# May on Brexit: What's the rush?

## ■ No EU exit deal till next year, vows new PM

**Theresa May has said the UK will not begin official negotiations on leaving the EU this year as she held talks with Germany's Chancellor Angela Merkel on Wednesday.**

Speaking in Berlin, the PM said securing a "sensible and orderly departure" from the EU would take time.

But she insisted the UK would not "walk away" from Europe and wanted to retain the "closest economic links".

Mrs Merkel said the two sides desired to get the "best result for Britain" but urged more clarity on timing.

Earlier, a military guard of honour greeted Mrs May, who succeeded David Cameron a week ago.

### 'special friend'

At a joint press conference, Mrs May said the UK was in no rush to trigger the two-year process of leaving the EU - telling reporters that although "this would not please everyone" it was right to hold off until the UK's "objectives were clear".

The process of preparing the UK for Brexit would require "serious and detailed work" but, irrespective of this, she said the UK was determined to maintain strong trading, economic and security links with Germany, which she described as "a vital partner and special friend".

"Of course, the nature of our relationship is going to change as the UK leaves the EU, but we both want to maintain the closest possible economic relationship between our countries and I believe that is what German and British businesses want too," she said.

"So it's good that we start from such a strong foundation and a position where both our countries believe in liberal markets and free trade and these should be the principles that guide us in the discussions ahead."

Asked how they had got on at their first meeting, Mrs May said they were two women who want to "get on with the job and deliver the best possible results for the people of the UK and Germany".

Mrs Merkel said she did not expect there to be any formal negotiations at this stage and it was "understandable" the UK needed a period of time to prepare.

But she said there was a need for a "certain timeline" with regard to Britain's exit and hoped the UK would begin to "define its principles" with regard to the process of activating Article 50 of the Lisbon Treaty, the official, legal mechanism for leaving.

### Birthday gifts

"We have to listen to what Britain wants and find what the right answer is," she said. "Britain does not want an

impasse, Germany does not want an impasse and the EU does not want an impasse".

The German chancellor said the two countries had "similar convictions and values" and she was determined to proceed in the "spirit of unity and friendship" that characterized Anglo-German relations.

But she said it was clear that Germany would hold the "balance of power" in the negotiations to come and although Mrs Merkel did want to make the

UK's departure work, the UK's "leverage had really faded" following the decision to leave.

A Downing Street source said the government was "encouraged" by the tone of the talks and the subsequent working dinner in the German chancellery.

"There was a free flowing conversation in the bilateral talks and the dinner," the source said. "The two established a personal connection and relationship and the

'communication channels are now open'.

"Although this was the first time that the two women had properly met as they seemed immediately at ease in each other's company and determined to build a personal relationship based on mutual trust."

It has emerged that the UK prime minister presented two books on the British outdoors to her German counterpart as a birthday present, reflecting their shared interest in hiking.

# May's nerveless debut at PMQs

■ PM mocks Corbyn and impresses observers at despatch box

Theresa May hosted her first Prime Minister's Question Time on Wednesday, and as expected, the tough-minded former Home Secretary came out swinging.

Britain's new Prime Minister had a tough act to follow with David Cameron, whose composure and wit at PMQ's was one of the defining features of his Premiership, and she was immediately under pressure from Labour, who hoped to score some early points against a debutante Prime Minister speaking from the despatch box for the first time.

Responding to a question about whether the Government plans to extend or cut workers' rights, May told Mr Corbyn: "I am interested that he refers to the situation of some workers who might have some job insecurity and potentially unscrupulous bosses.

"I suspect that there are many members on the Opposition benches who might be familiar with an unscrupulous boss.

"A boss who doesn't listen to his workers, a boss who requires some of his workers to double their workload and maybe a boss

who exploits the rules to further his own career. Remind him of anybody?"

It was a thinly-veiled reference to Mr. Corbyn's own troubles within his party, which has recently prompted a leadership battle and mass resignations from the Shadow Cabinet. Mr. Corbyn is also accused by some of bending the party's membership rules so he can recruit new supporters ahead of the upcoming Labour leadership ballot.

Mrs May also hit back at Mr Corbyn claims that the Conservatives' long-term economic plan had failed.

She said: "he calls it austerity. I call it living within our means.

"He talks about austerity, but it is actually not about saddling our children and grandchildren with debt."

May went on to say the answer to country's issues was 'not Labour's answer of unlimited, uncapped welfare,' but rather a 'strong economy which delivers well paid jobs. And in a parting zinger, she told Corbyn that "Labour may be tearing itself apart - but this side of the House will spend the summer bringing this country back together."

## House renews Trident system

■ Labour split as Corbyn opposes decision

■ Vote may hasten growing split with SNP

The House of Commons has backed the renewal of the UK's Trident nuclear weapons system by 472 votes to 117.

The MPs' vote approves the manufacture of four replacement submarines at a current estimated cost of £31bn.

Defence Secretary Michael Fallon told MPs nuclear threats were growing around the world and Trident "puts doubts in the minds of our adversaries".

Labour was split over

the issue with 140 of its 230 MPs going against leader Jeremy Corbyn and backing the motion.

A total of 47 Labour members voted against renewal, while others abstained.

Although Labour MPs were given a free vote, many used the occasion to attack Mr Corbyn, who is a longstanding opponent of nuclear weapons.

A succession of the party's MPs accused Mr Corbyn of opposing official party policy by arguing against it

at this stage with one, Jamie Reed, calling his stance "juvenile and narcissistic".

One Conservative MP, Crispin Blunt, voted against renewal while 322 supported the motion.

The UK has four submarines that each carry up to eight Trident missiles. The missiles can be fitted with a number of warheads, which can be directed at different targets.

## Johnson grilled on 'outright lies'

Boris Johnson was embarrassingly forced on to the back foot during his first London press conference as foreign secretary on Tuesday as he was repeatedly pressed to explain his past "outright lies" and insults about world leaders, including describing the US president as part-Kenyan and hypocritical.

Standing alongside John Kerry, the US secretary of state, Johnson claimed his remarks had been misconstrued, that his past journalism had been taken out of context, and world leaders he had met since his appointment fully understood his past remarks.

Johnson was holding a press conference designed to showcase the continuing closeness of the UK-US special relationship following the Brexit vote, as well as the joint commitment to finding a solution to the crisis in Syria.

Johnson twice referred to the crisis in Egypt, but was believed to be referring to Turkey.

He came under strongest attack from American journalists, who asked him if he was going to apologize to world leaders, including Barack Obama, for his past

# Owen Smith to face Corbyn in Labour leadership challenge

■ Angela Eagle steps aside to make way for single challenger in race to lead party after receiving fewer nominations than 'Blair-lite' Smith

Owen Smith will take on Jeremy Corbyn for the Labour leadership in a head-to-head race that will see the pair clash repeatedly during the summer before a result is announced at the party's conference on 24 September.

The Pontypridd MP became the sole challenger to Corbyn following a decision by Angela Eagle to pull out of the race after it became clear she would fall short of her opponent when it came

to nominations from MPs and MEPs.

Eagle said she would throw all her "enthusiasm and might" behind Smith, as she urged people to pay £25 to sign up as registered supporters before 5pm on Wednesday so they could vote in the contest.

## joint ticket

The pair indicated that they would be putting themselves forward as a joint ticket, with Eagle saying she would work in "lockstep" with the

former shadow work and pensions secretary.

Smith will seek to present his campaign for a leadership team drawn from all sides of the party.

Describing Eagle as a great friend and a pioneer in the party, he added: "I will want to work side by side with Angela throughout this contest. I want Angela to be at my right hand throughout this."

In an appeal to the party membership, he said: "I want to say to all

members of the Labour party tonight, young and old, longstanding and new members: I can be your champion. I am just as radical as Jeremy Corbyn."

Smith had attracted the nominations of 90 colleagues, including 88 MPs and two MEPs, while Eagle had the backing of 63 MPs and a further nine MEPs.

## no confidence

Both men will now take their campaigns to members, with ballot papers and online voting information being sent out to eligible members, who joined before January, on 22 August. They then have a month to decide before returning their papers by 21 September or voting online, with the result announced at Labour's Liverpool conference.

Corbyn, who was challenged following a

vote of no confidence by three-quarters of Labour MPs, is expected to launch his campaign this week. His pitch to the members who supported him in large numbers last summer is that he has led the party to successful results in local elections and deserves credit for his anti-austerity stance and for government U-turns on "cruel tax credit cuts" and reforms of disability benefits.

In a note to members, Corbyn conceded that "our party is divided", but argued that he could unify it again. "We need to use this contest to bring people together around strong policies to turn our fire on to the Tory government. There must be no personal abuse or threatening behaviour," he wrote, after Eagle and he received death threats. "Let's have a comradely

debate this summer."

One source close to the leadership said that the big worry for Corbyn's team had been losing in the second round. "With Angela as the rightwing candidate, it would have been easier for Owen to pull off some of our vote and then grab all of Angela's second preferences in a run off," they said. "In some respects, he's an easier beast to fight, as it's obvious now to voters that he's the Blair-lite candidate and he can't hide it any more."

Smith, who admitted it would be a difficult few months, is preparing to go to members with policies such as restoring wage councils, a £200bn investment plan, a referendum on the Brexit deal, an ethical foreign policy, and a new war powers act to help parliament scrutinize future conflicts.

insults, and whether other politicians could trust him.

Johnson, holding the press conference in the Foreign Office, said: "We can spend an awfully long time going over lots of stuff that I've written over the last 30 years.... All of which, in my view, have been taken out of context, through what alchemy I do not know – somehow misconstrued that it would really take me too long to engage in a full global itinerary of apology to all concerned.

## bumpiest ride

"There is a rich thesaurus of things that I have said that have, one way or the other, I don't know how, that has been misconstrued. Most people, when they read these things in their proper context, can see what was intended, and indeed virtually

everyone I have met in this job understands that very well, particularly on the international scene.

"We have very serious issues before us today we have an unfolding humanitarian crisis in Syria that is getting worse. We have a crisis in Yemen that is intractable and a burgeoning crisis on Egypt, and those are to my mind far more important than any obiter dicta (incidental remark) you may have disinterred from 30 years of journalism."

The event was probably Johnson's bumpiest ride since his appointment

as foreign secretary a week ago, although he was booed by a section of the audience after speaking at the French ambassador's party on Bastille Day.

Kerry was forced to prop up Johnson, saying the UK had made it clear after the EU referendum that it was committed to the UN, Nato and making the world safer.

"The people of Britain voted. This is a democracy and we all respect a democracy," he said, adding that he had been told that Johnson was a very bright and capable man.

# Margaret Thatcher demanded halt to Asian men bringing second wives to Britain, newly-released files reveal

Margaret Thatcher demanded a clampdown on Asian men bringing second wives into the country claiming the UK's immigration rules discriminated in favour of the "coloured Commonwealth", according to newly-released government papers.

Files released by the National Archives show how in 1986, ministers in Mrs Thatcher's government were under pressure to prevent Pakistani and Bangladeshi women in polygamous marriages joining their husbands in the UK.

A No 10 Policy Unit briefing note informed the prime minister: "Though the numbers are small, the problem is vexed and the Home

Office are exposed to public pressure."

The attorney general Sir Michael Havers, however, warned that any attempt to exclude the women concerned would be illegal without new legislation.

## 'acceptable range'

"I must, however, advise in the strongest terms against taking any action against second wives until there is a change in the law. Such unlawful action by the government cannot be contemplated."

Mrs Thatcher, however, was adamant that action had to be taken, scrawling in a handwritten note: "The country would be with us on this. We would be crazy to discriminate in favour of the coloured

Commonwealth against the UK."

Four years earlier, in 1982, she strongly objected to Home Office plans to relax the rules on women immigrants bringing in husbands and fiancés, insisting there were already enough ethnic minority men in the UK for them to choose a partner from.

"The outcome of admitting more husbands and male fiancés would mean that there would be more new families, large numbers on the unemployment register, and in the long run a requirement for the creation of more jobs," she complained.

"There were, furthermore, sufficient numbers in the ethnic minorities in this

country now to provide an acceptable range of choice for young women without the need for further young men to come to this country."

In contrast, when

employment secretary Norman Tebbit wanted to tighten the rules on "working holidaymakers" coming to the UK, Mrs Thatcher and home secretary

William Whitelaw objected noting that most of those who took advantage of the scheme were from "Old Commonwealth" countries like Australia.

## Budget airline takes £40m hit from post-Brexit sterling slump

The boss of Easyjet says the airline has seen its costs increase by £40m (\$53m; €48m) in just four weeks, as a result of the pound's drop in the wake of Britain's vote to leave the EU.

Carolyn McCall told reporters the drop had made fuel - which the firm pays for in US dollars - more expensive.

She added that the increased cost of travelling abroad is deterring some British holidaymakers.

Sterling has lost more than 10% of its value against the dollar since Brexit.

## extreme weather

Ms McCall's comments came as Easyjet released its quarterly results,

which warned that the company is earning less from each passenger.

Although passenger numbers have been rising - up to 20.2 million - extreme weather, air traffic control strikes and terrorist attacks have all contributed to the drop of almost 8% in "revenue per seat", a key measure watched closely by investors.

An "extraordinary number of external events" were to blame, Ms McCall said, "from Sharm el-Sheikh, Paris, Brussels and most recently, Nice and Turkey".

Easyjet's shares have dropped by more than 3% in London on the news.

## 'Good news'

But the chief executive argued that the drop in revenues was beneficial to customers.

"It is worth pointing out that although every

airline is having a tough time, it is very good news for passengers," she told the BBC's Today programme.

"It actually means it's cheaper to fly and ticket prices are low".

The devaluation of the pound since the Brexit vote has also had an impact on "consumer confidence", or whether people feel compelled to book flights and holidays, she continued.

## 'opportunity'

"If you are a passenger, you are reading every

day in the papers that it is more expensive to spend money on holiday," Ms McCall said, although she added that demand would probably "normalise over next few months".

Ms McCall also confirmed that the airline would not be following rivals such as Wizz Air in scaling back from the UK market as a result of Brexit.

"We see opportunity," she said.

"We will continue to grow in the UK."

Clyde, in Faslane, but all MPs for Scottish constituencies taking part in the vote, except for Scottish Secretary David Mundell, were against renewal.

The SNP opposed the move, saying nuclear weapons were "immoral" and the continued stationing of submarines on the Clyde could accelerate moves towards independence.

After the vote, the SNP said the government "must respect Scotland's clear decision against Trident renewal and remove these nuclear weapons of mass destruction from the Clyde".

Defence minister Harriett Baldwin said: "People put politics aside and marched through the lobbies in support of our nation's security. This was a very important vote as defence is the first job of

government".

Labour's John Woodcock voted in favour of the submarines which are built in his constituency, Barrow in Cumbria, and said: "This shows that the House of Commons but also the Labour party can take long term decisions in the future of the nation but also protect thousands of jobs across the country."

The vote, by a majority of 355, came at the end of a five-hour debate, in which Theresa May spoke at the despatch box for the first time as prime minister.

She said it would be an "act of gross irresponsibility" for the UK to abandon the continuous-at-sea weapons system.

Although preparatory work on renewal is already under way, Monday's vote gives the final green light to a new fleet of submarines which are due to come into service by the early 2030s.

He continued: "One evening my agent said 'I've got you a job, I've got you three days but

you can't call yourself Michael White, so give me another name.'

"I was in a telephone booth in Leicester Square and I was opposite the Odeon and I looked up, and my favourite actor is Humphrey Bogart, and there it was."

**Jousting at the Olympics?**

■ English Heritage 'deadly serious' about securing Olympic berth for jousting

**JOUSTING is not just a relic of medieval England, featuring two armoured horse riders hurtling towards each other with 12ft lances, but it also demands a level of agility and equestrianism that make it an ideal candidate for the Olympics, English Heritage said this week.**

And with that in mind, the organization has launched a campaign to get jousting recognised as an Olympic sport in time for Tokyo 2020.

"We are being deadly serious," said Lucy Hutchings, English Heritage's head of projects. "It is an incredible spectator sport, a really fascinating thing to watch. The skill of the knight and the horses make it a great thing to witness ... we

absolutely believe it deserves its place at the Olympic table."

English Heritage has held preliminary talks with the International Olympic Committee and the Fédération Equestre Internationale, and on Thursday it launched an online petition.

Hutchings said the IOC was in the process of making the Olympic programme more flexible and bringing in a rule that allowed the host nation to make its own proposals for additional events.

Tokyo has been considering skateboarding, climbing and surfing. "If skateboarding can be included then jousting has a good chance," said Hutchings.

Dominic Sewell,

English Heritage's jousting expert, agreed. "Given what sports have been submitted to the Olympics over the years, I don't think there is any reason that something which has been a sport for over a thousand years should not be considered.

"If the sport organises itself, there is no reason why we could not be ready for Tokyo."

Sewell said jousting, which requires "a huge amount of skill and involves a daily training regime", ticked lots of Olympic boxes. "You have to be strong, not just physically but mentally, so you can sit fearlessly in your saddle, face your rival and offer yourself as a target."

Just like dressage, it also requires an enormous amount of equestrian

training. Horses must be persuaded to accept a rider dressed in 45lbs of steel armor and to gallop at an opponent at speeds of up to 30mph.

"Horses being prey animals, they are naturally designed to run away from things, so to persuade it to run towards another large clanging thing at speed takes time," Sewell said. He added that jousting should be seen as England's first national

sport.

Jousting's heyday was in the 15th and 16th centuries, with Henry VIII one of its most famous advocates. Historians have recently speculated that the reason Henry became such a cruel and petty tyrant is that jousting injuries brought about a change in his personality.

The Olympics have a history of accepting new sports, including beach volleyball in 1996, and

golf and rugby sevens in Rio de Janeiro this year. Baseball was added in 1998 but taken out after 2008.

English Heritage said jousting was a popular sport not only in England, and not only at the castles where it will this summer be organising jousting events.

Jousting was recognised as a sport by a number of US states. It has been Maryland's official sport since 1962.

PERHAPS the single most important aspect of changing your lifestyle for the better comes from your mind.

Because your daily decisions around food and drink come from this place, and to really succeed in making the right decisions every day, you need a strategy. Here are a few of our recommendations:

### 1. Talk to yourself like a trusted friend.

Scientists at the Laboratory of Neuro Imaging estimate humans have about 70,000 thoughts per day. That means you have 70,000 opportunities either to make yourself stronger or to tear yourself down.

Your thoughts greatly influence how you feel and behave. In fact, your inner monologue has a tendency to become a self-fulfilling prophecy. Thinking things like, "I can't run," or "Nobody ever listens to me," can alter your behavior in a way that makes those predictions come true.

Practice replacing overly negative thoughts with more realistic ones. When you notice yourself thinking something like, "I'm a loser and I'll never amount to anything," remind yourself that your thoughts aren't necessarily true. Ask yourself, "What would I say to a friend who said this about himself or herself?" And then, offer those kind and gentle words to yourself.

### 2. Take charge of your

### emotions.

Allowing your emotions to control your life will deplete your mental strength. While there's nothing wrong with being in a bad mood sometimes, staying stuck in a negative rut can be a slippery slope; sadness can lead to self-pity, anger can turn to bitterness, and mild anxiety can become paralyzing fear.

A lot of problems stem from our desire to avoid discomfort. For example, people who fear failure often avoid new challenges in an effort to keep anxiety at bay. Avoiding emotional discomfort, however, is usually a short-term solution that leads to long-term problems.

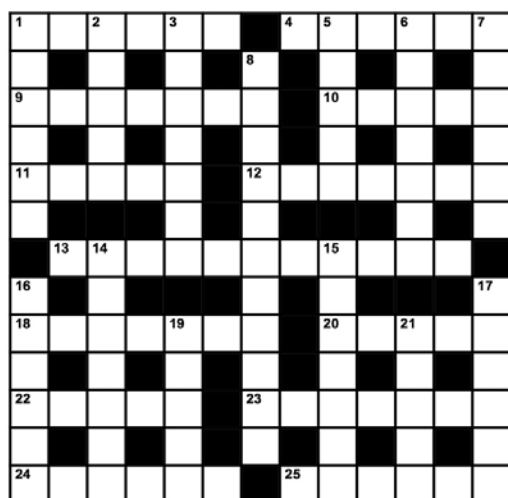
skills and I'm also the face of Russia and Ukraine in the individual videos for each country.

Celtic's first-leg defeat in Gibraltar was one of the worst in their history.

But a 3-0 home win secured a trip to Astana in the third qualifying round.

"It's a six-hour flight, five-hour time difference, 35C+, a plastic pitch, with no

water, but apart from that..." Rodgers told BBC Scotland.

"It is another test for us and the focus now will be getting a good performance over there."

Astana drew games against Atletico Madrid, Benfica and Galatasaray in the the group stage of last season's Champions League.

And they will pose a much sterner test for Rodgers' fledgling side than the part-timers from Gibraltar, with the away leg to take place next week before the

return at Celtic Park the following week.

Rodgers hopes to add to his squad before then, with defensive reinforcements a priority. "Hopefully that is the case," he said. "We would certainly like to. We will see over the coming days."

After the 'shock on the Rock' in Gibraltar, Scottish champions Celtic produced some flowing attacking football to see off the Red Imps, with first-half goals from Mikael Lustig, Leigh Griffiths and Patrick Roberts proving sufficient.

## Yasir Shah 'is best leg spinner since Warne'

■ Stokes hails Pakistani who spun England to First Test defeat

Pakistan's Yasir Shah is "the best leg-spinner since Shane Warne", says England all-rounder Ben Stokes.

Yasir, 30, finished with 10-141 as Pakistan beat England by 75 runs in the first Test at Lord's last week.

Stokes and James Anderson missed the match but both return for Friday's second Test at Old Trafford.

"They're a very good team but we go into the Test knowing how he goes about bowling and we should be able to counteract that," Stokes said.

Yasir, who has taken 86 wickets in 13 Tests, has moved to the top of the Test bowling rankings, the first leg-spinner to do so since Warne 11 years ago.

Australian Warne, who retired from Test cricket in 2007, is second only to Muttiah Muralitharan in the all-time list of Test

wicket-takers, with 708 from 145 matches at an average of 25.41.

Stokes, 25, has been missing for England after jarring his knee in the first Test of the summer against Sri Lanka in May, an injury which required surgery.

Having played solely as a batsman for his county Durham in the early stages of his comeback, he bowled in the victory over Lancashire at Southport last week, taking 3-50 from 19 overs in the second innings.

"I have been bowling in the nets but you can't replicate doing that, the only thing you can do is bowl in a game," he said. "So it was good on that point and it was a massive confidence boost."

Asked about the state of the series with Pakistan, he added: "It's one defeat. We're just treating it as a three-match series and hoping we can win it."

England wicketkeeper-batsman Jonny Bairstow said the team would not panic if they lost in Manchester, even though it would put them 2-0 down in the four-match series.

"It wouldn't be panic stations by any means," Bairstow told BBC Sport.

"We've got to go out there and put the record straight. We were slightly behind the eight ball pretty much all the way through. It's a case of going out there, expressing ourselves and attacking the challenge."

Leg-spinner Adil Rashid has also been added to the squad that features the 11 England players who were on duty at Lord's.

# BIG SAM GETS ENGLAND JOB

## ■ Premier League veteran has never won a trophy

Sam Allardyce has been named the new manager of England, the FA announced on Thursday.

He will leave Sunderland after nine months at the Premier League club.

Allardyce replaces Roy Hodgson, who quit in June after the surprise defeat by Iceland in the last 16 of Euro 2016.

The 61-year-old, who has also managed West Ham, Newcastle, Bolton and Notts County, spoke to the Football Association last week and has been chosen ahead of Hull's Steve Bruce.

The only remaining issue to be settled is compensation to Sunderland, with Allardyce having a year left on his contract at the Stadium of Light.

In a statement, Sunderland said it was "aware of the intense media speculation" but that Allardyce remained in charge "at the present time".

It added: "We share in the anger and frustration of our supporters and would like to assure them that we are working to conclude the matter

in the best interests of Sunderland AFC."

Allardyce was present as Sunderland beat Hartlepool 3-0 in a pre-season friendly on Wednesday but left before full-time.

The FA board met on Thursday to rubber stamp the decision after hearing from a three-man selection panel who told them Allardyce was their preferred candidate.

Both Sunderland and Hull had urged the FA to act quickly, with the new Premier League season less than a month away.

Allardyce was interviewed for the England job following Sven-Goran Eriksson's departure after the 2006 World Cup but Steve McClaren was appointed.

His first competitive game in charge will be a World Cup qualifier in Slovakia on 4 September.

Allardyce will become the 15th permanent England boss, the pinnacle of a managerial career that started at Blackpool in 1994 and has taken in 467 Premier League games.

Only Sir Alex Ferguson,

Arsene Wenger and Harry Redknapp have managed more games in the top flight.

Allardyce has never won a major trophy but did secure promotion to the Premier League with both Bolton and West Ham.

He also won Division Three with Notts County in 1998.

As a player, Allardyce started at Bolton in the 1970s before spells at Sunderland, Millwall, Coventry, Huddersfield, West Brom, Irish club Limerick and US side Tampa Bay Rowdies. He ended his career at Preston.

Bournemouth manager Eddie Howe and USA coach Jurgen Klinsmann had also been linked with the England job although a report in the Telegraph on Thursday claimed Allardyce became the number one choice only after Arsene Wenger had turned the job down.

The three-man FA panel was comprised of chief executive Martin Glen, technical director Dan Ashworth and vice-chairman David Gill.

They said they were

seeking a strong-minded, tactically savvy manager who could build a clear team identity.

Glenn added that the new manager would need to "build resilience" in players so they are able

to deal with criticism on social media and the pressures of an "intensely passionate" English media.

Allardyce's departure means Sunderland will now be looking for a ninth

permanent manager in less than eight years.

Former Manchester United and Everton boss David Moyes and current Burnley manager Sean Dyche are reported to be among the favourites.

## Mou: Sam's the right choice

Manchester United manager Jose Mourinho has backed the appointment of Sam Allardyce as England manager.

"He is the right person," Mourinho said of the Sunderland boss. "He is more than ready. He is a good motivator and can create a good team spirit."

Former England manager Sven-Goran Eriksson added: "Sam's been in English football for a long time. He's always been doing very well."

Allardyce's appointment was confirmed on Thursday.

Mourinho, speaking on United's pre-season tour of China, added: "I wish

him the best. I promise to try and supply him players and try to make sure the English players are always available in good condition."

Eriksson, who led England to the quarter-finals of three major tournaments between 2001 and 2006, warned success was "not that easy".

"What is successful for England? Is it quarter-final or semi-final? Winning?" asked the 68-year-old Swede, who now manages Shanghai SIPG in the Chinese Super League.

Allardyce, 61, was interviewed for the England job by the Football Association (FA)

when Eriksson left after the 2006 World Cup.

"If the FA want an Englishman, he is one of several good names," said Eriksson. "I wish him the best of luck. I know he is very organised. He knows all the players and he wants the job."

Eriksson said that a result like England's Euro 2016 last-16 defeat by Iceland, which led to Roy Hodgson's resignation, "should not happen".

"I know the fans and the FA are dreaming about reaching semi-finals and finals and winning a big tournament," he said, adding that England's World Cup triumph in 1966 was "a long time ago".
