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# 'BBC banned me' over Savile comments, claims Lydon

■ Former Sex Pistol says he 'did his bit' to alert the public to the predatory DJ but that his comments made in 1978 were never aired

John Lydon has claimed he was banned from the BBC after speaking out against serial abuser Jimmy Savile.

The former Sex Pistol was referring to an interview he'd given in 1978, during which he had said that Savile was "into all sorts of seediness. We all know about it but we're not allowed to talk about it. I knew some rumours."

Speaking to Piers Morgan for his popular British TV show *Life Stories*, he said: "I'm very, very bitter that the likes of Savile and the rest of them were allowed to continue. I did my bit, I said what I had to. But they didn't air that."

He continued: "I found myself banned from BBC radio for quite a while, for my contentious behaviour. They wouldn't state this directly; there'd be other excuses."

The band were already in the BBC's bad books before Lydon's Savile comments: God Save The Queen received a total ban on radio play from the corporation in May 1977. Lydon didn't go into the specifics of what the ban entailed, although he said:

"Weren't I right? I think most kids wanted to go on Top of the Pops but we all knew what that cigar muncher was up to."

Revelations about Jimmy Savile's sexual abuse came out almost a year after his death in 2012, leading to the Metropolitan Police Service to launch a criminal investigation into the allegations.

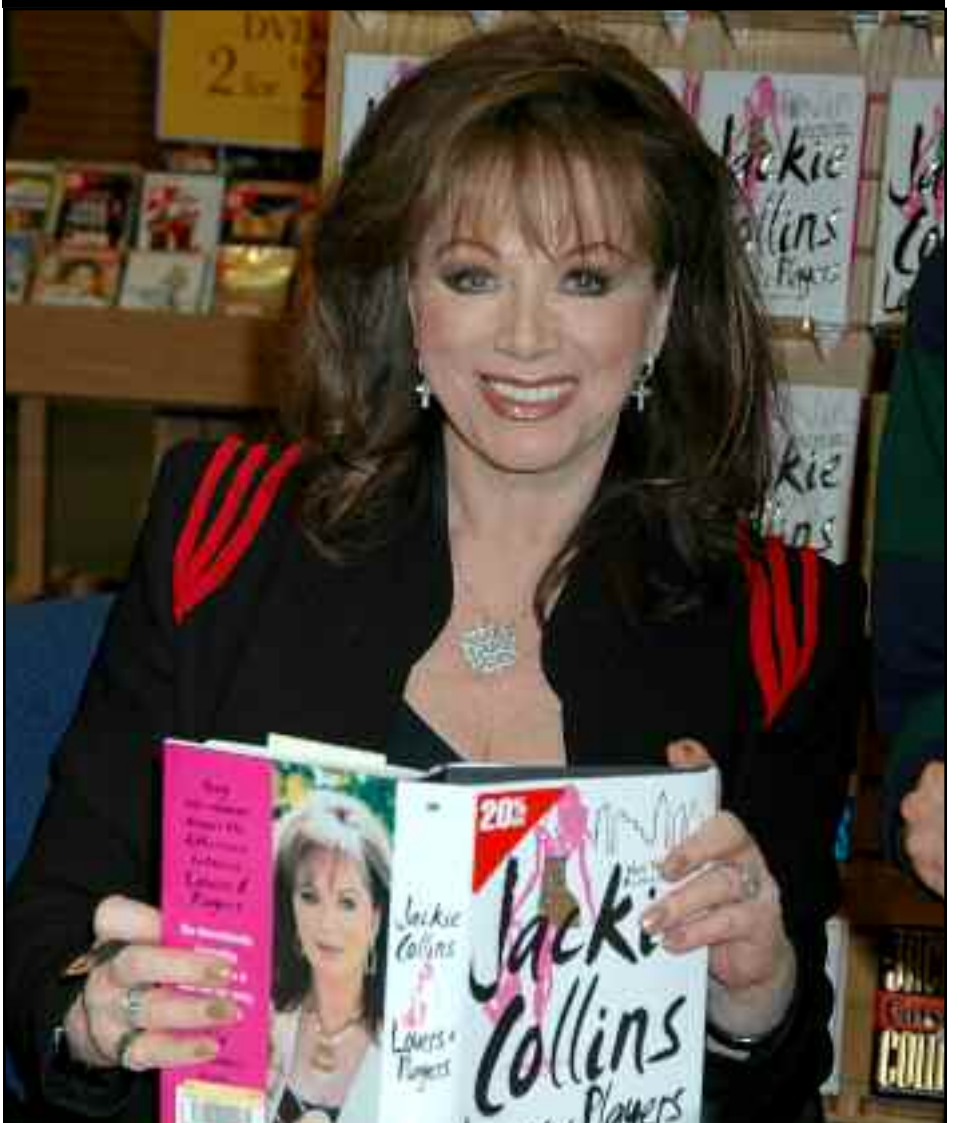
Lydon also talked about the death of his bandmate Sid Vicious, who took a fatal overdose of heroin in 1979. "Sid was my mate and all that, but I watched him slowly destroy himself," he said. "I've got to be honest - it came as no surprise."

He added: "It wasn't overwhelmingly catastrophic he killed himself. Most people who mess about with heroin, they lose their souls way earlier, it's just waiting for the body to keel over."

# Corbyn won't pursue 'Pig Gate'

■ Labour leader not interested in bizarre tales of PM's college days, but says allegations about knowledge of tax deals are more interesting

Jeremy Corbyn has said he is not interested in allegations about what David Cameron did or did not do with a pig while a student at university.

In an interview with the New Statesman magazine Mr Corbyn said he had "absolutely no response at all" to the story and that he was more concerned about allegations regarding knowledge of tax agreements, which made in the same book.

Call Me Dave, an unauthorised biography of Mr Cameron by former Tory treasurer Lord Ashcroft, made a number of allegations about the Prime Minister.

The peer alleges that Mr Cameron knew about his non-domiciled in 2009, stating that Mr Cameron was "fully aware of my status as a so-called non dom."

"Indeed we had a conversation about how we could delay revealing my tax arrangements until after the election," he said.

Mr Ashcroft's non-domiciled tax status became public

knowledge in March 2010. The Prime Minister said at the time he had only known about it for a month.

**private parts**

"I am concerned about the alleged knowledge, or not, of the non-dom status of some of his friends in the House of Lords," Mr Corbyn said.

The "pig" allegations, about which Mr Corbyn has said he has no interest, refers to an allegation that Mr Cameron inserted his private parts into the

head of a dead pig whilst a student at Oxford University, which friends of Cameron say is "utter nonsense".

Lord Ashcroft said in the same book that the claim, allegedly made by an MP who attended the university at the same time as David Cameron, could have been a case of mistaken identity.

Downing Street has declined to comment on any of the allegations made in Lord Ashcroft's book.

The allegations have caused huge amusement

- and some wonderful headlines in the UK this week, with all levels of British society weighing in. But perhaps the most original response came from a Smiths tribute band who released a new song called "This Charming Ham" just days after news of the allegations broke.

**'utter nonsense'**

The band - who go by the name of the Iain Duncan Smiths - reimagine songs from the seminal 1980s British band with a political angle. The hope to capitalize on the - erm - snoutrage of the moment by with a new version of the Morrissey and Johnny Marr song.

Lyrics in the new version of the song include: "Watch as I suckle the decapitated head / Of a pig that has not long been dead".

The band recently released a similar song called 'Pig's Mouth Strikes Again'.

The Iain Duncan Smiths repurpose songs by The Smiths into satirical, political songs with titles including 'How Soon Is NWO?', 'This Balanced Plan', 'Big South Strikes Again' and 'Heaven Knows You're Miserable Now'. They released their debut album, 'Devil's Tunes: The Very Worst Of The Iain Duncan Smiths', last week.


The album is named

after Iain Duncan Smith's 2003 novel The Devil's Tune, which received uniformly negative critical reception.

A Downing Street spokesperson has declined to comment on the Cameron speculation although a party source says that the alleged incident was "utter nonsense".

The book is being serialised this week by the Daily Mail. It is also claimed that Cameron was part of a "dope-smoking group" called the Flam Club who would smoke marijuana and listen to Supertramp together.

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# Tragic Jackie was 'too scared' to see the doc

■ "Completely doctor-phobic" bestselling author couldn't bring herself to see a doctor after finding a lump in her breast

**BEST-SELLING author Jackie Collins, who has died following a battle with breast cancer, avoided seeing a doctor for more than two years after she first suspected she had the killer disease.**

Collins, 77, was a fixture at the very top of Hollywood's social ladder for over two decades, thanks mainly to the success of her salacious sex-and-celebrity tales, which included *Hollywood Wives*, *The World is Full of Married Men* and *The Stud*.

Collins turned to writing after her career as an actress fizzled in the mid-60s - shortly after that of her sister Joan began to take off. Married to producer and nightclub owner Oscar Lerman, she often claimed she got all her ideas from the showbiz world she knew so well - and her career change paid off handsomely - earning her an estimated \$60m from a string of bestsellers over more than two decades.

But after losing three loved ones to cancer Collins preferred to keep her own illness quiet for six years. Indeed she recently confided that she avoided seeing a doctor for more than two years after finding a lump in her breast.

She explained: "I thought, 'I'm not dealing with this,' because in my mind I decided it was benign."

The star found the mass two years before she was diagnosed with stage-four breast cancer in 2009.

She added: "I've had to deal with losing my mother (to breast cancer), my husband (prostate cancer) and my fiancé (lung cancer) and I did not want to put pressure on

everybody in the family. So I happily, happily went day by day."

Although Jackie knew she should seek medical help, she was "completely doctor-phobic" and couldn't bring herself to do so.

While that was her decision, the star spoke out in an attempt to convince other women not to follow in her footsteps.

She said: "Women should get check-ups because it really helps to get diagnosed early. I know we're all told to do it, but some of us are too stupid, and I was one of them."

### shocked

Jackie only told her famous sibling about her illness two weeks before she died. Her sister was understandably shocked but did her best to be supportive, with Jackie admitting she was initially unsure Joan would be able to cope, which was why she didn't share her diagnosis.

Jackie explained: "I would really have affected

her. I just felt she didn't need it in her life.

"She's very positive and very social, but I'm not sure how strong she is, so I didn't want to burden her with it."

And in the last interview she gave before she died, Jackie remained in a firmly optimistic mood. "I couldn't care less about my age," she said. "I'm still here, I love what I do, and I have a passion for it ... it's better than the alternative."

Although her social life had eased up in recent years, during the 1970s and 1980s she could often be found at legendary watering holes in LA and London, including Chasens, The Polo Lounge and of course, Tramp, the Jermyn Street nightclub of which her husband was a founding partner with Londoner Johnny Gold. Tramp also opened a short-lived branch in Beverly Hills in the 1980s, at which Collins could often be seen holding court with celebrity friends including Sidney Poitier and Michael Caine.

After the news broke on

Sunday, her sister Joan posted a picture of herself and Jackie, writing: "Farewell to my beautiful brave baby sister. I will love you and miss you forever. Rest in peace."

Sitting in a London hotel suite recently to discuss her latest book, Jackie had been equally effusive about their bond. "Joan and I are the best of friends....We're very close. People are always trying to pitch us against each other ... Because we're both successful. But we're very different. Joan is incredibly social and flamboyant and she loves to dress up. I'm much more low key and much less likely to go out for lunches and dinners. She loves being out and about, and I love being home, writing."

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# Ginger avenger's bizarre plot to make Harry king

■ The court heard the accused felt alienated and marginalised for being a white, ginger-haired man.

A self-styled "ginger avenger" who fantasised about shooting Prince Charles and Prince William so that Prince Harry could become king has been found guilty of plotting a terror attack "for the Aryan people".

Bullied loner Mark Colborne compared himself to Anders Breivik, the far-right extremist who shot dead 77 children in Norway, and made notes in his diary about his plan to assassinate the heirs to the throne with a sniper rifle.

He copied out sections of The Terrorist Handbook from the internet, and acquired manuals on poisons, jurors were told.

Colborne, 37, was caught after his half-brother Kevin found papers setting out his feelings of racial hatred hidden in his bedroom at the family home in Southampton. He was arrested on June 3 last year.

A jury could not agree a verdict after a trial earlier this year, but following a retrial and lengthy jury deliberations Colborne was today found guilty by a majority verdict of preparing terrorist acts.

While the jury convicted

him of the main charge, it rejected allegations that he possessed chemicals to make cyanide and dimethyl sulphoxide, and that he stockpiled syringes and face masks.

The court heard Colborne felt alienated and marginalised for being a white, ginger-haired man. He suffered from agoraphobia and depression.

## 'opportunity to kill'

He fantasised about hitting back against people who bullied him for having ginger hair, and idolised IRA terrorists because they took violent action against their opponents and were often red-headed, his trial heard.

In his notebook, he wrote: "I don't want to be a serial killer. I'm more of an Anders Breivik. I have left potential targets open.

"I was waiting for an opportunity to kill one of them. Let it be Prince Charles which would be good."

He went on to state that he wanted a "silent rifle", adding: "Take up a good position and put a bullet in Charles's head.

"He is protected but not too protected. I would

sacrifice my life for that one shot. Kill Charles and William and Harry become king. Kill the tyrants."

Annabel Darlow QC, who prosecuted, said Colborne's notes expressed hatred for "non-Aryans" who he referred to as "blacks and Caucasian idiots".

Comparing himself to other right-wing extremists, he wrote: "I'm looking for major retribution, a mass terrorist attack which will bring to the attention our pain not just mine but my brothers around the world."

In his defence, Colborne admitted buying the chemicals and writing the diary, but dismissed entries as "angry rants" made when he was off medication for depression.

He said: "Fantasies about killing people as a hitman - that was my number one fantasy. Terrorism fantasies were sort of subsidiary but my main interest in being a professional hitman had taken over."

Colborne made no reaction in the dock as the verdict was delivered.

Sentencing was adjourned until next month.

## Hygiene-challenged kebab house owners face hefty fines for fecal contamination in their food

The owners of a Midlands kebab shop which sold food contaminated with human faeces have been ordered to pay compensation to customers who became ill.

A rare strain of E. coli - only the second outbreak of its kind in Europe - was found at The Khyber Pass in Nottingham in June 2014.

In August, owners Mohammad Abdul Basit and Amjad Bhatti pleaded guilty to breaching food hygiene regulations.

More than 140 people were affected by the outbreak.

Appearing at Nottingham Crown Court, the owners were each given a suspended four month jail sentence and ordered to pay each victim £200.

### 'Wholly inadequate'

Breaches included selling food unfit for human consumption, poor personal cleanliness of food workers and inadequate hand washing facilities and

drainage.

An investigation by Nottingham City Council led to the discovery that the food poisoning organism responsible was Enteroinvasive E. coli (EIEC).

EIEC is only found in the human gut and so inspectors concluded people affected by the outbreak must have eaten food contaminated with human faeces.

Officials said the outbreak was traced to the restaurant after analysis of faecal specimens from patients.

The same strain of EIEC was found in lettuce prepared by food workers at the takeaway.

Paul Dales, from Nottingham City Council's food, health and safety team, said: "This was a significant and serious food poisoning outbreak affecting a large number of people, some of whom developed severe symptoms.

"It's fortunate there were no fatalities, as this is a strain of E. coli rarely found in the developed world, this being only the second confirmed outbreak in Europe."

"It's clear that hand-washing practices by some workers were wholly inadequate and this led to food becoming contaminated," he added.



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# Ready for a Rollers reunion?

■ 1970s icons ready to rock the tartan once more...

Former 70s boy band Bay City Rollers have announced a reunion, nearly 30 years after splitting up.

During their heyday, the Scottish group sold 120 million records and had a huge teenage fanbase.

Famed for their tartan outfits, the band had several line-ups over the years.

The reunion features three of the "classic five" - Les McKeown, Alan Longmuir and Stuart Wood - who had hits such as Bye Bye Baby and Shang-a-Lang.

They also performed several sell-out tours and hosted their own TV

show.

Wood, McKeown and Longmuir have promised "a very special Christmas present to all the fans that have kept the faith with the band over the years".

It is believed that will include a new album and a comeback show at the Barrowlands in Glasgow in December.

Announcing the reunion at a press conference in Glasgow, singer Les McKeown joked: "You think we're doing it for money but we're doing it for the glory of Scotland and the glory of the tartan."

"Taking the Scottish name all around the globe. That's what we're doing it

for - to see our fans again one more time."

The band formed at the end of the 60s and its first incarnation was two Edinburgh brothers, Alan and Derek Longmuir, who formed a band with their school mates.

They conquered the UK, US, Australia and Japan but music journalist Caroline Sullivan told the BBC that by late 1977 their popularity had waned.

"There is obviously a sell-by date for all boy bands and the Rollers were reaching theirs," she said.

"They had a really good run. The fans were growing up and The Rollers themselves were

# Meaty history: Dorset butcher celebrates 500 years in business

■ Britain's oldest family business celebrated an astonishing milestone this week, surviving wars, floods and even plagues along the way

Each year about 240,000 British businesses collapse.

To survive beyond the first couple of years is an achievement; to celebrate 50 years trading is remarkable. But for a shopkeeper to be able to mark a 500th anniversary is worthy of great celebration - which is precisely what Richard Balson did last weekend.

RJ Balson & Sons, the butcher's shop he owns in the pretty market town of Bridport, Dorset, has survived the Reformation, the English Civil War, the start of the Industrial Revolution, the end of horsepower, the rise of the internet and more recessions than you can shake a black pudding at.

And all the while it's remained within the same family, so that experts have now declared it the oldest family company in Britain.

"It's unbelievable," he agrees, in a Dorset accent

steeped in brawn and chitterlings. To mark the occasion he threw a party at Bridport Town Hall. There were 300 guests, plenty of wine and canapés served by women "dressed as Tudor wenches" (in Balson's own words).

## antiquity

His shop remains a fairly small establishment in a space the business has occupied only since the 19th century; before then it operated out of various local pubs (a common distribution method for butchers in Georgian and Victorian England).

And before that the family had a market stall in the Bridport Shambles, shambles being an ancient name for a shelf, on which meat was slaughtered and then sold.

The proof of the company's antiquity rests on a document from September 1515, which granted one Robert

Balson the right to operate two shambles in return for "five shillings of legal money to be paid at the feasts of Easter and St Michael the Archangel."

On sale now is a mixture of novelty and old-fashioned fare. Packs of beef dripping share space with sliced chorizo.

There is a freezer of game: some traditional, like venison and rabbit, some exotic, like bison, zebra, crocodile, ostrich and kangaroo.

But it's not just staying abreast of TV-fuelled trends that has allowed the company to keep its head above water in an age when many small retailers, especially fishmongers, grocers and butchers, have gone to the wall.

From the early 1990s to the mid-2000s, butcher numbers tumbled from 15,000 to around 6,000, a drop of 60 per cent, according to Meat Trades Journal, though in the last couple of years figures

have stabilised.

Balson is clear that he can fight against the supermarkets. "The main thing is personal service. When you come in, you get a nice welcome, you say, 'how's your mum?', 'how's your daughter?'

Most of the people who come in, we've served their parents before them, and their grandparents before that and they like to be asked.

"You're not going to get that personal experience in a supermarket. Who

wants to queue up for 20 minutes before you even get to the checkout?"

In any case, if a shop has outlived 23 monarchs and 52 prime ministers, it probably stands a fighting chance of surviving the rise and Tesco and Aldi.

## THAT'S RICH: Downton's Dower House sells for £6m

**THIS WEEK sees the TV premiere of the final series of Downton Abbey in the UK, and the owners of one of the show's iconic properties is certainly cashing in on the moment.**

Byfleet Manor, known in the show as the Dower House, home to Lady Violet Crawley, the dowager played by Dame Maggie Smith, has been sold for a eye-watering £6m (\$9.128m).

Built in 1686, the Surrey manse has been a familiar backdrop to the Downton action for five years.

The 17th-century house was put on the market in May for £3.95 million, alongside four additional lots in the grounds - three more residential properties and a development plot. And now, the entire estate has been snapped up by a British buyer after attracting interest from around the globe.

Simon Ashwell, head of posh local realtor Savills Weybridge, said: "Houses like this are rare to the market so it wasn't surprising that Byfleet Manor went under offer within 12 weeks of coming to the market."

The home was sold by local business woman Julie Hatton, who bought it some 10 years ago for about £1 million.

"We're thrilled the buyer has purchased all five lots, rather than the

main house being separated from the remainder of this historic estate, which has connections to The Domesday Book as well as Downton Abbey," says Ashwell.

New research from Halifax reveals Downton's 'halo effect' extends to homes located close to stately homes - with house prices around stately homes growing at double the rate of the national average over the last 10 years.

"It can cost home buyers, on average, £41,000 extra to live nearby to a stately home compared to neighbouring areas," says Housing Economist at Halifax, Martin Ellis.

Byfleet Manor is set in sprawling grounds of almost 20 acres and offers extensive 6,000sq ft of living space, spread over four floors.

Thanks to its grand proportions and fine period architecture, the mansion has played a starring role in two other well-known period dramas, *Poirot* and *Cranford*.

But the estate once belonged to royalty, passing through the hands of King Edward I and Henry VIII. The Queen Consort Anne of Denmark, wife of King James I, was its last royal owner.

The Wallis' Board Chairman Jerry Magnin announced Mr. Crewes' appointment as the Company's first Artistic Director this week as the Board voted to approve the Search Committee's recommendation of Mr. Crewes, whose contract begins October 1, 2015. He will assume full-time

artistic leadership in April 2016.

"In just two years, The Wallis has risen to a premiere position in LA's lively performing arts landscape and Paul is the perfect person to guide The Wallis to a new level of prominence," said Mr. Magnin. The workshops took place 'in the spirit of cheerful anarchy and casually slipped into performance, and finally the production of shows,' according to the Kneehigh's website. "Proudly, we now find ourselves celebrated as one of Britain's most exciting new touring theatre companies."

As for Mr. Crewes, he finds himself facing the delicious prospect of a new life among the movers and shakers in Beverly Hills. He said of his appointment: "As we can see from last season's many successes, The Wallis is at the beginning of a very exciting journey...Every time I visit The Wallis I feel passionate about the opportunities that exist for this amazing organization in the heart of Beverly Hills."

Meet Jesse V. Johnson, from Windsor, who moved to LA 22 years ago to pursue filmmaking.

## Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

There has always been something intoxicating and seductive about LA. For a 21 year-old who ate, slept and lived movies, it was about finally being around other people your age who had come here for the same reasons, had similar passions, it was wonderful, really a love affair that has never really grown old for me.

## What do you miss most from home?

I missed my family growing up, the frost on a winter's morning. The sense of medieval promise that permeates the English countryside, legends in the ancient oaks and Arthurian whispers in the

## What was your first impression of LA and has it changed since? If so why?

LA was and is still a "sunny" place for me, always full of promise and excitement, and potential. Every day is an exciting adventure waiting to happen. Thrilling, ambitious, living in the UK never ever felt this way.

## Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?

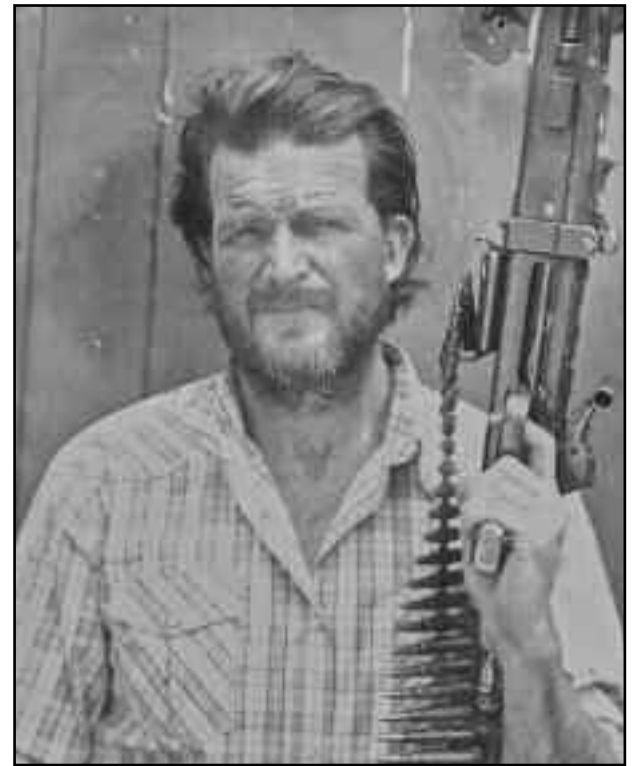
When I am pining for British food the Robin Hood pub in Sherman Oaks has a store next door that sells English comfort food. The food is excellent, and very traditional - my daughters love it too, and pleasing those two is a challenge in and of itself. Cycling the dirt track by Mulholland from Encino and the Nike tower to Canoga with my youngest daughter - it

feels like you're in the wilds, but really just around the corner.

## What would you suggest to others who are thinking about making the move here?

I would say, as in all things, do your homework, and be prepared to work hard, very hard. Harder than the next guy or gal. My initial months in LA, were spent driving from production office to production office, six different resumes in hand, various departments on a film set, and just smiling, shaking hands, making telephone calls, until I was hired, and keeping that momentum going, I was twenty-one and full of beans when I arrived, and loved every second of it - but that sort of thing isn't for everybody.

It really didn't change too much when I started directing a few years later, I still try to work harder than the next director. I would say, visit, and spend time here, make sure it is everything you think it is - it is certainly no longer the mecca of film production, and it's more expensive to live here than many states that

have much more production going on. If you are hankering for it, I would recommend moving though, the world is just better when you have travelled and lived in a few countries. If it doesn't go right and you lose everything, well then you have the adventure of building it all up again - I have lost everything more than once, and as much as it sets you back and shakes your foundations you have to be ready to live, I have also taken incredible risks that have paid off, usually more often than

they fail. It is all less important than you think, looking back, regret is pretty much the only thing I try to avoid - fruitlessly, I might add.

## If your your life was a TV show what would be the theme tune and why?

I feel a lot of empathy for Ray Donovan when I see that show - I'm not sure if it's still playing. My eldest daughter would say The Osbournes.

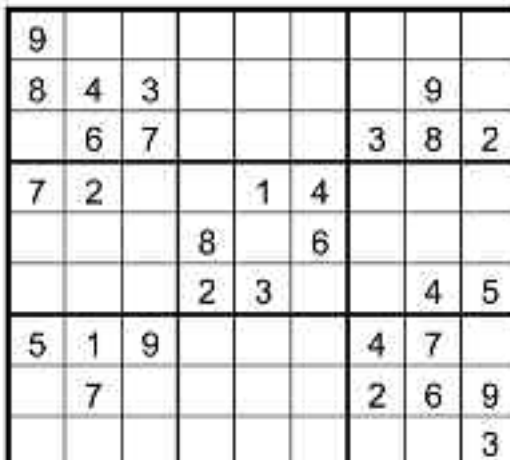

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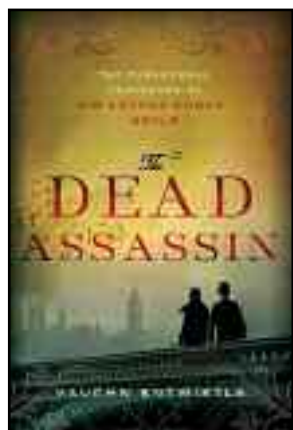
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## The Dead Assassin: Conan Doyle and Oscar Wilde ride again...

Exclusive interview  
with author Vaughn  
Entwistle and a  
review of the second

"I have been a lifelong Sherlock Holmes fan and Sir Arthur Conan Doyle was a personal hero of mine," says *The Dead Assassin* author Vaughn Entwistle. "Every detective needs a Watson, mainly in order to explain the plot to the reader. Originally, I was going to team Conan Doyle with C.J. Barrie, the author of *Peter Pan*. I wrote a test scene where the two authors met at the Savoy. As I was riffing on the idea, I thought it would be fun to have Oscar Wilde enter the restaurant. However, Wilde's overwhelming



personality didn't just steal the scene, he hijacked the entire novel. The combination of the brash and flamboyant Wilde with the staid and sober Conan Doyle set the pages on fire. I knew I had found my sleuthing duo."

In this second book in the *The Paranormal Casebooks of Sir Arthur Conan Doyle*, Entwistle brings detailed descriptions about where and what. Having Oscar Wilde join Doyle for sleuthing is an ingenious

pairing. The reboot of Holmes and Watson is a must-read for fans. However, it could have made more of an emotional connection.

Scotland Yard has Dr. Arthur Conan Doyle analyze a crime scene that has baffled them. A senior member of Her Majesty's government has been brutally murdered. Next to him is the body of Charlie Higginbotham, a known pickpocket and petty thief. However, Higginbotham was hanged at Newgate Prison for his crimes two weeks prior. Conan Doyle and his friend Oscar Wilde find themselves swept up in an investigation so bizarre it defies conventional thinking and puts the lives of their loved ones, the nation, and even the monarch herself in peril.

"The fog became another character in *The Dead Assassin*, hindering

Conan Doyle and Wilde's investigation while cloaking the nefarious deeds of the murderers," says Entwistle. "Everyone knows about the famous London fogs. But my research showed just how deadly they were. London sits on a marshy, low-lying ground and has always had fogs. But Victorian fogs were actually smogs, a combination of fog and smoke from thousands of chimneys burning coal."

To write about two such well-known authors, Entwistle did extensive research. "By the time I came to write the novel I was so immersed in the characters I was having dreams in which they talked to me. While writing, I keep a small book of Wilde's witticisms next to my keyboard and read a few pages before commencing work each

morning. Since writing my first novel, *The Angel of Highgate*, I have been living a large part of my life in the Victorian era. I read the diaries and collected letters of both Conan Doyle and Oscar Wilde to gain insight into the way they actually spoke and thought."

*The Angel of Highgate* will be published by Titan Books in December, and the author is currently writing the third book in series, *The Faerie Vortex*, in which Doyle and Wilde investigate the mysterious disappearance of two young girls whose mother claims they have been abducted by faeries. He's also writing a collection of ghost stories.

Entwistle lives in the city of Wells in Somerset. When he landed his book deal, he and his wife moved to England. "As a writer who specializes in historical fiction, much of

which takes place in England, it is much easier to carry out research and actually walk the ground of the places I write about," her says. He had lived in Seattle for twenty years and was born in Weston, Ontario, Canada to British parents.

Scott (pictured, above) 77, told a German entertainment website that the two franchises would eventually dovetail into



one another. The next installment will see Michael Fassbender and Noomi Rapace return to reprise the roles they occupied for the 2012 original.

"It will not be the next [film]" the director said. "It will be in the next but one Prometheus or perhaps even in a later film, before we are, in a sense, back in the Alien franchise."

Scott directed the first 'Alien' in 1979, which expanded into three sequels.

The first 'Prometheus' was billed as an Alien prequel in its own right, and received a mixed reception from critics and the public.

"The whole point [of Prometheus] is to explain the Alien franchise and how and why the aliens were created," said Scott.

"I always saw the Alien as a type of biological warfare. For me, the original spaceship, which I call the 'croissant', is a warship containing these biomechanoid creatures, which are all about destruction," he added.

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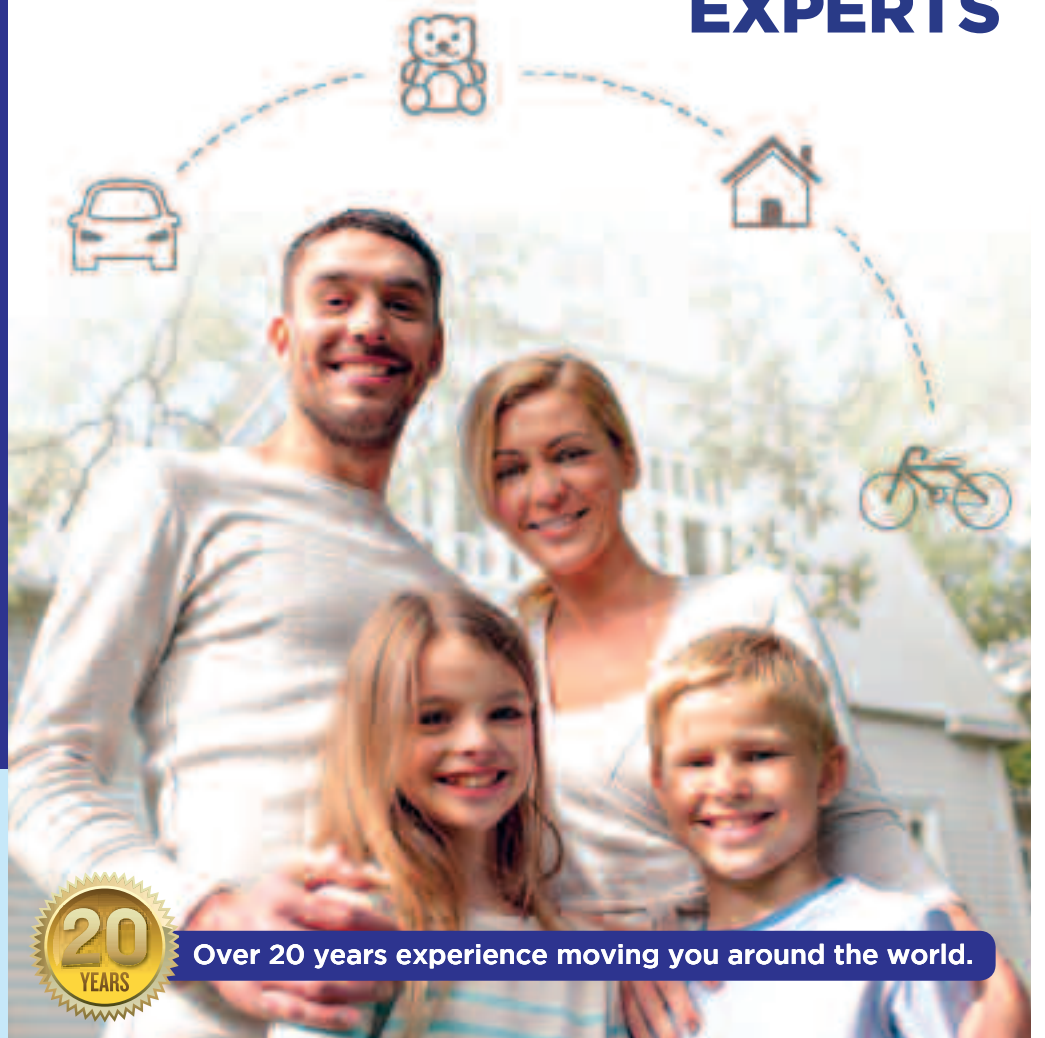

## Eva leaves Blues; legal action to follow?

**THE EVA Carneiro rumbled on this week after it was announced that the doctor has parted company with Chelsea.** She is now reportedly considering legal actions against the club after she had her role reduced following a spat with manager Jose Mourinho in the opening game with Swansea.

Mourinho was upset with Carneiro, 42, and head physiotherapist Jon Fearn for entering the field of play during the 2-2 draw to treat Eden

Hazard.

The Portuguese was visibly furious with their actions, and ran from his technical area to berate them. He later followed that by criticising Carneiro and Fearn in three separate media interviews, accusing them of not understanding the game.

The Football Association has confirmed it is looking into a complaint that the Chelsea manager used abusive language toward Carneiro, who has not

been seen on the Blues' bench since the incident.

Carneiro seems to have inflamed matters by a Facebook post she made the following day, thanking all those who had expressed support for her actions amid a flurry of social media criticism of Mourinho's actions.

Chelsea do not comment on internal staffing matters, but Carneiro has not reported for duty since her reprimand, while Fearn has continued to work.

Carneiro, who was due to return to work last Friday, could have grounds to launch claims of constructive dismissal and sex discrimination, and is reportedly considering her legal options.

She joined Chelsea in February 2009, having previously worked at the British Olympic Medical Institute and with England Women's Football and UK Athletics.

## Spurs left counting the cost after Gooner fans damage the Lane

Tottenham Hotspur have begun an urgent programme of repairs to White Hart Lane that will run into the thousands of pounds after discovering serious damage to seats as well as hoardings following the visit of Arsenal on Wednesday.

A total of 10 fans have already been arrested by the Metropolitan Police after the outbreak of disorder and vandalism in the away end of Tottenham's ground (pictured, above) that immediately followed Arsenal's 2-1 victory.

Arsenal supporters ripped up hoardings that ran around part of the middle section of the



stadium and Tottenham discovered on Thursday morning that many seats had also been destroyed. Work has already begun on repairing the damage and Spurs expect the stadium to be back to normal by the time of Manchester City's visit in the Premier League this weekend.

The hoardings had displayed various club

slogans, including the message, 'Tottenham Hotspur This Is My Club'. Both clubs are now helping police to identify the culprits and all available video footage will be passed onto the authorities.

Fans found to have indulged in criminal damage are also facing the prospect of a banning order from football.

## Tension high ahead of England-Wales clash

**THE RUGBY WORLD Cup is in full swing and this weekend's big showdown sees England facing Wales in what could be defining match for both teams.**

England are favorites given their impressive opener against Fiji last Friday and because of a sudden injury crisis for Warren Gatland's men. And memories are still fresh of the so-called Cardiff calamity of March 2013, when Wales scored their biggest Test victory over the ancient enemy since 1905: a 30-3 hammering that blew a hole in coach Stuart Lancaster's reforms and sent England reeling back across the Severn.

The shock of that defeat was haunting at the time and is still visible now, even though England have beaten Wales twice since in the Six Nations Championship. And at the final press conference ahead of the clash England's head coach betrayed his anxieties about facing Gatland's

block defence and midfield stampede.

"A game against Wales in my experience is like no other," Lancaster said. "In terms of the intensity and the pressure that builds around it, you can build another 10%. More than that, probably, as it's a World Cup. Fifty per cent. One hundred per cent."

Despite England's recent success with a more buccaneering approach, Lancaster's tactics this time seem more likely to be avoiding risk – this despite having home advantage and a long Welsh injury list.

"They are well-coached, well-prepared, extremely well-motivated and they have got eight or nine British Lions," Lancaster says. In the television interviews he went further: "It started with my first experience at Twickenham - and we lost that game. But more ingrained on my mind is the game when we went to the Millennium

Stadium [in 2013].

"I had been involved in 10 or 15 international games at that point as head coach but it was a totally different level in terms of the atmosphere and the intensity. From that point onwards you began to appreciate what the game means to both sets of fans. It means a lot to the Welsh but equally to the English as well. You then layer on the fact it is a Rugby World Cup, and the Pool we are in..."

"Wales are a very difficult side to play against home and away, and they have a very specific defensive system and are very hard to break down. There is very little width on the wings and a lot of our strengths of playing against them are playing through the line rather than playing around them."

England are currently ranked third in the world quoted at 4/1 to win the tournament. England vs Wales is scheduled for Noon GMT on Saturday, Sept. 26th.



# Brendan at the brink!

■ Anelotti and Klopp rumored to be waiting in the wings as Reds endure miserable start to the new season

Liverpool's owners have finally run out of patience with Brendan Rodgers and want Carlo Anelotti to replace him, according to at least one report from Merseyside.

The Reds barely managed to squeeze past not-so-mighty Carlisle on penalties in the Capital One Cup third round this week, and their performance was greeted by boos from the Anfield faithful at full time, after extra time and even after

they had managed to limp through on spot kicks, 3-2.

Rodgers' side have picked up just eight points from their opening six matches in the Premier league, this after the former Reading boss barely held onto his job at the end of last season after a dismal run of results and spent around £80million in the summer in a bid to return the Reds to the Champions League.

M e r s e y s i d e

correspondent Graham Beecroft told TalkSPORT he believes Wednesday night's stale performance was the final straw for team owners Fenway Sports Group.

"John W Henry would have looked at that performance and thought, 'this is not good enough and a change has to be made', and I understand that is going to happen," Beecroft told the Alan Brazil Sports Breakfast.

## TOON CRISIS: Ashley to stick by McClaren

DESPITE Newcastle United's woeful start to the season club owner Mike Ashley WILL stay loyal to Steve McClaren and give him time to turn it around.

Ashley has reportedly given assurances to the former England manager, under-fire managing director Lee Charnley and chief scout Graham Carr as they draw up plans for a risky January overhaul of the first-team squad.

Carr and Charnley have attracted intense criticism for the way they have conducted player recruitment, focusing entirely on young players from abroad, with head coach Steve McClaren floundering as he tries to improve results.

The quality of the four players signed in the summer at a cost of more than £50 million – players described as "exceptional" and capable of making an "immediate impact" by Charnley in an email to season ticket holders – has also been questioned. Carr was responsible for recommending all of them and his recent track record in the transfer market is poor.

But Ashley is determined to show he will not be swayed by public pressure or media criticism and will sanction more signings in the January window.

Carr, though, could be replaced in the summer as

he is almost 71 and McClaren will argue the case for a more innovative technical or sporting director to help Charnley with recruitment.

The transfer kitty will be supplemented by player sales, with McClaren keen to rid the dressing room of the players whose poor attitude, flimsy commitment and flaky mentality has left him facing calls for his removal after just eight games on Tyneside.

McClaren may have defended them publicly, but Newcastle are expected to listen to offers for Cheick Tioté, Papiss Cissé, Gabriel
