EU vote: chugging towards a Brexit?

■ EU referendum poll: Leave surges to SIX POINT lead

WITH LESS THAN a week to go before the pivotal EU vote, the Leave campaign is now six points ahead of Remain according to a stunning new poll.

The telephone study by Ipsos MORI on Wednesday also reveals widespread distrust of what is widely perceived as the Government's 'scaremongering' campaign.

The poll results show 53% of British people now want to leave the 28-country bloc, with just 47% saying they will vote remain.

This marked a huge swing from last month's poll by the same group, which saw 60% of people choosing Remain and

40% backing Leave.

It is also the first time Leave has lead the respected poll, commissioned by the Evening Standard newspaper.

The poll revealed only 17% of people believe George Osborne's claim households would be £4,300 worse off after Brexit. The poll also revealed immigration is now seen as the most important issue in the vote by 33% of people, overtaking the economy which has dropped to

28%.

However, despite Leave's lead, one-fifth of respondents said they may still change their mind on which way they will vote.

Gideon Skinner of Ipsos MORI said: "The Leave campaign is getting their messages across, especially on the

key public concern on immigration.

"But the Remain camp is finding it much harder to convince people that their core economic messages, both on the risks of Brexit and the benefits of staying, is going to have a personal impact on their lives."

And the increasingly

vitriolic tone of the campaign is also seen to be influencing voters, with music icon Bob Geldof earning widespread criticism for 'insulting' fisherman campaigning to leave the EU.

Geldof interrupted a flotilla of Leave supporters and blasted

his own music in an attempt to drown out there display, prompting one disgruntled campaigner to comment: "It's these kind of bullying, aggressive tactics from the other side that are causing fair-minded Britons to move ever closer to the **cont. on page 2, col. 6**

We'll make you pay: France threatens costly Brexit to avoid anti-EU surge

FRANCE will make Britain PAY if people vote to leave the European Union on June 23, according to reports from London.

The eurozone's second largest economy is determined to leave the UK with a bloody nose if it chooses to Leave and will ensure a divorce is sealed swiftly.

In a thinly veiled threat to voters, French officials have warned they will shun Britain when it comes to establishing new immigration and financial rules in the event of a British exodus.

The French are also expected to push other EU members to take a hardline approach to Britain over unwinding treaties and agreements binding the UK to the 28-nation bloc, according to an EU source.

A senior EU source told Politico: "If we say you

are outside the EU but can keep all of the advantages, access to the single market without any solidarity, it's a terrible message for the rest of the EU.

"A painless Brexit is impossible if we want to keep the rest of the EU present."

'business as usual'

One source close to the Leave campaign said: "This is business as usual from the French. It's simply the latest doomsday message from an EU country worried about losing the £350million that Brussels siphons off from British taxpayers every week."

But there is speculation Paris may be acting in spite, as they work to crush the rise of anti-EU National Front who could make waves in the country's 2017 presidential elections.

France warns Brexit would restrict the "passporting" of financial services, which allows foreign-owned companies to do business with the EU via offices in Britain.

In the event of Britain leaving the bloc, the EU may no longer recognise the British supervisory bodies, which could push firms to leave Britain and instead establish themselves inside Europe.

Sylvie Goulard, French MEP who sits on the economic and monetary affairs committee, told an American political news website: "I would be very tough. I see no reason to give passporting to a country that decides in a sovereign way to leave the EU."

"The day the UK leaves you cannot consider the British supervising authority as an authority of the EU."

On trade, EU members would have to curve a new relationship with Britain, something that would require the European Commission and debates in Parliament and Council.

It is believed that Paris hopes Britain will adopt the Nordic trade model, which accepts all EU regulations including the free movement of workers in exchange for access to the single market. And investment links are also in the firing line as France - the second biggest investor in Britain - threaten to reevaluate future involvement in the event of the UK leaving the EU.

As of December 2015 France has 124 projects in the UK, accounting for 8,198 jobs.

The nation will have to tread carefully, however, in terms of visa and travel restrictions - France has 160,000 citizens living in Britain, who could be targeted in turn by visa restrictions on foreign travellers and workers if Paris looks to punish the UK.

Petros Fassoulas, secretary general of European Movement International, a leading pro-EU group in Brussels, said: "The French don't want to create an EU economic cold war."

Another EU diplomat added: "People underestimate the rights of the EU citizen."

"You may have to go through diplomatic channels to defend your rights if the UK leaves the EU."

Disbelief and shock as Labour MP is shot dead in her constituency

An MP has died after she was shot and stabbed in an attack in her constituency, West Yorkshire Police have said.

Jo Cox, 41, Labour MP for Batley and Spen, had been left bleeding on the ground by her attacker. A 52-year-old man was arrested nearby.

Her husband Brendan Cox said she would want people "to unite to fight against the hatred that killed her".

David Cameron and Jeremy Corbyn were among the politicians paying tribute.

Vote Leave and Remain have both suspended campaigning in the EU referendum in light of the attack.

Mrs Cox is the first sitting MP to be killed

since 1990, when Ian Gow was the last in a string of politicians to die at the hands of Northern Irish terror groups.

Labour leader Mr Corbyn said the country would be "in shock at the horrific murder", describing the MP as a **cont. on page 6, col. 4**

Sir Clement Freud exposed as sexual predator

■ As Freud is accused of abusing girls as young as 10 over a number of decades, his widow says she is 'deeply saddened and profoundly sorry for what has happened to these women'

Sir Clement Freud, the former broadcaster and politician, was exposed on Tuesday night as a paedophile who sexually abused girls as young as 10 for decades.

Freud, who died in 2009, spent years abusing a girl who he brought up as a daughter, and violently raped a teenager while he was an MP.

His widow, Lady Freud, has apologised to his victims, saying she is "shocked, deeply saddened and profoundly sorry" for what her husband of 58 years did to them.

McCann link

Detectives investigating the disappearance of Madeleine McCann have been alerted to the fact that Freud had a villa in Praia da Luz, Portugal, the resort where the three-year-old went missing in 2007.

He befriended the McCanns in the weeks after their daughter went missing, entertaining them at his house on two occasions and keeping

Scotland: more armed police on the way

Scotland is to increase its number of armed police officers by about a third following warnings that the country would not be able to cope with a major terror attack.

Police Scotland said it would recruit an additional 90 officers who will be attached to Armed Response Vehicles, bringing the total number 365.

It will also recruit 34 more trainers and specialist firearms officers.

But the force stressed there was no specific terror threat to Scotland.

in contact by phone and email.

The McCanns are said to be "horrified" by the discovery that Freud was a paedophile.

His family, who include the PR executive Matthew Freud, have said that Freud was not in Portugal at the time of Madeleine's disappearance and that they have not been contacted by police.

However, officers from Operation Grange, the ongoing Metropolitan Police investigation into Madeleine's disappearance, are expected to assess the new information before deciding if it may be relevant to the inquiry.

Freud was unmasked as a child sex abuser after one of his victims contacted ITV's Exposure documentary team, who also broke the story of Jimmy Savile's paedophilia four years ago.

Sylvia Woosley said Freud befriended her family in 1948, when he was working at a hotel in the South of France, and started abusing her when she was 10.

Four years later, following a family crisis,

her mother asked Freud and his wife Jill if they would look after Mrs Woosley, and she found herself living under the same roof as her abuser, being brought up as a daughter. The abuse continued until she managed to move away when she was 19.

'sad day for me'

Another woman told ITV that Freud started abusing her in the 1970s, when she was 11, and eventually raped her when she was 18, by which time he was a Liberal MP sharing an office with Cyril Smith, who was also unmasked as a paedophile after his death. The rape was so brutal that his victim bled for a week.

Both women's accounts have been passed on to the Metropolitan Police.

Lady Freud said: "This is a very sad day for me. I was married to Clement for 58 years and loved him dearly. I am shocked, deeply saddened and profoundly sorry for what has happened to these women. I sincerely hope they will now have some peace."

Freud, who was knighted in 1987, was best known as a popular panellist on the Radio 4 show *Just a Minute* from 1967 until his death in 2009.

The grandson of the psychoanalyst Sigmund Freud and the brother

of the painter Lucian Freud, he worked his way into the heart of British society, and when he died the then Prime Minister, Gordon Brown, was among the mourners at his funeral.

His five children include Matthew Freud

and the broadcaster Emma Freud.

A spokesman for the McCann family said they had not until now been aware of Freud's child abuse and were not aware that he had ever been investigated by Operation Grange.

THE QUEEN celebrated her 90th birthday last weekend in no-nonsense mood as an estimated 10,000 well-wishers braved drenching rain and chilly conditions.

Having arrived 11

minutes late at St Paul's Cathedral on Friday, the Queen was in no mood to keep an army of charity workers invited to a special lunch to mark the big day, waiting for a minute longer than

necessary.

Anxious that her speech at The Patron's Lunch should be on schedule, Her Majesty felt the driver of her open-topped Range Rover was processing too slowly down The Mall.

At her urging, the Duke of Edinburgh banged on the roof of the car to alert him to pick up the pace, and the event was quickly back on track.

Her guests, of course, would no doubt have preferred the vehicle to crawl past, to give them the best possible view of their Patron, whom they had all turned out to wish a happy 90th birthday.

'granny'

Yet the Queen, who hates being fussed over, regarded the event as a way of thanking them, rather than the other way around. "You are an example to us all," she told them - words that

are so often used about the Queen herself - as she paid tribute to their "commitment, selfless devotion and generosity of spirit".

She also made it clear that after three months of birthday celebrations, which began on her actual birthday on April 21, it was time to move on and get back to work.

"I much appreciate the kindness of all your birthday wishes," she said, "and have been delighted and moved by the many cards and messages I have received."

"How I will feel if people are still singing Happy Birthday to me in December remains to be seen!"

Her grandson, the Duke of Cambridge, referring to her as "granny", praised her "strong health and relentless energy; her sharp wit and famous sense of humour, and the fact that the Queen remains very much at the helm of our family, our nation and the Commonwealth".

He also described her as someone "that world leaders can turn to for a first-hand perspective of the arc of history".

Her first Prime Minister, of course, was Sir Winston Churchill, who had a favourite expression to motivate his staff when times were tough: Keep Buggering On.

It may well have been in the Queen's mind as she and the Duke of York peeked through the net curtains on the balcony of Buckingham Palace in the

late morning to see a Mall filled with ponchos.

Her grandson Peter Phillips had spent more than 18 months organising The Patron's Lunch, to which all 612 of the charities connected to the Queen were invited (the fact that around 10 per cent of them had not taken up the offer suggested some had been put off by the controversial £150 per head ticket price, on top of travel and accommodation costs).

'only a bit of rain'

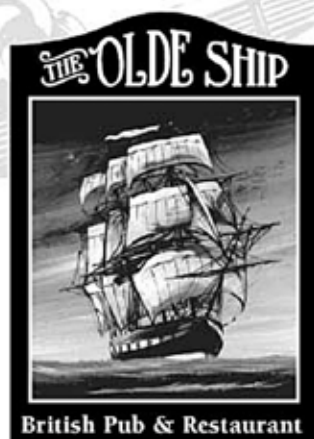
Mr Phillips knew that the one thing he could not control was the weather, and given the Queen's previous history of rain on her parades, he was right to be worried. The Coronation in 1953, the Thames Diamond Jubilee Pageant in 2012, and now this.

"I'm soaked," he admitted as he watched people taking their seats. "It's such a shame, it obviously would have been better if it was dry, but...the show must go on!"

Sir Cliff cleared of all abuse allegations

■ 'I've been hung out like live bait' says veteran entertainer

SIR CLIFF Richard has been cleared of sex assault allegations after the Crown Prosecution Service announced it would bring no charges following a two-year police inquiry.

The 75-year-old singer will face no further action following the controversial South Yorkshire Police investigation into allegations of historical sexual abuse.

Prosecutors announced on Thursday morning that there was "insufficient evidence to prosecute" the veteran entertainer after the police investigation that cost an estimated £800,000.

Sir Cliff said he is "obviously thrilled that the vile accusations" have been brought to a close" as he used his statement to say he had been "hung out like live bait" and called for those who are facing allegations to "never be named publicly until charged".

South Yorkshire Police apologised "wholeheartedly for the additional anxiety caused" to Sir Cliff by the force's "initial handling

of the media interest" in its investigation into the singer, when the BBC was tipped off about a raid on his home and broadcast it live.

Sir Cliff's Berkshire home was raided by South Yorkshire Police in August 2014 after they received a tip from Operation Yewtree, detailing an allegation that dated back more than quarter of a century. Officers travelled from South Yorkshire in a convoy of unmarked vehicles and entered the private estate shortly after 1pm.

'utterly inept'

But within minutes of their arrival news of the raid was being broadcast on the BBC which had stationed a producer outside the Sunningdale property the previous evening.

The broadcaster even used a news helicopter overhead to film detectives as they removed items from the star's apartment.

It was later revealed that the force had cut a deal with the BBC in order to allow the filming of the raid.

An independent investigation subsequently criticised the arrangement for interfering with Sir Cliff's privacy and causing unnecessary distress.

The Home Affairs Select Committee later described the police raid as "utterly inept".

In a statement, Sir Cliff said: "After almost two years under police investigation I learnt today that they have finally closed their enquiries.

"I have always maintained my innocence, co-operated fully with the investigation, and cannot understand why it has taken so long to get to this point!

"Nevertheless, I am obviously thrilled that the vile accusations and the resulting investigation have finally been brought to a close.

"Ever since the highly-publicised and BBC-filmed raid on my home I have chosen not to speak publicly.

"Even though I was under pressure to 'speak out', other than to state my innocence, which was easy for me to do as

I have never molested anyone in my life, I chose to remain silent.

"This was despite the widely-shared sense of injustice resulting from the high-profile fumbling of my case from day one. Other than in exceptional cases, people who are facing allegations should never be named publicly until charged."

'wonderful support'

He continued: "I was named before I was even interviewed and for me that was like being hung out like 'live bait'.

"It is obvious that such strategies simply increase the risk of attracting spurious claims which not only tie up police resources and waste public funds, but they forever tarnish the reputations of innocent people.

"There have been numerous occasions in recent years where this has occurred, and I feel

very strongly that no innocent person should be treated in this way.

"I know the truth and in some people's eyes the CPS' announcement today doesn't go far enough because it doesn't expressly state that I am innocent; which of course I am. There lies the problem.

"My reputation will not be fully vindicated because the CPS' policy is to only say something general about there being 'insufficient' evidence.

"How can there be evidence for something that never took place! This is also a reason why people should never be named publicly until they have been charged unless there are exceptional circumstances.

"To my fans and members of the public, to the press and media, all of whom continued to show me such encouraging and wonderful support, I would like to say "thank

you" it would have been so much harder without you."

The original allegation came from a single complainant who alleged that when he was 16 he had been molested by the singer during a Christian rally.

The incident was said to have taken place when devout Christian, Sir Cliff, appeared as a special guest of the American evangelist Billy Graham in Sheffield in 1985.

But Sir Cliff vehemently denied the claims suggesting the complaint had been the result of false rumours that had been circulating online.

He was subsequently questioned about the allegation but heard nothing more from the South Yorkshire force, which insisted there was much work to do in order to investigate such an historic claim.

England fans jailed over violence

Six supporters of the England football team have been given jail time in France as part of the investigation into the weekend's violence.

Another four England fans have been jailed in France following the weekend's violence in Marseille, bringing the total to six.

Lee Phillips, 23, and Paul Jackson, 21, were jailed for one month. Ashley Kelly,

26, was sentenced to three months and Steven Cornell, 28, was jailed for two months. They were all given a two-year ban from France.

Earlier, two other England fans appeared in court in Marseille over the violent clashes that erupted at the Euro 2016 tournament.

Alexander Booth, 20, and Ian Hepworth, 41, a psychiatric nurse from Sheffield, were jailed for

two months and three months respectively - and also banned from France for two years.

Before Booth was given his sentence, he told the judge: "I'm truly sorry. I was in the wrong place at the wrong time, but I'm no hooligan."

It comes as French authorities admitted that around 150 "hyper violent" Russian football hooligans escaped arrest.

Page testifies in 'Stairway' plagiarism case

■ **Zeppelin guitarist denies any prior knowledge of song he is accused of copying**

Led Zeppelin guitarist Jimmy Page told a Los Angeles courtroom on Wednesday that he had not heard a song he is accused of copying when he wrote Stairway To Heaven, until his son-in-law played it for him on the internet.

The British musician said the instrumental track Taurus, by American band Spirit, was "alien" to him and he was "confused" about why it was being linked to his classic 1971 hit.

A lawsuit has been filed by Michael Skidmore, the trustee of Spirit guitarist Randy Wolfe – known as Randy California – who drowned in 1997 having never taken legal action over the song.

Jimmy, 72, told the federal court that he "liked" Spirit in the late 1960s but he only became aware of the song Taurus in recent years.

"It was after the internet comparison which came up a few years ago," he said.

"My son-in-law brought to my attention a comparison of Stairway To Heaven and a Spirit song. I said I'd like to hear it. I don't do the internet or computers so he played it to me."

Jimmy said the music by Spirit began with an orchestra which was "totally alien" to him.

"I knew I had never heard it before," he told the court. "Something like that would have stuck in my mind. I would remember that."

"I was a bit confused because I thought, 'What has this got to do with Stairway To Heaven?'"

Page was joined in court by Led Zeppelin

singer Robert Plant as both men face a copyright infringement trial over the opening guitar riff of Stairway To Heaven.

Giving evidence on the second day of the trial, Page said he was aware of "some of sort of buzz" on the internet about a comparison between Stairway To Heaven and Taurus and acknowledged both tracks were in the same key of A minor.

'wink to music'

He told the court he had never seen Spirit play live, despite them performing on the same bill when Led Zeppelin played their first US concert in Denver, Colorado, in December 1968.

"I always thought the Denver show was us supporting Vanilla Fudge," he told the court.

The veteran rocker said he could remember owning Spirit's second and third albums in the 1960s but only discovered later that he possessed their first and fourth albums and a live recording by the band.

He told the court he owned a "massive amount" of music and a recent count had revealed he had 4,329 albums and 5,882 CDs.

The court heard that Led Zeppelin would play a riff from Spirit's song Fresh Garbage during a medley in their early shows in the late 1960s.

The Whole Lotta Love musicians would "wink to music that was hot at the time", Page said in written evidence read to the court.

"We didn't have a lot of material in those

days," he added.

Jimmy, wearing a black three-piece suit, with his grey hair tied back in a ponytail, nodded his head to the music as Fresh Garbage was played to the jury during the hearing.

Earlier, Wolfe's former bandmate Mark Andes told the court that Spirit played Taurus at the

Denver concert

And added that Spirit also played at music festivals in Texas, Atlanta, North California and Seattle where Led Zeppelin were on the bill.

The court was shown videos of Stairway To Heaven and Taurus being performed on an acoustic guitar.

Mr Skidmore's lawyer

Francis Malofiy asked: "Do they sound the same to you?"

Mr Andes replied: "They do."

The musician told the court that members of Spirit played snooker with Plant after the US group played a gig at Mothers club in Birmingham in 1970.

"much loved colleague".

He added: "Jo died doing her public duty at the heart of our democracy, listening to and representing the people she was elected to serve.

"In the coming days, there will be questions to answer about how and why she died.

"But for now all our thoughts are with Jo's husband Brendan and their two young children. They will grow up without their mum, but can be immensely proud of what she did, what she achieved and what she stood for."

Cafe owner Clarke Rothwell, who witnessed the attack, said he heard a "loud popping noise that sounded like a balloon burst - a loud balloon".

"When I looked round there's a man stood there in his 50s with a white baseball cap on and a jacket with a gun, an old fashioned looking gun in his hand," he said.

"He shot this lady once and then he shot her again, he fell to the floor, leant over shot her once more in the face area.

"Somebody tried to grab him, wrestling with him and then he wielded a knife, like a hunting knife, just started lunging at her with a knife half a dozen times. People were screaming and running from the area".

Eyewitness Hithem Ben Abdallah, said the mother of two was left lying and bleeding on the pavement after the incident.

Mr Abdallah, 56, was in a cafe next door to the library shortly after 13:00 BST when he heard screaming and went outside.

'Handmade weapon'

"There was a guy who was being very brave and another guy with a white baseball cap who he was trying to control and the man in the baseball cap suddenly pulled a gun from his bag".

After a brief scuffle, he said the man stepped back and the MP became involved.

Mr Abdallah said the weapon had "looked handmade" and a man who had been wrestling with the gunman continued even after seeing the gun.

He said: "The man stepped back with the gun and fired it and then he fired a second shot, as he was firing he was looking down at the ground."

"He was kicking her as she was lying on the floor", he said.

Her husband, Brendan, has since tweeted a picture of his wife standing by the side of the River Thames in London.

Leeds North East MP Fabian Hamilton said he had known Jo Cox since before she became an MP.

Mr Hamilton said: "And I'm just completely devastated, I know Birstall reasonably well, and I think we're all totally shocked."

Huddersfield MP Barry Sheerman said he was "absolutely stunned".

"I was a mentor to her," he added.

Finding enlightenment with "The Hairy Ape"

Call me crazy, but I think it's more than just coincidence that four days after *Odyssey Theatre* opens their production of Eugene O'Neill's expressionist play "The Hairy Ape", Pope Francis goes all High Sparrow at his morning mass, condemning the "theology of prosperity", saying employers who use the poor for their enrichment are "bloodsuckers".

One can most definitely say that this 1922 play, about man's dehumanization by modern industry and the privileged classes, seems very contemporary and relevant in our current economic and political times, which resembles a slow slide back to the financial and social inequality of the early 20th century.

"The Hairy Ape" tells the story of Robert "Yank" Smith, an uncouth coal-stoker, a runaway raised

on brutality, who finds belonging in the bowels of a streamliner, where he is king, the strongest of his co-workers, made up of immigrants, including an English socialist, intent on defending workers rights. However, he is made to question his value as a human being by the arrival of an "angel" in the form of Mildred, the ship-owners privileged daughter, who calls him a "filthy beast". Becoming conscious to the reality of his existence, he embarks on a quest in the streets of Manhattan to seek revenge, and to reaffirm his place in the

world. Sadly, all he finds is exclusion, suffering, and ultimately an ironic death.

It makes perfect sense that this production should be directed by award-winning British writer/actor/director, Steven Berkoff, returning for the third time to direct at the *Odyssey*. In an interview with *The Irish Times* in 2014, he said in the past that he has been kept outside of the RSC and National for years, and no doubt this exclusion from these national institutions, and constant feelings of being an outsider forging his own path, is echoed by O'Neill's protagonist, Yank.

In this production, Berkoff does what he does best, adhering to his artistic philosophy that "everything in [his] art must be created from the body onwards". The focus remains on his ensemble of actors, so

there is minimal set and lighting design, and it is up to the cast to physically communicate the location and emotion of the play. A lot is asked physically and vocally of the cast; from the sheer athleticism of the brawling coal-stokers, recreating the physical behavior of primates, to the stylized movement of the 5th avenue swells; which the whole cast does with great success. They are rhythmically accompanied by percussionist Will Mahood, to emphasize moments of action and tension, much like a hayashi in Japanese

Kabuki. Yank, played with gut busting energy by Hailé D'Alan, resembles every inch a brawler, though at times I found O'Neill's vivid language and ideas were getting lost as the focus is so strongly on the physical. Dennis Gersten gives a funny and affecting performance as Paddy, the eldest of the coal-stokers. The scene where he remembers his youth on the sailboats of old was one of the most moving in the play, aided by Berkoff's mesmerizing staging. Katy Davis and Jennifer Taub achieve stratospherically refined

airs in their uber-heightened delivery as Mildred and her Aunt. In short, the whole ensemble cast certainly proves that in this production they are "de ting in gold dat makes it money!"

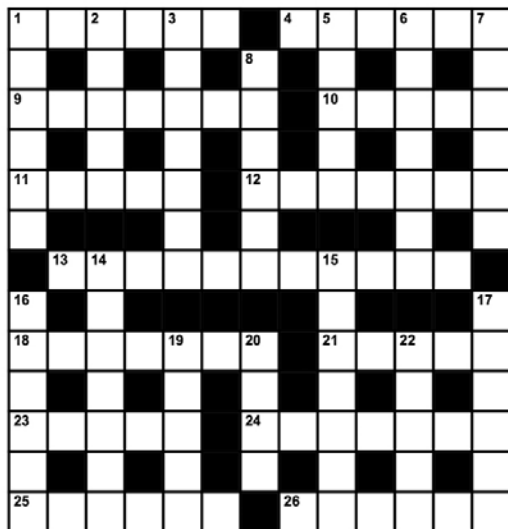

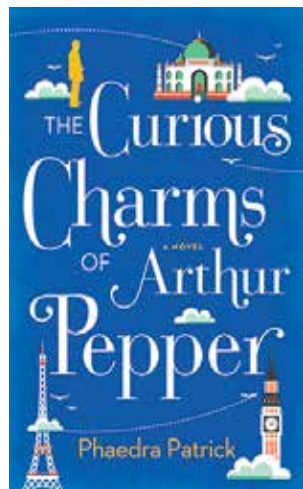

"When my son was smaller, he's now ten, he used to enjoy playing with my bracelet and I told him where each of the charms came from," says *The Curious Charms of Arthur Pepper* author Phaedra Patrick. "A friend had sadly passed away and I started to think of a story about Arthur Pepper, an elderly man who discovers a mysterious charm bracelet in his late wife, Miriam's, wardrobe. He sets off on an epic journey to find out the

story behind each of the charms."

A charm bracelet is the catalyst that sets Arthur on an adventure to learn about his wife and himself. The journey that Arthur goes on is cathartic, will take him out of his comfort zone. Ultimately, it's healing for him and those around him, a story of personal growth. The charms are the charms from his wife's bracelet and the hidden charms of Arthur, qualities that

he didn't know he had. This is the first novel by Patrick. Looking forward to more from this author.

Arthur Pepper lost his wife a year ago. He's a person of routine. He gets up in the morning at the same time. He wears the same clothing he's worn for most of his life. When his wife died he did take over watering her plant. Today is the anniversary of her death. As he's going through his late wife's things he finds a gold charm bracelet hidden in the toe of a boot. It stops him. Arthur has never seen his wife wear it. Who gave it to her? Why did she hide it? What does he not know about his wife?

Reflections on the horror of Orlando

I was hoping this week's newsletter was going to be all about us celebrating Gay Pride, but unfortunately the tragic events that occurred in the gay Orlando nightclub 'Pulse' put an end to that.

In the early hours of Sunday morning, 49 people lost their lives to a gunman, who decided it was okay to spray bullets into a joyous place and cut short the lives of these fun-loving club-goers. And it sickened me to the core.

I woke up at 7am on Sunday all eager, as I was supposed to join the British Consulate as part of their float that made its way down Santa Monica Boulevard just like I did last year. But after turning on my TV and watching the reports come in of this senseless tragedy, I collapsed, my heart sank deep into my chest and the tears just rolled out of my eyes. Having just coming back from gay clubs in New York City, attending the San Diego LGBT film fest the week before, and my many nights dancing in countless nightclubs over the years, this could have been me. These victims could have been my friends.

How was this possible? There are still so many questions still reeling in my mind. My fiancé Michael and I were still planning to attend the pride parade, albeit in a somber light to pay our respects to the slain, until the news changed stories, to one much closer to home. An arrest of a suspect in Santa Monica

who planned to attend LA Gay Pride with weapons and explosives. No news of whether he was alone, or part of a group. At that moment we decided it was best not to take that risk.

The march went ahead and luckily there were no incidents reported and everyone was safe. I felt so angry that my sense of security and freedoms were taken away from me at the moment and that I couldn't celebrate how far we have come in the LGBT community with equal rights.

I was glued to the news all day as the updates came in and one of the many things that stuck with

me was when his father reported that the killer was repulsed when he saw two men kissing. Right then I realized that even with our rights, we are still not equal and the fear of intimacy and affection that I have had in public with the man I love was still very much prevalent. My fear of offending someone with my love for another, as I drive past straight couples making-out or holding hands and most people being happy for this expression of love. But now at this moment realized that growing up gay in the UK we had to always hide in plain sight. Having to hide our affection, watching over our backs, hiding in alleyways as we embrace, sneaking a light touch when walking in the streets, linking fingers in the cinema once the lights went out, having a codeword pet name for I love you, when hanging up the phone with a lover, constantly living in fear that we would 'be found out.'

The truth is I lived a lot of my younger days in fear. I thought acting straight was a good thing, when really it was more of a defense mechanism created by my subconscious to protect myself. In reality I'm mad

at myself for being afraid to go on that march on Sunday, that somehow they got the better of me. I should have been there marching still, because clearly this is not over and it serves as a stark reminder that homophobia, just like racism and sexism, is still very much alive in America, and all over the world. And it's important for us to stand up, rise up for and support those who have been or are still being suppressed.

So I call on all my LGBT friends and straight allies to please join in an online movement with an image of #TwoMenKissing (or

Lendl: like I've never been away

■ Murray reunites with former coach in bid to derail the seemingly unstoppable Novak Djokovic

Ivan Lendl said it felt as if he had "never stepped away" after watching Andy Murray mark the resumption of their coaching partnership with a win.

Lendl was in the players' box as world number two Murray beat Nicolas Mahut 7-6 (10-8) 7-6 (7-1) to reach the second round at Queen's Club on Wednesday.

"Andy and I have talked over the last few years," Lendl, who reunited with the Scot on Sunday, told reporters.

"We've stayed in touch, and as you know, we parted on good terms."

Murray won the Olympics, the US Open and Wimbledon during his original spell with the Czech-born American, until Lendl decided in

March 2014 that he no longer wished to spend sufficient time on tour. The 56-year-old - an eight-time singles Grand Slam winner - is expected to work with Murray for up to 20 weeks a year.

He has never talked fondly about the travel involved, and says there is not one overwhelming reason why this feels the right time to return.

"Everybody asked me what was it that made you do it, and I can't answer that. I really don't know, there are so many factors in there," Lendl added.

"I can't say what changed it from 'not really' to 'yes'.

"I don't mind living out of a suitcase, and I don't mind the longer trips - let's say to London or to Australia - I just hate the ones from week to

week where you spend five days somewhere, and you have to go to the airport again."

Lendl has already been 'welcomed back to the locker room' by his former rival Boris Becker, who has recently enjoyed huge success with Novak Djokovic.

Djokovic currently holds all four Grand Slam titles, and helping Murray beat the world number one is one of the principal reasons Lendl has been drafted back into the team.

"Everybody can improve in almost every area - even Novak," Lendl said.

"There are obviously things which we are going to work on which are more important than some others, but I'm definitely not going to be specific."

Vettel error gifts Hamilton another win

Mercedes' Lewis Hamilton won the Canadian Grand Prix after a tense strategic battle with Sebastian Vettel's revived Ferrari on Sunday.

Vettel looked in total

control of the race after vaulting into the lead from third on the grid with a blistering start.

But the red-hot Ferrari surrendered the lead by pitting during a caution period, and Hamilton

- doing one pit stop to Vettel's two - controlled the race from that point on, allowing the defending champion to cut his title deficit to Nico Rosberg, who was fifth, to nine points.

Historic night for Northern Ireland

Gareth McAuley's header and a stoppage-time strike by substitute Niall McGinn helped Northern Ireland beat Ukraine 2-0 to earn their first win at a European Championship.

West Brom defender McAuley got on the end of Oliver Norwood's perfectly delivered free-kick for the crucial 49th-minute opener on Thursday night.

After the players were withdrawn because of a hailstorm, McGinn followed up Stuart Dallas' fierce shot to make sure of a famous victory and revive hopes of progressing to the last 16.

Michael O'Neill's men know they cannot finish bottom of Group C now as Ukraine remain without a point.

However, after losing their opening match to

Poland, they may still need a draw against Germany in Paris on Sunday.

Michael O'Neill gambled by making five changes, including relegating top scorer Kyle Lafferty to the substitutes' bench.

Lafferty's place went to 24-year-old Conor Washington, the QPR striker who was working as a postman and playing for St Ives in the ninth tier of English football the last time the Euros were staged in 2012.

But it paid off fantastically as Northern Ireland clinched their first win at a major tournament since famously beating hosts Spain at the 1982 World Cup.

Washington and Ward proved a handful for a Ukraine team who had kept 21 clean sheets in their past 39 games.

Northern Ireland's strength from set-pieces told again as McAuley, 36, brilliantly got on the end of Norwood's well-taken free-kick for the first goal.

After a hail shower that saw the players withdrawn and substitutions, six minutes of stoppage time were added on.

But Northern Ireland's nervousness disappeared when Aberdeen winger McGinn pounced to seal victory.

England shock mighty Wallabies as coach Jones' revolution gathers pace

RUGBY UNION: England's remarkable upswing under coach Eddie Jones continued at the weekend as they beat the Wallabies for only the fourth time in Australia, triumphing in a mighty battle in the first Test in Brisbane.

The win looked unlikely when they fell 10-0 behind early on as Michael Hooper and Israel Folau scored for the hosts.

But the tourists hit

back through the boot of Owen Farrell and tries from Jonathan Joseph and Marland Yarde.

Australia rallied as Hooper and Tevita Kuridrani crossed, but Jack Nowell had the final word for England.

It was England's first ever win in Brisbane, their biggest points tally home or away against the Wallabies and equalled the 25-14 victory in Melbourne in June 2003 as their biggest

margin of victory down under.

Saturday's victory puts them 1-0 ahead in the three Test series, which continues in Melbourne and then Sydney on the next two Saturdays.

James Haskell was at the heart of a tremendous performance from the England pack, while Farrell kicked 24 points in another impressive performance by the versatile Saracen.

Late show saves England

■ Euro 2016: Sturridge breaks Welsh hearts with last gasp winner

Daniel Sturridge struck an injury-time winner as England came from behind to beat Wales 2-1 Thursday night and secure their first victory at Euro 2016.

England keeper Joe Hart's dreadful blunder allowed Gareth Bale's 30-yard free-kick to creep in and put Wales ahead just before the interval in Lens.

Manager Roy Hodgson's side were jeered off at the break and, with England's campaign - and arguably his future - on the line, he gambled by introducing Jamie Vardy and Sturridge for the struggling Raheem Sterling and Harry Kane.

The roll of the dice worked as Vardy scrambled in an equaliser from close range after 56 minutes before constant England pressure saw Sturridge work his way into the area and poke past Wales keeper Wayne Hennessey at the near post.

England move top of Group B and need a point against Slovakia on Monday to earn automatic qualification into the last 16, while Wales must beat Russia to guarantee a top-two finish.

When England left the pitch at half-time accompanied by abuse from their own fans, everything was on the line in this Euro 2016 campaign.

England were facing a humiliating first defeat by Wales since 1984 and the pressure was on Hodgson as his own future would have been in jeopardy if he and his team had made an ignominious exit from France.

He needed to be positive and inspirational, qualities his detractors have accused him of lacking in the past - but here it came off.

Out went Kane and Sterling and on came Sturridge and Vardy. It was all-out attack and the momentum shifted almost instantly as the second half was a tale of almost virtual England domination.

A different script might have been written had Sturridge not produced that late winner, but the bottom line is Hodgson's ploy worked.

It was not scientific - more a question of throwing everything at it and see what happens -

but the desired result was achieved and England secured a win from a losing half-time position for the first time at a major tournament.

If Wales beat Russia in their final game, something they are eminently capable of doing, they will be in the knockout stages, a feat which can be regarded as a success in their first major tournament since 1958.

They were second best here, not offering enough attacking options around the world-class talent of Bale, but there is a resilience and unity about this team that serves it well.

They were outstanding defensively until that late twist. Their fate, however, remains in their own hands and this Wales team will not go quietly.

England escaped in this match - and they deserved the win - but this was not an entirely convincing performance and the first half was a wretched affair.

No wonder goalkeeper Hart ran the length of the field to join in the celebrations after Sturridge's winner

because he was responsible for the anxiety that threatened to engulf England.

Hart should have stopped Bales's powerful effort from distance, but the ball slipped through his hands as he dived full

length to his left.

Hodgson must also decide what to do about Kane and Sterling, two players he defended from criticism after their performances in the draw against Russia.

Kane looks a jaded

figure after a long season at Tottenham, while Sterling's confidence almost appears to be draining by the second. He missed an easy chance and felt the frustration of England's fans before he was taken off at half-time.
