## Jack Straw: I was 'never complicit'



**Former Foreign Secretary Jack Straw has said he was "never complicit" in the illegal rendition or torture of terror suspects during his time in office.**

The Labour MP (above) told reporters he would be "delighted" to give evidence to an inquiry looking at the treatment of detainees by British intelligence agencies in the decade following 9/11.

A US Senate report into the CIA has found "brutal" treatment of suspects.

Mr Straw said such behaviour was "wrong, full stop".

### Legal obligations

The UK asked for some material to be removed from the report for national security reasons.

But Downing Street

said no redactions related to British involvement in the mistreatment of prisoners.

Parliament's Intelligence and Security Committee, which is carrying out its own inquiry focusing on the UK's actions, is to ask the United States to hand over any material documenting the UK's role.

Mr Straw told the BBC: "As I've made repeatedly clear, I applied myself assiduously to the legal obligations on me, which were above all to ensure that people's human rights were observed and that any action I took was within the law."

"I was never, ever complicit in people being rendered illegally - still less in their bad treatment or their torture."

## Sir Malcolm Rifkind demands answers on British role in torture

Sir Malcolm Rifkind has demanded that the CIA hand over sensitive parts of a US Senate report detailing the role Britain played in the abduction and interrogation of terror suspects after 9/11.

The move comes the week after the report, detailing the harsh interrogation techniques used by the US intelligence agency on Al-Qaeda suspects, was published.

### redactions

Sir Malcolm, the head of the Commons Intelligence and Security Committee, wants the US to provide Parliament with the full account of the UK's involvement in

the detaining and interrogating of detainees from the report.

Downing Street confirmed that some parts of the report were redacted at the UK's request, for national security reasons, but said that no redactions pertained to British involvement in torture.

Documents show that since 2009 British officials, including Theresa May, met the US committee that compiled the report 24 times before the summary was published.

Writing in the Sunday Telegraph, Sir Malcolm said: "What needs to be discovered is whether

they [British intelligence officers] were aware of what the CIA was doing; whether they were willing to accept intelligence obtained by waterboarding and other inhumane practices, and whether they volunteered questions to be put to detainees being interrogated by the CIA."

It will be for the US government to decide whether to release the relevant parts of the report.

### inaccurate reports

Concerns have been raised that the Intelligence and Security Committee is investigating the role of

Britain in torture and rendition. Seven years ago the committee produced two inaccurate reports on detainees, owing to the fact that intelligence agencies had not supplied all the relevant evidence.

Sir Malcolm claims that this could not happen again as all British intelligence agencies are compelled to hand over their files to the committee, following a change in the law.

The MP praised the bipartisan nature of his committee, in comparison to the Senate committee, which voted along party lines on the conclusions of the report.



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## Falling prices brings UK oil industry 'close to collapse'

The UK's oil industry is in 'crisis' as prices drop, a senior industry leader has said.

Oil companies and service providers are cutting staff and investment to save money.

Robin Allan, chairman of the independent explorers' association Brindex, told the BBC that the industry is "close to collapse".

Almost no new projects in the North Sea are profitable with oil below \$60, he claims.

"It's almost impossible to make money at these oil prices", Mr Allan, who is a director of Premier Oil in addition to chairing Brindex. "It's a huge crisis."

"This has happened before, and the industry adapts, but the adaptation is one of slashing people, slashing projects and reducing costs wherever possible, and that's painful for our staff, painful for companies and painful for the country."

"It's close to collapse. In terms of new investments - there will be none, everyone is retreating, people are being laid off at most companies this week and in the coming weeks. Budgets for 2015 are being cut by everyone."

Mr Allan said many of the job cuts across the industry would not have been publicly announced. Oil workers are often employed as contractors, which are easier for employers to cut.

His remarks echo comments made by the veteran oil man and government adviser Sir Ian Wood, who last

week predicted a wave of job losses in the North Sea over the next 18 months.

### Decline

The US-based oil giant ConocoPhillips is cutting 230 out of 1,650 jobs in the UK.

This month it announced a 20% reduction in its worldwide capital expenditure budget, in response to falling oil prices.

Other big oil firms are expected to make similar cuts to their drilling and exploration budgets. Research from the investment bank Goldman Sachs predicted that they would need to cut capital expenditure by 30% to restore their profitability at current prices.

Service providers to the industry have also been hit. Texas-based oilfield services company Schlumberger cut back its UK-based fleet of geological survey ships in December, taking an \$800m loss and cutting an unspecified number of jobs.

Aberdeen-based Wood Group announced a pay freeze for staff, and cut rates for its contractors.

UK oil and gas production has been in decline since 1999 - though the rate of decline slowed in 2013, a year which saw the highest level of investment on record.

The industry was hoping to see continued high levels of investment, stemming the inevitable decline of production as North Sea's resources are used up. But falling oil prices have put that in doubt.

# The three faces of Georgie

■ new images of young royal reveal playful - and regal - side

They are the sort of pictures that would grace any doting grandparent's mantelpiece.

The rosy-cheeked Prince George sits on the steps of Kensington Palace chuckling to himself with no apparent cares in the world, in a set of three official portraits that have been released in time for Christmas by the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge.

At only 16 months he

looks like any sturdy, confident toddler might when confronted with an adult pointing a camera at them. In one of the photographs he stares straight down the lens, opening a hand as if about to reach out and grab an object in front of him.

In another he appears to be staring intently at something out of view, while in the third the prince inclines his head and looks as if he about to say something about this whole photo-session business he is having to go through.

The pictures were taken with Prince George seated on the stone steps of a courtyard in Kensington Palace, where his parents live, occupying Princess Margaret's former apartments. He was photographed in late

November, by an unnamed member of the Duke and Duchess's staff.

While in some respects the Prince is a thoroughly modern child - according to his father last week he spends as much time as he can trying to play games on his parents' iPad - there is something timeless, even old-fashioned, about his appearance in these photographs.

### hauntingly familiar

Dressed in navy, knickerbocker-style shorts and matching socks pulled up to his knees they could just as easily have been taken during the Fifties as at the tail-end of 2014.

His hair is neatly combed and the jumper is decorated with marching guardsmen, replete with

red tunics and bearskins. It is easy to imagine his grandfather, Prince Charles, wearing similar outfits at the same age.

Furthermore, the family resemblance is, perhaps unsurprisingly, quite apparent - lending a hauntingly familiar feel to what is a new set of images. Tony Glenville, the creative director of the London College of Fashion, said: "With so many children nowadays dressed as mini-adults, perhaps the royal family are right to go for a classic look for George."

"They have to bear in mind these photographs will be looked at for years to come. But while it may be a convention for him to look like Prince Charles did at the same age, the retro or vintage look is in fact very of the moment."

### Girl 'On Way To Join IS' Stopped On Runway

**A 15-year-old girl who was believed to be heading to Syria to join Islamic State fighters has been stopped by police just moments before her plane was about to take off.**

The teenager, from the Tower Hamlets area in East London, was travelling from Heathrow to Turkey.

It is believed she had planned to then continue her journey over the border into Syria.

The girl was reported missing by her family, who were unaware of her intentions.

"Until she went missing they had no idea what she was planning," he said.

According to one report, the girl had apparently been saving money secretly in order to buy a ticket to Istanbul.

Police checks revealed the girl was booked on a flight, and officers managed to get the plane stopped as it was taxiing on the runway earlier this month.

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# Will She? Bookies suspend betting on Queen announcing abdication in Christmas broadcast

■ But Palace laughs off rumors Her Maj will announce intention to quit on Dec. 25th

The bookmaker Coral has suspended betting on the Queen announcing her abdication in this year's Christmas Day broadcast.

The betting firm said it had decided to close the market after an "unusual" rash of wagers which "instantly set alarm bells ringing".

Sources close to the Queen, however, laughed off suggestions that she might abdicate, saying it was "just not true".

At about midday on Thursday, Coral had several online inquiries for the odds it would offer on the Queen abdicating in her Christmas message. It

began with a £200 bet, followed by several smaller bets in quick succession.

The bookmaker said the queries were "so specific" and so close together that it smelled a rat.

It had offered odds of 10-1 on the Queen abdicating during the Christmas message.

The speech to the nation has already been pre-recorded by the BBC, leading to suspicions that people with inside knowledge, either from Buckingham Palace or the TV camera crew, might have acted on leaked information.

Nicola McGeady, a spokesman for Coral, said: "Throughout the

year there has been major speculation about the Queen's future but today's gamble has really caught us by surprise.

"As far as we are concerned there's no smoke without fire when bets like this come through all in succession, so we have decided to be safe rather than sorry and pull the plug on the market."

'not true'

A Royal source said: "If the Queen was going to make a major announcement, she wouldn't do it in a pre-recorded speech that is shown in the South Pacific Commonwealth realms several hours

"It would mean the end of her reign would officially be announced in Tuvalu, rather than in London. So no, it's not true."

It is not the first time Coral has suspended betting on the Queen

abdicating. In January it temporarily closed the market after a £200 wager was placed in Windsor on a 2014 abdication, which followed reports that the Prince of Wales was taking on more of her duties.

Meanwhile William Hill slashed the odds on the Queen's speech being the most watched TV programme on Christmas Day from 100/1 to 7/1 and cut the odds on an abdication announcement this year from 16/1 to 5/1.

## A dinky Des Res: Britain's smallest detached home yours for just £100,000

A SHEFFIELD home made headlines this week as the country's smallest detached house – which will still set you back £100,000 (\$155,000).

A cosy property is a converted Coach House on Brincliffe Edge Road and has just 359 sq ft of

space over its two floors, but manages to cram in a living room, kitchen, bedroom and shower room.

The front door opens out into the living room, with the compact kitchen in the corner on the open-plan ground floor.

The house comes with space for off-road parking, as well as having a detached garage available.

With other semi-detached houses on the same street capable of selling for around £220,000, bargain

hunters have been checking out the property to see if it would make a worthwhile purchase.

Richard Atkinson, from estate agent Haybrook, said there had been plenty of interest in the unusual property from prospective buyers.

It has been on the market for around a month.

"It has been a combination of buy-to-let investors and people wanting their first home to be a good house in a good location," he said.

"We are up to double figures in terms of

viewings.

"I have been an estate agent for five years and I haven't seen anything like it in terms of its size. The garage is nearly as big as the house.

"It is a nice modern house inside and would be perfect for a young couple or someone on their own."

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## High Court judge bans man from having sex with his own wife

The husband of a mother of four who has the mind of a child has been banned from having sex with her by a High Court judge because she does not know she has the right to refuse.

The Bangladeshi man claims he has the right under his culture to have sex with her whenever he pleases and she has no right to refuse.

He has already taken his wife's cousin as a second "wife" and had two children with her, but still demands the right to have sex with the woman he married first.

However, with a mental age of between four and eight, the 39-year old wife - identified only by the initials TB - has been taken into care under the Mental Health Act by the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, where the family lived.

All their four children have also been taken into care because the woman does not have the ability to care for them.

But the husband - known as SA and married to her for 18 years - wanted her back home.

Family Division judge Mr Justice Mostyn refused in a judgment, but ordered anonymity in the case to protect the identity of the wife and children.

He said: "The evidence clearly shows that TB has barely an inkling of the health risks involved. She was unable to link sex to pregnancy. Indeed she had virtually no idea how her babies came to be in her tummy (as she put it). Although she found sex enjoyable and comfortable she had no idea that she had a choice and could refuse."

# Millionaire banker banned from City after serial fare-dodging

A former City executive has been banned for life from any senior role in the financial services industry, after being exposed as one of the UK's biggest train fare dodgers.

Jonathan Paul Burrows, a former managing director at Blackrock Asset Management, has been barred by the Financial Conduct Authority from taking any responsible role in the financial services industry.

Announcing the ban, the FCA's director of enforcement and financial crime, Tracey McDermott, said: "Burrows held a senior position within the financial services industry. His conduct fell short of the standards we expect. Approved persons must act with honesty and integrity at all times and, where they do not, we will take action."

His dishonest behaviour came to the attention of the City watchdog after it came to light that he had saved himself almost £43,000 over several years by exploiting a loophole at the ticket barriers.

The East Sussex commuter boarded the London-bound train at Stonegate, a rural station with no ticket barriers. When he arrived at Cannon Street station in London, he tapped in using an Oyster card, paying a £7.20 fare, rather than the £21.50 cost of his journey.

Burrows avoided prosecution after making an out-of-court settlement with Southeastern railways, but had to resign from his high-flying job at Blackrock after a public outcry.

The ruling ends Burrows's lucrative City career. At Blackrock he had reportedly earned £1m a year. He will never again be allowed into a position of authority, although, in theory, he could take junior back-office jobs.

In a statement after the FCA ruling, Burrows said: "I have always recognised that what I did was foolish. I have apologised to all concerned and reiterate that apology publicly today."

Last year the FCA

banned 43 people from working in senior financial services jobs for failing the "fit and proper" test, but few attracted as much attention as Burrows. The fund manager initially managed to keep his identity secret through an out-of-court settlement that roused the anger of

unions. At the time, Manuel Cortes, the leader of the TSSA transport union, said the anonymous agreement showed there was one law for the rich and one for the poor.

Burrows's identity was first revealed by the Daily Mail, who contrasted his "two huge, mortgage-free

mansions in the East Sussex countryside" with the £4,500 cost of the season ticket.

The majority of people subject to an FCA ban have committed offences at work and Burrows is only the second person to be banned by for wrongdoing unrelated to his job.

## Britain edges old enemy in commemorative 'truce' match

Britain has triumphed over Germany 100 years after the start of the First World War - in a commemorative football match to mark the "Christmas Truce" of 1914.

The Army side edged out German counterparts the Bundeswehr by one goal to nil in front of a crowd of 2,547 at Aldershot's ESS stadium Wednesday night.

The Christmas Truce was said to have taken place on Christmas Day a century ago, with British and German soldiers meeting in no-man's land

to shake hands, exchange gifts and play a game of football.

The event was attended by England World Cup winner Sir Bobby Charlton, FA chairman Greg Dyke and Head of the Army General Sir Nicholas Carter.

Lance Corporal Calum Wilkinson, who scored the third-minute winner, admitted it was a special feeling to see spectators attend in their thousands.

"To score in front of this many people and on this occasion is a big feeling for me," said 25-year-old Wilkinson of the Seven

Regiment Royal Logistics Corps.

"To be honest I didn't expect this amount of people. The fact there are two and a half thousand

people here is absolutely massive. I don't think any of us have ever played in front of that kind of crowd so it was really good.

All proceeds from the match will be donated to the Royal British Legion and the German Military's equivalent charity.

# F1 champ Hamilton named BBC's Sports Personality of the Year

Lewis Hamilton has been voted the BBC Sports Personality of the Year 2014.

The 29-year-old Mercedes driver won his second Formula 1 world title this season and joined an exclusive club by becoming the fourth Briton to win the drivers' championship at least twice.

Northern Irish golfer Rory McIlroy was runner-up, with athlete Jo Pavey third.

"I was sitting there saying Rory's going to have it," said Hamilton, who earned 34% of the vote. "I thought it had to be someone else."

The Englishman won 209,920 of the 620,932 votes cast, with McIlroy getting 123,745 (20%) and Pavey 99,913 (16%).

"I want to say a huge thank you to all the people who called in, I really wasn't expecting it," he added.

"I am so speechless. I'm so proud and honoured to be among such great sporting talent."

Hamilton was runner-up to boxer Joe Calzaghe in 2007 and Sir Chris Hoy the following year.

Having arrived at the SSE Hydro arena in Glasgow with his dog, Roscoe, he was presented with the trophy by former Scotland player and Liverpool legend Kenny Dalglish after his name was announced by former England rugby player Jonny Wilkinson in front of a 12,000-strong audience.

The venue, which hosted netball, boxing and gymnastics during the Commonwealth Games last summer, was chosen in the year that Scotland hosted the Commonwealth Games and golf's Ryder Cup at Gleneagles.

Hamilton becomes the fifth racing driver to win the award in its 61-year history, with Damon Hill ('94 & '96) and Nigel Mansell ('86 & '92) triumphing on two occasions and Stirling Moss ('61) and Sir Jackie Stewart ('73) claiming

the prize once.

Meanwhile, Paul McGinley capped a triumphant 2014 for golf by winning the Coach of the Year award.

The Irishman, who is 48 on Tuesday, oversaw a 16½-11½ win over the United States at Gleneagles in September.

However, his European side were beaten to the Team of the Year prize by England's women rugby players, who beat Canada 21-9 in Paris to claim the World Cup for the first time since 1994.

Hamilton's F1 title triumph came after a titanic, season-long struggle with team-mate Nico Rosberg in the dominant Mercedes cars.

Victory in the final race of the campaign in Abu Dhabi secured the crown for the Englishman, who took the lead at the start and controlled the race as Rosberg suffered car trouble and finished 14th.

The team also wrapped up the constructors'

championship after a record-breaking season.

It is six seasons since Hamilton's only previous World Championship victory, when he won in dramatic fashion on the last lap of the Brazilian Grand Prix.

He is now Formula 1's most successful British driver with 33 victories - two more than double Sports Personality winner Mansell.

"I could not have done this without my amazing team, my family, my dad who once had four jobs to

## Britain losing courage, military chief warns

The head of the British military has warned the UK is becoming too timid precisely at a time when the world is becoming more dangerous.

General Sir Nick Houghton said we are living in a "more dangerous, less certain, less predictable, more unstable place" and the British military is well-placed to play its part in defending freedoms and values.

He made the remarks in his annual end-of-year speech to The Royal United Services Institute.

General Houghton said events in Ukraine, Iraq

and Syria, and the spread of Ebola, have meant the world is more unstable than it was 12 months ago.

"I worry that as a nation we could have started to lose some of our courageous instinct: the instinct to take risk and to make sacrifice both for our own security and the common good," he said.

He admitted the legacy of Iraq and Afghanistan is still "challenging" and the sight of coffins being driven through Wootton Bassett has left the public feeling sympathy for the armed forces and tested resilience.

"We have created a

situation in which, to varying degrees, government, parliament and society have become more cautious, nervous, anxious about the employment of military force," he said.

General Houghton reiterated his support for the Reserve Force and his confidence that it will grow to 30,000 from its current size of about 20,000.

This is designed to counter-balance the severe job cuts in the Army and the General gently criticised those he says "seek to undermine" the strategy.

In 2015 there will be

another security and defence spending review. The military, in particular the Army, is still recovering from the last one in 2010.

General Houghton was measured in his comments, mindful that there is a General Election

five months away.

But he laid down a challenge to the next government.

"Defence has to know what the government's appetite for risk truly is, because without that understanding it cannot address the issue of how

best to structure, equip and employ itself to meet the security challenges of the age," he said.

"The government needs to state whether it believes we have a grander role, a greater ambition, a place beyond the ordinary."

# Calling time on the Cat & Fiddle

**And so it's gone.**

The Cat and Fiddle, the legendary Hollywood hostelry for expat Brits and those who loved them, finally closed its doors for good on Monday.

The Sunset Boulevard pub has been a local institution for almost three decades, standing the test of time while other bars and restaurants came and went. The Cat, as it has long been affectionately known, finally fell victim - as detailed in these very pages - to commercial pressures from a bigger richer tenant who simply wanted their space.

Sic transit gloria. Unsurprisingly the pub was jammed during its final few days, as regulars, occasional

visitors and the merely curious came to have a pint and say goodbye. News of the pub's closing even reached across the Atlantic to Italy, where former regular Morrissey, late of the Smiths, penned a blog post lamenting the pub's demise, opining: "A large part of me dies at news that the pillowy bosom of the Cat And Fiddle is to close down on December 15th, making the universe all wrong. A beacon of light will soon be a headstone, and where will we now go to chew each other's fat?"

Where indeed? There really is no other British watering hole like the Cat & Fiddle, with its graceful Mission architecture, tranquil leafy plaza and the tinkling waters of that gloriously oversized

fountain. Nowhere with the rock and roll history, where you were as likely to rub shoulders with penniless Irish artists as with millionaire rockers, and where for so many years the locals were entertained both by the pub's gregarious founder, Kim Gardner and his able deputy, "Marquee" Brian McCaffrey, late of this parish but now of Dublin, and beloved of a whole generation of Irish rockers.

When the British Weekly had its offices on nearby Wilcox Avenue back in the early Nineties, the Cat became our de facto lunch room, and one of the great things about it was that by day it was a fantastically civilized place for a nice quiet lunch, but by night it

became a different beast entirely, full of leather clad rockers and mini skirted girls, goths and headbangers and builders and executives and everything in between, all enjoying some good beer, authentic pub grub and endless conversation.

## 'it isn't the end'

Eric Clapton, Rod Stewart, Ronnie Lane, Ronnie Wood may have been the names that made the pub famous, but for longtime expats like

myself the bigger draw were the colorful cast of characters who could so often be found there in the early days: The Bournemouth Boys, Motorcycle Richie, John Sneddon, Michael Reilly, Billy Woods, Thomas Hynes and Martin Devane to name just a few.

Since Kim Gardner's death a decade ago, the pub has been largely run by his daughter, Ashlee, with Kim's widow Paula operating quietly as a

*consigliere* in the background. According to a BBC report this week Ashlee was upbeat despite the air of sadness that hung over the place, preferring to concentrate on the pub's next location, wherever that may be.

"I was more or less born here," she said, "but we've moved before, back in 1982. We've got some of the old staff working tonight too, and though it's a bit emotional, it isn't the end."







# Deja vu as City draw Barca - again

## ■ Champions League Draw: Chelsea get PSG while Arsenal face Monaco

**MANCHESTER CITY face yet another mountain to climb in the Champions League after being drawn against Barcelona.**

The English champions overcame heavy odds to qualify, beating both Bayern Munich and Roma in their final two group matches, but will not relish another encounter with the team which knocked them out at the same stage of the competition last season with a 4-1 aggregate victory.

There was better news for **Chelsea** and **Arsenal** managers Jose Mourinho and Arsene Wenger, who were granted their wishes by drawing Paris Saint-Germain and Monaco, respectively.

Former Barcelona player and director of football Txiki Begiristain, who holds the same position at City, said: "It is unbelievable. We don't need to talk because every time it is the same. Bayern Munich, Roma and CSKA in the group stage and now Barcelona, who we also drew last season.

Chelsea manager

Mourinho had claimed he wanted to draw PSG, despite the fact the French club would appear to pose a stern test for his side.

Speaking ahead of the draw, Mourinho had said: "Paris would be good as it's easy to travel for us and the fans. That would be good. But we can't decide the draw."

Having drawn Bayern Munich in each of the last two seasons at the last-16 stage, Arsenal were finally handed a favourable tie against Wenger's former club Monaco.

Wenger spent seven years as Monaco's manager, winning both the French League and Cup in that time, as well as guiding the team to the European Cup semi-finals and the final of the European Cup Winners' Cup.

Celtic have been drawn against **Inter Milan** in the last 32 of the Europa League, with Liverpool facing Turkish side Besiktas.

**Tottenham** play Serie A side **Fiorentina**, **Everton** face Swiss club **Young Boys**, while holders **Sevilla** are up against

Borussia Monchengladbach.

The two legs will be played on Feb. 19 and 26.

Celtic's tie against Inter Milan is a repeat of the 1967 European Cup final in Lisbon, which the Glasgow side won 2-1 to become Britain's first European champions.

# Rampant Spurs ease into last four

Four-time winners Tottenham moved into the League Cup semi-finals with an emphatic victory over Premier League rivals Newcastle United on Wednesday night.

Young Magpies goalkeeper Jak Alnwick's error allowed Nabil Bentaleb to score, before Nacer Chadli precisely fired in just 36 seconds into the second half.

Harry Kane blasted in across Alnwick, then substitute Roberto Soldado rolled in shortly after replacing Kane.

Spurs will face League One side Sheffield United in the last four.

Their supremacy left the home fans at a noisy White Hart Lane singing confidently about the prospect of making the short trip across north London for the final on 1

March.

And being drawn against the Blades in next month's two-legged semi-final will increase their expectations of Spurs reaching a first Wembley final for six years.

Spurs boss Mauricio Pochettino has changed his team regularly this season as his side juggle their domestic ambitions with the demands of the Europa League.

The Argentine claimed in the pre-match build-up that any side he picks is not 'weakened' - and this time his players proved him right.

One point separates Tottenham and Newcastle in the top half of the Premier League, and only Alnwick's mistake - on his third senior appearance - differentiated the two sides at half-time.

The 21-year-old failed to gather Christian Eriksen's left-wing corner, allowing home midfielder Bentaleb to swoop in with an outstretched leg at the far post for his first Spurs goal.

Visiting boss Alan Pardew surprised many by naming an inexperienced side at Manchester City in the last round, but it was a tactic which paid dividends as Newcastle shocked the Premier League champions with an energetic performance.

He named another unfamiliar line-up at White Hart Lane, to non-Magpies supporters at least, due to injuries and suspensions rather than choice.

The visitors lacked the nous and punch to take

the chances created against Tottenham - and they were heavily punished.

Newcastle scored 10 seconds after the restart in October's Premier League meeting between the sides at White Hart Lane, but on this occasion it was the visitors who started the second half slowly.

Belgium midfielder Chadli was allowed the space to run at a cowering Newcastle defence and strike into the bottom-right corner.

And when Kane - who

Pochettino says will be selected for the England senior squad in "a matter of time" - netted his 12th goal of the season, there was little prospect of a Newcastle comeback.

Soldado took advantage of a loose Alnwick save just 73 seconds after replacing Kane for only his fourth goal of a frustrating campaign.

Then it was a case of damage limitation for the visitors, who go into Sunday's Tyne-Wear derby against Sunderland on the back of a heavy loss.

## Sterling service as Reds book date with the Blues

Liverpool set up a semi-final meeting with Chelsea as Raheem Sterling scored twice in a Capital One Cup win away to Championship leaders Bournemouth on Wednesday night.

The makeshift striker nodded in the opener after Callum Wilson had missed a glorious chance to put the hosts ahead.

Lazar Markovic's precise finish doubled the lead, but the Reds were thankful for Yann Kermorgant's glaring miss.

Sterling stroked in after the break and, although Dan Gosling bundled in to set nerves on edge, the Reds held on.

Sterling's brace was the first time he has found the net for his club since September and, after missing a succession of chances in the weekend's defeat to Manchester United, he looked more composed in a new central role. His return to goal-scoring form might also be timely amid reports that talks with Liverpool over a new contract have stalled.

With Liverpool desperately short of form and Bournemouth topping the Championship on the

back of a 12-match unbeaten run, only ten league places separated the sides at kick-off.

But, after Wilson had stabbed wide with only goalkeeper Brad Jones to beat, the Premier League visitors made that narrow gap feel like a chasm in class.

Liverpool dominated possession and had already threatened through Adam Lallana and Steven Gerrard's crisp long-range strikes, when Sterling capped a 52-pass move with the opener.

Sporting a newly shaved head, the 20-year-old stooped to glance home a close-range header after Markovic's deep cross had been nodded into the six-yard box by Jordan Henderson.

Deployed as an advanced wing-back, Markovic had seen plenty of the ball and he played a part in setting up his second with a neat pass to Philippe Coutinho.

As Bournemouth defender Tommy Elphick turned his back, apparently distracted by a whistle from the crowd, the Brazilian fired a snap shot from a tight angle.

Goalkeeper Artur Boruc blocked his effort
