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After 13 years and 453 lost lives, our Afghan war is over

■ 500 troops will remain in Kabul to train Afghan security forces amid continuing fears Taliban could regain control

Britain's war in Afghanistan came to an end after 13 years as the flag was lowered over Camp Bastion in Helmand Province on Sunday.

In a historic moment in the Afghan desert, the Union Jack came down for the final time in an end of operations ceremony signifying the finish of the longest military campaign in modern times.

Those few hundred British troops remaining at the camp will begin to make their way home in the next few days ahead of schedule after handing over to the Afghan forces.

While some British personnel will remain in the country, Sunday marked the end of combat operations after a bloody campaign which was only meant to last a few years.

Those who are left will be given a new mission to train, advise and assist the Afghan forces – but will not be engaged in fighting.

Security was heightened at the camp as officials warned there was still a threat the Taliban could make one final attack as the troops prepared to leave.

Soldiers rehearsed the ceremony repeatedly – taking into account any hostile action which could arise given the nature of the event and the seniority of those present.

'sense of hope'

Military chiefs claimed only 'time will tell' whether the Afghan National Security Forces will be able to keep Camp Bastion and the Helmand province out of the hands of the Taliban.

But they said the British campaign in the country had given a new 'sense of hope' to the Afghan people and made streets in the UK safer from terrorist threats.

Brigadier Rob Thomson, the most senior British officer in Helmand, said of the end of combat operations: 'I think there are three emotions at play. We are proud of what our servicemen and women have done.

'We are happy and sad.

We are happy we are all going back to our families but we are also sad because we are leaving behind some friends who were courageous on the battlefield.' He said they had made a difference for British streets as well as those in Afghanistan.

Asked if we had won or lost the war, he said that in today's wars there is not a simple 'defeat' or 'victory' like there was with the Second World War.

He said: 'That's not how struggles end today. I think we have an army that is hugely adaptable

and can adjust in step as we enter a new campaign.

'I am kind of optimistic I think what we have achieved is something we can be proud of. There are still some challenges in Afghanistan. But we can be positive.'

In a parade attended by around 200 military personnel and civilians, troops paraded a US flag and two flags representing the regional command of Afghanistan.

While they were held high in the sky, the national anthems of

Labour facing meltdown in Scotland, new poll reveals

THE LABOUR Party could be wiped out in Scotland at next year's general election, according to new figures from a leading poll company.

Afghanistan and Britain played throughout.

Three of the flags in the centre of the ceremony on poles were then lowered - Nato's flag was first, followed by the Union Jack and finally the American flag, leaving just the Afghan flag still flying.

An Afghan sermon was followed by a prayer and Brigadier General Yoo, commander of Regional Command South West, who has led the mission in Helmand, relinquished his duties.

He said: 'Today is significant because it is the end of the beginning. It is the beginning for the resolution support mission in south west Afghanistan.'

'When you think about the cost it has been expensive. I am taking about the cost of human casualties. Every one of those who died are not victims, they are volunteers, and they would come back again and again because they believed in the mission.'

Major General Malook, of the Afghan army, said: 'I am really happy but I am really sad. I'm happy

because they are going to their homes, I'm sad because they are my friends.

'I'm certain we can maintain the security here.'

Defence secretary Michael Fallon admitted that 'mistakes' had been made.

'I think the generals have been clear that mistakes were made,' he said. 'Mistakes were made militarily and mistakes were made by the politicians at the time.'

'Clearly the numbers weren't there at the beginning, the equipment wasn't quite good enough at the beginning, and we have learnt an awful lot from the campaign.'

In an official statement, he added: 'It is with pride that we announce the end of UK combat operations in Helmand having given Afghanistan the best possible chance of a stable future.'

'Our Armed Forces' tremendous sacrifice laid the foundations for a strong Afghan Security Force, set the security context that enabled the first democratic transition of power in the country's history, and stopped it being a launch pad for terrorist attacks in the UK.'

The poll, by Ipsos MORI, showed Labour could lose 90 percent of its MPs in Scotland with just 23 percent of voters planning to back the left-leaning party, which has been hurt by the rising popularity of the Scottish National Party (SNP).

The SNP led a failed bid to secure Scottish independence in a referendum last month, but has since bounced back and its ratings remain high.

If Labour's support in Scotland did collapse in a May UK-wide election, the party's chances of unseating David Cameron in what is shaping up to be one of the closest electoral contests in modern British history would be badly weakened.

referendum

Labour has traditionally dominated Scottish politics and won 41 of 59 Scottish seats in Britain's parliament in the last UK-wide election, in 2010. But the Tories won the most seats overall, however, thanks mostly to its support in England.

But Thursday's poll suggested Labour would win just four seats in Scotland next year.

By contrast, Ipsos said 52 percent of Scots planned to back the SNP,

who spearheaded the push for Scottish independence in the run-up to last month's referendum. Labour campaigned for the 307-year-old union with England to remain intact.

"The referendum allowed many traditional Labour voters to vote against Labour party policy and once people have made that shift once, they're more likely to do so in the future," James Mitchell, co-director of the Academy of Government at Edinburgh University, told Reuters.

"Labour simply cannot take for granted its vote in Scotland as it could in the past."

'dinosaurs'

Last week, Labour's leader in Scotland, Johann Lamont, unexpectedly quit, highlighting divisions within the party by launching a scathing attack on what she called the "dinosaurs" among its London leadership. She didn't name him, but complained that the Scottish party was treated like "a branch office," a comment widely seen as criticism of Labour leader Ed

Miliband.

Some Scots feel the party, which has since launched a search for a new leader in Scotland, has lost touch with voters and failed to offer a distinctive vision for Scotland.

Mark Duffley, director at Ipsos MORI Scotland, said Lamont's resignation had been "bruising" for Labour.

"They will hope that this represents a trough in public support and that their upcoming leadership contest will allow them to begin to regain some of the support they have lost," he said.



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Police under fire after Cameron security scare involving jogger

■ Security experts claim the incident was a breach of security and is of concern given the heightened alert over terrorism threats

Police were urged to improve security for the prime minister after a man on Monday ran up to David Cameron and came within inches of

him before being bundled away.

Security experts said the incident amounted to a breach of security and was of concern given the heightened alert over the terrorist threat facing the UK. But the man's mother late on Monday claimed it was a misunderstanding that happened as her son jogged to the gym.

Facebook page: "So I'm all over the news as 'the protester that attacked David Cameron in Leeds'. Yeah, if you call brushing into someone while running, then getting assaulted by half a dozen coppers in suits attacking."

Keith Vaz MP, chair of the Commons home affairs committee, said the man should not have been allowed to get so close to the prime minister, especially at a time of heightened alert. He cited last week's attack on Canada's parliament, during which prime minister Stephen Harper was forced to take refuge in a cupboard as a gunman prowled the building. Vaz said of the Leeds incident: "We are lucky this gentleman did not mean him [Cameron] harm. They need to review security and lessons need to be learned."

Farley later wrote on his One former Scotland

Yard protection officer of 20 years service, quoted in the Guardian, said: "This is an embarrassing breach. There is no challenge [to the man]. The PM sees the individual before those colleagues who should have." He added that part of the problem might be that Cameron and his aides had asked for less intrusive security.

Later in the Commons, Cameron said: "Could I put on the record for once the debt I owe to the close protection teams that look after me and the very good job that they do?"

Making light of the incident, he added: "John

Prescott was in the room as I gave the speech, so as I left the room, I thought the moment of maximum danger had probably passed."

Mr Farley's mother said: "I've spoken to Dean. He's very upset by the whole situation. It's all a misunderstanding. He was just jogging to the gym."

Witness Chris Wilson described how Cameron deftly avoided the jogger: "It looked like Cameron sidestepped him. It was a lovely little move. He should be on the stage, really."

"And then he was

tackled by the person behind. And then he [Cameron] was in the car and the car was gone. They were on him. They were like flies around poo."

The statement from Scotland Yard announcing a review of the incident followed criticism from MPs and repeated replays of the incident on TV news channels and news websites. Mark Pritchard, Tory MP for the Wrekin, demanded a full investigation into how the Met security team allowed the man to get so close to the prime minister.

UKiP: the rise and rise

■ Poll support for insurgent party hits record high

SUPPORT for Ukip has surged to a record high following Brussels' attempt to hit Britain with a £1.7 billion "surcharge", a new poll showed this week.

It puts Ukip on 19 per cent, a jump of four points on last month and one point above its previous record support in June.

The Conservatives are up one point to 30 per cent to bring them level with Labour, which has slumped by five points to its lowest level under Ed Miliband.

The Liberal Democrats are down by one point to nine per cent, the Greens unchanged on four per cent and others unchanged on seven per cent.

The ComRes poll underlines Ukip's growing appeal to voters turning their backs on both Tories and Labour.

Almost one in five (19 per cent) of people who voted Conservative in 2010 now say they will vote Ukip, up from 14 per cent last month.

Nearly one in ten (9 per cent) previous Labour voters also plan to back Nigel Farage's party.



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WHY SO GLUM? it's in the genes, apparently The British are born to be miserable, new research finds

"The British do not expect happiness," claimed English writer Quentin Crisp – and it appears he may have been right.

New research from the University of Warwick has indicated that Britons are genetically programmed to be grumpy.

The British, French and Americans are all predisposed to be grumpier than nations such as Denmark because they possess a "short form" version of the gene which regulates the amount of serotonin – the chemical which controls happiness – within the brain.

The Danes, who regularly top happiness surveys of nations, enjoy a longer form of the gene, while Britons and Americans, despite equally stable economies

and governments, possess a shorter version resulting in a miserable attitude.

However, it could be worse: we could be French.

According to professor Andrew Oswald, who led the research looking at 131 countries, only the French had a shorter form of the gene.

Professor Oswald, who studies applied economics and quantitative social science, claimed many nations' citizens would still be unhappy were they earning a fortune, living to a ripe old age and basking in the sunshine daily.

"Among the nations we studied, Denmark and the Netherlands appeared to have the lowest percentage of people with the short version of the serotonin gene," he said to *The Times*.

'Britain's Schindler' honored in Prague

■ Nicholas Winton recognized by Czechs for saving children from Nazis

A British man who saved 669 children, most of them Jews, from the Nazis has been awarded the Czech Republic's highest state honour.

Sir Nicholas Winton was 29 when he arranged trains to take the children out of occupied Czechoslovakia and for foster families to meet them in London.

The 105-year-old was given the Order of the White Lion by the Czech president during a ceremony at Prague Castle on Thursday.

In a speech, he thanked the British people who gave the children homes.

He said: "I want to thank you all for this enormous expression of thanks for something which happened to me nearly 100 years ago - and a 100 years is a heck of a long time.

'no fear'

"I am delighted that so many of the children are still about and are here to thank me."

The remarkable mission of the man dubbed the "British Schindler" came to light only in the late 1980s.

It began in 1938 after the Nazi occupation of the Sudetenland, the name for areas of pre-war Czechoslovakia.

The then Mr Winton

visited refugee camps outside Prague and decided to help children secure British permits in the same way children from other countries had been rescued by "kindertransports".

At the time he was a stockbroker in London, and being from a German Jewish family he said he was well aware of the urgency of the situation.

"I knew better than most, and certainly better than the politicians, what was going on in Germany," he told BBC Radio 4's Today program ahead of his visit to Prague.

"We had staying with us people who were refugees from Germany at that

time. Some who knew they were in danger of their lives."

But he said he was not afraid to help: "There was no personal fear involved."

He organised a total of eight trains from Prague to London and helped to find foster families for the refugees.

He said he was aware that many children would have died if it had not been for his actions, but added: "That's what was happening all over Europe."

A ninth train - the largest, carrying 250 children - was prevented from leaving by the outbreak of World War Two. None of those

children is believed to have survived.

The Czech defence ministry sent a special plane to take him to Prague where he also met some of the people he rescued 75 years ago - themselves now in their 80s.

He did not tell anyone about his actions for 50 years, until his wife found a scrapbook.

He was knighted by the Queen in March 2003 and a year earlier was finally reunited with hundreds of the children he saved - including Labour peer Lord Dubs and film director Karel Reisz - at a gathering for 5,000 descendants of the "Winton children".

SINGER, amateur footballer and longtime local expat Robbie Williams became a father for the second time this week – and was more than happy to share the experience via social media.

The video shows Ayda pushing a wheelchair through the hospital, and when she turns the corner, Robbie can be seen sitting in it with Charlton in his lap.

Robbie shared clips of Ayda's labour on his official YouTube account and later spoke about his 'astonishing' wife.

He said: 'I've never been more in love, and I've never been more proud of my wife. She's been absolutely astonishing.'

Robbie had been entertaining his fans with amusing videos from the hospital room, including a video which showed him doing a rendition of Let It Go from the hit movie, Frozen, whilst his wife appeared to be giving birth.

One picture showed her on a bed wearing high heels with the words: 'When Ayda goes into

labour she comes correct,' the funnyman wrote as he helps his wife get through the experience.

He also published videos showing the pair of them dancing in their hospital room and another where he jokingly tells fans:

'It's quarter past seven, we've been here since ten o'clock last night and I know you're really concerned and worried and thinking about what's going on. I need you to know I'm doing great.'

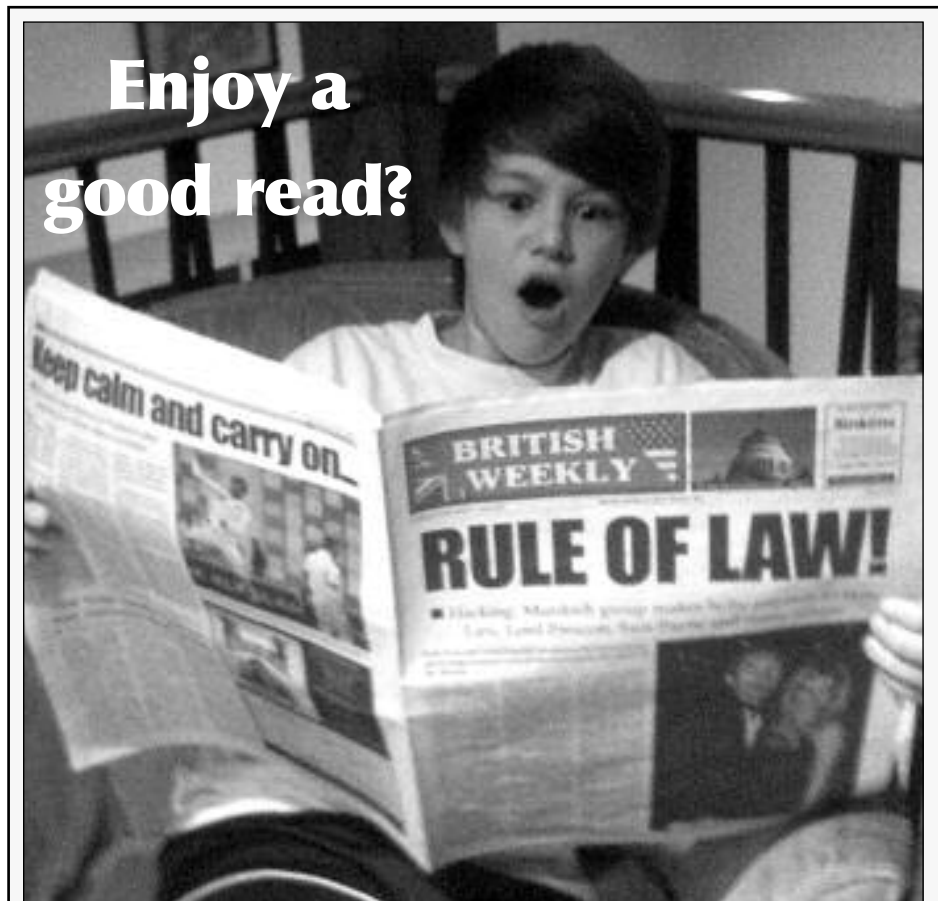
Robbie added: 'The universe has presented itself to us again and it's been a very emotional, amazing few hours and we're really happy and honoured that you experienced the journey with us.'

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Women who drink two cups of tea a day slash risk of ovarian cancer

WOMEN who drink two cups of tea a day can slash their risk of ovarian cancer by a third, according to new research.

Scientists at the University of East Anglia (UEA) have found that both tea and citrus fruits and their juices can dramatically lower risk of developing the deadly disease.

Their study reveals that women who



consume foods containing health-boosting flavonols and flavanones - which are both subclasses of dietary flavonoids - significantly decrease their risk of developing epithelial ovarian cancer.

The research team studied the dietary

habits of 171,940 women aged between 25 and 55 for more than three decades.

The team found that those who consumed food and drinks high in flavonols - which are found in tea, red wine, apples and grapes - and flavanones - which are found in citrus fruit and

Top Gear star Jeremy Clarkson has driven in to yet ANOTHER storm of controversial by tweeting that he was driving with a beer close at hand.

Clarkson, 54, tweeted: "One of the best drives of my life. Gravel road. M6. Sun going down. iPod playing Blind Faith. Beer in cup holder."

Clarkson (pictured, right) and his Top Gear co-stars are in Australia's Top End, in the Northern Territory, shooting a special episode of the BBC2 motoring show.

Carole Whittingham, founder of the anti drink-drive charity group Support and Care after Road Deaths and injury (Scard), said: "Personally, I think he is

an absolute idiot. He is in the media and he should be setting an example for safe driving.

"He likes to be controversial and this is just one in a long line of some of the stupid things that he has done. I just think that he has got an ego that is far too big. He should be making a good impression on people and giving a good example."

'wind-up merchant'

In response to the tweet Jim Campbell wrote: "If you drink and drive, you're a bloody idiot" while another follower added: "@JeremyClarkson drink driving eh?"

Another follower called Lucas The Kop Cat replied that

"Clarkson is the greatest wind up merchant of his generation. And everybody bit. Top work, Jeremy... :)"

Last week Alicia Castro, the Argentinian ambassador to the UK, demanded a public apology from the BBC following the row over a Top Gear special filmed in the South American country.

The show's crew had to leave Argentina after trouble erupted when it emerged they were using a Porsche with the registration number H982 FKL, which some people suggested could refer to the Falklands conflict of 1982.

'shocked' Top Gear executive producer Andy Wilman



has denied the number plate was a "stunt" and Clarkson was "shocked" when someone pointed out the link between the number plate and the Falklands War days into filming.

A statement from the embassy said: "Argentine ambassador to the UK Alicia Castro made a formal complaint to the BBC regarding Jeremy Clarkson's provocative behaviour and offensive

remarks towards the government and the Argentine people, following Top Gear's recent filming in Argentina, calling for the BBC to make a public apology."

She met the BBC's director of television, Danny Cohen.

The complaint referred to "serious accusations" Clarkson had made against the Buenos Aires government which he

said had made "political capital" out of the issue.

The embassy statement went on: "Furthermore, the Argentine ambassador deeply regretted Jeremy Clarkson's entirely false accusations of alleged resentment against British citizens in Argentina."

A BBC spokeswoman said it had received a complaint and "will apply its usual processes".

Women over forty 'need to go under the knife' to stop their men cheating

■ Expert claims surgery is only way to curb wandering eyes

Self-titled sex expert Louise Van Der Velde is telling women who reach their forties to get plastic surgery or face their partner running off with a younger model.

Louise, who runs a relationship therapy centre in central London, believes ladies only have themselves to blame if their husband starts to find other women more attractive.

She said: 'I think for the people who do want to have a monogamous relationship - the women are very quick to point the

finger.

'They say that their husband is messing about and he's left them for someone else, but I think it is absolutely the woman's responsibility when they have let themselves go over the years.

'We are the creators of our own destiny, if your fella cheats, you've created it yourself.

'The men have a right to look elsewhere, they have a right to be sleeping with an attractive woman.'

Apparently it could be worse though, while British and American women are not in good shape, Louise reserves her harshest criticism for ladies from some of the countries on the European mainland.

She said: 'I lived in Spain for fifteen years and the women there, they age because they eat all of these cakes and bread.

'A lot of the women, when they hit 50 they are pretty much a write-off in some of those countries, but it doesn't have to be that way.'

Steering clear of cakes and keeping in shape with regular visits to the gym is not enough though - Louise thinks that women should start to have breast augmentation, liposuction, fillers and the rest as soon as parts of the body start to sag.

She said: 'A lot of my female clients in their forties and fifties come in and they're unhappy that their husbands are playing away but they've

let themselves go.

'But no one's really happy with themselves when they are overweight and not looking good.

'Even when you buy a new dress you feel good - looking good is feeling good.

'I actively encourage my clients to get plastic surgery and it's received fairly well.

'I have had the odd client who think they should be accepted for who they are but some of them have taken it up.

'I've had some ladies who have had liposuction done for their weight and some who've had the gastric band.

'There are also some who've had their eyes and breasts done as well.

'Faces get saggy and a little bit of filler is good, it's very important that you find the right surgeon though.'

'If you have a good surgeon, they'll do it the right way.'

Louise claims to have had serious success with her pro-plastic surgery approach to healing marriages.

But sometimes the effects can be so strong that the balance in the relationship swings completely the other way.

She said: 'This one woman had a boob job and it gave her a totally new lease of life.'

'She decided that as her husband had cheated on her, she was going to go off anyway.'

'I take my hat off to those types of women as well because I think that maybe they had been staying in the relationship because they had settled and couldn't get anyone better.'

While Louise acknowledges that her comments may seem harsh and quite extreme, she is quick to point out that she practises what she preaches and has undergone extensive cosmetic surgery herself.

She said: 'People say to me it's easy because I am a natural beauty but I work really hard to look like this.'

'I decided that in my fortieth year I wanted to be the fittest I've ever been, so I had my boobs done.'

'I also had under my eyes done - I had the wrinkles taken out, I've also had my lips done.'

'Everybody says that they can't believe I'm 40, they all think that I look like I'm 30 and that's a great feeling.'

'I don't believe in growing old gracefully.'

Isis of Downton about to be killed off?

Speculation mounts over future of unfortunately-named Labrador

It has prompted numerous businesses to re-brand, while the parents of an eight-year-old girl in Australia have resisted those advising them to change her name.

Now the rise of the Islamic State in Syria and the Levant, known as Isil, Isis or IS, may inadvertently have claimed another namesake victim in the shape of the 'Downton Abbey' dog.

Speculation is rife that Isis, Lord Grantham's yellow Labrador in the ITV period soap-opera, may be on the verge of being killed off, as programme bosses scramble to avoid any association with the terrorist group.

'terribly listless'

The latest episode of the show, which aired on Sunday in the UK, appears to drop a number of hints as to the fate of the canine, who is named after the Egyptian goddess of the same name.

Lord and Lady Grantham are heard to observe that Isis is looking "terribly listless" as the apparently unwell Labrador lounges on the floor.

Their daughter Lady Mary Crawley wonders whether Isis has "caught a germ" or eaten a squirrel, while others ask if the "quite fat" hound is pregnant.

It will inevitably prompt viewers to ask whether the programme's creator, Lord Fellowes, has decided to cut his losses and write the animal out of the script, as the terrorist organisation continues to spread a trail of violence through Iraq and Syria.

The timing would

make sense for Fellowes, whose show, currently in its fifth series, has sometimes been found wanting for historical accuracy.

Viewers were quick to point out the unhappy coincidence, using the Twitter hashtag '#awkward' to sum up their discomfiture.

Isis replaced Pharaoh as the Crawley family dog in the second series of Downton, set in 1916-1918. The show has now moved on to 1924, meaning Isis is probably in late middle-age.

An ITV spokesman said on Sunday that the name 'Isis' was "unfortunate coincidence" and that it pre-dated the emergence of the terrorist group.

"At the time the dog was named and up to and including the majority of filming of Series five, no-one was using that acronym to describe a terror group. It is an unfortunate coincidence.

"We do not comment on future story-lines."

However, the spokesman declined to confirm or deny what would happen to Isis later in the series.

Others who have suffered from similarly name-association woes include Isis Leskien, eight, from Australia, whose parents said the rise of the jihadist group was "ruining our family and it's ruining Isis's future" but declined to change their daughter's name.

Isis Martinez, a woman from Florida, started a global petition urging the media to "stop calling the terrorists by our name", while an Australian construction firm urged staff not to wear uniforms, and Isis Equity Partners recently

announced plans for a re-brand.

Lord Fellowes told

juices - were less likely to develop the disease.

Ovarian cancer is the fifth biggest cancer killer of women in Britain after lung, bowel, breast and pancreas cancers.

It is known as the "silent killer" because its symptoms emerge only after the disease has advanced significantly.

Each year around 7,116 women in the UK are diagnosed and it kills 4,271.

Less than half of women will survive their cancer for five years or more.

Prof Aedin Cassidy, from the Department of Nutrition at UEA's Norwich Medical School, who led the study, said: "This is the first large-scale study

looking into whether habitual intake of different flavonoids can reduce the risk of epithelial ovarian cancer.

"We found that women who consume foods high in two sub-groups of powerful substances called flavonoids....had a significantly lower risk of developing epithelial ovarian cancer.

"The main sources of these compounds include tea and citrus fruits and juices, which are readily incorporated into the diet, suggesting that simple changes in food intake could have an impact on reducing ovarian cancer risk.

"In particular, just a couple of cups of black tea every day was associated with a 31 per cent reduction in risk."

The research was the first to comprehensively examine the six major flavonoid subclasses

present in the normal diet with ovarian cancer risk, and the first to investigate the impact of polymers and anthocyanins.

The study was led by Prof Cassidy and Prof Shelley Tworoger, from the Brigham and Women's Hospital and Harvard Medical School, and is published in the American Journal of Clinical Nutrition.

This is the latest research to hail the benefits of drinking tea to fight ovarian cancer.

In 2012, researchers at the School of Public Health at Curtin University in Perth, Australia, found that a lifetime of tea drinking can slash the risk of ovarian cancer in old age.

A two-year study of 1,000 women with an average age of 59, half who were diagnosed with the disease and 500 who were free of it.

Devilishly delicious, decadent fun, HORNS is a highlight of Halloween at this movies this year!

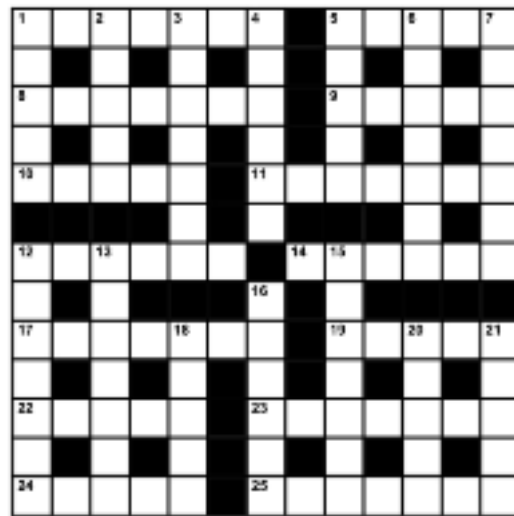

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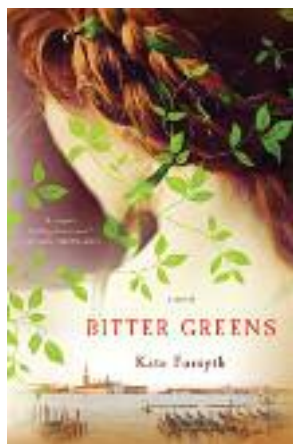
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Bitter Greens: a tasty little confection...

■ Exclusive interview with author Kate Forsyth and a review of her tale of Rapunzel, told from the perspective of that story's author

Rating: ★★★



"When I was twelve, I read a book called *The Stone Cage* by the British children's writer Nicholas Stuart Gray," says *Bitter Greens* author Kate Forsyth. "It's a retelling of Rapunzel told from the point of view of the witch's cat. I was utterly enchanted by this book, and realized for the first time that writers can retell a tale to give it greater depth and vividness."

Forsyth weaves a story within a story and brings the two together in this

retelling of Persinette, the story adapted by the Brothers Grimm that became Rapunzel. It is the story of Persinette and the parallel story of Charlotte-Rose, who has been banished from court for indiscreet behavior. She brings the stories together seamlessly. You never lose track of whom you're reading about. The emotions of Margherita and Charlotte-Rose are palpable and understandable. A story of black magic, romance and

love, you will not want to put it down.

Charlotte-Rose de la Force a relative of the Sun King, Louis XIV. She's has been banished from the Versailles court and sent to a convent. The old nun Sœur Seraphina tells her a hundred-year-old tale of a young girl who was spirited away from her family for a handful of bitter greens.

Persinette's father has stolen the parsley from the garden of courtesan Selena Leonelli. Stealing is punishable by having both hands cut off. He's forced to make a deal with Selena. He must give her their little girl, named Margherita, who Selena renames Persinette. Selena has mastered witchcraft to keep herself young. Imprisoned in a tower, Persinette starts to sing and hopes someone will hear her. One day a young man does. Charlotte-Rose

is captivated by the tale and motivated to write.

"I first read the Rapunzel fairy tale when I was a little girl in hospital," says Forsyth. "I had been savaged by a dog when I was a baby, and among other serious injuries, my left tear duct was destroyed. No one ever thinks much about that tiny piece of flesh in the corner of the eye, but it has an important function. It flushes away dirt and germs from our vulnerable eyes, which are deeply embedded in our brain. Without a tear duct, I spent my childhood in and out of hospital with a series of life-threatening infections and fevers. Rapunzel is a story about a girl locked away from the world against her will, much as I was imprisoned in that cycle of pain and illness. And at the end of the story, Rapunzel weeps when she finds her

blinded lover, and her tears fall upon the prince's eyes and heals him. So the story gave me hope that one day I too would escape and one day I would be healed."

For research, Forsyth traveled to France and Italy. One of the de la Force family descendants, the Comte de Sabran-Pontevès, gave her a private tour of the Chateau de Cazaneuve, in Gascony, where de la Force had been born. It is one of the oldest chateaux in France and still owned by the same family.

Bitter Greens was shortlisted for the Aurealis Award for Best Fantasy, the Ditmar Award and the Norma K. Hemming Award (for which it received an Honourable Mention).

Forsyth's next book is the historical novel *The Wild Girl*, the story of the forbidden romance

between Wilhelm Grimm and Dortchen Wild, the young woman who told him many of the fairy tales. Set during the Napoleonic Wars, it releases in the U.S. spring 2015.

Blues boss not impressed with club's fringe players

Jose Mourinho said some of his Chelsea players did not impress enough in Tuesday's 2-1 League Cup win at Shrewsbury to keep their place in the side.

The Blues struggled against their League Two opponents and needed a late own goal to secure their berth in the

quarter-finals.

"I expect people that have not been playing a lot to raise their level and create problems," said the manager.

"I love problems of choice, but it's easy to choose my team for Saturday."

Dane Andreas Christensen, 18, was given his debut, while fellow defenders Nathan Ake, 19, and Kurt Zouma, 20, were also given starts.

Egypt winger Mohamed Salah, an £11m signing last January, was replaced by Willian, who provided the assist for Chelsea's winner.

Mourinho, however, did praise goalscorer Didier Drogba, midfielder Oscar and defenders Gary Cahill and Filipe Luis for playing two days after helping Chelsea to a 1-1 draw at Manchester United.

He added: "I also had people like [goalkeeper] Petr Cech and [midfielder Jon Obi] Mikel, people with lots of years at the club, who would prefer to start at Old Trafford.

"They didn't and they came here today and

gave a fantastic example. After that there are the young boys and they have to follow the spirit and the professionalism of the others."

The Portuguese boss, who guided Chelsea to success in the Cup twice during his first reign, also paid tribute to 36-year-old striker Drogba.

The Ivorian, also in his second spell with the club, scored the first goal and then contributed to the 81st-minute own goal by putting Shrews defender Jermaine Grandison under pressure.

"I was worried when they equalised [through Andy Mangan] but we go through and Didier played a massive part in that," added Mourinho.

"Hopefully he will be good for the weekend but we will have to see because right now his character is stronger than his body.

"Maybe what he has done today is through his character - not his body.

"That's what makes players special and any of the young players lucky enough to play alongside him, learn from that."

Celtic winger slapped with 7-match ban

Celtic winger Aleksandar Tonev has been banned for seven matches for racially abusing Aberdeen defender Shay Logan.

The 24-year-old was charged following an incident with Englishman Logan during a Scottish Premiership match in September.

The Bulgaria international is on loan from Premier League side

Aston Villa.

Celtic say they will appeal against the punishment, saying the Bulgarian is "not a racist" and the club "absolutely abhors racism of any kind".

The incident with Logan came in the second half of Celtic's 2-1 win

over Aberdeen on 13 September.

"This was a very unfortunate case but the club has accepted Aleksandar's explanation that he did not say the words that were alleged to have been said and that he is not a racist," a Celtic spokesperson said.

Pardew blasts back as Toon take two major scalps in four days

Alan Pardew defended his position as Newcastle manager after their League Cup victory at Manchester City on Wednesday, telling supporters: "I do know what I'm doing."

Pardew, 53, has been the subject of protests from some fans after Newcastle's poor start of the season.

But the 2-0 win at Etihad Stadium secured a League Cup quarter-final place and followed Sunday's Premier League victory at Tottenham.

"This was a victory for our fans," said Pardew.

"It's important for us that we just keep this momentum going."

Newcastle sit 14th in the Premier League and face a trip to Tottenham in the League Cup last eight in the week beginning 15

December.

Pardew has guided Newcastle to fifth, 16th and 10th in his three full seasons at the club and has seen key players such as Andy Carroll and Yohan Cabaye leave for large transfer fees.

Supporters have held up 'sackpardew.com' banners during matches since early in the season.

He admitted he was under pressure earlier this month, but defender Daryl Janmaat said on Wednesday that the players are behind their manager.

"I do know what I'm doing," Pardew said. "I think I've had most of the scalps as Newcastle manager, maybe except Arsenal, and I look forward to playing them."

Pardew rested several

players at City ahead of Saturday's Premier League game against Liverpool at St James' Park.

Midfielder Ryan Taylor is likely to be available after describing his return from a 26-month lay-off with a cruciate ligament injury as a "dream come true".

"There are no words I can think of, from the medical team to the fans, I can't thank the football club enough," Taylor said.

Pardew said: "Ryan Taylor was a kind of story you'd read in some football magazine that was made up. He was

outstanding in his first game after all that time. Brilliant."

Taylor, 30, delivered the assist for Rolando Aarons to open the scoring, before substitute Moussa Sissoko hit the second to move Newcastle a step closer to a first Cup triumph since

1955.

Goalkeeper Rob Elliot added: "Tonight's all about Ryan."

"He's epitomised everything about us: two years of solid hard work, with setbacks. Everyone is buzzing for him and the fans - it's a great night for us all."

Bournemouth book Reds date

Championship side Bournemouth will play Liverpool in the quarter-finals of the Capital One Cup.

The south coast side have never featured in the last eight and will now host eight-time winners Liverpool at the Goldsands Stadium.

Derby have a home tie against Premier League leaders Chelsea, while League One Sheffield United welcome high-flying Southampton.

Newcastle, who knocked out holders Manchester City, travel to Tottenham.

The ties will be played in the week beginning 15 December.

Sheffield United reached the semi-finals of the FA Cup last season and are enjoying another good cup run after knocking out MK Dons in the previous round.

Hammers can nail down European place this season, says Carroll

West Ham striker Andy Carroll believes the east London club can qualify for European competition this season.

The Hammers have won their past three games and are fourth in the Premier League after Saturday's 2-1 win over Manchester City.

Carroll has been out all season with an ankle injury but is back in training.

"I think we can push for Europe. We're playing fantastically and I cannot wait to be a part of that," the 25-year-old told the club website.

"I think all the lads are positive about that and I know the gaffer is

too.

"The gaffer has signed some great players and we're showing the quality we've got with the goals we're scoring - that's why we are where we are in the league."
