## ■ Cameron says 'Britain is a moral nation' and pledges to do more as migrant crisis worsens

DAVID CAMERON has insisted Britain will do its fair share to help alleviate the migrant crisis sweeping Europe, telling reporters "as a father I felt deeply moved" by the image of a Syrian boy dead on a Turkish beach.

That image made the front pages of most of the nation's newspapers this week and with the crisis growing more acute each day, the Prime Minister is under growing pressure to devote more resources to the problem.

Mr Cameron said: "Britain is a moral nation and we will fulfil our moral responsibilities."

He pointed out that the Royal Navy had been involved in rescue missions in the Mediterranean and said the UK was the world's second biggest bilateral donor to aid Syrians.

He said the UK would continue to take in "thousands" of refugees, but he cautioned that this was not the only answer to the crisis, saying a "comprehensive solution" was required.

"We have to try and stabilise the countries from which these people are coming," he added.

In a sign of how far the

national mood has been changed by the images coming daily from the Mediterranean and Eastern Europe, the Sun, Britain's highest-selling newspaper, ran a headline which ran: "Mr Cameron, summer is over ... Now deal with the biggest crisis facing Europe since WW2."

The change of tone from a newspaper criticised by the United Nations rights chief in April after one of its columnists compared migrants to 'cockroaches' was a mark of the emotional impact of the images of human suffering across Europe.

### 'life saving work'

As the outpouring of emotion over the dead toddler put the government on the defensive, Chancellor George Osborne appeared on television to express sympathy and defend what he called

Britain's "leading role" in responding to the crisis.

"I was very distressed when I saw it myself this morning, that poor boy lying dead on the beach," Osborne said.

"What we need to do to help those desperate families is break up the

criminal gangs who traffick in people and led to that boy's death, beat ISIS which is the thing they're fleeing, we've got to make sure the aid is going there to help those families."

Osborne pointed to Britain's contribution in

aid to Syrians, which the government says is among the most generous.

But a growing chorus of critics said more could be done within Britain. The number of people signing a petition on parliament's website calling for more

refugees to be taken in was rising fast, from 85,000 early in the morning to 160,000 by lunchtime.

"The UK I know has always shouldered its burden in the world. DfID is doing life-saving work

# Corbyn cruises towards Labour crown with strong debate showing

- Far-left candidate unfazed by Blair's criticism
- Over 80% think frontrunner won televised debate

Jeremy Corbyn looks almost certain to be the next Labour leader after a strong performance in a televised debate this week.

Mr. Corbyn – whose far-left views have been strongly criticized by former Prime Minister Tony Blair, - was the clear winner of this week's Sky News debate, according to over 80% of those polled immediately following the broadcast.

Liz Kendall was a distant second on 8.5%, with Yvette Cooper on 6.1% and Andy Burnham on 4.7%.

Mr Corbyn, particularly scored favourably with his policies and ideas for dealing with foreign affairs.

Two-thirds of voters said he had the best answer on how to deal with the refugee crisis – with the remaining three candidates evenly split on about 12%.

At the hustings in Gateshead, Mr Corbyn said Britain needed to look at the crisis in the widest possible context but warned David Cameron's plans to accept another 4,000 refugees "did not sound

like enough".

Although the debate was in general well mannered, Mr. Corbyn did come in for heavy criticism from Ms Cooper, who took aim at what she described as his plan "for the Bank of England to print money" to pay for infrastructure projects.

### 'false promises'

In an event broadcast live on Sky News from The Sage Theatre in Gateshead, she turned to the left-wing favourite and said: "You're offering people false promises. Quantitative easing has stopped because the economy is now growing. "If you simply keep printing money when an economy is growing it simply increases inflation.

"You're offering people false promise. It sounds brilliant - everyone claps because everyone wants to see the schools and hospitals done. It's dishonest, it's false promise, we've got to offer people real hope.

"You're not being straight with people."

It was the third time during the debate that Ms Cooper took on the man who's popular with the

Labour grassroots.

When asked about the possibility of putting "boots on the ground" against ISIS in the Middle East, Mr Corbyn said an alternative would be to enter into "dialogue" with other countries in the region to isolate ISIS.

But Ms Cooper shot back: "ISIS is a barbaric totalitarian organisation ... it won't be dealt with by a few nice negotiations."

### 'history will be Iraq'

And when asked whether she would work with him if he was leader, she pointed out: "Jeremy has not wanted to be a team player in the past ... he voted against the party 500 times."

Earlier, Mr Corbyn was asked if he admires Tony Blair. Mr Corbyn said that while Mr Blair has some notable achievements such as passing the minimum wage law, "his history will be Iraq".

But leadership rival Andy Burnham said it was important to respect his electoral success: "To direct all this anger at man who won three General Elections and say he doesn't have a right to speak out ... is ridiculous.

"This party could go into a period of infighting coming out of this leadership election. If Labour does that, we will let down millions of people out there."

Mr Corbyn also spoke out strongly against the EU, saying he was "concerned about the way the European Union is increasingly operating like a free market across Europe, tearing up the social chapter and damaging workers' interests across Europe".

But outsider Liz Kendall interrupted, saying: "How can we tackle these things unless we play a leading role in Europe? We've been round this block before."

One question came from a local councillor who wanted to know how the candidates would deal with the current refugee crisis.

Mr Corbyn said the UK must "hold out the hand

of humanity", adding that taking 4,000 people was "not enough".

Ms Kendall said Prime Minister David Cameron has appeared "both heartless and powerless on the refugee crisis".

Ms Cooper said the government must do more and claimed her party had helped to change government policy in a matter of days, while Mr Burnham said "compassion and leadership" must be shown.

One member of the audience asked whether the candidates would be "willing to compromise your political principles in order to get elected?"

Mr Burnham gave an emphatic 'no', saying he had always stuck by his principles.

Ms Kendall said she believes in what she says, adding that the public don't trust Labour on welfare, for example. She

is pushing for the party to take a tougher stance on the issue.

Mr Corbyn, disagreed with her position, saying: "We fought election on a manifesto with cuts, job losses, accepting the language of austerity. The party has to challenge politics of austerity."

The candidates were asked whether they would support decriminalising the medicinal use of cannabis.

Ms Cooper said it should be evaluated in the same way as any other drug: "We have a process for deciding which medicines are safe. We should just apply that same process to cannabis. It should go through the same processes as any other drug."

Mr Corbyn said drug policy in general should be looked at, not just the medicinal use of cannabis.



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## Hundreds of arrests mar Notting Hill Carnival

More than 300 people were arrested during the two-day Notting Hill Carnival last weekend, which saw a police officer stabbed and another bitten in two separate incidents.

Two people were arrested in connection with the stabbing, with the officer receiving treatment for non-life-threatening injuries in hospital.

By late Monday, there had been 314 arrests at the traditional bank holiday festival, which was dogged by heavy downpours with almost an inch of rain falling.

These were for a range of offences including assault, criminal damage, theft, carrying weapons and drug possession.

The Met said it had impounded more than 3,500 nitrous oxide containers during the carnival, which was attended by around one million people.

The gas, also known as "hippy crack", can make people feel relaxed and giggly but can also cause loss of blood pressure, fainting and even fatal heart attacks.

In one incident a police officer was punched in the face and suffered a dislocated nose while confiscating 400 canisters.

A 19-year-old man was also taken to hospital with life-threatening injuries after being stabbed in the street. He is said to be in a stable condition.

There was a heavy police presence at the annual event, where the vast majority of carnival-goers got in the party atmosphere despite the showers.

# Beverley Sister Joy dies at 91

Joy Beverley, one third of the vocal harmony group the Beverley Sisters, has died at the age of 91.

The singer, from Bethnal Green in London, was the eldest sister in the trio, who were known for songs including Little Drummer Boy and the Irving Berlin standard Sisters.

They had their own BBC TV show in the 1950s and were made MBEs in 2006.

Joy was also married to Wolverhampton Wanderers' star Billy Wright until his death from cancer in 1994.

She died on Monday after suffering a stroke last week her son, Vince Wright, told the Express and Star.

"We all thought the world of her and we are devastated she is gone," he said.

"She was a very bubbly, but private, character. We are all going to miss her terribly, she has been a part of our lives for so long now it really is going to be a big loss for all of us."

### World record holder

Joy, born Joycelyn V Chinery in 1924, and the twins Babs and Teddie, born in 1927, were brought up in Bethnal Green in east London.

Their parents were George and Victoria Beverley - who performed as music-hall duo, Coram and Mills.

During their formative years, money was scarce and the sisters shared a bed until they were teenagers.

Speaking in 2002, Joy insisted they did not notice being poor. "Mother was very clever," she told the Independent. "If we said we wanted a bike,

she'd say: 'Oh, I love you too much to give you a bike.'"

During the Second World War the girls were evacuated to the Midlands. There they secured a contract to become "Bonnie Babies" in an advertising campaign for the bedtime drink Ovaltine. Radio appearances for the BBC followed - with support from bandleader Glenn Miller they became professional singers, renowned for their close harmonies and glamorous lifestyles.

### highest paid

After the war the siblings were given their own TV show, initially called Three Little Girls in View and later retitled Those Beverley Sisters as the group's profile improved.

In 1951, the trio signed a recording contract with Columbia Records that helped them become the highest paid female act in the UK, earning more than £700 a week at a time when the average weekly wage was £5.

They were the first British female group to break into the US top 10 and enjoyed chart success with Christmas records like I Saw Mommy Kissing Santa Claus.

### 'no guilt'

Other favourites included Bye Bye Love and Always and Forever.

But they all but retired after Joy married Billy Wright, then captain of the England football team, at Poole Register Office in 1958.

"I felt it was time we had an ordinary life," she recalled in a 1995 interview. "We'd had a successful career and I felt no guilt."

But the trio reunited in the 1980s, resurrecting old songs such as It's Illegal, It's Immoral Or It Makes You Fat for gay clubs and variety shows.

The sisters entered the

Guinness Book Of Records in 2002, as the world's longest surviving vocal group without a change in the line up.

The same year, they sang for the Queen and

the Duke of Edinburgh at a Jubilee concert.

In 2006, the group were made MBEs for services to music, and arrived at Buckingham Palace - as always - in identical outfits.

abroad but we can and must do more at home," tweeted Ruth Davidson, a member of the Scottish parliament and leader of the Scottish Conservatives.

Yvette Cooper, one of four candidates to lead the opposition Labour Party, called for Britain to take in an additional 10,000 refugees, drawing support including from political opponents.

"The Prime Minister is right to point to the need to continue to tackle the causes; and Yvette Cooper and others are also right to call for the UK to take in more refugees," wrote Tory MP Jeremy Lefroy on his blog.

"It is not either/or. We need to do both."

## 'Reduced to tears'

Earlier, Scotland's first minister, Nicola Sturgeon accused the government of a "walk on by" attitude.

Justin Welby, the Archbishop of Canterbury, described the situation as a "wicked crisis".

"My heart is broken by the images and stories of men, women and children who have risked their lives to escape conflict, violence," he said.

There have been cross-party calls at home and from abroad for the UK to take in more refugees, as Europe struggles to cope with the

daily influx of migrants. Attacking the government's response to the crisis, Ms Sturgeon pledged that Scotland would "stand ready to offer sanctuary to refugees that need our help".

She said she was "reduced to tears" at the image of the dead child, adding: "I am very angry at the walk-on-by attitude of the UK government and I implore David Cameron to change his

position and change it today."

Ex-party chairman Baroness Warsi was among the Conservatives calling for the government to do more, suggesting more women and children refugees should be accepted by the UK.

She told the BBC Britain had a "long and proud" tradition of helping in times of crisis.

Former Labour home secretary David

Blunkett told Thursday's Newsnight he thought the UK should take 25,000 refugees over a six month period.

Tory MP David Burrowes said "thousands, not hundreds" of people should be taken in, while Ruth Davidson, leader of the Scottish

Conservatives, tweeted "this is not an immigration issue, it's a humanitarian one", as she called for more help for refugees.

## Former garage sells for eye-popping £24m

### ■ Mayfair pad was once home to famed Bentley Boys

A former garage has become the world's most expensive mews home, selling for approximately £24 million in London's red-hot property market.

The 6,200 sq ft home in Mayfair used to house Bentley racing cars in the 1920s.

After the house was last sold for £7.4 million back in 2011, the property underwent a dramatic facelift where everything but the facade was demolished.

Now a state-of-the-art family pad set over four floors, the home boasts a large cinema, gym, wine cellar and a winter garden roof terrace.

It has a master bedroom suite with two bathrooms and two dressing rooms,

five further bedrooms, four more bathrooms and separate staff bedroom accommodation.

There is an impressive 43-foot high staircase which acts as a centrepiece of the property, which is more than six times the size of the average new home in Britain.

It also has an integral garage - which has room for no more than one 1920s Bentley Blower, a car which is now worth upwards of £5 million.

When the plush pad went on the market last year with estate agents Wetherell, Knight Frank and Rokstone, its price-tag of £24 million was 130 times more than the typical English home.

The property's sale was

confirmed by James Van Den Heule, director of Fenton Whelan, the upmarket developer behind the house which was on the Prime London property market for 12 months.

Land Registry records suggest the home was bought by a wealthy Qatari.

### 'discreet and secure'

Stamp Duty on a £24 million home is around £2.8 million, although Fenton Whelan would not discuss the deal or price paid.

Located on Reeves Mews, behind Upper Grosvenor Street, the home was originally built in the 1920s and used to store racing cars driven by

the famed Bentley Boys who would compete at legendary sports car race Le Mans.

Mews houses would historically be located at the rear of an opulent mansion and be lived in by staff or used as stables for horses.

But in recent years these smaller houses, tucked away from busier streets, have become far more popular and are now selling for multi-million figures.

The luxurious Reeves property is thought to be the most expensive mews house ever sold and James Robinson, general manager at mews specialists, Lurot Brand, thinks it could be a shrewd buy.

He said: "For many years mews houses were the rubbish behind the main homes but today they are like a little oasis."

"They are very discreet and secure and in the best part of town. Reeves Mews ticks all the boxes - it really has been done to the highest standards."

He added: "When I started selling mews houses in the late 1980s they were a lot more affordable."

"You could get them for around £200,000 but this was at a time when there were a lot of garages, so they were noisy with people doing MOTs."

"Once the garages started to leave the prices started rising and they're only going one way."

"I can't think of another mews house which has sold for this much. If the owner keeps it for ten years it might be worth £44 million."

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## Pensioner stung to death in Wales

A great-grandfather has been stung to death by a swarm of wasps after he accidentally disturbed a nest near his holiday home.

Clive Southall's head was so consumed by the mass of attacking insects that his horrified relatives said they could "hardly see his face" as he rushed back to his caravan.

The 83-year-old ran towards his family for help before heading to the shower in an attempt to wash the wasps off.

But Mr Southall, from Brierley Hill, near Dudley, Worcs, collapsed shortly after and had to be airlifted to hospital, after being stung hundreds of times.

The retired service engineer was at his holiday home at the Baxter Mill Caravan Park in Llanfair Caereinion, Welshpool when the accident happened on 11 August.

He died at Royal Shrewsbury Hospital on the same day, as a result of an anaphylactic shock.

During evidence given to an inquest at Telford Register Office, Mr Southall's family described Clive's death as a "tragic accident".

According to his son Mark Southall, 51, Clive and his 11-year-old grand-daughter Ellie were clearing weeds along the Afon Rhiw river bank near his holiday home at around 11am.

Julie Hartridge, officer for Shropshire coroner Mr John Ellery, who read out family statements at the inquest said: "At some point during this work it seems Clive slipped and disturbed a wasp's nest."

# Bond author 'sorry' over Elba comment

Author Anthony Horowitz has apologised for saying he thought Idris Elba was "too street" to be the next James Bond.

Horowitz, who has written a new James Bond book, made his comments about Elba - best known for his roles in Luther and The Wire - to the Mail on Sunday.

He told the paper it was "not a colour issue" - but some fans accused him of making a veiled racial remark.

Horowitz has now said the word "street" was "a poor choice of word" and he was "mortified to have caused offence".

Elba has long been touted as a possible successor to Daniel Craig as the fictional secret service agent.

Horowitz is currently

promoting Trigger Mortis, a novel featuring Bond, which has been authorised by the estate of original 007 author Ian Fleming.

In the original interview, the author said he thought Elba was not right for the part.

"Idris Elba is a terrific actor, but I can think of other black actors who would do it better," he said, suggesting rising star Adrian Lester as a possible alternative.

"For me, Idris Elba is a bit too rough to play the part. It's not a colour issue. I think he is probably a bit too 'street' for Bond. Is it a question of being suave? Yeah."

Despite his insistence that his opinion had nothing to do with skin colour, some Twitter users accused him of

racism.

"I'm really sorry my comments about Idris Elba have caused offence," Horowitz responded in a

statement.

"That wasn't my intention. I was asked in my interview if Idris Elba would make a good James Bond. In the article

I expressed the opinion that to my mind Adrian Lester would be a better choice but I'm a writer not a casting director so what do I know?"

## Screaming kids spoil the pub, says the boozers' bible

Unruly children shouting, screaming and running around are spoiling pub visits, says this year's Good Pub Guide, considered the boozers' bible by many Brits.

The main complaint from regulars this year has been about badly behaved youngsters.

The Good Pub Guide highlights the problem, and the dilemma for

landlords having to deal with unwelcome families.

One reader of the guide wrote: "Why are there undisciplined children who are allowed to run around unchecked, or screaming babies who aren't taken outside to calm down?"

Another said: "My peaceful lunch by the fire with a pint was totally ruined by a child running

around whooping and tripping up staff, and when asked to quieten down by the landlord, the poor man faced abuse from over-protective parents. Ridiculous."

The Guide's editor, Fiona Stapley, said she had recently witnessed first hand the difference in how children, and more importantly their parents, behaved in pubs.

"At one end of a table a child was left screaming, while at the other end a child was taken outside to quieten down. It all depends how parents treat their children," she told the Press Association.

"Now that almost all pubs warmly welcome children at all times, the few problem families, whose children run riot, stick out like the proverbial

sore thumb."

Some pubs seat families together in one room, while others offer well-equipped play areas or free wi-fi.

One publican said: "There is nothing more pleasant than a large family group out for Sunday lunch, with all generations present, including well-behaved children."

## Local expat facing sex charges kills himself

THE ONGOING historic sex abuse probe in Britain took a local turn this week when a British expat killed himself in Sherman Oaks as police closed in.

Christopher Ling, (pictured, right) 57, a teacher accused of sexually abusing young girls at a prestigious music school, killed himself as US marshals entered his San Fernando Valley home at around 6am on Wednesday morning.

Mr Ling, who taught the violin at Chetham's

School of Music until the summer of 1990, faced 72 counts of child sex abuse.

"We attempted to serve an arrest warrant on Christopher Ling and, in the course of that process, he shot himself," Laura Vega, a marshals service spokesperson, told reporters.

### naked bottoms

Like so many other British immigrants, the former teacher had reinvented himself, styling himself as a show business talent manager,

after leaving the UK over twenty years ago.

The US Justice Department had agreed to extradite Mr Ling after the British Crown Prosecution Service sought to return him to the UK.

Allegations against Mr Ling emerged after the trial of Michael Brewer, the school's former director of music, who was convicted of sexual assault.

In 2013, the Guardian reported that 10 former pupils alleged Mr Ling



had assaulted them during their time at the school.

Referred to as "Ling's Strings", the group of women claimed the music

teacher forced pupils as young as 13 to strip naked, would spank their naked bottoms, and groomed them during their lessons.



## The Great British Baking Show is back

### leading food writer

With nearly 60 years of cooking experience, judge Mary Berry is considered Britain's "doyenne of baking." Having learned the art from her mother, the adult Berry quickly established herself as a

## Arthur and George debuts on Mystery!

■ Latest import stars Martin Clunes as Arthur Conan Doyle

The Game Is On this Sunday night (September 6th) as PBS debuts the popular British television show Arthur & George, starring Martin Clunes as Sir Arthur Conan Doyle.

The three-part drama won plaudits from the press during its recent UK broadcast, with The Sunday Telegraph hailing it as "thoroughly enjoyable ... Clunes proves exceptionally winning as the widowed writer and sometime crusader for justice, Arthur Conan Doyle, who finds a new zest for life when he comes across the curious case of George Edalji."

The real-life Edalji case saw an improbable defendant, mild-mannered lawyer George Edalji, convicted for mutilating a pony and, by implication, a host of other farm animals in a

letters and intimidation aimed, oddly enough, at George's family. To Doyle, the whole affair suggested blatant racism, targeting a

family viewed as outsiders by the local people and officials.

Fortunately, my sister, Eileen Lee, is a founder of Brits in LA. I have seen Brits in LA emerge and flourish and I am a proud Key member.

**Have you ever visited Los Angeles - if so we would love to hear what your impression of LA is?** Having visited many times. I find that, more

than most cities, LA is all about being on the 'inside', connecting with people, getting to know them or the scenes which interest you, or for your career, rather than being an easily accessible more obvious city, like say Rome or Paris. It's extraordinarily different to London, which has a more institutionalised work culture, in television at least. Though I am a freelancer myself now, for 8 years, after 22 years spent as a BBC staff producer and director of factual documentary films & series.

**Do you think you could ever see yourself moving to LA, if not tell us what**

**keeps you in London?** For 20 years I have had the type of US Visa permitting me to make films in the USA, staying for longer periods, with my base in London. When it comes to moving, just ask my immigration lawyer, a fellow Brit in LA. When I give up London as my base then I will be over. Family keeps me here currently, and the sort of films I get commissioned to produce and direct and write are often very central to British culture, though I never exclude my options, subject areas, treating every subject of a film with the same great respect and enjoyment it deserves. Every project,

often every day, is a new adventure, wherever it might take me. I have made films in 35 countries now and I am most proud of raising the largest single private donation in the decades-long history of BBC Children in Need - £1 million pounds with a single three minute appeal film on child poverty and becoming the first female to direct (and produce) The Queen's Christmas Broadcast, broadcast around the world.

**Do you have a hidden gem want to share with us?**

My hidden gem is my home. It's remarkable to live in a city of 12 million, a couple of miles from the West End, yet, my garden is so quiet you can hear butterflies. As that's a little unfair, you can't visit, perhaps, then Richmond Park. Beautiful and big enough to ride a horse full pelt, which I manage to do most weekends, and having a huge dog I can recommend most of our London parks, with their

quirky history, heritage, and enormous green and plentiful spaces.

**Why would you recommend other overseas readers join Brits in LA?**

LA is all about connections, working knowledge, people, contacts. Even buildings change rapidly in LA. Brits in LA means you can keep on top of all that, have fun, make friends and do business, if you wish.

**We hear you are working on an exciting project at the moment - can you tell our readers all about it?**

I have three films completing this year. My next documentary broadcasts on BBC One, 9pm, on Monday 7th September: The Queen's Longest Reign: Elizabeth & Victoria. Presented by Sophie Raworth. Telling the story of the two female monarchs and marks the day, Wednesday September 9th 2015, when Queen Elizabeth II becomes the longest reigning monarch in British history & the

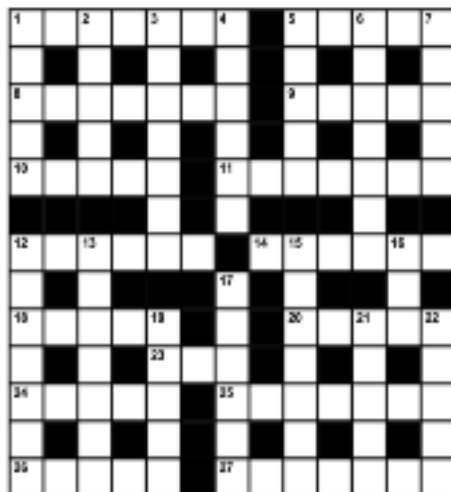

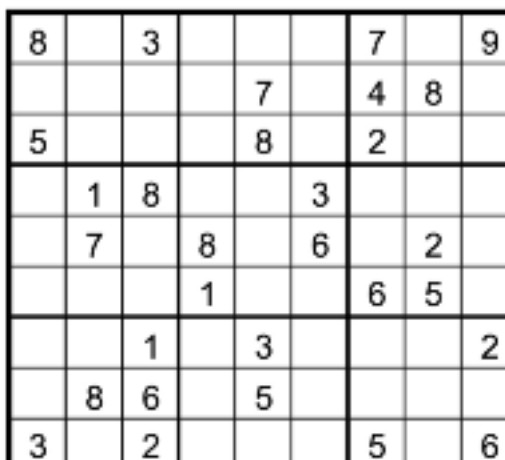

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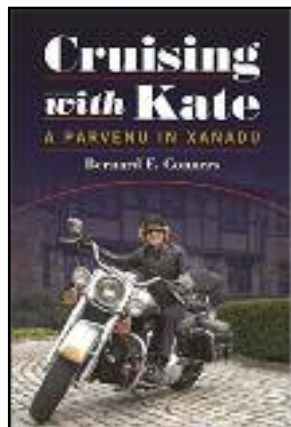
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## Cruising with Kate: autobiography falls a little short

Exclusive interview with author Bernard F. Connors and a review of his autobiography of life as an FBI agent living with the rich and famous

**"An autobiography focuses on one's innermost thoughts and develops a better understanding of one's self," says *Cruising with Kate* author Bernard F. Connors.** "It's often a vainglorious effort, challenging and depressing. Some express disappointment and criticism, others delight and understanding."

In *Kate* Connors describes himself as "incurably insecure personality" with "macho fantasies" of riding a

Harley Davidson. His Walter Mitty personality is at odds with what one expects from an intrepid FBI agent living the good life while solving major crimes.

*Cruising with Kate: A Parvenu in Xanadu* is the life story of Connors and his wife Kate. After being a pro football player, Connors joins the army and then becomes an FBI agent. Through his new friend George Plimpton, a respected sports journalist and editor of *The Paris*

Review, Connors joins the Manhattan literati scene, dining at the 21 and Elaine's. Next come the Hamptons and Hollywood. Connors says it was Plimpton who persuaded him to write an autobiography.

Connors opens a window into his professional life working for the FBI and to his personal life with his wife Kate. Yet writing about himself in third person keeps him at a distance from the reader. Connors has written half a dozen books, two of them bestsellers, yet for his memoirs it's as though he's a reporter describing someone else's life. His self-stated trait of insecurity is combined with a conflicting belief in his own significance and celebrity. The reader is prevented from being fully engaged by Connors' life story.

It's as though Connors is writing about himself through the misty eyes of his publicist, rather than from the incisive perspective of dashing G-man and celebrity. However, there are interesting moments, such as when the FBI guns down Dillinger after his betrayal by the woman in red. Dillinger unexpectedly shoves the two women away to protect them from a hail of G-men bullets.

Connors says he, "missed many opportunities that may have made a difference in his career because of a lack of self-confidence." One opportunity missed in *Cruising with Kate* is we don't really get to know Kate. Connors tells George Plimpton that sending a manuscript to a publisher is like sending a child to an orphanage, that he loathes the thought of his book

being, "shunted about with hundreds of other books." He chose to self-publish *Kate* instead.

For his research in writing *Kate*, Connors says he did a thorough review of old newspaper clips and publishing files. That effort also resurrected memories from long ago.

Connors has written six books. His novels are *Don't Embarrass the Bureau*, *Dancehall*, *The Hampton Sisters*, and *The Elevator*. *Bureau* and *Dancehall* were bestsellers. His non-fiction titles are *Tailspin* and *Cruising with Kate*. He's also written three screenplays, but none have been produced. *Dancehall* has been adapted for film, to start this summer in Lake Placid, New York.

Connors is currently writing the novel *The Elevator*, about a New York literary agent who finds himself in love and

immersed in New York's Upper East Side social world. Connors doesn't currently have an agent, although he's had several in the past.

### thinly veiled racism

have occasionally pointed out to people that 'I am an immigrant' (in response to their negative comments) but not surprised when the response is 'I don't mean people like you'. This thinly veiled racism is unacceptable and I don't want to be a part of it.

Is this why the Brits often choose to refer to themselves as ex-pats?

British Prime Minister David Cameron helped feed the fire when he referred to the 'swarm' of migrants descending on the UK. Not only is this kind of language extremely inflammatory, but he is another culprit of deliberately using the wrong term and lumping people of various circumstances under one label that doesn't sound as serious as refugee or asylum seeker. It is particularly dangerous when you are in such a position of power. People will never understand the difference between refugees and economic migrants, if prominent politicians can't, or choose not to....

### moral responsibility

Surely it is common sense to realize that when one is fleeing for their life that they are not just migrating? Sadly it seems it will take many more lives like that of Aylan, the three year-old Syrian boy whose drowned body was washed up on a Turkish beach this week, for the world to sit up and take action. We have to realize it is all of our moral responsibility to do as much as we can to help. There is no immediate solution to the conflict in Syria, so it is really crucial for all countries to step up and start accepting refugees.

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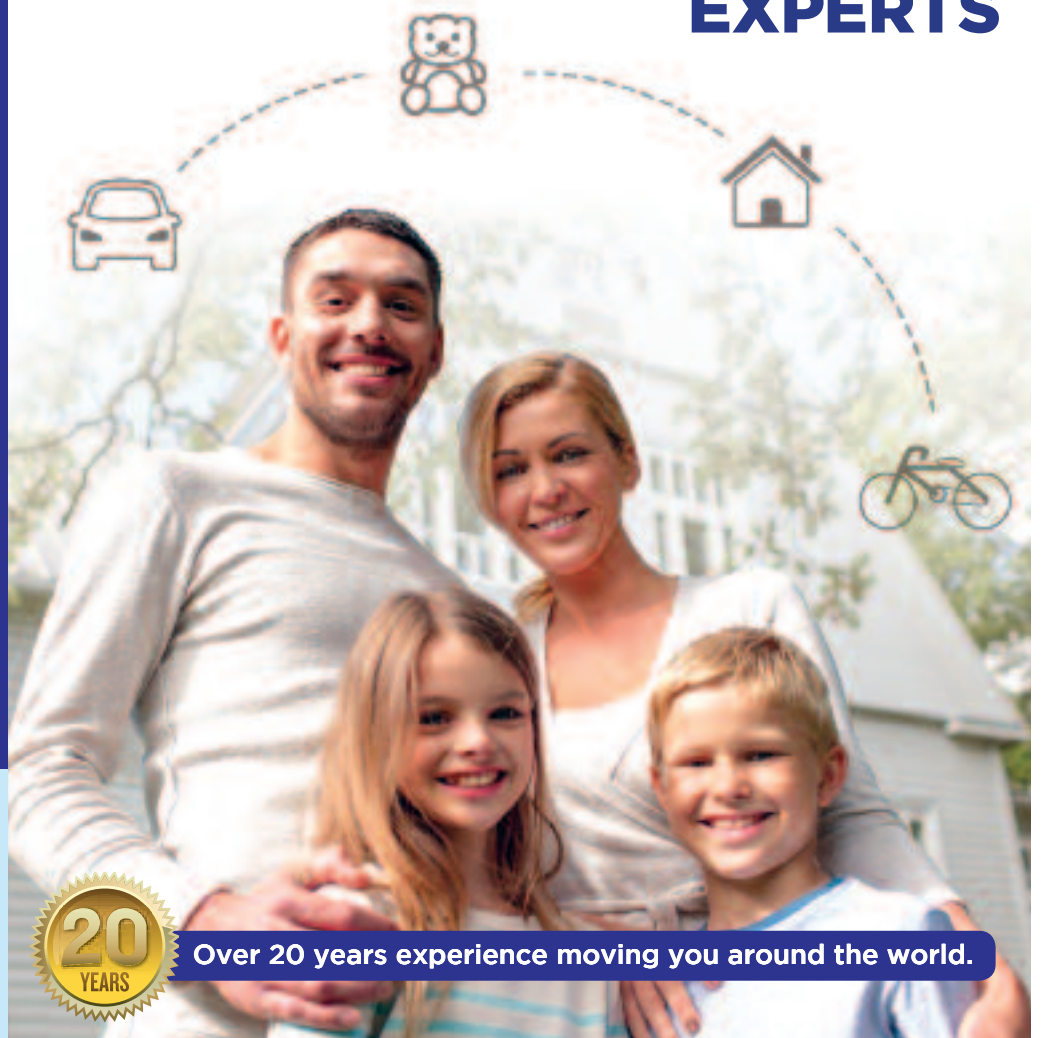

## Stuttering England lose first ODI

*First one-day international, Ageas Bowl, Southampton:  
Australia 305-6 (50 overs): Wade 71 not out, Warner 59, Rashid 4-59  
England 246 (45.3 overs): Roy 67, Taylor 49, Watson 2-39*

**A stuttering England batting display handed Australia a 59-run victory at Southampton in the first game of their five-match one-day series on Thursday.**

Adil Rashid's 4-59 reduced the Aussies to 193-6 but Matthew Wade (71 not out) added 112 with Mitchell Marsh (40 not out) to help the tourists post 305-6.

Jason Roy (67) led England's reply but fell when well set, as did James Taylor (49) and captain Eoin Morgan (38).

England lost three wickets in four balls at one stage and their last seven for 94 runs before being bowled out with 27 balls to spare.

Coming off the back of Monday's five-run victory in the Twenty20 international at Cardiff, England made four changes from their last ODI against New Zealand at Chester-le-Street in June.

Taylor replaced the rested Joe Root at three, Jos Buttler returned with the gloves in place of Jonny Bairstow and Sam Billings and David Willey were omitted in favour of Moeen Ali and Chris Woakes. Australia had just five survivors from their World Cup-winning side in

March.

Having won the toss and elected to bat, it was an innings of three parts from Australia.

A solid platform saw Joe Burns (44) and David Warner (59) put on 76 for the first wicket before a mid-innings wobble, when Steve Smith's side lost four wickets for 29 runs in the space of six overs.

But wicketkeeper Wade, whose unbeaten 71 not out came off 50 balls, recovered from being involved in the run-out of Shane Watson to share a vital seventh-wicket stand with Marsh.

The innings was even more impressive considering the 27-year-old Tasmanian took nine balls to get off the mark before striking 12 fours in his 48th ODI appearance.

Wade's return to the green and gold was to get even sweeter in the field when he took three catches with the gloves.

England's pursuit of 306 started with two promising innings from Roy and Taylor.

But both surrendered impressive starts when they gave their wickets away and England's reply fell flat.

Surrey opener Roy put on 70 with opening

partner Alex Hales (22) and reached his first ODI half-century off 49 balls with 10 fours.

But, just as he looked set to bat through the innings, he slashed Glenn Maxwell to point to be dismissed for 67 off 64 balls.

Taylor struck an impressive straight six off Marsh but the diminutive right-hander gifted his wicket one shy of 50 when he swung and missed at a straight one from Watson.

After a recovery of sorts between Morgan and Ben Stokes, England lost three wickets in four balls without adding a run to slump from 194-4 to 194-7.

Some late glimpses of class from Moeen and Rashid were not enough to mount a rearguard.

The two teams meet in the second ODI of the series at Lord's on Saturday.

## Adebayor left out of Spurs domestic and Europa squads

Striker Emmanuel Adebayor has been left out of Tottenham's Premier League and Europa League squads.

The 31-year-old, who joined Spurs on a permanent deal in 2012 for £5m, has yet to feature for the club this season.

Striker Saido Berahino, 22, was named in West Brom's squad, despite suggesting he will never play for the club again under chairman Jeremy Peace.

Goalkeeper Victor Valdes was named in Manchester United's Premier League list but not in the Champions League squad.

West Ham were keen to sign forward Adebayor during the transfer window, while Aston Villa wanted him on loan, but both were

put off by his high wage demands.

Tottenham had been trying to terminate his contract, but the Togo international wanted a £5m pay-off.

That figure is understood to be the value of the final year of his contract. According to reports, Spurs had been willing to pay a portion of that amount, but the player is said to have refused the club's offer.

The former Arsenal and Manchester City forward spent a successful 2011-12 season on loan at Spurs, scoring 17 goals.

However, he has only managed 18 league goals in 47 league appearances for the club since signing a permanent deal. He made 17 appearances last season, having

been granted two periods of compassionate leave for personal reasons.

Berahino was the subject of two failed bids on transfer deadline day from Spurs and tweeted that he was "sad" not to be able to say "exactly how the club has treated me" during transfer negotiations with Tottenham.

He had been left out of West Brom's last two Premier League games and the Capital One Cup tie with Port Vale, with manager Tony Pulis saying he was not in the right frame of mind to play.

Liverpool full-back Jose Enrique, 29, was named in the Reds' Premier League list, but was left out of the Europa League squad.

## Arsenal's Welbeck out till Christmas

**Arsenal striker Danny Welbeck is expected to be out until Christmas after having a knee operation.**

Welbeck, 24, who had surgery last week on the injury sustained in April, has scored eight goals in his first 34 games for the Gunners.

Arsenal, who were linked with Karim Benzema, knew the extent of the problem before the transfer

window closed but did not reinforce their attack.

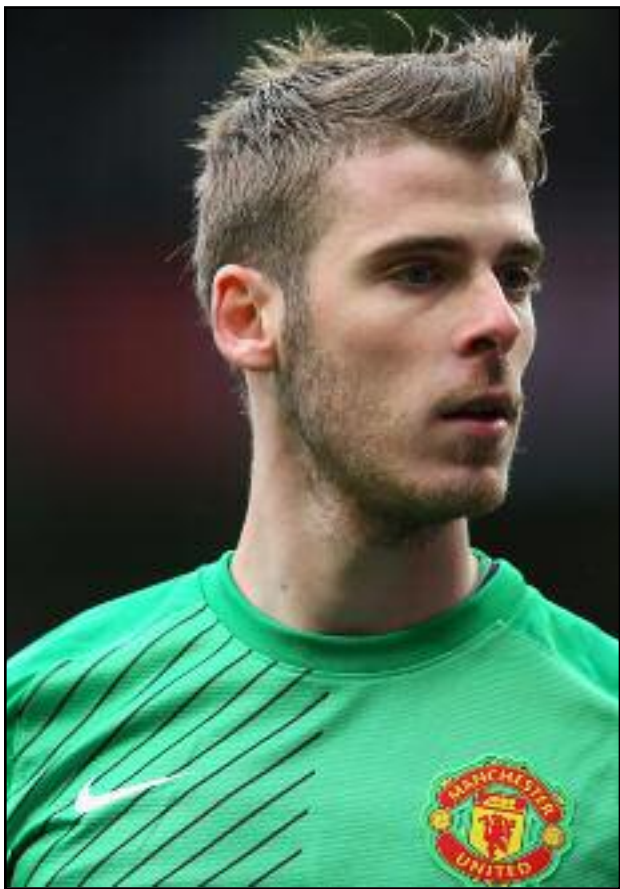
That means Olivier Giroud is their only recognised striker fit for selection.

Theo Walcott, Alexis Sanchez and Joel Campbell - who has not played for the Gunners since January - have experience of operating in that position, but are mainly used by Arsenal as wide players.

England international Welbeck, who joined from Manchester United in 2014, picked up the injury to his left knee after coming on as a substitute in Arsenal's 0-0 home draw with Chelsea in late April.

"The injury to his cartilage did not respond as well as hoped and the decision was taken last week for him to undergo surgery," said a statement.

# United deny blame for failed Real Madrid deal

Manchester United say they were not at fault for the collapse of goalkeeper David De Gea's move to Real Madrid.

Real released a statement saying they did everything they could to complete the £29m deal of the 24-year-old, but missed the deadline by two minutes.

But United say they submitted all the paperwork two minutes before 23:00 BST.

The Red Devils added: "The club is delighted that its fan-favourite double player of the year, David De Gea, remains a Manchester United player."

De Gea, who is out of contract next year, has not played this season.

Keylor Navas, 28 - who had been poised to move in the other direction - has been Real's number one since the club allowed Iker Casillas to join Porto.

De Gea joined United from Real's city rivals Atletico Madrid in 2011 in an £18.9m deal.

After several high-profile errors in his first few months in England, he established himself as one of the league's top keepers and made 175 United appearances in total.

United are now set to continue with four keepers for the Premier League season - De Gea, Sergio Romero, who has started all their games so far, Victor Valdes, whom the club failed to sell to Besiktas, and Sam Johnstone.

In January De Gea, who will now go on international duty with Spain, will be able to open talks over a free transfer move to Real next summer.

Apart from the eye-popping sum Manchester United spent on Anthony Martial, among the biggest spenders in the last few hours of the transfer window were Everton, who splashed out £9.5m on Ramiro Funes Mori from River Plate, and Sunderland, who were

persuaded to part with £10m to secure Fabio Borini's move from Liverpool.

Southampton have also spent some of their transfer kitty, paying Celtic £11.5m for Virgil van Dijk. Elsewhere in the Premier League, Matt Jarvis has moved from West Ham to Norwich on loan, while Aaron Lennon has completed his move to Everton from Spurs for an undisclosed fee. Nathan Dyer has moved from Swansea to

Leicester in search of regular first team football, while Michael Hector, who has moved from Reading to Chelsea for £4m, can have no such expectation.

Also on the move is speedy American defender DeAndre Yedlin, whom Spurs have lent to Sunderland so he can gain some Premier League experience at another team's

expense. Former Everton striker Nikica Jelavic is moving back to the Premiership, leaving Hull to join fellow Croatian Slaven Bilic at West Ham. Also moving the Hammers is Victor Moses, who has fallen out of favor with Jose Mourinho at Chelsea, where he will team up with former Arsenal midfielder Alex Song, moving from Barcelona

to east London on loan.

Manchester United have also been busy offloading players deemed surplus to requirements. Anders Lindgaard has moved to West Bromwich Albion on a free, Adnan Januzaj has joined Borussia Dortmund on loan, while surplus to requirements striker Javier Hernandez has been flogged to Bayer Leverkusen for £7.3m.

# Brilliant Bale puts Welsh at the brink

■ Wales on verge of Euro 2016 qualification following last-gasp winner from Real star

Gareth Bale proved Wales' saviour once again as his thunderous late header gave them a 1-0 win in Cyprus on Thursday to put them on the brink of qualifying for Euro 2016.

Wales midfielder David Edwards had a goal disallowed and Neil Taylor wasted a fine chance as a full-blooded first half ended goalless as Chris Coleman's team went in search of three precious points.

Scoring opportunities were sparse in a flat second period until Bale headed Jazz Richards's cross into the roof of the net to spark wild celebrations from the travelling fans.

Wales remain unbeaten

and three points clear at the top of Group B, knowing victory against Israel on Sunday will seal qualification and end a 57-year wait for an appearance at a major tournament. Wales are above England in the Fifa rankings for the first time as they moved to the brink of Euro 2016 qualifications with a 1-0 win Cyprus.

Chris Coleman's team held on to ninth - their highest-ever position - while England fell two places to 10th.

Wales boss Coleman said the rankings would be a "confidence boost" but said success was reaching Euro 2016.

Scotland have risen one place to 31st while Northern Ireland (41st)

and Republic of Ireland (51st) have both fallen one position.

Wales and England are both above European champions Spain (11th) and Netherlands (12th) in a list topped by Argentina.

Coleman said: "We've been low in the rankings and had that rubbed in our face many a time.

"Now we're doing very well, certain people want to say the rankings are this and they're that, but the players deserve it.

"At the same time, the rankings are not going to get us to France. Success is getting to France."

England, who are top of their Euro 2016 qualifying group with a 100% record, face San Marino today.

## Wenger questions Martial law

Manchester United's £36m signing of French teenager Anthony Martial shows the lack of top quality players available to big clubs, says Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger.

Martial, 19, joined the Red Devils from Monaco on transfer deadline day.

Wenger has been criticised for only adding one player - goalkeeper Petr Cech - to his squad this summer.

But he told BeIn Sports: "The problem at the moment is finding the players that guarantee you are a better team."

He added: "What happened last night with Monaco, who sold Martial to Manchester United for 80 million euros - Martial scored 11

goals in the French championship - that sums it up well.

"That means it's not the money that's missing at the moment, it's not the desire of investment that is missing, it's the number of players available who can strengthen the big clubs."

Arsenal were the only club from the top five European leagues not to sign an outfield player in the summer transfer

window, leading to criticism from fans.

But Wenger said: "Am I happy with the investment I make? Yes, every time. I bought (Alexis) Sanchez, I bought (Mesut) Ozil, I bought Cech, I bought Gabriel last year.

"You have to find the players to invest in."

The Arsenal Supporters' Trust has called for a the club to carry out an inquiry into its transfer policy.
