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A very long reign...

63 years and 219 days on the throne for Her Majesty...and she's still going strong

The Queen has thanked well-wishers at home and overseas for their "touching messages of kindness" as she became Britain's longest-reigning monarch.

Speaking in the Scottish Borders, the 89-year-old monarch said the title was "not one to which I have ever aspired".

At 17:30 BST on Wednesday she had reigned for 23,226 days, 16 hours and approximately 30 minutes - surpassing the reign of her great-great-grandmother Queen Victoria.

'long life'

David Cameron said the service the Queen had given was "truly humbling".

Dressed in turquoise with her trusty black handbag at her side, the Queen spoke briefly to the gathered crowds earlier.

"Inevitably a long life can pass by many milestones - my own is no exception - but I thank you all and the many others at home and overseas for your touching messages of great kindness," she

said.

In an otherwise low-key day, the Queen and Prince Philip travelled by steam train from Edinburgh to Tweedbank, where she formally opened the new £294m Scottish Borders Railway.

They were accompanied by Scotland's First Minister Nicola Sturgeon, who praised the Queen's "dedication, wisdom and exemplary sense of public service"

In London, a flotilla of historic vessels, leisure cruisers and passenger boats took part in a procession along the Thames and HMS Belfast sounded a four-gun salute.

pay tribute

The exact moment the Queen became the longest-reigning sovereign is unknown. Her father, George VI, passed away in the early hours of 6 February 1952, but his time of

death is not known. Business in the Commons was postponed for half an hour so that MPs, led by Mr Cameron, could pay tribute to the Queen.

The prime minister said she had been a "rock of stability" in an era when so much had changed, and her reign had been the "golden thread running through

three post-war generations".

He said it was "typical of the Queen's selfless sense of service" that she thought today should be a normal day.

summer break

Acting Labour leader Harriet Harman said it was "no exaggeration" to say the Queen was "admired by billions of

people all around the world".

In the House of Lords, leader Baroness Stowell said the Queen had served the country with "unerring grace, dignity and decency", adding: "And long may she continue to do so".

Buckingham Palace has released two official photographs to mark the occasion, taken by Mary

McCartney in the Queen's private audience room.

This is where she holds weekly audiences with prime ministers of the day, and receives visiting heads of state and government.

The Queen is taking her traditional summer break at this time of year at her private Scottish home, Balmoral.

Shadow ministers ready 'to desert Corbyn' if he's elected Labour leader

UP to eight members of the shadow cabinet could refuse to serve on the front bench if Jeremy Corbyn is elected Labour leader, it has emerged.

Shadow chancellor Chris Leslie said he could not work with the veteran socialist if he wins on Saturday.

Mr Leslie said: "I do not feel I could serve in his shadow cabinet. I don't believe he shares my instincts about responsibility in the economy, social issues or foreign affairs."

rival

Shadow home secretary Yvette Cooper and shadow education secretary Tristram Hunt also said they will not serve.

Ms Cooper, Mr Corbyn's biggest rival for leadership, is scathing about his anti-austerity politics.

It is understood Mr Corbyn will make a desperate appeal for party unity if elected.

Other possible refusniks are shadow business secretary Chuka Umunna, shadow Northern Ireland secretary Ivan Lewis, shadow international developme

nt secretary Mary Creagh, shadow Europe minister Pat McFadden and shadow Treasury chief secretary Shabana Mahmood.

back benches

In other news from Westminster, stand-in leader Harriet Harman bowed out from frontline politics on Thursday after three decades.

The MP for Camberwell and Peckham will return to the back benches.

She said it had been "an honour and privilege" to lead the party - but was glad to be handing over the baton this weekend.

Ms Harman, speaking to the BBC after Prime Minister's Questions, made a thinly veiled dig at Mr Corbyn.

privileged upbringing

Asked if she wished she had thrown her hat in the ring to succeed Ed Miliband, she said she did not want the top job but added: "I'm not old enough or posh enough to be a frontrunner."

Mr Corbyn, 66, is a year older than Ms Harman and also had a privileged upbringing.

Ulster turmoil as First Minister quits

THE future of Northern Ireland's devolved government was thrown into doubt this week after the country's First Minister, Peter Robinson, announced he was to step down.

His resignation, which will be followed by the majority of his Democratic Unionist ministers, comes amid a crisis in the wake of an IRA-linked murder.

Mr Robinson had warned that his ministers would step aside if the Stormont Assembly was not adjourned following a vote by its members or, failing that, if the British Government did not step in and suspend its work.

ultimatum

The DUP wanted all business brought to a halt to allow crunch talks over the political consequences of the murder of Kevin McGuigan.

Sinn Fein, the SDLP and the Ulster Unionists voted against the proposal.

The resignations will not bring an immediate collapse of the Assembly institutions, but the developments leave power sharing at Stormont hanging by a thread.

Party colleague Arlene Foster is to take over as acting First Minister.

Mr Robinson issued the ultimatum on Wednesday following the arrest of three leading republicans, including Sinn Fein's northern chairman Bobby Storey, over the fatal shooting of former IRA man Mr McGuigan.

All three men remain in custody.

revenge attack

Police have said current members of the IRA were involved in last month's shooting of Mr McGuigan in a suspected revenge attack for the murder of former IRA commander Gerard "Jock" Davison

in Belfast three months earlier.

Announcing his departure, Mr Robinson said: "In light of the decision by republicans, nationalists and the UUP to continue with business as usual in the Assembly, I am therefore standing aside as First Minister and other DUP ministers will resign with immediate effect with the exception of Arlene Foster.

'gravely concerned'

"I have asked Arlene to remain in post as Finance Minister and acting First Minister to ensure that nationalists and republicans are not able to take financial and other decisions that

may be detrimental to Northern Ireland."

Prime Minister David Cameron is said to be "gravely concerned" about the situation and a Downing Street spokeswoman said he was phoning Mr Robinson and Northern Ireland Secretary Theresa Villiers to discuss the situation.

Mr Cameron's official spokeswoman added: "We want to see all politicians in Northern Ireland working together to build a better future for the country and working to fulfil its great potential.

"We have been encouraging talks between the parties so they can work through their issues."



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MOVE OVER, Stonehenge, scientists have found "Superhenge".

An even more massive stone monument has lain hidden for thousands of years just a short walk away from the famous prehistoric site in Wiltshire.

The newly discovered remains are at a site called Durrington Walls, already well known to archaeologists. Here, a bank and inner ditch were built around a natural depression, creating a horseshoe-shaped structure about half a kilometre wide. It resembles an arena, and some think that is exactly what it was.

Now the mystery has deepened: remote sensing surveys have revealed that around 4500 years ago giant stones were arranged along the ground where the bank now is. Around 30 stones up to 4.5 metres (14.7 feet) long are buried there, and the surveys suggest there were at least 90 originally.

It appears the stones were deliberately toppled and buried when the bank was built around Durrington Walls, for reasons that are unclear. There are no plans as yet to excavate the stones.



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British jihadist killed after plot to kill the Queen

■ RAF drone used in attack PM describes as a "new departure" in terrorism fight

A British jihadist has been killed by UK forces in Syria after he directed a plot to kill the Queen, it emerged on Monday night.

In a move David Cameron said was "a new departure" for Britain, Reyaad Khan was last month assassinated in an RAF drone strike after security services uncovered his bid to stage a terror attack in the UK.

The Prime Minister said that it is the first time UK forces have directed a targeted attack against one of its own citizens when Britain is not at war.

targets for UK forces

It also marks the first British military action in Syria and Mr Cameron made clear that UK forces are now prepared to carry out more strikes in Syria, Iraq and Libya against specific targets.

Downing Street denied the existence of a "kill list" of terrorists.

However, it has been made clear by Whitehall sources that British-born Isil fighters including Jihadi John, the terrorist responsible for executing westerners in Syria, are targets for UK forces.

The Prime Minister authorised the strike without the approval of Parliament but said that it did not require a vote because it was an act of "self-defence" for which there was a "clear legal basis".

But the Prime minister has said that he believes action needs to be taken in Syria to prevent the

further escalation of the crisis.

Announcing the strikes, Mr Cameron said: "My first duty as Prime Minister is to keep the British people safe. That is what I will always do.

"There was a terrorist directing murder on our streets and no other means to stop them. This Government does not for one moment take these decisions lightly.

"But I am not prepared to stand here in the aftermath of a terrorist attack on our streets and have to explain why I did not take the chance to prevent it when I could have done."

Two other Isis fighters were killed in the attack on the Syrian city of Raqqa on 21 August. One of them, Ruhul Amin, 26, was also British, Mr Cameron said.

VJ Day plot

The Prime Minister said that a third Briton, Junaid Hussain, 21, was killed by a separate US airstrike.

Khan, 21, was targeted after it emerged he was leading a plot to attack the VJ Day commemoration services in London in August, government sources said.

The Prince of Wales, the Duchess of Cornwall and the Prime Minister were also at the event in central London.

Michael Fallon, the Defence Secretary, gave the go-ahead for the assassination at a meeting of the NSC on the Prime Minister's behalf, Downing Street said.

Defence sources said that British spy planes were used to locate Khan before the fatal drone attack was authorised.

A Rivet Joint plane packed with sensitive electronic eavesdropping intelligence equipment has been flying over Syria from Cyprus since October.

GCHQ's main effort this summer has been to sift and analyse traffic from Raqqa, the headquarters of Isil, and Khan's position is understood to have been given away after his communications were intercepted.

Mr Cameron said that both Khan and Hussain had been plotting "to

attack high profile public commemorations, including those taking place this summer".

Other ceremonies thought to have been threatened by the jihadists include the VE Day commemorations the day after the general election in May as well as Armed Forces Day in June.

"We should be under no illusion," Mr Cameron said. "Their intention was the murder of British citizens.

"So on this occasion we ourselves took action."

approval

Khan, from Cardiff, was a straight A-student who became radicalised

and fled to Syria where he joined Isis and regularly took to Twitter to boast of executing prisoners.

Mr Cameron faced anger from MPs who criticised him for not putting the air strikes in Syria to a vote in Parliament.

The Prime Minister has repeatedly said he would seek the approval of MPs before authorising any military action in Syria.

However, he has made clear that he is prepared to authorise strikes without Parliamentary approval if Britain is under threat.

Mr Cameron said: "If there is a direct threat to the British people and we are able to stop it by taking immediate action then as Prime Minister I will always be prepared to take that action and that's the case whether the threat is emanating from Libya, Syria or from anywhere else."

Harriet Harman, Labour's interim leader, called for "independent scrutiny" of the attack and called on the Government to publish its legal advice.

Jonathan King latest to be arrested on sex offence charges

The former music industry figure Jonathan King has been arrested on suspicion of historical child sex offences, according to reports from London.

Mr King, 70, was arrested at his home in Bayswater, west London, by Surrey Police officers on Wednesday morning.

Two other men, aged 77 and 86, both from Walton-on-Thames, were also arrested. All three were later bailed.

The arrests were made in connection with allegations linked to the Walton Hop Disco in

Walton-on-Thames.

An ongoing investigation, titled Operation Ravine, is looking into allegations of sexual offences against children connected with the disco in the 1970s and 1980s.

Surrey Police said specialist police officers were searching the men's properties.

All three men were arrested on suspicion of various sexual offences concerning boys under the age of 16, Surrey Police said.

Det Ch Insp Karen Mizzi said: "This is a

complex investigation into numerous allegations of sexual abuse and assault dating back over several decades.

"Our investigation focuses on the Walton Hop Disco, a popular event for youngsters between the 1970s and 1980s, and we are following a number of lines of inquiry."

Mr King is a former chart-topping star and TV producer who worked on BBC shows such as No Limits and The Great British Song Contest.

His lengthy career in music encompassed

performing, song-writing, TV presenting and as an industry executive.

He reached number four in the UK charts for his 1965 single Everyone's Gone to the

Moon, and also worked with bands such as Genesis and the Bay City Rollers.

I'm no hero but I'm finished flying, says BA pilot who saved 170 on burning jet

A British Airways pilot hailed as a hero after his aircraft caught fire at Las Vegas, has played down his part in the drama.

Chris Henkey, who was on his penultimate flight before retiring, insisted he wasn't the only one who helped save those on the Boeing 777-200, saying: "It's not

just me. It's the whole crew, really."

The 63-year-old, praised for his calm instructions which enabled all 170 people on board to escape, said he had never been involved in such an incident before. "Not at all," he said. "It's ironic, really. Nothing like it at all." But the veteran

pilot, who was due to make a final flight to Barbados to join his daughter in their favourite holiday destination, added: "It's safe to say I'm finished flying."

flames

Mr Henkey, from near Reading, was reluctant to talk in detail about

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the incident on the runway at during take-off for London Gatwick from McCarran International airport. As the plane burst into flames he slammed on the brakes and steered the aircraft to safety, allowing the 157 passengers, 10 crew and the three pilots to escape using emergency slides. He was cheered by passengers as they returned to the terminal and recordings of his exchanges with the control tower during the incident showed how calmly he dealt with it. His family and friends have described him as a hero, who was always calm under pressure. His fiancée Lenka Nevolna, 40, said: "He's a great man with a warm heart and

generosity and I'm very proud of him."

Terrified passengers described a "mad dash" to escape the burning aircraft as the blaze took hold on Tuesday.

'scary day'

Another passenger Jay Jennings, from Southampton, said the experience was "pretty scary".

He told CNN the plane was preparing for take-off when he heard a big thud. When he lifted the window blind he claims he saw "flames on the engine".

Dominic Worthington, from London, was also on the flight. He wrote on Twitter: "Scary day, captain and crew saved our lives today".

Lampreys return to UK waters

A TYPE of prehistoric metre-long vampire fish is returning to UK rivers for the first time since the 1800s.

The alien-like fanged lamprey - which has a circular disc of razor sharp teeth instead of jaws - has been found in waterways in Yorkshire. The largest of the UK lamprey species - the sea lamprey - can grow up to one metre in length. Once a common sight in our waterways, river and sea lampreys are now endangered across Europe.

The pollution caused by the Industrial Revolution, along with the construction of mill weirs that blocked their migration, had a devastating effect on their numbers.

The Environment Agency said lampreys are slowly returning to their old habitats, thanks to the lowest levels of pollution for more than 100 years and the Agency's work to remove some river structures like weirs. Where barriers cannot be removed a range of innovative techniques are being trialled, including the fitting of lamprey 'tiles', to help them navigate back to their old spawning grounds.

Environment Agency fisheries expert Simon Toms said: "For the last 200 hundred years, some rivers have not been capable of supporting lamprey species as a result of water quality, poor habitat and manmade barriers.

"Now that water quality has improved and some of these barriers have been removed we are seeing lampreys return to the upper reaches of rivers such as the Ouse, Trent, and Derwent, where they were absent as recently as 30 years ago.

Happy ending for baby-swap expat

■ Couple made plea for return of newborn baby after DNA tests showed they'd taken home the wrong one

A BRITISH expat and his wife who claimed their baby was swapped at birth and sold to traffickers in El Salvador have said they are 'absolutely thrilled' to be reunited with their lost son three months after he was taken.

Brit Richard Cushworth from Texas and wife Mercedes 'Mercy' Casanellas had made a public plea for their baby's return after DNA tests showed the child they cared for since birth was not theirs.

reunited

Mr Cushworth's father David told reporters of the family's joy, but that their thoughts are with the other family, who had no idea they were raising the wrong child.

David Cushworth, who accompanied the couple as the two children were swapped and reunited with their biological parents, said: 'We're all absolutely thrilled. This is an

answer to so many prayers.

The Cushworths had chosen the Centro Ginecologico, a private hospital in the capital of San Salvador for Mercedes to give birth and were initially delighted at a smooth and incident-free delivery.

dark skinned

But their suspicions were aroused when they were sent home with their baby a few days later, as the child was far more dark skinned and with different features to the one they had delivered.

The hospital initially dismissed their concerns that they could have been the victims of simple human error in the nursery, prompting them to have the baby's DNA tested - which proved the child could not be theirs. The devastated couple then accused Dr Alejandro Guidos, a gynaecologist at the prestigious, of masterminding a plot

with other hospital staff to switch their light-skinned baby and sell him to human traffickers.

After a police investigation their baby was quickly located at home with another couple who delivered at the same time as the Cushworths. The family was reunited in a child exchange which took place before a judge in a sixth floor office at the Prosecutor General's in Santa Elena, a suburb of San Salvador.

gagging order

'All the circumstantial evidence pointed to a criminal act, but the official story we are being told appears to show it was a mistake, a mix-up,' said David Cushworth.

'I can't say for sure what really happened. We'll have to see how it works out through the legal system before can be certain.

'I feel for the other family. We know nothing about them,

except that they only just found out today that their baby isn't really theirs. It must have been devastating.

'At least we suspected there was something wrong. It seems like they had no idea. Or if they suspected something, they didn't want to say.'

Mr Cushworth Snr, a former police officer from Bradford, West Yorkshire, said the family have been forced to sign a gagging order, and he would not comment on whether the family still thought the doctor was involved in the child swap.

'We're just happy it's

resolved,' he said.

Dr Guidos was freed by authorities on Monday evening, but it is understood that he is still under investigation.

Speaking to reporters, Dr Guidos said: 'I'm perfectly calm. I have nothing to prove. I am innocent.'

'The tests proved that and we move on.'

He also attacked both the Cushworths and the Centro Ginecologico hospital, adding: 'A public apology will not be enough.'

'The doctors have humiliated me. They judged me and condemned me before time.'

Rescues soar as walkers ditch maps for mobiles

WALKERS who cannot use a paper map and compass, relying instead on phones and GPS, are being blamed for a steep rise in mountain rescue call-outs.

Coniston Mountain Rescue Team in the Lake District has sprung into action 44 times this year - more than during the whole of 2014.

unprepared walkers

The organisation's Jeff Carroll said an "over-reliance" on high-tech navigation aides had been a major issue.



Mobile phone apps and GPS are no substitute for a traditional map and compass, say experts

He urged tourists, walkers and cyclists who explore the beauty spot's many trails to carry a simple compass and Ordnance Survey paper map.

Mr Carroll blamed people using GPS and

maps on their phones for the rise in emergency call-outs, saying these are "only ever really any good when the phone has decent signal or battery".

He added: "You speak to some people and they

say, 'Yes, we're well equipped. We've got shorts and a T-shirt'. That's not really well equipped."

Rescues in recent months have included a cyclist who got lost in Grizedale Forest, unprepared walkers in mist on the 2,634ft Old Man of Coniston and a plea to look for a missing dog.

The Mountain Rescue England and Wales website urges walkers to only use mobile phones for making emergency calls - not for map-reading.

It says: "A map and

compass are essential kit and should be easily accessible, not buried in the rucksack."

Safety adviser Heather Morning said electronic devices are no substitute for basic navigation skills: "The issue lies with people. A GPS, smartphone or navigation app is unable to read important subtleties, such as a sensible route choice.

"Unless you have already used your navigational abilities to programme in an exact route it won't direct you away from cliffs or show you the best place to cross a river."

took 20 minutes... and they loved it!"


"I love the song so much," he added.





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
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A Woman of Note: composer's tale is music to our ears...

Exclusive interview with author Carol M. Cram and a review of her new novel about a female composer in 19th century Vienna

Rating: 3 Stars



"A Woman of Note draws upon my love of classical music and the piano," says author Carol M. Cram. "I've been playing the piano since I was five years old. And although I will never be a concert pianist like Isabette in the novel, I get a great deal of pleasure out of my daily practice. My love of music led me naturally to creating a character who plays the piano and composes."

In early nineteenth-century Vienna, Isabette Grüber

captures audiences as a piano virtuoso. But music is a male-dominated profession so Isabette keeps secret her own compositions. Isabette meets the dazzling singer Amelia Mason and the composer Josef Hauser. Music is Isabette's constant through heartbreak and triumph.

A Woman of Note is a fantastic story idea. What if some of the great music we all know was actually written by a woman and we didn't know? The lead

character Isabette has interactions with many famous composers of the day including Chopin, Schubert and Berlioz. Cram's appreciation of music shines through in her descriptions. However, the plot revolves so tightly around Isabette that the supporting characters seem shallow. The book includes book club questions, author's note, list of compositions, acknowledgments and bibliography.

"When I started the novel, I had the idea that few women were composers in the 19th Century," says Cram. "Like most people, I had heard of only a small handful, and presumed that women just didn't compose much. As I dug into my research of music history, I was pleasantly surprised to discover that women played a much

larger role as composers than I had originally thought."

Cram says she researched a great deal about composers of the period and also studied women composers, particularly Fanny Mendelssohn and Clara Schumann.

"Clara's story really helped me to develop Isabette's story," says Cram. "Clara Schumann is probably best known as the wife of Robert Schumann. However, as I discovered in my research Clara was a very important figure in the musical history of the 19th Century in her own right. As a rival of Liszt, she was one of the period's top concert pianists. She was also a composer, a musical editor, and an innovator in addition to being the mother of seven children and the wife of a mentally ill composer who died in

his mid-forties after spending two years in an asylum."

In addition to doing a great deal of reading at the Music Library at the University of British Columbia, Cram traveled to Vienna where much of the novel takes place.

Cram's first published novel was *The Towers of Tuscany* about a woman who's an artist in 14th Century Tuscany. Cram says she was inspired by her husband, Gregg Simpson, a full time painter. *Tuscany* was shortlisted for the Bath Novel Award.

Cram is currently writing her third novel, *Upstaged*. Cram says the genesis for *Upstaged* was a paper she wrote about the Old Price Riots for her Masters of Drama at the University of Toronto in the 1980s.

Cram lives on Bowen Island, a small island that

is twenty minutes by ferry ride from Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. Cram was born in Victoria and grew up in Vancouver. Schooled in Britain, she received a B.A. in English Language & Literature from the University of Reading and a Post Graduate Certificate in Education at the University of Durham.

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

England find winning ways with World Cup on doorstep

England 21- Ireland 13
England will go into their home World Cup in winning fashion after they eased past Ireland at Twickenham at the weekend.

Fine Jonny May and Anthony Watson tries put England 12-3 up before May had a try disallowed for a forward pass.

George Ford took it out to 15-3 but Ireland cut the gap to two points as Paul O'Connell powered over and Johnny Sexton converted and added a penalty.

England looked worried but re-established control and Owen Farrell wrapped up victory with two penalties.

Stuart Lancaster's men start their World Cup campaign back at Twickenham against Fiji on Friday, 18 September, while Ireland face Canada the following day.

Ireland will go into the World Cup on the back of two straight defeats, something England at least avoided following a

dour loss to the French two weeks ago.

England's cutting edge out wide is razor sharp but the current pack is still to convince it can lay the foundations for global domination.

Ireland were outplayed for long periods but can be pleased with their refusal to fold, and in O'Connell they have a warrior to rally around.

Northampton flanker Tom Wood may well have claimed one of the few available places left in Lancaster's starting XV to face Fiji.

It has been a toss up between Wood and Wasps' James Haskell for the number six shirt, and the Saints man could well have the edge after an energetic performance that earned him the man of the match award.

But May can count himself unlucky not to take that accolade, showing his offensive and defensive prowess and almost certainly ensuring he will feature in two weeks' time.

The Gloucester wing

gained 81 metres overall, beat three defenders and made seven tackles - as well as scorching over for one try and being denied another by the referee.

England coach Stuart Lancaster said of the victory: "It's a results-based business and I understand that, but I think this team is ready.

"There are six or seven teams who could win it - I would add to the list Ireland, Australia, Wales, New Zealand, South Africa, the list goes on - and whoever does win it will have to put together a run of six or seven performances on the bounce.

"That's our challenge as well, but playing at Twickenham the way we did against Ireland, we're a hard team to beat."

England captain Chris Robshaw added a note of caution, telling reporters: "We were not quite clinical enough. The second half we came out of the blocks pretty slow, but overall we are pretty pleased."

United 'in talks' with De Gea

Manchester United have opened contract talks with goalkeeper David De Gea.

The Spaniard's present deal expires in 2016 and United had previously indicated they had abandoned hope of the 24-year-old signing an extension.

But following the collapse of a proposed move to Real Madrid on transfer deadline day,

negotiations have begun, with De Gea's agent Jorge Mendes attending the club's training complex on Thursday.

De Gea is yet to play this season.

Manager Louis van Gaal refused to pick the former Atletico Madrid man until the end of the transfer window, such was the uncertainty surrounding his future.

De Gea, United's player

of the season for the past two years, was upset at Van Gaal's claim he did not want to play in the opening games of the season, although club sources have since indicated any damage to the pair's relationship will be easily repaired.

It is still not known whether De Gea will start Saturday's Premier League game against Liverpool on Saturday.

Radcliffe 'categorically denies' cheating

Marathon world record holder Paula Radcliffe has "categorically" denied any form of cheating.

The 41-year-old Briton said questions raised during a parliamentary select committee "effectively implicated" her in the Sunday Times' allegations of blood doping in athletics.

Jesse Norman MP suggested London Marathon winners and medallists and "potentially British athletes" were under suspicion.

Radcliffe was not specifically named.

But she is a three-time London Marathon winner and the only British athlete since 1996 to triumph at the event - though Norman later tweeted that he had not made any allegation against individual athletes.

Following the Commons Culture, Media and Sport Committee hearing, Radcliffe issued a statement saying she was "devastated" her name had been "linked to these wide-ranging accusations".

The Sunday Times published data from 5,000 athletes, which it had reviewed by scientists and said revealed an "extraordinary extent of cheating".

The International Association of Athletics

Federations (IAAF) called the "sensationalist and confusing" and denied it had failed in its duty to carry out effective blood testing.

Radcliffe said she had the "greatest respect" for people "responsibly trying to uncover cheating", but added she was "profoundly disappointed that the cloak of parliamentary privilege" had been used to tarnish her reputation, without recourse.

She said: "I have campaigned long and hard throughout my career for a clean sport. I have publicly condemned cheats and those who aid them. These accusations threaten to undermine all I have stood and competed for, as well as my hard-earned reputation.

"By linking me to allegations of cheating, damage done to my name and reputation can never be fully repaired, no matter how untrue I know them to be."

Radcliffe, who also won the New York Marathon three times and the Chicago Marathon, retired from competitive athletics this year following a persistent foot injury.

She is regarded as the greatest female marathon runner in history.

She said she "wrestled long and hard with a

desire to speak out" following the initial publication of the joint Sunday Times and ARD/WDR investigation of 12,000 blood tests from 5,000 athletes between 2001 and 2012.

Late Laff leaves Northern Irish smiling

Northern Ireland supporters were in euphoric mood as they filed out of Windsor Park after Kyle Lafferty's dramatic last-gasp equaliser salvaged a draw against Hungary and kept their dream of qualifying for Euro 2016 very much alive.

Michael O'Neill's side's incremental progress towards next summer's finals now looks to have gathered unstoppable momentum and two points from their remaining two fixtures would be enough to secure their passage to France.

Republic of Ireland boss Martin O'Neill praised Jeff Hendrick and Jon Walters after they helped set up a vital 1-0

Euro 2016 qualifier win over Georgia.

Hendrick's superb run teed up Walters to score on 69 minutes as the Irish strengthened their hold on third place in Group D.

"Jeff was absolutely magnificent. He has that ability and it was great to see Walters scoring," said O'Neill.

"We didn't play well in the first half but then there was a great turnaround."

With Scotland losing 3-2 at home to Germany, the Republic are now four points ahead of Gordon Strachan's side with two rounds of fixtures remaining next month.

The Republic host leaders Germany and visit second-placed

Poland, while Scotland welcome the Poles before visiting Gibraltar in their final game.

The third-placed team with the best qualifying record from the nine groups qualifies automatically for next summer's tournament in France, with the other eight facing a two-legged play-off.

O'Neill says his side will "have a go" as they aim to at least secure a play-off spot.

"We need to find a win in two matches," he said. "We'll have to play better for the whole game."

As for Scotland manager Gordon Strachan, he remained upbeat following his men's loss to the world champions, insisting: "We are still in this."

Israel keep Welsh waiting

Wales were made to wait in their bid to qualify for Euro 2016 as they were held to a frustrating goalless draw by Israel on Sunday.

Wales seized control early on with chances for Andy King and Aaron Ramsey but they were shackled by a rigid Israel side.

The hosts continued to press after the break and Simon Church had an injury-time goal ruled out for offside, meaning Chris Coleman's side have not yet confirmed an end to Wales' 57-year absence from major tournaments.

Wales remain top of Group B and their hopes are still in their own

hands, with games away against Bosnia-Herzegovina and at home to lowly Andorra to come in October.

Coleman's team are a point ahead of second-placed Belgium, who beat Cyprus 1-0 later on Sunday, and five in front of Israel in third, but this stalemate at an expectant Cardiff City

Stadium interrupted the momentum of the Welsh campaign after three successive wins.

The Wales game got some good news on Thursday, when it was announced that the latest FIFA rankings will see them rise to number eight - their highest-ever ranking and two places above England.

Wenger: I did not lie on Welbeck!

Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger has denied that he misled people about the severity of Danny Welbeck's injury.

The striker has now been ruled out until Christmas with a knee injury - but Wenger says he told the truth when he informed the press on 27 August that Welbeck

was "progressing well".

"I am surprised that people accused me of lying. I did not know Welbeck had had a bad setback," Wenger said.

"I gave you the information I had. I did not lie to you."

Wenger had been hopeful that Welbeck would have been fit to return after the recent international break - but that changed soon after his weekly Friday news conference.

"I heard late on Friday night [27 August] that his condition had not evolved as well as we thought," he added.

"He had needed specialist and needed further investigation."

Arsenal revealed the extent of the injury suffered by Welbeck after the transfer window had shut.

Injury to Welbeck leaves Olivier Giroud as the Gunners' only recognised striker fit for selection, with Theo Walcott and Alexis Sanchez having been mainly used as wide players.

Arsenal knew the extent of the 24-year-old's problem before the transfer window closed on Tuesday, 1 September but did not reinforce their attack.

Roo: scoring record 'dream come true'

■ United striker breaks Sir Bobby's record in Swiss win

■ Rooney can go on to 60 or more, insists Hodgson

Wayne Rooney said it was a "dream come true" to break Sir Bobby Charlton's England goalscoring record and set his sights on adding to his total.

The 29-year-old Manchester United striker's penalty in the 2-0 win over Switzerland in a Euro 2016 qualifier took his tally to 50 goals.

"It's a great feeling," he said. "I've been close for the last few games and it's a dream come true.

"I've got a lot of football in me for England. I hope the goals don't stop."

The spot-kick was awarded late in the game when Raheem Sterling was fouled in the area by Granit Xhaka.

Rooney, who scored his

first England goal against Macedonia in 2003, said after the game: "It's a very special night for me and my family. A night I will never forget.

"I was very nervous stepping up to take the penalty. I knew it was such a big moment for me and my career. The players said to me afterwards it was like being at a concert because there were so many flashes from phones in the crowd.

"It's a huge honour because Sir Bobby Charlton is an England and Manchester United legend. I know Sir Bobby will be extremely proud that a Manchester United captain has broken the record."

The striker was handed

a commemorative England shirt by boss Roy Hodgson in the dressing room after the match, and made a speech in front of his colleagues.

"Nights like this you don't forget," he added. "When you create a bit of history it's a great feeling. It was really nice of the players and the manager to present me with a shirt afterwards."

"You would like to think we are on about 10 games a year and maybe if we ever did very well in a

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
