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# Life terms for Rigby killers

**RELATIVES of murdered soldier Lee Rigby said 'justice has been done' after the men responsible for his death were given lengthy jail sentences on Thursday.**

Michael Adebolajo has been sentenced to a "life means life" prison term for the killing of Army drummer while Michael Adebowale was sentenced to life with a minimum of 45 years.

The defendants greeted the sentences with fury at the Old Bailey this week, and both Adebolajo, 29, and Adebowale, 22, had to be manhandled out of court by security guards after being told by Mr Justice Sweeney that their crime was a "betrayal of Islam".

Adebolajo screamed at the judge as he was manhandled down the dock stairs in the historic Court No 2 but, in scenes lasting several minutes, his co-defendant was held to the floor and cuffed before being carried downstairs head first.

Relatives of Drummer Rigby, who were sitting just three feet away from

the dock, stood up and cowered away from the violence.

Eight dock officers wrestled with the killers, who hacked the 25-year-old soldier to death in May last year after running him over near his barracks in Woolwich, south-east London.

## **minimum term**

Angered by the judges' comments about Islam, Adebowale stood up and shouted: "That's a lie. It's not a betrayal of Islam. You don't know what Islam is."

The struggle erupted as the murderer yelled: "I swear by Allah that America and Britain will never have any safety. Allahu Akbar [God is Great]."

After the defendants had been removed Mr Justice Sweeney resumed his sentencing to give

Adebolajo a "whole-life" tariff, meaning he will spend the rest of his life in jail.

Adebowale was given life with a minimum term of 45 years.

The judge said the pair both became extremists and decided to "murder a soldier in public daylight" to advance their extremist cause.

He described the scene of the murder as a "bloodbath" and said they "butchered" Drummer Rigby.

Mr Justice Sweeney said the pair had not shown any regret for the killing, adding: "I'm sure this was a murder done for the purpose of advancing a political, religious or racial cause.

"Your sickening and pitiless conduct was in stark contrast to the compassion and bravery shown by the various women at the scene who

tended to Lee Rigby's body and challenged what you had done and said."

Adebolajo, who wanted to be called by the name Mujaahid Abu Hamza, was dressed in a black Islamic robe and had refused to stand up in court.

## Another week, another rainfall record....

WITH THE passing of another week in the great miserable British winter another record has fallen, as the Met Office announced this winter has been the wettest for almost 250 years in England and Wales.

Around 17 inches of rain was recorded up to February 24 in England and Wales, making it their wettest winter since 1766.

"New records have been set for many parts of the UK, with southeast and central southern England having seen well over double the rainfall expected in a normal winter," the Met Office said in a statement.

Provisional rainfall figures from December 1, 2013 to February 25, 2014 also show that Britain as a whole experienced its wettest winter since records began in 1910.

Over the past few months, heavy rainfall and storms in Britain, particularly in England and Wales, have resulted in the worst floods for the country in 50 years.

Floods have devastated homes and businesses, disrupted transport and ruined crops. Analysts estimate that the bill for repairs may end up reaching £1 billion.

# Big increase in net migration to UK

## ■ Latest figures likely to heap further pressure on Cameron

THE NUMBER of migrants coming to the UK in the year to September 2013 has reached 212,000 – almost double the Conservatives' target of below 100,000, according to official estimates.

The Office for National Statistics said the net flow – the numbers moving to the UK minus the numbers leaving it – rose from 154,000 in the previous year.

The increase has been driven by a big growth in the number of European Union citizens coming to Britain.

But No 10 said its aim had not changed.

Asked if David Cameron stood by his pledge to reduce net migration to under 100,000 by 2015, the PM's official spokesman said: "That is absolutely the objective and we are going to very much keep working towards that."

"We are putting in place what we believe are the right measures that go towards meeting that objective."

There was a rise in new arrivals from Poland, Spain, Italy and Portugal.

Some 24,000 citizens of Romania and Bulgaria also arrived in the year to September 2013, nearly

three times the 9,000 who arrived in the previous year, the Office for National Statistics said in a report. About 70% came to work, while 30% came to study.

Official figures for how many Romanians and Bulgarians have arrived since working restrictions were lifted on 1 January have yet to be released.

### 'Pull factor'

Some 532,000 people migrated to the UK in the year ending September, up from the 497,000 people who arrived during the previous year, while 320,000 left the country, down from the 343,000 the previous year.

The number of EU citizens arriving in the UK rose to 209,000 from 149,000 the previous year, the ONS said.

But immigration of non-EU citizens saw a statistically significant decrease, to 244,000 from 269,000 the previous year.

The overall increase of 58,000 in the net migration figure will come as a blow to Prime Minister David Cameron and Home Secretary Theresa May's aim of cutting it to the "tens of thousands" by the time of the next election in May 2015.

But the figures are still

down on the levels of net migration reached in the early days of the coalition-revised ONS figures suggest it reached 263,000 in the year to September 2011.

### unintended consequence

Immigration minister James Brokenshire insisted the government had not abandoned its target and its focus "absolutely remains on bringing net migration down to those sustainable levels".

He said the immigration flows that the government had some control over, from outside the EU, were

continuing to come down.

He told the BBC: "It is down to levels we have not seen, in terms of net migration from outside the EU, since 1998."

The latest figures show that however successful ministers have been in curbing non-EU immigration, they haven't been able to prevent Poles, Spaniards, Italians and Portuguese coming to the UK – principally to work.

It would appear to be the unintended consequence of Britain's economic recovery.

When statistics are published later this year,

on the number of Romanians and Bulgarians who entered the UK after work restrictions were lifted, the net migration target is likely to be even further away.

For Labour, shadow home secretary Yvette Cooper said the government's targets were "in tatters" and its policy was "a mess".

She added: "David Cameron promised, 'No ifs, no buts,' to cut net migration to the tens of thousands, yet these figures show net migration has gone up and is now more than twice that figure."



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## Former Sun editor tells of sanctioning payments to government officials

Rebekah Brooks, Rupert Murdoch's former British newspaper boss, told a London court on Thursday she had sanctioned payments to public officials "half a dozen times" but denied approving the illegal sums for which she is on trial.

Brooks is accused of authorizing almost £40,000 in illegal payments from a reporter on Murdoch's Sun tabloid to a Ministry of Defence (MoD) official while she was editor of the paper.

She denies a charge of conspiracy to commit misconduct in a public office, and other offences of conspiracy to hack phones and perverting the course of justice.

A national furore over phone-hacking by journalists at the News of the World tabloid, which she also edited, led to the closure of the paper in 2011, rocked Murdoch's media empire and had repercussions across the British political establishment.

However, the offence relating to authorizing illegal payments carries a potentially much lengthier jail sentence.

Giving evidence for a fifth day at London's Old Bailey court, Brooks said "there had to be an overwhelming public interest" to justify payments to officials and only in "very narrow circumstances".

Asked by her defence lawyer if she had ever sanctioned such payments, which is illegal, Brooks replied: "Yes, probably since I was deputy editor of the Sun, 1998 to 2009, a handful of occasions, half a dozen."

Brooks was asked about a series of stories she approved that the

prosecution says relate to illegal payments by a Sun journalist, who cannot be named for legal reasons, to an MoD official.

Brooks said she had not known who the reporter's source was, nor that she was a public official. "He probably should have brought it to my attention, absolutely," she said.

### "Cheap at the price"

The jury were also shown emails from the reporter asking Brooks to authorise payments to his "number one military contact", to which she replied: "Of course".

"Nothing would have flagged up to me that there was an issue with it," she told the court, adding she would not have been "policing" the reporter for any wrongdoing.

In one email, the reporter described a £4,500 payment for three of his stories as being "cheap at the price".

"I probably thought, yeah that's quite cheap at the price," she said.

Brooks said there was legitimate public interest in many of the stories and, although she had been unaware who the source was at the time, she hypothetically would have sanctioned payments for a few of them.

These related to reports of bullying of army recruits and a "war hero" quitting over the treatment of his troops.

"This was exactly the kind of campaign we were doing," she said. She told the jury there had been no reaction or complaint from the MoD about the stories or their origin, although the paper's campaigns had caused some political disquiet.

Adebowale, who was dressed in a black skull cap and black hooded top, referred to him by the name Ishmael Abdullah.

Richard Whittam QC, prosecuting, said they should both receive whole life terms because of the severity of their crime and its political motivation. David Gottlieb QC, for Adebolajo, had argued that a whole life tariff would not be appropriate for his client.

### 'sincere but misguided'

"The first defendant (Adebolajo) is not so depraved and wicked that he is incapable of redemption in the future," he told the court, adding that Adebolajo was a "sincere but misguided person who has committed a wicked act".

Abbas Lakha QC, for Adebowale, argued that a whole life tariff would be "inhuman" because it would "extinguish all hope of release".

The pair were convicted of murder last December but their sentencing was put on hold while the Court of Appeal decided whether judges were free to impose whole life tariffs following a controversial ruling by European judges.

Last week appeal judges backed existing British laws which say that in "exceptional" cases the most heinous criminals can be sent to jail for the rest of their lives.

Both killers were born into Christian families and converted to Islam.

Adebolajo became interested in the religion in his teens and eventually became involved in Islamist extremism.

His activities escalated in 2010 when he was detained in Kenya attempting to cross the border into Somalia. It is believed he intended to

join al-Shabaab, the Somali terrorist group. Adebowale and Adebolajo, who both grew up in east London, claimed they were "soldiers of Allah" and that the killing was a legitimate act because Britain was at war with Muslim people. During their trial at the Old Bailey, Adebowale, from Greenwich, south-east London, offered no evidence in his defence, but Adebolajo, from Romford, Essex, gave a rambling testimony during which he told the jury he loved al-Qaeda.

# 'Monumental blunder' cheats IRA bomb victims out of justice

Four soldiers murdered in one of Britain's most notorious IRA bombings have been denied justice after a key suspect walked free from court because of a "monumental" police blunder that has granted him effective immunity.

John Downey, 62, had been wanted for more than 30 years for his alleged role in the 1982 Hyde Park bombings, which saw a nail bomb tear through the ranks of

the Household Cavalry on a Changing of the Guard procession.

He was finally caught last year but this week learnt he will never be prosecuted after it emerged he was wrongly given a "get out of jail free" card in a deal brokered as part of the Northern Ireland peace settlement.

The collapse of the case

— and the passing of more than three decades — means it is unlikely that anyone will ever be prosecuted over the atrocity.

Mr Downey was one of almost 200 "on the run" IRA suspects who were sent a so-called "letter of assurance" that effectively protected them from prosecution.

He should not have

been sent the "comfort letter" because a warrant for his arrest was still in force by the Metropolitan Police.

But a senior judge threw out the prosecution after ruling the assurances in the letter had to stand, even if they were sent in error. Mr Downey has spent one year in Britain while on bail and could now sue the UK authorities.

The families of the victims said they had been "devastatingly let down" by the "monumental blunder" and demanded a full review. The mistake was

made by officers with the Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI), who knew Mr Downey was wanted over the Hyde Park bomb but failed to notify authorities. Sir Hugh Orde, who was PSNI chief constable at the time of the error, apologised unreservedly for the blunder while his successor pledged an investigation.

### extradition bid

Four members of the Royal Household Cavalry, Blues and Royals, and seven horses were killed in the 1982

atrocities when a massive car bomb was detonated as they passed by.

Lieutenant Anthony Daly, 23, Trooper Simon Tipper, 19, and Lance Corporal Jeffrey Young, 19, were killed outright and Squadron Quartermaster Corporal Roy Bright, 36, the standard bearer, died from his injuries four days later.

Mr Downey was identified as a suspect soon afterwards when his fingerprints were found on a parking ticket for the car prior to it being moved to Hyde Park. However, the Attorney

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## Minister threatens to quit

Northern Ireland's First Minister has threatened to quit unless there is a judicial inquiry into secret letters given to more than 180 Irish republican paramilitary suspects promising no criminal proceedings would be launched against them.

Peter Robinson made his announcement after a judge threw out the case against John Downey, the man charged with the 1982 Hyde Park bombing.

Mr Robinson told UTV News: "I will not lead an administration where the rule of law does not prevail."

He claimed he was not prepared to remain first minister in a power-sharing administration that was not kept properly informed on

such an important matter.

The Democratic Unionist Party leader said he would discuss his stance with the Northern Ireland secretary Theresa Villiers at a meeting later.

Mr Robinson called for all the letters, sent out as part of the Good Friday Agreement peace process, to be declared void.

He said: "I am not prepared to be kept in the dark by Her Majesty's government about matters relevant to Northern Ireland."

"I want a full judicial inquiry to find out who knew, when they knew and what they knew. I want to know who they are and what crimes they are believed to have committed."

General later ruled that any extradition bid was unlikely to succeed. He was eventually arrested at Gatwick airport last May while on his way to Greece and charged with the murders. He had believed he was free to enter the UK because he had been sent a letter of assurance in July 2007.

The assurances, agreed between Sinn Fein and the UK government, were sent in the years after the 1998 Good Friday Agreement, as part of the peace process, to suspects who had never been caught for their alleged activities.

Lawyers for Mr Downey argued in a two-week abuse of process hearing at the Old Bailey that prosecution would be unfair and would threaten the peace settlement. Mr Justice Sweeney, who has prosecuted several IRA cases during his career, agreed and threw out the prosecution, allowing the details of the case to be made public for the first time.

He said there had been a "catastrophic failure" in the case and it offended the "court's sense of justice and propriety" to now try the defendant.

**Sir Tom Finney was honoured by the great and the good of British football at his funeral on Thursday.**

Thousands of people lined the streets of Preston to see the funeral cortege as it travelled from Deepdale stadium to Preston Minster.

The minster itself was packed with many figures from football and the city to pay tribute to the former England winger, who died aged 91 two weeks ago.

Finney won 76 caps and scored 30 international goals, and played for Preston all his career, making 569 first-class appearances.

## 'admired and respected'

Sir Trevor Brooking, the former England international who represented the Football Association at the funeral service, told Press Association Sport: "He was one of the most genuine individuals you would ever be likely to meet. Everyone admired and respected him."

"To come to this event today, over 50 years since he played, and see all these people both here in the minster and on the streets, I can't think of many who would get the same reaction."

"As a player, he was

the match-winner, the crowd-pleaser, the one who could make the difference - I was a youngster in primary school when he was playing, I would watch him on a black and white telly and then go out into the garden with my brother to try to emulate him."

Football League chief executive Shaun Harvey was also among those at the service, and he said: "The great and the good of football have come out to say farewell to Sir Tom Finney - a man who was a genuine legend of our game."

"You only have to mention Preston and Preston North End... the conversation soon turns to Tom Finney and that sums up everything the man did for the club, the city and the game of football."

David Moyes, the Manchester United boss who started his coaching career at Preston, attended the service, as did England's record goalscorer Sir Bobby Charlton.

## 'Preston Plumber'

The funeral cortege travelled from Preston's Deepdale home - Finney was born on a street next to the stadium in 1922 - with a mounted police

escort from the Lancashire Constabulary to the minster.

The Preston and District Veterans' Association also joined the cortege to mark his service as a tank driver in the Royal Armoured Corps during the Second World War.

The funeral service was shown live on a big screen inside Preston's ground to a crowd of several thousand people.

Preston City Council had planned for tens of thousands to line the streets, with a number of schools giving children time off to attend the event.

Finney was nicknamed the 'Preston Plumber' - his father insisted he train as plumber and he

continued working in the family business throughout his career: useful extra income in the days of the maximum wage for players.

He was regarded as one of the true greats of English football - and his record of caps and goals came despite having lost six years to the war.

Fifa's British vice-president Jim Boyce represented the world governing body at the funeral.

He said: "Tom Finney was one of my boyhood heroes, and played in a day where footballers were earning a fraction of the money they earn today, and became a fantastic ambassador for Preston - the city and the club."

"It has been fantastic to see so many people turn out to show their affection to one of the game's true greats."

Preston chairman Peter Ridsdale said Finney had "touched the hearts" of the community.

He said: "What I think is wonderful is that so many people - not only from the game but also from the city - have turned out to say farewell."

"This is a player that truly touched the hearts not just of football, but the whole community."

"The whole of Preston has almost come to a standstill in the two weeks since his death, and that is testament to what a great man he was."

## Royal couple seek full time nanny....

**THEY vowed to go it alone, but rumour has it that Prince William and Kate Middleton are on the lookout for a nanny to help out with looking after Prince George.**

The duke and duchess (pictured, right) revealed that they were planning on bringing up their first child completely by themselves, but it seems as though their royal appointments are taking their toll and the pair are currently seeking part-time help.

The new parents are being assisted on a temporary basis by 71-year-old Jessie Webb, who looked after William during his childhood, but

according to sources word has gone out to a number of London agencies.

William and Kate appointed Jessie shortly after moving into Kensington Palace, but it has been reported that she recently handed in her notice.

They were also helped by Kate's mother Carole after George's arrival last July, when the couple stayed with the Middletons in Berkshire.

However, the pair are believed to be on the lookout for a full-time nanny in a bid to make royal appointments and holidays easier.

One company said to be on the shortlist is Nannies of St James, who

specialise in finding the best childcare for wealthy clients, including Middle Eastern royal families.

Kensington Palace refused to confirm the parents' plans, revealing that they "do not discuss personal arrangements."

Meanwhile, Kate and Will are said to be taking little George down under as they head on a historic tour of New Zealand and Australia.

Following a break on the Caribbean island of Mustique with the Middletons, he will accompany the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge on their three-week visit in April.



# It's the end of the Piers show...

Though I think he'll find a new home rather quickly, Piers Morgan's prime time talk show has been axed by broadcaster CNN.

The outspoken British journalist succeeded legendary anchor Larry King three years ago however his show, Piers Morgan Live, has had consistently poor ratings.

A CNN spokesperson told Sky News: "CNN confirms that Piers Morgan Live is ending. The date of the final program is still to be determined."

It was recently revealed that Morgan was interviewed by

police over p h o n e - h a c k i n g allegations although CNN have insisted the news was not a factor in Morgan's dismissal.

### 'taken a bath'

Morgan is a former U.K. tabloid editor who reinvented himself as a TV personality with stints as a judge on "Britain's Got Talent" and its U.S. spinoff, NBC's "America's Got Talent,"

and as a contestant on "Celebrity Apprentice."

He recently stated: "I think I can credibly do news and the ratings reflect that, but it is not really the show that I set out to do." He also admitted his show had "taken a bath in the ratings" and that it had been a "painful period".

"Look, I am a British guy debating American cultural issues, including guns, which has been very polarising, and there

is no doubt that there are many in the audience who are tired of me banging on about it," he told *The New York Times*.

"There are all kinds of people who can do news here. I'd like to do work – interviews with big celebrities and powerful people – that is better suited to what I do well."

Earlier this month, Morgan confirmed that

he was interviewed in December by British police investigating the illegal interception of telephone voicemails. Morgan, who said he had given a previous witness

statement, has consistently denied wrongdoing. CNN did not comment on Morgan's future with the channel.

## Right-wing delights in skewering Morgan's 'obviously repugnant personality'

PIERS Morgan's staunchly pro-gun control views have made him something of a hate figure for those on America's political right, so it was no surprise that the news of his CNN career's demise was met with joy in some quarters.

One reviewer in the *National Review* opined that Morgan's low ratings stemmed from his clear sense of superiority to his audience.

### 'reflexive disdain'

"Suffice it to say that if Morgan takes any succor at all from this peculiar misreading of his fortunes, he will have rather spectacularly missed the mark," wrote Charles W. Cooke. "What distinguished him from successful and beloved British imports such as Alistair Cooke, Christopher Hitchens, and Craig Ferguson was not the voice but the attitude. Most Brits move to America because they adore the place .....Morgan, conversely, came for work and work alone - believing, as Simon Cowell told him, that his fortune lay in America -

and he demonstrated a reflexive disdain for his audience that he never quite managed to overcome.

"Back in the old country, Morgan's name is synonymous with arrogance and with overreach, and he is known less for his interviewing skills and show-business acumen than for allegedly hacking the telephones of celebrities; for retaliating against even minor criticism by siccing paparazzi on the speaker; for having published "calculated and malicious" fake

photographs of British soldiers abusing prisoners; and for considering nothing whatsoever to be more sacred than his insatiable ambition.

The definition of "countryside," Stephen Fry once quipped on the BBC, is "to kill Piers Morgan."

"Given that Morgan is an obviously repugnant personality, that he willfully fails to grapple with the topics at hand, and that he is physically incapable of allowing a guest to upstage him, he was always going to have his work cut out."

## Meet the new Philip Marlowe...courtesy of Dublin's John Banville

**PHILIP MARLOWE** remains one of American fiction's most enduring creations, but while creator Raymond Chandler is long gone, his best-known character, the down-at-heel and ethically compromised Los Angeles private detective lives on in a series of novels by various writers, few of which approach the genius of the original.

But that may have changed now that acclaimed Dublin writer John Banville is on the case. Banville is a Man Booker Prize winner (for *The Sea* in 2005), and under the nom de plume of Benjamin Black, has authored the highly-acclaimed Quirke series of postwar mysteries set in Dublin. The Quirke novels are wonderful - psychologically intense, rich in period and personal detail.

In Black's new book, *The Black-Eyed Blonde*, Philip Marlowe resurfaces so clearly, so visibly, that you can feel his alienation at the wealthy heiress' mansion on the beach. You are dropped straight into old LA's Barney's Beanery, where Marlowe fishes for information about the blonde's missing boyfriend. The story: a

guy goes missing. The wealthy blonde girlfriend wants to find him. But of course that's only the very first part of the tale. It's in the complications, the nature of the character and the conflict that we realize that Benjamin Black's great Dublin character, Quirke, is not unlike Raymond Chandler's rumpled Los Angeles Marlowe. As one reviewer put it: "In Black's most capable hands, our Marlowe lives and breathes as if Raymond Chandler himself willed him to life. Being a Dubliner, Black alludes to Dublin and to Ireland, lending authenticity to his re-creation. Philip Marlowe has finally met his dopelganger."

John Banville will be reading excerpts from *The Black-Eyed Blonde* at the Sunset/Sundance Five Cinemas, 8000 Sunset Boulevard in West Hollywood on Thursday, March 6th at 7.30pm as part of Writers Bloc a non-profit organization that for 18 years has sought to bring great writers to the readers of Los Angeles 'to hear and see how they think,' as the organization's website puts it. # Britten's "Billy Budd" now playing at the LA Opera

**THE ENGLISH** Opera Billy Budd makes a rare and welcome appearance in Los Angeles this month at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion as the culmination of the city's "Britten 100/LA" festival, last year having been the centenary of composer Sir Benjamin Britten's birth.

For those with a hazy knowledge of the art form, Billy Budd proves good opera doesn't always have to focus on lovelorn couples and heaving corsets. Based on a novella by Herman Melville (of *Moby Dick* fame) this all-man show is set aboard the stifling, enclosed world of HMS Indomitable, a British warship serving in 1797 during the Napoleonic Wars. Our hero, Billy (a spirited Liam Bonner), is a handsome and optimistic fellow, upbeat and sunny despite being pressed into service from a merchant ship, (archly-named *The Rights of Man*). But Billy is cursed by a stutter, a legacy of some sort of childhood trauma and which later becomes a key plot device.

Undercurrents of lust and sexual repression are brought to the surface as Billy's physical beauty brings him to the attention of the brutish master-at-arms, John Claggart, (Greer Grimsley) whose unrequited lust turns to bitter hatred and results in him framing Billy for fomenting mutiny, forcing a court martial at the hands of the decent and skeptical Captain Vere (Richard Croft).

Billy is infuriated and upset by the charges, and, unable to speak through his stammer, strikes Claggart, killing

him, leaving Vere with no choice but to hold a court martial immediately, his only option under the Articles of War. Billy pleads with Vere to save him, but he is sentenced to death. The sentence brings the ship to the brink of mutiny, but Billy, just before being hung from the yardarm in a very Christ-like fashion, tells the men that death is his fate and asks them not to revolt. Billy is brought onto the main deck. Just before his execution, he praises his captain one last time, singing, "Starry Vere, God bless you!"

The story is neatly bookended by the ruminations of Vere, who, as an old man long retired from the sea, is still haunted by his memories of the event.

Billy Budd is both an

anti-war story and an oblique critique of sexual repression. Britten's music, right from the opening curtain, is full of ambiguity and quiet menace, letting the audience know, long before Billy's tragic end, that there is something very nasty just over the horizon.

NOEL COWARD FANS (and aren't we all?) will want to make a beeline to Pasadena this month for a new production of *A Song at Twilight* at the Pasadena Playhouse, starring Bruce Davison and Sharon Lawrence and directed by Art Manke.

*A Song at Twilight* was first produced in 1966 and is Coward's final play, and deals with many issues of contemplation and reflection with which the author was struggling at the time. We meet author Hugo Latymer (Davison), who has reached the autumn of his days with everything a man could wish for: wealth, success, fantastic friends, and a life filled with laughter, luxury and travel. But a profound fear of intimacy and public scandal have kept him from embracing the one true love in his life, and now he wonders if he would trade the success for a chance to do it all again.

Perhaps the best estimation of the play's issues and power comes from The New York Times, which said of *A Song at Twilight*: "In his final theater work Sir Noël Coward's talent to amuse was darkened and deepened by his capacity to reflect."

Bruce Davison is best known to movie audiences for his Oscar-nominated, and Golden Globe-winning turn in the groundbreaking AIDS drama *Longtime Companion*.

Sharon Lawrence is a veteran of stage and the small screen, perhaps best known for her role as Andy Sipowicz's ill-fated wife Sylvia in the ABC-TV show, *NYPD Blue*.

I'm just a few degrees of separation from every actor in Hollywood.

**You reveal yourself to be a really good dancer both in *British Hustle* and the accompanying pop video for the film's soundtrack album. Where did that talent come from?**

I've been dancing for years. I used to hang out at Studio 54 all the time. In my era that was the way you got to meet girls. It was a good way to break the ice to say 'Would you like to dance?' I was even in the movie *Studio 54* with Mike Myers. I've been in a lot of pop videos and shown my dance moves in a few of them.

**Do you have a lot of British friends?**

Oh yes. Famous ones too. I was on a British reality TV show called *The Farm* a few years ago and got

along really well with the Brits on it, like Lionel Blair, Emma Noble, Emma B and especially ventriloquist Keith Harris. He's a terrific guy and he even let me put my hand up the keester of his puppet Orville the Duck, which I considered a great honor.

**Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?**

The Rainbow Bar and Grill right in the heart of the Sunset Strip is a favorite place of mine. That bar and that area has got so much rock n'roll history thanks to great bands like Guns n' Roses, Poison, Warrant and The Doors. It's an exciting, atmospheric hangout. Plus there's more girls than guys there and I like those odds.

**What would you suggest to others who are**



**thinking of making the move out here?**

If you're already a big fish in a little pond, there's nothing wrong with that. Coming out to LA can make you an international star, but you can also get swallowed

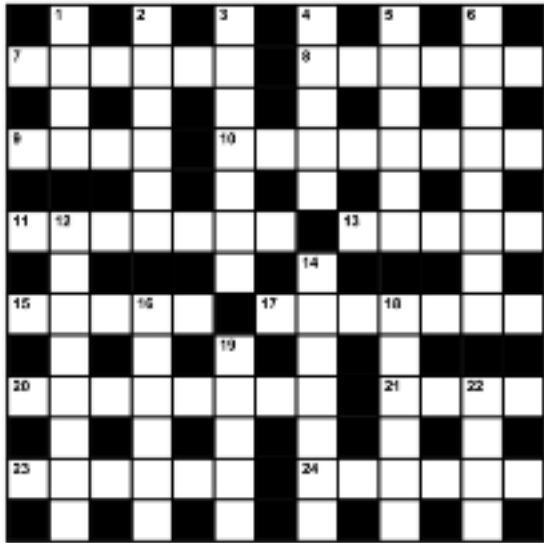

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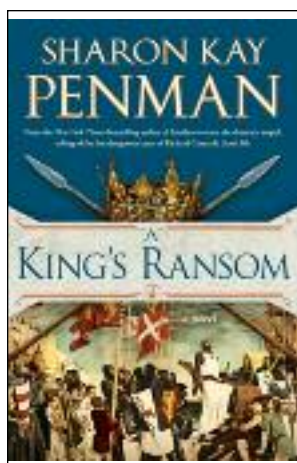
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# Richard I: Lion-hearted and more...

■ *Exclusive interview with Sharon Kay Penman on her latest novel about Richard the Lionheart and his life during and after his imprisonment*

Rating: ★★★★★

"Although Richard I is probably one of the best known of medieval monarchs...even people who know nothing of history have heard of him...there has never been a serious novel about the man," says *A King's Ransom* author Sharon Kay Penman. "The closest to it was *The Lion in Winter*, with its brilliant cast of Peter O'Toole, Katharine Hepburn, and a young Anthony Hopkins as Richard. This is one of my all-time favorite films...but it is not historically accurate.



Richard Coeur de Lion (Lion Heart) himself was a great surprise to me, for when writing of a real historical figure, I'd never before discovered such a disconnect between the man and the myth."

Penman's long-awaited sequel to her book *Lionheart* covers the last seven years of Richard's life. There's betrayal, war, illness and intrigue. There were lots of rumors about Richard.

Was he gay? Did he have affairs during his travels and his imprisonment? Penman shows the courage and compassion shown by his mother Eleanor, sister Joanna and his wife Berengaria. Penman's writes sweeping historical events that engage and the story moves along at a nice clip. She includes everyday details that get you right into the story. You can read this book without reading *Lionheart*, but it works better to read them in order. Although *Ransom* is over 700 pages, once you start reading you won't want to stop.

In *A King's Ransom*, the Pope has decreed all crusaders to the Holy Land are to have safe passage, but the Holy Roman Emperor defies that papal decree. For 15 months, Richard is imprisoned at Trefils, where most men never

leave alive. His devoted mother Eleanor of Aquitaine does everything in her power to raise the ransom, which is unreasonably high.

"When Richard first appeared, very briefly, in my novel *Here be Dragons* twenty-eight years ago, I saw him as one-dimensional, the ultimate warrior king, drunk on blood and glory, and too easily accepted the verdict of a Victorian historian that he was a bad son, a bad husband, a bad king. Twenty-some years later, I began to do serious research on Richard for *Devil's Brood*, and what I found was eye-opening."

"He was indeed hot-tempered and arrogant and so astonishingly reckless in battle that it is a miracle that he managed to live to be forty-one," says

Penman. "And he was most certainly a brilliant commander, one of the best generals of the Middle Ages, as well as being a formidable fighter, almost invincible in hand-to-hand combat. He was, however, a bad husband, his infidelities notorious enough to warrant a lecture from the Bishop of Lincoln."

Penman leads tours to England and France in which she follows the paths of Eleanor of Aquitaine and Richard III.

"It is always great fun to visit the places that mattered to the people I write about," says Penman. "Richard III and Eleanor of Aquitaine are especially beguiling ghosts to chase after, and I loved being able to share these experiences with people who are just as fascinated as I am by medieval history. I was delighted by how easily

we bonded, probably because we have so much in common. Fourteen from the Eleanor tour signed up for the Richard III tour too, so it was almost like a family reunion."

British actor (right) says that he would 'absolutely love' to play both Reggie and Ronnie Kray, and looks set to star in the film version of their criminal lives.



## ■ Manny rescues Spurs again in pulsating Europa Cup tie

**Tottenham produced a stunning comeback to beat Ukrainian visitors FC Dnipro and reach the Europa League last-16 on a dramatic Thursday night at White Hart Lane.**

Trailing 1-0 from the first leg, Spurs' task became tougher when Dnipro's Roman Zozulya headed in a vital away goal.

Spurs, needing at least three goals to progress, were handed a lifeline by Christian Eriksen's precise free-kick.

But, after Zozulya was sent off for a headbutt, Emmanuel Adebayor's two close-range finishes saw Spurs advance.

Tottenham will now face Portuguese leaders Benfica, beaten Europa League finalists against

Chelsea last season, in the next stage.

However, with almost an hour gone of the second leg at White Hart Lane, Tim Sherwood's side looked set to become the latest Premier League team to suffer in European competition.

None of their English top-flight rivals won their Champions League last-16 first legs, while Swansea were eliminated from the Europa League earlier on Thursday.

Spurs appeared on course to continue the negative trend - until their fortunes dramatically changed in a manic second-half spell. Tottenham scored all three goals inside 13 minutes, with Zozulya's moment of madness sandwiched between.

Dnipro's Roman Zozulya

was incredulous at the red card shown by referee Antony Gautier

Inexplicably, the Ukraine forward headbutted Spurs defender Jan Vertonghen, after a number of previous confrontations between the pair, as Dnipro defended a home free-kick while still leading 2-1 in the tie.

Zozulya was instantly dismissed by referee Antony Gautier in the middle of a furious exchange between both sets of players in the Ukrainian penalty area.

More importantly, it stoked up the Spurs crowd and swung the momentum in their team's favour.

The home side instantly took advantage of the numerical advantage as Eriksen whipped in a dangerous cross from the left which

allowed Adebayor to poke in.

Four minutes later, the Togo striker put Spurs ahead in the tie for the first time by controlling Zeki Fryers' long ball on his chest and calmly stroking past Dnipro keeper Denys Boyko.

The manner in which Spurs celebrated, with a

jubilant Sherwood fist-pumping the air as he raced down the touchline, showed the relief that had been lifted inside White Hart Lane.

All the drama came after a frustrating first half, where Tottenham dominated possession without testing the Dnipro goalkeeper.

Sherwood's side went into the match on the back of two successive defeats following their loss in Ukraine and a disappointing reverse Premier League strugglers Norwich on Sunday.

Ahead of kick-off, Sherwood insisted his

## World Cup: Hodgson 'not afraid' to leave out big names

**England manager Roy Hodgson says he is prepared to leave experienced players out of his World Cup squad.**

Hodgson must decide on his 23 names for the tournament in Brazil by 2 June.

Younger players including Southampton's Luke Shaw and Liverpool's Raheem Sterling are in his squad for Tuesday's friendly with Denmark.

"I am very conscious that I could have to leave a big name out," he said. "It wasn't easy before the Euros, this time it will be

even harder."

Ashley Cole, England's most-capped left-back with 106 appearances, has not played regularly for Chelsea this season and faces competition from Everton's Leighton Baines and the uncapped Shaw from the list for the Denmark friendly.

"Before the Euros at least I was choosing names of players I knew and players I had seen play but had never really worked with," said former West Brom manager Hodgson, who was appointed England manager in May 2012.

"This time I will have to disappoint some people I have worked with who have maybe done a good job for me and the team."

The 30 players Hodgson will consider for the meeting with Denmark on Tuesday include several who have been given first caps this season, including Southampton striker Rickie Lambert and Everton midfielder Ross Barkley.

More experienced names omitted include Gareth Barry, who has impressed on loan from
