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Scotland 'on cusp of making history'

- **Salmond in buoyant mood as clock ticks down to independence vote**
- **But "Better Together" campaign still enjoys slender lead in the polls**

Scotland is on the "cusp of making history" by voting for independence, the country's first minister has predicted.

Alex Salmond described the referendum as a "process of national empowerment".

But financial markets did not share Salmond's optimism, with several banks this week revealing contingency plans for a "Yes" vote, while leading retailers John Lewis and Asda said prices may rise after independence.

And Labour leader Ed Miliband said a "No" vote would deliver stronger devolved powers for Scotland.

Mr Salmond has called for an inquiry into what he said was the leaking of sensitive market data by the Treasury ahead of a formal announcement by the Royal Bank of Scotland (RBS) that it would relocate its registered headquarters to London if Scotland votes for independence.

He was speaking to the international media at an

event in Edinburgh which was taking place on the anniversary of the 1997 devolution referendum.

A new poll has suggested the "No" campaign holds a narrow lead ahead of Thursday's referendum. Two previous polls suggested the race was neck and neck.

On 11 September 1997 Scotland voted overwhelmingly for devolution, leading to the re-establishment of the Scottish Parliament after nearly 300 years.

SNP leader Mr Salmond used the anniversary to argue that a "Yes" vote for independence in the referendum next week would be a continuation of "Scotland's constitutional journey to date" and would mark "the opportunity of a lifetime".

He said: "Scotland is on the cusp of making history. The eyes of the world are

upon Scotland. And what the world is seeing is an articulate, peaceful, energised debate.

"Scotland will vote 'Yes' next Thursday and they will vote 'Yes' because last-minute, cobbled up promises from the 'No' campaign which unravel at the slightest scrutiny

will not fool anyone in this country and neither will the blatant bullying and intimidation of the Westminster government."

In other referendum news, the Edinburgh-based Scotsman newspaper says it is backing a "No" vote. In a leader

piece this week, the publication said it was concerned about issues such as currency, EU membership and defence.

But Scotland's largest fund manager's boss said an independent Scotland would be a huge success. Martin Gilbert, chief executive of

Aberdeen Asset Management said: "I think an independent Scotland would be a big success, but it is a secret ballot and I will abide by that."

The Electoral Commission has revealed that 4,285,323 people have registered to vote in the referendum.

Orangemen set for huge Glasgow parade

Scotland's biggest-ever Orange Parade is set to take place this weekend, as thousands of pro-unionists show support for the 'No' vote ahead of the country's referendum.

As many as 15,000 members of the Grand Orange Lodge of Scotland are expected to march through Edinburgh on 13 September as part of a rally to back the Better Together campaign.

The parade, which will

pass through the capital's Royal Mile, will contain banners, bands and members in full outfits to show how they are "Proud to be British".

The march arrives after the Alistair Darling-led Better Together campaign restored its lead in the polls after previously falling behind to Alex Salmond's 'Yes' campaign for the first time.

The Orange Order assured the parade will be

in "good humour" and predicted there will not be the sort of disorder which has plagued similar walks in Scotland and Northern Ireland.

During an Orange Walk in Glasgow in July, a 12-year-old girl was left with blood pouring down her face after she was accidentally struck with a glass bottle after a fight broke out nearby.

Following the injury to the girl, Labour MP Jim Murphy called for the

upcoming Edinburgh march to be cancelled, adding the incident left a "scar on Glasgow".

He added: "I am disgusted. The march before the referendum vote shouldn't go ahead. Better Together want nothing to do with the Orange Order."

A Orange Order spokesperson said: "It's intended that the good humour will spill over into the parade which will see traditional lodge

banners supplemented by referendum banners bearing the message: 'Proud to be Scottish – Proud to be British'. The parade will have a family atmosphere with the Order bringing its junior members, and it will be bedecked with Union flags, Saltires and balloons."

Police said they have all the necessary arrangements in place in order to deal with the parade.

A spokesperson added: "Police Scotland's priority is to ensure public safety and security and we will uphold the right of anyone to march and demonstrate peacefully."

"This event, like every other of this type, will be policed appropriately and proportionately and we will respond appropriately to any issues which arise, dealing accordingly with anyone who breaches the law."

Abroad, key vote brings worry for some, hope for others

Britain's international partners are 'aghast' in the words of at least one report this week, that one of the leading Western powers could break up and turn in on itself if Scotland votes next week for independence from London.

Although foreign capitals have been largely silent on the issue, it's an open secret that many fear such a split would foreshadow a British exit from the European Union, on which Prime Minister David Cameron has promised a referendum in 2017, weakening the world's sixth largest economy and its continental partners.

Some also fear it would set a precedent, boosting separatism in Catalonia and elsewhere in Europe.

But independence campaigners from around the continent have welcomed the vote by flocking to Edinburgh to support the "Yes" campaign and hope to draw lessons for their own struggles.

Some posed for a group photograph with Scottish nationalist leader Alex Salmond, now racing to turn narrowing opinion polls into a win in the Sept. 18 vote.

The idea is not sitting well in leading capitals.

U.S. President Barack Obama has been forthright in urging Britons to stay together and in the EU.

"We obviously have a deep interest in making sure that one of the closest allies that we will ever have remains a strong,

robust, united and effective partner," Obama said on a visit to Europe in June.

Privately, U.S. and European officials say they are concerned that a Britain amputated of a third of its territory and 8 percent of its population would be more introverted and less willing to engage in military coalitions abroad.

puzzling

European partners have tried to be quietly supportive of Cameron on Scotland, underlining how keen they are to keep Britain in the EU, while privately puzzling over his decision to risk everything on two uncertain referendums.

"A Scottish exit from the union (with England,

Wales and Northern Ireland) would be bound to heat up the debate about an early referendum (on leaving the EU)," said Phillip Missfelder, foreign policy spokesman for Chancellor Angela Merkel's conservatives in the German parliament.

Merkel has made clear Berlin wants to keep Britain in the EU and is willing to accommodate some of London's demands for changes to help Cameron win the in/out plebiscite he has promised if he is re-elected next year.

In highly centralised France, it is the precedent of separatism that is causing most political anguish.

"The idea that this can happen in Europe in regions like Scotland -

even though it isn't at all the same context - demonstrates that frontiers are exploding and this is worrying," said Socialist Patricia Adam, who chairs parliament's defence committee.

Some foreign businesses are also worried. The head of France's Thales, which employs 7,500 people in Britain as one of its biggest defence suppliers, said a Scottish vote to secede would create uncertainty and put into question jobs and production sites on both sides of the border.

Some European diplomats are alarmed by Cameron's high-wire strategy for trying to hold the country together and keep it in Europe: "How could he take such ill-calculated risks?" a French diplomat asked

privately.

Meanwhile in Spain the semi-autonomous Catalan government wants to hold a consultative referendum on statehood on Nov. 9 but the Spanish government says that is illegal.

"The Scottish vote for us is an injection of enthusiasm and hope," said Alfred Bosch, spokesman for Catalonia's Republican Left party. "The difference is that the UK government has been democratic and allowed it, but the Spanish government hasn't."

Conservative Spanish commentators have slammed Cameron for allowing the Scottish vote. Respected columnist Jose Antonio Zarzalejos called it "one of the greatest risks for the EU and for Great Britain in 300 years".



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Royal couple 'thrilled' as Kate pregnancy is confirmed

Prince William says he and the Duchess of Cambridge are "thrilled" they are expecting their second child.

Kensington Palace said the duchess was suffering from a severe sickness - as she did when she was pregnant with Prince George.

Speaking at a visit to Oxford University the duke said it had been a "tricky few days" but was "great news".

The couple's second baby will become fourth in line to the throne, behind 13-month-old Prince George.

Asked about the duchess, Prince William said she was "feeling okay" and that he was "going to go back and look

after her now".

He told journalists the couple were "immensely thrilled", but said it was still "early days".

"It's important that we all focus on the big news, the big international and domestic things that are going on at the moment. That's what my thoughts are at the moment," he said.

A statement from the palace said the Queen and both families were delighted with news of the pregnancy.

Prince Harry said it was "very exciting news" and joked that he "can't wait to see my brother suffer more".

Speaking while visiting competitors ahead of the first Invictus Games, he

said Catherine was "pretty poorly" but was "doing the best she can".

Prince William was speaking after he formally opened a £21m China study centre at Oxford University.

The duchess had been due to accompany him on the visit, but the palace said her sickness meant that she would no longer be attending and was being treated by doctors.

The duchess's first pregnancy was revealed when she was just a few weeks pregnant with Prince George after she was admitted to hospital suffering from severe sickness in December 2012.

The sickness - called *hyperemesis*

gravidarum - is a condition that may require supplementary hydration, medication and nutrients.

It affects 3.5 per 1,000 pregnancies, causes severe vomiting and can lead to dehydration, weight loss and a build-up of toxins in the blood or urine, called ketosis.

'Fantastic news'

Arriving at the new study centre the duke told a well-wisher who sympathised with Catherine's condition that she may be over the worst of the acute sickness in a "few weeks' time".

The duchess is due to make her first official solo overseas tour, to Malta for two days, from 20 September.

Kensington Palace said the duchess's attendance at future events would be decided on a "case-by-case" basis.

The baby

announcement came after the couple's first child, Prince George, had his first birthday on 22 July.

Prime Minister David Cameron offered his congratulations to the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge in the House of Commons.

"We have heard this morning the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge are expecting their second baby.

"On behalf of the whole country, I'm sure the whole House will want to join me in congratulating them on this fantastic news and wishing them well in the months ahead," he said.

Labour leader Ed Miliband added his own good wishes, saying: "I join with the Prime Minister in congratulating the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge on their happy news.

"I too wish them well in

the months ahead."

Earl Spencer, Prince William's uncle, told LBC radio station it was "fantastic" news.

"I have never known a period of news where things have looked so dark and bleak around the world and to have this pop up is just fantastic.

"I think that's really what it's about, it's just making the nation a happier place and that is what today's news does," the earl, brother of the late Princess Diana, said.

Earlier, Deputy Prime Minister Nick Clegg said the pregnancy was "fantastic news".

Scottish First Minister Alex Salmond said: "This is very happy news for any couple, and on behalf of the people of Scotland, I am delighted to send our best wishes to the countess and our hearty congratulations to the royal couple."

'I hope it will be a girl this time!'

■ Charles reveals he's hoping for a granddaughter

PRINCE CHARLES has expressed his delight at the prospect of being a grandfather yet again - telling well-wishers he hoped The Duchess of Cambridge's next baby would be a girl.

And Charles isn't the only royal to state a preference for a girl, with Prince Harry also revealing that he'd like a niece - if only for the chaos she would bring to

his brother's life.

Whether it's a boy or girl, Charles was happy to describe the news as 'splendid' as he was quizzed by well-wishers during an event in Bermondsey on Wednesday which saw him meet young entrepreneurs supported by the Prince's Trust.

He was questioned by the family of entrepreneur Demi

Owoseje, who had opened up her leather upholstery studio for a royal visit.

Although Charles appeared to enjoy being shown around the studio, when Ms Owoseje's sister Toyin, 26, and mother Elizabeth, 50, were introduced, there was only one subject on their mind - Kate's pregnancy.

Toyin congratulated Charles first, with the royal skittishly replying: 'What did I do?', before adding: 'It hasn't arrived yet - (but) splendid, we're very excited.'

Betting began on the sex of the new child within minutes of the announcement, with a girl the favourite according to bookmakers Coral.

Popular names for a new princess include Elizabeth, Alexandra, Victoria and Charlotte. Less popular choices include Eleanor and Florence.

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I may be tactile but I'm no moron, DLT tells London court

■ Former DJ describes 'two years of hell' since allegations of assault surfaced

Dave Lee Travis is a "tactile person" but not a "moron", the former Radio 1 DJ told a court this week as he denied assaulting a woman at a pantomime.

He also told Southwark Crown Court he would not approach a stranger and "pinch their bottom".

The 69-year-old said he had had "two years of hell" as a result of the

allegations, and described the alleged victims as "liars".

Mr Travis denies two counts of indecent assault and one of sexual assault.

He is being retried on one count of indecent assault of a woman in the 1990s and another of sexual assault on a different woman in 2008 - after a jury failed to reach verdicts earlier this year.

Mr Travis, who is on

trial under his real name, David Griffin, has also pleaded not guilty to an additional count of indecent assault alleged to have taken place in Manchester on 17 January 1995.

'Baddie' role

Asked about the charge of indecently assaulting a woman at a pantomime, Mr Travis said: "It doesn't bear thinking about to be

honest."

He said: "The thought of sexually attacking someone as part of that team is just not something you would want to do. You would have to be a complete moron to do that - something that I am hoping that no-one is going to suggest is that I am a moron."

He said he enjoyed playing a baddie saying: "I relish it, there is nothing better than going on stage and saying 'I hate kids'."

Questioned by his barrister Stephen Vullo, Mr Travis said pinching someone's bottom was a line he had not crossed.

He said he was "tactile

with everybody - men, women, certainly women, anyone because it's just a natural thing for me to greet someone.

"I give a squeeze and have been known to give a guy a hug and a kiss on the cheek if I know he is a great guy."

'Terrible word'

Mr Travis also told the court Radio 1 had made him famous but that he had also made personal appearances to boost his income as the pay was "pretty pathetic".

And asked if he had worked since his arrest in November 2012, he said he had not "done a single thing".

Mr Travis said his career was effectively "stopped dead" when he was arrested.

He told the court: "I've had two years of hell, lost half a million pounds, my life and house... this is made-up rubbish."

He also criticised police and prosecutors.

Commenting on his former Radio 1 colleague the late Jimmy Savile, he told the court that, while they were contemporaries, he "never had a sensible conversation with him because he put up a wall".

Mr Travis, a keen photographer, also denied that he was sleazy in the way he approached his work with the camera.

One of his previous projects included taking images of people and asking what they liked or disliked about themselves.

He said: "No, sleazy is a terrible word that is easily bandied about. Sleazy has nothing to do with what I did ever."

Later, he said he liked to photograph women because "they're great subjects", adding: "They have wonderful curves and things."

The trial continues.

TV host: it's agony for Cliff

Cliff Richard is 'imprisoned' by the allegations of sexual assault against him, Gloria Hunniford has claimed.

Hunniford, a veteran British TV presenter who has known the singer for 45 years, phoned him especially for her popular TV show, *Loose Women*, a month after his house was raided by the police.

Gloria explained: "Because Cliff loves coming on *Loose Women* I

thought I'd ring him this morning, and ask him if it was alright to tell you how he is and these are absolutely his words.

"He's totally devastated because he's got no idea of course who his accuser is and these are his words, he is appalled about what he regards as a completely false accusation, those are his words and he couldn't believe that this would actually put him through such agony, again he said 'agony'."

Princes William and Harry applauded as brave disabled soldiers competed on the first day of competition at the Invictus Games this week.

The two brothers sat side-by-side and cheered from the stands at the Lee Valley Athletics Centre in London as they enjoyed the athletics on the first day of the event.

After attending a military service of remembrance at lunchtime, the pair settled in for the afternoon's action - and looked impressed with what they saw.

Competitors were clapped and cheered during the finals of various track races from the 100m to 1,500m featuring servicemen and women with a range of injuries.

Former Royal Marine Andy Grant, 26, who won the 1500m for competitors who have lost limbs below the knee, said: 'It is just amazing to be

running round and getting cheered. Especially the commentary - when they say, 'Andy Grant, Royal Marine,' and everyone is cheering, it is an amazing feeling. It has been an amazing week to be

honest.'

The Liverpoolian, who had the lower part of his right leg amputated after being caught in a blast while serving in Afghanistan, added: 'I knew straightaway how important sport was just through my rehab, but seeing the guys now, I don't think there is anything more inspiring than seeing a guy who two years ago was lying in a ditch in Afghanistan bleeding to death, and now he is running 100m in Paralympic time.'

'brilliant'

The veteran joked about how a tattoo on his leg has changed: 'I had a Liver Bird and You'll Never Walk Alone tattooed on my leg.'

'When I had the leg amputated the surgeon came in afterwards and informed me that the operation went really well. However the tattoo had now changed.'

The soldier lost both his legs in combat and suffered burns to the face.

He added: 'Because there was so much damage to the leg he had to pull round skin from the back of the leg to create a decent stump. He managed to cut off the word alone so the tattoo now reads You'll Never Walk.'

Corporal Ricky Fergusson, 29, who lost both legs, an eye and fingers on both hands in a bomb blast in Afghanistan in 2010, competed in the 100m IT2 sprint for competitors with limbs missing above the knee.

The veteran from Telford, Shropshire, finished last after he had a problem with one of his prosthetic limbs but remained positive about the day: 'I think this is brilliant, it's great to have servicemen and women here from all over the world.'

'They will hopefully find it fun and some of the smaller countries will get an idea of what it's like to compete on a big stage.'

'The Invictus Games is something great to work towards. You can use it as motivation to get better or take it to the next level and try and go to the Paralympics in Rio.'

'inspire and humble'

Before the action got underway, the Prince attended a drumhead service of remembrance, organised in part to mark the anniversary of the 9/11 terror attacks in New York but also to remember those who have died or been injured in conflict.

Prince Harry, who is the driving force behind the Games, said he was 'thrilled' when asked for his assessment of the first day of the competition for wounded serving or veteran, servicemen and women from across the globe.

Harry praised competitors, many still serving soldiers, from around the globe for their stories that 'move, inspire and humble'.

Inspired by the US Warrior Games, Prince Harry vowed to bring a larger event to the UK and now teams from 13 nations, including the US, will compete over four days in a range of challenging sports.

In the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, the home of London 2012, Harry was introduced by US first lady Michelle Obama who had recorded a video message for the launch.

The prince told the 6,500 spectators who had watched the opening ceremony: 'No longer are these inspirational men and women defined by their injury but as athletes, competitors and team mates.'

'Over the next four days we will see some truly remarkable achievements. For some of those taking part, this will be a stepping stone to elite sport but for others it will mark the end of a chapter in their recovery, and the beginning of a new one.'

Want a happy child? move to Norwich!

City is voted best place in Britain for youngsters to grow up thanks to combination of open spaces, play parks, and safe roads

A NEW SURVEY of what kind of town makes for a happy childhood has confirmed what many residents of Norwich have long known – that it's a great place to raise your kids.

The Norfolk city, which is also famous for Stephen Fry and Lord Nelson, scored well on most counts including a low crime rate and plenty of outdoor space. In fact the only category in which it fell short was its lack of hills suitable for sledging

in the winter, due to its notoriously flat landscape.

Lower down the list, cities like Birmingham, Bristol and Cardiff made the top ten.

They were voted in thanks to the volume of parks and playgrounds within walking distance of homes.

facilities and amenities

Coastal towns and cities like Newquay, Truro and Plymouth have the advantage of being nearer the seaside, earning them

a place in the top 20.

Apart from local amenities, other factors for a happy childhood are safety related, were policeman on patrol, good street lighting, neighbourhood watch schemes and lollipop ladies at crossings.

Researchers looked at the facilities and amenities which parents believe are important for a happy childhood and combined this how many of them are offered where they live.

This may have hampered the chart positions of cities like London and Brighton where many people live in flats and apartments in the research, compiled by soft drinks firm Panda Drinks.

Other features British parents rate as helping a child grow up happy include having friends who live nearby, areas safe enough for them to cycle and even a beach a short drive away.

Nina Uttley, brand

manager for Panda Soft Drinks, said: 'A happy childhood does not depend on the latest games, expensive gadgets and access to theme parks.'

'This survey shows just how vital the great outdoors can be.'

'Even if you live in an urban area, easy access to parks or playgrounds and a short drive to a beach or woodland, can help give children the healthy, active upbringing they deserve and improve their overall happiness.'

Jack the Ripper finally unmasked?

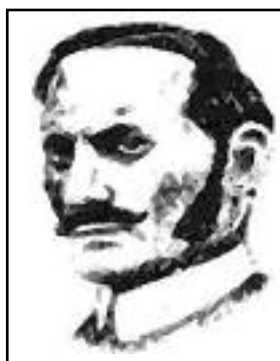
THIS WEEK brought the latest in a long line of claims to have finally unmasked Jack the Ripper.

But instead of merely relying on conjecture and re-examining old police reports to conjure up an educated guess as to the identity of the world's best-known serial killer, the latest claim uses the latest forensic DNA techniques and comes from a scientist, Dr Jari Louhelainen, a senior lecturer of molecular biology at Liverpool John Moores University.

Louhelainen claims he's found conclusive evidence, which proves Aaron Kosminski (above, right) was responsible for the murders, after he analyzed a shawl which allegedly belonged to one of the victims.

Kosminski was one of the original six key suspects who police at the time believed carried out at least five of the murders in 1888.

The Shawl was found by the body of the Ripper's fourth victim, Catherine Eddowes. Many years afterwards businessman, Russell Edwards bought the item at an auction. It's believed



a police officer on duty at the time of the murders had taken the shawl home for his wife.

Edwards later passed it on to Dr Louhelainen, who specialises in analysing evidence from historic crime scenes. He compared the DNA from the shawl to DNA from the victim's relatives and the suspect's then concluded it was Kosminski.

Kosminski was a 23-year-old Polish man, working as a hairdresser at the time of the murders. He lived with his siblings just yards away from where the third victim, Elizabeth Stride was killed, which happened on the same night as Eddowes' murder.

The Pole was arrested on an unrelated charge shortly after the final murder and sentenced to life imprisonment in a London asylum, where he remained until his death in 1919.

British expat killed by Great White

A BRITISH expat's dream life abroad came to a horrifying end this week when he was killed by a shark in Australia.

Paul Wilcox, 50, originally from Warwickshire, suffered severe leg injuries during the attack off a beach in Byron Bay, the most easterly point on the mainland.

His parents, Marie and Bryan, of Llanfihangel Glyn Myfyr in north Wales, spoke to their son hours before he died on his regular morning swim - when the subject of sharks was raised.

"This subject came up in a joke when we last spoke to him," Bryan told the Welsh newspaper the Rhyl, Prestatyn and Abergele Journal.

"But he said there had only been three shark attacks in the last 12 years."

Mr Wilcox, who moved to Denbighshire as a child with his family, was an information technology specialist and emigrated in the 1980s. He had only recently moved from Sydney to the beachside community of Byron Bay with his wife Victoria, and was on his regular morning swim

when tragedy struck at Clarkes Beach on Tuesday.

He was swimming just 15 metres from the shore when the attack occurred.

A swimmer brought Mr Wilcox to shore but he was pronounced dead.

Beaches in the area were temporarily closed and people were warned to stay out of the water.

'very loyal'

"At 10:45 police and paramedics were called to Main Beach after reports of a shark attack," New South Wales police said in their initial statement.

"He was in the water when he was bitten. He was seen floating in shallow water, close to the shore line, and dragged onto the beach. An ambulance was called and he was pronounced dead a short time later."

Ms Wilcox said of her son: "I adored him".

She added: "Paul and I - I can honestly say - since he was an adult....never had a cross word.

"I absolutely adored him and I want people to know that."

She described her son as a "very loyal" person who "loved his hugs".

She added: "I had a happy, well-adjusted, lovely, lovely son talking to me the day before - 24 hours later he's dead and I still can't take it in."

Witness Mark Hickey said he tried to help.

"I saw what looked like seaweed but it was blood in the water," he said.

"I didn't know it was a person but when I realised, I ran out and waded to the bank and grabbed him and did CPR, but it was too late."

A 12 foot shark was later spotted in the area by police helicopters. Because the Great White is a protected species in Australia killing it was considered a last resort. It was later herded out to deeper water by a group of police boats and jet skis.

Marie also told the Rhyl, Prestatyn and Abergele Journal that her son, who moved to Australia when he was 22, was enjoying a "dream life" in Australia.

"He told me he had 90 per cent of paradise but needed his family here too," Marie said, adding that her son had told her recently that he wanted a "mum hug".

"My heart's ripped out," she said.

"But he was living a wonderful life and that's all you want for your child."

Bryan said his son was wearing a wetsuit and flippers when he was bitten. The bite amputated his right leg, causing fatal blood loss, the newspaper reported.

LA Theatre Works opens season with all-Welsh cast for Thomas's classic "Under Milk Wood"

LA Theatre Works (LATW) is celebrating its 40th anniversary season this year and will open next week by paying homage to the great Welsh poet Dylan Thomas on the 100th anniversary of his birth. LATW will record his immortal "play for voices" *Under Milk Wood*, with a distinguished cast of Welsh and Welsh-American actors.

The gold standard for the play was cast in 1954 with the BBC production starring Richard Burton, who famously said of the play: "It is all about religion, sex and death".....it is a comic

masterpiece."

Thomas' intensely beautiful, poignant and sublimely funny linguistic tour-de-force about the salty little fishing village of Llareggub (read it backwards) remains as haunting as ever. Even for today's audiences, Llareggub remains an enchanted spot where the wicked are forgiven and their indiscretions transformed into rich fuel for comedy.

The characters who populate the fictional village have become household names: the blind old seadog Captain Cat forever mourning his

dead love Rosie Probert, the Rev Eli Jenkins greeting each morning in verse, Polly Garter with her list of lost paramours, Mr Pugh who dreams of poisoning Mrs Pugh, Mrs Ogmore-Pritchard and her two dead husbands, Dai Bread and his two live wives.

Sara Sugarman directs Matthew Rhys, Laura Evans, John Francis, Jason Hughes, Christopher Monger and Cerris Morgan-Moyer. Keeping a welcome link with the late, great Burton, both his daughter and grandson, Kate Burton and Morgan Ritchie also appear in the cast.



It's official: Corden to replace Ferguson on the Late, Late Show

Actor James Corden has been confirmed as Craig Ferguson's successor as host of *The Late Late Show* on American TV.

"I can't wait to get started," said the 36-year-old star of *Gavin and Stacey* (above, left).

He said he was "thrilled and honoured" to follow the "brilliant" Ferguson and that it was "hugely exciting... to host such a prestigious show".

Corden will take over next year from Ferguson

(above, right), who has been hosting the late-night talk show since 2005 and is stepping down in December.

Corden's appointment was widely rumoured last month but has only now been confirmed by the CBS network.

His previous hosting experience includes four stints at the Brit Awards and his presenting role on the Sky panel show *A League Of Their Own*.

The actor's profile in

the US was boosted in 2012 when he won a Tony for his role in the Broadway transfer of stage hit *One Man, Two Guvnors*.

He was recently seen alongside Keira Knightley in the musical romance *Begin Again* and has a role in big-screen musical *Into the Woods*, out at Christmas.

In a statement, Corden said he would do his best "to make a show America will enjoy".

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MEET A MEMBER: Peter Foldy

Meet Peter Foldy from Budapest via Sydney and Toronto, who moved to LA 25 years ago to pursue music and film.

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

I was signed by RCA Records in Los Angeles as a recording artist and the moment I stepped off the plane, I knew I would end up here. L.A. was the place that most closely resembled Sydney, which is one of my favorite cities in the world and was a great environment to grow up in. Beaches, sunshine, really cool people. Love Oz.

What one thing do you miss from home?

Home has been three other cities so far and each one has something special. Budapest has an incredible history and culture, with great theater, music and it's own cafe society. Friendships are long lasting and meaningful there. Sydney, as mentioned above has the great beaches and Toronto is where my mother and sister live so I do go back often. Toronto is also the place that launched my music career, where I was able to record a demo of my

music, land a record deal and end up on the top of the Canadian charts - and I do miss that part of my life, when my music career was really taking off. It was really a once in a lifetime moment.

What do you find the biggest difference is living here versus everywhere else you've lived?

For people in the entertainment business, Los Angeles is the city where no one really looks down on you for following your dreams. No one says: what are you going to do when you grow up? Or don't you think you should have a back up plan? If entertainment is the business you want to be in, there is really no other city that is more accepting and supportive. I've gone from being a recording artist to being a film director, working on feature films with top name actors, and now back to music again, having just recorded a new 10 track CD called Nine Lives, which is coming out this month and available on iTunes and Amazon and all the other outlets (sorry for the shameless self-promotion). No one

told me I was crazy to do that, in fact I got nothing but encouragement, and that is one of the reasons I love L.A.

Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?

I like a restaurant called Ca Brea, very close to where I live. Great Italian food, and a cool, intimate bar with a happy hour that goes from 5 - 10 every night. Friendly bartenders, \$5 drinks and appetizers that are delicious. Great for a conversation.

What would you suggest to others who are thinking about making the move here?

Learn how the business operates. There is an order here, a method to the way the business is run. Figure out how to approach people in the industry in the most professional manner. Cold calling people, or emailing headshots or script ideas generally doesn't lead anywhere, in fact many people don't accept them and it could make you seem like an amateur. The best thing to do, assuming you really have the talent, is network, find allies and make connections who could then, if they believe in you, introduce you to the people who can help move your career forward. This is a town where people tend to work with their friends and friends of friends. Become one of them. Don't let the concept of Hollywood overwhelm you. It's actually a small town in terms of the industry. The chances of it happening are generally greater here than anywhere else. Unless you want a career in the theater, in which case London is the place to be. Currently, L.A. loves

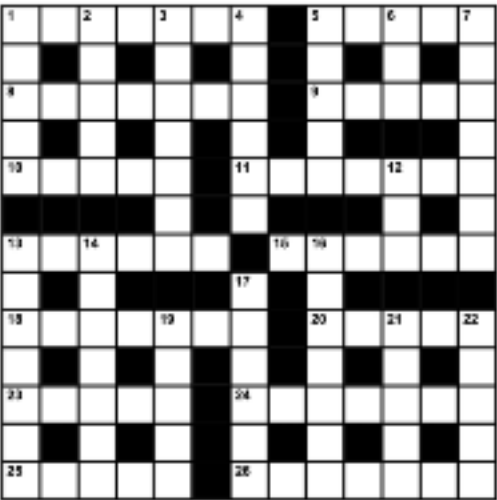

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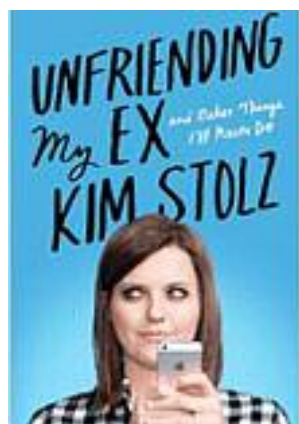
Unfriending My Ex: life lived on social media

■ Exclusive interview with author Kim Stolz and a review of her new book about social media and the pitfalls of being too connected

“I didn’t blame social media for my transgressions but I do believe it provided an easy, slippery slope for me to live out my most dangerous impulses,” says *Unfriending My Ex and Other Things I’ll Never Do* author Kim Stolz, the MTV news anchor who’s been a contestant on America’s Next Top Model and was named by Out magazine in 2012 as one of the 100 Most Compelling People of the Year.

“I was on a plane, 36,000 feet in the air, and



received an email from my then-girlfriend which was a pasted GChat conversation that I’d had with an ex,” says Stolz. “I had forwarded the GChat conversation to my roommate at the time and my girlfriend had logged onto my roommate’s computer and it was staring at her in the face.”

Stolz has written a memoir about how her whole life is lived online, that she needs to disconnect to reconnect.

Most of us have a smart phone and are connected at all times. We do business, get our news, share our news via social media. Many share more than they should. If there is a hook-up, break-up, feud or make-up, we find out via social media. Friends and followers, lost loves or unwanted losers, who are all these people in our lives? Do we really know who anyone is?

Social media is both entertaining and feckless. Stolz will make you think about how connected you are to living, breathing people, not just online avatars. She says we should disconnect to feel real. If you are one of the few left who doesn’t live their whole life online, it can give you a perspective on your friends and acquaintances who are.

Internet savy or just addicted to digital? How often are we connecting on a personal level? Can we disconnect from the matrix or are we self-obsessing voyeurs?

“When I started writing this book, I had assumed that the generation younger than me who knew nothing other than a life on social media and smart phones would be no help in bringing our society to a better, less addicted place,” says Stolz. “When I interviewed them, I was astounded and pleased to find that they are experiencing the same emotions and fears and frustrations. It gives me hope for society and the future. I’ve had to deal with the dichotomy of writing about a lot of the downfalls of social media while also using that medium to promote

it.”

In writing about the dangers of too much time online, Stolz spent significant time online doing research, but also spoke with experts. “I did massive twitter polls, other medium-led polls, interviewed psychologists and behavioral specialists, interviewed other authors who have written on the subject, and read a ton of research and statistical studies. I found most by ordering on Amazon or downloading documents on the Internet.”

Unfriending My Ex is Stolz’s first book. Stolz has written for MTV.com, Foxnews.com, Huffington Post, TrueSlant, Cosmo, TechCrunch and Self Magazine. When not writing, she’s the Director of Equity Derivative Sales at Bank of America Merrill

Lynch. She was born and still lives in New York City.

“I think we just have to find a balance of using social media but not letting it use us or abuse us,” says Stolz. Her book may help you decide what that balance is.

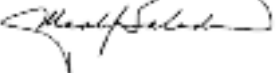

■ 'Bold approach' pays off as England make bright start to Euro 2016 qualifying

Roy Hodgson believes the 2-0 win in Switzerland could be the start of a new bold approach for his England side.

Danny Welbeck scored two second-half goals to give an attacking England team an opening victory in their Euro 2016 qualifying campaign on Monday night.

Hodgson, 67, said: "It was a bold approach but we decided there was no point coming here for a 0-0, we want this team to progress.

"When we can counter-attack, the pace, energy and youth of the team is shown."

With striker Daniel Sturridge injured, England lined up with captain Wayne Rooney joined by Welbeck, 23, in attack, with Liverpool's Raheem Sterling, 19, behind at the tip of a midfield diamond.

And the three players combined for the opening goal as Welbeck swept in Sterling's pinpoint cross, before new £16m Arsenal

signing Welbeck sealed the win in the last minute from substitute Rickie Lambert's pass.

Hodgson was pleased with how his side settled into the new shape and believes progress is being made after a poor Fifa World Cup campaign in Brazil this summer, where defeats by Italy and Uruguay and a draw against Costa Rica saw them exit at the group stage.

"Two important players in that system are Jack Wilshere and Raheem Sterling, at the base and at the tip of the diamond," Hodgson said.

"We wanted to get them on the ball. We thought that Switzerland would find it hard to deal with it and they had to change their system in the second half.

"This is the way forward. We've got to back them.

"Yes the World Cup didn't go our way, yes we have been disappointed - but we have been building up. We didn't hit a brick

wall and it was all wrong, we had to maintain faith that we are on the right track and we are getting the right players.

"It was so important to get a good start against the team who are our biggest rivals in the group."

Welbeck had not scored for England since a brace against Moldova last September, but his two efforts were well taken to put Hodgson's side in early control of Group E.

With the top two teams in each group qualifying automatically and trips to Lithuania, Slovenia, San Marino and Estonia to come, England have arguably already come through their toughest test.

Welbeck said of his brace: "It's satisfying. As a team we got the right result and started the campaign well.

"It's difficult to pick a team with so much talent across the whole squad but when I play in my preferred position I know what I can do for the team."

Strachan: we could have beat Germans

Gordon Strachan believed his Scotland side were going to beat the world champions before Germany claimed a 2-1 win in Dortmund on Sunday night.

Thomas Muller's first-half header was cancelled out by Ikechi Anya's strike in the Euro 2016 qualifying opener.

But Muller netted his second from a poorly defended corner to secure victory for Joachim Low's side.

"At 1-1, I genuinely believed we were going to win the game," said Strachan. "I saw players

playing with no fear."

Muller's opener also owed a debt to slackness in the Scottish rearguard and Strachan admitted his players had taken time to settle at Signal Iduna Park.

"The first 20 minutes, it wasn't fear," he explained, "They tried to rush passes. We lost the ball quite a lot and it gave Germany easy possession.

"The Germans are always going to have more of the ball and probably more chances, that goes without saying.

"The second half we played with no fear. They really should be proud of

what they did.

"The longer the game went on, the more of a threat we had. All we need to do is work on the first 20 minutes, get that sorted out then we'll be fine, we'll be good."

Strachan was animated as he came onto the pitch after full-time and the Scotland players were frustrated that they had not been given the opportunity to take a corner before Norwegian referee Svein Oddvar Moen blew his whistle.

"I was on to make sure my coaching staff didn't
