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# OUTRAGE AT RELEASE OF TRIPLE COP KILLER

A notorious police killer is to be released from prison in a decision described as "scandalous, hurtful and abhorrent".

Harry Roberts, 78, was jailed for life for murdering three unarmed officers in Shepherd's Bush, west London, in 1966.

They were shot when they approached a van containing Roberts and two others, after an armed robbery.

Home Secretary Theresa May said she strongly believed police murderers should be behind bars for life.

London Mayor Boris Johnson called the decision "sickening".

The Metropolitan Police Federation said the decision was a "betrayal of policing" by the judicial system.

It said Roberts' planned release, approved by a Parole Board panel, was a "scandalous, hurtful and abhorrent decision which opens the door even further for those who have scant regard for law and order".

"Those who place their lives on the line to protect the public deserve better

than this terrible outcome," it added.

But Deputy Prime Minister Nick Clegg defended the Parole Board, saying it was not about "feelings" but "how the justice system works".

"If you want to run the system according to the latest emotion you feel, fine, but that would be a disaster," he said on his

phone-in show on LBC.

Roberts could be released from Littlehey Prison in Cambridgeshire within days, although it could take up to three weeks. He will have to adhere to strict conditions.

The murders of PC Geoffrey Fox, 41, Sgt Christopher Head, 30 and 25-year-old Det Con

David Wombwell became one of the most infamous crimes of the 1960s, causing public outrage.

Roberts and two associates - John Duddy and John Witney - had been sitting in a van near Wormwood Scrubs prison when three policemen approached to ask questions.

Roberts shot dead Mr Wombwell and Mr Head, while Mr Fox was killed by another member of the gang.

### Jungle training

Roberts was on the run for 90 days, using his Army jungle training to camp out in Hertfordshire, where he was eventually arrested.

He has now been in prison for 18 years longer than the 30-year minimum term recommended by the trial judge.

Responding to the Parole Board decision, Home Secretary Theresa May said: "Policemen and women go out to work every day knowing that they might face great danger and they carry out their duties with great courage.

"I strongly believe that anyone who murders a police officer belongs behind bars - and behind bars for life."

# Tories set for another humiliating by-election defeat, says new poll

**The Conservatives are heading for another humiliating defeat at Ukip's hands in the crucial Rochester and Strood by-election, according to a survey by leading British polling firm ComRes.**

The poll shows Nigel Farage's party has opened a 13-point lead over the Tories ahead of the contest on 20 November, which was triggered by the defection of the party of Mark Reckless, the former Tory MP for the Kent constituency. He looks set to become Ukip's second elected MP.

### leadership contest

The findings are a huge setback for David Cameron, who is desperate to avoid a second by-election disaster following Douglas Carswell's victory in Clacton this month. Rochester and Strood is seen as the most important by-election for many years. If the Tories lose, some of their MPs may try to oust Mr Cameron by forcing a party leadership contest. But Cameron allies doubt his critics would split the party six months before a general election.

The ComRes survey of 1,500 adults in Rochester

and Strood, commissioned by Ukip, puts the party on 43 per cent, the Tories on 30 per cent, Labour on 21 per cent, the Liberal Democrats on three per cent, the Greens on two per cent and others on one per cent. Ukip's 13-point advantage is four points higher than the previous poll in the constituency and suggests the Tories' decision to "throw the kitchen sink" at the by-election is not working.

Mr Cameron has ordered Tory MPs to make at least three visits and ministers are flocking to the area. But ComRes found that 66 per cent of local people believe the Tories "are coming across as desperate" by sending so many politicians there.

The findings suggest the Tories will struggle to halt Ukip's bandwagon. Mr Cameron's main hope may be to woo the still sizeable Labour vote, as the Tories did during the Newark by-election in June, when they saw off Ukip by appealing to Labour and Lib Dem supporters. That might require a change of tone by the Prime Minister, who has ramped up his anti-EU rhetoric in the past week by promising measures to curb migration from other EU

member states.

### 'huge boost'

Although one in five local people (19 per cent) says they might change their mind before polling day, current Ukip supporters are the least likely group to do so. Some 88 per cent of them are "very" or "fairly" sure they will back Ukip. But one in four Labour supporters may change their mind.

A majority of voters (53 per cent) believe Mr Reckless "did the principled thing" by leaving the Tories and

joining Ukip. Some 50 per cent believe he is being unfairly attacked by his former Tory colleagues, while 40 per cent do not. However, 52 per cent think that Mr Reckless "cost the taxpayer a lot of money unnecessarily" by forcing the by-election.

Six out of 10 people (62 per cent) agree that the contest is "a good opportunity" to show how unhappy they are with the Government.

If Mr. Cameron were to lose control of his party, either before or after the next election, the red-hot

favorite to replace him would be Boris Johnson. The London Lord Mayor is more popular than Cameron, who is in turn regarded favourably by more people than Mr Reckless and Mr Farage.

Patrick O'Flynn, a Ukip MEP and the party's economic spokesman, said: "These results are a huge boost to our campaign and will further raise the morale of our 'people's army' of volunteers that is working to get Mark Reckless re-elected in Rochester and Strood."



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# Tributes flow as Bellingham dies of cancer

■ Actress lauded as 'consummate professional'

■ "She was funny, she was loyal, talented and a great mum," says *All Creatures* co-star

**British actress and presenter Lynda Bellingham, who had cancer, has died at the age of 66, her agent has confirmed.**

Sue Latimer said she died earlier this week "in her husband's arms".

The actress, best known for her long-running role as a mother in the Oxo TV adverts, had been battling colon cancer since being diagnosed in July 2013.

Bellingham said she had planned to end her treatment to limit her family's suffering after it spread to her lungs and liver.

In a statement on behalf of Bellingham's family, Mrs Latimer said: "Lynda died peacefully in her husband's arms yesterday at a London hospital."

She added: "Actor, writer and presenter - to the end Lynda was a consummate professional."

Bellingham was also known for such shows as the long-running BBC hit *All Creatures Great and Small* and in more recent years was on the panel of *Loose Women*, an ITV

lifestyle and chat show that has been broadcast since 1999.

Husband Michael Pattermore told *Yours* magazine, for which his late wife was a columnist, that she had been unable to die at home as she had hoped.

"She was in too much pain and they didn't have it under control enough for me to be able to look after her," he said.

He told the magazine: "I just want her to be remembered as an actress more than anything, not as a celebrity or one of the *Loose Women*."

"She started her career as an actress and never thought of herself as a celebrity - she's always been an actress."

Speaking earlier this month, Bellingham said her decision to give up chemotherapy was "a huge relief because I took back some control of myself".

The first 20 minutes of Monday's *Loose Women* was dedicated to the show's former co-host.

"The mood is very different in the studio today," host Ruth

Langsford said. "It's a very sad day for us here on *Loose Women*... but we want this to be a celebration of Lynda."

Bellingham's friend Christopher Biggins gave an emotional tribute, telling the show: "Last night was a very difficult night, but I went to bed laughing, thinking of a joke she used to tell over and over again.

"It's a blessing in a way, we don't want her to suffer any more."

Colleen Nolan, a panellist on the programme, was visibly moved but singer Jane McDonald, who also used to work on *Loose Women*, said Bellingham "would be mortified if we were all sad, weeping and wailing".

## 'Naughty and funny'

She added: "We have to keep the spirit of Lynda alive."

During an emotional appearance on the show recently, the actress told viewers: "Grasp it all, don't be afraid, enjoy the bits you can and tell your family you love them while you have the

chance."

After her death was announced, Christopher Timothy, who starred opposite Bellingham in *All Creatures Great and Small*, described her as "a real friend".

"She was a life force. She was funny, she was loyal, talented and a great mum," he told the BBC.

Michael Redfern, who played Bellingham's TV husband in the Oxo commercials that became a national institution, said "everyone liked her".

"I think she was just normal, I think that's all it was," he said. "She was like the lady next door, the wife, your mother. She had everything, just a

very open person."

Kaye Adams, another of Bellingham's *Loose Women* co-presenters, said Bellingham would be remembered as "honest, generous, kind, courageous, intelligent, thoughtful".

Bellingham was born in Montreal, Canada, but

grew up near Aylesbury in Buckinghamshire after being adopted.

She studied at the Central School of Speech and Drama.

The actress, who had two sons and was married three times, was awarded an OBE in 2013 for her charity work.

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# 'White' taxi drivers a big selling point in sex scandal town

■ Rochdale firm offers 'local' drivers on request

**Minicab customers in the town caught up in Britain's biggest grooming scandal are being offered white drivers on request, it has emerged.**

Residents in Heywood in the Greater Manchester borough of Rochdale have been offered the service after two local drivers of Pakistani origin were jailed for their part in the rape and trafficking of young white girls.

Stephen Campbell, the manager of Car 2000, which took over Eagle Taxis, a firm that employed drivers at the heart of the scandal, said that a consequence of the affair was that many white customers ask for white drivers – or "local" drivers, as they usually describe them.

"We have had quite a lot of customers requesting what they call a 'local' driver. A bit insane if you consider that most of the [Asian] lads were born in Rochdale," he said.

"But it's a business and

we have got a duty to do what the customer asks us to. I don't think we can discriminate against the customer in the same way. It is a business at the end of the day. We have a large bank loan to pay back," he said.

## **grooming gangs**

If he could, Campbell said, he would persuade people to take any driver. "The Asian drivers are harder working, they do what they are asked and they don't complain about it. They have a much better work ethic. If the public could actually see these [Asian] people close up and see what they are about, I don't think they would be asking for white drivers."

The news emerged as MPs in areas where Asian grooming gangs have operated have expressed concern about racial tensions, which have yet to subside some six years after the scandals first emerged.

Heywood was at the centre of the Rochdale

scandal after a sex trafficking gang of men of mainly Pakistani origin were found to have preyed on at least 47 girls, all of whom were white. Two drivers from the now defunct local firm of Eagle Taxis were among nine Asian men jailed for their involvement.

Ukip ran a byelection campaign in Heywood and Middleton earlier this month focusing on the issues of child grooming and immigration and came within 617 votes of overturning a near 16,000 Labour majority.

## **sexual assault**

Simon Danczuk, the MP for Rochdale, said: "This is extremely worrying and a stark reminder of the impact that grooming scandals have had on northern towns. This will not be a problem exclusive to our borough, I'm sure."

The "white drivers on request" policy does not breach the minicab firm's license and it can

continue with the policy, a spokesman for the council said. Mark Widdup, the director of economy and environment at Rochdale borough council, said: "This is first the council has heard of this company's policy. However, this appears to be a decision made by the company and there is currently nothing in the conditions of their license which state that they cannot operate such a policy, just as some firms choose to offer customers only female drivers."

Campbell, 34, said his father James bought into the Heywood firm in 2011. A few months later, they realised that Car

2000 was at the centre of a major scandal as it emerged that drivers from Eagle Taxis were embroiled in grooming allegations. Mohammed Amin, 45, of Falinge, a driver for 14 years who was known as "Car Zero", was convicted of sexual assault and received a five-year jail

term.

Abdul Aziz, 41, a married father-of-three from Rochdale who was also a driver, was convicted of trafficking for sexual exploitation, received a nine-year sentence. They were two of nine men initially convicted in a complex trial.

## **EU makes Britain pay for recovery**

■ Brussels demands £1.7bn more – because the UK's economy is doing better than its rivals

**The UK has been told it must pay an extra £1.7bn (2.1bn euros) towards the European Union's budget because of the country's relative economic health.**

The additional payment is a result of new calculations by the EU, which determines how much each member state should contribute based on gross national incomes.

The £1.7bn would add almost a fifth to the UK's annual net contribution.

It comes at a time of increased pressure on

David Cameron over Europe.

The recent success of the euro-sceptic UK Independence Party in by-elections has prompted renewed calls for the prime minister to renegotiate the terms of the UK's relationship with Europe.

Mr Cameron is currently meeting other EU leaders for a summit in Brussels.

A government source told the BBC: "It's not acceptable to just change

the fees for previous years and demand them back at a moment's notice.

"The European Commission was not expecting this money and does not need this money and we will work with other countries similarly affected to do all we can to challenge this."

Under the new calculations, the UK and the Netherlands are both being asked to pay more, while France and Germany are both set to receive rebates.

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# Alvin Stardust dies at 72

Singer Alvin Stardust has died aged 72 after a short illness.

He had recently been diagnosed with metastatic prostate cancer and died at home with his wife and family around him, his manager said.

Born Bernard Jewry in the East End of London in 1942, his hits included My Coo Ca Choo, Jealous Mind and I Feel Like Buddy Holly.

The former glam rock star had been due to release his first studio album in 30 years on November 3rd.

He recently announced the record, titled Alvin, was finished and would represent "a new and exciting departure" of which he was "immensely proud".

The singer had performed on stage at the Regal cinema in Evesham, Worcestershire on Saturday.

## indifferent career

Stardust grew up in Mansfield and started playing guitar as a schoolboy. He met one of his biggest influences, Buddy Holly, at a gig in Doncaster and played backstage with the singer and his band the Crickets.

He signed his first record deal in 1961 as the frontman of Shane Fenton and the Fentones, though the band struggled to get in the charts.

After an indifferent career throughout the 1960s that saw him never quite make the breakthrough he craved, things turned around dramatically in 1973 when he signed with Magnet Records and took on a new name, and adopted a dramatic new image.

"It started off as Elvin Starr, because they wanted a kind of rocky, country name," he recalled in 2010.

"But [a woman] who was doing promotion for us said it wasn't 'glam-rocky' enough, so it

became Stardust and then Alvin."

My Coo Ca Choo, the debut song under his new guise, peaked at number two in the UK singles chart.

Known for his rockabilly quiff, sideburns and black gloves, he projected a glowering persona he said he adopted because he was nervous and "didn't want to be found out".

His success led to him being part of a Green Cross Code road safety campaign in 1976, which saw him instructing children to look both ways before they crossed the road.

That success continued into the 1980s with Pretend, I Feel Like Buddy Holly and I Won't Run Away all making the top 10.

## musicals

Once described as "the Godfather of British Rock 'n' Roll" by Rolling Stone Keith Richards, he made sporadic acting appearances in Hollyoaks, The Grimleys and Doctors.

He also appeared on stage in such musicals as Godspell, The Phantom of the Opera and Chitty Chitty Bang Bang at the London Palladium, in which he played the fearsome Child Catcher. Stardust was married three times. His first wife was Iris Caldwell, with

whom he had two sons, Shaun and Adam.

His second wife was the actress Liza Goddard, with whom he had a daughter named Sophie. "RIP Alvin Stardust," Goddard tweeted on Thursday. "Thank you for our beautiful daughter and granddaughter."

Stardust went on to marry Julie Paton, an actress and choreographer, with whom he had a daughter, Millie.

Shaun is now a headmaster of a school in Reigate, while his brother is a producer and DJ who records under the name Adam F.

DJ Tony Blackburn remembered the singer as "a great showman" who would be "sorely missed". "Performing was his life," added the veteran broadcaster.

"He had this bad boy image, but he was not like that at all," Blackburn continued. "On stage he was brilliant, but off stage he was just an ordinary guy."

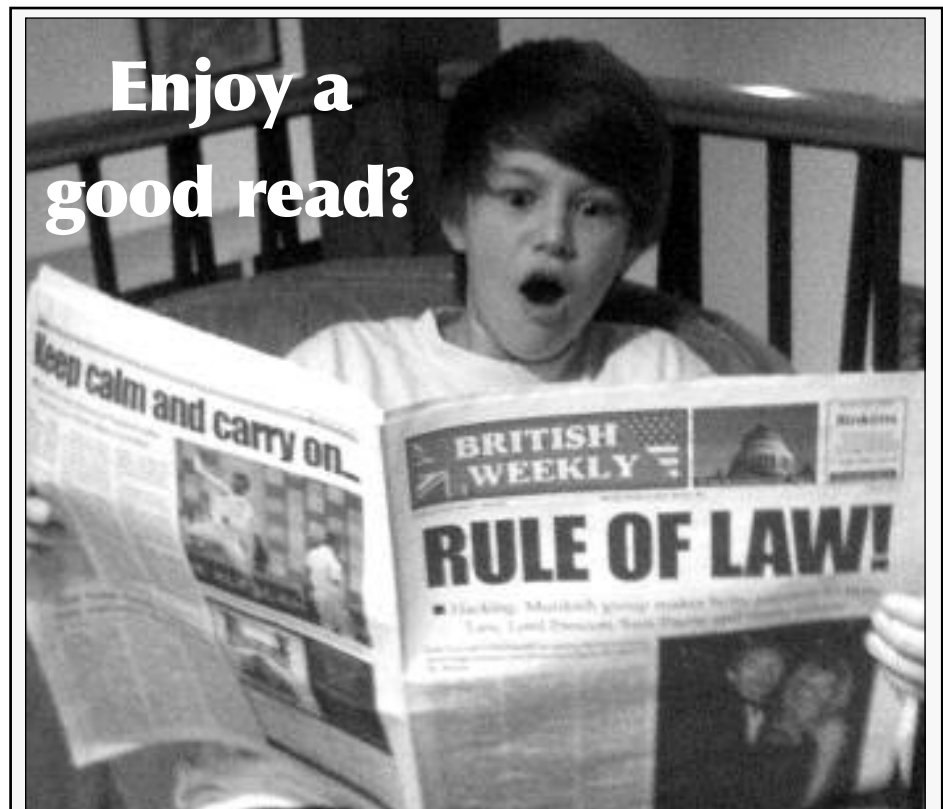
Stardust, a committed Christian, was also remembered as "a great bloke" by his former Hollyoaks co-star Jeremy Edwards.

"RIP Alvin Stardust, the original landlord of the Dog in the Pond," the actor wrote on Twitter, referring to the Channel 4 series' fictional public house.

"I may not have known him long, but even in that short time he proved to be one of the most genuine and likeable men I've ever met," said the singer's manager Andy Davies. "His passing is a huge and sad loss."



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# Three dead as Hurricane Gonzalo barrels into Britain

BRITAIN'S traditionally windy autumn weather took a darker turn this week as the remnants of Hurricane Gonzalo battered the country and caused three deaths and several injuries.

Winds of up to 108mph were recorded on Monday, and a woman died after she was crushed to death by a tall tree while walking through one of the most upmarket areas of London.

Paramedics tried in vain to resuscitate her, but she was pronounced dead at the scene at around 11.30am near Hyde Park Barracks in Knightsbridge, Central London.

A man in his 30s was also crushed to death as he

carried out repairs under a van in Essex.

The jack supporting the transit collapsed in the strong winds and the vehicle fell on top of the victim near his home in Canvey Island.

He has been named locally as builder Scott Powell.

One of the online tributes said: "Rip Scott, a real top bloke. Going to be missed. Thanks for your help mate, sleep well."

The other victim was a 63-year-old man who was killed when his Ford Fiesta smashed into a railway bridge in St Helens, Merseyside, while the area was lashed by heavy rain and 35mph gusts.

Police are investigating

the cause of the crash.

As well as the three deaths, at least five people were hurt during the storms.

A man thought to be in his 30s was taken to hospital with life-threatening leg, chest and head injuries after being hit by a falling tree in Belgravia, Central

London.

A terrified driver escaped from his sinking car which careered off the road and plunged into the water of a Fenland drainage ditch at Sixteen Foot Bank near March, Cambs.

The 21-year-old man was treated for minor injuries and shock after

getting out of the Ford Fiesta and scrambling up a muddy riverbank.

The high winds and heavy rain caused chaos for road, rail and air travellers.

At Leeds Bradford Airport, planes battled to land in the gusts.

Winds reached 69mph on the Cumbrian

coast and hit 108mph on the Cairngorms.

Hurricane Gonzalo caused havoc in Bermuda after developing in the Caribbean, and, thanks to unseasonal winds, turned east across the Atlantic, rather than following the more traditional hurricane path of hitting the eastern seaboard of the US.

## Britain's smallest home snapped up for £275,000

Britain's smallest home, which is less than half the size of a train carriage, has sold for £275,000 after the advert went viral.

The converted flower shop has just 188sq/ft of space and is a fifth of the size of the average new build.

It features a bed on a mezzanine, a tiny bathroom and an open plan kitchen and living area.

Despite going on the market for £275,000 there was no shortage of interest, with more than 220,000 people viewing the adverts on property sites Rightmove and Zoopla.

And after a flurry of enquiries and a number of offers, the house, in Islington, north London,

was quickly snapped up.

Hamish Allan, from estate agency Winkworth, said: "We had lots of interest from a broad range of potential buyers.

"There were first-time buyers, enquiries from people who wanted an extra or spare room and someone else who looked at buying it and putting it on AirBNB.

"It was only on for three weeks and we had a number of offers. The home is unique, there is no other way to describe it.

"It used to be a flower shop until the conversion. It is a really cleverly designed home and there is another bed which comes out, but we can't call it a two-bed home."

at the SNP party conference in Perth in November.

He said that he would "continue to offer to serve" as MSP for Aberdeenshire East after standing down with the next Scottish election being held in May 2016.

# Stoneheart Asylum: you really would be mad to miss it...

■ Panoply of British talent makes for a wonderful reimagining of Poe's creepy tale, writes **Debbie Lynn Elias**

**Madness and mayhem are the watchwords of the day when it comes to Stonehearst Asylum.**

Directed by Brad Anderson from a script by Joe Gangemi based on the 1844 story "The System of Doctor Tarr and Professor Feather" by Edgar Allan Poe, the film abounds with twists and turns set against a richly textured and lush, stylized Victorian-era visual palette. Boasting a panoply of British and Irish talent including Sir Ben Kingsley, Sir Michael Caine, David Thewlis, Brendan Gleeson, Jim Sturgess and Kate Beckinsale, among others, Anderson's genre mash-up touches on everything from Hitchcockian suspense to period drama to bloody horror to romance and even some macabre humor. Although things feel a bit directionally convoluted at times, where Anderson excels is keeping us riveted to the screen with the constant intrigue of this delicious descent into madness.

Setting the stage, we meet "The Alienist" (Brendan Gleeson), a Victorian-era medical school professor-cum-surgeon. Typical of the medical thinking of the day, women are dismissed as mere chattel and their illnesses are all diagnosed as "hysteria" with favored treatments being electro-shock therapy and placement in an asylum; after all,

"every mad woman insists she's sane" when she really isn't. And as The Alienist demonstrates on a drugged-out and obviously distressed young woman who pleads for sanctuary and help from the observing medical students, in The Alienist's thinking, a grope, jab and fondle of the females also goes a long way.

Meet recent Oxford graduate Edward Newgate (Jim Sturgess). Eager for clinical experience, he arrives at Stonehearst Asylum on Christmas Eve 1899 seeking a residency with Dr. Silas Lamb (Ben Kingsley), director of Stonehearst. Expecting to learn cutting edge treatment methods, Newgate is unprepared for Lamb's methodology. The inmates are running loose in the asylum. No shock treatments, no isolation, no restraints, no medication, the inmates are given free reign with every whim and desire not only met but encouraged.

And then there is Eliza Graves (Kate Beckinsale). Smitten with Eliza from the moment he lays eyes on her, Newgate believes her to be one of the staff and sets out to woo her. Imagine his surprise when he learns that she is, in fact, a patient, put into the asylum by her very brutal and vicious husband.

inmates have taken control of the asylum, with the real head of the facility, Dr. Salt (Michael Caine), imprisoned along with head nurse Mrs. Pike and the rest of the surviving staff. According to Salt and Mrs. Pike, the "lunatic demon" Lamb, himself at the asylum thanks to a complete psychotic break associated with war crimes and atrocities he committed, has already killed numerous staff and is now plotting to poison the rest. Knowing he must do something to help, but not wanting to leave for fear of never seeing Eliza again, Edward instead tries to gain more information on Lamb, believing he can

formulate his own plan for Salt to regain control of Stonehearst.

As Edward Newgate, Jim Sturgess steals the heart with a sincerity and kindness, while Kate Beckinsale glides through much of the film with an elegant beauty. But on the turn of a dime, we see the strong, confident, defiance so familiar to all who have seen her in the "Underworld" franchise. From the moment we see Edward's carriage pulling up to the asylum in a steely grey fog, Brad Anderson's direction sets the tone for psychological terror that is a fitting tribute to the tale's originator, Edgar Allan Poe. Together Anderson and

cinematographer Thomas Yatsko spare nothing when depicting the medical horrors of this world, with primitive electroshock treatments, rapes, homicidal tendencies and atrocities and bodies burning in fires, just to name a few of the visual treats on offer here.

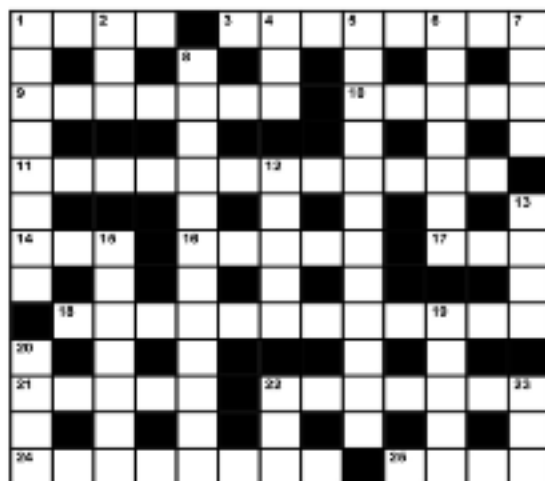

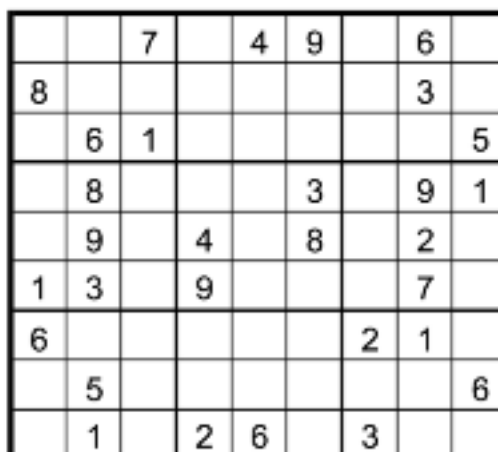

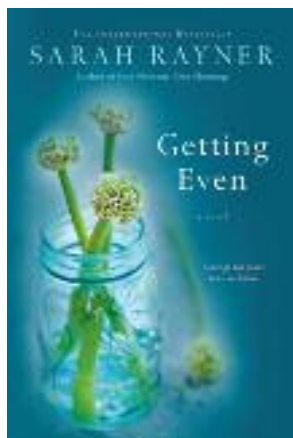

# Getting Even: hot tale best served cold

■ Exclusive interview with author Sarah Rayner and a review of her book about revenge

"Like Ivy, the anti-heroine in my novel, I was a copywriter," says *Getting Even* author Sarah Rayner.

"I worked in advertising for twenty years. Thus, when it came to writing about the machinations of an agency, I didn't have to research a great deal. Not that I am as bitchy as Ivy in my novel, or as vengeful, but it was more a case of turning up the volume on my experiences rather than

inventing them."

This is chick lit with a twist. Rayner brings suspense, intrigue and romance to the table and the story's twists and turns delight and keep the reader guessing. Ivy and Orianna work together at an ad agency in London. They present ad campaigns that win the company lots of money. Orianna is having an affair with a senior level executive and she gets Ivy's promotion. Ivy is out for

revenge.

Ivy and Orianna are opposite extremes. Ivy is vengeful and vindictive. Orianna is naive and clueless. At times you want to crack their heads together and say, wake up! This is an exploration of what not to do when your best friend betrays you. Rayner's writing is strong and holds readers. "I've heard actors say it's liberating to play a villain, and the same is true for an author," says Rayner. "I just relished that Ivy was able to say and do the things that a sense of propriety and professionalism prohibit me from voicing. To let rip through her was very cathartic. I also play with notion that in advertising it's often hard to tell where fact ends and fiction begins. That was very entertaining for me as an author, as it allowed me to poke fun,

in an affectionate way, at the industry that had supported me."

"Wherever Ivy goes there's bound to be trouble, and that has a lot of potential narratively," says Rayner. "I feel I know these all characters so well now. I'm rather tempted to throw them into a situation and just watch what happens. I suppose that most of my lead characters are likeable, although one or two of them are pretty blind, especially in *Getting Even*."

Rayner has written five novels, two set in London: *The Other Half* and *Getting Even*, and three are set in Brighton: *One Moment, One Morning*; *The Two Week Wait* and *Another Night, Another Day*. The latter will release in the U.S. in December. She gave up a career in advertising when her third novel,

*One Moment, One Morning*, became an international bestseller.

Sara Goodman at St. Martin's in the U.S. is Rayner's editor. Francesca Main at Picador is Rayner's UK editor.

"Sarah Rayner came to me from Picador UK, one of our Macmillan sister companies across the pond," says editor Sara Goodman. "Her novel *One Moment, One Morning* had become a publishing phenomenon. With its beautiful writing and searing emotional storyline, we quickly realized it would also be perfect for a U.S. audience. To my utter delight, Sarah informed me that she had published two novels back in the early 2000s that she was eager to bring back to life, *The Other Half* and *Getting Even*. We originally

# Rent dispute spells last call for the beloved Cat & Fiddle

DECEMBER 15th will mark the end of an era for the local British community as the venerable Cat & Fiddle in Hollywood finally shuts its doors.

The much-loved pub, which was founded in 1982 in Laurel Canyon by the late rock musician Kim Gardner and his wife Paula, has been an integral part of the local British scene for just about as long as anyone can remember, but has fallen victim to the gentrification of Hollywood – a process the Cat & Fiddle

itself helped make possible. The pub quickly outgrew its first location and in 1985 moved to Sunset Boulevard, just west of Wilcox Avenue, where it has been ever since. The pub's combination of a warm welcome and good beer and great food made it a hit not just with the locals but with anyone coming to Hollywood for a night out. The sprawling, tree-lined patio in particular has long made it almost unique among watering holes in the area.

Amid reports that a large

restaurant chain had offered the pub's landlord twice the current rent to take over the tenancy of the space, the British Weekly contacted owner Paula Gardner, who told us: "Yes, it's true I'm sorry to say. Because we don't own the lease we are at the mercy of the landlord. If he finds a new tenant who can offer him ten times what we're paying, we have to leave, it's a simple as that.

"I told the staff on Friday and by Saturday the news had leaked out. We've had hundreds of regulars

coming to the pub telling us how sorry they are. Hard as

it is, we have to move on and so we're currently looking for another location in Los Feliz. That's all I can tell you right now.

"Our last big night here looks like being our Halloween Party. We'd love to see all our friends, old and new, to help us go out with a bang."

The mood at the pub on Monday alternated between outrage and resignation. One regular, a transplanted Dubliner named Martin, who told us he'd been drinking at the Cat since 1985, summed up the mood.

"Oh man it's terrible news. The Cat has been part of my life here. It was the only place you could go for a decent pint and a good

chat back in the dark old days, when Hollywood was full of crime and grime, long before it became the hipster destination it is now.

"The idea of being turfed out not because you can't pay your rent, but because someone else can pay twice as much seems so cold and Darwinian, but that's the society we live in. When you can pay top dollar and keep an area going, everyone loves you. But when that same area booms and everyone wants the space you're in, there's no sentiment. Loyalty counts for nothing. It's match the asking price or leave. I don't care what they put in this space or how much money they spend to upgrade it, it'll never be like the Cat."

## Measure "LC" is a HUGE WIN For Our Community.

### The operative text of Measure LC

NO NEW DEVELOPMENT without additional voter approval.

If all or part of the Airport land is permanently closed to aviation use, no new development of that land shall be allowed until the voters have approved limits on the uses and development that may occur on the land. The only exceptions are parks, public open spaces, public recreation facilities, and cultural, arts, and education. All of these things are a HUGE WIN for our community!

Measure LC allows us to keep Local Control of our airport land, and specifically prohibits the City Council from over-development of the airport land if any part of the airport were to close. Vote YES on LC.

## In Contrast, the Deceptive Measure "D" Is Designed to Benefit the Privileged Few.

### The operative text of Measure D

Specifically worded to require a majority of "voters of the City," not a majority of votes. THIS IS EFFECTIVELY IMPOSSIBLE.

This is effectively impossible (see above).

Even if we could pass a vote to close the airport, we'd still have to successfully close it. The FAA isn't going to allow that to happen.

(a) Voter approval shall be required before any City decision becomes effective that changes the use of land currently used for the Santa Monica Municipal Airport and related aviation services to non-aviation purposes, or that closes or partially closes Santa Monica Municipal Airport. The term "voter approval" means a majority of the voters of the City voting "yes" on a ballot measure approving such a change at a general municipal election.

(b) Unless the voters have approved the closure of the airport pursuant to paragraph (a) of this section, and such decision has become effective, the City shall continue to operate the Santa Monica Municipal Airport in a manner that supports its aviation purposes, and shall not impose additional restrictions on providers of aviation support services to tenants and airport users that inhibit the sale of fuel or the full use of aviation facilities.

The real purpose of Measure D! Aviation operators want to keep their taxpayer-subsidized cash-cow, and to prevent us from stopping (or even limiting) their polluting, noisy, and dangerous jets.

Measure D makes the airport "All or Nothing" and they've made the "Nothing" option impossible. If Measure D passes, we'll be stuck with this bad neighbor, exactly as it is today, FOREVER. Vote NO on D.

## Mario told: shape up or ship out

### ■ Italian fined after Real shirt swap leaves Rodgers fuming

Mario Balotelli is facing an early end to his Liverpool career unless he makes a dramatic turnaround between now and Christmas.

The troubled Italian striker has been a huge disappointment since he was recruited to replace the departing Luis Suarez, failing to find the net for his team and often appearing uninterested on the field.

Balotelli was the focus of much of the Reds fans' anger following their humiliating 3-0 midweek loss in the Champions League to Real Madrid, after the player swapped shirts with Real defender Pepe at half-time and failed to emerge for the second half.

Anfield boss Brendan Rodgers, who has fined Balotelli for the shirt-swapping incident, stressed on Thursday that there is no room for sentiment in football. And that means he won't

hesitate to bring in a replacement forward during the January transfer window if necessary.

More importantly than the shirt-swapping issue, the Italian's performances since his £16million move from AC Milan two months ago are proving a huge concern to Rodgers - and the January transfer window opens in 68 days.

He said: "At this moment in time, I'll be working with the players that we have and he is one of them. Not just improving him, but improving all the players. And we will see come January what the team needs."

Balotelli has had the second-most shots per game of any striker in any of the top five leagues in Europe, but is yet to score in the Premier League. His only Liverpool goal so far came in the Champions

League win over Ludogorets.

Rodgers said: "We brought in the player to give him a chance, and [we] give him every chance. At this moment in time, of course, he hasn't scored the goals we would like or want. We have to give him that opportunity, and we will give him every opportunity."

In a match billed as Liverpool's return to the biggest stage in club football the home fans did their best to prove resurrect memories of their glorious European past. But after a bright start the Reds fell away as Real took control with Modric and Kroos quite imperious in midfield and Benzema, Ronaldo and Rodriguez a constant menace up front.

The match was over as a contest before half time. A brace from Benzema and a sublime strike from Ronaldo put Carlo

Ancelotti's men on cruise control for the second half, with Isco and Rodriguez in particular a constant menace for Liverpool's backline.

### Vital three points for Celtic

The Romanians created more chances than the hosts but failed to break through.
