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Obama to Charles: we're really quite fond of you!

IT WAS ALL SMILES in the Oval Office as the Prince of Wales met US President Barack Obama at the White House on Thursday.

Prince Charles and the Duchess of Cornwall met Mr Obama and vice-president Joe Biden in an affirmation of the continued close relationship between the USA and Great Britain.

Mr Obama and the prince last met four years ago when he flew to the US a few days after the wedding of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge.

The president told the prince that the Royal Family was fondly regarded by the American people.

Mr Obama told the prince it was "fair to say that the American people are quite fond of the Royal Family".

The prince replied: "That's awfully nice to know."

The president continued with the light-hearted comment: "They like them much better than they like their own politicians."

On Thursday Prince Charles also visited the Carlos Rosario International Public Charter School in Washington DC, which provides education and

training for the capital's adult immigrant population.

He also played 10-pin bowling during his tour of the city's US Armed Forces Retirement Home. The six-lane bowling alley is designed to provide exercise for the veterans who live at the home.

Bill Bowen, an 80-year-old former staff sergeant from the US Air Force, spoke to the prince during the visit.

Mr Bowen said: "I told him I was the worst bowler in this alley and he said, 'No, I am.'"

Earlier in their tour the pair visited monuments to Abraham Lincoln and Martin Luther King Jr and were joined by figures from the American civil rights movement, Jesse Jackson and Congressman John Lewis.

The royals are to join the commemorating of several important milestones.

These include the 150th anniversaries of the end of the American Civil War and the death of President Lincoln, and the 800th anniversary of Magna Carta.

Prince Charles is also expected to receive an award for exceptional leadership in conservation from the International Conservation Caucus Foundation.

Despite what started as a troubled relationship back in the 1700s, the royal family seems to today love America right back.

This trip is Prince Charles's 19th to the United States. Speaking to the president, he also praised his "nice" trip to Mount Vernon Tuesday.

"Because, you know, I went there 45 years ago - in 1970," the prince said, "so it was fantastic. It is very special there."

Osborne's budget for savers and workers

■ Chancellor hails Britain 'the comeback country'

George Osborne has announced tax cuts for first-time buyers, workers and savers in his final Budget before May's general election.

The chancellor claimed Britain was "walking tall again" after five years of austerity.

He also cut 1p from beer duty, 2% from cider and whisky and froze fuel and wine duty. Cigarettes will go up by 16p a pack as earlier planned.

Labour leader Ed Miliband said Mr Osborne had "failed working families".

"This a Budget that people won't believe from a government that is not on their side," Mr Miliband told MPs.

In his final set-piece pitch to voters before May's election, Mr Osborne announced that if the Conservatives win power the first £1,000 of savings interest would be tax free - meaning 95% of savers would pay no tax.

He also said savings put aside for a deposit by first-time buyers would be topped up by the government - to the tune of £50 for every £200 saved - in a move that will come into force this Autumn.

The new Help to Buy ISA accounts will be made available through banks and building societies.

Other measures include:

■ Relaxing pension rules from April 2016 to allow up to five million existing pensioners to swap their fixed annual payments for cash

■ Annual tax returns to be scrapped and replaced with "digital tax accounts"

■ A fresh crackdown on tax avoidance and evasion, which he said would raise £3.1bn

■ Raising the rate of the bank levy to 0.21% to bring in an additional £900m a year

■ A further boost for regional growth, including extending enterprise and housing zones - and plans for a tidal lagoon to generate green electricity in Swansea Bay. Severn Crossing toll rates will be reduced from 2018

■ £1.3bn in tax cuts for North Sea oil exploration and continued production in older fields

■ The price of 20 cigarettes will go up by 16p as part of a the long-standing formula that the price rises by 2%

above inflation but there will be no change to that formula

'hard work'

Mr Osborne hailed slightly better than expected growth figures, which suggest the economy will expand by 2.5% this year, rather than 2.4% and described his economic package as a "Budget for Britain - a comeback country".

He said the government had met its 2010 target to end this Parliament with Britain's national debt falling as a share of GDP, meaning the "the hard work and sacrifice of the British people has paid off".

Setting out his plans in the Commons, Mr Osborne said: "We took difficult decisions in the teeth of opposition and it worked. Britain is walking tall again.

"Five years ago, our economy had suffered a collapse greater than almost any country.

"Today, I can confirm: in the last year we have grown faster than any other major advanced economy in the world."

'rollercoaster'

He said he would use a boost in the public finances caused by lower inflation and welfare payments to pay off some of the national debt and end the squeeze on public spending a year earlier than planned.

In 2019/20 spending will grow in line with the growth of the economy -

bringing state spending as a share of national income to the same level as in 2000, the chancellor told MPs.

This was seen by observers as a move aimed at neutralising Labour's claim that the Conservatives would cut spending to 1930s levels.

But Shadow Chancellor

Ed Balls said the Treasury's own figures showed spending at the "lowest level since 1938"

in 2018/19 while the independent Office for Budget Responsibility, in its analysis, said Mr Osborne's plans implied a "rollercoaster profile" for expenditure over the next five years.

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My mistake killed 96, admits Hillsborough cop

The Hillsborough police match commander has agreed his failure to close a tunnel "was the direct cause of the deaths of 96 people".

David Duckenfield also accepted he "froze" during the afternoon of the 1989 football disaster.

Mr Duckenfield was giving evidence for a sixth day at the new Hillsborough inquests in Warrington, Cheshire.

He was being questioned by Paul Greaney QC on behalf of the Police Federation of England and Wales.

Mr Duckenfield, now 70, had earlier denied claims he "bottled it" and "panicked" as the disaster unfolded.

The jury was told the former chief superintendent had at least three minutes to "consider the consequences" of opening an exit gate at the stadium, as a crowd of fans built up outside.

Mr Greaney suggested a child of "average intelligence" could have realised what would happen when the gate, which allowed up to 2,000 fans to enter, was opened.

'no idea'

But Mr Duckenfield said he did "not think of it on the day" because of the pressure he was under.

He had "no idea" Liverpool fans would head through the gate for a tunnel which led to the already-packed terraces, he told the jury.

When asked by Mr Greaney if his failure to take steps to close the tunnel entrance was the direct cause of the deaths of 96 people, Mr Duckenfield replied "yes sir".

Ninety-six Liverpool fans died after crushing

at the FA Cup semi final match between Liverpool and Nottingham Forest held at Hillsborough.

Mr Greaney asked Mr Duckenfield if he had been incompetent in his role on the day of the disaster.

The retired officer answered: "I think it is a view some would agree with sir."

When asked by the barrister if he "simply froze", Mr Duckenfield said he thought it would be "fair to say that we were all in a state of shock."

It was the match commander's job to "get past any feelings of shock", Mr Greaney said.

"Yes, sir, but I am human," Mr Duckenfield replied.

Earlier in the inquests, he admitted he had lied about fans forcing an exit gate open to enter the ground.

He issued a long apology to the families of the victims, who have been campaigning for 26 years to establish more detail about what happened during the disaster.

John Beggs QC, representing Mr Duckenfield, said: "I think you understand, don't you, why the delay in providing a more gracious and more full apology has caused to many both offence and distress? You understand that?"

"I fully understand that sir," Mr Duckenfield said.

Heather Mills claims Sir Paul McCartney only worked with Rihanna and Kanye West so people would remember who he is'.

The 47-year-old charity campaigner and Alpine skier launched a stinging attack on her ex-husband - who collaborated with the stars on a new single FourFiveSeconds - and insisted people are not interested in him because the Beatles legend isn't relevant anymore.

After initially claiming it was 'boring' to talk

about Paul - who she divorced in 2006 after four years of marriage - Heather went on to claim that Paul has to work with current artists so 'people remember who he is'.

Speaking on Ireland's Late, Late Show, she said: "I go down the street and all I get is kids coming up to me and half of them don't even know who he is. That's why he's got to do songs with Rihanna and Kanye West, so people remember.

But most of the time I have people coming to me on the street saying 'Oh my god you're a ski-racer' or 'you help the animals', or you know, I own the biggest vegan company in the world."

She also said: "This is just someone I fell in love with, who to me was a normal guy, who happened to write a few cool songs in the 60s and a few in the 70s".

Welshman charged for treatment in English hospital as he was 'classed as foreigner'

■ Nicholas White shocked to receive £1,775 bill for tests at Hinchingsbrooke Hospital after falling ill while visiting relatives in Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire

A man from Wales was charged £1,775 for treatment in an English hospital - because he was a "foreigner".

Nicholas White, 64, was shocked when the bill arrived after he was taken ill while visiting relatives in Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire, just before Christmas.

"I was told that because I was Welsh I counted as a foreigner and would therefore have

to pay," said Mr White, a retired teacher from Dyffryn Ardudwy, Gwynedd, Wales.

He spent three days undergoing tests at the Hinchingsbrooke Hospital and was released with suspected gallstones.

Several weeks later, Mr White was offered an appointment for a follow-up procedure in the form of a gastroscopy to investigate what was causing his pain.

He decided to travel back to Hinchingsbrooke Hospital but, moments before he was due to have the medical procedure, Mr White said he was ushered into a side room by an administrator and told he would have to pay for the examination and the previous three-day stay because he was "technically a foreigner".

Mr White said: "I was dressed up ready for the

op - I had the printed wristbands already on - when they ushered me in. I was told that because I was Welsh I counted as a foreigner and would therefore have to pay."

After recovering from the procedure, which discovered a hiatus hernia that does not need surgery, Mr White was "shocked" to see a letter posted through his door with "IMPORTANT" handwritten in red pen.

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Cop alleges ANOTHER Cyril Smith cover-up

■ Late politician was caught abusing boy and sex-offender policeman hid the truth, claims retired cop
 ■ Rochdale MP used his position to repeatedly escape police and court action for decades

Explosive new revelations of a police and establishment cover-up over Cyril Smith's paedophile past emerged this week.

A retired police officer said the 29-stone Liberal MP was protected by a sex-offender sergeant after he was caught at a sex party with two boys.

Smith walked free and the retired officer – then a probationary beat bobby – was threatened with the Official Secrets Act and told to stay silent by his colleague Don Mackintosh, who himself turned out to be a paedophile.

But on Monday after 27 years, the former Greater Manchester officer broke cover to

reveal his anger amid growing fury over how Smith repeatedly escaped prosecution during four decades of appalling abuse.

His revelations mean Smith escaped possible prosecution at least eight times after orders were made at the highest level to cover up his crimes.

Last year's publication of the Simon Danczuk's book, *Smile For The Camera: The Double Life Of Cyril Smith*, blew the lid off Smith's sordid sexual activities, detailing how the Rochdale MP had repeatedly escaped police and court action for decades despite leaving a trail of young victims in his wake.

The strong suggestion has always been that the establishment conspired – via the police and security services – to protect the MP who was seen as a useful bulwark against the hard Left.

On Tuesday night Greater Manchester Police announced a new inquiry into the claims.

'prolific abuser'

They were made just days after it was revealed that Smith had been arrested at a similarly sordid event in London but was let off.

And this week another police force, Northamptonshire, disclosed that it, too, was probing suggestions that it let Smith off the hook

in the 1980s when it discovered child pornography in his car.

Labour MP Mr Danczuk said last night: 'More police officers are now coming forward to share their anger and disgust at how there was simply no appetite to prosecute Cyril for child abuse.'

'Cyril Smith was a prolific abuser of children and I've no doubt that he was on the radar of a number of police forces.'

Earlier this week the independent police watchdog revealed it is overseeing 14 separate claims of cover-ups and corruption in historic sex abuse case by Scotland Yard.

Prime Minister David Cameron has already guaranteed that police whistle-blowers will not be prosecuted under the Official Secrets Act if they come forward.

'criminal investigation'

The retired Greater Manchester officer was threatened with the Official Secrets Act after he discovered Smith at the party with a prolific sex offender and two drunk teenage boys in 1988.

The officer said: 'I had been in the force about six months. The occupier was about 70 and seemed an old granddad type.'

In the house was Cyril Smith and a police sergeant in civilian clothes. The officer identified himself and showed his warrant card, saying he was there "on other business".

'There seemed to be a party going on, with two

young lads there. Smith and the officer left. The boys, aged about 14 to 15, were drunk.

'One was missing from a children's home. I called for a van and took him back. The other lad walked off.'

'The old man was arrested and I took him to the main police station in Stockport.'

The following day, the officer says, he was called to a meeting by a senior officer and his mentoring officer, Sergeant Mackintosh, who was later exposed as a prolific child abuser and who was found hanged in his home last year.

The officer said: 'I was told I would break the Official Secrets Act if I told anyone. In no uncertain terms I was told to say nothing. They knew Smith was there and knew who he was.'

Greater Manchester Assistant Chief Constable Ian Wiggett said: 'These fresh allegations will now be examined by Operation Clifton, a criminal investigation into how previous reports of child sexual abuse were handled or allegedly covered up. These allegations are concerning and will be treated seriously.'

British beaches fouled by invasion of wet wipes

Britain's beaches are becoming clogged up with wet wipes as people increasingly flush them down the lavatory.

Marine conservationists have said the number of wet wipes found on beaches has risen by around 50% over the past year as people use them instead of toilet paper, in baby changing, to remove make-up and to apply fake tan.

The Marine Conservation Society's latest annual "Great British Beach Clean" survey of more than 300 beaches showed a 6.4% rise in beach litter in general between 2013 and 2014.

The charity revealed 2,457 pieces of litter were collected from each kilometre (0.6 mile) of coastline cleaned, up

from an average of 2,309 in 2013.

Within that, an average of 35 wet wipes were retrieved, up from 23 on the previous year.

Many people do not realise that what goes through the sewers may end up in the sea.

Gill Bell from MCS told Sky News: "You don't want to put anything down your toilet other than the three Ps - pee, poo and paper."

"Nothing else needs to go down the toilet. A lot of those other things contain plastics and plastics can remain in the environment for years.

"Not only do they remain in the environment, they break down into smaller and smaller pieces so they affect animals from the bottom to the top of the

food chain."

The plastic in wet wipes, which stops them disintegrating like toilet paper, also causes blockages in the sewage system - and once those blockages happen everything else flushed down the toilet can back up into people's homes or overflow into rivers and seas.

Other strange objects found on the beaches during the survey included a colostomy bag, a plastic hand, a piping gun nozzle, a bra strap and, on one particular beach, nine pairs of shoes of various sizes.

The charity's call for a national marine litter action plan comes as the Prince of Wales attended a one-day long conference in the US and called for action to halt the dumping of plastics -

by far the greatest source of pollution in the sea.

Prince Charles said: "I was horrified to learn that, according to recent research, we collectively allow as much as eight million tonnes of plastic to enter the oceans every year."

"Today, almost half of all marine mammals now have plastic in their gut and I know I am not the only person haunted by the tragic images of seabirds, particularly albatrosses, that have been found dead, washed up on beaches after mistaking a piece of plastic for a meal."

"Speaking as a grandfather with a new grandchild due to appear in this world in a month's time, I think we probably owe it to everyone else's grandchildren to grasp that solution."

From one Queen to another! Kristin Scott Thomas receives her damehood ahead of her West End debut....as the British monarch

Kristin Scott Thomas has collected her damehood from the Queen at Buckingham Palace.

The 54-year-old film and television star, best known for roles in *The English Patient*, *Gosford Park* and *Four Weddings And A Funeral*, wore a demure blue coat and matching hat for the royal occasion.

Dame Kristin was honoured for her services to drama ahead of her West End debut as the Queen in *The Audience*.

Scott Thomas takes over from Dame Helen Mirren in *The Audience* which is inspired by the Queen's private weekly meetings with the country's prime ministers over her six-decade reign.

The PMs include David Calder as Winston Churchill, Mark Dexter as

David Cameron, Michael Gould as John Major, Gordon Kennedy as Gordon Brown, Sylvestra Le Touzel as Margaret Thatcher, David Robb as Anthony Eden and Nicholas Woodeson as Harold Wilson.

It is the latest role for the Cornwall-born actress whose career has seen her honoured in both the UK and France where she now lives.

'pulling my leg'

She was made an OBE in 2003 and two years later was presented with France's Legion of Honour in recognition of a career.

However when she first learned of the damehood from her agent, Kristin, 54, thought it was all just a big wind-up.

The *Audience* is scheduled at the Apollo Theatre, opening on May 5th, following previews from April 21st.

Jeremy Clarkson Top Gear 'fracas' report due next week

JEREMY CLARKSON'S career as a BBC presenter is hanging in the balance with the Corporation's report into his recent shoving match with a producer due to be handed over to the director general next week.

The internal investigation into Clarkson's suspension, following a "fracas" with Oisin Tymon, will be considered by Tony Hall.

Director of BBC Scotland, Ken MacQuarrie, who is leading the investigation, "is now considering the evidence", a BBC spokesperson said.

"Once this has been considered, we will set out any further steps."

"The BBC will not be offering further commentary until then,"

the spokesperson concluded.

Clarkson was suspended from the global smash hit show *Top Gear* on 10 March, following an alleged altercation with Tymon over catering arrangements following a long day's shooting.

Online petition

Mr Tymon did not file a formal complaint and it is understood Clarkson reported the incident himself.

A lawyer for Mr Tymon said his client "intends to await the outcome of the BBC investigation and will make no comment until that investigation is complete".

All remaining shows in the current series were pulled following the incident.

Top Gear is one of the BBC's most popular and profitable TV shows, with an estimated global audience of 350 million.

Its success is largely attributed to the contentious host, who has appeared on the show since 1988.

An online petition calling for the star's reinstatement - set up by political blogger Guido Fawkes - has accrued more than 975,000 signatures since the presenter's suspension.

Clarkson has expressed regret over the incident, which his co-presenter James May labelled "a bit of a dust-up".

The host has long been controversial and has a history of making comments which many consider offensive, with

more than one TV critic observing that he would have been fired long ago if it were not for the phenomenal revenue the show brings the BBC.

Clarkson was given what he called his "final warning" by bosses at the corporation last May after claims he used a racist word during filming.

And it later emerged that the show could have

stayed on air without Clarkson - but his co-hosts reportedly refused to present the show without him.

James May and Richard Hammond were offered the chance to front *Top Gear* during Clarkson's suspension, according to a BBC executive.

Discussions were held about broadcasting the last three episodes with

mainly recorded segments while the two co-stars filmed the studio parts.

However the BBC insider said that May and Hammond rejected the offer and refused to go on air without their long-time colleague.

The source said: "They didn't want to do it without Jeremy so the talks didn't get off the ground."

Veteran British rocker Andy Fraser dies in Temecula

■ Bassist found fame in his teens as member of Free, penning the enduring rock anthem 'All Right Now'

Andy Fraser, who has died in California at age 62 from HIV-related causes. Fraser had been living in the desert community of Temecula, where he

died Monday, the Riverside County coroner said in a statement.

Fraser was born to a single mother in London's Paddington in 1952 and showed an aptitude for music at a young age, begging his mother to buy him a piano when he was just five. At twelve he switched to electric guitar, before moving to the bass three years later, quickly becoming one of the brightest young talents on London's vibrant underground music scene.

Fraser was just 15 when he formed Free in 1967 with three other London teenagers (Paul Rodgers, Paul Kossoff and Simon Kirke). Almost at once the band won critical acclaim and a contract with Island Records, although their debut album (Tons Of Sobs) and its eponymous follow-up managed few sales.

Then, in May 1970, Free

released the album Fire And Water and the single All Right Now. The former topped the UK album charts, while All Right Now went to No 2 and made No 1 in 20 other countries. The song, co-written by Fraser and Rodgers, has since enjoyed huge exposure not only through airplay but also in films, television series and

advertising campaigns. The song is also a staple of football stadiums. The Stanford University and University of Southern California marching bands each play it at virtually every game. Fraser kept playing music for most of his life, but he would never equal the success he had as a teen with Free, which broke up in 1972.

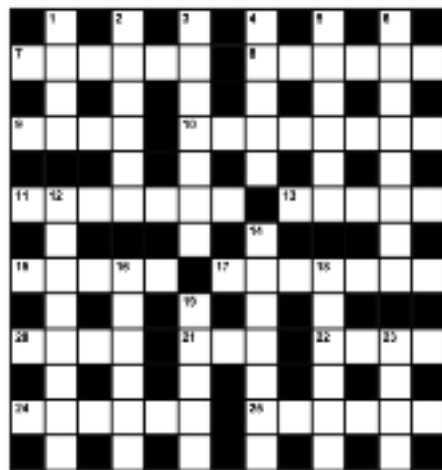



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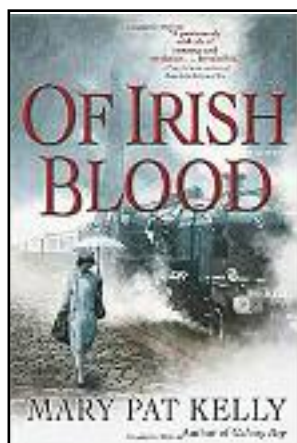
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Of Irish Blood: delving into a very green past...

Exclusive interview with author Mary Pat Kelly and a review of her new novel about an Irish American war photographer who gets caught up in the Irish Rebellion



"I was very surprised when I discovered the Irish College of Paris in 1985," says *Of Irish Blood* author Mary Pat Kelly. "In the 17th Century when Ireland was under English rule Catholicism was outlawed. It was forbidden for Catholics to go to school, own land or vote. Priests in Ireland were hunted and killed. At this time 38 colleges were set up across Europe to educate priests and laypeople. The Irish College started still exists and is now the Irish Cultural Center. *Of Irish*

Blood was inspired by the life of my great aunt Nora Kelly, who according to family lore worked in Paris for year as a buyer for Marshall Fields department store. I imagined here finding the Irish College and meeting Ireland's revolutionary women as well as famous American expatriates such as Gertrude Stein."

Kelly weaves real people throughout the story. So much is covered in the book you may wish

it had been two books, one on Nora's life in the States before and during WWI, the second about the Irish Rebellion and Nora returning home. Nora is feisty and very creative.

It's 1903. Nora Kelly is 24 and lives in Chicago. She works as a switchboard operator, gets promoted, and starts designing clothing for women. She advances by moving to Boston, but becomes involved there with the gangster Tim McShane. She goes to Paris and learns how to use a camera. She meets artists and many well known people like Gertrude Stein and Sylvia Beach. It's now 1914. Europe is about to enter the First World War. Nora can't go home so stays in Europe where she becomes a war photographer. Being Irish, she becomes embroiled in

the Irish rebellion.

"I researched *Galway Bay* and *Of Irish Blood* for 40 years," says Kelley. "My Ph.D dissertation was entitled, *The Sovereign, Woman: Her Image in the Literature of Ireland*. I learned a lot about the myths and sagas of Ireland. And through my documentaries I studied more recent history as well as researching my own family. I viewed 14th century manuscripts in the Royal Irish Academy on Dublin including *The Book of the Kelly's* which is important in *Of Irish Blood*. When a fragment is discovered in the Irish college it becomes kind of a talisman for the gathering of revolutionaries.

While researching *Galway Bay*, Kelley found the grave of her great great grandmother in Chicago. "There was no headstone.

It was an unmarked grave. So put out a call to her descendants. Now I knew my first cousins and some of my second cousins but the Kelly Clan in Chicago is a mighty group and we found each other and came together to dedicate a Honora's headstone in Calvary cemetery in Chicago. Her grandson Ed Kelly, who became Mayor of Chicago is buried nearby."

"*Galway Bay* was my way of telling the story of Irish America through my own family history, especially the devastation caused by the Great Starvation of the 1840's and how Honora saved her children and escaped to Chicago," says Kelley. *Of Irish Blood* is the sequel to *Galway Bay*. It follows the Kelly family through the next-generation those born in America."

Kelley is currently

writing the book called *Irish Above All*. That follows the Kelly family through the rise of Ed Kelly as he becomes mayor of Chicago in 1933 and his influence in FDR's administration during the Second World War.

Kelley has lived in New York since 1970. She was born in Chicago.

Yorkshire opener Adam Lyth, Durham seamer Mark Wood and Yorkshire leg-spinner Adil Rashid are all included.

The trio are the only players yet to be capped

at Test level in a squad captained by Alastair Cook.

Middlesex opener Sam Robson has been left out despite playing in England's last seven Tests, with fast bowler Steven Finn also omitted following a disappointing World

Cup.

Trott scored 3,763 runs in 49 England Tests before leaving Australia after the first Test in Brisbane in November 2013 due to a long-standing anxiety condition.

Having started the 2014 season with

Warwickshire, his county campaign was interrupted when he took another break from the game in April.

But, following sessions with psychiatrist Dr Steve Peters, he returned to the Bears side in May, ending the summer with 628 first-class runs.

He made a triumphant return to international colours in January, scoring a double hundred as captain of England Lions in South Africa.

National selector James Whitaker said: "Jonathan Trott is a player of proven international pedigree and we are delighted to welcome him back into the squad."

SIX NATIONS: England team talk delayed until task is clear

England will hold their team talk just half-an-hour before Saturday's 5pm kick-off of the Six Nations decider against France at Twickenham. Coach Stuart Lancaster will inform the players of the required winning margin after the other two matches finish.

Wales play Italy in Rome (12:30 GMT), before Ireland face Scotland at Murrayfield (14:30 GMT).

"It's an unusual situation, but we'll prepare for all eventualities," lock Geoff Parling told reporters.

England, who last won the Six Nations in 2011 and have finished runners-up for the last three seasons, go into the final round of matches top of the table but level on points with Ireland and Wales.

They hold a points difference of +37 to Ireland's +33 and Wales's +12.

England players will be told to focus on their preparations for the match rather than be distracted by score updates from the other

matches.

British and Irish Lion Parling is the only change to the side which beat Scotland 25-13 in their last outing, coming in for Dave Attwood.

Parling added: "It is better that he (Lancaster) does it and says 'this is the craic' rather than Chinese whispers from the lads."

Lancaster will wait until half-an-hour before the 17:00 GMT kick-off before issuing instructions to the players.

He said: "We firstly have to understand what will be the challenge. The Ireland match in Scotland will finish at about 4.25pm and we kick off at five.

"We will have to make sure the players understand the objectives. It might be just to win the game, or it could be to win it by 10 or 20 points.

"It is certainly a unique situation where the end of the Championship is decided with staggered times, with the teams playing last knowing there is a certain points differential to score."

Arsene Wenger: Monaco did not deserve last-eight place

Arsenal boss Arsene Wenger says Monaco did not deserve their place in the Champions League quarter-finals after failing to register a shot on target in the second leg of their tie.

The Ligue 1 side advanced on away goals after beating Arsenal 3-1 at Emirates Stadium before losing 2-0 in Monaco.

Asked if Monaco deserved to progress, Wenger said: "I don't believe so.

"If you look at the number of shots on target they had you will be surprised. Every defeat hurts but we didn't lose."

Wenger's comments contrasted with those of captain Per Mertesacker.

The German World Cup winner said: "The best team went through. Monaco deserved it because they played much better in the first leg.

"We came here and tried absolutely everything. We could have scored more than two. We regret the first game."

Needing to score at least three unanswered away goals, the Gunners went ahead through Olivier Giroud's close-range finish.

Aaron Ramsey came

off the bench to score late on, but Monaco held on.

It is the fifth straight year Arsenal have exited at the last-16 stage.

While the previous four defeats have been at the hands of Bayern Munich (twice), AC Milan and Barcelona, Wenger said this one was the most disappointing.

"I would take it separately from the other years," he said. "The overall situation is very disappointing but if you look at the game tonight it is very positive. This game is in line with what we have done recently."

Arsenal's victory was their eighth in nine

games and handed Monaco their first home defeat in 17 matches.

But Wenger, a former Monaco coach, blamed the overall result on "impatience" in the first leg.

The Gunners had made it 2-1 at the Emirates with a goal in the 90th minute only for Monaco to score a third in added time.

"We paid for not producing the performance we wanted in the first game but this time Monaco played at home, had zero shots on target and go through to the quarter-finals," he said.

United will be my last job, says Van Gaal

Manchester United manager Louis van Gaal says he will retire from football when his spell with the club ends.

The 63-year-old, who is contracted to United until 2017 after joining the club last summer, wants to spend more time with his family.

Dutchman Van Gaal has coached some of Europe's biggest clubs, including Barcelona, Bayern Munich and Ajax, in his career.

He told the Daily

Telegraph: "I am old. This is my last job. For sure."

He added: "I have to pay attention to my kids, my grandchildren but also to my wife. They deserve it.

"Now I cannot pay that attention. I was not at the birthday of my grandson, for example. I don't like it."

Van Gaal said he planned to retire to Portugal with wife Truus and "play golf, eat fantastic food".

Dynamo halt Everton's forward progress

England's last remaining team exited European competition as Everton were soundly beaten in their last-16 Europa League tie against Dynamo Kiev on Thursday.

In a week where Manchester City and Arsenal exited the Champions League, poor defending cost Everton in Ukraine, as they lost 6-4 on aggregate.

Romelu Lukaku's strike cancelled out Andriy Yarmolenko's wonderful opener.

But Lukasz Teodorczyk, Miguel Veloso, Oleg Gusev and Antunes scored, before Phil Jagielka's headed consolation.

Everton's resounding defeat ends a dismal month for English sides in Europe, with Chelsea, Liverpool and Tottenham also knocked out.

The collective failings mean the country does not have a side in the last eight of the Europa League or Champions League for the first time since 1995.

It will pose further questions on the strength of the domestic game and Martinez will likely be quizzed about his team's defensive generosity as they surrendered a 2-1 first-leg lead in their first European away loss of the season.

Kane said: "It's something I'd always dreamed of as a kid."

The forward's Tottenham team-mate, defender Kyle Walker, also returns to the national squad for the first time since November 2013.

England meet Lithuania at Wembley on 27 March in their latest Group E Euro 2016 qualifier before a friendly in Turin against Italy on 31 March.

Aston Villa midfielder Fabian Delph is back after missing November's games against Slovenia and Scotland with injury.

Only two goalkeepers are named after West Brom's Ben Foster was ruled out for a month with a knee injury.

"We regard Jack Butland as the third keeper," Hodgson added.

Touré heading for the exit as City flop again

YAYA TOURE is likely to lead a Manchester City exodus this summer after the team again fell short in the Champions League.

Despite the narrow 1-0 scoreline at the Nou Camp on Wednesday night City were completely outclassed by their hosts, who were again orchestrated by the dazzling Lionel Messi. But for the heroics of Joe Hart, City could have lost by half a dozen goals.

According to reports from inside the club, this latest disappointment on Europe's biggest stage will prompt City's deep-pocketed owners to dispense with many of their highest-paid but under-performing stars.

Top of the list is Touré, who still has two years remaining on his contract and as the club's best-paid player, earns at least £220,000 a week but is still

coveted by several of the biggest clubs in Europe.

Bacary Sagna, Martín Demichelis, Aleksandar Kolarov, Samir Nasri and James Milner are also said to be on the chopping block after the team were outclassed by Barcelona over two legs.

Of those players who did not start in Wednesday's loss in Catalonia, Gaël Clichy, Pablo Zabaleta, Jesús Navas, Fernando, Stevan Jovetic and Edin Džeko may also be expendable. Frank Lampard is finally leaving to join New York City FC.

Touré is wanted by his former City manager Roberto Mancini, who is in charge of Internazionale. The City executive are aware of Mancini's interest in taking the Ivorian but whether the Italian club have the finance to buy Touré and match his

considerable salary is in the balance.

Last week Mancini said: "Yaya has played in every top league, apart from Germany and Italy. If, as it seems, he wants to have an experience in Italy, then there is this possibility he could come here. It won't be easy but he's a player with incredible technique and character. Would Inter be his first choice? That's certain."

City are keen on De Bruyne, a former Chelsea midfielder who was sold to Wolfsburg for £18m. He has scored nine goals in 25 Bundesliga appearances for a Wolfsburg side nine points clear in second place. At 23 and as an established Belgium international, De Bruyne fits the profile wanted by City in their drive to lower the age of the squad.

Ayoze Pérez, the 21-year-old Newcastle United striker, is also on

City's radar. At the weekend John Carver, the Newcastle manager, claimed he had "a good chat with Brian Kidd [assistant manager] at Man City about him".

With Džeko having disappointed since signing a new deal last year and Jovetic unhappy at being left out of the Champions League squad for the knockout phase,

the hope if either of these were to leave would be that if Pérez were acquired his potential could complement Agüero and Wilfried Bony, the established strikers.

Mourinho eyes £40m FFP windfall

Jose Mourinho has been given the green light to spend big as Chelsea will have access to over £40million in extra Financial Fair Play cash this summer.

The money is likely to fund the pursuit of a superstar who can bring the West London team closer to the Champions League glory craved by owner Roman Abramovich.

And top of the shopping list is thought to be French midfielder **Paul Pogba**, the former Manchester United prospect who has blossomed into a superstar with Italian outfit Juventus.

Mourinho is free to throw off some of the

shackles of the 'one in, one out' policy he has operated under since returning to Stamford Bridge thanks to a whopping £200m Yokohama shirt sponsorship deal, the fact Fernando Torres will no longer be a financial burden on the club and Eden Hazard's new contract.

While £40m may not seem like a huge figure in comparison to what clubs pay on transfer fees, it is extremely significant in terms of FFP costs.

Torres has hit Chelsea for just over £18m-a-year in FFP costs and this summer is the first in which the Blues can budget for not having the

Spaniard on the books.

The permanent move to AC Milan that allowed Torres to join Atletico Madrid on loan saw Chelsea accept an £18.72m Financial Fair Play hit on the striker this season in order for him to be wiped off next season's books.

Financial Fair Play accounting dictates that players are valued annually, which is calculated by adding the amortised transfer fee to the annual wage.

And Chelsea have also saved themselves money on FFP by handing Eden Hazard a new contract, even though they have increased his wages to £200,000-a-week.
