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MP resigns over rent boy scandal

Labour MP Keith Vaz has stepped down as chairman of the Home Affairs Select Committee amid a sex scandal involving paid male escorts.

The married father-of-two had been under huge pressure to stand down from the committee which probes issues such as immigration, drugs policies and sex workers after it was revealed he paid rent boys for sex at his flat.

As chairman of the powerful Commons panel, the 59-year-old has publicly said he was "not convinced" that men who pay for sex should face prosecution.

Announcing his resignation, the Labour MP said: "It is in the best interest of the Home Affairs Select Committee that its important work can be conducted without any distractions whatsoever."

He said: "It is in the best interest of the Home Affairs Select Committee that its important work can be conducted without any distractions whatsoever."

"I am genuinely sorry that recent events make it impossible for this to happen if I remain chair."

"I have always been passionate about select committees, having served as either chair or

member for half of my time in Parliament. The integrity of the select committee system matters to me.

"Those who hold others to account must themselves be accountable."

Vaz added the decision to resign and stand aside immediately from the committee's business was "my decision, and mine alone" and "my first consideration has been the effect of recent events on my family".

He added: "After speaking to the House authorities, I will formally tender my resignation to Mr Speaker so that it coincides with the timetable for the election of other committee chairs, such as the Brexit Committee, Culture, Media and Sport, and Science and Technology, so that the elections can take place together."

At the weekend, the Sunday Mirror published pictures it said showed Mr Vaz with male sex workers in a flat in north London that he owns. Illegal drugs were mentioned

during a secretly recorded conversation.

Another Labour MP will now be elected to replace him, with Conservative MP Tim Loughton taking over as interim chairman.

Speaking after Mr Vaz had informed committee colleagues of his intention to resign, Mr Loughton said a new chairman

should be in place in October.

He said Mr Vaz had given a "very frank account of what had happened" and that the committee had accepted his resignation "with sadness".

Conservative MP Andrew Bridgen has said he would refer the matter to the Commons Standards commissioner and may also report Mr Vaz to police.

Married father-of-two Mr Vaz said he was referring the paper's allegations to his solicitor.

Born in 1956 to Goan parents in Aden in what is now Yemen, Vaz went to Cambridge University where he studied law and then became a solicitor. He has been MP for Leicester East since 1987.

He is Parliament's longest-serving British Asian MP and has chaired the influential Home Affairs Select Committee since 2007. He was Britain's Minister for Europe under Tony Blair and said the vote to leave the EU was a "catastrophe".

Labour MP Chuka Umunna, who sits on the Home Affairs committee, said Mr Vaz had done a "fine job" as chairman, but said he had made the right decision in stepping down.

Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn said Mr Vaz's future on the party's ruling National Executive would be discussed when it meets.

Hate preacher sentenced: judge blasts extremists who live on the benefits while claiming to 'despise' the West

A senior judge has challenged Islamist extremists who live on benefits while claiming to "despise" Western democracy, as he sentenced hate preacher Anjem Choudary to five-and-half years in prison.

Choudary has lived on benefits in the UK for the past 20 years, during which time it is understood he has claimed up to £500,000 from the state.

While living off the state - dubbing his benefits 'Jihadiseekers' Allowance' - Choudary became one of the country's most notorious radical preachers - professing hatred against the West.

'calculating'

But he managed to avoid a criminal conviction until he was charged last year with drumming up support for a terrorist organisation by pledging allegiance to Islamic State of Iraq and Levant (Isil).

On Tuesday he was sentenced alongside fellow radical Islamist Mohammed Mizanur Rahman after both being convicted of inviting support for the terrorist group.

Before sentencing them, Mr Justice Holroyde heard that the pair were both living off

benefits.

After hearing Mr Rahman's lawyer speak, the judge asked: "Is it not an anathema to be funded by the liberal Western democracy he so adamantly despises?"

MPs have now called for the Home Secretary to be given powers to block hate preachers from receiving benefits.

A former work and pensions secretary also spoke of his frustration at being unable to deprive terrorist suspects of state benefits.

The Old Bailey heard a "calculating" and "dangerous" Choudary had published an oath of allegiance to Isil knowing it was likely to encourage his vulnerable or fanatical followers to commit terrorist attacks.

Mr Justice Holroyde dismissed regret from the 49 year-old, saying he "knew exactly what he was doing".

The judge said Choudary had invited support for Isil while it was "engaged in appalling acts of terrorism".

He said: "At no point did either of you say anything to condemn the violent means by which [Isil] claimed to have established a caliphate."

The Old Bailey heard Choudary was an influential ideologue who had tens of thousands of followers on social media. He publicised his oath at a crucial time just as Isil had launched its self-styled caliphate in Iraq and Syria and many people were looking for guidance on its legitimacy.

Choudary's influence was so strong that Siddhartha Dhar, who is later believed to have succeeded 'Jihadi John' as Isil executioner, asked him for a "verdict" on the caliphate, saying his words "would be gold on Twitter".

Choudary and Rahman, 33, each to five-and-a-half years, Mr Justice Holroyde said they had shown "no remorse at all for anything you have said or done, and I have no doubt you will

continue to communicate your message whenever you can".

Their supporters in the public gallery shouted "Allahu Akbar" as the two men were led from the dock.

■ 16-year old Rocco will continue living in London with his filmmaker father

Madonna and Guy Ritchie have finally settled their months-long custody battle over their son Rocco. The former couple came to an agreement in court on Wednesday.

According to New York Supreme Court documents, the pop icon and her filmmaker ex settled their legal battle, and there was "no appearance" in court regarding the matter.

Ritchie's lawyer, Peter Bronstein, said in a statement outside the court that Rocco, 16, will continue to live with his father in London, according to the Associated Press.

The dispute began

in December 2015 after Rocco refused to return to New York to be with his mother for Christmas. At the time, the teen was living with his father in London.

Rocco is just one of Madonna and Ritchie's sons. The two, who were married from 2000 to 2008, also have an adopted son named David, who is 10.

Madonna and Ritchie took the battle to the courts, opening litigation in New York and London.

In December a judge ruled that Rocco should return to his mother's custody, but decided not to issue a warrant to enforce the order. Rocco has since remained in London with his father and enrolled in

a school in the capital.

During a hearing in Manhattan, State Supreme Court Justice Deborah Kaplan had implored Madonna, 58, and Ritchie, 47, to settle the matter privately.

"No one is disrupting his household other than the inability of the parents to reach a resolution," Ms Kaplan said. "If they cannot resolve this matter then eventually the court will."

Ellen Sigal, a court-appointed lawyer for Rocco, said in March that the dispute was causing the teenager stress.

"It's been a very difficult time for him,"

Police smash 'significant' Isil-inspired terror plot

■ Two men planned Paris-style attack, say Met

Two men have been arrested on suspicion of plotting a Paris style marauding terror attack on the streets of Britain.

The pair, who are understood to be brothers, were arrested in a dawn raid at a property in west London on Thursday morning.

Security sources said the raid had interrupted a "significant" terrorist plot aimed at bringing death and mayhem to Britain.

The plot was said to have been inspired by Islamic State in Iraq and Levant (Isil) and was believed to involve guns and possibly bombs.

Security sources suggested that rather than a "lone wolf" style attack, the plot was more widespread and serious in nature.

However, the suspects are not believed to have been in possession of weapons at the time of their arrests and the raids are thought to have taken place at what was an early stage in the alleged plot.

The arrests come just days after hate preacher Anjem Choudary was jailed for five and a half years for pledging an oath of allegiance to Isil.

There had been concern that Choudary supporters might try to mount some sort attack in revenge for the cleric having been convicted and jailed, but was not clear if the plot was connected.

ringleader

The two suspects aged 19 and 20 were being questioned on suspicion of preparing a terrorist act.

While the younger brother was said to be the ringleader of the alleged attack, the 20-year-old was also arrested on suspicion of funding terrorism and failing to disclose information regarding an act of terrorism.

In addition a third man was detained by counter-terror police in south east London, on suspicion of a religiously aggravated offence.

Theman, who was arrested at his home in south-east London, was born and raised in the Iraqi city of Mosul.

His father had worked for the military in Iraq and was forced to flee the country, travelling to Britain in 2007 with the rest of his family.

The 19-year-old was held on suspicion of a racially aggravated offence, relating to a "separate matter", according to Scotland Yard.

However security sources said the three arrests were linked.

UK economy bounces back after Brexit shock

LONDON: The bounce back in Britain's economy from the initial shock of the Brexit vote has expanded to the country's recruitment and housing markets, according to two surveys which previously painted a bleak outlook.

The Recruitment and Employment Confederation - which last month said hiring was in "dramatic freefall" - said firms increased permanent staff for the first time in three months, and were also spending more on temporary workers.

The Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors said its monthly house price index jumped to +12 in August from July's three-year low of +5, the first rise in six months, though still one of the lowest readings in the past year and a half.

"There are clear signs that the housing market is settling down after the initial surprise of the outcome to the EU referendum," RICS chief economist Simon Rubinsohn said.

The Bank of England's decision to cut interest rates in August for the first since 2009 probably contributed to the brighter mood, Rubinsohn added.

The recovery in the RICS and REC surveys follows a pattern set by surveys of the services and manufacturing sectors which plunged in July, when Britain was plunged into political chaos by the Brexit vote, before rising sharply in August.

Housing and retail firms also gave confident outlooks. Housebuilders Barratt and Redrow have also sounded upbeat.

Dixons Carphone, Britain's biggest electricals and mobile phone retailer, reported better-than-expected sales and said it had not seen no Brexit impact on demand.

Some economists have pulled back from forecasts of outright recession made in the wake of the Brexit vote, though almost all - including the BoE - still expect a sharp slowdown.



1666 AND ALL THAT: Londoners enjoy a blazing good night's fun on the Thames

A wooden replica of 1666 London was set ablaze on the River Thames on Sunday night to commemorate the 350th anniversary of the Great Fire of London.

The 120 metre long installation was lit up on Sunday in memory of the inferno that ripped through the City of London, destroying homes, businesses and iconic structures such as

St Paul's Cathedral.

The large wooden model of the 17th century London skyline, titled London 1666, has been designed by American "burn" artist David Best.

The event was the grand finale of the London's Burning festival commemorating the Great Fire.

Unlike 350 years ago, fire crews were on hand with powerful water

canons and high-pressure hoses to extinguish the flames at the end of the performance.

The 1666 blaze ripped through the heart of London for four days, leaving 80 per cent of the walled city in ruins.

Called London 1666, the spectacular blaze has been captured on multiple cameras.

Those who were not able to make it down to the

river, between Blackfriars and Waterloo Bridge, were able to watch it being live-streamed on YouTube.

The project was put together by artists David Best and the Artichoke organisation, retelling the story of a blaze that hit the capital 350 years ago.

It began on September 2 1666 at a baker's shop in Pudding Lane and raged for four days.

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Let's work together for an amicable split, PM tells EC's Tusk

Britain and the European Union should work together to smooth their divorce and forge a new strong relationship, Prime Minister Theresa May told European Council President Donald Tusk on Thursday.

May's spokeswoman said that the two leaders' first meeting since she became prime minister following the June 23 Brexit vote was friendly and that the British leader felt the EU understood her need to take time to form a negotiating stance before triggering the formal

divorce procedure.

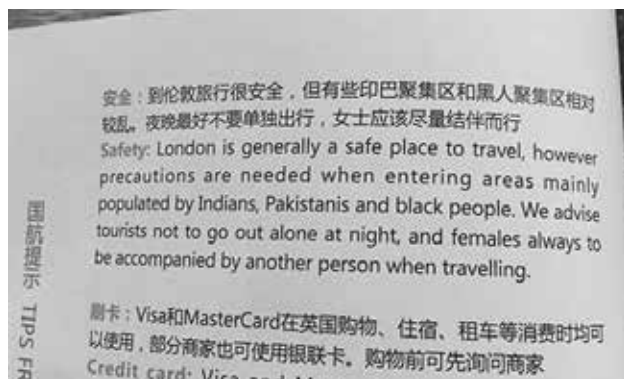
"The main points that the prime minister made were about working together so that there was a smooth process for the UK leaving the European Union, that is why we are taking time to prepare for the negotiations," the spokeswoman told reporters.

May also told Tusk that Britain would be a "strong player" while it remained in the European Union, and would continue to stand firm on sanctions against Russia over its action in neighbouring Ukraine.

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Air China magazine condemned over 'racist' guide to London

■ MPs seek apology from ambassador after inflight guide states 'precautions are needed' in ethnic minority areas



MPs have urged China's UK ambassador to intervene in a row over racist comments reportedly issued by a Chinese airline about ethnic minority areas of London.

An image of text from an inflight Air China magazine posted on social media (above) prompted outrage after it warned passengers that "precautions are needed when entering areas mainly populated by Indians, Pakistanis and black people".

The text, tweeted by Beijing-based producer Haze Fan of US news channel CNBC, added: "We advise tourists not to go out alone at night, and females always to be accompanied by another person when travelling."

Two MPs have urged Liu Xiaoming, China's ambassador to the UK, to secure an apology to their London constituents.

Virendra Sharma, Labour MP for Ealing Southall where 39% of the population is Asian, wrote to Liu to complain about "blatant racism" from the airline.

He said: "I am shocked and appalled that even today some people would see it as acceptable to write such blatantly untrue and racist statements.

"I have raised this issue with the Chinese ambassador, and requested that he ensures an apology is swiftly forthcoming from Air

China, and the magazine is removed from circulation immediately

"I have invited representatives of Air China to visit my constituency of Ealing Southall to see that a very multicultural area is safe, and would be of great value for those visiting London to see.

"I will await their response, and if an appropriate one is not forthcoming I shall feel forced to question whether Air China is a fit company to operate in the UK."

Rosena Allin-Khan, Labour MP for Tooting, which has one of the largest south Asian populations in London, said: "I think it is offensive to all Londoners, not just the ethnic minorities mentioned."

Speaking to the Evening Standard she said: "I am going to be writing to the Chinese ambassador to invite him to visit Tooting in London, where all races live side by side. Then they can see how we live and our wonderfully diverse community."

In her tweet, Fan asked what London's mayor, Sadiq Khan, thought about the comments.

Lambeth and Southwark London assembly member Florence Eshalomi also invited Liu to her constituency. She said this would show him "what an international city London is".

After half a century in pole position, Ecclestone strikes deal to hand over reins of Formula One

Bernie Ecclestone's reign over Formula One could be reaching the finish line after an American entertainment tycoon agreed to buy the motor-racing championship in a deal worth £6 billion.

Liberty Media is buying 100 per cent of the shares of F1's parent company Delta Topco from the British private equity firm CVC Capital Partners.

Ecclestone, who has been part of Formula One ever since the 1950s, will remain as chief executive for three years but 21st Century Fox vice-chairman Chase Carey will become the new chairman.

Reluctant to delegate, Ecclestone has not groomed a successor and critics have accused him of holding back the sport through a failure to embrace fully new media or the digital marketplace, something Liberty is expected to make a priority.

The deal, which has an enterprise value of

\$8 billion according to a company statement, heralds a new era for Formula One, a European-dominated sport that has long sought to break into the US market and win fresh audiences.

Liberty Media president and chief executive Greg Maffei said: "We are excited to become part of Formula One. We think our long-term perspective and expertise with media and sports assets will allow us to be good stewards of Formula One and benefit

fans, teams and our shareholders.

"We look forward to working closely with Chase Carey and Bernie Ecclestone to support the next phase of growth for this hugely popular global sport."

Ecclestone added: "I would like to welcome Liberty Media and Chase Carey to Formula One and I look forward to working with them."

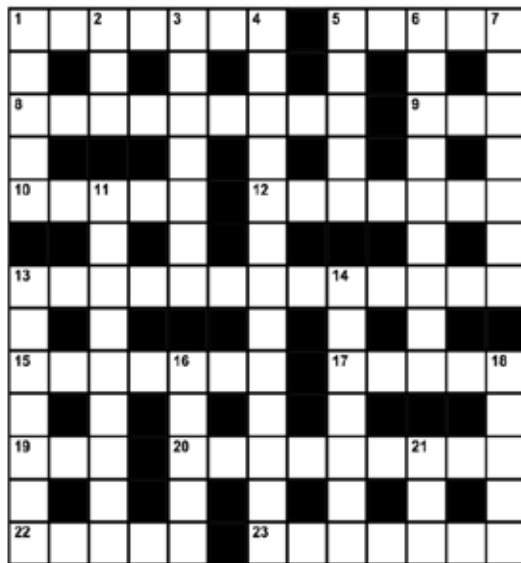

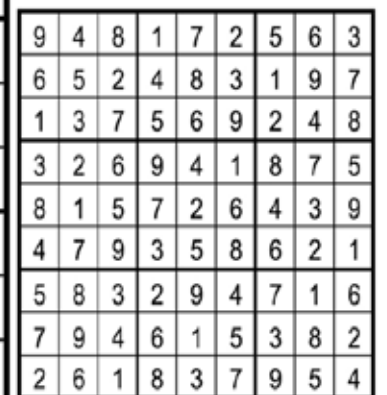

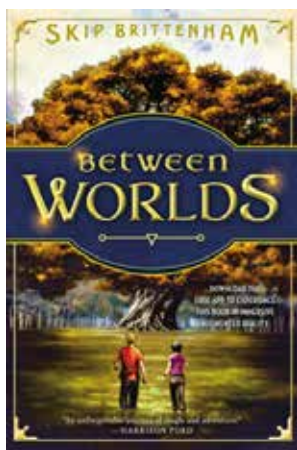
Between Worlds: where literature meets apps

with author Skip
Brittenham about his

with creatures visible
in augmented reality

"We had already been doing augmented reality images and apps with the graphic novels I was involved in, *Anomaly* and *Shifter*, so it seemed natural to try to let the readers have the same type of high tech tools available with my young adult novel. I think that this generation wants more interactivity in every form of entertainment they consume."

Those are the words of author Skip Brittenham, whose latest book focuses on how two teens learn to trust each other and themselves. There's an app that you download that utilizes your camera. Once downloaded,



focus on the pictures in the book and you'll see 3D creatures pop up. There are also details about the creatures. This is an inventive way to learn more about the creatures. Some of the creatures have human traits. At times the creatures are trying to help them, but the kids in the book don't know and run into more danger. The fighting and death is violent, which can be a bit much for a young child to read. Instead of the violence, it could have had more emotional connection.

What our young heroes learn when they are transported to the land of Nith gives them confidence. Along the way, they make a new friend.

Mayberry and Marshall are two teens who don't quite fit the mold to be considered popular. Mayberry is a science geek from New York, who dresses Goth. She's moved with her parents to a small town so her mother can do research. Mayberry's only friend is Marshall, who's lived there all his life. His family used to be very rich, but was wiped out by bad investments. Marshall tells Mayberry about the wishing tree in Mystery Forest. They find the wishing tree and make wishes. Both fall asleep and awake in Nith where there are mystical and scary creatures. How will they get home?

"The book has a lot of science backing up some

of the story elements," says Brittenham. "I was researching the longevity of planets and animals and stumbled upon the quaking aspen trees size and age. I was also reading a book about string theory at the same time and put the two together...and watched my 15-year-old daughter consume entertainment and then communicate with her friends. I have never taken a writing class. I learned how to write by slogging away at it on my computer."

"Over the years I read a lot of scripts and watched them evolve into movies or TV shows so I became very familiar with various approaches to the creative process," says Brittenham who is an entertainment lawyer. He has co-written two graphic novels, *Anomaly* and *Shifter*. *Between Worlds* has yet to be optioned for film or television.

Brittenham says he was reading and researching just for general education purposes, not for any book. "My theory about education is that you are either going up or down and if you are standing still you are going down. If you always talk about and live based on where and what you have been it is hard to discover a vibrant fulfilling future."

Arianne Lewin is Brittenham's editor at Penguin.

"I submitted the book to Penguin and they wanted to publish it," says Brittenham. "They assigned Arianne to me and we went at it. She recommended that I eliminate a plot line involving the parents of the female lead character Mayberry because YA readers don't care that much about adults' problems. I thought about it and decided she was right."

Swift end to Tom and Tay's summer fling!

The split was reportedly 'amicable'. Public fascination with the couple may have contributed to the breakup, according to Us Weekly.

'surprise of the century'

The couple's romance was initially confirmed after UK tabloid The Sun published photographs of Swift, 26 and Hiddleston, 35, looking like a couple from a Nicholas Sparks film while walking along the beach on June 14 in Westerly, Rhode Island - just two weeks after the singer and musician Calvin Harris parted ways.

Shortly after, Harris called out Swift on Twitter after she claimed she was the sole writer of his hit single, "This Is What You Came For."

"I figure if you're happy in your new relationship you should focus on that instead of trying to tear your ex bf down for something to do," Harris wrote on Twitter, referring to Swift's relationship with Hiddleston.

Swift and Hiddleston outings over the summer were highly publicized.



In June, Swift met Hiddleston's parents in the U.K. after Hiddleston met Swift's family in Nashville. The two took part in a big bash in Rhode Island in July where Hiddleston wore a much lambasted "[heart] T.S." tank top.

Some critics of the couple questioned whether they were in it for the publicity.

"The truth is that Taylor Swift and I are together, and we're very happy," Hiddleston told The Hollywood Reporter in July. "That's the truth. It's not a publicity stunt."

Despite their steadfast

position of authenticity, Swift and Hiddleston's breakup did not seem unexpected to many on social media Tuesday.

"Now there's the surprise of the century," tweeted Kia Makarechi, a story editor at Vanity Fair.

Others suggested titles for a possible new album Swift could write about the "Avengers" actor - as the singer/song writer has been known to tap into her life experiences for lyrical inspiration.

Lions CAN beat the All Blacks, insists new coach Gatland

Warren Gatland, who was appointed as head coach of the British and Irish Lions on Wednesday, believes his side can beat world rugby's top-ranked team New Zealand next year.

The New Zealander will be seeking to lead the combined nations to their first back-to-back series success in more than 40 years, having been in charge of the team's last tour -- a 2-1 victory in Australia in 2013.

The Lions' only series victory against New Zealand was in 1971, followed up three years later by a triumph over South Africa.

Gatland, who is again taking a sabbatical from his role as Wales coach, admits it is "the biggest job in world rugby against the best opposition in world rugby."

"Success in 2017 is about going to New Zealand and winning the Test series, and I honestly believe we can do that,"

the 52-year-old told the Lions' official website. "If we don't believe that, then we shouldn't even be getting on the plane.

"If there's players out there who have doubts, then make yourselves unavailable because we have to go down there as a squad of players and a group of people who believe 100% that we are good enough to go to New Zealand and win a Test series."

The last Lions team to tour New Zealand, in 2005, lost all three Tests under the guidance of coach Clive Woodward, who had led England to victory at the World Cup two years earlier.

The All Blacks have won back-to-back World Cups since then, defending their title last year in England.

Gatland's Wales team lost in the quarterfinals, as did Scotland and Ireland. England failed to reach the knockout stage, but bounced back under new coach, Australian Eddie Jones, to win this year's Six Nations title.

Eden Hazard has become the second Chelsea player in two days to hail the impact of new manager Antonio Conte - while taking a scarcely concealed swipe at former boss Jose Mourinho.

The Belgian's indifferent form became one of the hallmarks of an utterly miserable last campaign at Stamford Bridge, with Mourinho dismissed in December following the team's woeful start to their title defence.

And hot on the heels of defender Gary Cahill labelling 2015-16 a 'disaster' for Chelsea, Hazard reflected on an 'ugly' season, while perhaps insinuating his former manager's lack of top-flight playing experience meant he didn't know how to treat his Premier League winning stars.

'Conte puts trust in his players and now we are good after an ugly season last year,' said Hazard.

'I've always been the same player but Conte

knows how to treat players having played at the highest level himself.'

Manchester United boss Mourinho paid with his job in west London for Chelsea losing nine of their opening 16 league games last season.

All the while speculation persisted regarding Hazard's apparently strained relationship with his Portuguese manager.

Those suggestions were only lent further credence when Hazard surrendered to a hip injury 31 minutes into what would prove Mourinho's final game in charge, a 2-1 defeat at Leicester.

Over the weekend Cahill had fired the first salvo at his former manager, claiming the team had lost its way during Mourinho's final months in charge.

'We needed organisation. We went from winning the league to the disaster of last season. We lost our way tactically; everyone's head was in different directions,' the centre-back told BBC Radio Five Live.

'It is the hardest thing when everyone is not on the same wavelength. People talk as if you wake up one day and suddenly you're a bog-standard player. It doesn't happen.'

have retired after the Euros. It's not because he could break my record. Far from it. If he does and he plays well, fine."

Rooney did not touch the ball once in the Slovakia penalty area but England's captain and record goalscorer says the debate over his role in the team has been an "overreaction" following the 1-0 win in Trnava.

"I played in that role and helped us win the game," Rooney, who has scored 53 goals for his country, told Sky Sports I've never felt he is as good as a lot of people thought he was," he said.

Shilton also had harsh words for out-of-form 'keeper Joe Hart, who has recently moved to Italian side Torino on loan after being relegated to third choice at Manchester City.

"Obviously Hart's a good keeper but although he has great games, a keeper is judged by the amount of mistakes he makes and those have happened right through his career. In the Euros he made two mistakes in three games.

"What I don't understand about Joe is that he has 60-odd caps and yet people were saying he was getting too wound up before games in the Euros. If you don't know what you're doing after 60 caps, there is something wrong. I thought he was too wound up but apparently that is his style.

"He's under pressure now and he's come back to the pack. Joe was always looked upon as the No1 but now there is competition.

"It's all to play for now. It's up to the other keepers to make the shirt theirs.

"You need three or four keepers to choose from and then Sam makes his choice from there and stands or falls by it."

Liverpool midfielder Adam Lallana grabbed a dramatic 95th minute winner with his first goal in 27 caps as England

Allardyce then admitted his huge relief after they beat Slovakia - who had captain Martin Skrtel sent off after a horrific stamp on Harry Kane - and revealed a fan

gave him a lucky coin.

England boss Allardyce said: "A father of a son in a wheelchair came to the hotel this morning and asked if it was okay to have a picture with his son.

"When we finished he

said: 'Let me give you a lucky coin.' Here it is. I had it with me in my pocket, we won, so it'll stay with me.

"It was a huge relief for me, I'll tell you that now. You've got to beat 10 men when it comes around. I think that, finally in the end, we got the ball in the back of the net which was richly deserved based on us dominating the game.

"It was pretty nerve-racking at the end because the 10 men scenario meant we must win. We got what we deserved in the end and won in the last minute. We have dominated the game and got a very important win."

Allardyce admitted his relief after his reign began with a victory and his sheer relief and joy was obvious afterwards as England overcame their hardest fixture.

"It's the biggest job I've ever had. You know you're leading the nation forward. Everyone is looking at you. They want you to show the way forward and be successful," said Allardyce.

"It's that much bigger when the nation's watching you. I had a whole lot of messages today. It was impossible to try and attempt to reply to all the goodwill messages from across the country.

"In the end, everyone back home was waiting with baited breath and we scored the winner. Everyone back home is happy and can have an extra drink.

"The fans here were happy and the goal came in their end. We dominated the game and finally got what we deserved."

Hat-trick for Snodgrass

Robert Snodgrass scored a hat-trick as Scotland started their World Cup qualifying campaign by hammering Malta 5-1 at the weekend.

The Hull midfielder's cross-come-shot looped in to give the Scots the lead, but Alfred Effiong headed a reply.

Chris Martin's side-footed finish restored the lead and Snodgrass added a penalty as Jonathan Caruana was

controversially sent off.

Snodgrass tapped-in his third after Steven Fletcher's header, with Malta's Luke Gambin also sent off late on.

It was an up-and-down display for the Scots as they opened impressively, laboured after Effiong's equaliser then capitalised on Malta being reduced to 10 men.

The turning point was the penalty, when there looked to be little

if any contact as Caruana chased Martin into the six-yard box while the Scotland striker was stretching to reach an Andrew Robertson cross.

Scotland took control as Malta lost their discipline in the closing stages and Gordon Strachan's side go top of Group F ahead of England, who won 1-0 in Slovakia, on goal difference after the opening set of fixtures.

Bale brace keeps Welsh on summer time

Wales started their 2018 World Cup qualifying campaign in confident fashion as they convincingly beat Moldova on Monday.

The Euro 2016 semi-finalists initially faced spirited Moldovan resistance but led 2-0 at half-time thanks to goals from Sam Vokes and Joe Allen.

Gareth Bale seized on a woeful pass for the third, then netted a last-minute penalty for his second of the night.

Wales' win puts them top of Group D on goal difference ahead of Austria.

Welsh confidence has been at an all-time high since their superb performances over the summer and Chris Coleman's men will travel to Vienna for their next World Cup qualifier on Thursday, 6 October, hoping the feel-good factor stays strong into the autumn.

As the group's top seeds, Coleman's side

had been expected to make light work of Moldova, who are ranked 154 places below them in the world rankings.

After a cagey first half hour they eventually did so with a flourish, becoming the first team to score three or more goals against the eastern European minnows since England's 4-0 victory in 2013.

Having led Wales to a first major tournament semi-final at Euro 2016, Coleman said he was

"desperate" to follow that achievement by qualifying for the 2018 World Cup in Russia.

The former Fulham manager and his players want to ensure their summer exploits in France were not a one-off but a springboard to sustained success.

They were backed by a typically vociferous Cardiff City Stadium crowd of 31,731, close to capacity once again as a nation basks in its greatest footballing era.

And although it came against limited opposition, this opening victory was an encouraging start as Wales aim to end an absence from World Cups that stretches back to 1958.

"That was the perfect start," former Wales international John Hartson said on Radio 5 live. "Moldova were awful, it was a comfortable win as you will see and great start to the qualifying campaign."

TENNIS: Nishikori fightback sends Scot tumbling out of US Open

Britain's Andy Murray made his earliest Grand Slam exit of the year as Japan's Kei Nishikori fought back to win their US Open quarter-final in five sets on Wednesday.

Murray, seeded second, led by two sets to one but eventually lost 1-6 6-4 4-6 6-1 7-5 in three hours 57 minutes.

The Wimbledon champion lost his rhythm after rain brought the roof across, then his cool when the stadium sound system interrupted a break point.

"It was too exciting on the court, but I tried to stay calm," said Nishikori.

Nishikori added: "I didn't start well - he has a great return - but I finished well.

"The rain delay helped me to change tactics. I tried to hit a few more drop-shots than usual today and it worked really well."

Murray, 29, had been on course to become only the fourth man since the Open era began in 1968 to reach all four major finals in the same year.

He was Australian and French Open runner-up before winning Wimbledon.

Murray began in terrific form, overpowering Nishikori in a 35-minute first set, but he lost control of the match when a passing rain shower led to the new roof being brought over Arthur Ashe Stadium.

Nishikori levelled at one set all and infuriated Murray by breaking

straight back three times after losing his serve.

Murray's frustration only grew when he let a 40-0 lead slip at 4-4 in the third, but he looked to have finally taken control when the Scot took the next two games.

His momentum stalled dramatically early in the fourth set when he was seemingly in charge of a rally on break point, only for the stadium sound system to emit a loud noise that caused the umpire to halt the point.

Murray was furious, arguing with both umpire and tournament referee, but the point, the game and, within half an hour,

the set went Nishikori's way.

"They stopped the point and I was just curious why that was and that was it," Murray said. "Did it affect me? Definitely."

A butterfly persistently fluttering around the net only added to Murray's annoyance as the 2012 champion lost seven straight games, but twice fought back from a break down in the fifth set to edge ahead at 5-4.

With 16 service breaks between them, there seemed every chance Murray would finally get over the finish line, but Nishikori played superbly

to hold to love and it was the Japanese who then claimed the 17th and

decisive break.

There was to be no final set tie-break as Nishikori

proved the stronger with another nerveless hold that ended Murray's hopes.

Shilts blasts Roo AND Hart

- Rooney 'should have quit after Euro 2016'
- Hart 'not nearly as good as he thinks he is'

FORMER ENGLAND international Peter Shilton has blasted two of England's most senior international players, claiming neither Wayne Rooney nor Joe Hart were worth their places in the national team.

Rooney should have retired from international football after Euro 2016, claimed the ex England

captain, analyzing the Manchester United star's performance for England in Sunday's World Cup qualifying victory over Slovakia.

Rooney's value to the team has become a hot topic after he spent most of the game playing in a deep midfield role.

"I don't think he's a striker anymore," said

Shilton, who won 125 caps. "We are trying to fit him in, but he's not a midfield player for me. Never will be."

Speaking to BBC Scotland, Shilton, 66, added: "He is spraying a few balls around, but I don't think he's being very effective.
