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JURY SWORN IN FOR ROLF HARRIS TRIAL

■ Veteran entertainer faces 12 counts of indecent assault in cases dating back to the 1960s

Twelve jurors have been sworn in ahead of the trial of Rolf Harris at Southwark Crown Court on a string of indecent assault charges.

Harris, 84, was in court for Thursday's procedure and was accompanied by his wife of 55 years Alwen Hughes, daughter Bindi, with whom he arrived holding hands, and other family and friends.

Trial judge Mr Justice Sweeney told the jurors the long-standing show business star faced charges dating from between 1968 to 1986 with some evidence from events in Australia and New Zealand.

Harris is accused of 12 counts of indecent assault on four girls, the youngest of whom was seven or eight and the oldest 19. He has already pleaded not guilty at an earlier hearing.

single charge

Seven of the charges are related to one girl aged between 12 and 19 years old and took place between 1978 to 1985.

Three regard a

14-year-old girl and are said to have taken place in 1986, while the other two are single charges concerning a girl aged seven or eight years old, who claims to have been assaulted between 1968 to 1970.

The other single charge is also on a then 14-year-old girl, who the prosecution say was targeted between 1975 and 1976.

Harris, famous for his songs, cartoons and TV shows, stood as the charges against him were listed.

Mr Justice Sweeney warned the jury of six men and six women not to research anything about the case or discuss it on any forms of social media, reminding them of a previous case where a juror had been jailed for doing so.

Before discharging them until Friday, when the case is due to begin,

he said: "You know very little about the case but you will know a great deal more of what the allegations are tomorrow morning."

huge interest

Afterwards Harris left in a silver people carrier surrounded by security staff.

The case at Southwark Crown Court is expected to last until the end of June.

Harris, who was born in Perth, Australia, has lived in the Berkshire village of Bray for more than 50 years and his trial has attracted huge interest not only in this country but also his country of birth.

Also famous as an artist, Harris painted a portrait of the Queen in 2005 and hosted her Diamond Jubilee concert in front of Buckingham Palace two years ago.

His first hit was Tie Me Kangaroo Down Sport in 1960 and his 40-year music career included the UK number one Two

Little Boys.

His lengthy career has seen him receive a number of honours including Officer of the Order of Australia in the Queen's Birthday Honours of 2012. He also has an MBE awarded in 1968, advanced to an OBE in 1977 and then further to a CBE eight years ago.

Police chief defends Adams arrest

■ Top NI cop dismisses allegations of 'dark forces'

Northern Ireland's chief constable has defended his officers' decision to arrest and question Gerry Adams over the Sinn Féin president's alleged role in the kidnapping, killing and secret burial of Jean McConville.

Matt Baggott said on Tuesday that it was both "unfair" and "inappropriate" for Adams and his supporters to claim there were "dark" elements opposed to the peace process behind his detention.

The head of the Police Service of Northern Ireland said: "The arrest and questioning of Mr Adams was legitimate and lawful and an independent judge subsequently decided that there were grounds for further detention."

Adams was arrested last Wednesday and held until Sunday night for questioning about his alleged role in one of the most notorious murders during the Troubles. McConville, 37, a Protestant-born Catholic convert, was dragged away in front of her children at their home in the Divis flats complex in west Belfast in 1972, driven across the border to the Irish Republic, shot in the head at a remote

coastal spot in County Louth, and then buried in secret. She became the most famous of the "disappeared" – 16 IRA victims shot and buried at secret locations across Ireland during the Troubles.

political crisis

Baggott, who retires from the most challenging job in UK policing after the summer, said it had been wrong of Sinn Féin to question "the motivation or impartiality of police officers tasked with investigating serious crime in this very public, generalised and vague manner".

The deputy first minister of Northern Ireland and Adams's

closest colleague within Sinn Féin, Martin McGuinness, had spoken of "dark forces" within the police and even on Friday appeared to hint that the party would withdraw its support for policing while his leader remained in custody.

After his release on Sunday evening, Adams attempted to defuse a potential political crisis by stating at a rally in west Belfast that he and his party still supported the PSNI.

Peter Robinson, the first minister at Stormont, said earlier on Tuesday that he had been prepared to risk breaking up the power-sharing government in Belfast if Sinn Féin had removed its

support for the PSNI. Sinn Féin's support for the police at the 2006 St Andrews agreement was one of the key foundation stones of the deal that led to the once unthinkable government that included the party and the Democratic Unionists the following year.

acrimony

The DUP leader said that in the absence of Sinn Féin's support for policing, his party would have put forward a motion to exclude the republican party from the Northern Ireland executive.

"We would not be slow in bringing forward a motion for their exclusion," Robinson said.

"Indeed, if Sinn Féin had not corrected their position, the motion would have gone down."

Such a move would have triggered the collapse of the devolved administration because Sinn Féin – and possibly also the rival nationalist SDLP – would have been able to use a veto in the regional parliament to stop the exclusion motion. In turn this would have resulted in a breakup of the fragile power-sharing coalition between unionists and nationalists.

However, the acrimony between Sinn Féin and the DUP has not dissipated. Robinson also questioned whether McGuinness had compromised his position because he said the code of

office for the first and deputy first minister required their full support of the police and the judicial system in Northern Ireland. Relations between the two leaders of unionism and nationalism are currently described by sources at Stormont as "arctic".

Meanwhile dissident republican sources told a British newspaper that there is no threat to the lives of Adams or one of his chief lieutenants in the republican movement, Bobby Storey.

The Sinn Féin leader revealed that the PSNI had informed him via his wife that there was a death threat from "criminal elements" against him and also directed at Storey.

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Maddy search focused on three main dig sites

■ Progress being made but tensions remain between local authorities and Met officers probing the 2007 disappearance

Scotland Yard detectives are in Portugal to oversee the excavation of a number of sites as part of the investigation into the disappearance of Madeleine McCann.

The digs for evidence are set to take place at three principal locations around the resort in Praia da Luz where the youngster vanished in 2007.

Scotland Yard detectives believe the sites were not properly explored at the time of

her disappearance.

One is a road just below the apartment block where trenches were dug before Madeleine went missing, that were filled in the day after she vanished.

excavations

There is a waste ground to the side of the apartment block where a man was seen carrying a child, according to some witnesses, soon after Madeleine disappeared.

And there is the beach

area where over the years there have been reports of activity, of people seen there acting suspiciously.

British detectives have been meeting their Portuguese counterparts, and forensics officers are due to use ground-penetrating radar equipment to aid the search at the three sites.

It is not known exactly when the excavations will begin.

Madeleine disappeared from the

apartment she was staying in with her parents and two siblings on May 3, 2007. She was three years old at the time.

Officers from the Metropolitan Police have also identified three potential suspects they want to talk to, not necessarily concerning Madeleine's disappearance, but who had been involved in break-ins in the area and who they believe may have vital information about the missing girl

leaks

However, they have reportedly been refused permission by Portuguese authorities to search the homes of these burglary suspects,

who used to work at the Ocean Complex at the time Madeleine vanished.

A local British reporter in Praia da Luz, said: "That's a blow for Scotland Yard," before adding that disagreements over leaks to the media may delay British police in their efforts to scour areas they will be given access to.

"I'm not sure that those searches are going to begin quite so quickly," he said.

"The Portuguese are making it very clear that they were not happy with journalists being briefed. It's not something that happens in this country and in fact, the Portuguese

authorities, according to the Scotland Yard message...

had threatened to stop any of the work once it begins if they hear that Scotland Yard are talking to reporters, or indeed if reporters are in any way disrupting the work.

"I get a sense that because of this developing row, that may put off what is going to happen soon, but maybe not in the next couple of days as we anticipated."

Kate McCann said last week, on the seventh anniversary of her daughter's disappearance, that she needed to know what happened - even if it was the "worst-case scenario".

Team Scotland 'could be ready for Rio'

There is "no obvious or major barrier" to a Scottish team taking part in the 2016 Rio Olympics if the country votes for independence, according to a report issued on Thursday.

A group chaired by former Labour first minister Henry McLeish found there were various practical measures which would have to be undertaken for Team Scotland to take part in the Olympics and Paralympics, but that they were "achievable".

It urged the Scottish Government to have early talks with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and International Paralympic Committee (IPC), in the event of independence, to demonstrate Scotland's "readiness to engage in the Olympic and Paralympic movement".

The Working Group on Scottish Sport was appointed in September to examine the development of sport in an independent Scotland.

Over six months, the group considered a range of topics including the action required to ensure Scotland can be successful in future

Olympics and Paralympics in its own right, and the steps required to ensure it remains a country of "sporting excellence".

In a 53-page report, the group concluded: "Although the final decision on whether Scotland could compete at a future Olympic and Paralympic Games rests with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and the International Paralympic Committee (IPC), upon reviewing the process, examining precedent and looking at our own state of readiness, the group concluded that there was no obvious or major barrier to securing Olympic and Paralympic accreditation for an independent Scotland in time to compete in Rio 2016."

The report said Scotland has a "strong track record of competing successfully internationally" and stated: "There are a number of practical arrangements the Scottish Government would have to undertake in order to secure Olympic and Paralympic accreditation and the group have

provided detailed recommendations on this, such as the establishment of a National Olympic Committee.

"Beyond the specific Olympic and Paralympic activity, there are a number of actions currently undertaken at a UK level that would need to be worked through in the event of Scotland becoming independent (such as developing an anti-doping structure and policy, developing a framework for coaching, developing capacity within Scottish Governing Bodies of sport etc).

"In the group's view, all of these are achievable with appropriate resources to support this."

In the event of independence, athletes could choose whether they wanted to compete for Scotland or Great Britain, the report suggested.

It said: "The Olympic charter states that a '...competitor who is a national of two or more countries at the same time may represent either one of them, as he [or she] may elect'.

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Shamed BBC presenter Hall facing new rape charges

Broadcaster Stuart Hall groomed two schoolgirls and raped them in his BBC dressing room – one of them at least 30 times, a court heard on Wednesday.

Hall plied one youngster with alcohol before raping her and sometimes gave her £20 afterwards, telling her ‘treat yourself’, it was alleged.

Another girl was raped in his marital home where he took cuttings of her pubic hair to use as a ‘sexual trophy’, the jury was told.

Peter Wright QC, prosecuting, said: ‘Such “trophies” speak volumes, we say, as to the nature of the relationship that existed between them.’

‘His sole concern was self-gratification. She

was, we say, his “toy”, to be used and abused as he saw fit.’

‘very intoxicated’

Hall, now 84, first raped girl A in his dressing room at the BBC in Manchester, some time between January 1976 and April 1977, when she was 14, jurors at Preston crown court heard

After filming, Hall took her to his dressing

room and plied her with alcohol until she was ‘very intoxicated’, Mr Wright said.

At 15 she had become a regular visitor to the studios after school, with the girl estimating he had ‘intercourse with her on at least 30 occasions in such circumstances’.

Girl B’s abuse started when she was 12 and continued until she was 15, jurors heard, and included her being indecently assaulted by Hall in her own bedroom.

sentence

The former *It’s A Knockout* presenter admitted that indecent assault but he said he did so when she was aged 13 or over.

Hall first raped her when she was cleaning stables, the court heard. Mr Wright said: ‘He approached her in the stables, partially removed her clothing and raped her against a

wall.’

She also went to the TV studios and was allegedly raped in his dressing room. Hall’s barrister, Crispin Aylett, said the defendant denied being a rapist ‘whatever his shortcomings, whatever he has done’.

Last year, Hall, from Wilmslow, Cheshire, was jailed for 15 months for

14 offences of indecent assault against 13 girls. His sentence was later extended to 30 months at the Court of Appeal.

In the latest case, he denies 20 charges of rape and indecent assault involving two victims in the 1970s when he was in his mid-40s. He has admitted one count of indecent assault. The trial continues.

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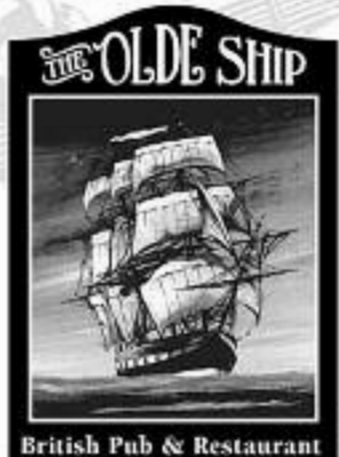


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Playing dress-up: Boy banned from church-run after school club - because he wears dresses

Furious mum Georgina has lodged a complaint with the church claiming they are discriminating against

her son.

Georgina, 36, who has three other children, fumed: ‘I was so cross when I was told he couldn’t wear dresses, I was speechless. All I could ask was “why?”

‘Wearing the dress is his choice and if it makes him happy, it’s fine with me.

‘This is not a case of my son being trapped in a girl’s body, he’s a normal boy who, because he has three big sisters, likes wearing dresses. What is wrong with that?’

‘He is going to be so upset as he loves going to play there.’

Corrie: Hilda Ogden says there's too much sex

'Coronation Street' legend Jean Alexander, who played Hilda Ogden in the ITV soap, has admitted she no longer watches the show because it features too much sex.

The 88-year-old actress played the much-loved, curler-wearing cleaner for 23 years before quitting in 1987 says 'Corrie' has also lost much of its humour.

"The only stories they seem to have in mind is who's jumping into whose bed next. I lost interest somehow," she told *The Mirror*.

"Things have to move on, I know, but in the days of Hilda Ogden, Annie Walker and co, the Street was gentle, funny and

human. The humour has all but gone out of it."

And Jean has ruled out making a return to the cobbles, saying Hilda's character would have to change too much.

"It is more than 25 years since she left the Street and I have been asked a number of times to do an episode but Hilda wouldn't be the 'old scrubber' she was.

"But people would want her to be the old Hilda. I couldn't do that."

"I loved playing Hilda. I never envisaged how iconic she would become, but to be able to make her someone so many people recognised was an honour."

Max Clifford, Britain's best-known publicity agent, has been jailed for eight years for a series of indecent assaults.

The 71-year-old showed no emotion as the judge delivered the sentence last Friday but grimaced and shook his head as details of the offences were read out.

Earlier he was found guilty of eight counts of indecent assault against four women between 1977 and 1984.

Judge Anthony Leonard, at Southwark Crown Court, told Clifford he had led a "double existence", living an outwardly respectable existence while grooming young girls for abuse.

He condemned Clifford for displaying a "contemptuous attitude" during the trial.

The judge singled out one occasion during the trial when Clifford crept up behind a Sky News reporter as he made a report outside court and began mimicking his gestures.

tears

The judge condemned his actions as an attempt to "trivialise the proceedings of this court" and described Clifford's behaviour as "quite extraordinary".

He imposed sentences of up to 24 months on some counts, but ordered some of the punishments to be served consecutively, making a total of eight years.

Some of Clifford's supporters, sitting behind the dock in the public gallery, broke down in tears as he was sentenced.

Clifford was also ordered to pay £55,000 in costs.

Judge Leonard said Clifford's victims believed he was "untouchable" because of his dominant position in the entertainment business and the publicist had traded on this power.

Passing sentence at Southwark Crown Court, the judge told him: "These offences may have taken place a long time ago, when inappropriate and trivial sexual behaviour was more likely to be tolerated, but your offending was not trivial, but of a very serious nature."

'dominant character'

Judge Leonard added that he thought Clifford's personality and position in the public eye were why the crimes had not been made public sooner.

He said: "The reason why they were not brought to light sooner was because of your own dominant character and your position in the world

of entertainment which meant that your victims thought that you were untouchable, something that I think you too believed."

Describing his extensive charitable work, the judge said: "Although your charitable work has gone on for a long time after your offending stopped, I cannot ignore that for decades you were leading a double existence."

At a mitigation hearing earlier in the day the judge told Clifford, who was convicted of eight counts of indecent assault earlier this week, said that if the offences had been committed today he would have been charged with rape and his starting point would be 10 years' imprisonment.

But he added: "My sentencing powers are restricted to what was available at the time, and the maximum was two years in prison."

The most recent offence

committed by the public relations guru was in 1984, just before new legislation introduced tougher punishments for sex offenders.

A type of sex act of which Clifford was convicted "would now be charged as rape", the judge said. Earlier, Clifford claimed he was innocent as he arrived at Southwark Crown Court in south London, saying: "I stand by everything I have said in the last 17 months."

Asked how he was feeling ahead of the sentencing, Mr Clifford added that it was "not the best day of my life".

He continued: "I just have to make the best of what the court gives me.

"It is the same as I have felt since it started 17 months ago, it is like living under a dark cloud.

"It is the same for my family...for my daughter and everyone close to me."

Murder charge for 13-year-old

A 13-year-old boy has become one of the youngest people in British criminal history to be charged with murder.

The teenager, who cannot be named for legal reasons, was charged after a break-in which led to the death of Mark Thomas, 39. The boy remains in custody and was due to appear at Wimbledon Magistrates' Court on Friday after press time.

Mr Thomas was found by police and paramedics with serious injuries at his home in Roehampton, South-West London, on April 22.

A post-mortem examination revealed that he had suffered serious haemorrhaging due to a stab wound to the lung.

A 15-year-old boy has already appeared in court charged with Mr Thomas's murder, while a 17-year-old has been released on bail after being arrested on suspicion of murder.

'good guy'

Last week, Mr Thomas's sister Vyree Thomas Williams, who lives in New York, paid tribute to her brother. She said: 'It's so hard. My brother was hard-working.

'I was proud to call him my brother.

'He was a good guy – he was humble. He wasn't perfect, but he was determined to make it and he gave up everything to be in London to have a better life.'

Detective Chief Inspector Charlie King, of Scotland Yard's Homicide and Major Crime Command, said: 'At this early stage we are keeping an open mind about any possible motive.'

Top Gear host's wife set to drive off with half his fortune

■ ...and she deserves every penny, claims first ex-wife

Jeremy Clarkson's soon-to-be ex-wife "deserves every penny" she can get from his £30 million fortune, his first wife said this week.

Alex Hall, the first wife of the Top Gear presenter, says his current spouse, Frances Clarkson, is the secret to his success and has "done her penance".

The outspoken BBC star is said to be splitting from his wife after 21 years, and Ms Hall said she should receive a large chunk of his fortune.

She told the *Daily Telegraph*: "She's done her penance. It is her hard work that has made him into the idol he is today.

"Jeremy is the frontman but behind the scenes she was the swan paddling frantically beneath the surface.

"So she deserves every penny she gets – she worked for it."

Mrs Clarkson works as his manager and has been instrumental in building his career and so could expect a big portion of his fortune.

News of the impending divorce comes a week after the presenter

"begged forgiveness" for apparently mumbling the N-word while reciting the children's nursery rhyme 'Eeny, meeny, miny, moe', in Top Gear outtakes.

News of the impending divorce emerged on Monday after Mrs Clarkson, 52, was reportedly spotted "toasting the end of her marriage" during a holiday in Majorca with a female friend.

relationship

"Francie had a really jolly, boozy time because she is finally getting a divorce from Jeremy. All her friends have been waiting for years for her to do it and she finally has," a source said. The couple, who have three children, are said to have been living separately for three years.

Clarkson, 54, is alleged to have struck up a relationship with Phillipa Sage, a former beautician who has worked with the Top Gear team as an events organiser. They were first spotted together in 2011 and were photographed kissing on a beach holiday in Greece

last year.

Both parties remained silent this week, with Clarkson's spokesman declining to comment.

Mrs Clarkson said: "I do not want to make a comment at this time."

Miss Hall married Clarkson in 1989 but their union lasted just six months before she ran off with one of his best friends.

Clarkson's fortune has been estimated at £30 million. In 2012, he earned £14 million from Top Gear: £8.4 million for his stake in the programme, a £4.86 million dividend payment plus his £1 million salary.

He is also in demand on the after-dinner speaking circuit, where he can command at least £20,000 for one evening.

The Clarksons have two family homes: a mansion in Chipping Norton, Oxfordshire, where he socialises with David Cameron, and a converted lighthouse on the Isle of Man. Clarkson also has a flat in Fitzrovia, central London.

And then there are the

cars: a 2011 report by hire car firm The City Car Club suggested Clarkson owned a stable of 12 cars including a Lamborghini and an Aston Martin V8 Vantage.

James Maguire, a divorce lawyer of James Maguire & Co, said Mrs Clarkson would be

entitled to take half of her husband's assets.

"The law on divorce now works on a sharing principle which tends to be a 50-50 split," Mr Maguire said.

"With a high value case like the Clarksons, you are looking at sharing the assets."

Author Leslie Thomas dies at 83

■ Bestselling novelist's big success came with *The Virgin Soldiers* in 1966, based on his time spent in national service

The novelist Leslie Thomas, a Barnardo's boy who became a global bestselling author, best known for *The Virgin Soldiers*, has died aged 83.

His wife, Diana, said: "He had a wonderful life and he travelled the world. All he ever wanted to do was write and that is what he did. He died at home with his family around him."

'great characters'

Susan Sandon, managing director at his Penguin Random House publishers, said: "Leslie Thomas was an immensely popular author with a huge gift for storytelling and a wonderful sense of humour.

"His books have given so many people pleasure over the years, with their mix of great characters, strong sense of time and place, and unique ability to combine laughter and

tears in the space of a few sentences."

Although he averaged a book a year for 40 years, nothing matched the success of his 1966 novel, *The Virgin Soldiers*, inspired by his national service in Malaya, which sold 500,000 copies in its first six months.

It became an international best seller, inspired two films, *The Virgin Soldiers* and *Stand Up Virgin Soldiers*, and made Thomas rich and famous. He was awarded an OBE for services to literature in 2004, and once described the book's title as "the best three words I ever wrote".

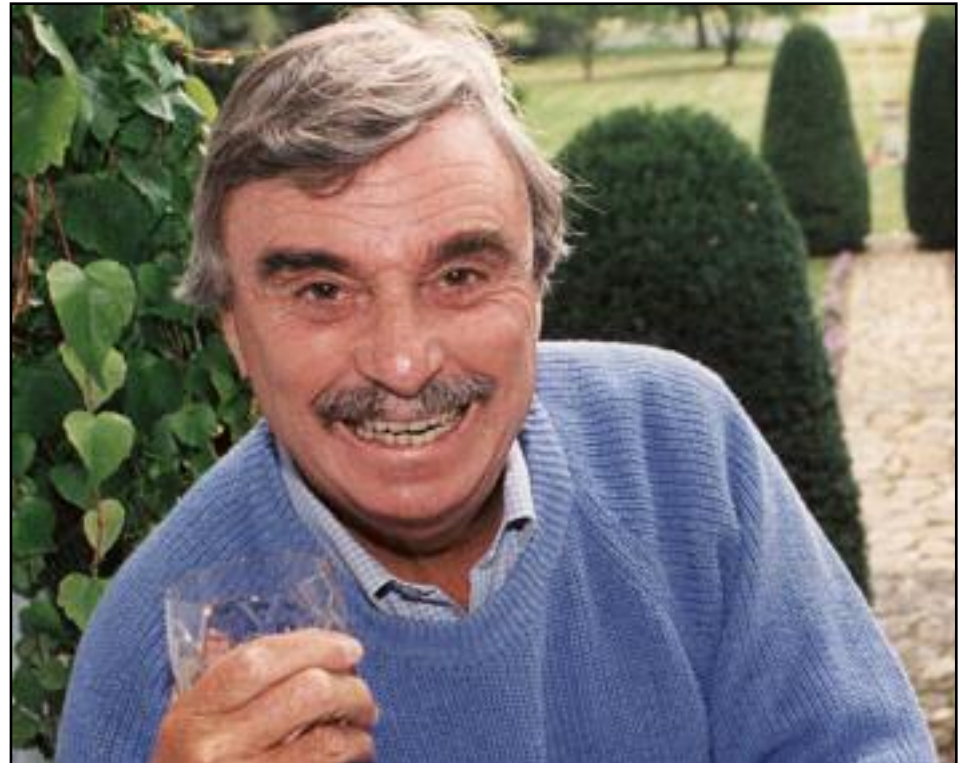

Thomas was brought up in a Barnardo's home after both his parents died young. He later became a patron of the charity, which tweeted on Tuesday night: "Very sad news about the death of author and former

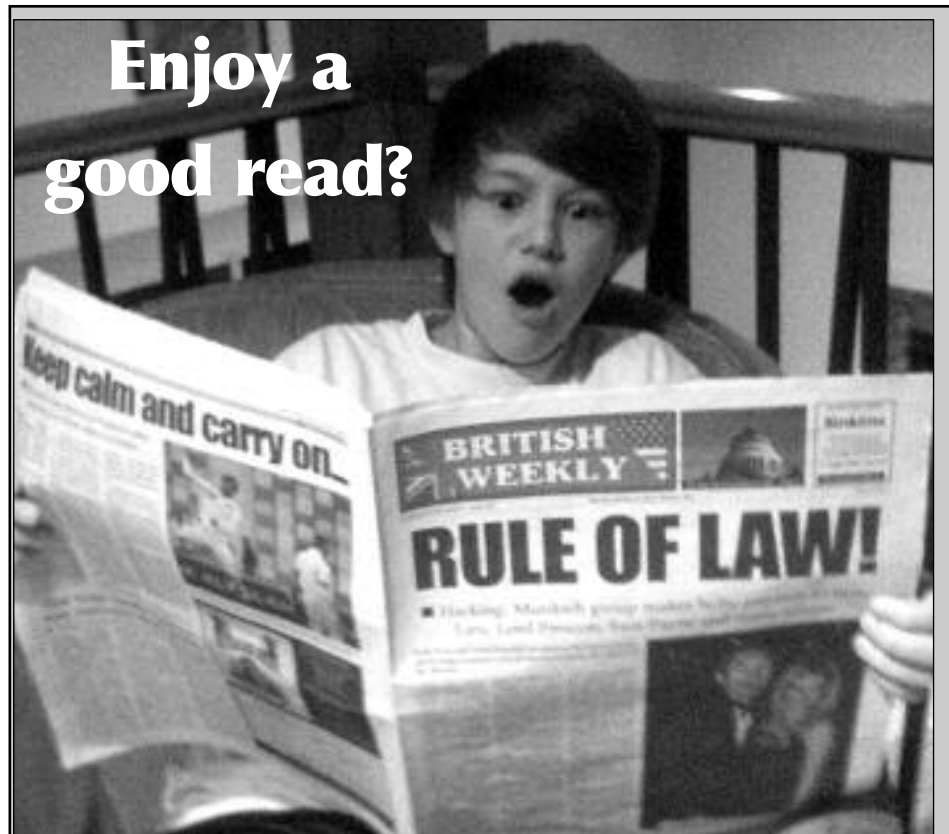
Barnardo's boy Leslie Thomas - our condolences to his family."

He began as a teenage reporter on a newspaper in Essex, before eventually getting to Fleet Street on the *London Evening News*, where he covered international stories including the trial of Adolf Eichmann. His success bought one of the grandest houses in the beautiful Cathedral Close in Salisbury, where his neighbors included the former prime minister Edward Heath.

The author Peter Finch, former chief executive of Literature Wales, said: "He was a super-friendly person. There was no edge to him whatsoever. He was a slightly private person but he was good company. He was a raconteur. That was his strength, which you can tell from the books. He made me laugh, a lot."

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BAFTA honor for veteran star Cilla

Presenter Cilla Black is to be honoured at the upcoming TV Baftas in recognition of her outstanding contribution to entertainment over half a century.

The 70-year-old, who has hosted hugely popular TV shows such as *Surprise Surprise* and *Blind Date* in Britain as well as enjoying a pop career, is to be given the Special Award at the ceremony to mark her years in showbusiness.

She follows previous recipients such as Simon Cowell, Jon Snow, Murray Walker and Jeremy Paxman.

Black, who first hosted her own BBC show in

1968, said: "I am thrilled to be honoured with this award - I am totally delighted. I've been very fortunate to have a long and full career in television and this means the world to me."

She will collect the prize at the event - officially called the Arqiva British Academy Television Awards - on May 18 at the Theatre Royal, Drury Lane, in London and it will also be broadcast by BBC1.

Black was an associate of The Beatles and their manager Brian Epstein in the early 1960s and she scored two number ones in 1964 - *Anyone Who Had A Heart* and *You're*

My World - as well as enjoying many other hits, before going on to concentrate on TV.

She has hosted more than 500 editions of her programmes and was the first woman to have her own prime-time chat show on BBC1.

Andrew Newman, the chairman of Bafta's television committee, said: "From hosting her own show for the BBC in '68 to defining ITV entertainment throughout the '80s and '90s, Cilla has been an extremely popular and hugely influential entertainer throughout her long career in television."

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Witchy tale may keep you burning the midnight oil

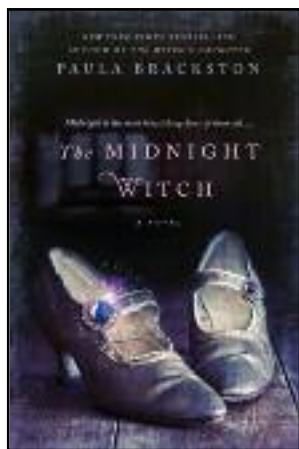
■ Exclusive interview with author Paula Brackston about her new novel *The Midnight Witch*.

"My books always start with a new witch, and in this case I already knew I wanted an urban and glamorous setting," says The *Midnight Witch* author Paula Brackston.

"I think the first decades of the twentieth century in Britain were such a time of contrasts... beautiful art, fashion, and great wealth, but devastating war, political struggle and poverty. This combination inspired Lilith's story."

Set in Edwardian times, this dark and romantic novel explores what happens if members of the British aristocracy



were also powerful witches. An interesting twist on romantic suspense. This complex storyline will intrigue you with the struggle between good and evil. However, the descriptions are so detailed it slows down the story a bit.

The sixth Duke of Radnor has died leaving behind his son Freddy, the new duke, his grieving wife and Lady Lilith Montgomery, his beautiful daughter. Lilith is the new head of the

Lazarus Coven. Freddy is weak and addicted to opium. Lilith faces the threat of a powerful group of sorcerers known at the Sentinels. She is engaged to childhood friend and fellow witch Viscount Louis Harcourt Louis. Lilith falls in love with Bram, a talented artist. She can't keep her life a secret from him. Can she save the coven, her brother and her love?

The book is long, and the story complex, being told from three different viewpoints. Brackston says she did a great deal of rewriting and tweaking. "The more you revisit a manuscript, I find, the more surreal the whole experience of writing the novel becomes. You get so immersed in the world of your story it gets harder and harder to pull yourself back out of it at the end of each day or

session."

Brackston read a lot of fiction and non-fiction set or produced during the Edwardian era and through the First World War as her research for *The Midnight Witch*. She found some archives online. "The Internet is a wonderful resource, particularly if, like me, you live somewhere remote," says Brackston. "But, it is easy to get lost in all the available information. Not all of it is useful, relevant, or even accurate, so you have to be careful and double check anything you want to use. I also watch films set in my chosen era, as I find it helps me to tune in to the speech patterns of the time, as well as getting a powerful visual sense of the years I am trying to recreate."

To make the trailer of her book Brackston used photographs of her

great-grandmother, Tweak Strannack. "Seeing her image as Lilith made the book feel much more personal to me," says Brackston. The trailer is at her website.

This is the third Brackston book featuring witches, after *The Witch's Daughter* and *The Winter Witch*. "My writing career really took off with the publication of *The Witch's Daughter* which became a New York Times bestseller," says Brackston. "This meant I was able to become a full-time writer and concentrate on my books, which has been wonderful. I do sometimes worry that I spend more of my time in a fantasy world than the real one, but my family have their own ways of keeping me grounded."

She is finishing her latest book featuring a very charismatic witch,

As these people take their movies very seriously. And with good reason, it's not often you get to see these classics on the big screen, if at all. "Winning the title is very important but so is the way we are going to win it," Pellegrini said.

"There are many ways to win it but I choose this one - attractive football."

City had been top of the table for only 11 days of a campaign lasting eight months before returning to the summit with their convincing win over Villa, which saw them score their 100th league goal of the campaign.

Any victory for Pellegrini's men against a Hammers side who they have already beaten three times this season, scoring 12 goals in the process, will make certain they finish as champions.

Even if they draw, City

have a vastly superior goal difference over Liverpool, which means the Reds would need to beat Newcastle by 13 goals in their final fixture to overtake them.

City have suffered last-day drama before, famously clinching the title through Sergio Agüero's injury-time winner against QPR in 2012.

But Pellegrini is not contemplating a tense finish this time, stating for the first time that he is confident of getting his hands on the Premier League trophy, to go with the Capital One Cup won in February.

"Of course I expect to win the title now," he said. "It is the last game and we know if we win the last game we will win the title."

"Everybody was talking about us being the favourites but in March we were nine points behind Liverpool and eight behind Chelsea. We had three games in hand but we had to win all of those games."

hope we are not going to lose on Sunday, but we must play the way we have played against Villa, and the way we have played all season."

"We have a style of play which makes us an attractive team," he explained. "We score many goals and we always think we can score more."
