# Britain must stay in EU, says Obama

**BARACK OBAMA has urged Britain to resolve its issues with the European Union and ensure the UK retains its influence on the world stage by staying firmly engaged with the rest of the Continent.**

The US President was speaking ahead the G7 summit in Germany at the weekend and said the US-UK relationship remains strong, adding: "We have no closer partner around the world."

He said: "I would note that one of the great values of having the United Kingdom in the European Union is its leadership and strength on a whole host of global challenges."

"So we very much are looking forward to the United Kingdom staying part of the European Union because we think its influence is positive not just for Europe, but also for the world."

The comments are the strongest indication yet that Washington wants a Yes vote in the referendum which Mr Cameron has promised by the end of 2017 on whether Britain should stay in the EU.

Mr Cameron embarked

on a tour of Europe soon after the election to seek support in his bid to renegotiate Britain's relationship with Brussels.

But he faces a tough opposition in the lead up to the referendum, with eurosceptic members of his party signalling they are ready to campaign for exiting Europe.

At least 50 Tory MPs, including former Cabinet ministers Owen Paterson and John Redwood, have signed up to the newly-formed Conservatives for Britain (CfB) to keep the pressure on ahead of the vote.

Mr Cameron earlier arrived at the G7 summit urging the world's most powerful leaders to keep up a united front in response to the conflict between Russia and Ukraine.

He added that Russia should continue to be subjected to sanctions.

"It (sanctions) has an impact on all countries.

"(But) Britain hasn't let

should either."

The EU and US worked in concert to impose stiff sanctions on members of President Vladimir Putin's inner circle and key sectors of the Russian economy in the wake of last year's annexation of Crimea.

Russia was also ejected from the G8 group, resulting in this year's

slimmed-down summit line-up of seven.

Cameron He also urged the G7 to tackle corruption in the wake of the scandal engulfing FIFA.

He described corruption as "a cancer at the heart of so many challenges we face in our world", adding: "This is something we must not turn a blind eye to as

perhaps was done for too long in the world of football."

Mr Cameron was joined by German Chancellor Angela Merkel, Mr Obama, French President Francois Hollande, Italian PM Matteo Renzi, Canadian PM Stephen Harper and Japanese PM Shinzo Abe for the two-day summit.

# Back me on EU or quit, PM tells Tory rebels

## ■ Cameron gets tough ahead of vital EU talks

David Cameron has suggested that he expects all members of the government to back him over any EU deal.

Speaking at the G7 summit in Germany, he said he was confident he could secure sufficient reforms but indicated that ministers who did not support him would have to resign.

The prime minister also said he was taking a “very open-minded view” on the timing of the in/out referendum.

It comes after President Obama declared he wanted Britain to stay in the EU.

The prime minister said: “If you want to be part of the government you have to take the view that we are engaged in an exercise of renegotiation to have a referendum and that will lead to a successful outcome.

“Everyone in government has signed up to the programme set out in the Conservative manifesto.”

Mr Cameron added: “I am carrying out a renegotiation in the national interest to get a result that I believe will be in the national interest. I’m confident I can get that.”

He told reporters it was not a “on the one hand, on the other hand approach”.

“The government isn’t neutral in this. We have a clear view: renegotiate, get a deal that’s in Britain’s interest and then recommend Britain stays in it.”

### ‘Sufficient reforms’

Eurosceptic Conservatives have made it clear they are ready to campaign for an exit vote if the prime minister fails to come up with a package they believe delivers real change.

At least 50 Tory MPs, including former cabinet ministers Owen Paterson and John Redwood, have signed up to the newly-formed Conservatives for Britain group to keep the

pressure on ahead on the public vote.

Steve Baker MP, who is co-chair of the group, said he believed some cabinet members would resign over issues surrounding EU

membership.

“If we don’t get a sovereign Parliament, I would be quite surprised if one or two don’t resign, but that really is a matter for them,” he told the reporters.

# Cameron’s EU talks: what is Britain looking for?

AT THE HEART David Cameron’s effort to hammer out a new deal with the EU is a fundamental disagreement between the UK and many of its EU partners about the wisdom of forging an “ever closer union” of the peoples of Europe. The key reforms he is seeking are:

- Restricting access to in-work and out-of-work benefits to EU migrants
- Giving greater powers to

national parliaments to block EU legislation

- Supporting the continued enlargement of the EU to new members but with new mechanisms in place to “prevent vast migrations across the Continent”

- Freeing business from red tape and “excessive interference” from Brussels and providing access to new markets through “turbo charging” free trade deals with America and

Asia

- Protection for the City of London financial markets from EU legislation

- Creating safeguards to ensure changes in the single market cannot be imposed on non-eurozone members by the eurozone

### What else does Mr Cameron want?

The prime minister has said Britain would resist any move towards a European Army and that he wants to free British

police forces from EU interference. He has also ruled out Britain joining the euro.

But he has placed less emphasis in recent years on demanding changes to EU social policy, such as the maximum 48-hour working week, agency workers, maternity leave and non-discrimination rules.

### When will the referendum be held?

The official UK

government position is that a referendum will be held by the end of 2017 but Downing Street sources have said: “If we can do it earlier we will.”

There is speculation David Cameron is planning to hold the vote in 2016 to avoid a clash with French and German elections in 2017.

The prime minister wants treaty change but even if the referendum was held in 2017 there may not be enough time to legally


incorporate any reforms into a treaty and it would have to be done at a later stage.

An early referendum would anger Eurosceptics who believe it would not allow enough time to make the case for exit or negotiate any meaningful concessions.

crucial in any referendum and there is already a debate about what it should be. The Draft European Union (Referendum) Bill, published by the Conservatives in 2013, proposed this form of words: "Do you think that the United Kingdom should remain a member of the European Union?"

Some thought that leaned too far towards the status quo, encouraging a yes vote, and the Electoral Commission said it was not clear and direct enough. The watchdog proposed this form of words instead: "Should the United Kingdom remain a member of the European Union?"

### Court of human rights

The new Conservative government will attempt to repeal the Human Rights Act, which requires UK courts to treat the European Court of Human Rights as setting legal precedents for the UK, in favour of a British Bill of Rights.

The European Court of Human Rights is not a European Union institution. It was set up by the Council of Europe (CoE), which has 47 members including Russia and Ukraine.

### What about freedom of movement?

The freedom for people to move around Europe, enshrined in the EU treaties, works in parallel with the other three basic freedoms in the single market: freedom of goods, capital and services.

It is likely to be a "red line" for other EU leaders, who do not want to see it eroded.

Mr Cameron has steered clear of tackling it directly - for example by asking for an emergency "brake" on free movement, or a cap on numbers - focusing instead on reducing the incentive provided by welfare payments.

# Regal Mirren crowned queen of Broadway

**Dame Helen Mirren has won her first Tony Award for her performance as the Queen in The Audience.**

The veteran British actress picked up the award at Sunday night's ceremony for best performance by a leading actress in a play, beating stiff competition from fellow Brits Carey Mulligan and Ruth Wilson, as well as Elisabeth Moss and Geneva Carr.

The Prime Suspect star was initially reluctant to star in *The Audience*, written by Peter Morgan, since she had already won an Oscar for her role of Queen Elizabeth II in the movie *The Queen*, also written by Morgan, set in 1997 after the death of Princess Diana.

### 'beautifully built'

But that changed when she read Morgan's clever script for *The Audience*, which imagines the private weekly meetings between the monarch and the 12 prime ministers who have served in her six-decade reign.

After her name was called at the awards

ceremony in New York, Dame Helen walked onto the stage and said: "Your Majesty, you did it again."

She continued: "The foundation upon which I stand is beautifully built by an elegant and fleet play by Peter Morgan, an elegant and theatrical production by Stephen Daldry, an elegant and imaginative set by the great Bob Crowley, a stage management team who are certainly not

elegant and a crew who are stupendous, a dresser who is a rock, producers who rock and of course an incredible cast of British and American actors who make the Atlantic look like a little creek you can just pop across.

"This is an unbelievable honour and I am so thrilled."

Mirren joked that she should do an audiobook next - were she to win a Grammy for it, she would join the elite group of 12 "Egots" - artists who have won an

Emmy, a Grammy, an Oscar and a Tony. Her co-star in *The Audience*, Richard McCabe, also picked up a supporting actor award for his performance as Harold Wilson.

### unknown

As he collected his gong, he proclaimed: "Oh my giddy aunt."

On a good night for British talent the previously-unknown Alex Sharp won for his breakthrough performance in *The Curious Incident of the*

*Dog in the Night-Time*, the play adapted from Mark Haddon's bestselling novel about a teenager on the autism spectrum trying to solve the mystery of how his neighbour's dog died. He beat the likes of Bradley Cooper and Bill Nighy, despite it being his first major role.

"Oh my God, this is so crazy," he said on accepting the award. "Oh jeez. This time last year I picked up my diploma, graduating from Juilliard [drama school], so to be holding this is insane."

Sharp was born and is now based in London, but he was mostly home-schooled, spending the early years of his life travelling the US in a caravan with his family before living in Italy and Devon. After being rejected from British drama schools, he decided to go travelling again and worked as a handyman.

He was renovating houses when he applied for the prestigious New York school, and got in after performing a scene he wrote himself - despite saying it was by a minor British playwright. He dedicated his award to "any young person out there who feels misunderstood".

# 'Disruptive' Kate Moss escorted off Luton plane

WE ALL GET those end-of-vacation grumps now and then, but supermodel Kate Moss took it a tad too far this week, behaving so badly on her flight back from a Turkish sunshine break that she was escorted off the plane by police after reports that she was being "disruptive".

However, no formal complaints were made and the supermodel was not arrested following her arrival into Luton Airport from Bodrum in Turkey on Saturday.

A Bedfordshire Police spokesman said: "We were called to assist staff in escorting a passenger from a flight arriving into Luton airport this afternoon. The passenger had been reported as being disruptive on the flight.

"Officers attended and escorted the passenger from the plane. No formal complaints were made against her and she was not arrested."

An easyJet spokeswoman said: "easyJet can confirm that police met flight EZY2232 from Bodrum to London Luton today due to the behaviour of a passenger onboard."

## trouble in the air

Famously discovered by Storm model agency founder Sarah Doukas aged 14 at JFK airport, her early ascent to global fame saw her starring in Calvin Klein ads.

She has graced thousands of covers and walked down countless

catwalks since a photoshoot in style magazine The Face made her a star.

Moss is not the first supermodel accused of causing trouble in the air.

In 2008, Naomi Campbell was banned from flying with British Airways following a row about lost baggage.

The supermodel, who was caught in the chaos at Heathrow's Terminal 5, held up a flight for almost an hour as it waited to take off for Los Angeles.

She later kicked and spat at police officers as they removed her from the aircraft, accusing them of targeting her because she was black.

Campbell, 38, later admitted two counts of assaulting an officer, disorderly conduct and using threatening words or behaviour.

## Dubious honor: London tops in cocaine sewage

**Scientists say London has the highest concentration of cocaine in sewage of anywhere surveyed in Europe.**

The data from the European Union's drug monitoring body found the capital slightly ahead of Amsterdam.

While London comes top for cocaine flushed down the toilet, Amsterdam's drains contain greater amounts of cannabis.

The European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction data comes from sampling in more than 50 cities.

### weekend peaks

The results, which take into account the size of each city's population, show that on average, drug users in London relieved themselves of 737mg of cocaine per 1,000 people during the week in

2014.

The amount of cocaine in London's waste water peaks on a Friday and Saturday, but then begins to fall away dramatically on Sunday and into Monday.

The amount of cocaine found in both Antwerp and Amsterdam continues to rise into Sunday, potentially suggesting that the drug's peak consumption in these cities comes or continues later into the weekend than in the UK. A detailed analysis of weekend waste water shows that Amsterdam ranks higher than London over Saturday and Sunday alone.

### highest rate

Scientists around the world have been increasingly monitoring waste water in cities so they can draw a more accurate picture of drug

consumption over the year.

The figures for London tally with the monitoring agency's wider research which indicates that the UK has the highest rate of cocaine use among young adults in Europe. It said that around 4% of people aged between 15 and 34 had said they had taken the drug in the 12 months leading up to the 2013/14 report. While there are fluctuations from year to year, most studies indicate that most drug use is in decline.

The scientists tested for five different drugs and found that Amsterdam came top of the league table for both ecstasy and cannabis. Oslo in Norway and Dresden in Germany had by far the highest amounts of methamphetamine in sewage - while London had no trace at all.



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## New Scottish bill clears first stage

The bill which proposes further powers for Scotland has passed its first parliamentary hurdle without a vote.

The Scotland Bill was given its second reading in the Commons on Monday with no need for a division.

The proposals now move on to the committee stage, when MPs will be able to propose and debate amendments.

The bill follows the recommendations of the Smith Commission, which was set up after the independence referendum.

It would give Holyrood control over income tax rates and bands, a half share in VAT revenues and a greater say over welfare powers in Scotland.

The Secretary of State for Scotland, David Mundell, opened the debate by reiterating the UK government's commitment to deliver its promise of further devolution.

Mr Mundell said that if MPs voted for the bill at the second reading it would be subjected to four days of line-by-line scrutiny at the committee stage.

The Tory MP said he was happy to have his "feet held to the fire" because he was confident it delivered the Smith Commission recommendations in full.

But the SNP, which has 56 of Scotland's 59 MPs, is calling for further powers over employment laws, the minimum wage and business taxes to also be devolved.

The party's Westminster leader Angus Robertson told MPs: "There is no doubt that the bill before us does not match the pledge of the campaign or the spirit or letter of the Smith deal."

# The sad decline of Arsenal and England stalwart Kenny Sansom

■ Former footballer, 56, has resorted to sleeping in South London parks

**Former England football star Kenny Sansom has revealed he wants to kill himself as he battles alcoholism and homelessness.**

The 56-year-old has resorted to sleeping in a park and asking friends for 'tablets' in a desperate plea to end his life after losing his house and belongings.

It comes weeks after the former Arsenal defender spent the night in police cells following a drunken row with his girlfriend.

While Mr Sansom's battle with alcoholism has been well documented, he says he is now finally ready to accept help after taking to South London streets to sleep rough.

In a candid interview with The Sunday Mirror, the father-of-three tells of how he never recovered from his divorce from his wife of 29 years, Elaine.

'Money, my ex-wife, there's a lot of things I could have done better. It's my fault, all the things I feel sad about, it's my fault.

'I just don't want to be around, I don't want to be living the horrible life that I'm living,' he told the newspaper.

Mr Sansom's battle with alcoholism was described in depth in his 2008 autobiography, To Cap It All... My Story.

The book was dedicated to his former wife Elaine, Mr Sansom's childhood sweetheart. The pair married when he was 20 and had three children

together, Kate, Natalie and Harry, but parted ways when his alcoholism escalated.

By the time of Mr Sansom's autobiography, he was living with his mistress, Denise Mullins.

'I lost my wife, that hurts me a lot. She was beautiful, absolutely beautiful,' he said, speaking of his separation from Elaine.

Following their split, he moved in with Ms Mullins whom he met on a holiday to Marbella.

But after failing to overcome his demons he was thrown out and began relying on relatives for places to sleep.

At the height of his career in the mid-1980s, Mr Sansom was earning £1,200 a week and lived in a £1million mansion.

He was England's first choice left-back, winning 86 caps between 1979 and 1988, and made over

300 appearances for Arsenal.

Having grown up in South London as one of six, Sansom was tee-total until his 21st birthday when he was coaxed into drinking by his father.

Despite ending the night vomiting in a nightclub toilet, he previously told of enjoying being drunk and began drinking regularly.

Throughout the Eighties he often showed up at practice having been drinking. Eventually Elaine begged the then Arsenal manager, George Graham, for help - a request reportedly ignored.

After being dropped by the club aged 29 he descended into alcoholism and soon alienated his three children and five grandchildren, said relatives in a previous interview.

Today he is without almost all of his England caps after selling them to fund his alcoholism and typically starts his days by downing a bottle of rosé wine.

He then visits a bookmakers to blow his £622 monthly Professional Footballers Association (PFA) pension on betting before guzzling bottles of the cold medicine Night Nurse so that he can fall asleep, he said.

While the footballer has been treated at rehabilitation centres in the past, he said seeing photographs of himself lying passed out in the park has prompted him to finally accept the help he desperately needs.

'I do need help, I know I do. I hope this wake-up call will save my life.'

Mr Sansom is due to check in to a treatment centre with the help of the PFA and the Sporting Chance clinic this week.

# e-cigs banned in Wales

■ Health experts remain divided over new device

**People will be banned from using e-cigarettes in enclosed places such as restaurants, pubs and at work in Wales, under a new public health law.**

The plan, likely to come into force in 2017, has already divided opinion among health and medical groups, including some anti-smoking campaigners.

But ministers say it is a "balance of risk" and will stop children smoking.

All tattoo and piercing parlours will also need licences under the Public Health Bill.

The new tobacco and e-cigarette measures will mean shops will have to join a register for retailers of tobacco and e-cigarettes - aimed at stopping illegal sales to under-18s. It will also be an offence to "hand over" tobacco and e-cigarettes to children - and this will include online sales.

The bill also means a restricted use of e-cigarettes, banning them in enclosed public spaces and workplaces. This will include lorries and taxis.

This final measure is proving the most controversial and is likely to come into force

in 2017, but a precise date has not been given.

Public Health Wales, local health boards and the BMA are in favour of the e-cigarettes curbs.

But anti-smoking campaign group ASH Wales, Cancer Research UK and Tenovus are among those opposed and the British Heart Foundation, British Lung Foundation and Royal College of Physicians want more evidence.

In a public consultation on the proposals last year, 79% of responses were opposed.

There have been concerns that it might make it more difficult for smokers using e-cigarettes as a way of stopping.

George Butterworth, tobacco policy manager for Cancer Research UK, said there was no evidence of normalisation of e-cigarettes with young people - and those using them were "very, very small numbers".

"Those that are, are the type of people who would try alcohol or tobacco cigarettes anyway - so without that evidence we wouldn't support a ban on the use of e-cigarettes indoors

under the idea of normalisation," he said.

"E-cigarettes are an opportunity for people to move away from tobacco smoking which is very, very bad for their health, and we wouldn't want to put up any barriers to prevent people from quitting cigarettes."

Officials acknowledge there is divided opinion but believe the evidence is now growing to support a ban. Although the numbers of children using e-cigarettes are low, ministers do not want to take the risk of children seeing smoking "normalised" again after the success in banning smoking.

There are similar e-cigarette restrictions in countries like Belgium, Spain and Malta, with proposals in France and Ireland. But this would be a first for the UK.

The BMA says it is "vital" that e-cigarettes do not undermine tobacco control and they are particularly worried that the way they are marketed is making them attractive to children.

It also says more research is needed to find out whether e-cigarettes actually help smokers to quit.

## Energy line wipes 80% off Scottish estate's asking price

**A billionaire could see £12 million wiped off the value of his 547-acre Scottish country pile after losing a battle with an energy company to stop pylons being built across the estate.**

Brendan Clouston, a Canadian telecoms tycoon who is a close friend of Bill Gates, put his Eilean Aigas estate on the market in 2012 with an asking price of £15 million.

Three years later, the Inverness-shire property is due to go on auction in September for a price in excess of £3 million if it is not sold before.

It is thought that part of the reason behind the

colossal drop in value of the four-storey mansion is the construction of the controversial Beaulieu to Denny power line, which runs through the wooded estate.

Mr Clouston, who is now based in the Channel Islands, had been a fervent critic of Scottish and Southern Energy's power line.

He helped finance the local campaign group Pylon Pressure and gave evidence at the public inquiry into SSE's plans.

Mr Clouston admitted that the construction of "super pylons" on his secluded island estate were partly responsible for his decision to put his property on the

market in 2012.

SSE bought a strip of land near the estate under a compulsory purchase order so it could widen a road for traffic working on the line.

Steve Byford, the chairman of the local community council of Kilmorack, said of Mr Clouston: "He spent a lot of money on lawyers to fight the proposals.

"He was passionate about the estate. If push came to shove and the line had to go through his estate, he wanted to pay for the line to go underground. But all his objections fell on deaf ears. It was a sad case for Mr Clouston and his estate."

## Star's son sought after smashing four-star hotel room in Crawley

**BRITISH police were on the trail of the troubled son of Hollywood actor Tom Hanks this week after the 24-year-old's hotel room was trashed.**

Detectives were called in after damage totalling £1,200 was found at the four-star Arora Hotel near Gatwick Airport in West Sussex.

A TV set was torn off the wall after Chet Hanks had taken three girls back to the room for a drinking session.

Hanks, an actor and would-be rapper who has battled drug addiction, was on holiday and had been a guest at a club near the hotel.

A source said: "He was pretty obnoxious once he started drinking at the club. He kept saying 'do you know who I am?'"

"Nobody was impressed and that was clearly annoying him. Nobody recognised him. He then went back to the

hotel with a British actor friend and three female promoters. He was sick in the car park and then went up to the room and got really loud. Next morning he was gone but the room was trashed."

Sussex Police said: "A guest has caused an estimated £1,200 of damage to a hotel room. We are working with other agencies to try to trace him so he can be interviewed."

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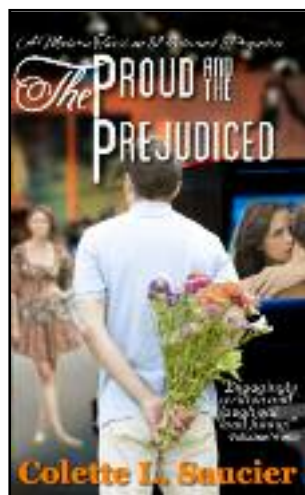
# Proud and Prejudiced: taking on the classic

■ Exclusive interview with author Colette L. Saucier and a review of her modernization of the Austen classic

"I always threatened to burn it," says *The Proud and the Prejudiced* author Colette L. Saucier. "The history of this novel begins with the book-within-the-book *The Edge of Darkness*. I had written that novella a lifetime ago...inspired by too many soap operas and too many Sidney Sheldon books. My daughter had read it when she was a teenager and for some reason loved it. After I found a publisher for my first novel [*Pulse and Prejudice*], she pulled this out from where she had hidden it from me."

We meet Alice



McGillicutty, head writer of the TV soap opera *All My Tomorrows*. She's having a tough year. Her mother passed away and she broke up with her boyfriend. The show she writes for is tanking in the ratings. The network has pressured star Peter Walsingham to join *Tomorrows* to raise the ratings. Peter arrives on the set with an entourage, including his manager and his actress girlfriend. Alice

is reading an old book she found in her mother's things. The book is old-fashioned, full of drama, angst and romance. Alice's own life starts to mirror the plot of the book.

A pleasant read for summer. *Pride and Prejudice* fans will recognize some of the dialog. The story moves between Alice and Peter's story and *The Edge of Darkness*, a novella written in first person. More back story could have helped to understand Alice and Peter better, why they do what they do. As Alice is a writer, it could have been more fun to have her writing the novella that mirrors her life instead of merely reading it.

Saucier says she did little research for this book, coming on the heels of her previous Austen-inspired novel. "After spending 18 months researching *Pulse and Prejudice*, not having to

do much research came as a welcome relief," says Saucier. "The New Orleans scenes I had researched over the years from all my visits to the French Quarter."

"Since I had just written an adaptation of *Pride and Prejudice* and had read Miss Austen's novel about ten times by then, it felt natural to write a modern take on the classic love story," says Saucier. "Although I begin with a detailed outline of the plot and the characters, once I begin writing, I devote much of my writing time to meditating to get into the head of the character."

In addition to *Pulse and Prejudice*, Saucier wrote the romantic psychological thriller *Alicia's Possession* and other works under a different pen name. In addition to the Amazon Breakthrough Novel Awards, the abridged version of *The Proud and the*

*Prejudiced* was named Favorite Modern Adaptation of the Year by Austenesque Reviews. Austenprose has named Saucier as Debut Author of the Year. *Pulse and Prejudice* won the Chatelaine Award for First Place in its Category for Romantic Fiction and the Readers' Choice for Best Novel of the Year by Austenprose. *Alicia's Possession* was voted a Top 10 Romance Novel of the Year in the P&E Readers' Poll. *The Proud and the Prejudiced* has yet to be optioned for television or film.

Saucier's next novel is the romantic suspense thriller *The Widow Viuda*. She is currently writing *Dearest Bloodiest Elizabeth*, the sequel to *Pulse and Prejudice*. The newlywed vampire Darcy and his bride Elizabeth move to antebellum New Orleans. "Because it is not an adaptation, I am not

restrained by anyone else's plot; so it will be much darker, bloodier, and sexier," says Saucier.

Saucier will be at Authors After Dark in Atlanta in August. She lives in southeast Louisiana in a small lake community outside of New Orleans.

# Toughen up, Raheem!

## ■ Harsh words from Hodgson after dull display in Dublin

England manager Roy Hodgson has told under-fire striker Raheem Sterling he needs to toughen up if he is going to forge an international career.

The unsettled Liverpool striker was booed almost continuously by the home crowd during a dull goalless draw for the England team against Ireland in Dublin over the weekend.

Sterling's evident desperation to leave Liverpool over the summer has angered the club's large contingent of Irish fans, who made their displeasure evident during an otherwise uneventful 90 minutes at the Aviva Stadium. Sterling was eventually substituted to even louder jeers as Hodgson tore into his players and the performance after

admitting England fell well below their standards.

"I think he (Sterling) is going through a bad time publicly," said Hodgson. "You can't expect people just to shrug off the criticism he has been receiving, not least from the local media in Liverpool. That becomes national pretty quickly.

"He does ever so well and tries well to shrug it off, let his football do the talking. He needed this game to realise that, if he is going to get it out of his system, he's going to have work harder still and get a thicker skin than he has at the moment. We only took him off today to give others the game."

But Hodgson insisted he will stick by below-par Sterling even for next weekend's Euro 2016 qualifier in Slovenia.

"No, I have no reservations about him," said Hodgson. "I trust

Sterling. But players are not robots. He's done some fantastic things for us, but today he didn't hit those heights. It'll take a lot before I and the English national team sway from Raheem Sterling."

England struggled to get going in Dublin as they laboured to a goalless draw which left Hodgson disappointed and highly critical of some of his players.

He added: "We set ourselves high standards and got nowhere near them in the first half. Marginally better in the second half, but we were very critical of ourselves.

"The positives for me are harder to find than they would have been for Martin O'Neill. Two obvious positives were the spirit in which the game was played: competitive, both teams trying to win, and the

atmosphere in the stadium and the behaviour of the fans was a remarkable positive.

"We've had a good run, a year almost unbeaten, but we came here believing if we played our best football we could win the game. But we never got close to that. We didn't lose, but we have to accept – myself and the players – there were a lot of things we could have done better."

in your own bed and having your friends and family around."

Murray's disappointment at not reaching his first French Open final was tempered by the knowledge that he had enjoyed the best clay-court season of his life – this was his only defeat in 16 matches on the surface this year – and had pushed Djokovic harder than any other player in Grand Slam or Masters Series tournaments this year.

The Scot takes encouragement from his performances against the world No 1 in both the Australian Open final, where he was up a break in the third set having levelled the match at one set apiece, and in Paris, where he fought back from two sets down.

"I needed to start the match better here, but overall I don't think I'm too far away," Murray said when asked about his rivalry with Djokovic. "Australia is his best

surface, his best tournament. He loves the conditions there.

"He's also been much better than me over the years on clay courts. On grass we've only played a couple of times and I've played well against him. I prefer the conditions at the US Open and Wimbledon, so hopefully I can close the gap a bit more."

Djokovic was on the other side of the net when Murray won both his Grand Slam titles, at the US Open in 2012 and Wimbledon in 2013. And Murray said he would look forward to meeting him again at the All England Club, even though he has now lost to the Serb eight times in a row.

"It would mean that I would be in the semi-finals or the final, so I would obviously always sign up for that," Murray said. "I know how difficult it is to go far in these events on a regular basis. Any time you get to play him or Roger [Federer] or Rafa [Nadal] it's great, a great learning experience. You can always improve."

## Yet another record for Wiggo

**Sir Bradley Wiggins has broken the iconic cycling hour record by completing a distance of 33.88 miles.**

The 35-year-old smashed the previous mark, held by fellow Briton Alex Dowsett, of 32.89 miles that had been set in May.

Roared on by a capacity crowd at Lee Valley VeloPark in London, Wiggins became the sixth rider to claim a Tour de France title and the hour record.

"I'm just glad it's done," he said. "It was torturous."

Wiggins, who becomes

the fifth person in the past nine months to break the record, joked: "That's the closest I have ever come to what it's like to have a baby."

Wiggins, a multiple Olympic and world champion on track and road, surpassed Dowsett's record of 212 laps, set in Manchester, with 1min 42secs to spare and eventually completed 218 laps.

But the 2012 Tour de France winner fell short of the target he had set himself of 55.250km, or 221 laps.

"You're constantly looking at the clock

counting down," he said. "When you're out there, you never think it's coming to an end."

Wiggins joins five other riders, among them Eddy Merckx and Miguel Indurain, to have won the Tour de France and broken the hour record.

"I always compare myself to the greats and I am just glad to be in the company of those guys," said Wiggins.

"To get up there and do that, to put yourself on the line, takes a lot of courage and it's a mental game as much as anything."

Former British cycling

performance director Dave Brailsford said it was "an honour" to witness the occasion.

"Bradley rode well on what was a heavy and hard day," he said.

"I'm so pleased for him. It's his day and he is such a magnificent athlete."

Since the UCI, cycling's world governing body, unified the regulations surrounding the event last year, four riders have held the record: Germany's Jens Voigt, Matthias Brandle of Switzerland, Australian Rohan Dennis and Dowsett.

# United richest club yet again

Manchester United is the world's most valuable football brand, replacing Bayern Munich, according to a report from consultancy Brand Finance.

Despite winning no trophies again last season the Old Trafford club's brand is estimated to be worth \$1.2bn (£789m).

Six of the top ten most valuable club brands were English.

Barcelona, who won the Champion's League Final on Saturday, slipped two places from last year, to sixth most valuable club, worth \$773m.

"Even if recent reports of fan losses are to be believed, United retains legions of followers in India, South East Asia and China, contributing to a total of over half a billion individuals and the news certainly does not appear to have deterred sponsors," said the report's authors.

They point to the club's lucrative shirt sponsorship deal with Chevrolet and "record breaking" kit supply deal with Adidas.

They added that "the huge windfalls that [Man Utd] can expect, will see both revenues and brand value

continue to increase in the coming years".

The also say that the club's brand value has increased by 63% since 2014.

"The most critical success factor in the Manchester United brand's renewed financial potency has been this year's record-breaking, £5.1bn deal for the UK broadcast rights of the Premier League."

Bayern slipped to second in the football brand table, with Real Madrid third, and Paris Saint-Germain in ninth. There were no Italian clubs in the top ten.

## Ings seals Reds switch



Liverpool have confirmed the signing of Burnley striker Danny Ings.

The England Under-21 international (above) is out of contract at Turf Moor and will join the Anfield club on 1 July

subject to a medical.

The Clarets are entitled to compensation for Ings but the clubs have not yet agreed a transfer fee.

Ings, 22, scored 11 goals in the Premier League this season but

could not prevent the club from being relegated.

He becomes the second summer signing at Anfield after James Milner joined from Manchester City last week.



## Beaten Murray looks to home comforts

ANDY MURRAY may have come up short against Novak Djokovic – yet again – in an epic French Open semi-final last week, but the Scotsman believes he is closing in on the world number one and that having home advantage could make the difference in his quest for a second Wimbledon title.

Murray's grass-court season follows six months

on the road. The 28-year-old has barely paused for breath since leaving for his winter training camp in Miami in December.

"I've hardly spent any time at home this year," Murray said in the wake of his heart-stopping 6-3, 6-3, 5-7, 5-7, 6-1 defeat at the Roland Garros.

"The first few months of this year has probably been the least amount of

time I've spent at home for six or seven years. I played quite a bit after Australia, with the Davis Cup and then Rotterdam and Dubai.

I've hardly been in my own bed more than seven or eight days this year, so it's going to be nice to be home for a long stretch. All the British players love it. It's nice being in front of a home crowd and staying
