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# HIGH COURT SETBACK FOR BREXIT

- Only Parliament can trigger Article 50, judges rule
- Setback for May could bring snap election

Parliament must vote on whether the UK can start the process of leaving the EU, the High Court has ruled.

This means the government cannot trigger Article 50 of the Lisbon Treaty - beginning formal exit negotiations with the EU - on its own.

Theresa May says the referendum - and existing ministerial powers - mean MPs do not need to vote, but campaigners called this unconstitutional.

The government is appealing, with a further hearing expected next month.

The prime minister's spokeswoman said she would be calling President of the EU Commission Jean-Claude Juncker to say she intended to stick to

her March 2017 deadline for triggering Article 50.

Amid suggestions that she might try to call an early general election, she added that Mrs May believed "there shouldn't be an election until 2020 and that remains her view".

A statement is to be made to MPs on Monday but the government says it has no intention of letting the judgement "derail Article 50 or the timetable we have set out".

Brexit Secretary David Davis said he presumed the court ruling meant an act of Parliament would be required to trigger Article 50 - so would be subject to approval by

both MPs and peers.

But the government was going to contest that view in an appeal, and said the referendum was held only following "a six-to-one vote in the Commons to give the decision to the British people".

"The people are the ones Parliament represents - 17.4m of them, the biggest mandate in history, voted for us to leave the European Union. We are going to deliver on that mandate in the best way possible for the British national interest," he told the BBC.

Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn urged the government "to

bring its negotiating terms to Parliament without delay", adding that "there must be transparency and accountability to Parliament on the terms of Brexit".

But UKIP leader Nigel Farage said he feared a "betrayal" of the 51.9% of voters who backed leaving the EU in June's referendum and voiced concern at the prospect of a "half Brexit".

Westminster sources said the court ruling could mean potentially "months and months" of parliamentary hurdles but added that a majority of MPs would be likely to vote for Article 50 - **cont. on page 2, col. 1**

despite having backed the Remain campaign - as Brexit had been supported in the referendum.

Investment manager Gina Miller, who brought the case, said outside the High Court that the government should make the "wise decision of not appealing".

She said: "The result today is about all of us. It's not about me or my team. It's about our United Kingdom and all our futures."

Government lawyers had argued that prerogative powers were a legitimate way to give effect "to the will of the people".

**"pure question of law"**

But the Lord Chief Justice, Lord Thomas of Cwmgiedd, declared: "The government does not have power under the Crown's prerogative to give notice pursuant to Article 50 for the UK to withdraw from the European Union."

The three judges looking at the case found there was no constitutional convention of the royal prerogative - powers used by ministers - being used in legislation relating to the EU.

They added that triggering Article 50 would fundamentally change UK people's rights - and that the

government cannot change or do away with rights under UK law unless Parliament gives it authority to do so.

Calling the case "a pure question of law", Lord Thomas said: "The court is not concerned with and does not express any view about the merits of leaving the European Union: that is a political issue."

**"disappointed"**

Former attorney general Dominic Grieve told reporters he believed there was time for the government to get legislation through Parliament before the end of March, should they lose the appeal.

He added: "It will certainly allow the opportunity to debate the issues surrounding Brexit but it is worth bearing in mind that it's a bit difficult to fetter the government as to what it should do after Article 50 is triggered because actually, what the government can deliver ... is entirely dependent on the negotiating position of the 27 other member states... So you can't really order the government to stay in the single market because that may not be something that the government can deliver."

Reacting to the ruling, International Trade Secretary Liam Fox told the House of Commons the government was "disappointed" but remained "determined to respect the result of the referendum".

## Its not about me, insists Brexit foe

**The woman behind the legal battle to block Brexit has said she was "delighted" at Thursday's court ruling.**

Millionaire businesswoman Gina Miller spearheaded the campaign against the Government triggering Article 50 - the formal beginning of the UK's exit from the EU - and emerged triumphant outside the High Court in central London.

Ms Miller, an investment fund manager and philanthropist, was applauded after judges ruled that Parliament as a whole would have to approve the start of Brexit.

She said: "The result today is about all of us, it's not about me or my team.

"It's about our United Kingdom and all our futures. It's not about how anyone voted.

**"not about politics"**

"Every one of us voted for the best country and the best future."

She added: "This case was about process not politics."

Speaking before the Government announced it would be appealing, Ms Miller urged ministers to make the "wise decision" not to challenge the ruling.

She said: "My dedicated team at (legal firm) Mishcon (de Reya) and counsel and I are absolutely delighted that we have been able to be part of this debate, and

to bring some sobriety as we go forward.

"The judgment, I hope - when it's read by the Government and they contemplate the full judgment - that

they will make the wise decision of not appealing but pressing forward and having a proper debate in our sovereign parliament, our mother of parliaments that we

are so admired for all over the world."

The Government plans to appeal the ruling and still hopes their original March date for beginning the process will go ahead.

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# Harry cancels secret trip to see 'new love'

■ Prince and 'Suits' actress have been an item for six months, say reports

**PRINCE** Harry cancelled a hush-hush trip to visit stunning actress Meghan Markle after details of their friendship emerged, it was reported this week.

Harry, 32, was booked on a flight to Toronto where the US star is based.

But he scrapped the trip at the last minute after their six-month relationship became public.

The development came as bookmakers dramatically slashed the odds of a royal wedding next year.

Harry is said to be "besotted" with Meghan, 35, who stars in the hit US TV legal drama *Suits*, which is filmed in the Canadian city.

At the weekend, the Sunday Express revealed model Meghan has enjoyed a string of intimate dinner dates at Kensington Palace with the Prince.

It is said she has made a number of low-key visits to London and has been introduced to the

Duke and Duchess of Cambridge. On her most recent visit she posted a picture of Buckingham Palace on Instagram saying she was "gutted" to be leaving.

## passion for Africa

The pair have been spotted wearing identical blue-beaded bracelets, prompting suggestions Harry may have given one as a gift to the actress.

The couple are said to have met in May while Harry was in Canada promoting Invictus Games Toronto 2017, the Paralympics-style competition for injured service personnel started by the Prince.

The pair share a passion for Africa, where the Prince recently spent time in Malawi, and where his love interest has carried out humanitarian work.

On Monday it emerged Harry was booked on Flight BA0093 from Heathrow to Toronto on Sunday.

## wedding odds slashed

Harry, Britain's most eligible bachelor, has

been single since he split from long-term girlfriend Cressida Bonas more than two years ago.

Meghan, who has an African-American mother and Dutch-Irish father, was married to film producer Trevor

Engelson in 2011 but the couple split after two years.

She has more recently been linked with Toronto chef Cory Vitiello, 36.

On Monday night bookmakers Paddy Power offered odds of just

5-2 on the two appearing together at the traditional Royal Christmas church service at Sandringham and 6-1 that the couple will marry next year.

Kensington Palace said it does not comment on private matters.

## No Orgreave inquiry, says government

The Government has ruled out an inquiry into the "Battle of Orgreave", a violent confrontation at the height of the miners' strike. Striking miners had set up pickets at

the Orgreave colliery in Yorkshire to stop lorries carrying coke away. On 18 June 1984, some 6,000 police officers, 42 of them on horses, arrived at the scene, and

corralled miners into a field, setting the stage for a series of clashes. Police insist they were trying to impose law and order; miners claim they were brought in to teach them

a lesson, and break the strike. There have long been calls for an inquiry, but this week Home Secretary Amber Rudd said she had decided it was not in the public interest. Campaigners are now threatening to seek a judicial review of her

decision.

## Academies plan dropped

Plans to force schools to become academies have been dropped. The Education Bill, unveiled by David Cameron's government in March,

initially proposed turning all English schools into academies. That was later watered down, and now the Bill has been dropped altogether. Plans to get rid of reserved places for parent governors on school boards have also been scrapped.

# May to fight FIFA on poppy ban

■ Auld Enemies set to defy governing body in Friday's clash

**THERESA May** on Wednesday told MPs it is "utterly outrageous" of Fifa to try to ban the England and Scotland football teams from displaying poppies when they clash on Armistice Day this week.

It came as Football Association chairman Greg Clarke said England players would wear poppies for their 2018 World Cup qualifier on November 11, despite being outlawed by the sport's world governing body. The English FA said in a statement: "The poppy is an important symbol of remembrance and we do not believe it represents a political, religious or commercial message, nor does it relate to any one historical event."

## 'appropriate tribute'

"In keeping with the position agreed with Fifa back in 2011, the FA intends to pay appropriate tribute to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice by having the England team wear black armbands bearing poppies in our fixture on Armistice Day."

Earlier in the day Mr Clarke had told ITV: "Of course we should wear poppies, and that is our plan. There will be poppies at Wembley."

Mrs May used Prime Minister's Questions on Wednesday to back the campaign for Fifa to relent. Its rules say players' jerseys displaying "political, religious, commercial, personal statements, images and/or other announcements" are banned. It argues that allowing poppies – worn to commemorate the dead of conflicts dating back to the First World War – would open the door to similar initiatives all over the world, and risk football's neutrality.

Five years ago a similar row ended with Fifa letting home nation sides sport poppy armbands.

The Prime Minister said: "The stance taken by Fifa is outrageous. "Our footballers want to recognise and respect those who have given their lives for our security." And in a direct message to Fifa, plagued by corruption scandals, the PM concluded: "Before they start telling us what to do, Fifa jolly well ought to sort their own house out."

Fifa general secretary Fatma Samoura said its rules must be applied "uniformly" adding: "Britain is not the only country suffering from the result of war."

## Sign of the times: Proudly chav boy buried in adidas-style shoebox coffin

■ Hundreds of mourners turn out for the funeral of a popular 17-year-old

■ Three men and a boy, 15, were arrested following death but will face no further action

**Hundreds of mourners congregated at a popular teenager's funeral on Thursday as he was buried in an Adidas shoebox-style coffin adorned in flowers spelling the word 'chav'.**

Jack Gudge, 17, died from serious head injuries following a fight outside a Tesco Express store in Bournemouth, Dorset, on July 16.



appeared in black, white and yellow around the coffin.

Streams of tearful well-wishers, many of them teenagers, hugged and consoled one another as they queued up to enter St Mark's Church, Bournemouth.

Dozens of people had to stand at the back of the church because it was so full.

Jack Gudge died from serious head injuries following a fight outside a Bournemouth Tesco

Three men and a 15-year-old were arrested at the time, but police announced last month that nobody will face criminal charges.

At his funeral eight friends carried Jack's bright blue coffin, which had three white stripes wrapped around the top to replicate an Adidas shoebox.

A flower arrangement that spelled out 'chav' – which was one of Jack's favourite terms –


## 'overwhelming'

He also admitted to watching a couple of episodes of the Chris Evans-hosted *Top Gear* but only because "it was a television programme about cars".

## Wife reunited with hubby she stabbed

An 84-year-old woman jailed for stabbing her husband can reunite with him after a restraining order was lifted.

Elizabeth Stokes was jailed for four-and-a-half-years in 2014 for attacking John, 71, after wrongly believing he was having an affair.

Now the order banning her from contacting him has been lifted at Gloucester Crown Court.

### 'Terrible mistake'

Mr Stokes said he had forgiven his wife and fully recovered from his injuries.

able to visit each other under supervision of the probation service for the next two years before possibly being allowed to live together again.

During the hearing, Mr Stokes said: "I honestly believe her when she says she is very remorseful about what happened."

"She realises she made

a terrible mistake.

"We want to carry on with our marriage and our relationship as soon as possible and I honestly believe it will work and things will be better in the future."

She said: "I had been suffering from stress for a long, long time. Of course, I am sorry for what I did."



## Cornwell's family reunion

Having sold 20 million books, Bernard Cornwell is the world's most successful historical novelist. He is also a smoker, a drinker and an atheist – which makes sense, given his past, says Frances Hardy in the *Daily Mail*. The product of a wartime liaison, he was adopted as a baby by the Wigginses, a couple from Essex who were members of a Protestant fundamentalist sect called The Peculiar People. Family life was bleak, and brutal. "The list of prohibitions was endless," he says. "Alcohol, tobacco, TV and cinema, for a start. Military service was also prohibited, though Joe [Wiggins] was very harsh. He was a man drunk on God, and the Bible said: 'Beat your children', which he did, very brutally, with a 4ft cane." Yet he bears no malice towards Joe; it was his hate-filled mother who made his life hell. Once he reached adulthood, he never spoke to her again.

But he did know he was adopted, and 15 years ago, he found his biological father – a Canadian former airman – and flew to Vancouver to meet him, and his half-siblings. "They welcomed us generously and instantly. We were family... It was more moving than I expected. A pleasure. I liked these people who snorted when they laughed, as I did; who had the same gait." A year later, he was reunited with his birth mother, at her flat in Basingstoke. "And what struck me was that it was absolutely crammed with historical novels." She too had married and had a family – but she told him she had thought about him all the time, and worried. "She remembered the Wigginses standing at her bedside in the maternity home. 'I knew they weren't cuddly,' she said, and how right she was."





"I fell in love...but he was a development economist, later a diplomat, and his work and life were clearly going to be abroad," says *Full Marks for Trying* author Brigid Keenan. "So, I had a choice. Career or love. Of course I choose love...which meant that I spent the next 40 years worrying about what to do as I followed him round the world." Keenan, already a London journalist, became an author.

*Full Marks for Trying* is an autobiography. Keenan's father is an army officer in the closing days of British rule over India. At age eight Keenan and her

family move to London. Sent to finishing school in Paris, she comes back to London and is a debutante. She overhears her mother say she's desperately plain and decides to make a name for herself. By age 21 she's the fashion editor at the Sunday Times. Celebrities she hangs out with include English fashion photographer David Bailey and the first supermodel, Jean Shrimpton. Next, Keenan meets her future husband.

Keenan's writing is honest with British dry wit sprinkled liberally

in the mix. Shes wistful about the past, but she's still up on the current trends and technology. It's the Swinging Sixties with the young in-crowd in London fashion.

"When I met my future husband in 1970 I was working at The Observer as woman's editor then, but had previously worked on The Sunday Times and as assistant editor on Nova magazine," says Keenan. "This was the magazine of the 60s and early 70s. I'd also tried to be a war correspondent in Vietnam, and failed. In our first posting in Brussels, I finished a book, *The Women We Wanted to Look Like*, which was a history of fashion in 20th century, told via the women who wore the clothes, that is, Jackie Kennedy. After a visit to Kashmir, I wrote a book about that country while we were posted to the Caribbean."

"For *Full Marks for Trying* I had to be very sure of my facts about the Partition of India," says Keenan. "I quote

from my father's letters. He witnessed horrors at this time. I did this at the British Library which holds the old India Office Library."

Posted to Kazakhstan, Keenan didn't speak Russian or Kazakh. "And there were no old buildings to write about, so I was in despair. Then I thought of turning the diary I had always kept, jotted down on the backs of envelopes or loose bits of paper, into a book about being what it is like being a trailing spouse." That book, *Diplomatic Baggage*, became a bestseller.

The sequel, *Packing Up*, is about the couple's last posting in Azerbaijan.

Keenan says becoming a fashion editor at The Sunday Times in 1961 when she was only 21 was a piece of luck. "I felt I wanted to write about that so I did flashbacks in *Packing Up*. But, my most wonderful editor at Bloomsbury, Alexandra Pringle, decided to take out the flashbacks as it was all getting a bit complicated." The cuts

became Keenan's latest book, *Full Marks for Trying*.

Keenan wrote *Dior in Vogue* published by Octopus Press, *The Women We Wanted to Look Like* by Macmillan, *Travels in Kashmir* by OUP, *Damascus, Hidden Treasures of the Old City* by Thames & Hudson, *Diplomatic Baggage* by John Murray, *Packing Up* by Bloomsbury and *Full Marks for Trying* by Bloomsbury.

Keenan is now the fashion editor of *The Oldie* magazine in UK. "I interview a well-known person each month and ask them about their clothes and views on fashion."

Keenan is currently revising *The Women We Wanted to Look Like*, to bring it up to date from when it was first published forty years ago. She's also writing *Alphabet* for children, her own version of the alphabet that she taught her children to read with. An artist friend is doing the illustrations. Keenan is contemplating

Keenan divides her time between the family home in Somerset and a small flat in London. She was born in India, in Ambala, Punjab. She's been married for 43 years, is 76, and has two daughters and four grandchildren.

## When London is calling, you simply must answer...

ONE OF THE crown jewels of the City of Angels is the Getty Center, located just off the 405 freeway in the Sepulveda Pass.

Since it opened its doors in 1997 the Getty has featured one great British exhibit after another. But if you haven't yet visited, you now have the perfect excuse with their LondonCalling Exhibit, which I was fortunate enough to catch this week.

The show features six of the leading postwar artists from the so-called "School of London" who rejected the artworld of the time's preoccupation with abstraction and conceptualism in favor of the human figure and everyday landscape. Drawn primarily from the Tate in London, this exhibition highlights the work of Francis Bacon, Lucian Freud, Leon Kossoff, Michael Andrews, Frank Auerbach, and R.B. Kitaj.

Now you may be forgiven for thinking that all these artists are from the UK. But only a half were born there. Bacon, Kossoff and Andrews. The group was named after the American artist R.J. Kitaj realized there was quite a significant amount of working painters in London during the 70's, but they needed more publicity and recognition. You had the school of

Paris already, whose artists were already making waves. So he coined the phrase School of London to develop interest. And boy did it!

And, while it was none too clear how much they had in common, they at least flew the flag of figurative painting when it was distinctly unfashionable.

Along with some of Brits in LA key members, I got to listen to a talk with Andrea Rose and Art dealer William Acquavella, moderated by Julian Brooks who shared some wonderful anecdotes about the artists. For example, did you know Lucian was the grandson of Sigmund and this was considered his Achilles' heel, with most people initially assuming he was merely trading on the family name? Or that he loved to gamble and once had a gambling debt of £1.2 million? These and many other stories about the artists had us entertained for over an hour. The show ends November 13th so do try to see it before it moves on. I am particularly fond of Bacon's work, so if anyone has a few million dollars to give me I'll happily make an investment on one of his works. A Triptych of his sold at auction for \$140m just a couple of years ago, which is more money than I can usually find down the

back of my couch.

I also got to see the #fivefilms4freedom screening at the London Hotel as part of the BFI series showcasing filmmakers from around the world making films that portray the LGBT community in their neighborhoods. Stephen Fry was among the panelists who discussed the importance of these stories and others like them. Among the audience were BILA members Manny Patel and Fiona Harden, as well as Consul-General Chris O'Connor, John Scott, BAFTA/LA CEO Chantel Rickard and filmmaker Julia Verdin.

In a more escapist vein I was also lucky enough to catch the Pet Shop Boys in concert at The Microsoft Theater this past week. They were in fine form, singing a lot of new songs but making sure to play plenty of oldies to please the, ahem, oldies in the crowd.

Spurs have the option to play all home league and cup matches, as well as any European games, at Wembley next season.

Pochettino added: “It is embarrassing for me.

“After two games at Wembley, Monaco and Bayer Leverkusen, there is no excuse. We were poor and we need to find the answer in ourselves.

“We are very disappointed and we cannot show the performance that we have in recent weeks - that is the problem.”

The Leverkusen defeat followed a 2-1 loss at Wembley against Monaco in their opening Champions League game of the season.

Wednesday's match was played in front of 85,512, the highest English club home Champions League crowd, but saw Spurs fall to their sixth successive Wembley loss.

Spurs now lie third in Group E behind Monaco and Bayer Leverkusen with two games left to qualify for the knockout stage, away to Monaco and at home to CSKA Moscow.

“We must win, if not we can forget the

Champions League,” Pochettino said.

“We need to improve and we don't have too much time to do that.”

Spurs return to Premier League action on Sunday in the North London derby against Arsenal.

## Battling Celtic make their point

Celtic kept their Champions League hopes alive by battling back to draw with Borussia Monchengladbach on Tuesday.

Scott Sinclair curled a shot against the post for the visitors before Lars Stindl volleyed Gladbach ahead.

Andre Hahn fired off the crossbar as the hosts pressed for a second and Celtic's Moussa Dembele drew a save from goalkeeper Yann Sommer.

Dembele was then fouled by Julian Korb, who was sent off, and the striker converted the resulting penalty.

Brendan Rodgers' side, who face Barcelona in Glasgow on 23 November, move on to two points at the bottom of Group C, trailing Gladbach by two points and final group opponents Manchester City by five.

Though Celtic's Champions League fate is all but sealed, Dembele's cool penalty ensures they can still overtake Borussia in third and secure a Europa League berth.

## Ozil clever finish proved me wrong – Wenger

Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger thought Mesut Ozil had made a mistake by trying to outfox the Ludogorets defence before scoring a superb winner on Tuesday.

Ozil scored the Gunners' third as they came from two goals down to win 3-2 and reach the Champions

League last 16.

The German chipped the ball over the keeper before beating two defenders and slotting the ball into the empty net.

“To me it didn't look like the optimal solution, but when the ball was in the net I thought it was,” said Wenger.

“The great players

make the right decisions in the game situations they face. They always make the optimal solution.

“You wanted him to take maybe his chance earlier, but at the end he had enough skill to prove that he was right.”

Arsenal top Group A with 10 points, the

same number as Paris St-Germain, and nine ahead of both Ludogorets and Basel with two games remaining.

They were trailing the Bulgarian side 2-0 after just 15 minutes on Tuesday but drew level before half-time through goals from Granit Xhaka and Olivier Giroud.

Ozil, 28, scored the winner in the 87th minute - his fourth goal against Ludogorets in two matches.

The Gunners host French champions PSG on 23 November before travelling to Switzerland to face Basel in their final group game on 6 December.

# This will scar us, says Cook

■ Shocking loss will leave England vulnerable against No. 1-ranked India, admits skipper

ALISTAIR Cook has admitted that England could be psychologically scarred for their upcoming tour of India by a horrendous batting collapse that led to their first ever Test defeat by Bangladesh.

England, chasing 273 runs to win on Sunday, were cruising at 100 without loss at tea on the third day of the Second Test in Dhaka.

But the dismissal of Ben Duckett to the first ball of the evening session sparked an implosion that saw them lose all 10 wickets for just 64 runs in 22.2 overs.

Bangladesh's spinners ran riot to seal their first home win against a

major nation since the gained Test status in 2000 and captain Cook said: “We go to India as pretty heavy underdogs. There's no doubt about it. But sometimes English people like being underdogs.”

India top the world cricket rankings and will take on England over a five Test series. The tourists' seeming inability to handle spin bowling has some predicting a whitewash, prompting Cook to emphasize the need to keep mentally strong.

“This is when we need to really stay strong as a group,” he said. “When you're at home, you can get away from it for a

couple of days. But we haven't got that luxury.

“We have to watch guys and make sure as a group we stay together and put a few things on to take guys' minds away from it and when we are training make sure we're on the right track.”

England lost their cool as they slipped to defeat on this third day.

Talismanic all-rounder Ben Stokes has been fined 15 per cent of his match fee for his verbal clash with Bangladesh's Sabbir Rahman during a morning session in which England dropped four chances as the hosts built their lead.

Cook was spoken to by the umpires after

Stokes received several warnings for his sledging of Sabbir.

He said: “I do find it a little bit frustrating. They're both very competitive cricketers, Sabbir and Stokes.”

“To me, people love it - that's what people watch. Sometimes I believe the umpires can get involved too quickly and then it blows up even more.”

The pundits were equally harsh on Cooks team, with George Dobell on ESPNcricinfo thundering: England didn't just lose; they lost ten wickets for a pathetic 64 runs. It was like watching a “Greatest Hits compilation” of

their historic failings: there was “the comical fielding, the impotent bowling” and, worst of all, the batting collapse.”

Blame the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB), said Scyld Berry in *The Sunday Telegraph*. The governing body has “presided over the extinction of the spin culture” in English cricket. In the early 1990s, almost all counties fielded two specialist spinners. But since then, spin bowling has been in decline in England - and the ECB has done too little to encourage it, even taking action at That neglect leaves England vulnerable against Asian spinners.”

# Pep hails landmark win

■ Barca victory shows what club can do, says buoyant City manager

**Manchester City manager Pep Guardiola says his side's 3-1 Champions League victory over Barcelona is a landmark win for the club, but admits they did not do it playing the way he favours.**

City had not beaten Barca in five previous attempts in Europe and Guardiola said after the Group C game on Tuesday: "It is a good step to say that once in our lives we played against the best team in the world and we beat them."

"We competed with Barcelona, but for now we did it in a different way. We played more long balls because we are still not ready to keep the ball and play like they do."

## thrilling comeback

"They have been playing that way for 25 years. For us, it is three or four months that we have been trying to play in a different style."

City staged a thrilling comeback after Lionel Messi's 90th Champions League goal put the visitors 1-0 up in the first 20 minutes.

The win, courtesy of two goals from Ilkay Gundogan and Kevin de Bruyne's free-kick, leaves City second in the group behind Barca, needing

one more win from their two remaining games to progress to the last 16.

Guardiola, who won the Champions League twice as Barca manager, had seen his side lose 4-0 at the Nou Camp last month in the reverse fixture after goalkeeper Claudio Bravo was sent off.

## "more direct"

But the 45-year-old Spaniard said that when it was "11 v 11" in the first game, his side performed much better than for the 38 minutes on Tuesday night.

"They were 1-0 up and we were really in trouble. They had a chance to score their second and if they had, then the game was done - finished," said Guardiola.

"Our equaliser changed absolutely everything for our mood. We also realised our build-up was too complicated, because they were playing a high-pressing game against us."

"We did not feel comfortable and we changed the way we played. We tried to play a little bit more direct."

Guardiola, 45, took charge of City in the summer with the brief of conquering Europe and he feels that, psychologically, they have taken a big step

in the right direction.

City progressed to the semi-final of the Champions League last season under previous manager Manuel Pellegrini.

"If you talk about the whole performance then, for the first 38 minutes, we were still not able to compete with the best clubs in the world," said Guardiola.

"But, in the second half, it was different. I saw my players were upbeat - they knew they had gone through their bad moment. That sureness Barca had in the first half, we were able to turn that around."

"Now they will realise that they have beaten the best team. Future generations will see that and know they have to do that again. That is a process."

"It was the same with the group of players with Joe Hart and Vincent Kompany who won the title twice in five or six years together. The players arriving at the club now understand they have to do that, or try to do that too."

## More United misery

**Fenerbahce scored two stunning goals to beat Manchester United on Thursday and leave Jose Mourinho's side in danger of Europa League elimination.**

Striker Moussa Sow gave Fenerbahce the lead within 65 seconds with an overhead kick which sailed over David de Gea, and Jermain Lens curled in a brilliant free-kick in the second half.

The visitors dominated possession

but saw world-record signing Paul Pogba go off with a leg injury in the first half.

Captain Wayne Rooney smashed in a 25-yard consolation goal late on.

Defeat means United are third in Group A - one point behind leaders Feyenoord and Fenerbahce - with two games left, against the Dutch side at Old Trafford and away to Ukraine's Zorya Luhansk.
