strip down."

'Big fuss'

When she told her mother what had happened, they agreed he was a "pervy old man" and that they would not let the incident get in the way of her career, she added.

She told jurors she did not go to the police or tell her bosses at the time because she did not want to jeopardise

her fledgling career by making a "big fuss".

It was after allegations against Mr Travis surfaced in the press that she decided to go to the police, the court heard.

Two friends, with whom the woman shared a house, gave evidence at the trial.

One told the jury her friend appeared "stressed" and "upset" when she came home on the evening of the interview, and had said Mr Travis put "both his hands on her breasts".

Mr Travis, of Buckinghamshire, denies sexually assaulting the female reporter in 2008.

He further denies 13 counts of indecent assault between 1976 and 2003 - involving 11 women, one of whom was 15 at the time of the alleged offence.

The trial was adjourned until Thursday.

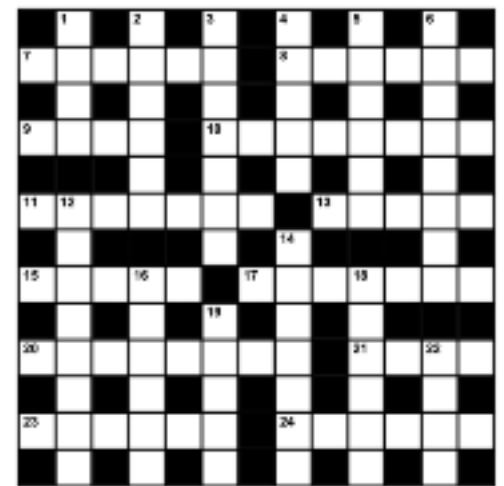

Jane Austen and the Arts: a must read for JA fans...

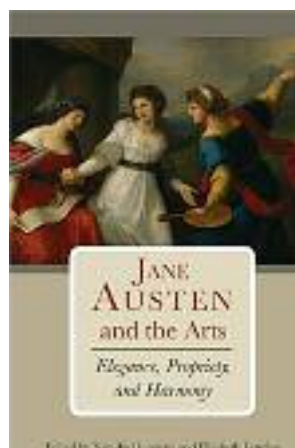

"I met a man named
Vivasvan Soni while
attending a Romanticism
conference in Neuchatel
Switzerland, where I
chaired a panel on *Jane
Austen's Prospects*," says
Jane Austen and the Arts
editor Natasha Duquette.

"After a hike in the
Alps, Viv and I discussed
Jane Austen and
philosophy over a fondue
dinner in a tent." It must
have been an engaging
dinner, because Soni later
wrote the preface to *Jane
Austen and the Arts*.

The book is a collection
of essays examining
Austen's role as artist and
her works as art, her



aesthetic philosophy. This
collection of essays began
as a panel on *Jane Austen
and the Sublime* as
envisioned by Gillian
Dow.

How much did Jane
Austen affect drama, art,
architecture, drama,
dancing, poetry, and
music of her time? Did
she plan on changing her
world? Or, was she just
writing her observations?
The writers explore the
social, moral, psychological,
and theological functions of
art in Austen's writing.
Austen, who at first wrote

anonymously, was
revered even before her
public knew she was the
author.

The essays make
connections between the
aesthetics of Austen's
writing, both fiction and
her letters, using
Romanticism, Gothicism,
music, dance art, and
politics. Connections are
drawn between Edmund
Burke, Adam Smith,
Johann Wolfgang von
Goethe, Madame de Staël,
Joanna Baillie and Jean
Jacques Rousseau. What
emerges is a woman who
knew exactly what she
was doing. The essays are
easy to read if you're
familiar with Austen's
work, and this collection is
a treat for Austen fans.

Duquette started doing
research at the Chawton
House Library in 2008.
"The writer on whom that
research is mostly focused
is a contemporary of
Austen's named Mary
Anne Schimmelpenninck," says Duquette.

In 1815, Schimmelpenninck wrote a treatise
titled *A Theory on the
Classification of Beauty and
Deformity*. That book
features prominently in
the introduction to *Jane
Austen and the Arts* and in
the chapter titled *Delicacy
of Taste Redeemed: The
Aesthetic Judgment and
Spiritual Formation of Jane
Austen's Clergymen Heroes*.

"As well as working at
the Chawton House
Library, I also worked at
the British Library in
London, the Bibliotheque
Nationale de France in
Paris, and the Huntington
Library in San Marino
California," says
Duquette. "I discovered
the documents by reading
21st century scholarship
on Austen in particular,
and on Romantic-era
women writers in general.
Two books that have been
very helpful in leading me
towards interesting
historical sources are: *Jane
Austen's Anglicanism and
Romantic Visualities:*

*Landscape, Gender, and
Romanticism.*"

Duquette chaired the
2009 Chawton House
Library conference *New
Directions in Austen
Studies*. She edited a
collection of essays titled
*Sublimar Aspects: Interfaces
between Literature,
Aesthetics, and Theology*
(Cambridge Scholars,
2007) and created a
modern, annotated
edition of Helen Maria
Williams's 18th century
novel *Julia* (Pickering &
Chatto, 2009). "Jane
Austen knew of and read
Helen Maria Williams's
writing," says Duquette.
"Her hero Henry Tilney
refers to *Julia* in *Northanger
Abbey*."

Duquette will be
presenting a paper titled
*Fanny Price amidst the
Philosophers* at the 2014
Annual General Meeting
of the Jane Austen Society
of North America. The
JASNA conference is
October 10th through 12th
in Montréal, Quebec,

"I was a brush-your-teeth-and-have-a-shower kind of guy.

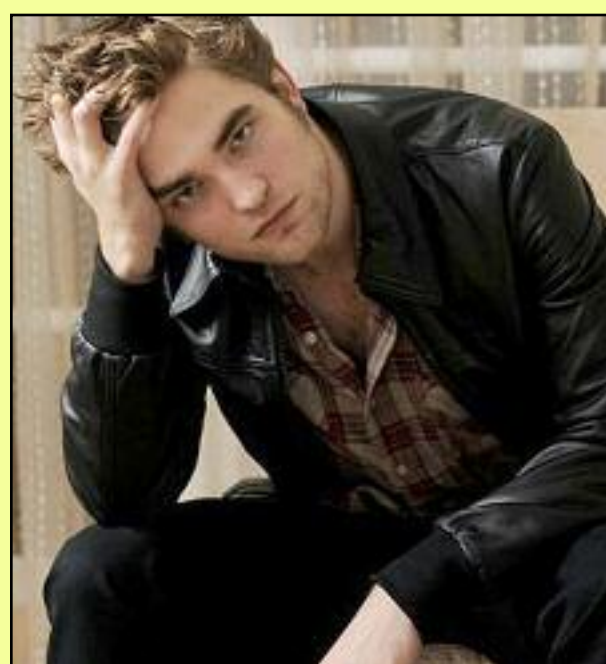

Cook considers jumping ship as one-day captain

Alastair Cook ponders future as England one-day captain. Alastair Cook says he could resign as England one-day captain after Australia won the limited-overs series.



ALASTAIR COOK: nine successive losses to Australia

Having lost all five Ashes Tests, England slid to their third successive one-day defeat on the tour as Australia took an unassailable 3-0 lead.

"I think English cricket needs a little bit of a change," said Cook, who became one-day captain in May 2011.

"I think there will be some changes. We have

kept losing games of cricket and I haven't been able to turn it around."

Cook replaced Andrew Strauss as skipper, leading England to the final of last year's Champions Trophy where they were beaten by India in a match

reduced to 20 overs per side at Edgbaston.

He has won 29 of his 52 international games in charge, but asked whether he wanted to continue as one-day skipper.

Cook said he could not make a decision on his

future "in the middle of the series", adding he did not know how he would feel back in England.

With two one-day matches left, he added: "I've got a job to try and turn this around, try and win one of these games. That's the task at hand.

"I'm competitive. I want to leave everything out on the pitch. We'll deserve the stick we get because we haven't won games of cricket. Simple deal."

The left-handed opening batsman, who made his ODI debut in 2006, has scored 2,742

ODI runs in his 75 matches at an average of 38.08.

"I want to be part of a successful one-day team," he added. "I feel that I'm a good enough player to do that and my record suggests that I can do that."

England lost the final one-day international at home last summer to concede the series 2-1 and have now lost nine successive matches in various formats against the Australians.

On a dismal tour that has seen Jonathan Trott, Graeme Swann and Steven Finn leave early because of a combination of illness, lack of desire and poor form, Cook's team have won only two matches against modest representative opposition.

Only Eoin Morgan passed fifty in the latest defeat at the Sydney Cricket Ground.

"We were at least 30 or 40 runs short," said Cook. "Everyone got 20 or 30-odd and we didn't convert to big scores and a hundred as we did the other day in Brisbane.

"They've won a lot of cricket against us over the past two months and

it's difficult to stop that."

Meanwhile, Australia counterpart Michael Clarke confirmed he would be rested for the next match in Perth on Friday, before returning for the finale in Adelaide on Australia Day, 26 January.

City stroll into final past hapless Hammers

Manchester City cantered into their first League Cup final in 38 years with a record 9-0 aggregate victory against semi-final opponents West Ham Tuesday night.

Holding a seemingly impregnable 6-0 first-leg lead, City strikers Alvaro Negredo and Sergio Aguero combined to complete the formalities at Upton Park.

An unmarked Negredo nodded in, Aguero clipped past Jussi Jaaskelainen and the Spaniard barged through to net.

City will face Sunderland at Wembley on 2 March.

Blues boss Manuel Pellegrini has targeted the unprecedented 'quadruple' of winning the Premier League, FA Cup, League Cup and Champions League in his first season at the Etihad.

Pellegrini made sweeping changes to the side which smashed through the 100-goal barrier in only their 34th match of the season on Saturday.

But, to the chagrin of West Ham, the Chilean reunited Negredo and Aguero in a fearsome-looking attack, while injury-hit £22m summer signing Stevan Jovetic made his first

substitute appearance since October.

Going into the game, the pair had scored 21 goals apiece - with the whole West Ham team netting only 31 - but had not started together since Argentina striker Aguero injured his calf against Arsenal on 14 December.

Negredo needed just 154 seconds to open the scoring when he planted in Portuguese teenager Marcos Lopez's pinpoint cross with the freedom of the Hammers penalty area.

Then, Aguero kept pace with his strike partner by pouncing on more calamitous Hammers

defending to clip beyond goalkeeper Jussi Jaaskelainen.

And, after collecting a neat one-two from Aguero, Negredo surged through a pair of flimsy Hammers challenges to tuck past Jaaskelainen.

With West Ham needing almost a miracle to reach Wembley, Allardyce urged his players to restore pride in front of a sparse 14,390 crowd in east London.

But the home fans had little to cheer with City keeper Costel Pantilimon only stretched on a handful of occasions.

Mohamed Diame, who was later carried off on a

stretcher with a knee injury, slashed an angled shot wide and substitute Carlton Cole was denied by the feet of the giant Romanian.

However, the hosts were boosted by an encouraging 45-minute display from Andy Carroll, who was making his first Hammers start since the final game of last season after a foot injury.

The England striker was the Hammers' most potent attacking threat before being replaced by Cole at the break, although showed his rustiness by heading over the City crossbar when well-placed.

Chelsea boss Mourinho, 50, said last week that while he understood it was "hard" for Mata to sit on the bench, the Spaniard still had a "big role" to play at the club.

The Portuguese has trusted Eden Hazard, Oscar and summer signing Willian in attacking roles this season and while his relationship with Mata is healthy, he has conceded Chelsea's system does not suit the player.

"There are fantastic players, but sometimes the fantastic players are more fantastic to a certain system and less fantastic in a certain model of play," Mourinho recently said in an interview with the BBC. "He is an unbelievable player and a fantastic boy who is trying his best to adapt."

Chelsea paid £23.5m to sign Mata from Valencia in 2011. The former Real Madrid youth player began life in England by scoring 13 goals in his first at Stamford Bridge won the FA Cup and Champions League.

He followed it up with 20 goals in the 2012-13 season as Chelsea lifted the Europa League under Rafael Benitez but, since Mourinho returned for his second spell at the club, Mata has seen his playing time limited.

He was substituted 53 minutes into the Blues' 3-0 win at Southampton on New Year's Day, his last appearance, and was visibly frustrated when taking his place on the bench.

Paul Ince says he is "deeply disappointed" to have been told about his sacking as Blackpool boss in a text message from the Championship club.

The ex-England star left the Tangerines on Tuesday after less than a year.

Ince, who said his exit came without warning, expressed "sadness" at the decision and the manner in which he was told of his sacking.

Blackpool chairman Karl Oyston said the 46-year-old was informed about his exit by "letter and text message".

The Blues agreed to sell Juan Mata to Manchester United on Wednesday.

United's club-record £37m move for Mata appears to have encouraged Chelsea to move swiftly for Salah, who would become their third signing of the January transfer window after the arrivals of Nemanja Matic and Bertrand Traore.

His potential capture will also offer Chelsea manager Jose Mourinho a further attacking option, following Kevin De Bruyne's loan move to Wolfsburg.

"Chelsea Football Club can confirm an agreement has been reached with FC Basel for the transfer of their 21-year-old attacking midfielder Mohamed Salah," read a statement on the club's website.

Salah, who can operate in a variety of attacking roles, has been tracked by a number of clubs after impressive displays in the Europa League last season and this year's Champions League.

The Egypt international scored against Chelsea in the semi-finals of the Europa League in 2013, before getting goals in both Champions League matches against Jose Mourinho's side this season.

After starting his career at Egyptian side El Mokawloon, Salah moved to Basel in 2012 and scored five league

goals in 29 appearances as they secured a fourth league title in as many seasons.

His form this season has helped Basel to top spot in their domestic league ahead of its resumption after a winter-break.

Mata in £37m United move

■ Moyes smashes transfer record after shambolic cup exit

Spain midfielder Juan Mata was expected to arrive at Manchester United on Friday for a medical ahead of his proposed move from Chelsea.

United have had a bid, believed to be in the region of £37m, accepted for Mata, who is set to sign a four-and-a-half year deal at Old Trafford.

The 25-year-old was due to fly to Manchester by helicopter before sealing a move to the Premier League champions.

He has struggled for a regular Chelsea starting place under Jose Mourinho.

Mata, who has won 32 caps, said goodbye to team-mates and staff at Chelsea's Cobham training ground on Wednesday.

Manager David Moyes declined to answer questions on Mata after his side's League Cup semi-final defeat by Sunderland.

Members of the media were informed before the post-match news

conference that Moyes would be answering questions on the game only and when asked afterwards about Mata, the Scot said: "We are not saying anything."

Should the deal go through it would break United's previous transfer record - the £30.75m they paid Spurs for Dimitar Berbatov in September 2008.

On Tuesday, Chelsea insisted that Mata, who had been voted the club's player of the year two seasons in a row, was not for sale.

But the player, who was part of the Spain squad which won the World Cup in 2010 and European Championship in 2012, has been substituted in nine of his 13 Premier League appearances for the Blues this season, prompting speculation other clubs could bid for him in the January transfer window.

United have made no secret of their plans to rebuild their team under Moyes and are prepared to pay a premium for top

players if it means securing them now rather than waiting until the summer.

"A lot of the work we are doing now is in preparation for the summer," Moyes told United's matchday programme ahead of the Sunderland game.

"If we can do any business now then we will certainly try to do it, but I will not compromise the standards required for a player that can come into this club and help improve it."
