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# DRINK TEA FOR STRONG BONES!

**Good news for tea drinkers: downing three cups a day of Britain's favorite beverage could slash the risk of hip fractures by almost a third, a new study has found.**

Scientists say the humble brew could become a powerful weapon against osteoporosis - a condition where the bones become brittle and fragile.

The study suggests healthy plant chemicals called flavonoids in black tea could help an ageing population ward off the bone-weakening illness.

For years, scientists have suspected these antioxidant chemicals help to reduce the risk of major illnesses like cancer and heart disease.

But the latest breakthrough points to drinking tea as a potent new way to protect the body's bones during the ageing process.

One in three women and one in 12 men in the UK develops osteoporosis at some point in their lives - and it

already affects around three million people.

Women who use steroid drugs, smoke, drink heavily and have a family history of the disease are most at risk.

But diet is also crucial and poor eating habits during youth are thought to increase the dangers of the disease later in life.

It progresses when osteoclasts, cells that break down old bone by removing the calcium and phosphorous that gives it strength, start to outnumber osteoblasts, rival cells responsible for making healthy new bone.

Right the way through life old bone is being destroyed by osteoclasts and new bone is formed by osteoblasts.

But after the ages of 30 to 35, there are fewer osteoblasts than

Experts from the Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital in Perth, the Royal Perth Hospital and the Flinders University of South Australia in Adelaide, had read reports that tea might improve bone density.

But they wanted to see if drinking more of it lead to fewer fractures in elderly women.

They studied almost 1,200 women in their seventies over a ten-year period.

Each one was quizzed on their tea drinking habits and then closely monitored to see if they suffered a major fracture due to osteoporosis over the next decade.

During that period 288 of the women fell and broke a bone and nearly half involved a hip fracture.

The results showed that those women who drank three or more cups of tea every day were 30

per cent less likely to have suffered a break than those who drank less than one cup of tea a week.

In a report on their findings the researchers aid that every cup of tea the women drank each day appeared to cut the risk of a fracture by around nine per cent.

Researcher Dr Jonathan Hodgson said: 'There is increasing interest in the role of dietary factors in osteoporosis and fracture prevention.

'There is evidence that foods rich in flavonoids – such as fruits, vegetables and tea – may also be related to bone loss and fracture outcomes.

'Flavonoids are a large class of phytochemicals widely distributed in plant foods.

'And tea is the main source in many populations.

'We have shown that a higher intake of black tea and flavonoids was associated with lower risk of fracture in elderly women.'

# Holiday misery for thousands as flights grounded in Egypt

■ British flights cancelled over fears that Isis blew up Russia jet

Thousands of Britons were stranded in Egypt this week after No 10 declared that a bomb was the likely cause of the explosion of a Russian aircraft minutes after it left the Red Sea resort of Sharm el-Sheikh.

The biggest British airlines grounded all flights in and out of the resort after the warning, which was believed to be based on information from foreign intelligence agencies, including those in the US. As many as 20,000 British tourists are understood to be in the area.

Downing Street's declaration that an explosive device "may well" have brought down the aircraft caused a diplomatic row on the eve of a visit to Britain by President Sisi of Egypt. Sameh Shoukry, the country's foreign minister, described the warning as premature and unwarranted. The Metrojet flight was heading for St Petersburg

when it broke apart over the Sinai desert on Saturday.

The 224 people on board, almost all of them Russian tourists, were killed. British security experts were sent to assess the security at Sharm el-Sheikh's airport, with all British flights grounded. Consular staff were deployed to help British citizens in Egypt.

Following an emergency Cabinet meeting Philip Hammond, the foreign secretary, said there was

"a significant possibility the crash was caused by an explosive device on board the plane". He apologised to those caught up in the flight ban, saying: "We have to put safety and security of British nationals above all other considerations."

Isis had claimed responsibility for the attack, but the suggestion was dismissed by the Russian and Egyptian authorities, who suspected a technical fault. The terrorist group has challenged sceptics to

prove that it was not behind the crash.

On Thursday a logjam of British tourists at Sharm el-Sheikh's airport began to ease with the arrival of special 'rescue' flights from carriers including Easyjet, Monarch, Thomson and British Airways. Passengers were only allowed to bring small carry on bags on board, with all other baggage going through a rigorous separate screening and transported on separate, cargo-only planes.



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# Oscar winner Welland takes final bow at 81

■ Z-Cars actor struck gold with his acclaimed Chariots of Fire screenplay

**O S C A R - w i n n i n g screenwriter Colin Welland has died aged 81 after suffering from Alzheimer's disease for several years, his family has announced.**

Welland enjoyed a long career, first as an actor on the seminal 1960s TV show Z Cars, but is best known on these shores for winning an Academy Award for the screenplay of Chariots Of Fire, memorably crowing in his acceptance speech: "I'd like to finish with a word of warning: You may have started something. The British are coming."

Born in Lancashire in 1934 as Colin Williams, Welland thought of Liverpool as his home town.

Explaining the use of northern characters in his plays, he said: "I find Northern people wear their hearts on their sleeve, are far more communicative, are far more honest, and they stimulate me far more."

Tributes were this week paid to the dad-of-four, who was born in Leigh, but moved to Liverpool when he was five and spent most of his childhood in that city's Kensington neighborhood.

Dave Morrissey, the Walking Dead actor, who is also from Kensington, tweeted: "Colin Welland RIP. Such a great actor and writer. Kes is my all time favourite film and he was so wonderful in it. So sad."

Tributes flooded in across social media, from actors to Rugby League fans - Welland was a huge Warrington Wolves fan.

On TV, Welland played PC Graham in episodes of long-running police serial Z Cars whose theme tune became synonymous

Everton Football Club.

Brian Blessed, his co-star in the series, said: "We were both physically powerful Colin and I.

"I read some of his scripts he had wrote for Z Cars and I said these are the best scripts I have read in years, and he said the BBC wouldn't accept them.

**'tremendous ability'**

"They don't want an actor who's appearing in Z Cars to be a writer at the same time. So I told Colin keep writing, and he eventually won an Oscar.

"I remember a BBC reporter shaking my hand telling me how good I was in Z Cars and I said it wasn't me, it was Colin. People often got us confused.

"He was a very tough guy so I'm absolutely shocked that he has died. We were tremendous chums.

"He had a tremendous ability for writing. He could write anything in any style.

"Incredibly versatile was Colin and a great big heavy man, he played a lot of rugby, he was very

fast, an extraordinary character.

"He was great as the schoolteacher in Kes and, of course, he was a schoolteacher originally."

Welland taught art in Leigh, where he was known there as "Ted" because of his Teddy Boy curly-hair style.

In 1973, in an interview with Roy Plomley on Desert Island Discs, he discussed his early career.

On his father's advice, he first became an art teacher, despite having acting ambitions.

He said: "I wanted to go on the stage, you see, but my dad had his feet firmly on the ground. He said, be an art teacher first, you can paint and draw, be an art teacher first, and if you don't like that, then go on to the stage. So that's what I did."

Welland studied art in Yorkshire, before attending Goldsmiths College in London.

It was his impending marriage motivated him to try his luck as an actor. He said: "I was 26, I was going to get married, and I thought: if I get married I will lose my opportunity,

because responsibilities naturally follow marriage."

After an audition at Manchester's Library Theatre, he was hired for £7.10 a week and made his stage debut as the lead in Harold Pinter's The Birthday Party.

His last appearance as an actor was in 1998 in TV mini-series Bramwell where he played Mr Barclay, and the previous year he appeared in TV hit Trial & Retribution.

In a statement released by his literary agent Anthony Jones, the family said: "Colin will be desperately missed by his family and friends.

"Alzheimer's is a cruel illness and there have been difficult times but in the end Colin died peacefully in his sleep.

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# Ex-wife branded a 'lodger' wins payout

A "callous" art college lecturer said that he was not sure that he loved his ex-wife any more than his dog and described her as a "mere lodger" despite a 30-year relationship, the court of appeal was told this week.

Rupert Ashmore, 66, argued that Kim Woodward, 49, the mother of his child, was not entitled to a penny after they split in 2010.

The couple started a relationship in 1985, when Ms Woodward was Mr Ashmore's student. She was 19 and he was a 36-year-old lecturer at Salisbury College of Art. They moved in together, started a design business, married and had a son. Yet Mr Ashmore told a judge sitting at Barnstaple county court that he had informed her that he never wanted a "long-term commitment" and that marriage "was only good for the tax breaks".

The design business,

which they ran from their home in the 1980s and 1990s, was said by Mr Ashmore to be his alone, with Ms Woodward a £400-a-month assistant. She was described as merely an employee with whom he was having an affair. When they separated in 2010, he was adamant that she was not entitled to anything even though they had lived in a £700,000 house in north Devon.

After a two-year legal battle, in which the judge, Mark Ball, branded Mr Ashmore "selfish", he has finally agreed to pay her £275,000 in exchange for relinquishing any claim to the property.

Ms Woodward had taken him to court after he refused her a share of their home at Leworthy Barton, near Bideford, when they broke up. The property was in his name. In her evidence, she said that she found her former husband "controlling and

intimidating". She said that he had reacted badly to her pregnancy in the early 1990s and that they had separated for a time.

Judge Ball had rejected the retired lecturer's claim that Ms Woodward had been only a lodger in their home and an assistant in their business. Mr Ashmore's evidence was "untrustworthy, partial and self-serving", the judge said.

"His attempts to belittle all or any contribution by Ms Woodward are easily dismissed by what I find to be his quite extraordinary attempts to keep for himself the fruits of what were clearly joint efforts over a number of years," he added.

At the county court in 2013, Judge Ball awarded Ms Woodward a half share of Leworthy Barton, which comprises a farmhouse, 50 acres of land, barns and stables.

Mr Ashmore challenged the county court ruling

that Leworthy Barton be sold and the proceeds divided equally between them, insisting that she was entitled to nothing, but the appeal judge, Sir Terence Etherton, said it was a "strange proposition" to suggest that someone who had done so much over 25 years should find themselves with "not a penny".

After a half-day of argument, Mr Ashmore offered Ms Woodward £275,000. She accepted and the case was settled.

## Tom Graveney out at 88



**Former England cricketer Tom Graveney has died at the age of 88.**

An elegant batsman, Graveney (above) played 79 Tests for England, scoring 11 centuries and averaging 44.38.

He scored more than 47,793 first-class runs - including 122 hundreds - in a career that stretched from 1948 to 1972 and included spells at Gloucestershire, Worcestershire and Queensland.

After retiring, he became a BBC commentator and served as the 200th president of the MCC in 2005.

He was the first former professional cricketer to be appointed to the post.

Graveney captained England once at the age of 41, deputising for Colin Cowdrey against

Australia at Headingley in 1968.

His older brother Ken died recently at the age of 90. Both were former Gloucestershire captains.

Graveney was Worcestershire president from 1994-98 and remained a regular visitor to New Road.

In a statement, the club said he had had Parkinson's disease for some time.


Worcestershire chief executive David Leatherdale said: "He was one of the stalwarts of our first two championship triumphs and will be hugely missed by everyone at Worcestershire CCC and by cricket as a whole."

Former England batsman Geoffrey Boycott said he fulfilled a

childhood ambition by playing alongside Graveney.

"He was my boyhood hero and I ended up batting with him - first at Lord's in 1966. He got 96 and I got 60," he told BBC Radio 5 live.

"He was an aesthetic player as well, he was lovely on the eye because he played gorgeous cover drives. He made 120-odd first-class hundreds, so that shows he could play, he could seriously play."

BBC cricket correspondent Jonathan Agnew said Graveney was "renowned as a great stylist" and later a "forthright pundit".

"I knew him as someone who loved cricket, someone who really loved talking about the game," said Agnew. "He would sit in the bar and just talk for hours about the modern game, and how he used to play"

## 41 years later, 'Lucky' Lucan will finally be declared dead

**Lord Lucan is set to be officially declared 'presumed dead' this week - more than 41 years after he vanished following the murder of his children's nanny.**

His son George Bingham, 48, is set for victory in his bid to obtain a death certificate for his father in the High Court - clearing the way for him to inherit Lord Lucan's title.

Lord Lucan vanished without trace in 1974 after the murder of his children's nanny Sandra Rivett, who died after being hit with a lead pipe in the basement of the family home in Belgravia, central London.

The peer had been legally declared dead solely for the purposes of a probate settlement but his son's petition to take his father's seat in the

House of Lords was not approved.

Mr Bingham said he is following up the case after the passing of the Presumption of Death Act, which came into force last October.

The act was passed in 2013 after a campaign by relatives of people struggling to obtain death certificates for missing people suspected to have died.

Mr Bingham has previously said he is not convinced his father killed Ms Rivett but believes he did commit suicide after her death.

It is suspected Lucan killed his nanny when he mistook her for his wife on the night of the murder.

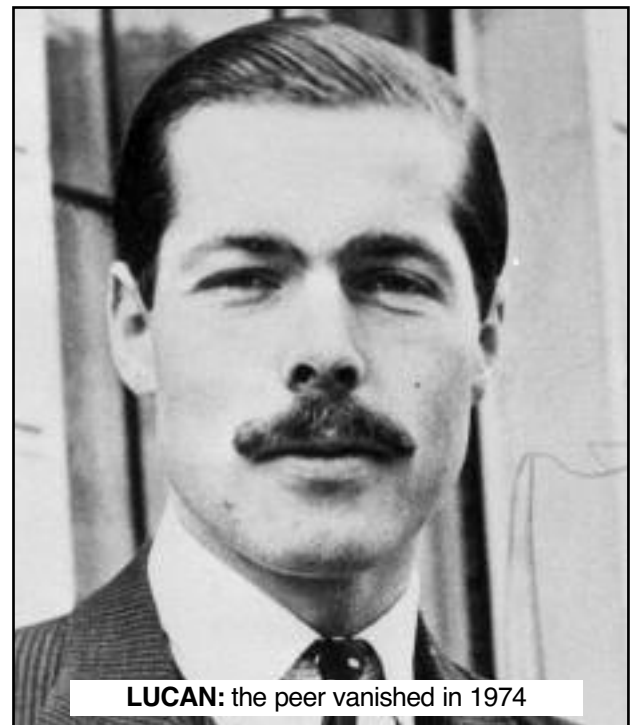
Lady Lucan was herself badly injured in the attack and named her husband as the man who

attacked her and killed Sandra Rivett.

The police named the peer as the prime suspect, but could only find a blood-stained car he was seen driving, abandoned at Newhaven, east Sussex.

There has been no formal sighting of Lord Lucan - aged 39 at the time - since the early hours of the next day, when he visited the home of a friend in Sussex.

There have been numerous supposed sightings of the missing

## Cops quiz Sir Cliff yet again

Singer Sir Cliff Richard has been re-interviewed by police investigating alleged sexual assaults, his spokesman has said.

The entertainer, 75, was interviewed under caution last year by detectives investigating a claim of a sex crime involving a young boy in the 1980s.

He has never been arrested or charged.

The allegations are "completely false", and the star co-operated

fully when he voluntarily met with South Yorkshire Police this week, his spokesman said.

"Other than restating that the allegations are completely false and that he will continue to co-operate fully with the police, it would not be appropriate for Sir Cliff to say anything further at this time," he said.

Sir Cliff was first interviewed last summer, after a high-profile police raid

on his apartment in Berkshire.

Since then, police have confirmed to a parliamentary committee that their investigation has expanded, but said this meant no date could be given for when it would be concluded.

The singer has described the claims he faces as "absurd and untrue".

It is not known what police questioned Sir Cliff about on this occasion.

# Who do you think I am? Becks cries foul as fans mistake him for Ricky Gervais

David Beckham was in the news again this week after allegedly seeing red when he was mistaken for actor Ricky Gervais while working out at the SoulCycle gym in Brentwood.

The former footballer reportedly didn't take the comparison too well, storming out of the gym,, according to several observers.

Beckham was at the gym talking to a trainer when someone reportedly accidentally mistook him for "The Office" star because of his English accent. Soon, people crowded around him, asking for his autograph. According to an eyewitness, Beckham was happy to oblige with the autograph signing even as others were congratulating him for

Gervais' nomination as host of next year's Golden Globes awards ceremony.

"David was very friendly with the first few people in line who were saying things like, 'Hey, Ricky' and 'Would you mind signing this, Ricky?'" the eyewitness told *The Daily Star*.

However, Beckham soon lost interest with the well-wishes and stormed out of the gym. The eyewitness claimed he was clearly unimpressed being associated with Gervais, who is much older than him, not to mention that they don't have the same physical build.

"But it swiftly became clear that he was well and truly pissed off at being mistaken for a guy who is quite a lot older than him and, with the best will in

the world, will never be in the same sort of physical shape. In the end, he stormed off to the changing rooms with a bright red face and a very angry expression, refusing

The 40-year-old was reportedly further called by Gervais' name when he left Soul Cycle. Another eyewitness told the publication that a few people had gathered outside the gym after being notified through calls and texts about the actor's presence.

"They were under the impression he was Ricky Gervais too and he had to run the gauntlet of more 'Ricky' calls before he roared off in his car," the source revealed.

While we Brits can always tell the difference between the two, it's understandable that some bystanders might confuse Beckham with Gervais since the pair both sport the same patchy beard

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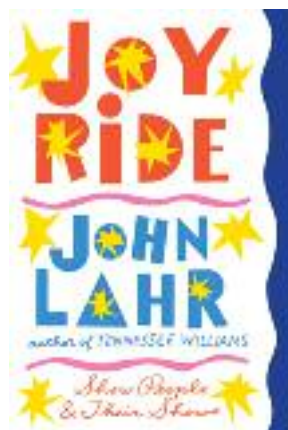
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# Joy Ride: dispatches from theatre's front line

Exclusive interview  
with author John

"The New Yorker is a kind of magic carpet," says *Joy Ride* author John Lahr. "Because of it, I got extraordinary access to people who interested me, which no other writer could get. For instance, I walked with Arthur Miller to the Connecticut cabin he built in order to write *Death of a Salesman*...visited Pittsburgh with August Wilson...sat with Ingmar Bergman at the National Theatre in the very seat he sat in as a boy when he first attended the theatre. In all these cases, I followed my personal



taste. The people included in this book are the foremost stage artists in the Western world."

*Joy Ride: Show People and Their Shows* is taken from Lahr's reviews and interviews when he was chief theatre critic for **The New Yorker**. Precise and engaging, Lahr divides *Joy Ride* into three sections: playwrights, productions and directors. He shares the biographical details and analysis of the makers of classic shows on Broadway, the genius

behind the process of working in the theatre. For every fan of New York theatre and Broadway, it's a lively way to deconstruct a play.

Profiles include Arthur Miller, who is best known for *Death of a Salesman*, August Wilson who did a ten-play cycle of African-American life in the U.S., David Mamet and Mamet's sister Lynn who is an American theatre director, playwright, screenwriter, and television producer. Lahr reminisces about first-run shows like *Carousel* and *The Pajama Game* and describes their revivals. High points include Royal Shakespeare Company director John Barton and a section on director Mike Nichols.

"Each profile takes about three months to research and write," says Lahr. "In that time, I have

amassed eight to ten hours with the subject, interviewed subsidiary characters in his or her story, read the work, and amassed a dossier of transcribed interviews that amounts to about 1,000 pages. So, a great deal of effort and scrutiny goes into each one. In most of the cases, like August Wilson, Wallace Shawn, Sarah Ruhl, Mike Nichols because of my unique access to them, the profiles represent the fullest account of their work, opinions and life that currently exists."

"The book evolved out of a conversation with my editor at Norton about the teaching of drama and the boring theoretical texts students had to read," says Lahr. "People read plays out of the context of the lives of the playwrights who made them. To stimulate interest and to bring more

information to the student, my idea was to publish profiles of playwrights and directors to show the synergy between the work and the life of the artist. When you write profiles, every encounter with a fine writer has its surprises...Miller's cabin, David Mamet's struggle with his father, August Wilson's writing regime and channelling his characters, Mike Nichols' ideas about comedy."

Between 1992 and 2013, Lahr was the senior drama critic of *The New Yorker*, the longest tenure in that position in the magazine's history. His books include *Light Fantastic*, *Show and Tell*, and *Honky Tonk Parade*. He's written twenty books including two novels, *Notes on a Cowardly Lion* which is a biography about his father, Bert Lahr, and *Prick*

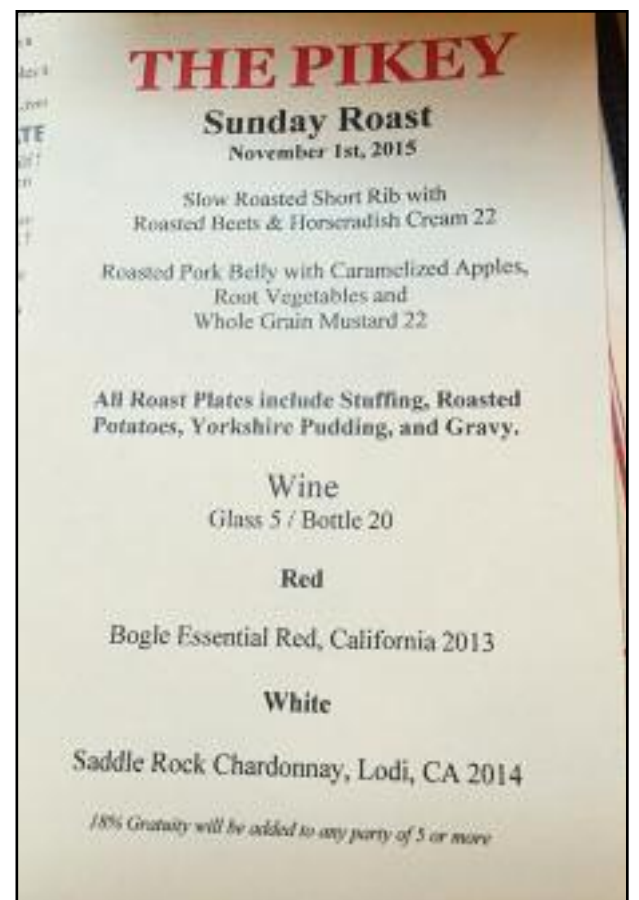

## More misery for Cook's men

*Third Test, Day Five:  
Pakistan (234 & 355), beat  
England (306 & 156) by  
127 runs*

**THERE was more misery for England's cricket team this week as England subsided to a 127-run defeat in the third and final Test against Pakistan and a 2-0 series loss in Sharjah.**

Resuming on 46-2 in pursuit of an unlikely 284, England lost four wickets for 11 runs in the first hour and were eventually bowled out for 156.

On a pitch turning sharply, only Alastair Cook resisted with 63 and was the ninth England wicket to fall.

Yasir Shah took 4-44 and Shoaib Malik 3-26 to give Pakistan's spinners a total of 17 wickets in the match.

In contrast, England's trio of slow bowlers returned combined figures of 7-423 from 115.2 overs.

England, who have lost seven of their past nine Test matches away to Pakistan, are without a series victory abroad for three years and slip from third to sixth in the world rankings.

Though England were found wanting against the turning ball, they ultimately paid the price for errors over the first four days.

While they can rightly point to losing Ben Stokes through injury, England must also reflect on a first-innings collapse that saw their last six wickets fall for 78 runs.

Not only were England's spinners very poor in the second innings, but Mohammad Hafeez, who made 151, was afforded two dropped catches and a missed stumping.

Cook's men came some close to winning the first Test and were competitive for large parts of the series, but were defeated by batting collapses, fielding errors and inferior spin bowling.

## Van Gaal acknowledges fan frustration

**Manchester United manager Louis van Gaal acknowledged fans' unhappiness over his tactics, but insisted they would not be upset after Tuesday's Champions League win over CSKA Moscow.**

The Dutchman's decision to replace Anthony Martial with Marouane Fellaini at 0-0 drew jeers at Old Trafford.

Wayne Rooney later scored the only goal of the game in the 79th minute.

"I'm not deaf. That's the opinion of the fans but afterwards they shall not be disappointed," said Van Gaal.

Rooney's goal - his 237th for United, moving him joint-second in the club's all-time goalscorers' list, alongside Denis Law - was the

team's first in 404 minutes, a run including goalless draws against Manchester City, Middlesbrough and Crystal Palace.

United legend Paul Scholes has blamed the team's lack of creativity on Van Gaal's tactics, while the 64-year-old's tendency to deploy Martial - who has scored one goal in his past nine games - on the left and persist with England captain Rooney as his main striker has drawn criticism.

France international Martial played up front alongside Rooney against CSKA but his substitution in the 66th minute drew an angry response from the crowd, who chanted the teenager's name and demanded more

attacking intent from their side.

"I'm very happy because I put Rooney again in the striker's position and he scored," said Van Gaal.

It was not just inside Old Trafford where frustration over 19-year-old Martial's substitution was felt, as social media activity peaked too.

In 15 minutes from 21:05 GMT the term "Martial" was tweeted more than 13,000 times, with 2,600 tweets sent in the minute he was taken off.

BBC Radio 5 live pundit Pat Nevin described the decision as "a shocker". "He was the last player I expected to be taken off," added the former Chelsea player.

## Arsenal have 'small chance' of qualification

**Manager Arsene Wenger said Arsenal have only a "small chance" of reaching the Champions League knockout stages after a 5-1 thrashing by Bayern Munich on Wednesday.**

Defeat leaves the Gunners bottom of Group F, six points behind leaders Bayern and second-placed Olympiakos.

Arsenal must now beat Dinamo Zagreb and Olympiakos in their final two games, and hope the Greek side lose at Bayern.

"There is still a chance to qualify," said Wenger. "We have to realise that our chance is at a minimum."

The Gunners' hopes of reaching the knockout stages for a 13th successive season are in danger after they were outclassed by Pep Guardiola's Bayern, suffering their record-equaling European defeat.

After Robert Lewandowski, Thomas

Muller and David Alaba scored in the first half, Arjen Robben added a fourth with his first touch 10 minutes into the second half.

Olivier Giroud pulled one back with a well-taken volley before Muller added his second a minute from the end.

"It leaves us short," said Wenger. "It will be very tight but we have to fight until the end. Let's hope Bayern beat Olympiakos and we win at home against Zagreb. That leaves us with a chance to qualify from the last game."

"It's a small chance but there is still a real one."

Arsenal's performance was in stark contrast to the 2-0 win over Bayern at Emirates Stadium a fortnight ago, and Wenger bemoaned his side's

defending.

Centre-back Gabriel, playing instead of Laurent Koscielny after the French defender injured a hip, struggled to cope with Bayern's attackers, who were ably supported by a fast-paced midfield.

"Defensively we were extremely poor. We never looked like a team that could play like a unit," said Wenger, whose team host Tottenham in the north London derby on Sunday.

"The crazy thing is we looked like we could create chances but overall we had a disappointing performance."

"There was no pressing, no concentration, no challenges. We watched them play. They are a good side and we paid for it."

## Celtic slip up again in Europa League

**Celtic's defensive frailties were exposed again as their chances of Europa League progress were severely dented by a home defeat by Molde on Thursday.**

First-half goals by Mohamed Elyounoussi and captain Daniel Hestad did the damage as Molde reached the last 32.

Kris Commons had briefly drawn Celtic level but Ronny Deila's side could not muster a second goal and had midfielder Nir Bitton sent off on 75 minutes.

Celtic are bottom of Group A, but two wins will see them through.

They face Ajax at

home on 26 November before travelling to Turkey to face Fenerbahce on 10 December.

The departure of the injured Jozo Simunovic after only nine minutes did nothing to aid Celtic's hopes of keeping the Norwegians out and his replacement, Tyler Blackett, was involved in the concession of the opening goal.

His half-clearance was chested down by Elyounoussi and with no pressure applied to the winger, he was able to let it bounce before thumping it past a static Craig Gordon.

Molde's second was

even poorer from Celtic's perspective.

Elyounoussi outmuscled Tom Rogic almost on the byeline, and when his cross arrived at the back post, Hestad showed greater desire than Blackett to stab the ball over the line, becoming the oldest player to score in a Europa League tie, at the age of 40.

Blackett's ignominy was complete when he was taken off to be replaced by Nadir Ciftci, and though Bitton slipped into central defence to replace him, he was soon off as well, having hauled down Ola Kamara as he burst through on goal.

Captain Vincent Kompany said it was "important" for Manchester City to win their Champions League group after they secured a place in the knockout stages.

City reached the last 16, where they have lost to Barcelona for the past two years, with a 3-1 win at Sevilla.

"It's an incredible achievement to have qualified with two games still to go," said Kompany.

"Now we go on - we need to make sure we end as group winners."

Raheem Sterling, Fernandinho and Wilfried Bony scored as City won a third successive Champions League match.

Victory for the Premier League leaders, coupled with Juventus's 1-1 draw at Borussia Monchengladbach in the group's other game, means they have reached the knockout stage in record time.

Manuel Pellegrini's side qualified for the last 16 after five games in 2013-14, then by beating Roma in their final group game last season.

Finishing as runners-up in their group saw them drawn against Spanish giants Barca.

But City are guaranteed to win their group this season if they beat Italian champions Juve and German side Monchengladbach in their final two matches.

"It's important for us to finish first in our group because we've been unlucky with draws before," said Kompany.

City produced a

devastating attacking display against Sevilla, with Sterling and Fernandinho giving them a 2-0 lead after just 11 minutes.

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# Mousa late show leaves Spurs on top

Tottenham moved to the top of Europa League Group J after Mousa Dembele's superb late winner gave them a 2-1 win against Anderlecht on Thursday.

The Belgian side were the brighter team early on but that ended when Harry Kane scored his fifth goal in eight games by sweeping in Christian Eriksen's flick.

Spurs goalkeeper Hugo Lloris was kept busy by the shot-hungry visitors.

And although Imoh Ezekiel came off the bench to equalise with 18 minutes left, substitute Dembele fired in from 18 yards against the run of play.

The Tottenham defence had their hands full with Anderlecht striker Stefano Okaka causing problems, but having let a lead slip two

weeks ago, this time Spurs were rewarded for a solid defensive performance.

If they beat bottom side Qarabag on 26 November and Monaco defeat Anderlecht, Mauricio Pochettino's side will qualify for the knockout stages with a game to spare.

The return of Spurs striker Son Heung-min after six weeks out with a foot injury was also a welcome boost ahead of Sunday's north London derby against Arsenal.

After their 2-1 win in Brussels, the Belgian side showed why they are second in the Jupiler Pro League as they gave Spurs a stiff test once again.

Despite going behind to Kane's goal just before the half-hour mark they did not lose their early momentum and

peppered the Spurs goal with shots from distance, while the hosts' defence was also kept busy all evening dealing with a succession of crosses.

For the most part Lloris and his defenders were accomplished in their efforts to repel Besnik Hasi's team but Ezekiel's well-timed run allowed him to poke home Steven Defour's cross only three minutes after coming on.

The Nigerian also had a decent chance to score with 10 minutes left but Toby Alderweireld made one of many well-timed tackles.

That missed chance proved crucial as Dembele collected the ball from fellow replacement Son and smashed a right-footed shot from the edge of the box into the top corner.

Second-placed Liverpool now trail Group B leaders Sion by two points but are three ahead of Bordeaux, who visit Anfield on 26 November.

The Reds will qualify for the knockout stages if they win that match, with their last game a trip to Switzerland to face Sion.

Jürgen Klopp's appointment as Liverpool boss was greeted with almost universal excitement by Reds fans after a disappointing start to the season under

Brendan Rodgers.

Thursday's win - their first in this season's Europa League - was their third in succession and supporters will have seen nothing to suggest their belief in Klopp is misplaced.

A new high-tempo, direct pressing style left Rubin Kazan with just 32% possession and seven shots - none on target - compared to Liverpool's 23.

The result means Klopp is unbeaten in his opening six matches, a positive start to his tenure.
