Maddy police ready to pounce

■ **Authorities closing in after 'major breakthrough' in long-running case**

MADELEINE McCann detectives are set to make arrests after a major breakthrough in the case, it was revealed on Thursday.

Scotland Yard said they had discovered their chief suspect abused a British girl in the same resort two years before Madeleine vanished.

The victim, who was 10, was attacked in her bed in Praia da Luz in Portugal's Algarve region.

Police believe the fact that he struck so close to Madeleine's holiday villa is of huge significance to their new probe into her 2007 disappearance.

They were tipped off about the previously unknown incident after a Crimewatch TV appeal last month.

They revealed on the BBC show that they wanted to trace a serial sex attacker they had linked to 12 attacks on white British girls as

they slept in flats and villas in the Algarve.

Police said that appeal had given them information about six other similar assaults, including the one in Praia da Luz.

suspects

All 18 attacks appear to have been committed by the same man who was described as "smelly and

pot-bellied".

The Met now hope to visit Portugal as early as next week. They want to question a number of suspects but will need Portuguese police to make arrests and carry out interviews.

Clarence Mitchell, spokesman for Madeleine's parents Kate and Gerry, both 45, said: "The fact that yet

Ukip suspend poster boy Lampitt after he claims Labour leader was 'not a real Brit'

THE UK Independence Party (Ukip) have suspended one of its most high-profile members for "repellent" comments he made on Twitter, it has emerged.

A party spokesman said they were aware of at least six posts from Andre Lampitt expressing "extreme racist views" including anti-Islamic sentiments.

In the past few months Mr Lampitt had called Labour leader Ed

Miliband not a "real Brit" adding that the Labour leader was Polish and also called slavery an "act of war" on Twitter.

The Zimbabwean decorator and kitchen fitter was hoping to become a Ukip candidate for local elections and appeared in a party political broadcast.

In it he wore a builders hard hat and said "since the lads from Eastern Europe" had moved to the UK he had struggled

to provide for his family.

Ukip spokesman said Mr Lampitt's membership had been "suspended immediately pending a full disciplinary process."

They added: "We are deeply shocked that Mr Lampitt has expressed such repellent views."

Since Ukip suspended Mr Lampitt's membership it appears his Twitter account has been deleted.

In one post Mr Lampitt claimed Mr Miliband was

"not a real Brit...He was only born here" and suggested the Labour leader was Polish.

In another tweet written to a user he said: "Oh for Gods sake get over it slavery was an act of war you lost stop being so damn jealous and move forward."

While in another post Mr Lampitt said: "I want to start a website islamoutofuk.co.uk".

Before the account was taken offline, the Ukip hopeful described himself on Twitter as: "Born British in Rhodesia and proud of heritage sad at how Britain is run."

It comes after party leader Nigel Farage was forced to defend the latest Ukip European elections poster against accusations of being racist.

One poster read: "26 million people in Europe

are looking for work. And whose jobs are they after?"

Alongside the anti-immigration message was a picture of a giant hand pointing at whoever would be reading the poster.

Labour MP Mike Gapes had blasted the posters as "racist" while former Tory minister Lord Deben said "UKIP stands for the worst in human beings".

Inquiry into Hillsborough 'insults' from Whitehall

The Cabinet Office is making "urgent inquiries" following claims that government computers were used to make offensive and inflammatory comments about the Hillsborough disaster.

Anonymous alterations to the Wikipedia page about the tragedy were made from computers on Whitehall's secure

intranet, the Liverpool Echo said on Thursday.

The newspaper said revisions to the online encyclopaedia began five years ago on the 20th anniversary of the tragedy, and again in 2012.

Among the reported amendments to the Hillsborough section was an insertion saying "Blame Liverpool fans", and two years go the

phrase "You'll never walk alone" was altered to "You'll never walk again" and later "You'll never w*** alone."

A spokeswoman for the Cabinet Office said: "We thank the Liverpool Echo for bringing this to our attention. This is a matter that we will treat with the utmost seriousness and are making urgent inquiries."

new information is coming out since the last appeal shows the scale of work that is yet to be done.

"Naturally Kate and Gerry hope that it can be completed as soon as possible.

"There is a lot of information that still needs to be checked and Kate and Gerry are hoping it leads to Madeleine being found.

"They remain very grateful to the Metropolitan police for the work they continue to do."

He added that the families of previous victims did not wish to be identified but were "prepared to help police all they can".

'horrendous experience'

Five of the new crimes have been classed as sexual assaults, while the sixth was described as a "near miss". Portuguese police have announced that African burglar Euclides Monteiro, who died aged 40 in a tractor accident five years ago, is the serial attacker but Scotland Yard are not so sure.

DCI Andy Redwood, leading the Met probe, said the latest cases emerged after more than

500 members of the public phoned a special hotline for the case.

He said the horrific sexual assaults had left the lives of the victims and their parents shattered.

He told press at central London's New Scotland Yard on Thursday: "For every one of these families it's been an horrendous experience."

Deputy Assistant Commissioner Martin Hewitt revealed British police are poised to stage operations on Portuguese soil soon.

He said: "I am cautiously optimistic that in the not-too-distant future we are going to start to see activity."

Kate and Wills follow in Diana's footsteps with visit to Ayers Rock

■ The Duke and Duchess continue Down Under tour with trip to iconic Australian landmark

■ Charles and Diana made same trip in 1983

IN AN UNCANNY echo of his late mother's visit to Australia thirty years ago, Prince William this week posed for pictures in front of the iconic Ayers Rock, - in virtually the same spot as Prince Diana in 1983.

The trip to Uluru, as Ayers Rock is officially known, came on the 16th day of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge's three-week official tour to New Zealand and Australia.

Kate and William watched in awe - and batted away the flies - as the sun set over the remarkable 1,142ft-high red sandstone landmark in the heart of the Australian Outback. 'It's a beautiful sight. Quite breathtaking,' the prince told his 32-year-old wife, who was in a Hobbs dress she has worn previously in the UK and wedge heels.

A schoolgirl told Kate: 'You were both like magic when the photos were being taken, I was like "How are they not swatting flies away?"'

Kate laughed: 'I know. It was difficult.' William added: 'They were all coming for us.'

solitude

Earlier, the couple, who had left baby George in Canberra, enjoyed a rare moment of solitude when they visited a water hole at the bottom of Uluru, walking along a tree-lined track ahead of their Aboriginal guide, aides and police bodyguards.

Tour guide John Sweeney, who accompanied Aboriginal guide Sammy Wilson, said: 'We let them have a bit of time to themselves, pretty

rare on a trip like this.

'Sammy told them the ancestral story, which relates to how this part of Uluru was formed. Sammy showed the cave painting that his grandfather did, which was one of the last paintings done at Uluru.

'They were very interested in everything that was said. They were an absolute pleasure. They apologised for not bringing the baby. Sammy said it was all right - he could come back later on.'

'special place'

Vincent Nipper, 35, whose grandparents met Charles and Diana in 1983, said: 'It is really important for them to come to a special place like this. I am really happy to meet them and that they have come here.

'Thirty years ago his parents came here. They were over the other side of the rock and they met my grandfather and my grandmother. I am told that they felt it was really special. They said they must come back and bring their son back here. I am glad he was able to come back like his parents said he would.'

The royal couple watched a welcoming dance from several elderly bare-chested Aboriginal women at the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre before receiving gifts from local artists.

Kate was given a necklace, made from nuts and seeds found in the desert, which she wore for most of the day.

The trip to Uluru had started with a visit to the National Indigenous Training Academy, the

Duchess wearing an oatmeal Roksanda Ilincic dress and LK Bennett heels. There, the flies had got the better of Kate, one landing on her nose as she met a young local girl.

The royal couple were presented with gifts from the academy, including a hand-painted bracelet, traditional hunting spear, wooden bowl, clapping sticks - a percussion instrument - and a small kangaroo-hair blanket.

glamping

Kate seemed pleased with her bracelet, putting it on immediately and marvelling at the detail that went into it.

Later the couple indulged in a bit of glamping - sleeping out under the stars at a luxury campsite so that they could experience Uluru at sunrise before flying to Adelaide on the next leg of their trip.

Earlier in the day the couple took part in an Aborigine Welcome to Country ceremony at Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre.

After meeting elders from the Anangu people of Uluru, they gathered around a camp fire to watch the Inma ritual which incorporates traditional clapping sticks.

The royals later spoke to

several young people who were part of the ceremony, good naturedly posing for pictures with several teenage girls.

And Chevez Kirkman, 15, who excels in maths

and sport at Nyangatjatjara College, was asked by Prince William if he followed an English soccer side.

When Chevez said no, the Duke suggested his

own side, saying, 'If you were to have one, maybe Aston Villa would be a good one.'

The Duke is known to be a keen supporter of the Midlands side.

Camilla mourns after sudden death of brother

CAMILLA, Duchess of Cornwall, was said to be 'devastated' by the freak death of her beloved brother in New York this week.

Mark Shand, the brother of Prince Charles' wife, was in New York for a charity auction at Sotheby's and had arrived at the Gramercy Park Hotel's Rose Bar just before 1 a.m.

Wednesday accompanied by a relative, police said. He went out to smoke a cigarette around 2:30 a.m. and fell backward as he tried to re-enter through a revolving door, they said.

He was taken to a hospital, where he was pronounced dead at 11:25 a.m., police said. The cause of his death

will be determined by the medical examiner's office.

New York Police Department detectives were at the Manhattan hotel on Wednesday afternoon, taking a look

at the locations of security cameras. A worker at a building across the street said detectives had asked if the building had any security video, which it didn't.

A call to the hotel's representatives was not immediately returned.

Shand was chairman of an elephant conservation charity and was known for his work as a travel writer and conservationist. He was the author of several books including "Elephant Tales" and "River Dog: A Journey Down the Brahmaputra."

British royal officials at Clarence House said in a statement that Camilla, Prince Charles and all of her family members are "utterly devastated by this sudden and tragic loss."

"Mark Shand was a man of extraordinary vitality, a tireless campaigner and conservationist whose incredible work through The Elephant Family and beyond remained his focus right up until his death," it said.

Sotheby's said it was "deeply saddened" by the news of Shand's death and it was honored to have helped him raise money for his causes.

Camilla and Charles are due to go on a tour of Canada next month.

A hearse arrived just before 1pm carrying her coffin, which was painted sky blue with clouds and flowers along the side. In a fitting tribute, the coffin featured an illustration of the doting wife and mother-of-two with her family and pets.

Joining her father Sir Bob Geldof and sisters Fifi, Pixie and Tiger at the funeral service held at St Mary Magdalene and St Lawrence church in Kent were a host of celebrities including Kate Moss, Nick Grimshaw, Eliza Doolittle, Alexa Chung, Jaime Winstone, Trudie Styler, Mariella Frostrup, Jo Wood, Billy Wyman, Sarah Ferguson and Razorlight frontman Johnny Borrell.

The model and journalist was found dead at her home on April 7. A cause of death has yet to be determined.

Boy jailed for 'campaign of rape' against sister, 9

A teenage boy who carried out a "campaign of rape" against his younger sister has been given a 10-year custodial sentence.

The boy was 13 and his sister was nine when he began attacking her between 2008 and 2011.

He raped her more than 50 times and made threats to stop her telling

people, Lincoln Crown Court heard.

The attacks ended when the boy, now 18 and from South Lincolnshire, formed a sexual relationship with another girl.

Sentencing the teenager to 10 years in a young offenders' institution, Recorder Gareth Evans QC told

him: "This was akin to a campaign of rape.

"You caused her physical and mental anguish which must have been obvious.

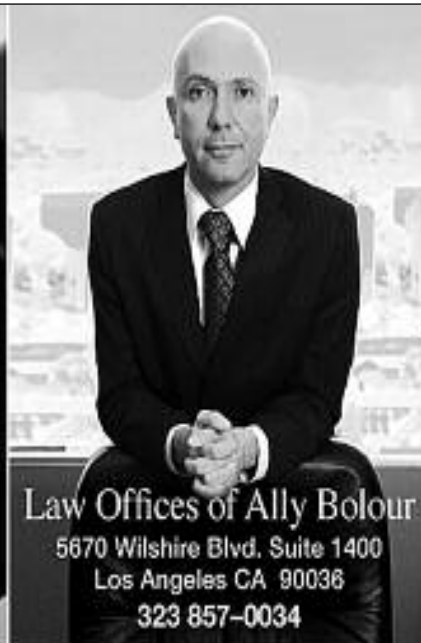
"Her innocence was taken away in the very place she should have found safe - her home."

A jury found him guilty of six charges of rape.

Costa living turns sour for countless Brits in Spain

■ Almost 90,000 flee country as Spanish dreams shrivel in the sun

THE dream of living in the Mediterranean is over for almost 90,000 British expats, who have abandoned Spain after the Eurozone crisis hit the country.

Tens of thousands flocked from Spain last year, as a shrinking jobs market and a property slump contributed to the exodus of Britons.

It is the second year in a row Spain's population has been reduced by

departing British expats, with almost one in four leaving the country.

Jackie Miles, 48, is among the Britons who moved from Spain in 2013, when she left with her two children and husband for Dubai. She said: "We had been in Spain for 13 years and loved it, but like many other British people we had to find work and it just wasn't possible any longer in our part of Andalusia."

The figures have been revealed by Spain's National Statistics Institute.

In January 2013 there were 385,179 British expats living in Spain but that slumped to 297,229, a drop of 23 per cent, in December.

The number of Germans living in Spain also dropped by 23.6 per cent, while the amount of French expats fell by 12.7 per cent.

Maura Hillen is

chairman of AUAN, a group that campaigns for British homeowners caught in a property scandal in Spain.

She said: "There is a wider trend of Britons leaving.

"People who retired out here in their 50s and 60s have seen their circumstances change.

"Advancing age, losing a partner and the rise in the cost of living make life here less attractive."

London's Gherkin skyscraper is set to be auctioned off later this year after lenders appointed receivers to the iconic City building today.

The tower, formally known as 30 St Mary's Axe, was at one time the UK's most expensive

office when German bank IVG and private equity firm Evans Randall bought it for £630 million from original owner Swiss Re at the top of the market in 2007.

But the financial crisis sent its value plunging and the buyers defaulted on a £400 million loan

from a five-bank consortium in 2009. Part of the loan was also made in Swiss francs, increasing the burden on the borrowers as the currency soared against the pound.

But recovering property markets and huge demand for assets in the capital have

boosted sale prospects for the Gherkin, prompting lenders to bring in Deloitte as receivers. It is understood a sale is likely within months.

One senior property source put the value of the Gherkin at close to £600 million and said it would attract interest from a host of international and domestic buyers. He said: "This is a trophy product.

Values for prime assets are approaching the levels we saw at the peak of the market."

Potential buyers include Chinese insurer Ping An, which bought the Lloyd's Building for £260 million last year.

The Gherkin was commissioned by Swiss Re to replace the Baltic Exchange, damaged by an IRA bomb in 1992. Architects Foster and

Partners designed the building, which would become one of the design companies most famous creations.

Work on the construction began in 2001 and the Gherkin opened three years later, with more than 76,500 square metres of commercial space including a club on the top floor with panoramic views.

Rangers legend Jardine dead at 65

Former Rangers, Hearts and Scotland defender Sandy Jardine has died at the age of 65.

Rangers confirmed that Jardine had lost an 18-month battle against cancer on Thursday evening.

He was part of their European Cup Winners' Cup-winning team of 1972 and played 38 times for his country.

Ibrox manager Ally McCoist said everyone at Rangers was devastated at the loss of "a legend" and "a great man".

And the club said their thoughts were with his wife Shona, children Steven and Nicola, his grandchildren and friends.

Hearts also extended their condolences to his family, with the Tynecastle club adding they were deeply saddened at the death of a club legend.

Edinburgh-born Jardine began his career with Rangers in 1965 and went on to make over 600 appearances for the Ibrox side.

As well as playing in the club's European triumph in 1972, the full-back won three top-flight titles, five Scottish Cups and five Scottish League Cups with Rangers.

A move to Hearts followed in 1982 and, along with former Rangers team-mate Alex MacDonald, he was joint-manager at Tynecastle between 1986 and 1988.

After his playing career ended, he returned to work for Rangers in various roles. In November 2012, it was confirmed Jardine was being treated for cancer.

"He was respected not only by Rangers fans but also the wider football community and he is a huge loss to the game," McCoist said on Rangers' website.

Just like Wimbledon! Andy Murray is honored...and breaks down in tears

ANDY Murray was overcome with emotion this week as he was presented with the Freedom of Stirling, in scenes reminiscent of his post-Wimbledon tears.

The tennis star was awarded the honour at his old school, Dunblane High.

But the emotional event all got a bit too much for the 26-year-old, who had to pause several times to wipe away tears.

Two years ago, Murray gave a similarly teary interview following his Wimbledon final defeat to Roger Federer.

However, he soon bounced back to win Olympic gold at London 2012 before going on to break Britain's long wait for a Wimbledon champion last summer.

'emotional'

After receiving today's award, Murray spoke to the audience and said: "I'm going to keep this very short because there's a good chance I'll get emotional.

"It feels good to be home."

After pausing to wipe his eyes he went on: "I'd like to thank the council for voting me in, I was expecting a few nos.

"I'd like to thank all my family and friends and girlfriend for coming to support me."

He apologised as he took another break, before being given a standing ovation as he said: "I think everyone knows I'm extremely proud of where I come from.

"It means a lot to me so thanks to everyone for coming along and I apologise for this behaviour."

He later explained why he became so emotional,

adding: "I don't get the chance to come back that often and I don't get the chance to see my family as much as I would like and I'm very proud of where I come from. So to get this honour from my local council means a lot.

"I don't think anyone would have really expected it - tennis players don't really come from Scotland, so it's a strange story, but proves that anything can happen if you believe and you dream and work hard, then you can achieve whatever you want to, so it's a nice story."

Bagpipes accompanied Murray's entrance as he arrived at the school's 'Murray Hall' with his girlfriend Kim Sears.

The Olympic gold medallist admitted that he did not actually know what the Freedom of the City afforded him.

He said: "I've read a bit about it on the internet. I don't know exactly what it lets me do but I don't think I can do anything different to anyone else.

"It's amazing, it doesn't happen that often, so it shows the support from the public, which has been unbelievable."

He was later advised the honour would now mean he had permission to drive a flock of sheep down the city's high street.

'buzzing'

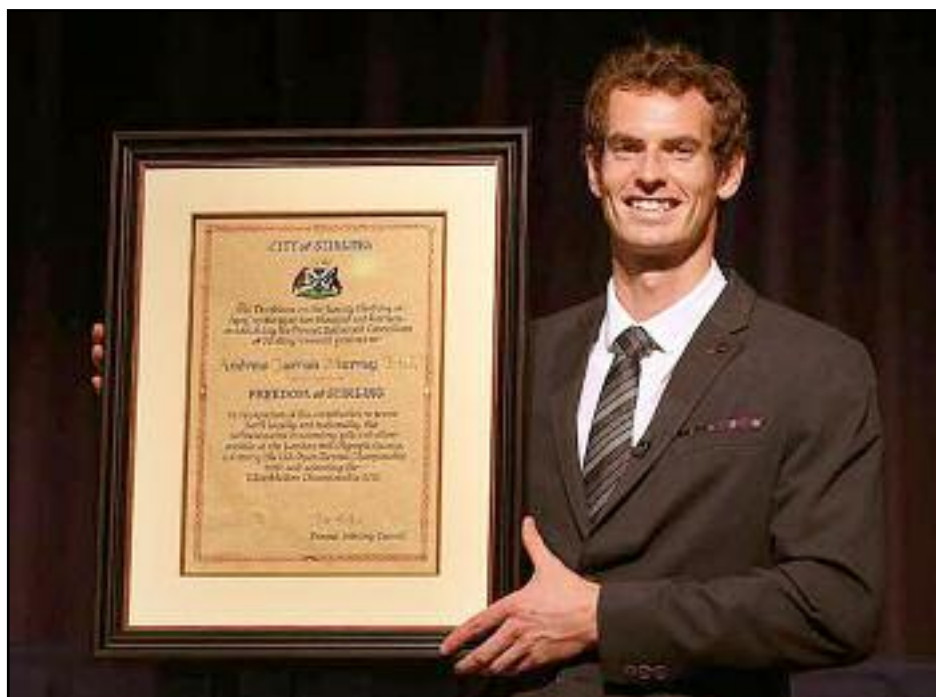
He joked: "I don't think it's the case anymore but I might give it a go this evening and see what happens."

As he left, Murray paused to chat with pupils, sign autographs and even posed for a 'selfie' with a student.

Alex McRae, a sixth year pupil at the school, said: "Everyone here is behind Andy at all his

events so it was brilliant to meet him.

"He was overwhelmed by the people who came to see him and it was emotional for him.

"There's swimmers, footballers and tennis players in the school and I think everyone has been motivated by what he said.

"He even asked us about our exams and personal lives. He took a real interest and it just shows that he's a nice guy."

The Freedom of Stirling has only been granted on

four other occasions.

It was decided that Murray would receive the honour in 2012, after his stunning performance in the London Olympics and first Grand Slam win at the US Open later that year.

But the star's intensive training and competition schedule meant it could only be awarded now.

Stirling Provost Mike Robbins said: "Everybody is buzzing about today's special ceremony. There's always a lot of interest and excitement whenever

Andy comes home, and we're delighted to welcome him back.

"We hope that today's very special event will inspire young people to get into sports and lead healthy and active lifestyles."

He bestowed the Freedom of the City on Murray, saying: "I now formally present Andy with the scroll which confers upon him the freedom of the city of Stirling, here in Dunblane, and, from one Dunblane person to another, I'm delighted."

Hypnotic Hardy keeps us 'Locked' into compelling and daring new British film

When I first heard about LOCKE, I had no idea what to expect from writer/director Steven Knight.

A man in a car? Driving? Alone? The whole concept may have some thinking "what the hell can you do with that?" but Knight defies any expectations, mesmerizing the viewer with both character and cinematography. The car, of course is a touchstone of the world today where so much of our individual and collective lives are lived and from Ivan Locke's first phone call, we are captivated.

And then we see Tom Hardy give a *tour de force* performance in what is essentially a one-man show in a single location movie. Hardy plays Locke as a man at the pinnacle of his trade, on the biggest day of his professional life. A strong, confident man, Locke is a construction foreman and also a devoted husband and loving father. Doing everything right is of the utmost importance to him. He carries that with him in life and at work, reinforcing those beliefs on the eve of the biggest job of his life.

One night stand

A 55-storey building, the tallest in the British Isles, is having its concrete foundation poured in the morning. One bad pour, one runny slurry, an improper grade of cement to cut costs, and that building will eventually topple. Much like life. Needing everything to go

smoothly, Locke has thoroughly prepared for the event. The one thing he didn't prepare for, however, was a telephone call from his one-time site assistant with whom he had a one-night stand and now, nine months later, she calls to say she is giving birth to his child and she needs him to come to the hospital; now.

Most men would dismiss the call and focus their attention on the matters at hand. But Ivan Locke isn't just any man. He will maintain control and handle it all; even if that means turning the morning concrete pour over to his less experienced assistant, even if it means disappointing his two sons and a tradition of watching football together, even if it means confessing to his wife about his one-time indiscretion, even if it means losing his job. He is Ivan Locke. He is the foundation of his world. He will be strong. He will not crumble. Or will he?

Which he is why he is tooling down the M1 in the dead of night in his bells-and-whistles-laden BMW, heading for the London hospital where his lapse in judgement is about to come to term.

panic

With a steady stream of phone calls, Locke starts juggling all the balls amidst the darkness of night with the only light being the brightly lit bluetooth dashboard display within the car, at times his best friend, at others, his worst nightmare. Problems mount with the job and his assistant Donal. Histrionic panic sets in with mother-to-be

Bethan. Anger rages with his wife Katrina. Sadness fills his sons. And we are there in the car with Locke with only the faceless voices as company, telling the story of a man's life.

As Ivan Locke, Tom Hardy is in control, commanding, a man reigning over a crumbling dominion but determined to steer the ship to where he wants it. The calm of Hardy is imposing, at times almost threatening. You are waiting for him to snap, to bend, to break. Yet the only time he does is with himself. He never lets any chink in his armor be heard in his voice when speaking with others. The building is a metaphor for Locke himself. He is the solid secure foundation for all those around him.

inky night sky

Written and directed by Steven Wright, the construct of Locke fascinates, starting with the premise of shooting at night and the brilliance of cinematographer Haris Zambarloukos.

Night shoots - on clean freeways that skirt majestic cities ablaze with lights against an inky night sky - have the capacity for gorgeous lensing and that's precisely what Zambarloukos gives us. The play of lights, the blur and distortion, the color of tail-lights, signal lights, tinged yellow lights from buildings, the misty halogen pallor of street lamps. They all mesmerize under Zambarloukos' lens. The result is visually stunning, three dimensional and like Hardy's performance, prove totally hypnotic.

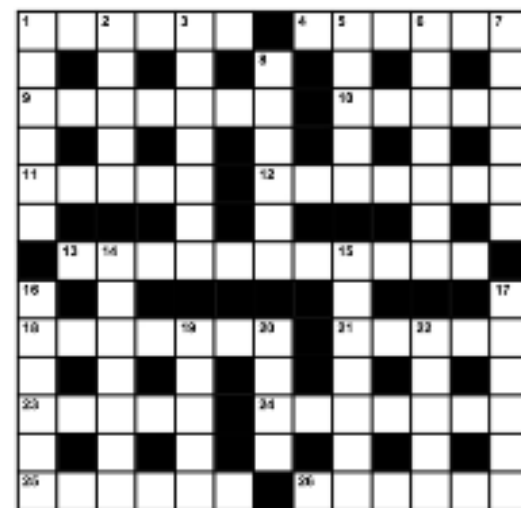

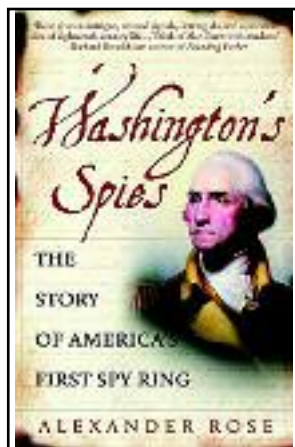
Time to 'Turn'? 'Washington's Spies' sparks AMC show

■ Exclusive interview with author Alexander Rose about his book *Washington's Spies*, the basis for the AMC television series *Turn*

Rating: ★★★

"Barry Josephson, the producer (of the AMC mini-series *Turn*) contacted me from out of the blue about three years ago," says *Washington's Spies* author Alex Rose.

"Barry and Craig Silverstein invited me along to watch the pilot being filmed down in Virginia, which was very exciting. I spent two weeks down there, seeing how the sausage gets made. It was quite fascinating, especially for



a writer more accustomed to working alone in an archive."

Washington's Spies is a factual book not a historical novel. Washington used a handful of rebels acting as spies although spycraft hadn't yet been refined and these early American spies made many mistakes, some fatal. The British spies were no better. Major John Andre, when captured by the

Americans, revealed the fact that Washington's star general Benedict Arnold was a traitor.

In the summer of 1778 General George Washington needed to know where the British would strike next. Washington's goal was to find out as much as he could about what General Henry Clinton was doing and stop him. He enlisted a group of loyal Americans who later become known at the Culper Ring comprising, among others, a Quaker torn between family loyalty and political principle, a sailor who was a thrill junkie, a party boy, an Ivy League-educated cavalryman who was a friend of Nathan Hale, and a peaceful farmer who wanted nothing more than to retire, but couldn't. The spies

operated in British-occupied New York.

An academic book, *Washington's Spies* is not a novel and Rose doesn't give dialog, but does use lots of quotes from correspondence. It explores the relationship between Washington and his spies. Rose talks about the technical aspects of Culpers' spycraft including using invisible ink and cryptography and the footnotes make for fascinating reading of anecdotal details. At the end of the book Rose traces the people's lives and their deaths after the war.

Rose says choosing the Culper Ring was an accident. "I was reading a biography of Benedict Arnold and I became interested in the wider espionage angle during

the Revolution. It turned out much, against my expectations, that hardly anything had been written on the subject. So then it was a matter of finding the right story to hang it on, which is where the Culper Ring came in."

Rose spent a great deal of time poring through the Culper Ring correspondence and trying to read their handwriting.

"All the Culper letters are lodged in the George Washington Papers at the Library of Congress," says Rose. "Anyone can go see them, or at least consult them online."

For this season, Rose has been serving as a consultant on the AMC series. "I go over the scripts and make suggestions," says Rowe, "but it's up to the writers what to do from there. As

for the look of the show, that's nothing to do with me; that's the work of the brilliant costume, props, construction, and special-effects people. They're the ones who brought the series to life."

Ramires to miss rest of season

Chelsea midfielder Ramires will miss the rest of the Premier League season after accepting a charge of violent conduct.

The Brazilian was sanctioned following an off-the-ball incident involving Sebastian Larsson during his side's 2-1 defeat by Sunderland on Saturday.

The 27-year-old will serve a four-match ban after a review panel decision.

Manager Jose Mourinho and assistant Rui Faria are also subject to Football Association charges from the match.

Ramires elbowed Larsson towards the end of the first half at Stamford Bridge, a few moments after the Sunderland midfielder had barged him off the ball in front of goal.

The incident was later reviewed by a panel of former referees, and Ramires will now miss Chelsea's remaining Premier League fixtures this term - against Liverpool, Norwich and Cardiff - as well as their

first game of next season.

He is, however, eligible for the second leg of Chelsea's Champions League semi-final against Atletico Madrid next Wednesday.

Mourinho refused to take questions after the defeat to bottom club Sunderland, which ended his unbeaten Premier League home record as Chelsea manager.

However, he congratulated both referee Mike Dean for his performance, which he described as "unbelievable", and Mike Riley, head of refereeing

body Professional Game Match Officials Limited, in a television interview.

With three games left, they top the Premier League table and need seven points to be

crowned champions. "It has always been tougher in the transfer market when you are not competing at the highest level," said Ayre.

"We have always been fortunate to be able to bring great players here despite that, but there is no question it opens up a few doors for us and makes it a little bit easier.

"There is no question we always expected that the squad we need for next season will be very different to the squad that we have needed for this year when we were not playing in Europe."

It is likely that Liverpool's main focus will be on defensive reinforcements.

Moyes hits back!

- Glazers fly in as United come under attack
- Club branded 'unprofessional' by LMA

SACKED Manchester United boss David Moss ensured his departure from Old Trafford would be less than cordial when he pointedly refused to thank his former players and was then caught up in a furious war of words with the club about his controversial sacking.

As three members of the Glazer family, United's American owners, prepared to fly in for a Friday summit meeting, the bitter fall-out from the Moyes affair gathered momentum.

Moyes thanked Sir Alex Ferguson, his coaching staff and the fans but significantly made no mention of the players, who he feels let him down.

And League Managers' Association chief executive Richard Bevan accused United of being "unprofessional" by leaking reports of Moyes' departure before informing him he was fired.

"The LMA is very disappointed with the nature of David's departure from Manchester United,

and to read extensive reports in the press confirming David's sacking before David himself had been spoken to officially by the club," said Bevan.

"Throughout his time at United, David, as he always does, has conducted himself with integrity and professionalism, values that he believes in and that have been strongly associated with the club and its rich tradition.

"It is therefore sad to see the end of David's tenure being handled in an unprofessional manner."

United hit back by insisting the final decision to dispense with Moyes was not taken until late on Monday evening. "We do not accept it was handled in an unprofessional manner," said a spokesman.

Moyes, alarmed by speculation on newspaper websites that he was facing the sack, spoke to executive vice-chairman Ed Woodward on Monday afternoon, but Woodward could not confirm he was out of a job because conversations with the

Glazers continued until late in the evening.

Moyes' fate was only officially confirmed when he met Woodward face-to-face at Carrington training ground early on Tuesday morning.

In a statement he admitted the job was "a significant challenge" and accepted results and performances had not been "what United and its fans are used to or expect", saying: "I both understand and share their frustration."

Holland coach Louis Van Gaal, keen to return to club football after the World Cup in Brazil, remains favourite but United have not ruled out Carlo Ancelotti, well aware he could be fired by Real Madrid if they fail to win either the Champions League or La Liga.

The Glazers will also meet interim manager Ryan Giggs to offer the club's longest-serving player their full support ahead of his four-game spell in charge and will stay to watch Saturday's home game against Norwich.

Klopp rules out move from Dortmund

Jurgen Klopp has ruled himself out of contention to become the next manager of Manchester United.

The 46-year-old Borussia Dortmund coach (right) had been among the leading candidates to replace David Moyes, who was sacked by United on Tuesday.

"I find it a little uncomfortable having to



turn somebody down without them making an enquiry," Klopp said.

"But it seems like I have got to do it anyway. There are about 1,000 reasons why I'm so happy to be working here."

Klopp has won the Bundesliga title twice with Dortmund since he replaced Thomas Doll as manager in 2008. He also guided them to last season's Champions League final, in which they lost to Bayern Munich.

Klopp extended his Dortmund contract until 2018 in October last year and said that, although United are a "really great club", he is not tempted to leave Westphalia for Old Trafford. "I'm still really happy here," the German added.
