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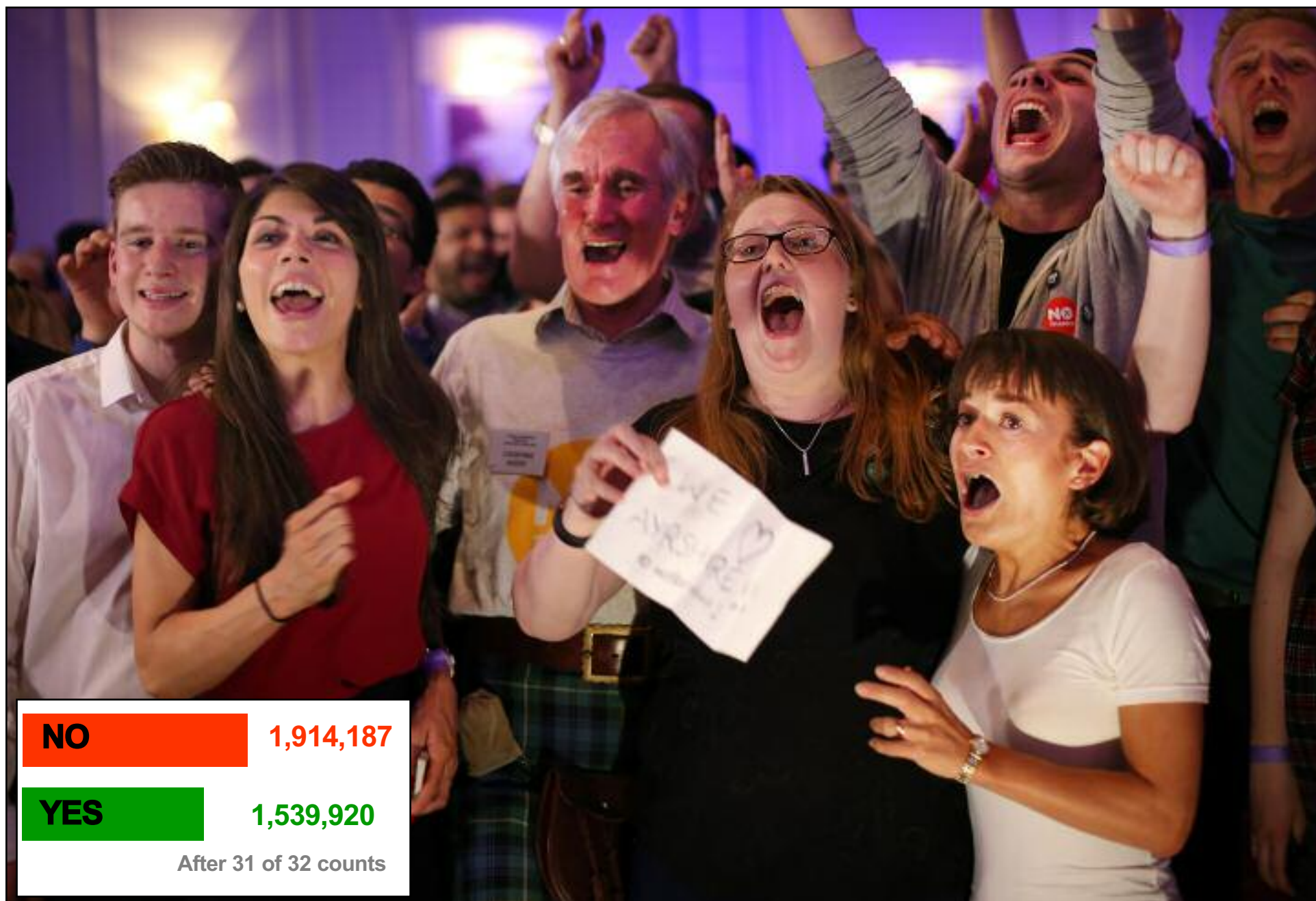
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IT'S NO GO: Scotland rejects independence

■ Kingdom still united as No campaign wins by clear majority

Clear win for No vote

The people of Scotland have rejected the option of independence by a clear margin.

While Glasgow voted in favour, the margin of victory was not large enough to give Alex Salmond and his campaign the momentum they need with the vast majority of constituencies choosing to stay within the United Kingdom by clear majorities.

As the British Weekly went to press, Salmond's deputy Nicola Sturgeon conceded defeat with a handful of results still to be declared.

The Deputy First Minister said there was a "real sense of disappointment that we have fallen narrowly short of securing a Yes vote".

"But I think it's clear that this is a message for change and that change must be delivered now."

And while Glasgow voted yes, Edinburgh went no by a comfortable margin.

There were wins for Yes in only three other of Scotland's 32 local authority areas - Dundee, West Dunbartonshire and North Lanarkshire.

While there was a comfortable majority in Dundee, the turnout in the city was 78.8% - lower than many other parts of

Scotland, indicating that the Yes campaign has not managed to get voters out in sufficient numbers. The turnout in Glasgow was even lower at 75%.

At the same time, nationalists conceded defeat in Mr Salmond's Aberdeenshire constituency.

'deliver on the promises'

SNP MSP Stewart Stevenson said: "The challenge now bluntly, in Aberdeenshire and elsewhere, is for those who've won the referendum to deliver on the promises that they made to the people of Scotland."

Mr Salmond had been expected to make an appearance at the Aberdeen Exhibition and Conference Centre (AECC) but instead went directly to Edinburgh from his home in Strichen.

Sir Malcolm Bruce, Liberal Democrat MP for Gordon, said: "The point about this area is that it's Alex Salmond's backyard and his basic proposition has been overwhelmingly rejected here in Aberdeenshire, which I think will have implications."

On the First Minister's decision not to appear at the AECC count, Sir Malcolm said: "He only

likes to come for acclamation, he doesn't like to come and commiserate with his troops. I think good leaders should be with their troops whether they win or lose but he only wants to be the centre of attention.

'new settlement'

"He was coming here until he got first indication that it wasn't going well and he immediately aborted it."

Perhaps the most encouraging aspect of Thursday's vote was the turnout, as Scots demonstrated to a global audience just how seriously they took their right to vote. Turnout in the vast majority of areas topped 80%, a figure not seen in British general elections for many generations.

Indications from Westminster suggest a sea change is coming in British politics, with a 'new settlement' expected to be announced by David Cameron as early as Friday. The Prime Minister is expected to announce significant new powers be devolved to the Scots - while bowing the backbench pressure by removing the rights of Scottish MPs to vote on English matters.

Look how far we've come, says Salmond

- First Minister calls on Westminster to deliver on campaign promises
- Huge turnout reflects 'great credit on Scotland throughout the world'

Shortly after 6am on Friday local time First Minister Alex Salmond delivered what amounted to a concession speech, telling his supporters: "I accept the verdict of the people and I call on all of Scotland to follow suit and follow the democratic verdict of the people of Scotland."

"Let us say something which I hope unites all campaigns and all Scots. I think the process by which we have made our decision as a nation reflects great credit on Scotland throughout the world. The turnout of 86% of is one of the highest in the democratic world and represents a triumph of the democratic process and for public participation in politics.

"I accept the result and I pledge to work constructively in the interests of Scotland the rest of the United Kingdom."

But he then went on to mention the promises that were made late in the campaign by what he referred to as the 'union parties' warning that "Scotland will expect these to be honored in rapid course."

Amid tearful scenes from his dejected supporters, Salmond preferred not to dwell on the number of Scots who had voted to retain the Union, but rather those who had chosen a different path.

"We will never be allowed to go back to business as usual in politics again. Friends,

sometimes it's best to reflect where we are on a journey. 45 per cent, or 1.6m of our fellow citizens, voting for independence. I don't think any of us, when we entered politics, would have thought that figure creditable or possible."

'scare and fear'

He also referred to the 'scare and fear at the heart of the Westminster establishment' at what he described as 'the movement of people that is going forward in the heart of Scotland.'

"Today of all days as we bring Scotland together, let us not dwell on the distance we have fallen short but the distance we have travelled....we shall go forward as one nation."



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Scottish MPs to be barred from voting on English laws

■ 'English question' answered: Conservative MPs had threatened to block proposals to devolve more power to Scotland unless more powers are handed to England

The Prime Minister was expected to make a statement on Friday setting out measures to ensure that only English parliamentarians vote on English-only issues.

It comes after the Prime Minister, Ed Miliband and Nick Clegg made a "vow" to devolve more powers to the Scottish government in the wake of a No vote.

That prompted anger from Conservative MPs who threatened to block the proposals unless more powers were devolved to England.

However, Mr Cameron is expected to reject calls by Tory MPs to have a separate English parliament.

Michael Gove, the chief whip, said Mr Cameron's statement would recognise that in the wake of the increased powers going to the Scottish government "the rest of the United Kingdom needs to have its position enhanced as well".

He said: "We need to look again at the arrangements which look after the people who live in the majority of the United Kingdom and I think the Prime Minister in particular will be spelling out some ways forward which will allow Westminster to change how it operates in order to ensure that the interests of English voters are effectively protected - indeed enhanced.

"If decisions are taken which affect only the people of England, or

only the people of England, Wales and Northern Ireland, then we need more clearly to respect the wishes of folk in those particular countries.

"But I don't think we want to go down the route of an English parliament."

It is understood the Prime Minister will say he wants the new measures implemented "swiftly" to address the "English question" raised by the Scottish independence debate.

'whole raft of goodies'

It will stop Scottish MPs voting on issues that affect English voters in areas where powers have already been devolved to Holyrood, such as health and education.

Mr Cameron was facing a growing rebellion from back-benchers and even

his own ministers over his offer to give Scotland more powers over tax and welfare spending in the event that it chooses to remain in the Union.

Claire Perry, the rail minister, said that the pledge by the three main parties to maintain the current level of funding for Scotland and devolve local taxes is "hardly equitable" to those in England.

She warned against giving Scotland "financial party bags" with "a whole raft of goodies" which will have to be "paid for by us south of the border to try and appease the Yes voters".

Mrs Perry wrote an article in the Wiltshire Gazette and Herald, her local newspaper, in which she said: "The funding formula for Scotland, the rather cobbled together Barnett formula, already

delivers per capita funding north of the border well in excess of that spent per head in the other parts of the union.

'cool calm analysis'

"If there is a proposal to allow devolution of local taxation, as well as maintaining the current level of funding a

dollop from the UK Parliament, then that can hardly be equitable for those of us in the Devizes constituency and all other areas in the non-Scottish union.

"Cool, calm analysis, not promises of financial party bags to appease Mr Salmond, are what is needed from tomorrow and onwards, but either

way I am expecting Parliament to be recalled next week to understand the result and any proposed settlement."

It came as a poll by Dods, a leading political information service, found that eight in 10 Tory MPs are opposed to maintaining the high levels of public spending in Scotland.

Cagey Murray finally comes out in favor of Scottish independence

■ Tweet on eve of vote ends staunch refusal to show his colors

Tennis star Andy Murray appeared to declare his support for Scottish independence in an 11th hour intervention on Thursday morning, after years of keeping silent on the issue.

Having refused to be drawn on the subject in the past, Murray seemed to tweet his support for the Yes campaign to his 2.7 million followers.

The 27-year-old Wimbledon champion - one of Scotland's highest profile nationals - nailed his colours to the mast just hours before polls opened, writing: "Huge day for Scotland today! No campaign negativity last few days totally swayed my view on it. excited to see the outcome. lets do this!"

campaign tactics

Murray, who grew up in Dunblane, Stirling, has previously expressed his admiration for staunch No supporter Gordon Brown, however on Thursday suggested he had been put off by the No camp's recent campaign tactics.

His tweet received mixed reactions from his fans. One wrote: "Aw nice one Andy! (Left it a wee bit late there, could you no have come out a bit

sooner" While one follower from the No side said: "Disappointed in you andy, you may have just swayed the undecided."

As a long-time resident of Surrey, Murray will not have a vote but he has generally been seen as a firm Scottish nationalist - drumming up controversy in 2006 when he said he would support "anyone but England" in the World Cup.

'snap decision'

Murray has been quizzed on the issue previously but dodged the question, although in an interview in June he criticised Alex Salmond, the Scottish First Minister, for waving the country's flag at the tournament last year.

When pressed on the issue of independence in an interview after his Wimbledon victory, he said: "You don't want to come to a snap decision and then see the country go t*** up.

"I am proud to be Scottish, but I am also proud to be British. I don't think there is any contradiction in that."

Speaking just last month, he said that he had not given it much thought as he did not

think it looked likely the result would be a Yes.

"If Scotland became independent, then I imagine I would be playing for Scotland," he said.

"I haven't thought that much about that yet because I don't think it's looking too likely that it's going to happen. But if it did happen, then it would be pretty much the first time in my life that I would have ever (had the chance to play for Scotland)."

He added that he did not like making his views on politics known as previous comments had "caused me a headache ... and a lot of abuse".

And sure enough with minutes of declaring his allegiance Murray began to receive some shocking hate-filled comments on the social media site.

Someone known as Harry S who posts on twitter as @sportingharry said: "Wish U had been killed at Dunblane you miserable anti-British hypocritical little git. Your life will be a misery from now on."

Police Scotland Assistant Chief Constable Bernard Higgins responded to the abuse by telling reporters:

"We are monitoring social

media and where appropriate will take action against those involved.

'too good to miss'

Murray's apparent support for the Yes campaign follows messages from celebrities, as well as US presidents past and present, urging Scots to vote no.

More than 200 famous

names, including rockers Sir Paul McCartney, Sting and Mick Jagger; composer Andrew Lloyd Webber; comedian Eddie Izzard; model Stella Tenant; actresses Helena Bonham-Carter and Dame Judi Dench, Simon Cowell, and Stephen Hawking signed a letter urging Scotland to stay in the union.

US President Barack Obama said on

Wednesday that a united Britain has been a valuable ally for the US and one he wants to keep "strong and robust."

However Murray will find support in fellow Scot, Sir Sean Connery, who said in March: "Simply put - there is no more creative an act than creating a new nation. I believe the opportunity of independence is too good to miss."



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KATE: acute morning sickness



Suffering Kate to skip solo Malta trip

The Duchess of Cambridge will not travel to Malta for her first official solo overseas visit because of acute morning sickness.

Kate is suffering from hyperemesis gravidarum - just like when she carried Prince George.

The family decided to cancel the Malta visit in consultation with the Duchess's doctors.

Her husband, the Duke of Cambridge, will take her place.

In a statement Kensington Palace said: "The Duchess of Cambridge will no longer visit Malta this weekend. The Duke of Cambridge will undertake the visit instead."

"Her Royal Highness continues to suffer from the effects of Hyperemesis Gravidarum. The decision not to travel was taken by the Duke and Duchess on the advice of the Duchess's doctors.

"The Duke is honoured to represent Her Majesty The Queen on the visit, which commemorates the 50th anniversary of Malta's independence.

"The visit itinerary remains unchanged."

Kate and William were forced to announce the pregnancy earlier this month before the 12-week period because of the Duchess' illness.

The illness causes severe vomiting and can lead to dehydration, weight loss and a build-up of toxins in the blood or urine.

It affects 3.5 out of each 1,000 pregnancies.

The Duchess had been due to visit Malta's national library to see letters from British monarchs Henry VIII and George II.

She would have also taken part in Independence Day celebrations and a number of walkabouts.

Islamic extremists release new British hostage video

A third British hostage has been paraded by Isil extremists as the terrorist organisation appeared on Thursday night to adopt new tactics in its attempts to undermine the Government.

In a video posted online John Cantlie, a photojournalist and war correspondent who has worked for several national newspapers, says that he has been "abandoned" by Britain and appeals for the Government to "negotiate" with his captors.

Unlike previous videos, he appears alone and is not threatened with beheading. The murderer known as Jihadi John - who has killed three hostages and last week threatened the life of a volunteer British aid worker - does not appear.

'Unwinnable conflict'

Instead, Mr Cantlie promises a series of "programmes" in which he will reveal the "truth behind the systems and motivation of the Islamic State" and how the West is embroiled in "yet another unwinnable conflict". He says his "fate lies in the hands of the Islamic State".

Previously Islamic State in Syria and the Levant (Isil) has used videos to threaten captives with death unless their governments cease aggression.

Mr Cantlie suggests that David Cameron's government should pay a ransom for hostages, something the Prime Minister has flatly refused to do but which other European countries are believed to have agreed to.

Thursday also marked the first time that Isil has

attempted atrocities outside the Middle East. Fifteen people were arrested in Australia over an alleged plot to behead someone at random in Sydney "within days".

France announced on Thursday that its forces would join air strikes against Isil in Iraq but not in Syria.

Mr Cantlie is the third Briton involved in an Isil hostage video. Earlier this month David Haines, an aid worker, was beheaded by the group and Alan Henning, a volunteer aid worker, was told he would be next to die.

'nothing to lose'

Mr Cantlie, 43, of Haslemere, Surrey, appears to hold little hope that he will survive. He says: "You're thinking, he's only doing this because he's a prisoner. He's got a gun at his head and he's being forced to do this. Right? Well it's true, I am a prisoner... But seeing as I've been abandoned by my government and my fate lies in the hands of the Islamic State I have nothing to lose.

"Maybe I will live, maybe I will die. But I

want to take this opportunity to convey some facts that you can verify."

In the video, entitled "Lend me your ears", Mr Cantlie sits at a table in a darkened room wearing orange Guantánamo-style robes that three other western hostages were made to wear before they were killed. He speaks directly to the camera clasping his hands in front of him in the style of a news presenter.

'very distressing'

Philip Hammond, the Foreign Secretary, said that the footage would be examined "closely", adding: "These videos can be very distressing for the families of the individuals involved." At the weekend it emerged that Mr Haines had become the first Briton to be murdered by a man believed to be the British-accented terrorist known as "Jihadi John", who has beheaded two American journalists.

In a video of his killing the terrorists threatened to murder Mr Henning, a 47-year-old from Manchester who was captured in Syria late last

year.

Mr Cantlie, who has worked for The Telegraph, The Sunday Times and The Sun, says in the latest footage that he came to Syria in November 2012 and was later captured by Isil.

He adds: "After two disastrous and hugely unpopular wars in Afghanistan and Iraq, why is it that our governments appear so keen to get involved in yet another unwinnable conflict.

"I'm going to show you the truth behind the systems and motivation of the Islamic State and how the Western media, the very organisation I used to work for, can twist and manipulate that truth for the public back home."

Baroness Neville Jones, a former security minister, said that the video suggested that Isil is trying to "drum up support" in the wake of the "extremely brutal murders" of other hostages.

The Quilliam Foundation, a counter-extremism think tank, said the video was a sign that Isil is becoming "desperate".

■ Royal and Ancient Golf Club votes to accept women members

This week's independence plebiscite was not the only momentous vote taking place in Scotland this week.

In a move almost as earth-shaking as the possibility of Scottish secession, The Royal and Ancient Golf Club has voted in favour of allowing women members for the first time in its 260-year history.

The St Andrews-based club has 2,400 global members who were entitled to vote and more than three-quarters took part in the ballot.

Of those that voted, 85% were in favour of change.

"This is an important and positive day in the history of the R&A Golf Club," said chief executive Peter Dawson.

"The R&A has served the sport of golf well for 260 years and I am confident that the club will continue to do so in future with the support of all its members, both women and men."

Dawson added that the vote would take immediate effect and a "significant" initial number of women would be fast-tracked to membership in the

coming months to avoid the long waiting list.

Founded in 1754, the Royal and Ancient's members play on the St Andrews links course regarded as the "home of golf".

Before Thursday's vote, women could play on the course, on Scotland's east coast, but they were not allowed in the clubhouse and had no significant part in the sport's rulemaking arm, the R&A.

That body, separated from the club 10 years ago, controls golf around the world apart from in the United States and Mexico.

A statement from the Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA) backed the results of the ballot.

DOWNTON Abbey star Laura Carmichael has spoken out about George Clooney's guest appearance on Downton Abbey.

The actress, who plays Lady Edith in the hit period drama, described the Hollywood superstar as "hilarious" before revealing that it is Dame Maggie Smith that ends up falling for his charm on set.

Speaking on the popular ITV breakfast show This Morning, the 28-year-old admitted that it was all very up in the air and none of the cast even knew if he was going to put in an appearance or not.

"We didn't even know if it would actually happen until he turned up," she said.

"We were filming away and then heard 'he's here, he's here, he's arrived'... But he was wonderful and so brilliant and I'm very excited for everyone to see it."

"There is a very brilliant moment with Maggie and George - and I don't know if I want to give away any more than that really - but Maggie does a very comedy fall," she divulged.

EU vacuum ban helps stores suck up sales

A rush to buy high-powered vacuum cleaners to beat an EU ban helped push UK retail sales higher in August.

The Office for National Statistics (ONS) said it measured a surge in sales last month as new rules meant that from September 1, companies were unable to manufacture or import any vacuums with motors above 1,600 watts.

The move was designed to boost energy efficiency and tackle climate change - with the EU insisting the law would not have an

impact on cleanliness as the motor's power did not determine its efficiency.

The ONS said it also noticed a 23.4% leap in furniture sales on the same period last year - with desks and flat-pack

furniture leading the way as students prepared for a new university academic year.

Total retail sales rose 3.9% on the year last month, the ONS said, with volumes 0.4% higher

than in July.

Consumer spending has been crucial to the UK's economic recovery, helped by rising employment, record-low interest rates and weak inflation - especially in the supermarket sector.

However, wage increases have failed to keep pace with rising prices, reducing consumer spending power.

Concerns over pay have helped ease pressure on rate-setters at the Bank of England, as they consider the prospect of a hike in borrowing costs.

Just the recipe for Sunday evenings this Fall: Miss Marple on PBS

THE WEATHER may still be roasting in Southern California but the autumn nights are drawing in and there are few better companions for a Sunday evening than Miss Marple and PBS.

Sundays, September 21st and 28th sees British actress Julia McKenzie return as the timeless spinster sleuth in three new episodes of the popular Agatha Christie series — “A Caribbean Mystery,” “Greenshaw’s Folly” and “Endless Night.”

A **Caribbean Mystery** (Sunday, September 21st, 8-9:30pm) finds Miss Marple staying at a lavish tropical island hotel, where she soon investigates the sudden death of a fellow guest. With the help of a curmudgeonly business tycoon, they unravel a web of deceit, murder and “dark magic,” leaving Miss Marple to consider every one of the hotel’s guests as a suspect. Sir Antony Sher guest stars.

Greenshaw’s Folly (Sunday, September 21st, 9:30-11pm) sees Miss Marple asked for help by an old family friend and her young

son. She finds them work and lodging at nearby Greenshaw’s Folly, the family home of an eccentric botanist. All seems well, until the house’s loyal butler dies unexpectedly. When another houseguest goes missing, Miss Marple begins a search for the truth, unveiling secrets of both the past and present.

In **Endless Night** (Sunday, September 28, 9-10:30pm) Miss Marple befriends Mike, a charming working-class chauffeur who recounts his romance with Ellie, an American heiress. Despite being warned off by an elusive gypsy woman, they plan their dream home at a local spot known as Gypsy’s Acre. Not long after the young couple is wed, Ellie is thrown from her horse and dies, fueling speculation of a gypsy curse. Following two more suspicious deaths, Miss Marple begins to sort out the clues, but can she solve the mystery before she finds herself in danger? Tom Hughes and Joanna Vanderham.

Lansbury to kick off national tour of *Blithe Spirit* at the Ahmanson

The ageless, timeless and quite wonderful British treasure known as Angela Lansbury will launch the North American tour of her acclaimed production of “*Blithe Spirit*” from December 9th at the Ahmanson Theatre in downtown LA.

Lansbury, who first moved to Hollywood in 1940 and has been acting ever since, has played the eccentric medium and clairvoyant, Madame Arcati in this Noel Coward classic to sold-out engagements both on Broadway and in London’s West End.

The play concerns the socialite and novelist Charles Condomine, who invites Madame Arcati to his house to conduct a séance, hoping to gather material for his next

book. The scheme backfires when he is haunted by the ghost of his annoying and temperamental first wife, Elvira, after the séance. Elvira makes continual attempts to disrupt Charles’s marriage to his second wife, Ruth, who cannot see or hear the ghost.

The play was first seen in the West End in 1941, creating a new long-run record for non-musical British plays of 1,997

performances. It also did well on Broadway later that year, running for 657 performances. Coward adapted the play for film in 1945, starring Rex Harrison, and directed a musical adaptation, *High Spirits*, on Broadway in 1964. It was also adapted for television in the 1950s and 1960s and for radio. The play enjoyed several West End and Broadway revivals in the 1970s and

1980s and was revived again in London in 2004, 2011 and 2014. It returned to Broadway in February 2009, with Lansbury starring. The play is directed by Michael Blakemore and co-stars Charles Edwards, Susan Louise O’connor, Charlotte Parry, Jemima Rooper and Sandra Shipley.

Goodbye Marilyn: A Love Letter struggling for focus

Marilyn Monroe (Melanie Cruz) enters her bedroom. She seems lost and listless, unfocused, drunk and full of self-pity. Feeling abandoned and ignored by her lovers JFK and his brother Bobby, and in an attempt to dull her pain, she downs numerous pills, till Marilyn suddenly finds herself in her room with ex-husbands Joe DiMaggio (Adam Selmon), and Arthur Miller (Chris Karmiol), fathoms of her barbiturate-and-vodka-soaked mind.

Director Michael Philips has written a piece that gives a fictional alternative

to the last hours of Marilyn’s life, but instead of tragically dying alone, he has given her companions to ease her passing.

It is in the context of her personal life, her marriages and sexual relationships, the abandonment and abuse of her early life, played out through reminiscent conversations, enactments of first meetings, and rehashing of old grievances, that we see Marilyn’s need for love, admiration, and her deep desire for a familial belonging she never had as a child, and that she had hoped to find with these men.

Philips says his intention when writing the play was not to answer

any questions about the circumstances of Marilyn’s death, rather to present the comforting idea that she did not die alone, that “As we are dying, our loved ones come and give us peace”. A nice idea indeed, but sadly, it’s his desire not to answer any questions that is the problem with this piece - it lacks purpose and the actor must struggle to find its focus. The actors do their best to bring this piece to life, but the characters feel underwritten. This becomes very apparent in the abrupt ending of the play. The audience felt like they’d had the rug pulled from under them and that there was missing some vital piece of information.

The staging isn’t helpful

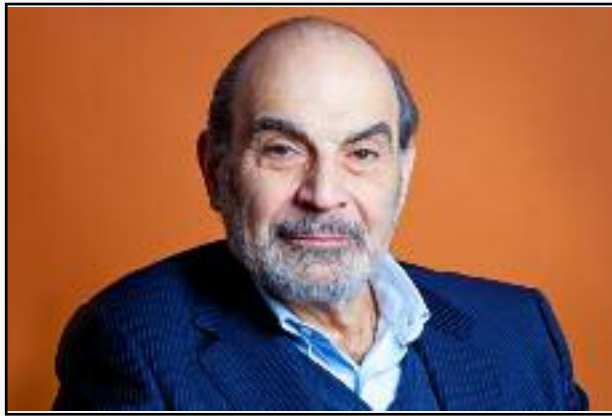
either. Granted, the director has limited options in such a small theatre space, but the set and lighting design are rudimentary and lack ingenuity.

However, the play is not without its good moments. In the dialogue, Philips has recreated the snappy vernacular of the period very well, and the interaction between the ex-husbands and Marilyn is not without wit, humor and pathos, which are played well by all three actors.

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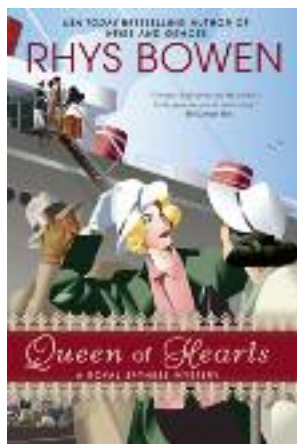
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Queen of Hearts: Bowen plays a trump card

"Everything has to be right," says *Queen of Hearts* author Rhys Bowen. "So this book takes Georgie across the Atlantic on a luxury liner, and in the interest of art and accuracy I had to cross the Atlantic on the Queen Mary 2. You see how we writers have to suffer... It actually gave me wonderful insights."

Amateur sleuth Georgie and her mother Claire Daniels, the glamorous and much-married actress, are aboard the RMS Berengaria en route to America. Movie mogul Cy Goldman wants Claire to

star in his latest film, a talkie to film in Hollywood. Onboard the ship, jewelry is being stolen. Georgie's beau Darcy O'Mara is undercover on board the ship trying to track down the thief.

Bowen brings aristocratic glamour to Hollywood. The details about the transatlantic trip aboard the Berengaria and little aspects of vintage Hollywood and Beverly Hills are a fun twist in the Royal Spyness series. The

series started in 2007 and now comprises eight books. This book is great fun and an easy read and the interaction between Georgie and her mother leaves you hungry for more.

Georgie's full title is Lady Georgiana Rannoch, thirty-fifth in line for the British throne. She's been invited on an all-expenses-paid trip by her mother because she wants to divorce her husband Homer Clegg and decides on Reno as the best place to do it quickly. Once in Hollywood Cy invites everyone to his house...which is more of a castle. On arrival they find out Cy's wife will be there too. It's all pretty civilized, until Cy gets murdered. Who did it? Can Georgie solve the mystery?

The first book in the mysetery series, *Her Royal Spyness*, is being made into a motion picture in

England. Bowen says the character of Georgie hasn't changed that much in the course of eight books. "A little more worldly-wise perhaps, and a little more savvy at investigating crimes, but still penniless, still striving to make her own way in a difficult world, and still a virgin, I regret to say."

To research her latest book, besides taking a cruise, Bowen looked at lots of old newsreel clips of Beverly Hills from the Thirties. There was almost nothing there at that time apart from the hotel. She says she found lots of photographs taken on the Berengaria. "I knew what every space there looked like," says Bowen.

Books in Royal Spyness series have won an Agatha, a MacAvity, an RT Reviewer's Choice, an award for best mystery series, and had many nominations. "One of the

books also just won an Audie for best female narration for the audio version," says Bowen, "with Katherine Kellgren, my narrator, beating out Meryl Streep."

Jackie Cantor is Bowen's editor at Penguin. "She's been with me since book one and I adore her," says Bowen. "She is so easy to work with and my biggest cheerleader."

Meg Ruley at Janerosen in New York is Bowen's agent. "She is simply the best, and nicest and I adore her too," says Bowen.

Bowen is currently writing the next Lady Georgie book called *Malice at the Palace* set at a royal wedding. Bowen will be at the Capital Book Festival in Sacramento in October and the Tucson book festival in March.

Bowen lives in Marin County, California during the summer and in Arizona in the winter. She

Amy died aged 27 after struggles with

alcohol and drugs. An inquest into her death found that she died of accidental alcohol poisoning.

Her family later set up a charity, The Amy Winehouse Foundation, to prevent the effects of drug and alcohol misuse on young people.

■ City keeper upbeat despite last-gasp Champions League defeat at Bayern

Manchester City goalkeeper Joe Hart is confident his team can qualify for the knockout stage of the Champions League despite losing their first group match.

City were beaten 1-0 by Bayern Munich on Wednesday night after a last-minute strike from former City defender Jerome Boateng.

Last season, City overcame an early loss to Bayern to reach the last 16.

"Last year we had a poor start against Bayern but we won the rest of our games and qualified - we're confident we can do it again this time," said Hart, 27.

The Premier League champions were indebted to their goalkeeper, who made a string of saves to keep the score at 0-0 before Boateng's strike deflected off Mario Gotze's back to hand Bayern the points.

City came close to equalising in stoppage

time when substitute Sergio Aguero burst past Dante but poked his shot wide.

"We fought hard all night against a really good team and had chances as well," said Hart. "We played well but just a nasty deflection at the end hurt. Jerome Boateng came back to haunt us."

Boateng spent the 2010-11 season at City before he was sold to Bayern.

Hart added: "We made good clearances, we made good blocks and we made them work hard for everything."

In the other Group E contest, Roma showed their pedigree with a 5-1 thrashing of CSKA Moscow.

City host the Italians in their next Champions League game on 30 September, before back-to-back games against CSKA.

"We showed that we

can match Bayern Munich but we have some very tough games now and we have to play well against CSKA and Roma," added Hart.

Bayern boss Pep Guardiola fully expects the group to go right to the wire.

"We know how difficult this group is," said the 43-year-old former Barcelona coach. "We know it will not be decided until the last game so to start with this victory is very important for us."

Former Arsenal full-back Bacary Sagna, who was making his European debut for City, urged his team-mates to swiftly put the Bayern game behind them and focus on Sunday's Premier League game against leaders Chelsea.

"It's very bad because until the end we were focused and we conceded a poor goal," said the 31-year-old.

Wenger: Give Welbeck time

Manager Arsene Wenger says Arsenal "have to be patient" with new signing Danny Welbeck after his miss proved costly in the 2-0 Champions League defeat at Borussia Dortmund in midweek.

The 23-year-old England forward, a £16m arrival from Manchester United this month, shot wide when clean through with the Group D game goalless.

Dortmund scored either side of half-time to secure victory.

"Danny will improve - we don't have to make a problem of that," said Wenger.

"He had a very lively first half. He had two or three good chances but couldn't finish them. There was one obvious one. We have to be patient with him."

Welbeck scored both goals as England beat Switzerland 2-0 in a Euro 2016 qualifier on 8 September.

But he has not found the net at club level since scoring for United in a 3-0 Premier League win at West Brom on 8 March.

After Welbeck's miss at Signal Iduna Park, Ciro Immobile gave the home side the lead with a low shot, before Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang finished

another fine breakaway.

Aubameyang also hit the crossbar in a game that saw Dortmund have 22 shots to Arsenal's four.

Defeat in their opening game leaves the Gunners - competing in the Champions League for the 17th successive season - bottom of the group after Galatasaray and Anderlecht drew 1-1.

"It's very difficult to go into any individual assessment of any player because as a team we were not at the requested level," said Wenger.

Arsenal face Galatasaray at Emirates Stadium in their next Champions League game on 1 October.
