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# IRAQ REPORT: nine months wait ahead

- David Cameron 'immensely frustrated' by delay in glacially slow Chilcot report
- Tony Blair's office denies former PM had any role in delay in inquiry's findings

THE LONG-AWAITED Chilcot inquiry report into Britain's participation in the Iraq War may finally be made public next summer....thirteen years after the conflict began.

Sir John Chilcot, chair of the inquiry and a former high ranking civil servant, announced on Thursday that his report - all 2m words of it - would be made public in June or July next year, pending security clearance of its content.

The report's progress has been glacial for many bereaved families

and for others eager for a forensic spotlight to be shone on what they consider the manipulation of intelligence by Tony Blair's government. And the news this week that the wait will be at least another nine months prompted David Cameron to say he was "immensely frustrated"

on behalf of families who lost loved ones in the war after the former mandarin said he would complete his work seven years after Gordon Brown set up the inquiry.

### national security

In a letter to the prime minister this week Chilcot said the text of his report should be finalized in the week of 18 April 2016. He then promised to hand the document over to officials, who will be allowed to conduct national security checks before its publication which should take place in June or July.

Chilcot preempted criticism of his decision to allow officials to clear the report by saying it was necessary to avoid an inadvertent breach of

national security and to ensure there had been no breach of article two of the European convention on human rights (ECHR), the right to life.

In his letter, Chilcot said: "National security checking is distinct from the process of declassifying material for disclosure in the inquiry's report. Its purpose is to ensure that the government's obligations under article two of the ECHR and for the protection of national security will not be inadvertently breached by publication of the inquiry's report as a whole.

### right to reply

Tony Blair's office denied that he was the cause of the delay. The former prime minister's spokeswoman made clear that he replied in August this year after receiving documents in January from the Chilcot enquiry as part the process in which witnesses who are to be criticized are given a right to reply. The documents sent to Blair were understood to have run to thousands of pages.

Cameron made no attempt to hide his irritation: "I am immensely frustrated by

the slowness and amount of time it has taken, he said. "I am not frustrated on my own behalf. I am frustrated for the mums and the dads who lost loved ones and who want to know what happened and why it happened and want to make sure that the lessons are learnt."

Cameron played down the significance of the vetting of the report on national security grounds. He said: "On Chilcot, we will follow absolutely the required method of responding to independent inquiries, where they arrive on the government's desk, there is a very brief bout of national security checking that has to be

carried out.

"When we had the Saville inquiry – which was an even longer inquiry into Bloody Sunday – I think it took two weeks for my office to make sure that was turned around and published. I'll publish it as quick as I possibly can. I know how long people have waited, they don't want to have to wait any longer."

### pressure

Publication has been held up by two factors. Chilcot was involved in a lengthy wrangle with two successive cabinet secretaries, Gus O'Donnell and Sir Jeremy Heywood, over the publication of correspondence between

Blair and George W Bush.

This focused on whether Blair provided undertakings to the US president in the run-up to the Iraq invasion in

2003 – around the time of his visit to Bush in Crawford, Texas, in April 2002 – that Britain would join US forces. Blair has always said he gave no definitive

commitment to the US and actually succeeded in putting pressure on the White House to seek UN authority in the autumn and winter of 2002.

## SPIES NEEDED: MI6 turns to parenting website

**BRITAIN'S shadowy secret intelligence service has found an unlikely new arena from which to draw new recruits – the wildly popular UK parenting site Mumsnet.com**

In a sign of growing gender equality in one of the last bastions of male supremacy, MI6 is recruiting a new breed of female intelligence officer, and their recent ad on the website has received a LOT of attention from potential Moneypennys.

The ad went up on the parenting site on October 21 and stresses the 'importance of discretion'.

The ad went on: "In today's world, intelligence is drawn from sources as diverse as satellites and seismic sensors, social media and SMS. Yet human intelligence, gathered in the field, will always have immense significance and value. As an Intelligence Officer you could play a wide range of roles at the heart of our work – from analysing intelligence to planning operations to working in the field overseas.

The Secret Intelligence Service also stipulates: 'You should not discuss your application with anyone other than your

partner or a close family member.'

Mumsnet CEO Justine Roberts said MI6 had first placed the ad on the site in May – and it received more applications than any other job advertised on the website.

Asked why parents might make perfect spies, she said they were 'used to having eyes in the back of their heads and being invisible, once you reach a certain age'.

The ad has received a lot of attention from mums already.

One woman writes: 'I could be a spy. I think I'd be really good. I'm very

good at sitting quietly yet taking everything in. And I can remember conversations word for word. Can't drive though.'

Another comments: 'I do it IF I got Daniel Craig or Matt Damon as my side-kick.'

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### Internet fame for brave pensioners who foiled Salford robbery

TWO have-a-go pensioners who foiled an armed robber have become internet sensations after a video clip of their bravery went viral.

Ron Smith, 78, and Robert Anderson, 72, held a shop door shut, trapping a knife-wielding thug who was trying to steal from the till.

It led to the arrest of 19-year-old Liam Redford, who was jailed for two years.

The courageous action of Ron and Robert was captured by a CCTV camera and has been viewed online 21 million times all over the world.

Ron said: "Blimey, I'm speechless. I have had people contact me from America and Scandinavia about the video.

"People say we were heroes but I would hope anyone would have done what I did."

The drama unfolded last December at a convenience store in Salford.

Ron recalled: 'I was just walking past the shop and looked in and saw this lad holding a big knife at a girl behind the counter.

"I thought, he's not getting out while I'm here." Robert, who was nearby, went to help when he realised what was going on.

Redford had filled a bag with £450 in cash and cigarettes worth £200.

But but when Ron and Robert refused to let him out of the shop he threw his haul at the assistant and pleaded: "Tell them to open the door. "I just want to go, you can have your money."

He then escaped through a bedroom window but was caught by builders who went to the aid of the pensioners.

# Top Gear's Clarkson threatened with jail as Argentina reopens Falklands car row

## ■ Clarkson and Top Gear programme chiefs face a worst case scenario of three years in prison after three appeal judges order reactivation of the case

Jeremy Clarkson's hopes of putting the infamous Top Gear Falklands row behind him were dashed this week after a court probe was reopened in Argentina.

A judge in the southern city of Ushuaia had thwarted attempts to have the former BBC presenter charged with falsification in April after the controversial number-plate on the Porsche he drove was swapped ahead of a riot.

But state prosecutors appealed Maria Cristina Barrionuevo's decision not to press ahead with a full-scale criminal investigation against Clarkson and his ex-Top Gear team.

And now the probe is back on - with Clarkson and programme chiefs facing a worst case scenario of three years in prison - after three appeal judges sided with prosecutors and ordered Barrionuevo to reactivate the case.

### violent disturbances

The decision raises the real prospect of the high-profile presenter and his former Top Gear co-hosts Richard Hammond and James May being summoned to give evidence in the city they fled in October last year before programme technicians and camera crews were caught in violent disturbances as they tried to escape to Chile.

Falklands war veteran Osvaldo Hillar, who prompted the court probe by filing an official

complaint over the number-plate change on Clarkson's car, has already been called to give evidence.

The motormouth presenter sparked anger last year after driving through Argentina on a 1,400-mile road trip for a Top Gear Christmas special in a red Porsche with the number plate H982 FKL on it.

War vets accused Clarkson, who once drove through an Indian slum in a Jaguar fitted with a toilet, of goading them over the Falklands.

### 'malicious mockery'

An Argentine politician also made the improbably claim that the digits 269 on the number plate of the Ford Mustang Richard Hammond drove were close to the 255 Britons killed during the war - and the numbers 646 on James May's Lotus could be taken as a reference to the 649 Argentinian casualties.

The Top Gear team ended up having to cut short filming and flee the country with a police escort after being told to leave by angry locals who stormed their five-star hotel in Ushuaia and threatened to kill him.

Clarkson and his co-hosts flew to the capital Buenos Aires before returning to Britain.

Nearly 30 other members of the film crew were stoned as they headed for Chile by road and had to abandon Clarkson's Porsche and

the other two cars by the side of the road.

The number plate that sparked calls for a full criminal probe - HI VAE - was found on the battered Porsche which was attacked by a furious mob after it was left at the side of the road.

The furore sparked a diplomatic incident with Argentina's ambassador Alicia Castro calling the H982 FKL plate "malicious mockery" of those who fought in the 1982 Falklands War.

Maria Cristina Barrionuevo rubbished claims by the BBC and the controversial presenter the use of the plate H982 FKL on

Clarkson's infamous Porsche was an "unfortunate coincidence."

She also dubbed the decision to drive through southern Argentina with the vehicle "arrogant and disrespectful."

But she rejected calls to launch an official probe into the Top Gear team over the number plate change, concluding programme chiefs had acted to avert more conflict and had not been motivated by "bad faith."

The three appeal judges nullified her decision and ordered her to reopen the case - at the request of state prosecutor Daniel

Curtale - after a private hearing in the nearby city of Rio Grande.

Prosecutors claim the Top Gear team committed a crime under article 289 of the Argentinian Penal Code which carries a prison sentence of between six months and three years for those who "falsify, alter or suppress the number of an object registered in accordance with the law."

The BBC has consistently denied suggestions the Porsche was bought for its number plate, or the number plate was changed after it was purchased.

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# When Harry met Barry...

## ■ Prince joins President and First Lady promoting Invictus Games for wounded veterans

Prince Harry met with US president Barack Obama during a visit to the US to promote the Invictus Games this week.

The prince met Mr Obama in the Oval Office of the White House for an informal chat after earlier joining Michelle Obama to meet injured service personnel in Virginia.

The Games are an international event for injured and sick service personnel.

The first Invictus Games took place in London last year, with the next due in Orlando, Florida, next year.

During his visit with the First Lady the prince took in a game of wheelchair basketball, watching former soldiers take part in a very different type of combat. At one point the prince caught the basketball and handed it to her. The pair share the same passion - helping injured servicemen. But the pair, who have met several times, can also share a joke. Addressing the women present, she said: "Don't pretend you haven't noticed Prince Harry is here."

The hundreds

gathered were told that sport had changed the lives of many injured servicemen. Max Rohn, who lost his leg in Iraq in 2009, said Harry's support meant the world to him. Sport, he said, gave him the hope he was missing.

Prince Harry and the first lady were joined by Jill Biden, the US vice-president's wife, for a tour of the purpose-built United Service Organizations Warrior and Family Center at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, which supports troops, their families and carers.

They joined an art therapy class for veterans then visited a music therapy room.

They also watched a sports event before giving speeches.

### 'Personal sacrifices'

In his speech, Prince Harry said his deployments to Afghanistan "changed the direction" of his life.

He said that after returning to the UK on a flight with three critically injured British soldiers, he realised he had "a responsibility to help all veterans, who had made huge personal sacrifices

for their countries, to lead healthy and dignified lives after service."

He added: "I hope that Invictus 2016 will remind people everywhere just how incredible our service personnel are, and how much of a positive contribution to society they make.

"I am sure the American public will embrace the Invictus Games, just as the British public did in 2014."

Prince Harry founded the Invictus Games after seeing a similar event, the Warrior Games, held in the US in 2013.

He said the aim was to change perceptions of physical and mental injury.

"One thing we have to talk about more is breaking down these barriers around so-called invisible injuries, like post-traumatic stress, just as we have for physical injuries like the loss of a limb," he said.

"We have to help [veterans] to get the support they need, without fear of being judged or discriminated against. Not only is it OK to talk about it, we have to talk about it."

The White House drop-in marked Prince Harry's first meeting with President Obama, but it is not the first time

he has met the first lady. They previously attended a White House event to support military families in 2013, and met

this summer at Kensington Palace during Mrs Obama's tour of the UK for her Let Girls Learn initiative.

## Five Britons in whale watching tragedy named

FIVE Britons who died when a whale-watching boat sank off the coast of western Canada earlier this week have been named.

David Thomas, 50, and his son Down's Syndrome child Stephen, 17, from Swindon were among those who died. Stephen's mother Julie was rescued from the boat, which capsized in clear conditions off the coast of British Columbia.

Nigel Hooker, 63, from Southampton, Salford-born Jack Slater, 76, who had lived in Canada for many years and Katie Taylor, 29, also died.

Canadian government investigators are looking into the cause of the accident.

All five of the victims were on the open, upper deck of the boat, but were not wearing life jackets, regional coroner Matt Brown told a news conference.

The other passengers were all in an enclosed part of the boat.

Officials have said more of the 27 people on board could have died had it not been for the "amazing response" from locals around Tofino.

A 27-year-old Australian man from Sydney is still missing after the accident on Sunday afternoon.

### 'Shocked and saddened'

The Down's Syndrome Association described Stephen Thomas as "a very talented young man and a gifted photographer".

Isambard Community School in Swindon also paid tribute to former pupil Stephen.

Headteacher Sue Banks said he was "always a positive role model for others - he never used the term 'I can't' and was constantly smiling".

She said he had a love for art and his work was regularly exhibited in the school and sold at the annual art show.

David Thomas worked for Microsoft. A statement from the

company said they were "shocked and saddened" to hear the news.

Michel Van der Bel, Microsoft UK general manager, said: "Our thoughts and deepest sympathies are with their family, friends and David's colleagues and we will be doing everything we can to support them."

Mr Slater's family said he was a retired navy engineer from Toronto, who had lived in Canada for over 30 years and had three daughters. He was on the boat with his wife, Marjorie, who is being treated in hospital.

His daughter Michele Slater Brown wrote on Facebook he was "larger than life, a charmer, handsome, entrepreneur, engineer in the Navy... he was our dad, our lovely dad, I will miss him forever but I'm grateful for all the times I spent with him, I love you dad."

Ms Taylor was also a British ex-pat living in the ski resort of Whistler.



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# Palace date for Lamps

Former England and Chelsea midfielder Frank Lampard has been awarded an OBE by the Duke of Cambridge for services to football.

Speaking outside Buckingham Palace after his investiture this week, he said the honour was a huge personal achievement.

He said: "It ranks right up there with my achievements on the pitch and what I won with Chelsea in particular and playing for my country.

"To receive an award like this amongst some very special people here in the military, people that are doing a lot of good work in charity - it was very humbling for me to be involved and to be amongst them."

Lampard spent six years at West Ham before moving to Chelsea in 2001, going on to make more than 400 appearances for them.

The football star, who now plays for American team New York City FC,

said he had discussed his Chelsea career with the Duke, whom he described as an "incredible man".

"He gives so much time to everybody, he talks to everyone and we just chatted a bit of Chelsea, a bit of England, a bit of America.

"It was very brief because people are coming through quickly but we chatted a bit of football. I know he knows his football. He's been involved with the England team so he's very up on it."

# Scots left stunned by school stabbing death

SCOTLAND was left stunned this week by the stabbing death of a 16-year-old Aberdeen schoolboy.

Bailey Gwynne, described as "a special son, brother, grandson and friend" died of his wounds after an argument with another teenager at the highly-rated Cults Academy school on Wednesday afternoon. A 16-year-old suspect has been detained by police.

Head teacher Anna Muirhead said the victim was "very gentle" and "caring" and pupils and staff were in a "state of total shock".

She added: "I think it is fair to say the whole school community is totally devastated but at the moment, of course, our thoughts are with the boy's family."

In an emotional statement, the schoolboy's relatives

said: "There are no words. Bailey is our beloved boy and our heart. Our hearts have gone with him."

"He will always be our boy. We don't know what we will do without our junior 'man about the house'."

At a press conference on Thursday afternoon, Ch Supt Adrian Watson confirmed that Police Scotland were not looking for anyone else in relation to the death and that further details of the charge facing the 16-year-old would be given when he appeared in court on Friday.

Friends and fellow pupils laid floral tributes outside Cults Academy throughout Thursday and many attended a vigil at the nearby parish church in the evening.

Young people came to the school gates in small groups or individually, some visibly upset, to

push their bouquets through the wire fencing to build up a display of bright blooms.

As heavy rain battered the plastic wrappings throughout the day, one boy spoke of his shock as the news of the fatal stabbing spread through the school. "It's a very good school, I've always felt safe there," he said.

Around 400 of Bailey's friends and fellow school pupils gathered to remember him at Cults Parish Church.

The place was packed out, with many having to sit in the aisles, as over 100 candles were lit, tears shed, messages written and memories shared.

Unlike traditional services, tea, coffee and cake was served and chairs were laid out to encourage people to sit and talk in groups.

Current and former pupils, parents, members of the local Cults

community and church elders moved around the room adding their messages of support throughout the vigil.

Bailey is said to have uttered the word 'stabbed' as he fell to the

ground after what has been described as a 'pointless fight which got out of hand'.

Teachers and pupils fought to keep the teenager alive before he was taken by ambulance

to Aberdeen Royal Infirmary, where he later died.

Bailey, a fifth year pupil, lived in the village of Maryculter with his four brothers, and their mother, Kate.

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# Fasten your seat belts: Gervais is back for Globes

Comedian Ricky Gervais is to return for the fourth time as the host of Hollywood's Annual Golden Globe Awards.

The outspoken star caused controversy in 2010 when he made barbs at some of Hollywood's leading stars and had vowed in 2012 to never host the awards again.

But in a blog post entitled "Ricky's back!" the Hollywood Foreign Press Association, which organizes the Golden Globes, confirmed the news this week.

The 73rd ceremony will take place on 10 January in Los Angeles.

In response to the news, Gervais, 54, tweeted: "It's a good job I'm drunk. Otherwise the thought of hosting The Golden Globes again would seem like a real pain in the arse."

While some critics have embraced Ricky's no-holds-barred attitude towards the Hollywood elite, feeling that the self-congratulatory atmosphere of one of Tinseltown's biggest nights deserved to be punctured, others were horrified at just how close to the bone some of his comments cut, fearing some celebrities might not

show up for the event rather than risk being the target of Gervais's ridicule.

- Telling Kate Winslet after her film *The Reader* earned her the Best Supporting Actress Award: "Well done Winslet! I told ya, do a Holocaust movie and the awards come."

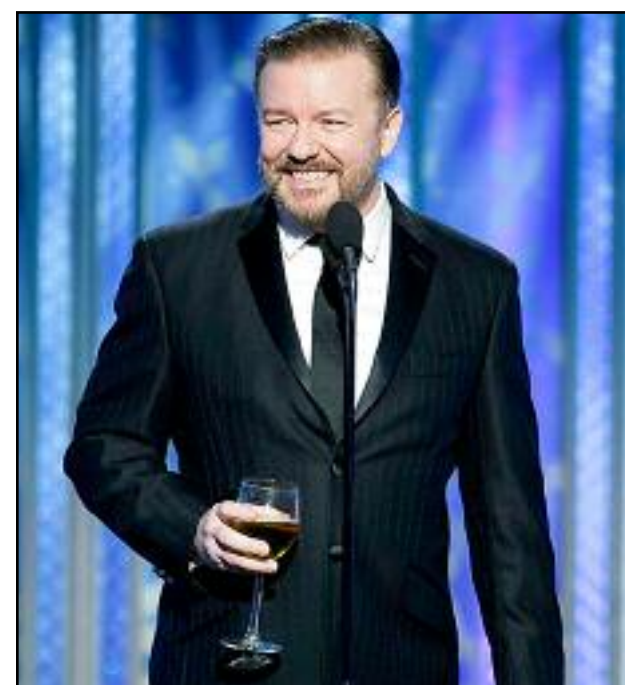
- "I drink no more than the next man. Unless the next man is Mel Gibson".

**irreconcilable differences**

A source added that Gwen, 46, and Gavin, 49, did not have a prenup. Californian law states that the couple are entitled to equal shares of their assets, but Gavin has agreed to take far less than his 50 per cent portion, presumably to reach a quick settlement.

A judge is expected to sign the final divorce papers by the end of the year.

phone, a car and a bank account. It was probably the most stressful 13 days I've had in a long time, but it was worth it all!

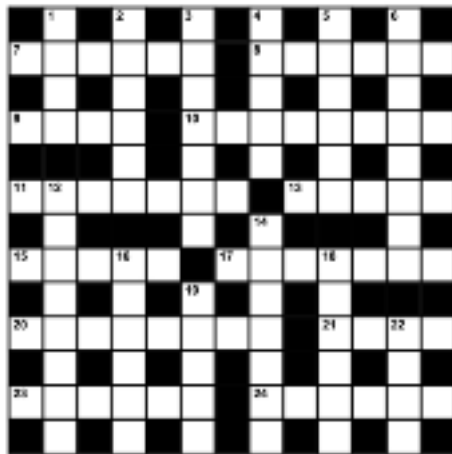

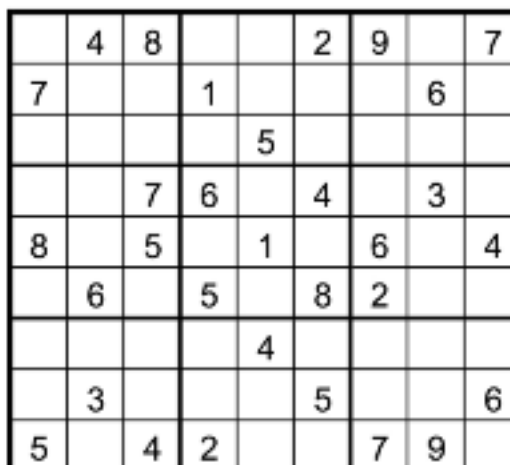

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# Carter and Lovecraft: wonderfully twisted stuff

Exclusive interview  
with Jonathan L.

"Macmillan (the leading publishing house) had an elevator pitch about setting a Lovecraftian story in the modern day, and then looked around to see if they were already publishing anyone who might be interested in taking it on," says Carter and Lovecraft author Jonathan L. Howard. "Carter & Lovecraft is unusual to me because it's the first time I've written a book to spec. Thomas Dunne Books, which is a part of



Macmillans, had published two of my Johannes Cabal novels, the former of which in particular [*Johannes Cabal: The Fear Institute*] is very Lovecraftian. The TV rights for *Carter & Lovecraft* were sold before it was even published. That was very cool."

Howard modernizes H.P. Lovecraft's style of writing, the late American author whose works of horror fiction had little

recognition during his life, but gained prestige later to such a degree that he is now considered one of the great American writers. You'll like Carter, the lead character. Originally a tough cop, he's got more heart than it first seems. His banter with Emily is witty and almost feels British. Howard guides us into what the characters are thinking without losing Carter's point of view.

After the sudden death of his partner, NYPD homicide detective Daniel Carter leaves the force to become a private investigator. He's unexpectedly inherited some property in Providence, Rhode Island. He thinks it's a house and he'll sell it. On arrival he finds out it's a rare book store. He meets Emily

Lovecraft, who's related to the man who left the property to Carter and the last known descendant of the famous writer. But then people start dying. Carter has Emily help him. Can her knowledge of H.P. Lovecraft stories help them catch the killer?

"Given that I was working from an elevator pitch, most of which I dispensed with, there wasn't a lot of material to go on, and not a great deal of time to create the whole thing from very nearly scratch," says Howard. "Yet here it is, and I am honestly proud of it."

"The original pitch was very two-fisted and had a descendant of H.P. Lovecraft as a modern day detective who ends up bumping into beasts of the (Lovecraftian fictional universe) Cthulhu

Mythos," says Howard. "As much to his surprise as any one else's. It sounded like fun, but it had been done before, so I suggested taking it a little bit further away from battling horrors with assault rifles and making it more about the cosmic horror of what does it mean for us all if such things exist? What if that utterly alien horror is only an onion skin's distance away from us, and it turns out that very thin layer of protection isn't all it might be? It meant that I could go back to some ideas that I'd considered for *The Fear Institute* but hadn't used as they would have been unnecessary for telling that story, use them to create something new that was contemporary and a little more raw than the Cabal novels."

Jones, rejoined by producer Mark Sovel, aka "Mr. Shovel," will now host a two-hour program on L.A.'s KLOS (95.5 FM).

In an announcement, the station calls the latest incarnation of the program a "two-hour open forum show where the only rule is doing whatever Jones wants."

In the past that has

included spinning music from the eclectic collection of the former punk icon, who recently turned 60, to wide-ranging interviews. The new weekly show will run Fridays, noon to 2 p.m.

Jonesy's Jukebox was a

daily staple in Indie 103.1 from its launch in 2004 until the station's demise in early 2009. The show had a run on Internet radio beginning later that year, and then on KROQ from late 2010 until March 2013.

## Murdoch and Hall: really an item?

Rupert Murdoch is in a 'romantic relationship' with Mick Jagger's former girlfriend Jerry Hall, it has been reported.

The billionaire media mogul, 84, is said to have been introduced to the 59-year-old Texan in Australia by one of his sisters and a niece.

A close family friend of the Murdochs said: "It's all very new. They are really enjoying each other's company very much."

"He is very fond of her. There is no question that they are a couple."

Rumours Mr Murdoch, a naturalised American, and Miss Hall were romantically involved have circulated for several weeks.

Now, however, it has been suggested the pair will appear together for the first time in public at the Rugby World Cup final at Twickenham this weekend. It follows time spent together in California and a recent outing to see the hit Broadway musical Hamilton in New York.

Mr Murdoch, who has been married three times and has six children, was divorced from Wendi Deng, 46, in 2013, amid rumours she had become infatuated with Tony Blair.

She is alleged to have



commented approving on the former Prime Minister's "piercing blue eyes", "good body", "good legs" and "butt [sic]" in a note alleged to have been written while Miss Deng was still married to Mr Murdoch.

Mr Blair has denied all allegations of an affair with Miss Deng, while friends of Miss Deng said the pair were never more than friends.

Ex-Model Jerry Hall began dating Rolling Stones singer Mr Jagger in 1977. The couple, whose 1990 'marriage' in Bali was later annulled, officially split in 1999.

They have four children together, including model Georgia May, who are believed to be aware of the relationship.

Mr Murdoch's involvement with Miss Hall, who also dated Roxy Music frontman Bryan Ferry, is evidence the octogenarian is 'as

vigorous in his private life as he is in business', a source told the *Mail On Sunday*.

## F1 champ Lewis salutes matching his idol Senna

NEWLY CROWNED Formula One world champion Lewis Hamilton said his latest win was the most important of his career after matching childhood hero Ayrton Senna's three titles.

Hamilton won the US Grand Prix in Austin, Texas, after a late error by Mercedes team-mate Nico Rosberg.

"The last two times were really climactic in the last race. This one still feels just as special if not more special," said the 30-year-old Briton.

"It has kind of topped last year for me - it's equalling Ayrton," he added.

Hamilton said that his career aim had always been to match the achievements of the great Brazilian, who was killed in a crash in the 1994 San Marino Grand Prix.

Hamilton, who now has 43 career victories compared to Senna's 41, said: "It is a very humbling experience to equal Ayrton Senna who inspired me and still does today.

"For me the target was always to get the three Ayrton had. I don't know what's coming next. There is no-one else I want to equal or emulate.

"I feel like I have the baton now for myself and Ayrton and I will carry it as far as I can and see where I can build it.

"As a driver you want

to win everything you compete in, to perform at your best and hopefully better than everyone else. When you win a title that signifies I guess your greatness and the people around you."

Hamilton also dedicated his third world title to his family.

"I'm just overwhelmed," Hamilton said. "It's really difficult to find the words.

"It's just crazy to think I am now a three-time champion. I owe it all to my dad and family who sacrificed it all to see me here."

And after his 10th victory of 2015, he still has a chance to equal the record number of wins in a season - 13, held by Sebastian Vettel and Michael Schumacher.

Niki Lauda, the non-executive chairman of Hamilton's Mercedes team and a three-time world champion himself, said the Briton would "get better and win more".

Team boss Toto Wolff added: "Lewis deserves the world championship, he was brilliant in his driving."

Hamilton's great rival Fernando Alonso, the driver the Englishman respects most on the grid, was one of many to offer his congratulations.

"Really strong performance, well deserved," the two-time champion said.

"Fantastic. Congratulations. He dominated all season. Last year Nico was a little closer and gave him a little bit more of a fight but this year it was not a fight. Lewis was very strong from the beginning of the year."

Alonso's McLaren team-mate Jenson Button, the 2009 world champion, said: "Congratulations to Lewis. Great job.

"The team are in another category at the moment, they are doing such a good job. But fair play to Lewis, he has not put a foot wrong and he has come away on top."

## Batting collapse to blame for England loss, says Cook

Pakistan: 378 and 354-6 declared  
England: 242 & 312 all out

England captain Alastair Cook blamed a first-innings batting collapse for his side's defeat by Pakistan in the second Test in Dubai.

The tourists came within 6.3 overs of securing a draw, but Cook pointed to England's loss of seven wickets for 36 runs on Saturday.

"In these conditions you can't afford those two or three hours," said Cook.

"But the character we have shown today - we are disappointed not to get over the line."

England number eight Adil Rashid, playing in

only his second Test, batted for four hours on a wearing fifth-day pitch while Mark Wood and Stuart Broad also provided admirable final-day assistance.

Joe Root (71), Jonny Bairstow (22) and Jos Buttler (7) were all dismissed before lunch, but the tailenders threatened to deny Pakistan what had looked a routine victory.

Spinners Yasir Shah (4-87) and Zulfiqar Babar (3-53) finally broke through in the final hour of the day to ensure the hosts head into the final Test of the series at Sharjah on Sunday 1-0 up.

"These are a fantastic bunch of players," added Cook. "The lower order showed a lot of

character.

"You always think that it is never over. Mark Wood and Jimmy Anderson are capable so it wasn't impossible. Some good things have come out of this but we shouldn't have been in that position.

"We will dust ourselves off now. It will be a great last Test."

Pakistan captain Misbah-ul-Haq said: "You have to give credit to the opposition.

"They showed character. They played very well on the last day against two really good spinners.

"Overall, the spinners bowled well, under pressure. When we needed the breakthrough they kept their nerve."

## We can keep Andy Carroll fit, vows high-flying Bilic

West Ham striker Andy Carroll can stay injury free, says manager Slaven Bilic after the substitute's winner in the Hammers' 2-1 dramatic home victory over Chelsea on Saturday.

The 26-year-old, whose career has been riddled with injuries, scored his first goal since January in his fifth game since returning from knee surgery.

"We changed the schedule and philosophy and the way of training," Bilic said.

"He always used to come back after five or six weeks of training, but it doesn't help him."

The Croat, who replaced Sam Allardyce in the summer, added: "He goes running into the box and fighting with
