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# Nigella refused entry to USA

Drugs admission means celebrity chef must now apply for a visa

**NIGELLA Lawson has been barred from entering the US after admitting in court to taking cocaine, it emerged this week.**

The celebrity chef is a frequent visitor to these shores, most recently to film and promote her popular cooking contest show, *The Taste*, but she was prevented from boarding a flight from Heathrow to LA this weekend, according to onlookers.

It is thought that she may have fallen foul of the country's tough stance on drugs offences.

Giving evidence in a fraud trial against her two former assistants Francesca and Elisabetta Grillo last year, Ms Lawson admitted to drug use under oath.

She denied being a habitual user, but said that she had taken cocaine on several occasions and smoked cannabis.

Scotland Yard released a statement saying that they did not plan to act over the confession.

However, America

reserves the right to bar foreigners who have committed drugs offences, even if they have not been charged.

Ms Lawson initially travelled to America in the wake of the court case to promote *The Taste* without difficulty, but it appears the authorities have now toughened up their stance.

According to the *Daily Mail*, a fellow passenger at Heathrow saw Ms Lawson on Sunday after she had been told she could not board the plane.

They said: "She didn't seem to say much, but she did not look happy."

"She could not get on the flight so she had to turn around and leave."

Ms Lawson had earlier tweeted a photo of a sun hat and a tube of Coleman's mustard, with the caption 'packing for my holiday'.

Experts say that she

must now apply for a waiver of inadmissibility in order to enter the country, which can take as long as 25 weeks to obtain.

However, the process can be fast-tracked if the applicant can demonstrate a need for it to be handled quickly, according to immigration lawyers.

Ms Lawson recently gave her first interview since the trial and her separation from husband Charles Saatchi, which came after he was pictured putting his hand around her neck last year.

Speaking to Michael McIntyre on his BBC 1 chat show, she said that she had "had better times".

She said that she was "not an innocent" but refused to be drawn on the court case and details of her life with her former husband.

# No wizard wheeze: Saharan dust cloud leaves England choking

JUST A FEW short weeks ago much of Britain was suffering through gale-force winds, record rainfall and widespread flooding.

But as the first week of April arrives an unusual new weather phenomenon has gripped the country, a blanket of smog caused by a rare combination of local emissions, light winds, pollution from the continent and dust blown over from the Sahara.

## maximum level

The smog cloud has shrouded many of England's most famous monuments for days, prompted a rash of calls to the emergency services over health fears and even stopped Prime Minister David Cameron from taking his early morning jog.

Pollution levels in the capital and southeast England were rated at a maximum level of 10 on Thursday, according to the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra).

Pollution levels in Britain reach the highest level in particular places a few times a year, a

spokesman said.

In March, air pollution levels in Paris hit such heights that transport chiefs enforced the most drastic traffic curbs in years, making public transport free in the French capital.

Landmarks like London's Big Ben and the huge "Angel of the North" sculpture in the city of Gateshead were shrouded in haze as frustrated tourists try to take pictures through the murk.

## respiratory problems

The pollution has been a particular bane for those with respiratory problems and health experts have been discouraging people from taking vigorous exercise outdoors.

Cameron was one who heeded the advice.

"I didn't go for my morning run this morning, I chose to do some work instead. You can feel it in the air," he told the BBC.

Asthma UK said an overnight poll showed there had been a surge in reported asthma attacks triggered by the high pollution levels.

Some 30 percent of

respondents had had an asthma attack as a result of the pollution and 84 percent reported using their blue reliever inhaler more than usual, the charity said.

London's ambulance service said calls out for people with breathing problems were 14 percent higher than average on Wednesday.

Forecasters say the smoggy conditions are likely to last into the weekend.

## Rail link to Cornwall restored

The main railway line through Dawlish in Devon, which is the main rail artery to the South West, reopened to passengers on Friday after part of the track was destroyed during winter storms.

The rail track was swept away along with part of the sea wall in early February, cutting off the service linking Cornwall and much of Devon with the rest of the UK.

A 300-strong Network Rail team has rebuilt the track at a

cost of £35m.

The sea wall of the coast-hugging line at Dawlish was breached and the line badly damaged on 5 February.

Repair work was under way before being hampered by another severe storm on the night of February 14 when huge waves damaged a line of shipping containers forming a breakwater and punched a new hole in the sea wall.

Then on 4 March,

engineers discovered 25,000 tonnes of a cliff face near Teignmouth just south of Dawlish had sheared away above the line.

It resulted in water jets being used to pummel the cliff face to create a controlled landslide.

Network Rail chief executive Mark Carne said: "Our army of engineers has done an amazing job of putting back together a railway that was ravaged by the elements."



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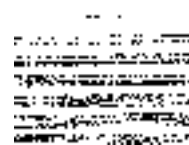
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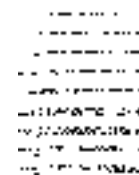


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## Prince Andrew jumps on the Selfie craze

Celebrities the world over have been jumping on the selfie craze - and now Prince Andrew has become the first member of the Royal family to take a selfie (above) in a Palace.

Hosting an event for start up businesses at St James's Palace, the Duke of York seized the opportunity to snap a shot of himself and the assembled delegates.

Speaking to the 350-strong audience, he said: "This is a unique day at the Palace because we are encouraging you to use your phones and electronic gadgetry."

"As a result of that I've decided there's a bit of a thing going around about selfies."

The Prince then produced his smartphone and snapped the shot before uploading it to his Twitter account (@TheDukeOfYork). It has since been shared more than 200 times.

The Duke had already gone against royal protocol earlier in the evening by defacing a sign banning mobile telephones so that it instead read: 'Mobile phones are allowed inside the State Rooms'.

A Buckingham palace source said: "This was a tech-heavy event and the Duke quickly got into the spirit of things."

"He resisted the temptation to refer to the Royal photograph as a 'onesie'."

VATICAN CITY: The Queen met Pope Francis for the first time on Thursday and gave a bemused pontiff culinary delights from the royal estates, including a dozen eggs and a bottle of whisky.

"I've also brought something from all our estates, which is for you personally," said the queen, wearing a lavender dress and a purple hat, as she handed Francis a wicker basket full of food at the end of a 17-minute private meeting in the Vatican.

The 18 items from Buckingham Palace, Windsor, Sandringham and Balmoral also included two types of honey, "Coronation Best Bitter," "Grandad's chutney" and "Sandringham hand-made aromatherapy soaps".

A Vatican official said the pope would likely share the food with other residents of the guest house where he has lived since his election after renouncing the spacious papal

apartments or would donate it.

The Queen and Prince Philip, the Duke of Edinburgh, met the pope in a modern room attached to the Vatican's audience hall without much of the ceremonial pomp that usually accompanies such visits.

A Vatican statement did not say what the two discussed. The Queen is also the Supreme Governor of the Church of England, which split from Rome in 1534.

The pope is Argentine and Britain went to war with Argentina over the Falkland Islands, which Argentina calls the Malvinas, in 1982.

To cut short any speculation that the two might have discussed the Falklands, the British embassy reminded reporters that while the pope may be Argentine, the Vatican's official position on the territorial dispute is a neutral one.

Francis also gave the queen a gift for her eight-month-old great-grandson, Prince George of Cambridge. It was a sphere made of

# UKIP leader scores another impressive win in EU debate

■ Farage continues to confound his critics by besting Lib-Dem leader for second time

**THE UNLIKELY** rise of Nigel Farage continues.

The leader of the UK Independence Party (UKIP) was acknowledged to have bested deputy Prime Minister Nick Clegg for the second successive debate over Britain's future in Europe according to snap polls on Thursday.

## assured performances

Farage – a former City trader and Conservative MP who left the party in 1992 after the signing of the Maastricht Treaty – has been treated by much of the British media as a figure of fun since becoming leader of UKIP in 2010.

Yet his assured performances on television and radio, coupled with growing unease about widespread migration into the country, have delivered a remarkable upsurge in Farage's popularity and credibility, which will likely be further enhanced by his performance against the Lib-Dem

leader in this week's televised debate.

A YouGov survey had 68% of people backing the UKIP leader, while just 27% thought Nick Clegg won the night. Another poll, in *The Guardian*, had a similar result with Mr Farage on 69%.

Senior Lib Dems Danny Alexander, the Chief Secretary to the Treasury, and Tim Farron, the party president, insisted Mr Clegg had won.

However, Patrick O'Flynn, the communications director for UKIP, told Sky News it was a "massacre".

Peter Kellner, the YouGov president, said the underlying data was bad news for Mr Clegg. He said: "The most

interesting change is there has been a shift to Farage among Labour voters since last week and among Lib Dems."

Last week, 51% of Labour voters backed Mr Clegg – a point that Lib Dem strategists focused on, arguing that was what it had all been about. They said Mr Clegg wanted to win pro-Europeans away from Labour and the Conservatives, with 27% of the latter backing Mr Clegg.

## credentials

But on Wednesday night Mr Kellner said far more Labour voters thought Mr Farage won the debate and even one in three Lib Dem voters felt the UKIP leader stole the night.

It is the second week Mr Farage has emerged the victor.

After last week's impassioned debate, shown live on LBC and Sky News, a YouGov poll of 1,003 people found 57% thought the UKIP leader performed best compared with 36% for Mr Clegg.

Burnishing his credentials as a champion of the working class, Mr Farage used the second debate to repeatedly made digs at the "rich people" and the "political elite".

And he positioned himself as the head of the "people's army" inviting people to join him and "topple the establishment who got us into this mess".

He said immigration had left the "white working class as an

underclass", and the country's health service, schools and communities were not able to cope with Britain's "open-door" policy.

And he claimed a new house would need to be built in Britain every seven minutes to cope with the number of immigrants.

He said he would support immigration if it was all about people speaking English and bringing skills – but it was not.

## 'danger to peace'

The Liberal Democrat leader said it was "silly" to suggest that 485 million people in Europe were about to come to Britain.

He replied: "It is as silly as me saying that five million people living in

Scotland might all move to Orpington next Tuesday. It is not going to happen."

The two men clashed angrily on EU foreign policy on the conflict in Syria, the crisis in Ukraine and on Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Mr Farage said the EU had brought about the bloodshed in Ukraine by coercing the country into the European Union in an act seen as "deeply provocative" to Mr Putin.

He said: "They actually toppled a democratically elected leader. Yes, I know Ukraine's corrupt, I know it wasn't perfect, but they toppled a leader and I do not want to be part of an emerging, expansionist EU foreign policy. I think it will be a danger to peace."

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# Former Dynasty star O'Mara dead at 74

**Former Dynasty star Kate O'Mara has died at the age of 74, her agent said.**

The British actress was best known for her role as sister to Joan Collins' Alexis Colby in the US soap.

She also had prominent roles in the '80s series *Howards' Way* and *Triangle*, and in *Doctor Who*.

Her agent said she died in a Sussex nursing home following a short illness.

He praised her "energy and vitality" and her "love for theatre and acting".

"A shining star has gone out and Kate will be dearly missed by all who knew and have worked with her," said agent Phil Belfield, who labelled the actress "extraordinary".

Born into a theatrical

family O'Mara enjoyed a busy career on stage before breaking into television in the late 1960s in shows which perfectly suited her glamorous good looks, including *The Saint*, *The*

Champions, The Avengers, Department S and Jason King. She became a series regular on the BBC haulage drama, *The Brothers*, before snagging her first transatlantic role playing the manipulative Cassandra "Caress" Morrell in *Dynasty*.

## disaster

Co-star Joan Collins tweeted: "Tragic news about Kate O'Mara, we had great fun on *Dynasty* when she played my sister Caress... RIP."

She also appeared in *Doctor Who*, opposite both Colin Baker and Sylvester McCoy, as renegade Time Lord The Rani - a role she said she would love to return to.

"If you put a much older woman in *Doctor*

Who, they can identify with it," she said ahead of the 50th anniversary celebrations for the show, where she tweeted images of herself with former co-stars.

"I think it's quite an interesting concept and if you remember things like Grimm's *Fairytales*, the older woman is often the villainess, often the terrifying figure - why I do not know, but often she is. I think it's an idea to be exploited."

Her life was clouded in disaster when her son, Dickon, a former RSC stage manager, hanged himself on the last day of 2012 in the home he shared with her at Long Marston in Warwickshire. Though she was a trim, perennially fit

good care of oneself, a vegetarian and teetotal all her life, this was a blow from which she never really recovered.

In 2008, she had enjoyed a great critical success as Marlene Dietrich in *Lunch with Marlene* at the New End in Hampstead (Frank Barrie played Noël Coward) and had most recently been seen in *Benidorm*, the ITV soap, and touring with the Agatha Christie Company in *Murder on the Nile* in 2012.

In 1961 she married the actor Jeremy Young. They divorced in 1976. Her marriage to Richard Willis, 18 years her junior, in 1993 ended in divorce three years later.

She is survived by Belinda.

## Argentina unveils new Falklands banknote

**ARGENTINA'S president has unveiled a new banknote featuring a map of the Falklands and a picture of a man who led a bloody uprising against the British.**

Cristina Kirchner, 61 revealed the note on Thursday and pledged an "eternal fight" for the Falklands at an event marking the 32nd anniversary of the Falklands War.

The blue 50 peso note, worth around £3.75, features an image of Antonio Rivero who led an attack in the disputed territory that killed five people in August 1833.

His actions against the British went unpunished as a local court system had not been established and 'the Gaucho' is seen as a hero in Argentina.

A government spokesman described the creation of the new banknote as an "act of

historic, social and political revindication of our sovereign rights."

The banknote was unveiled at Argentina's government house in Buenos Aires.

It was applauded by a crowd after an Argentinian flag covering a mock up of the note was removed.

Mrs Kirchner described the Falklands by their Spanish name of *Islas Malvinas* and said: "This is a homage to our *Islas Malvinas* and to all those who gave their lives to this cause."

Mrs Kirchner went on to describe the Falklands

as the "largest military and nuclear NATO base in the South Atlantic."

She also sent a message to Britain, warning that: "History shows that colonial enclaves are always recovered."

The Falklands War lasted 74 days in 1982 and claimed the lives of 255 British soldiers, three civilian islanders and 649 Argentinian soldiers.

A referendum was held last March on the sovereignty of the Falklands. The vast majority, 99.8 per cent, voted to remain a British territory.

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# Glasgow’s iconic Red Road tower blocks set to tumble for Commonwealth Games

They have been a fixture of Glasgow’s skyline for five decades, but the Red Road tower blocks will come tumbling down in less than 30 seconds as part of the Commonwealth Games opening ceremony in Glasgow on July 23rd.

The live demolition of five of the six remaining towers will be the biggest of its kind ever seen in Europe, organisers say.

An estimated television audience of 1.5 billion is expected to tune in to see the 30-storey blocks crumble.

The event will also be beamed live to the opening ceremony itself inside Celtic Park on a giant 100-metre screen which will fill the entire south stand of the stadium.

More than 1,250kg of explosives will be used and the demolition will take just 15 seconds.

A total of 887 nearby homes will be evacuated, with residents invited to the ceremony on July 23.

Eileen Gallagher, independent director on the Glasgow 2014 board, said the demolition proves Glasgow is a city that is “proud of its history but doesn’t stand still”.

City council leader Gordon Matheson said: “Red Road has an iconic place in Glasgow’s history, having been home to thousands of families and dominating the city’s skyline for decades.

“Their demolition will

all but mark the end of high-rise living in the area and is symbolic of the changing face of Glasgow, not least in terms of our preparations for the Games.”

Built between 1964 and 1969, the flats were once the highest in Europe at 89 metres (292ft).

Six of the original towers remain after two previous demolitions, one in 2012 and the other last year.

They were originally designed to hold 4,700 people but in later years numbers dropped as the properties slipped into decline.

Director Andrea Arnold used the buildings as the setting for her 2006 Scottish Bafta-winning film Red Road.

One block, Petershill Court, is used to house asylum seekers and will be brought down at a later date.



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# Tayside pilot to fly around the world in 80 days

A Tayside retiree is gearing up to fly around the globe in a single-engine plane in 80 days.

Scot Dave McElroy is taking on the 36,000-mile challenge to raise money for Scotland’s Charity Air Ambulance.

The 66-year-old will spend at least 275 hours in the air in a Piper Comanche, starting and finishing in Perth and making 52 stops in 25 countries along the way.

The flight is only the second of its kind to take off from Scotland.

Mr McElroy, who is chairman of the Scottish Aero Club, will visit five continents and cross the Pacific, Atlantic and Indian oceans as well as the Mediterranean and Caribbean seas on his flight.

He hopes to raise £150,000 for Scotland’s Charity Air Ambulance, which operates out of Perth airport, having already covered the costs of the flight himself along with his Canadian partner Chris Elgar.

He said: “The planning has been challenging in itself.

“It took four months to secure my permit to enter Israeli airspace.”

**Oceanic flying**

Mr McElroy has been flying since he was 19, logging some 2,800 hours in the air.

However he faces many challenges on his adventure - one being a 16-hour flight over the Pacific Ocean, between Hawaii and California.

“Oceanic flying is different because the vista never changes, apart from the weather - hour after hour of endless water and sky,” he said.

“My longest over-water flight to date was three and a half hours across the Caribbean.”

Mr McElroy will take off from Perth Airport on 19 May, and plans to be back in Scotland by 6 August, via a host of stop-offs including Israel, Pakistan, Indonesia, Australia, Fiji, California, Panama and Newfoundland.

He said his personal highlights of the route included meeting up with a Scottish man living on remote Christmas Island, and making an appearance at the world’s largest airshow in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

## Shropshire teen earns £24k by playing Grand Theft Auto in his bedroom

A SHROPSHIRE TEENAGER is enjoying a nice little earner just by playing popular video game Grand Theft Auto 5 in the comfort of his own bedroom.

A-Level student Fred Pye pockets £2,000 each month from posting videos on YouTube of him playing GTAV on his Xbox.

The 17-year-old’s videos, which offer gamers advice and tips, have been viewed 25million times and he earns thousands from advertising revenue.

His YouTube channel NoughtPointFourLIVE has 138,000 subscribers and receives almost 2.5million unique visitors each month.

The youngster from Shrewsbury started his YouTube channel “for fun” around two-and-a-half years ago.

Speaking to reporters on Thursday, the Shrewsbury Sixth Form College pupil said: “My friends thought it was quite funny and took the mickey a bit, as you would expect, but my views just kept growing and growing.

“It can be a bit time consuming as it takes around three hours per video, but I think it’s worth it as the more views I get, the more sponsorship I get.

“That is how I make my money, I get up to £2,000 a month, which is great and a big help for someone of my age, I think my friends realised it was serious when they knew that.

He added that his parents are “very supportive” of his efforts on YouTube and that he always does his schoolwork before recording a new video.

GTAV was released on September 17 last year and in just 24 hours it made an incredible £480million worldwide in revenue.

Mr Pye, who is studying advanced maths, history, English and politics, said he is planning to take a gap year when he graduates.

“Hopefully I can be successful in this and do it for life, that would be just great, it is every gamers dream to be able to play and get paid and that’s what I am doing.”

## Kirkin’ O’ the Tartans this Sunday in Hawthorne

LOCAL Scots are encouraged to mark the annual Kirkin’ O’ the Tartans on Sunday, April 6th at the Calvary Presbyterian Church of Hawthorne, 13560 Hawthorne Blvd., starting at 10.15am.

This popular event has become a very special day in the Scottish-American calendar, allowing all represented clans to be recognized and have their tartans blessed.

In common with the wild bacchanalia that is now St. Patrick’s Day, The Kirkin’ O’ The Tartans is an event celebrated far more devotedly on this side of the Atlantic than back home, and the event’s origins are undoubtedly shrouded more in legend than fact, but in the interests of context, here is a little backstory on the ritual:

### Battle of Culloden

Following the final defeat of the forces of Jacobite uprising in 1746 at the Battle of Culloden and the defeat of Bonnie

Prince Charlie, the government at Westminster sought to stamp out the most overt symbols of Scottish identity and crush the clan system to ensure there were no future revolts against English rule north of the border. The Act banned the wearing of any sign of the Tartan, forbade any speaking in Gaelic, outlawed Scottish music, dancing, or the playing of the pipes. That much is fact. But legend has it Scottish Highlanders subsequently hid pieces of tartan under their clothing and brought them to church for a secret blessing or kirkin’ at a particular point in the service by the minister.

During the 36 years

following the Disarming Act of 1746 when the Westminster government strictly enforced this ban, during the Sunday service Highlanders would touch the hidden cloth when the minister gave the benediction, thus rededicating themselves to God and their Scottish heritage.

### Scottish-American pride

At least that’s the popular story behind the custom, although historical records to back it up are hard to come by. What is undisputed is that the practice gained ground in America thanks to the efforts of Reverend Peter Marshall, an expat Scot and pastor of the leading Presbyterian

Church in Washington, D.C who hoped to drum up patriotic fervor among Scottish-Americans during World War II by instilling pride in their ancestry. Marshall’s influence as chaplain to the US Senate brought immediate attention to his annual Kirkin’ ceremony and the practice quickly spread, to such an extent that it is now found in Episcopalian, Methodist, Roman Catholic, Orthodox, and other denominations across the world.

As for Tartan Day, that is an even more recent American ‘tradition’. In 2004, the National Capital Tartan Day Committee, a coalition of Scottish-American organizations, successfully lobbied the US House of Representatives. On March 9, 2005, the United States House of Representatives unanimously adopted House Resolution 41, which designates April 6 of each year as “National Tartan Day.” So now you know.

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## A Royal Passion: Queen Victoria and Photography, now featured at the Getty

Currently featured at the Getty Center is an absorbing exhibition entitled: A Royal Passion: Queen Victoria and Photography, which examines the fascination Queen Victoria developed with the emerging technology of photography shortly after ascending to the British throne in 1837.

This exhibition explores the relationship between the new art form and the queen, whose passion for collecting photographs began in the 1840s. On display are rare daguerreotypes, private portraits of the Royal Family, and a selection of prints by early masters of photography.

Over the course of her long reign, the queen was photographed as loving mother, devoted wife, grieving widow, and powerful sovereign. She was the first British monarch to have her life fully recorded by the camera, and her portraits became emblematic of an entire age.

On April 12th the Getty will stage a Family Festival to allow the whole family to explore the world of Victorian photography. 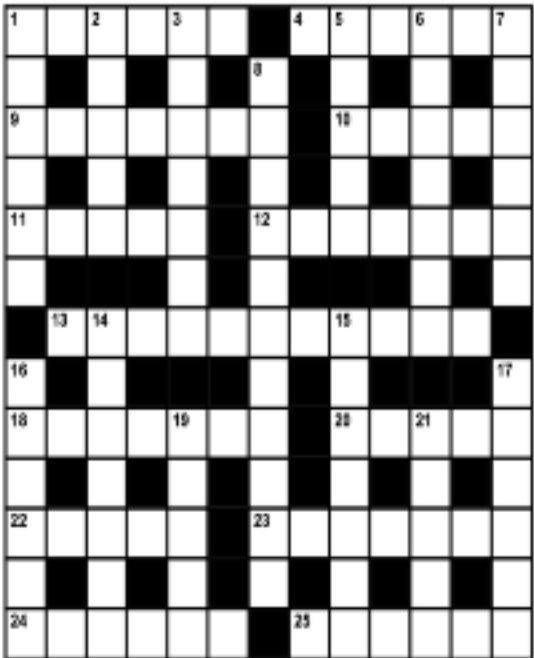

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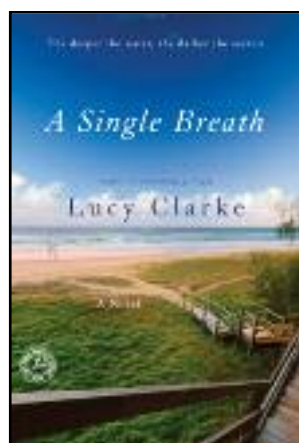
# A Single Breath: love and betrayal Down Under

■ Exclusive interview with author Lucy Clarke and a review of her new novel of love and betrayal set in Tasmania

**“There is something so irresistible about secrets,” says *A Single Breath* author Lucy Clarke.**

“The moment I hear someone whisper, ‘I’ve got a secret’, my ears prick up. I’m sure that many people keep the odd secret in order to protect someone they care about, and most of these will be harmless enough. But then there are those darker secrets, the ones that are tightly wrapped with lies, and presented as truth. Those are the dangerous ones – and also the ones that are



wonderfully exciting to explore in fiction.”

Clarke’s writing is engaging, will keep you guessing to the end of the book. There are plot twists and a shocking ending, and Clarke’s vivid descriptions of Tasmania feel like being there.

*A Single Breath* takes us on the journey of Eva, a midwife who, while mourning the death of her husband, learns the man she loved and married is a fraud. Why did he do it?

One nagging question, why she didn’t do a Google search before marrying him?

Eva and Jackson have been married for eight months when tragedy strikes. Witnesses see Jackson swept out to sea while fishing. A search is started at once, but no body is found, leaving Eva devastated. Putting her midwife business on hold, she visits Jackson’s family in Tasmania.

Instead of it calming her and bringing peace, meeting Jackson’s father Dirk and brother Saul brings more questions. Her whole marriage was based on lies. As Eva spends time with Saul, she starts to develop feelings for him. Can she trust him? Will she trust any man again?

“After my first visit to Tasmania, I knew I wanted to set a novel

there,” says Clarke. “So I returned the following winter for a research trip. Later on that year, I heard of a friend-of-a-friend who was leading a double life in order to hide a huge secret from her family.” Clarke was intrigued by the idea of not really knowing those we think are closest to us. She thought how devastating it would be to find out the truth after that person had died. “These two threads began to weave together,” says Clarke, “stitching themselves into the beginning of a story.”

Clarke prefers to write longhand. “There’s something about the simplicity of a pencil and a blank page that appeals to the romantic in me,” says Clarke. “I love to write to music, too. There are certain albums I play to help me step into a character’s mindset, or to

inspire a particular atmosphere in a scene.”

Clarke’s first novel, *Swimming At Night* was released in hardback last summer. It will be available this summer in paperback.

Clarke is currently writing her third novel. Called *The Blue*, the novel is set on a yacht sailing towards the South Pacific crewed by a group of travelers. “Best friends Lana and Kitty join the yacht in the Philippines and sail through crystal blue lagoons, and remote, uninhabited islands,” says Clarke. “But, on a 10-day ocean crossing, the crew wake to discover one of their friends is missing. Relationships between the crew fracture, and Lana and Kitty’s friendship is stretched to breaking point. It’s a story of friendship, love, hedonism, and the

delicate balance between truth and lies.”

Clarke was born and still lives in Bournemouth with her husband. “Our house is a two-minute walk from the beach, and on windless nights we can hear the waves breaking, which is heaven,” says Clarke.

## Benteke to miss World Cup

Aston Villa striker Christian Benteke has been ruled out for a minimum of six months with a ruptured Achilles tendon.

The 23-year-old Belgium international will have surgery on the injury sustained in training and will miss this summer’s World Cup in Brazil.

Villa manager Paul Lambert said: “It’s a terrible blow both for Christian and for the club. “But he’ll work hard because that’s what he does and he’ll come back

for us stronger than ever next season.”

Benteke joined Villa in August 2012 in a £7m deal from Belgian club Genk.

He scored 23 goals in all competitions in his debut season in England and was linked with a move away from Villa Park.

Benteke handed in a transfer request last summer, but withdrew it to sign a new four-year contract in July 2013.

He has scored 11 goals this season despite going four months without finding the back of the net and was set to be named in

the Belgium World Cup squad even though his last national appearance came in the September 2013 in victory over Scotland

. Manchester United forward Wayne Rooney lacks the mentality to become a “world-class” player, says Queens Park Rangers midfielder Joey Barton.

Rooney, 28, recently signed a new contract that puts him among the highest-paid players in football.

But Barton - an admirer of Rooney - said his mental approach leaves him

behind the world’s best on the pitch.

“Look at his approach and mentality compared to Cristiano Ronaldo’s. Polar opposites,” he told BBC Radio 5 live.

The 31-year-old added: “Rooney potentially, could have been world class. But why is Ronaldo a Ballon d’Or winner and Rooney isn’t?

“Players who have worked with both say the level of discipline Ronaldo has is the reason he is the best player in the world.”

■ Chelsea boss angry at 'joke' PSG goal as French opponents gain Champions League advantage

Chelsea boss Jose Mourinho criticised his side's "joke" defending and blamed his misfiring strikers after a 3-1 defeat by Paris St-Germain left their Champions League campaign in trouble.

"The third was not a goal, it's a joke. Gary Cahill says 'sloppy'. I say 'ridiculous'," said the Portuguese.

Mourinho fielded winger Andre Schurrle on his own up front, leaving £50m signing Fernando Torres on the bench.

"I'm not happy with my strikers, I have to try

things," said Mourinho.

"With Andre, at least I know we have one more player to have the ball, we have one more player to associate with the other players.

"Football is also about scoring goals. That is for strikers, for real strikers. I had to try."

Torres has scored only nine goals in his 32 appearances this season, while Demba Ba, who was an unused substitute, has five in 22 appearances.

Cameroon international Samuel Eto'o has been more prolific but has been out injured since the 6-0 win over Arsenal on 22 March.

While Mourinho

has regularly expressed his dissatisfaction with his forwards, his defenders, who had conceded just four goals in the Champions League this season before defeat in Paris, have been largely exempt from criticism.

However, the Portuguese believes all three of PSG's goals could have been prevented.

Ezequiel Lavezzi swept in an early half-volley to put the hosts ahead before Eden Hazard levelled from the spot after a foul on Oscar.

David Luiz bundled into his own net to restore PSG's lead, then, after Edinson Cavani fired wide, Pastore's solo

effort swung the tie the home side's way.

"We played against a great team with fantastic attacking players and you would expect them to score fantastic goals, not the goals they scored," added

Mourinho.

"We assisted the striker for the first goal. For the second goal, the way the team was positioned defensively was not right. The third was ridiculous.

"We made individual mistakes in areas where,

for the whole season, the guys perform and we have no problems.

"They have the right to make their mistakes, because we have other players that make mistakes the whole season."
