

Nasa hacker loses extradition fight

A mildly autistic 31-year-old Briton could face a 99-year prison sentence for hacking into American missile defence centres after a British court gave the go-ahead for his extradition this week.

Lauri Love from Suffolk, who has Asperger's Syndrome, and stands accused of hacking into the computer systems of the US missile defence agency, Nasa and the Federal Reserve, lost his appeal against extradition to America last week.

Judge Nina Tempia said the 31-year-old could be cared for by "medical facilities in the United States prison estate" and implied that he should answer the "extremely serious charges" in the country where the damage was inflicted.

"extremely serious"

Love, who lives with his parents in Newmarket, was granted permission to appeal against Friday's ruling and given bail pending further legal action. The battle over his fate could eventually reach the European court of human rights in Strasbourg and last several years.

There were gasps

in the courtroom as Tempia read out her ruling, which followed a full case hearing in June. Love's supporters, who stormed out of Westminster magistrates court in London shouting "kangaroo court", fear he could face up to 99 years in a US jail if convicted on all counts.

Delivering her judgment, Tempia said: "Mr Love faces extremely serious charges for offences of computer hacking over a period of one year, from October 2012 to October 2013.

"I accept Mr Love suffers from both physical and mental health issues, but I have found the medical facilities in the United States prison estate, on arrival and during any sentence if he is convicted, available to him, are such that I can be satisfied his needs will be comprehensively met by the US authorities.

"I am satisfied Mr Love's extradition would be compatible with his convention rights and

"It's not fair or just that a boy who has mental health issues should be taken away from his family and support by the US that is determined to exact vengeance on him," said the father of Lauri Love (pictured, above)

I send this case to the secretary of state for her decision as to whether or not Mr Love should be extradited."

The home secretary, Amber Rudd, has until mid-November to consider the case. If and when she decides

to authorise Love's extradition, he will have 14 days to appeal against the ruling.

"big debate"

Ahead of Friday's hearing, Love said he held little hope of justice if he was extradited, and

suggested a jail term in the US could cause his health to deteriorate and would lead to a mental breakdown or suicide. The electrical engineering student also suffers from severe eczema and depression.

He and his family want

him to face justice in the UK rather than the US, which he said "coerces" people into pleading guilty to get reduced sentences.

Love embraced friends and family, who appeared shocked and

Kinnock: Labour won't win a general election again in my lifetime

Lord Kinnock, the former Labour leader, has predicted his party will not win another general election in his lifetime ahead of Jeremy Corbyn's expected coronation this week.

The peer, who defeated the hard-Left in the 1980s and put Labour on the road to modernisation that would sweep Tony Blair into power, said the party was facing the "greatest crisis" in its history.

He made the comments in a BBC Panorama

programme broadcast on Monday in which some of Mr Corbyn's supporters warn of retribution against MPs who have opposed his leadership.

Len McCluskey, the general secretary of Unite, says that some MPs have behaved "absolutely despicably" and suggests he supports stripping them of their right to stand at the next election.

"I think anybody who kind of behaves in a way that is totally disrespectful

and [outwith] the culture of the Labour Party is basically asking to be held to account," he says.

On Saturday, the result of the leadership race between Mr Corbyn and Owen Smith will be announced, with the former widely expected to be re-elected.

Speaking to Panorama, Lord Kinnock, who led Labour between 1983 and 1992, offered a bleak picture of the party's chances of winning back power.

"Not just in my

lifetime but stretching back to the 1930s, by any examination this is the greatest crisis that the Labour Party has faced," Lord Kinnock says.

"I'm 74, and unless things change radically, and rapidly, it's very doubtful that I'll see another Labour government in my lifetime."

In a separate development, Mr Corbyn is on course to call for party members to be given a say over which MPs are selected for the shadow cabinet.

And a leading current affairs TV show, *Dispatches* on Channel Four is also set to air a potentially explosive investigation into Momentum, a pro-Corbyn activist group, that will question whether it is mounting a hard-Left takeover of the Labour Party.

A Momentum spokesman criticised the programme, saying the undercover investigation raised questions about the broadcaster's impartiality.

Boris Johnson 'didn't want Brexit victory'

Boris Johnson only campaigned to leave the EU to set himself up as the next Conservative leader, Sir Alan Duncan said the day before June's referendum.

Sir Alan said he believed the now foreign secretary, who is his current boss, wanted to lose narrowly and be the "heir apparent" to David Cameron.

The foreign minister's comments were made in a BBC Two documentary broadcast in the UK on Thursday evening.

Mr Johnson has said the UK will be better off outside the European Union.

In his first interview after becoming foreign secretary he said: "There is a huge opportunity and...I have been very struck by how excited and how positive people here are about the opportunities for Britain."

The UK voted by 52% to 48% to end its membership of the bloc in a referendum on 23 June.

In a behind-the-scenes documentary, *Brexit: A Very British Coup?*, Sir Alan - then a backbench MP but now a minister in Mr Johnson's Foreign Office - predicted the result would be 52% for Remain and 48% for Leave.

And he questioned the motives of Mr Johnson in backing the campaign to exit the EU.

"I think there are a lot of Leave people who don't believe it, and I've always thought that Boris's wish was to lose by one so that he could be the heir apparent without having to have all the... you know... of clearing up all the mess, that's always been my view of Boris."

He added: "By championing leave, he can be the great heir apparent of the future, darling of the activists, but actually it would be quite good if he didn't actually win the referendum because there would be total chaos."

Bicycle campaigner knocked down by cyclist

A leading London bike campaigner was left unconscious after being knocked down...by a cyclist.

Emma Robinson was on her way to a meeting about cycling routes as part of her job as Barnes town centre manager when she was knocked down by a cyclist riding on a pavement in Twickenham.

She was knocked out in the incident which happened last month and still suffers dizzy spells.

It may take her up to three months to make a full recovery.

'It was a very scary moment,' she told the *Evening Standard*.

'It was literally moments after I had come out of the offices

and the next thing I knew I was on the ground.

'I flew through the air and hit my head which meant there was a lot of blood. When I did come to I remember I had no vision and couldn't feel my arms and then I just remember this pain in my head.'

The cyclist fled when police were called but was later arrested.

angered by the decision. "If you have come for justice then you have missed it," Love told a crowd of press in the courtroom afterwards.

He added that he had not yet read the judgment and would "delay processing it until he was in a safe place". He added: "It may simply be that this is such an important case that it has to be settled at a higher court."

His father, the Rev Alexander Love, said: "I don't criticise the judge. She has just acted on a law that is flawed."

"I always used to believe that to be born in this country was to win the lottery of life. But it's not fair or just that a boy who has mental health issues should be taken away from his family and support by the US that is determined to exact vengeance on him."

'no love'

"We have recently had a big debate [in the referendum] about who can come into this country. We need to have one now about who can be taken out."

Outside the court, Karen Todner, Love's solicitor, said she was very disappointed by the district judge's ruling. She pledged to appeal against the decision, initially at the high court and, if necessary, at the supreme court and eventually the European court of human rights in Strasbourg.

"I feel awfully disappointed," Todner said. "I thought we had done enough. I'm hopeful that the higher courts will consider the human rights issues. This is not the end of the road ... I was in and out of courts for 10 years with [the extradition case of the computer hacker] Gary McKinnon."

At one stage supporters blocked the road outside the court, bringing traffic to a standstill. They chanted "no love for the US gov" before being moved on by police.

Great British break-off? Berry latest to jump ship as show moves to Channel 4

■ Paul Hollywood the only member of original cast staying with hit TV show

Mary Berry will not be a judge on The Great British Bake Off when it moves from the BBC to Channel 4, but Paul Hollywood has said he will remain.

Berry said she was staying with the BBC out of "loyalty", adding that it had nurtured her and the show.

She said Bake Off had been "a unique and brilliant format from day one" and that she was "just sad for the audience who may not be ready for change".

'right decision for her'

But Hollywood said he was "delighted" to be staying on the show.

"It's been a huge part of my life in the past few years and I just couldn't turn my back on all that," he said.

Berry wished the show "every success", and added: "Farewell to soggy bottoms."

Last week Mel Giedroyc and Sue Perkins also announced they were leaving, saying they were not "going with the dough".

Hollywood, who has signed a three-year deal, said: "I want to thank the

BBC and Mel and Sue for making my time in the tent great fun and really rewarding."

He also thanked his fellow judge Berry in a later tweet, adding: "She has made the right decision for her."

Berry, Hollywood, Giedroyc and Perkins have appeared on the show since the first series was broadcast on BBC Two in 2010.

Jay Hunt, chief creative officer of Channel 4, said: "Paul really is the star baker - an exceptional talent with a twinkle in his eye."

She added: "His wit, warmth and wisdom are vital ingredients in Bake Off's success. I'm so delighted he's coming to Channel 4."

Charlotte Moore, controller of BBC One, said: "Mary is an extraordinary woman, loved and adored by the British public, and the BBC is her natural home," adding: "I can't wait to cook up more unmissable shows with her in the future."

Love Productions, which makes the series, said they respected Berry's decision but that

the whole crew would "miss her".

'heavily dependent'

Former Culture Secretary John Whittingdale told BBC Radio 4's World at One he had been "surprised" at Channel 4's decision to buy Bake Off, adding: "It does raise questions about whether or not it's appropriate."

Whittingdale said the

network had a remit to be distinctive and different - but accepted the need to generate revenue through advertising to fund such programming.

"But in this case, they have essentially poached a show, which is very successful, from another public service broadcaster - and at some considerable cost," he said.

Whittingdale said

it was "up to the production company to decide which way to go, but they've followed the money".

He added: "It's one of those shows that is very heavily dependent on the character of the presenters."

"If you take those things away, you're not left with much other than, I suppose, a tent and a few ovens."

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Trump campaign 'stole image' from Cypriot immigrant

A CYPRIOT immigrant now living in the UK became an unlikely player in the US presidential election this week when it emerged Donald Trump Jr. stole an image he created for use in a Tweet for his father's campaign.

Trump Jr's tweet comparing Skittles to refugees caused a furore on social media, and to make matters worse it has now emerged that not only did the man who created the image not give his permission for the Trump campaign to use it, but that he is also an immigrant himself.

David Kittos, 48, from Guildford in Surrey, woke up to find an image he had posted to Flickr in January 2010 had become embroiled in a political controversy.

"This was not done with my permission, I don't support his politics and I would never take his money to use it," Mr Kittos told the BBC.

"In 1974, when I was six-years old, I was a refugee from the Turkish occupation of Cyprus so I would never approve the use of this image against refugees."

In his tweet, the son of the Republican

presidential candidate uses Mr Kittos' image with the accompanying text: "If I had a bowl of skittles and I told you just three would kill you, would you take a handful?"

"That's our Syrian refugee problem."

He adds: "This image says it all. Let's end the politically correct agenda that doesn't put America first."

'No permission'

Wrigley, the company that owns Skittles, stepped in to the furore by responding: "Skittles are candy. Refugees are people. We don't feel it is an appropriate analogy".

David Kittos, who

does not follow Twitter, was alerted to the use of the image by friends.

A keen photographer, he told the BBC he originally took the picture in his home studio: "I was just experimenting with something called off-camera flash."

"This was six years ago when there were no Syrian refugees at the time and it was never done with the intention of spreading a political message."

"I have never put this image up for sale. This was not done with my permission, I don't support Trump's politics and I would never take his money to use it."

Mr Kittos' personal history means he is particularly dismayed by his image being used in a debate around accepting refugees.

'Pure greed'

"I am now a British citizen but I am Greek-Cypriot by birth and in 1974 I was a refugee because of the Turkish occupation."

"I was six years old. We lived in the area of Cyprus that is now under Turkish military control. We had to leave everything behind

overnight. Our property and our possessions."

Mr Kittos is unsure whether he will take action over the use of his image by the Trump campaign.

"I would like the Trump campaign to

delete the image, but they are probably not interested in what I have to say," he said.

"I was thinking about getting lawyers involved but I don't know if I have the patience."

"This isn't about the

money for me. They could have just bought a cheap image from a micro stock library. This is pure greed from them. I don't think they care about my feelings. They should not be stealing an image full stop."

Great Britain asked to apologize by Palestinian PM for 1917 declaration

BRITAIN has been asked to apologize for its 1917 declaration endorsing the founding of a Jewish homeland in Palestine by the Palestinian president.

Speaking at the UN General Assembly, Mahmoud Abbas said Palestinian people had suffered greatly because of the 1917 Balfour Declaration in which Britain said it favored the establishment of a home for the Jewish people in Palestine, but that this should not undermine the rights of others living there.

He said: "We ask Great Britain, as we approach 100 years since this infamous declaration, to draw the necessary lessons and to bear its historic, legal, political, material and moral responsibility for the consequences of this declaration, including an apology to the Palestinian people for the catastrophes, misery and injustice this declaration created and to act to rectify these

disasters and remedy its consequences, including by the recognition of the state of Palestine."

He added: "This is the least Great Britain can do."

Israeli-Palestinian peace talks last collapsed in 2014 and there are few hopes for a resumption anytime soon in part because of Israeli anger at Palestinian violence and Palestinian criticism of Israel's construction of settlements on occupied land where Palestinians want to establish a state. The declaration, named for the British foreign secretary at the time,

offered a more nuanced message than Abbas described.

It said: "His Majesty's Government view with favour the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavors to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country."

Queen's cousin comes out as first openly gay Royal

Lord Ivar Mountbatten, a cousin of Queen Elizabeth II, has become the first member of the extended British royal family to come out as gay.

The 53-year-old, who has three children with his ex-wife, Penny Thompson, found love with a man he met during a ski trip, he told London's *Mail on Sunday*.

"I am a lot happier now, though I am still not 100 percent comfortable with being gay," he said.

"Coming out' is such a funny phrase but it's what I suppose I did in a rather roundabout way, emerging to a place I'm happy to be," he told the outlet. "I have struggled with my sexuality and in some ways I still do; it has been a real journey to reach this point."

Mountbatten, who is the son of the 3rd Marquess of Milford Haven and godfather to Prince Edward's eldest child, said he has known since his teens that he was bisexual. Thompson was also aware of his sexuality when they married in 1994.

"She was understanding and I will always be grateful to her. We had a lot of fun, we have three fabulous daughters and I don't regret any stage of my life," he said.

The couple divorced in 2011 and Mountbatten had a "gay fling" in the ensuing years, he told the *Mail*. But he never felt comfortable enough

to come out about his sexuality until recently, when he met 54-year-old airline cabin services director James Coyle.

The pair was skiing in Verbier, Switzerland when a chance encounter at a bar changed their lives forever.

They immediately hit it off and exchanged phone numbers, they both recalled. Coyle was already open about his sexuality, having come out after his mother's death in 2003. If this relationship was to continue, Coyle declared that it could not be in secret.

"If I was going to be with him, it had to be in the open with friends and family. I wanted us to be honest, not to hide anything, not to be anything else," Coyle told the *Mail*.

Mountbatten agreed, first speaking with his family, who "could not be more supportive," he said.

The couple decided to come forward to the media after receiving inquiries into their personal lives, they told the newspaper.

In June, Prince William also made history by becoming the first royal to appear on the cover of a gay magazine.

His photo spread on the U.K.'s *Attitude Magazine* followed joint efforts by his wife, the Duchess of Cambridge, and his brother, Prince Harry, to address mental health issues and fight bullying that can come with them.

Oxford tops world university rankings



DREAMING SPIRES: but uncertainty over Brexit may jeopardize Oxford's supremacy

Oxford University has come top of the Times Higher Education world university rankings - a first for a UK university.

Oxford knocks California Institute of Technology, the top performer for the past five years, into second place.

But there are warnings the vote to leave the European Union could destabilize UK higher education and hinder work with academics abroad.

The rankings show a mixed picture for European universities, while Asian institutions continue to rise.

teaching, research and international outlook - for example, numbers of overseas students and

staff.

Editor of the rankings Phil Baty said it was "fantastic news" Oxford had come top, but the UK's vote to leave the European Union was a big threat to the sector.

"The referendum result is already causing uncertainty for the sector," he said.

"As well as some top academics reporting they have been frozen out of collaborative research projects with EU colleagues, many are admitting that they might look to relocate to a university outside the country.

"It is also having an impact on the UK's potential to attract international talent in the future."

'Bullying' fraudsters nailed after £113m spending spree

A "clever, persistent and pitiless" gang who posed as bank employees to steal £113m from small businesses have been sentenced to 21 years in prison.

Some 750 accountants and solicitors were mercilessly targeted by the crooks who drained the firms' bank accounts and spent the proceeds on a lavish lifestyle of expensive cars and five-star hotels.

At its height, the criminal operation was stealing between £1m and £2m per week and

led to police mounting the biggest cyber-surveillance operation of its kind to arrest the gang.

The fraudsters used a "network of money mules" to siphon the cash into accounts in Dubai and Pakistan and drove Bentleys, Range Rovers, a Rolls-Royce and a lime green Lamborghini. Around £66m has never been recovered.

One firm of solicitors lost more than £2.1m in a single hit, several companies nearly went bankrupt

and one victim later committed suicide.

Masterminded by Feezan Hameed Choudhary, 23, from Glasgow, the gang cold called small businesses and told employees they were speaking to fraud investigators to persuade them to provide log-in details to their bank accounts.

The gang manipulated phone networks to display false numbers when they called and regularly discarded pre-paid dongles in an attempt to erase their

digital footprints.

Choudhary was so convincing, persuasive and controlling while talking to his victims that he was described as "authoritative to the point of being bullying" by judge Peter Testar who sentenced the gang at Southwark Crown Court.

Jailing Choudhary for 11 years, judge Testar said: "Anyone who had heard the calls would have been struck and affected by them. There was a great deal of sophistication in the fraud."

Lots of our members join our group Brits in LA seeking out words of wisdom - what is the best piece of advice you've been given?

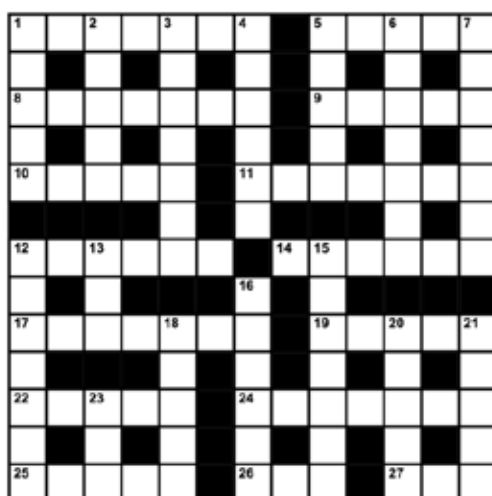

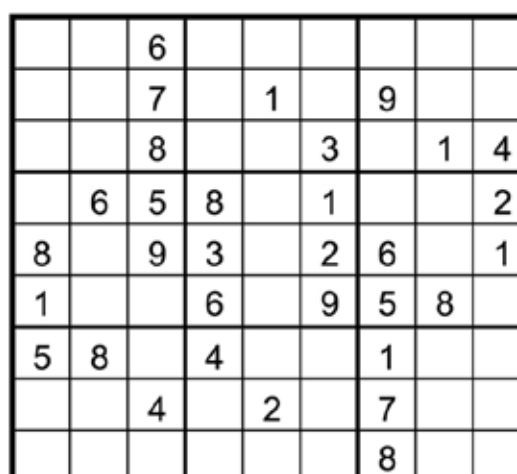

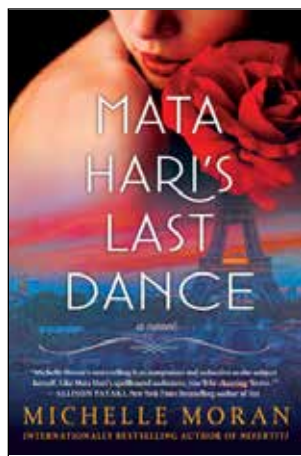

Mata Hari's Last Dance: not putting a foot wrong

"What interested me most about Mata Hari was not actually her dancing or even her extravagant lifestyle, but her emotional arc," says *Mata Hari's Last Dance* author Michelle Moran. "What was it like to go from such a privileged and carefree upbringing to total poverty, then back again to tremendous wealth? How did she handle it? Was this why she couldn't seem to make any relationship stick? What would make an eighteen year-old woman answer an ad for marriage in a newspaper and then give herself to a man



twenty years her senior? Desperation, obviously, but what else? I try to cover all of that."

Moran's books are typically about women in power. Mata Hari has almost no power. She's a beautiful woman who knows how to use her beauty to captivate men. She was a sensual woman in a time when it was considered scandalous to be so. It still is. Hari did what she had to in order to survive in a male-dominated world. She travels, dances and meets many important people of the day. The

bravery she shows at the end of her life tells us she must have been deeper. I've been reading Moran's books since 2007, when I first picked up in the UK a copy of *Nefertiti: A Novel*. Her stories typically leap off the pages, with Moran bringing the location and historical figure to life. With *Mata Hari* it seems that everything is happening to her. I wish we'd gotten inside Mata Hari's feelings.

In 1904 Paris, after failing to be hired to dance at the swanky nightspots La Madeline and L'Ete, 25-year-old Margaretha Zelle meets Edouard Clunet, a lawyer to some very rich men. Edouard becomes her agent, booking her to dance for exclusive events. She becomes a star in Paris. She takes many lovers, some men, some women. She'd abandoned her daughter to escape an abusive marriage. By

1917 Mata Hari's star has faded. She's become a spy and a double agent, seducing officers from France and Germany. Arrested as a spy, she is convicted by the French military in a secret trial. Was she an enemy spy or just a beautiful woman persecuted for refusing the advances of an obsessive French officer?

Visiting the Musee Guimet in France inspired Moran to write about Mata Hari. "This is where Mata Hari had her debut. Imagining her dancing there pre-WW1 made me want to know more about who she had been. She was the Madonna of her time. Everyone knew of her. And then suddenly one day she was gone. A closed trial, an execution.... Can you imagine?"

Moran began her research in France, then continued in the U.S. reading biographies and memoirs. Everything

she found was in books or online in old newspapers. Moran's book covers from Mata Hari's childhood to her death.

Mata Hari's Last Dance is Moran's seventh novel. She's written *Nefertiti*, *The Heretic Queen*, *Cleopatra's Daughter*, *Madame Tussaud*, *The Second Empress*, and *Rebel Queen*. Her fourth novel, *Madame Tussaud*, was optioned for a miniseries. A screenplay adaptation was written by the Michael Hirst of *The Tudors* fame. However, it was not produced.

"After every book I attend signings and the readers I meet there make everything worth it," says Moran. "There are so many fascinating people in this world. If you had a full-time job just talking to people you still wouldn't ever hear every possible life situation or story."

Moran hasn't

announced her next book, but says she's completely in love with the subject matter. "I'll be going to Canada to do some research for it in a few months, and after that, Europe."

Moran was born in California and now lives in the San Fernando Valley. She herself as a Valley girl.

Ranieri dismisses ‘prehistoric’ Mou feud

Leicester manager Claudio Ranieri says Jose Mourinho “is a fantastic person” and any issues between the two are “prehistoric”.

The champions play Manchester United at Old Trafford on Saturday, with the two managers having clashed in the past.

Mourinho called Ranieri “a loser” after replacing him at Chelsea and also insulted him while Inter Milan boss.

Ranieri said: “Mourinho is a fantastic manager, intelligent, clever. “[The issues] were a long time ago.”

Mourinho replaced Ranieri at Chelsea in 2004 and said that the club considered the Italian to be “a loser”, before the pair repeatedly fell out while both managing in Serie A.

The Manchester United boss won the treble with Inter at the end of his three-year spell 2010, with Ranieri in charge of Juventus and Roma during that period.

Mourinho criticised Ranieri’s command of English, said he was “almost 70” when he was 56 and again questioned whether he had the mentality to win titles.

But Ranieri said any complaints were “prehistoric, not now.”

“It [their relationship] is fantastic, very good, no problems,” he said.

“Why? Do you remember in the summer when we had the Soccer Aid, I managed the Rest of the World team against Jose’s English side.

“Maybe he has to offer me a good red wine. I love red wine and if he offers I will go and drink it with him [after Saturday’s game].”

United saw off League

One Northampton on Wednesday, while City won 2-1 at Swansea to set up the second meeting of the two teams this season following City’s derby

Elsewhere, West Ham will host London rivals Chelsea, while Tottenham travel to Liverpool.

Ties will be played on the week beginning 24 October.

City, who won the cup last season after beating Liverpool on penalties, are yet to lose under Pep Guardiola this season.

Jose Mourinho’s United ended a run of three successive defeats against Northampton, a sequence

that had started with the 2-1 derby loss to City.

Arsenal face Reading, a team they beat 7-5 in the League Cup fourth round in 2012, having been 4-0 down at one stage.

Euro 2020: Football will be coming home!

- Wembley to host final and semis of European championship
- Other matches to be spread throughout the continent as tournament celebrates 60th anniversary

Wembley Stadium will host the final and semi-finals of Euro 2020, European governing body Uefa has confirmed.

Glasgow's Hampden Park and Dublin's Aviva Stadium will also host last-16 matches and three group games.

The English Football Association won unanimously after the German FA (DFB) withdrew just before the Uefa vote to focus on a bid to stage Euro 2024.

Cardiff missed out as one of the 13 venues that will host matches for the first pan-continental Euros.

England's FA chairman Greg Dyke, 67, said: "This bidding process was open to more than 50 Uefa countries so for Wembley to be recognised in this way is testament to a lot of hard work behind the scenes."

Dyke confirmed that the FA had held discussions with their German counterparts but said there was no deal in place to back DFB's bid for Euro 2024.

"There is no agreement other than we will not bid for 2024, as we wouldn't get it," Dyke said.

England manager Roy Hodgson said the opportunity to play a final at Wembley would be excellent motivation for his players.

"For the young team that is emerging, many of those players will be at their best football years in 2020," the 67-year-old said.

"If the young players of today do not use this to spur them on then they are making a mistake."

"By 2020 some of them will be playing their fifth tournament and that is

the type of experience you can't buy."

The quarter-finals and three group matches will be held in Munich (Germany), Baku (Azerbaijan), Rome (Italy) and St Petersburg (Russia).

The other host cities that will hold three group games and a last 16 game are Copenhagen (Denmark), Bucharest (Romania), Amsterdam (Netherlands), Bilbao (Spain), Budapest (Hungary) and Brussels (Belgium).

Scottish FA chief executive Stewart Regan said the backing of former Manchester United manager Sir Alex Ferguson and the long history of football in Scotland had been key to their bid.

"Glasgow was the city that held the first

ever football match at international level - between England and Scotland - back in 1872 and we played heavy on the history," Regan said.

"Sir Alex Ferguson, last week, supported us, and spoke very passionately. Football has won today and we are delighted."

The current multi-country format is the brainchild of UEFA president Michel Platini and is expected to be a one-off to mark the 60th anniversary of the European confederation.

Platini told reporters: "This is an historic moment because we'll be able to bring this competition to all the countries of Europe and especially to countries that would never otherwise have the chance to host such a competition."

HOW IT ALL WORKS OUT

■ None of the 13 hosts, including England, are given preferential treatment. Everybody has to qualify for the final stages.

■ 20 of the 24 finalists will comprise the top two from each of 10 qualifying groups of five or six teams, matches to be played between March and November 2019.

■ The final four will gain entry by winning a series of play-offs from the newly formed UEFA Nations League. Matches in the League will be played September to November 2018, play-offs in March 2020.

■ For the finals, 24 teams will be split into

six groups of four, with the top two progressing. UEFA have not finalised how the draw will be arranged but each group is expected to be hosted by two cities close to each other with teams in each group determined to some extent by region.

■ The first knockout round will take place in Copenhagen, Bucharest, Amsterdam, Dublin, Bilbao, Budapest, Brussels, Glasgow, Munich, Baku, St Petersburg and Rome with the quarter-finals in the last four cities.

■ Both semis and the final will take place in a "week of football" at Wembley in July 2020.
