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Seven terror plots foiled, claims PM

LONDON: British security services have foiled around seven terror plots in the past year with fighters returning from Syria posing a growing threat, Prime Minister David Cameron said Monday.

"Our security services have foiled no fewer than seven different terrorist plots right here in Britain over the past year alone," Cameron said in a speech in London.

"We need to do more to ensure our agencies have the resources and the information they need to prevent and disrupt plots against this country at every stage."

Cameron had earlier said that the plots were foiled in six months, but later clarified that the period was actually a year.

In the wake of attacks in Paris that killed at least 129 people, British security services will have to re-think their strategy to deal with multiple coordinated street attacks, according to the prime minister.

"The more we learn about what happened in Paris the more it justifies the approach that we are taking in Britain,"

Cameron told the audience at the Lord Mayor of London's Banquet.

"When you are dealing with radicalised European Muslims, linked to ISIL in Syria and inspired by a poisonous narrative of extremism, you need an approach that covers the full spectrum - military power, counter-terrorism expertise and defeating the poisonous narrative that is the root cause of this evil."

Cameron has said that signs of hope emerged from Saturday's talks in Vienna on Syria on how to deal with the Islamic State (IS) group, also known as ISIL.

Cameron added there were "hopeful signs" from Saturday's talks in Vienna on Syria that progress was being made on how to deal with the Islamic State (IS) group.

But he has stressed that any settlement must

include the removal of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, a sticking point between the West and Russia.

'Generational struggle'

Britain is to recruit an extra 1,900 security and intelligence staff to counter the threat of terrorist violence following the Paris

attacks, as part of the government's five year defence and security review to be unveiled next week.

It has been described as the biggest increase in British security spending since the 7/7 bombings in London that killed dozens in 2005.

increase the staff of intelligence agencies MI5, MI6 and GCHQ by some 15 percent in order to fight what Cameron called a "generational struggle".

In addition, Cameron announced an additional £2 billion in spending on the British Army's SAS and other special forces, to new weapons, vehicles and equipment.

More of Britain's aid spending would go towards fragile states, and moderate Muslims in Britain would be helped with funding, protection and political representation, Cameron said.

There will also be a doubling of British funding for aviation security around the world, in response to the crash of a Russian plane in Egypt last month that the British government suspects may have been downed by a bomb.

British media reported the current funding for aviation security at around £9 million.

Britain is engaged in air strikes against IS in Iraq, but has not joined in the operation over Syria.

Cameron wants to extend the mission, but has acknowledged that work is required to convince opposition politicians in order to get his plan approved.

House prices hit another new record

Average UK home now fetches £286,000

House prices in Britain have risen by 6% over the past year with an average home now costing £286,000.

The surge in house prices has been led by a boom in demand in London, the South East and East of England.

It means the average home in London now costs a record £531,000 – three times that of than the cheapest area, the North East, where the typical property is £158,000.

Prices in the capital have increased by 7.2 per cent year-on-year, and are now nearly 48 per cent higher than the peak before the 2008 financial crisis.

Both the East and South East have seen stronger house price growth this year than London, with prices rising by 8.4 per cent and 7.4 per cent respectively.

In England as a whole, house prices increased by 6.4 per cent in a year, pushing the average to £299,000.

Within the UK, Northern Ireland saw the fastest house price growth over the last year, with a 10.2 per cent increase to £162,000, while Wales and Scotland saw increases of 1.1 per cent in the average price of a home.

Jeremy Duncombe, director of Legal and General Mortgage Club,

said: 'Given the increase in demand, and that supply remains limited, we expect house price growth to climb further in the final quarter of the year.'

'The scale of the disparity between house

prices in different regions of the country illustrates the need to not only build more homes, but to also ensure that more properties are built of the right size and in the right places.'

But Campbell Rob,

CEO of leading homeless charity Shelter, said that every monthly increase in property values 'is yet another blow for the millions of people whose dreams of a home of their own have all but disappeared'.

Cameron set to get his own Air Force One

Prime Minister David Cameron and senior ministers are to get their own plane for official trips.

An RAF Voyager A330 air-to-air refuelling aircraft will be refitted at a cost of about £10m.

The government says the move will save about £775,000 a year as the plane will be cheaper than chartering flights.

But Labour said the

size of any savings would not be known until he started using the plane while the SNP urged full transparency.

Most government departments are facing budget cuts of at least 25% over the next four years.

A source said the PM's flights, using either Royal Squadron planes or long haul charter, cost on average £6,700 per flying hour

and the RAF aircraft would cost £2,000. It would be available for refuelling when it wasn't in use.

The flight would also be available to the Royal Family.

When he was prime minister, Gordon Brown cancelled plans drawn up by his predecessor Tony Blair to buy two private jets, which had been nicknamed "Blair Force One" in reference

to the aircraft used to fly the US president, Air Force One.


Downing Street said the plane would save £775,000 a year over "at least the next 20 years", but it did not give any details about how this had been calculated.

The prime minister's spokesman said the plane's "primary use" would still be refuelling and it would continue to carry RAF livery, but

158 new seats would be fitted and it would provide "secure communications" for the prime minister.

The details of the new arrangements are expected to come at the strategic defence and security review on Monday.

There is no definite timing for the plane to come into service but it could be as early as next year.






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You must speak English, Supreme Court tells migrants

The Supreme Court has rejected a challenge against immigration rules requiring people to speak English before joining spouses in the UK.

The case was brought by two female British citizens whose husbands, from Yemen and Pakistan, want to come to the UK to be with their families.

Currently, the men must learn English and pass a test at an approved centre.

Their wives argued this was not feasible and breached their right to a family life. The judges did not agree.

The London court heard that Saiqa Bibi and Saffana Ali both claimed their husbands would not be able to pass a test before coming to the UK.

They argued the men would have to learn computer skills and travel long distances to take their English tests.

As such, their right to a private and family life under article 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR) was being breached, the court heard.

Since late 2010, the spouse or civil partner of a British citizen or person settled in Britain must pass an English language test before coming to the country.

Before the amendment to the immigration rules, they were only required to demonstrate such knowledge two years after entering the UK.

The panel of five judges were asked to rule that the pre-entry measure was "unreasonable, disproportionate and discriminatory".

The court unanimously dismissed the appeal.

Former brothel madam Cynthia Payne dies at 82

■ 'Madame Cyn' ran notorious brothel in Streatham, south London, that was shut down in the 1980s

Britain's best known madam Cynthia Payne – who was nicknamed Madame Cyn – has died aged 82, her family has said.

Payne was known for running a brothel in Streatham, south London, that was shut down in the late 1980s. In later life, she became an after-dinner speaker and she has been the subject of books and films.

She hit the headlines in 1978 when police raided a sex party at her home to find elderly men paying with luncheon vouchers.

imprisonment

Her life story was told in two films, one starring Julie Walters, and several books, including *An English Madam*. In 1980, she was sentenced to 18 months' imprisonment, reduced to six months and a fine on appeal, for running a brothel at her house on Ambleside Avenue.

But, in 1987, she was acquitted of controlling prostitutes in a second trial at the Inner London crown court. "This is a

victory for common sense. But I have to admit all this has put me off having parties for a bit," she said afterwards.

The BBC reported that she sent the judge, Brian Pryor QC, a copy of *An English Madam* following the conclusion of the 13-day trial with the inscription: "I hope this book will broaden your rather sheltered life".

'very big heart'

Family friend Kevin Horkin described her as "a national treasure" and an "extremely colourful archetypal English eccentric".

"She was a person with a very big heart," he said. "She is someone who epitomised the phrase 'what you saw is what you got'. Her beliefs, however, shone through strongly in the campaigning activity she was involved with in order to change Britain's sex laws, publicising the issue when she stood for parliament on two occasions in the Kensington and Chelsea byelection of 1988 and in the general election of

1992 in Streatham. She is someone who will be very sorely missed by all who knew her."

'best hostess'

Payne's website read: "I hit the headlines in 1978 when the police raided my home along a

pleasant tree-lined avenue in suburban Streatham, interrupting a sex party that was in full swing.

"For months afterwards, the media would write of queues of middle-aged and elderly men waiting to exchange

their 'luncheon vouchers' for food, drink, friendly chat, striptease shows, and a trip upstairs with the girl of their choice. Vicars, MPs and lawyers were amongst those who considered me to be the best hostess in London."

Barney batters Britain

■ Second named storm leaves thousands without power

■ First big snowstorm of winter season on the way

Thousands of homes were left without power and rail passengers faced lengthy delays after the second named storm of the winter season battered the UK with winds of more than 80mph this week.

Named Barney, the storm left 2,500 homes in the West Midlands

without their electricity supply, according to Western Power Distribution, and Welsh residents have also been badly affected.

Over 500 homes were still without power in Wales at press time with 6,000 Scottish Power customers off supply in North Wales at one point.

About 485 homes in some of the worst affected areas like Aberdaron and Caernarfon are still cut off, with a further 90 in Pembrokeshire still without power.

The highest winds were recorded on Tuesday at 83mph in coastal areas of North Wales, while gusts of 66mph registered in the villages of Weybourne in Norfolk and Wittering, near Peterborough in Cambridgeshire.

The second storm to bear a human name, coming hot on the heels of Storm Abigail, brought gusts strong enough to fell a metal advertising tower at The Fort Shopping Park in Birmingham, although nobody was hurt.

And to make matters worse, the Met Office

warned that blizzard conditions could be expected from Friday as the first major snow of the season hits the country.

A spokeswoman for the Met Office said: "We have a snow warning in force and for strong winds. Due to the strong winds we could see blizzards like conditions.

"Most places will see ice as temperatures drop to freezing. The wintery

weather will hot on Friday and remain for the weekend. Next week the weather will get milder again."

Last time the country saw a lot of snow at this time of year was in late November 2010.

This cold spell is expected to be fairly short-lived with temperatures expected to return to more typical values for the time of year early next week

with the weather remaining unsettled.

And in a sign of our social media-dominated times, the Environment Agency has warned Britons against talking 'selfies' against a background of crashing surf or high winds, due to rising number of casualties swept into the seas or injured by debris while trying to capture the perfect picture for Facebook.

Blind girl banned from using white stick

A blind girl has been banned from bringing her white walking stick to school because of "health and safety" reasons.

Lily-Grace Hooper, seven, suffered a stroke when she was just four days old, leaving her with virtually no sight.

But her school, Hambrook Primary School in Bristol, has told the youngster she can no longer use her cane because it could trip up teachers and other pupils.

A risk assessment completed on behalf of the school said the cane caused high risk to other people and that Lily-Grace should instead have "100 per cent" adult support at all times.

However, her mother is worried her daughter will become too dependent on having someone show her around - and said having a helper would set her daughter apart from other pupils.

Lily-Grace started using the cane in school in April. Her mother, Kristy Hooper, said it had become "an extension of her daughter's arm" and that it was vital she was allowed to use it.

She added: "It is a disability, but I want to celebrate it and make sure she can become independent. When the school told me she can no longer bring her cane into school, I just thought this must be health and safety gone mad.

"She hasn't had any problems with any of the other students, and none of the parents have complained about it - in fact, they have all been very supportive."

Man held in death of Yvonne Fletcher

A Libyan man has been arrested on suspicion of conspiracy to murder PC Yvonne Fletcher three decades ago.

PC Fletcher, 25, died after being shot while policing a demonstration outside the Libyan Embassy in London in 1984.

Scotland Yard described the arrest of the man, in his 50s, as a "significant development".

He was detained on Thursday morning in south-east England and is now in custody. He was also held on suspicion of money laundering.

Two other Libyan nationals - a woman in her 40s and a man in his 30s - were also arrested on suspicion of money laundering at separate addresses in London and south-east England.

PC Fletcher's family said in a statement that her father Tim had recently died, with his "one regret in life" being that he had "never witnessed any justice".

PC Fletcher was one of 50 officers policing a protest against Col Muammar Gaddafi's regime outside the embassy when she was hit by a burst of gunfire from a first-floor window.

The death of Gaddafi in 2011 and the subsequent regime change provided new lines of enquiry, with police visits to Libya

since then unearthing "new and fresh evidence".

The force has released images of 14 people they want to trace from a pro-Gaddafi group, which was holding a counter-demonstration nearby.

'Darkest day'

Video footage of the demonstration and shooting has also been released.

The 54-second clip shows the chaotic moments after shots were fired, with dozens of demonstrators falling to the ground after a loud bang is heard.

Commander Richard Walton, head of counter-terrorism at Scotland Yard, said: "The day Yvonne was shot remains one of the saddest and darkest days in the history of British policing.

"We have never lost our resolve to solve this case and to bring to justice those who conspired to commit this act of murder."

He said a number of shots were fired at 10:17 on the morning of 17 April, 1984, hitting PC Fletcher in the back. Ten anti-Gaddafi campaigners were also injured in the shooting.

Mr Walton said a pistol and an automatic weapon are thought to have been used. Police believe the shooting was part of the "stray dogs campaign" arranged from Libya to attack overseas dissidents.

PC Fletcher's family said: "Recently we have had to come to terms with another loss through the death of Yvonne's father, Tim.

"His one regret in life was that no one had been arrested... [he] never witnessed any justice. "Resolving this crime is still important to all the family.

"Any information, however small, can help bring closure for the family and we therefore continue to support the Metropolitan Police in their ongoing investigation."

THE MULBERRY Inn in Surrey is a long way from the Hollywood Bowl.

Yet former Beatle Paul McCartney will play the cosy commuter belt pub next summer as part of a fundraiser for leading British charity Children in Need.

Tickets for the show, which will take place on Saturday June 25, were sold by auction and sold out by 9.30am Thursday morning, raising £2 million.

The pub is owned by controversial BBC Radio 2 DJ Chris Evans, who invited Macca to perform while back stage at a BBC event, according to the musician, appearing on

Evans' show this week.

The best advice I've had here came from a British Professor who said: "There are few really big decisions, if you come to a fork in the road, just think about which way you want to go and keep walking."

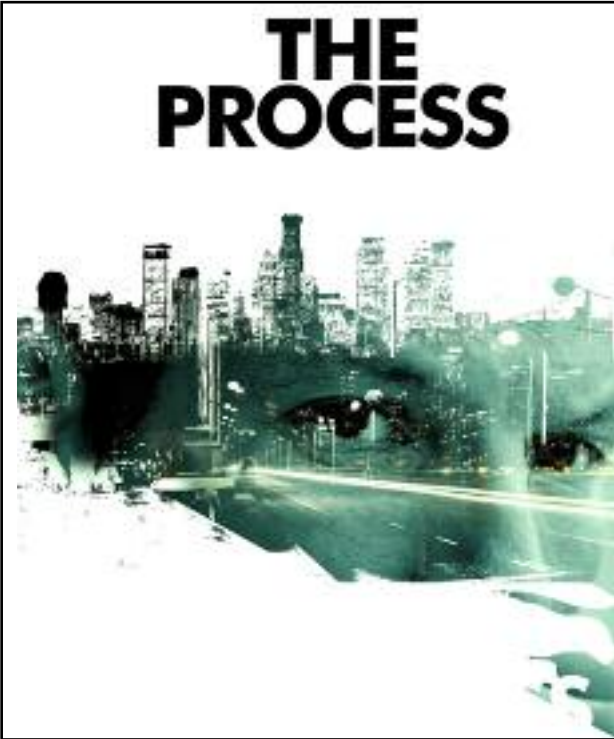

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The Haunted Season: classic British mystery

Exclusive interview
with author G.M.
Malliet and a review
of her latest Max
Tudor mystery

"Every single life decision I've made has been in the furtherance of the novels I longed to write," says *The Haunted Season* author G.M. Malliet. "I suppose I had some hero-worship of authors going on as I was growing up. I couldn't think of a more glamorous occupation."

"The fictional village of Nether Monkslip was the starting point for this series," says Malliet. "I started doodling a rough sketch of the village, that sketch in the hands of a skilled artist named Rhys Davies, commissioned by my editor at the time, later



became endpapers in the hardcover version of the first book, and appeared in several books thereafter. It also features as a banner on my website. In other words, I got a lot of mileage out of that one map."

The Haunted Season brings the classic elements of a British village mystery, but the stories are not old fashioned. It's a wonderful twist that cleric Max Tudor was once an MI5 agent. The book starts with the point of view of Max's new assistant

Destiny in London, which is fine, except it switches abruptly to Max in the village. What happened to Destiny? The relationship between Max and his New Age wife is charming.

In the sleepy English village of Nether Monkslip, Max Tudor the vicar and his parishioners look forward to the return of Lord and Lady Baaden-Boomethistle. There's a murder and a secret involving a kidnapped baby. And, there's a violation of the sanctuary of the church. Your typical British sleuthing. Overall, the story has too many twists, mysteries and subplots.

For research, Malliet did a lot of reading on rural England and English villages. "I also follow the weather over there quite closely as it is always an element of my books. And travel, I get to the UK once

a year on average. Yorkshire is a particular favorite although my Max Tudor books are set along the Southwestern coast. I recently revisited Orchard House, home of Louisa May Alcott, and I was teary-eyed as I was leaving. To have that kind of impact on generations of readers, I think that is what every writer secretly hopes for."

All four of the Max Tudor books to date have been nominated for the Agatha Award for best novel. Malliet's first St. Just book, *Death of a Cozy Writer*, won the Malice Domestic grant and the Malice Domestic Agatha award. Malliet says the Max Tudor and St. series were written with television in mind, and have yet to be optioned for TV or film.

Anne Brewer at Minotaur Publishing Macmillan is Malliet's

editor. "Just being published was a life-long dream come true," says Malliet. "The most difficult part of writing a book is that you are never quite done. You edit and revise and copy edit and proof, and by the time it is actually published you feel like you've read it a dozen times, which you pretty much have, and you are itching to move on to the next thing."

Malliet got her break when editor at Minotaur found her online. "She liked what she'd seen on my website," says Malliet. "Fortunately, I had been sketching out the Max books in my head and on paper for a long time by that point, so I was ready."

Malliet is next writing the fourth book in the St. Just mystery series. She's finishing writing a draft of a standalone mystery, first-person, set in one of the posh postal codes just

outside London. "It is a bit of *Desperate Housewives* in the Village," says Malliet.

Malliet lives with her husband in Virginia, near Washington, D.C. She spent her childhood in Fairbanks, Alaska, living in a log cabin.

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Adele Rolls in Deeper With Her Latest Album, '25'!

British singer Adele has always been more than just a pretty voice. Though she's blessed with a mighty instrument - a resonant alto that stretches to gleaming heights - what has made her singing stand out is its instinctive quality, her willingness to jump into a song heart-first.

Where many contemporary pop stars are concerned with projecting attitude, Adele understands the value of unfettered emotion. Judging by her new project '25' out Nov. 20, the four years since Adele's last studio album have provided plenty of fodder in this arena.

Titled, like her previous efforts, for the year that inspired the record, the collection at first suggests an artist closer to 35, or even a decade older than that. There's a recurring sense of youth flying by, or a longing as if it's already passed. There's no extended adolescence for this millennial, apparently.

The stark opening piano chords of Hello, the first single, set an almost funereal tone. "Hello from the other side," she belts, her singing seeming a tad less husky than in the past, perhaps as a result of her surgery following the vocal problems that thwarted her 2011 tour.

But she sounds as



strong and as vulnerable as ever, her voice sometimes threatening to break at the end of a note, only to come back in full, aching force.

"The other side" is not the afterlife, but our time on earth following early adulthood. Other songs, too, approach the passage of time with the kind of dark romanticism a young singer would more typically use to describe a dangerous lover. "You still look like a movie, you still sound like a song/My God, this reminds me of when we were young," she sings to a former flame on When We Were Young.

On A Million Years Ago, a bit of melancholic nostalgia that could be a lost Jacques Brel tune, she remembers when "life was a party to be thrown," and laments that old acquaintances "don't recognize me in the light of day."

The co-writers and

producers on 25, among them Greg Kurstin and Adele's Rolling In the Deep collaborator Paul Epworth, craft tracks that sound lush but are also spacious, wisely keeping Adele's vocals in front - even on more muscular numbers such as the galloping Water Under the Bridge and I Miss You, with its thick, insistent percussion. Love In The Dark is the only song featuring strings; on it, Adele begs, "Take your eyes off of me so I can leave."

25 ends on an uplifting note, though, with the chiming Sweetest Devotion, a love song to Adele's three-year-old son. "I've been looking for you, baby, in every face that I've ever known," she sings. Take heart, aging kids. Maturity and responsibility have their rewards as well.

Adele darling, you are rolling higher than ever with this album babe... it's a winner!

'Alien: Covenant' reveals Fassbender's fate!

Just as Ridley Scott revealed the name of the next installment of *Prometheus*, a flood of new information has just hit the internet.

Oo-er!!

The film, now retitled 'Alien: Covenant' (originally *Alien: Lost Paradise*), now has an official logo and synopsis from 20th Century Fox confirming Michael Fassbender, (pictured, right), will return for the movie.

The studio description reads: "Ridley Scott returns to the universe he created in *Alien* with *Alien: Covenant*, the second chapter in a prequel trilogy that began with *Prometheus* - and connects directly to Scott's 1979 seminal work of science fiction.

"Bound for a remote planet on the far side of the galaxy, the crew of the colony ship *Covenant* discovers what they think is an



uncharted paradise, but is actually a dark, dangerous world - whose sole inhabitant is the 'synthetic' David (Michael Fassbender), survivor of the doomed *Prometheus* expedition." Notably, Noomi Rapace's explorer Elizabeth Shaw is not mentioned although she was last seen alive in *Prometheus*.

The description also confirms there will be another film after *Covenant*, making up a full prequel trilogy

linking directly to the original *Alien*.

Scott previously said that the first sequel would not lead straight into the original, but that it would take time for the series to explain what happened.

He said at the time: "The whole point of it is to explain the *Alien* franchise and to explain the how and why of the creation of the *Alien* itself. I always thought of the *Alien* as kind of a piece of bacterial warfare."

Rugby great Jonah Lomu dead at 40



ICONIC: Lomu arrived on the world stage in unforgettable fashion at the 1995 World Cup

New Zealand rugby union great Jonah Lomu has died aged 40.

Lomu, who scored 37 tries in 63 matches for New Zealand between 1994 and 2002, had been diagnosed with a rare and serious kidney condition in 1995.

It forced him to quit the game and he had a kidney transplant in 2004, but the organ stopped functioning in 2011.

“Jonah was a legend of our game and loved by his many fans both here and around the world,” said New Zealand Rugby chief executive Steve Tew.

“We’re lost for words and our heartfelt sympathies go out to Jonah’s family.”

Family spokesman John Mayhew told New Zealand television that Lomu’s death was “totally unexpected” and that he had only arrived back from the UK on Tuesday, after spending time there for

the Rugby World Cup.

New Zealand Prime Minister John Key said: “The thoughts of the entire country are with his family.”

New Zealand Sports Minister Jonathan Coleman said Lomu “was the first global rugby superstar”.

He was a “huge inspiration to Polynesian men and actually in later years with his battles against kidney disease, very inspirational to people suffering from chronic diseases as well”, he said.

Lomu is survived by his wife Nadene and two sons.

The son of Tongan immigrants, Lomu made his Test debut in 1994 against France in Christchurch.

As well as playing for several domestic teams in his homeland, he made 10 appearances for Cardiff Blues in Wales between 2005 and 2006, shortly before his retirement.

Despite never winning the World Cup, he is the joint top try-scorer in its history - alongside South Africa wing Bryan Habana, scoring 15 tries in 11 games.

He was at his best at the 1995 and 1999 World Cups, terrifying defensive lines with his speed and size – he was 6 feet 4 inches tall and weighed 262lbs.

In a memorable match against England in the 1995 semi-final, he bulldozed several players and ran straight over the top of full-back Mike Catt on his way to a try.

His performance in that tournament has been widely credited with helping attract the major commercial deals that enabled the sport to enter the professional era.

But a rare kidney condition, nephrotic syndrome, hampered his career. A later transplant was rejected by his body in 2011.

Eddie Jones was set to become the England rugby team’s first foreign head coach on Friday.

Former Australia and Japan coach Jones had needed to secure his release from a “long-term contract” with South African franchise the Stormers.

Jones succeeds Stuart Lancaster, who left the job after England’s failed 2015 World Cup campaign.

Former England captain Steve Borthwick could be brought in as part of Jones’ coaching team. He is under contract as forwards coach at Bristol and worked with Jones at Saracens and Japan.

South African Jake White had also been under consideration for the job of head coach.

However, White - a World Cup winner with the Springboks in 2007 - said on Thursday: “I have

a contract with Montpellier. I’m not going to change, I’m staying here. It’s important for the club, for the players and for the atmosphere to remove the doubt.”

Jones was only appointed as the new Stormers head coach in September after leading Japan to the World Cup in England, during which they recorded a famous victory over South Africa in the pool stage.

He fits Ritchie’s desire to appoint a man with “proven international experience”.

As well as Jones and White, Wales coach Warren Gatland had been linked with the role,

although the New Zealander insisted he is committed to honouring his contract, which runs until 2019.

However, former Australia international David Campese said a foreign coach makes England look “desperate”.

Speaking on BBC Radio 5 live, he said: “Don’t you want an Englishman to coach an English team and win the World Cup?”

“It obviously shows that after the World Cup you guys are lost. You’ve got all the money in the world - and all the players - and you’ve still got no idea how to play the game.”

Veteran Bell dropped for South Africa tour

spinner Samit Patel are included and Adil Rashid is left out.

Bell, 33, said he was “absolutely gutted” to miss out, but is “determined” to win his place back.

The tour begins on 15 December, with the first Test on 26 December.

England, who start with a warm-up game against a South African Invitational XI, will play four Tests, five one-day internationals and two

Twenty20s.

South Africa are the top-ranked Test side in the world.

Martin O'Neill wants his Republic of Ireland team to create more magical moments when they play at the Euro 2016 finals in France next summer.

The Irish sealed their place by beating Bosnia-Herzegovina 2-0 in Dublin on Monday, clinching a 3-1 aggregate win.

“This is a special night which cannot be taken away from us,” said O'Neill. “We will have a massive contingent of fans going to France and I would like to emulate the days of Jack Charlton and Mick McCarthy.”

The win sparked emotional scenes from the home side and its fans but Bosnia were left

aggrieved, feeling the 24th minute penalty that put the Republic ahead was harsh.

England boss Roy Hodgson said of the game: "I was pleased the FA set about showing our respect and marking this sad occasion.

"It was handled quite brilliantly.

"It was a very poignant occasion and we achieved all the things we wanted to achieve in the remembrance. An act of defiance was better than

the other alternative."

France boss Didier Deschamps told reporters: "We would like to thank everyone for their statements and their actions of solidarity. We feel very grateful because not just the people at Wembley, but the whole nation has supported us."

On fans uniting to sing La Marseillaise, the 1998 World Cup winner said: "We felt very, very strong emotions, powerful emotions. Everyone has their own way of displaying their emotions but it was certainly a moment where everyone came together."

Barca join Stones hunt

■ Catalan giants join Chelsea and United in tug of war for Everton defender

John Stones is likely to be the subject of an intense bidding war next summer with Barcelona among the leading teams scouting the Everton star.

Scouts from the Catalan giants were detailed to watch England's friendly against Spain in Alicante last week and although Stones never left the bench, the central defender's display in Tuesday's victory over France will ensure Barcelona continue to monitor his progress.

Just days before facing England with Spain, Barcelona defender

Gerard Piqué named Stones as the only Englishman in his World XI in an with The Daily Telegraph.

Piqué praised the defender as "one of a new generation who understand football not just as a defender", prompting several observers to conclude the praise was the opening salvo in a charm offensive designed to lure the player next summer.

The 21-year-old Stones was the subject of a £30m bid from Chelsea during the summer which Everton rejected, with

Toffees manager Roberto Martínez reportedly telling the player that he would one day move somewhere 'better than Stamford Bridge'.

Moving abroad so early in his career might be a step Stones is unwilling to take. Another obstacle in the way of Barcelona's interest would be his fee. Having seen off repeated bids from Chelsea, Everton will demand over £40 million when they eventually agree to sell and Barcelona do not traditionally pay the biggest money on central defenders.

England edge France on night of football unity

■ Alli and Rooney on target in emotional night at Wembley

England beat France 2-0 Tuesday night at Wembley on an emotional night as more than 70,000 fans honoured the victims of the Paris attacks.

Fans united before kick off to sing La Marseillaise - the French national anthem - in front of the Duke of Cambridge and Prime Minister David Cameron.

There was a perfectly observed minute's silence, with both sets of players standing together.

Dele Alli scored on his full England debut, a fine 25-yard finish, before Wayne Rooney's volley sealed victory.

England's 10th and final game of the calendar

year brought a seventh victory yet this was a night when the result, tactics and performance were secondary.

The French Football Federation chose to go ahead with the fixture despite Friday's attacks in Paris that left 129 people dead.

There was an excellent show of unity for the French national anthem

before the England and France teams mixed in with each other for a pre-match team photograph to huge applause.

England boss Roy Hodgson and his France counterpart Didier Deschamps embraced after joining Prince William, president of the Football Association, in
