

No longer the back of the queue?

■ Trump victory great news for Britain, top Tories insist

BRITAIN'S right wing has greeted Donald Trump's stunning victory in the US presidential battle with delight, claiming that Britain is now at the 'front of the queue' for a trade deal.

Jubilant MPs pointed to the billionaire's support for a quick agreement with the UK after Brexit as they celebrated his triumph.

Foreign Secretary Boris Johnson said it was time to be "overwhelmingly positive about the possibilities" of a Donald Trump presidency.

"I would respectfully say to my beloved European friends and colleagues that it's time that we snapped out of the general doom and gloom about the result of this election and collective 'whinge-o-rama' that seems to be going on in some places."

'great opportunity'

He said Mr Trump had had a "very good conversation" with Mrs May and was "a deal maker; he wants to do a free trade deal".

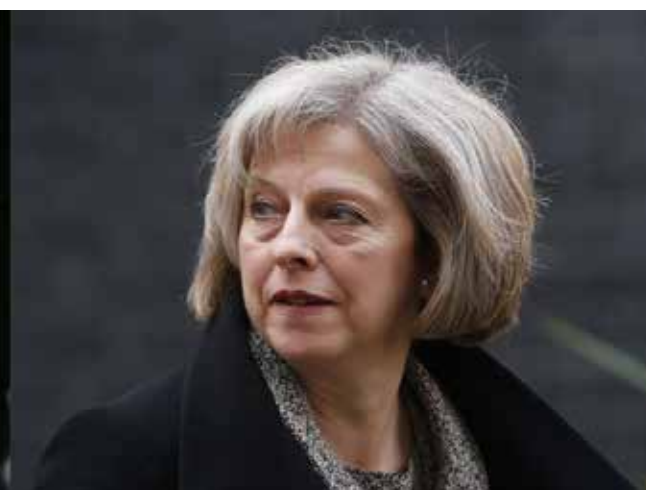
"And I believe that this is a great opportunity for us in the UK to build on that relationship with America that is of

fundamental economic importance to us, but also, great importance for the stability and prosperity of the world."

Earlier his cabinet colleague Chancellor Philip Hammond was asked what it meant for the US/UK "special relationship" that Mr Trump had spoken to other world leaders before the UK's prime minister.

He replied: "The special relationship is alive and well and strong and deep... what's special about the special relationship between the UK and the US is that it is not a relationship between any two people or the holders of any two offices, it's a very deep relationship that works at many levels."

And former Conservative leader Iain Duncan Smith told BBC Two's Newsnight that he believed there was a "real opportunity" for the UK to "reinvigorate" its relationship with the US,

arguing it had been "in the freezer now for about eight years".

"I think there's a real opportunity with Donald Trump there for us to be able to reinvigorate that relationship. Brexit means we are now freer to make arrangements.

"He's already said he would want to see some kind of agreement with the UK and from that, we can build - whether it's Nato or whether it's global relations, whether it's about arguing over WTO and trade."

Earlier, Conservative MP Jacob Rees-Mogg told the BBC's World at One he saw both Brexit and Mr Trump's election as a

"triumph of optimism for people in America, who believe in the American Dream and believed that the liberal elite were taking it away from them" while in the UK he believed it was "about feeling that the UK could stand on its own two feet".

close connections

Mr. Trump's election could also put the final nail in the coffin of the trade package being negotiated between the US and EU - despite pleas from senior Eurocrats for him to change his approach.

Former Conservative Party deputy chairman Lord Ashcroft tweeted:

'So the UK will not be at the back of the queue for a UK/UK trade deal.'

It later emerged that Mr. Trump has invited Theresa May to visit Washington in a phone call in which both stressed the importance of UK/US relations.

Downing St said Mr Trump had spoken of his close connections with the UK while Mrs May congratulated him on his win.

Mr Trump, whose mother was Scottish, said the UK was a "very, very special place for me and for our country".

May is expected to be among the first foreign leaders to meet Mr. Trump

personally following his inauguration in January. May has already signaled her high hopes that the so-called Special Relationship will continue.

'I would like to congratulate Donald Trump on being elected the next President of the United States, following a hard-fought campaign,' she said in a statement.

'Britain and the United States have an enduring and special relationship based on the values of freedom, democracy and enterprise.

'We are, and will remain, strong and close partners on trade, security and defence.

BAR WARS! outcry as Toblerone cuts down on famous chocolate triangles

TOBLERONE lovers say they feel cheated after the chocolate's makers changed its famous "mountain" shape.

Gaps between the previously tight-knit peaks have been widened to cut costs – leaving the bars around 10 per cent smaller.

Horried customers have slammed the new design in online posts, saying it looks like a "toothless comb".

"all about the triangle"

Garry Cornell wrote on the Toblerone Facebook page: "Terrible decision. The new shape ruins the whole experience.

"Why not keep the shape and have one less triangle? The joy was always in breaking off one triangle at a time."

And Stephen Mason posted: "Toblerone is all about the triangle."

Toblerone's 400 gram bars have shrunk by nine per cent to 360g and the 170g bars are down by more than 11 per cent to 150g.

US company Mondelez International, which produces Toblerone, claimed the move was needed to save the popular treat in the face of rising costs.

The company, which also owns Cadbury, has been criticised in the past for altering famous products such as Dairy

Milk bars and Creme Eggs.

Mondelez said in a statement: "Like many other companies, we are experiencing higher costs for numerous ingredients.

"We carry these costs for as long as possible but to ensure Toblerone remains on-shelf, is affordable and retains the triangular shape, we have had to reduce the weight of just two of our bars in the UK."

negative effect

The packaging is unchanged, leading to claims people are being fooled.

Robert Haigh, of consultancy Brand Finance, said "They don't seem to have a reverence for traditional confectionery. Not changing the packaging could be seen as deceptive and we will wait to see whether it has a negative effect.

"Creme Egg sales plunged when they changed the recipe."

Walkers crisps and food group Unilever have both raised prices following a fall in the value of the pound.

Toblerone was launched in Switzerland in 1908 by Theodor Tobler. It was bought out by Mondelez, then known as Kraft Foods, in 1990.

'I look forward to working with President-elect Donald Trump, building on these ties to ensure the security and prosperity of our nations in the years ahead.'

Mrs May's careful approach to Mr Trump during the presidential battle was in stark contrast to predecessor David Cameron's public views on the Republican candidate.

The then-PM joined condemnation of Mr Trump's suggestion that Muslims should

be banned from the US 'until our country's representatives can figure out what is going on'.

Mr Cameron said: 'I think his remarks are divisive, stupid and wrong and I think if he came to visit our country I think it'd unite us all against him.'

The barb led Mr Trump to question whether the 'special relationship' would continue.

new reality

In May, Mr Trump dismissed Mr Obama's suggestion that the UK would be at the 'back of the queue' for a trade deal outside the EU.

'I don't want to say

front or anything else,' he said. 'I mean, I'm going to treat everybody fairly but it wouldn't make any difference to me whether they were in the EU or not. You'd certainly not be at the back of the queue, that I can tell you.'

Meanwhile European leaders were scrambling to adjust to the new reality of dealing with a man who was widely considered to be unelectable.

As the impact of the decision by American voters started to sink in, EU commission president Jean-Claude Juncker and European Council president Donald Tusk made a desperate bid to

revive the stalled TTIP trade deal with the US.

In a joint letter to Mr Trump, they stressed the importance of 'strengthening transatlantic relations'.

Referring to the trade negotiations and cooperation on security, they said: 'We should consolidate the bridges we have been building across the Atlantic.'

But former Labour leader Ed Miliband was far less sanguine about the prospect of a Trump presidency, telling reporters: "I think we should be deeply worried about the implications for many of the things that we care about."



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Jimmy Young, from pop star to BBC 2 legend, dead at 95

■ Former crooner enjoyed long second career as BBC Radio DJ

BRITAIN loses one of its most enduring radio entertainers this week with the passing of Sir Jimmy Young. He was 95.

Young was a one-time crooner and disc jockey who became Britain's most popular broadcaster; from 1973 to 2002 Radio 2's Jimmy Young Programme claimed a regular audience of between five and seven million listeners.

The "JY Prog", as Young christened it, ran from noon to 2 pm every weekday and featured a winsome blend of sport, politics, phone-ins, recipes, gardening, medical advice, travel and consumer issues, interspersed with light music of the "easy listening" kind.

only child

For three decades it was the chosen vehicle of politicians wanting to speak to "middle England" and the chatty format of the program gave them an almost unique opportunity to appear normal: "Now Margaret, how about three minutes of Andy Williams?" Young would enquire. "That would be lovely, Jim." By the time he retired, Young had interviewed every prime minister since Alec Douglas-Home (Mrs Thatcher appeared 14 times) as well as members of the Royal family and innumerable world leaders.

But although he enjoyed huge success later in life the first few decades were less promising. Born Leslie Ronald Young on September 21 1921 at Cinderford, in the Forest of Dean he was an only child. His father and uncle ran a bakery and

his mother kept the books and played the organ at the Baptist church. She taught her son to sing and play the piano.

Jimmy won a scholarship to the local grammar school, where he became a champion boxer. But his parents' marriage broke down when Jimmy was 16. Desperately unhappy, he decided to run away from home, a response he would repeat several times during his life when things got too emotionally fraught. He remained in touch with his mother, but though his father lived to be 93 he only saw him once ever again.

At the outbreak of war, Young tried to join the Army but was rejected as being too young. He added a couple of years and tried the RAF which recruited him as a physical training instructor, though he eventually found his niche as a singer with a rest and recreation unit in Burma. On demob, he became a session singer and married Wendy Wilkinson, a nurse, in 1946. They had a daughter, but the marriage broke up three years later.

No. 1 hits

In August 1949 Young entered show business with his own band and played and sang at London night spots. In 1951 he had a hit with Too Young and in 1955 became the first British artist to have two consecutive No 1 hits – Unchained Melody and The Man from Laramie. A year later he married the singer Sally Douglas; but that marriage too would break up seven years later.

Jimmy Young's relaxed vocal delivery appealed to older listeners but

as the decade wore on he got a sense he was becoming irrelevant. The turning point, he later said, came when he went to the cinema in 1958 and "heard a voice coming out of the screen that sent a chill up my spine. It was Bill Haley. 'This is the end for you, Jim,' I told myself."

current affairs

When he realised in 1960 that he only had three weeks of bookings for the whole year, Young had thoughts of suicide and began to collect sleeping pills. But he was saved in the nick of time by a clairvoyant who told him his career was going to be "bigger than it had ever been" and that he would not reach his peak until the 1980s.

Young made a tentative move into radio and was soon offered regular work at a variety of stations before finding a home on Radio Luxembourg and later moving to Radio 1 in 1967.

He was only given a six-month contract, but the Radio 1 Jimmy Young Programme lasted for six years, building up an audience addicted to its eclectic mix of light music, recipes ("What's the recipe today, Jim?" became a national catch-phrase) and the presenter's strange manipulations of the language: For a while TTFN ("ta ta for now") became English for good bye. In 1968, Young was named "Radio Personality Of The Year" by the Variety Club.

Young was approaching his 50th birthday when Ian Trethowan, then the BBC's managing director of Radio, asked him what he would like to do next. Convinced

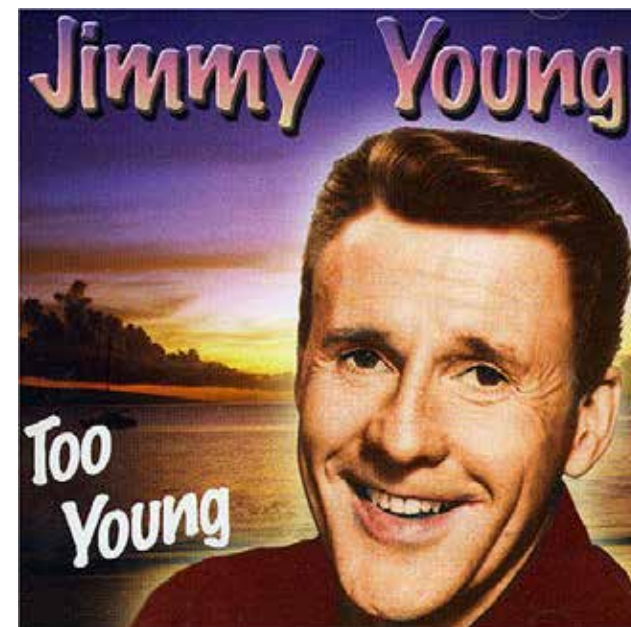
that popular radio was underestimating people's interest in what was going on in the world, Young told him he would like to do a current affairs programme with music, and in 1973, he was given a daily two hour slot on Radio 2. That became the flagship Radio 2 show for which he is best known.

The programme broke the mould with top news interviews interspersed with music and comments from listeners being read out on air. Over the next three decades, it became almost a national institution.

As well as radio, Young made regular appearances on television and presented several shows including Jimmy Young

Asks (BBC, 1972) Jim's World (ITV, 1974) and The Jimmy Young Television Programme (ITV, 1984-87). He produced a

series of cookery books based on the recipes from his programme. His autobiography was published in 1982.

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Back off my girl, furious Harry implores the media

Prince Harry has condemned the media for subjecting girlfriend Meghan Markle to "a wave of abuse and harassment," issuing a highly unusual statement Tuesday that confirmed his relationship with the American actress and expressed concern for her safety.

Harry's office said that while the 32-year-old prince understood that there was significant curiosity about his private life, a line had been crossed in terms of media intrusion. Harry said the statement was issued in hopes that media driving the story will "pause."

"Prince Harry is worried about Ms. Markle's safety and is deeply disappointed that he has not been able to protect her," said the statement from Kensington Palace. "It is not right that a few months into a relationship with him that Ms. Markle should be subjected to such a storm."

One Daily Mail headline called her a "saucy divorcee." Another described her ancestors as "a tailor, a teacher and a cleaner in racially-divided Jim Crow South - while his were ruling the British Empire."

"not a game"

Harry said the commentators will say this is "the price she has to pay" and that "this is all part of the game."

The palace said that Harry "strongly disagrees."

"This is not a game - it is her life and his," the statement said.

The palace said some of the harassment hasn't been apparent to the public. It said Markle's mother has struggled to get past photographers to gain entry to her front door, reporters and photographers have tried to gain illegal entry to her home, her ex-boyfriend has been offered bribes while

friends and co-workers have been bombarded for data.

"But the past week has seen a line crossed," the palace said. "His girlfriend, Meghan Markle, has been subject to a wave of abuse and harassment."

Harry said the statement was issued in hopes that the media "can pause and reflect before any further damage is done."

In a 2015 article for Elle magazine, Markle wrote about how she came to terms being a "biracial woman." She said her mother is African-American while her father is white.

"While my mixed heritage may have created a gray area surrounding my self-identification, keeping me with a foot on both sides of the fence, I have come to embrace that," she wrote. "To say who I am, to share where I'm from, to voice my pride in being a strong, confident mixed-race woman."

The 35-year-old Markle is best known for playing paralegal Rachel Zane in the TV legal drama "Suits." She has also worked with the United Nations on gender equality and is a global ambassador for the charity World Vision Canada.

Tabloids in Britain and beyond have jumped on the story and speculated about the relationship for weeks, with many commenting on her mixed-race heritage and contrasting her background with the prince's. The palace said the harassment has "been very public - the smear on the front page of a national newspaper; the racial undertones of comment pieces; and the outright sexism and racism of social media

Driver arrested after tram crash kills seven

A HORRIFIC tram crash in south London this week took the lives of seven people, while the tram's driver has been arrested on suspicion of manslaughter.

The tram driver, a 42-year-old man from Beckenham, has been arrested on suspicion of manslaughter after the incident, which happened Wednesday evening in Croydon.

British Transport Police said they were investigating whether he fell asleep.

Officers were expected to remain at the scene for the next 24 hours as authorities launch inquiries into the crash.

Investigators from

the Rail Accident Investigation Branch said the tram was travelling at a "significantly higher speed than is permitted" before it careered off the track.

"carnage"

A spokesman said: "Initial indications suggest that the tram was travelling at a significantly higher speed than is permitted."

Transport for London also said it had also launched an inquiry to identify what went "catastrophically wrong".

London's Transport Commissioner Mike Brown said: "I am devastated for the

families and friends of those who have lost their lives and those who have been injured.

"Clearly something has gone catastrophically wrong and we will work tirelessly and quickly with the emergency services, the tram operator First Group and others to establish a cause."

More than 70 firefighters were sent to the emergency operation as dozens of passengers were rushed to two hospitals in south London.

London Mayor Sadiq Khan and Croydon MP Gavin Barwell were among those to visit the scene.

Passengers told of

"carnage" and "blood everywhere" as they likened the derailment to "something out of a film".

Martin Bamford, 30, from Croydon described the scene as "total carnage".

Speaking outside Croydon University Hospital, where he is being treated for fractured or broken ribs, Mr Bamford said: "It was just terrifying."

"There was a woman that was on top of me. I don't think she made it at all. She wasn't responsive. There was blood everywhere."

Asked about the driver, he said: "I asked him if he was okay. He said 'yeah'. I said to him 'what happened?'

He said he thinks he blacked out."

The crash is believed to be the first tram crash involving fatalities on board since 1959, when two women passengers and the driver died after a tram caught fire in Glasgow, following a collision with a lorry.

London's only tram network operates in the south of the capital, from Wimbledon to Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington, via Croydon.

More than 27 million passengers used the service in 2015/16. The system uses a combination of on-street and segregated running for the 17 miles (27km) of track.

British banker jailed for life for horrific murder of sex workers

A BRITISH banker who filmed himself torturing and murdering two women in his Hong Kong apartment has been jailed for life.

Rurik Jutting, 31, denied murdering two prostitutes, pleading diminished responsibility due to alcohol, drug abuse and sexual disorders.

But a jury at Hong Kong's High Court rejected his claim and returned unanimous guilty verdicts.

Sentencing Jutting to life, Judge Michael Stuart-Moore spoke of a dark world of cocaine abuse, prostitutes and sexual sadism.

He said: "This must

rank as one of the more horrifying murder cases ever to come to court in Hong Kong."

The judge described the former public schoolboy's actions as "sickening in the extreme

and beyond a normal person's imagination".

And he told the court: "There are insufficient superlatives to describe what he did."

Lawyers for Jutting said he will apply to serve part of his sentence in Britain.

But Judge Stuart-Moore said he was sending details of the case to British authorities and urged them against falling for the killer's "superficial charm".

Jutting showed no emotion as the judge described him as an "archetypal sexual predator" who was an extreme danger to women.

The murders of

Indonesian-born Sumarti Ningsih, 23, and Seneng Mujiasih, 26, were even more shocking because he had been given every possible material advantage in life.

He went from a very privileged upbringing to a great career with a massive salary, the judge said.

Cambridge university-educated Jutting, who grew up in Chertsey in Surrey, was earning £350,000 a year when he quit his job with the Bank of America.

In a statement he said he was haunted daily by what he had done and that he was "sorry beyond words".

Jutting had argued that cocaine and alcohol disorders as well as

personality disorders including sexual sadism and narcissism had impaired his ability to control his behaviour.

But the prosecution insisted he was able to form judgments and exercise self-control before and after the killings.

He videoed torture scenes on his mobile phone and recorded hours of footage in which he discussed the murders, his cocaine binges and graphic sexual fantasies.

Defence lawyer Tim Owen said the high-flying banker told his employers he was HIV positive, an excuse for his increasing absenteeism and a clear sign that he was starting to lose his grip on reality.

He spent £1,000 a day on his cocaine habit and used a range of prostitutes, including transsexuals and homosexuals, to indulge his torture and rape fantasies.

He consumed three grams of cocaine, energy drinks and six bottles of wine and spirits a day, the court heard.

His slide toward sexual sadism was to end in horrifying murders. In one video filmed by Jutting, his victim begged for her life before having her throat slit.

Police found another video in which the monster declared: "My destiny is to push the boundaries to complete utter inhumanity. There will be no redemption for me."



Winner: life after death?

In death, as in life, Michael Winner can be somewhat overbearing. The film director turned restaurant reviewer died in 2013, in bed at the sprawling Kensington mansion in which he grew up. Pop star Robbie Williams and his wife Ayda Field (pictured) bought the house for £17.5m, and have spent nearly three years redecorating. But Field, 37, says she can feel the spirit of the late bon vivant "watching over her" and criticizing her taste in furnishings. "I am kind of concerned because I'm like: 'Michael, do you like this? Is this OK with you?'" she told the **Daily Mail**. Field has hired a Native American shaman to drive out Winner's spirit using burning herbs. "I am going to have it blessed, saged, the whole LA thing," she said.

THE ROYAL FAMILY has had to endure many indignities at the hands of the press – not all of them deliberate. About 20 years ago, **The Times** ran a photograph of the Queen's sister, who had just recovered from a minor illness, with the caption: "Princess Margaret looking much better as she leaves hospital." In the second edition, the story was replaced by one about a naked protester, pictured getting into a taxi with his buttocks and undercarriage visible. Unfortunately, no one changed the caption. When the Times royal correspondent rang Buckingham Palace to grovel, he was told: "You would be in trouble, but Prince Philip found it hilarious."

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Critics pay court to The Crown

Netflix's \$100m Elizabethan gamble is paying off royally, say TV pundits

THE CROWN, Netflix's \$100m gamble on the reign of Queen Elizabeth II, looks to have paid huge dividends since its online debut last week. Not only are their viewing figures reportedly huge, but the show has won over the critics, too.

Hugo Rifkind in *The Times* said he had experienced a heavy sense of foreboding on hearing that the American streaming service was spending "gazillions" on a six-season, 60-part drama about the Queen's reign. But having binge-watched the "barrage of livery and footmen and Land Rovers and banquets" that comprise the first series of *The Crown*, I'm now a fan. Screenwriter Peter Morgan and director

Stephen Daldry have set out to make the "benchmark televisual portrait" of Elizabethan Britain. And they've succeeded.

Starting, Godfather-style, with a wedding - that of the young Elizabeth (Claire Foy) to Philip Mountbatten (Matt Smith) - the series luxuriates in its reported £100m budget, said Gabriel Tate in *The Daily Telegraph*. The sumptuous production values are matched by the talents of the cast, said Martin Hoyle in the *FT*. Foy and Smith are both convincing in their roles, but what stands out is American actor John Lithgow's recreation of an ailing, petulant Winston Churchill. "If Winston wasn't like this, you feel, he should have been."

That is precisely the problem with this portrait

of the Windsors, said David Stephenson in the *Sunday Express*. Too often one finds oneself suspecting that it just wasn't like this in reality. But does it matter, asked Tate. The key requirement is that it should hold together as drama as well as spectacle, and Morgan, who scripted the movie *The Queen*, ensures it does: the scene where a dying George VI (a "towering performance" from Jared Harris) joins carol singers in a rendition of *In the Bleak Midwinter* is especially stirring. It may not have happened, but it works. The makers of *The Crown* were right to refuse offers of assistance from the Palace, said Lucy Mangan in *The Guardian*. It has left them free to make "a rich, non-reverent drama". This is Netflix's "crowning achievement so far".

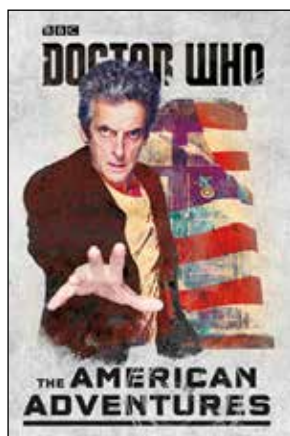

Dr. Who in America: strong medicine?

"*Doctor Who: The American Adventures* wasn't actually my idea at all," says author Justin Richards.

"It was something the publishers asked me if I'd be interested in doing, which I was. I've done a lot of Doctor Who related writing, of course. I've also written quite a few children's novels, as well as a couple of science fiction novels...*The Suicide Exhibition* and *The Blood Reed City*, both set during the Second World War and involving aliens."

A great holiday gift for kids, *Doctor Who: The American Adventures* is a collection of short stories aimed at middle school

kids. With six stories that feature the Doctor's adventures in America, it introduces a child to Doctor Who and relates real world history.

An image of current Doctor Peter Capaldi graces the cover. The way the Doctor is written a child can imagine how he looks with no preconceived notion. If you do know the many incarnations of the doctor you can pick the one that you like best. However, all the quirks of the Doctor that adults love are not in the book. The missing details that could have been in the stories might

be disturbing for some children.

For parents this lighter treatment may have been a better choice over a darker interpretation. Although...*Grimm's Fairy Tales* is very dark. *The American Adventures* gives no explanation of why the villains became bad, and in that sense won't teach tolerance. The conflict resolution comes quickly and without the messiness of the real world conflicts. Could Doctor Who have rehabilitated a few bad guys?

The six stories are set in different times and locations. The writing is simple and could work as a comic book, which this is not. It might have been interesting to have each story be a little bit longer so there is more character and location development.

"The novels and short stories are very separate from the TV series," says Richards.

"Each story is very different. I really just

took aspects of American history and tried to think of stories that would slot into those events and times. I did quite a bit of reading up on the parts of American history that the stories touch on, which was interesting and fun. I relied on books and the internet."

Richards has a different editor for each book he writes. The editorial team at BBC Children's books, part of Penguin Random House, handled this one.

"They know me as I've written a lot of *Doctor Who* books already," says Richards. "The process is fairly straightforward: They brief me on what they want, and I produce an outline. Once they're happy with that, the BBC gets to approve it and maybe make comments, then I write the book. That then goes through another edit, and again is approved by the BBC."

Richards has won a couple regional book awards in the UK and been shortlisted for

several more.

The American Stories is a collection of six stories. *All That Glitters* is set in 1849 California and centers on panning for gold and an unusual item found in the pan. *Off the Trail*, set in 1846 on the Oregon Trail, is about a family moving west who suddenly realize that they are not where they thought they were supposed to be. *Ghosts of New York*, set in 1902 New York City, has builders of the subway system seeing ghosts of family, friends and co-workers.

Taking the Plunge, set in 2017 Florida, features Doctor Who noticing something odd about the people coming off amusement rides. *Spectator Sport*, set in 1815 New Orleans, presents the ultimate tourist destination for aliens from other planets watching the Battle of New Orleans happen live. *Base of Operations*, set in 1944, has the bodies of U.S. servicemen in

training being taken over by an alien race.

Richards is currently writing and editing more *Doctor Who* books for next year.

Richards lives and works in Warwick, in the Midlands in the UK, near Birmingham. He was born in Epping in Essex.

Auld Enemies meet again

England and Scotland meet for the 113th time at Wembley on Friday night as a rivalry which "is known throughout the world" returns.

The oldest fixture in international football, which took place after press time, is the first competitive meeting of the sides since 1999.

With only one team guaranteed a place at Russia 2018, England top Group F after three games with Scotland fourth.

Wayne Rooney returns to captain England with Scotland captain Darren Fletcher saying a draw would be a good result.

The sides - who first met in 1872 - played friendlies in 2013 and 2014 but last played competitive matches in a two-legged play-off for Euro 2000 in November 1999.

Scotland won at Wembley but England won 2-1 on aggregate.

England Under-21 boss Gareth Southgate was put in charge of the senior team for four games following the departure of Sam Allardyce after only one match.

Allardyce left following a newspaper investigation claiming he offered advice on how to "get around" rules on player transfers.

Under Southgate, England beat Malta 2-0 and drew with Slovenia in World Cup qualifiers.

After the match against Scotland, England meet Spain in a friendly at Wembley on 15 November.

Asked if he wanted the job on a permanent basis, he said: "I'm really enjoying being in the role."

"What happens to me is not important. We

have to win this game for the country, and because we want to be top of the group and heading to [the 2018 World Cup] in Russia.

"What happens to me is important to my family, but other than that it isn't the purpose of the game. I want the players to enjoy the football and play well.

"My focus is 100% on the match and it would be irresponsible and unprofessional for it to be any other way."

Scotland manager Gordon Strachan - who has faced scrutiny coming into the game - says he does not need to impress on his players the importance of the match.

"My players are intelligent enough to understand the fixture," Strachan said. "I don't think I have to show them anything."

"They know the fixture, everybody knows the fixture. It's known throughout the world. So I don't have to show them the importance."

"The importance is not to become caught up in

the emotion of the game. It's important to use your emotion and passion, to run further than you've ever run before, to jump higher than you've ever jumped, to concentrate more.

"I don't think you get too emotional. If you get too emotional then you can lose focus. So we're looking for that emotion and passion to play better than we've ever played before."

Klopp plays down title talk

Liverpool manager Jurgen Klopp has played down talk of a title challenge despite his side topping the Premier League for the first time since May 2014.

Two and a half years after the Reds finished two points behind champions Manchester City, a 6-1 win over Watford moved them one point clear of Chelsea.

City and Arsenal - third and fourth respectively - are one further back.

"We've started collecting points but we need to go on with this. Then we will see where we can end," Klopp said.

Liverpool, who last won the title in 1990, led the table going into the final weeks of the 2013-14 season but a home defeat by Chelsea - a game that featured a now infamous slip from Steven Gerrard - and a draw at Crystal Palace in their final three matches

proved costly.

"I know in the past a lot of things happened here and the story two, three years ago when it was really close, but this is not the team two or three years ago," said Klopp.

"This is not the team 25 years ago. We're completely new. We stay cool. It's the best position I can imagine but nothing else has happened."

Sadio Mane scored twice in the victory over Watford, with Philippe Coutinho, Emre Can, Roberto Firmino and Georginio Wijnaldum also on target.

Chelsea had gone top on Saturday with a 5-0 win over Everton, after City followed up their Champions League victory over Barcelona with a 1-1 draw at home to Middlesbrough.

Arsenal would have gone top with victory over Spurs in Sunday's early game but were held to a 1-1 draw at home.

"There's no pressure after 11 match days, absolutely no pressure," added Klopp.

"We saw Chelsea, quite impressive. Man City playing Barcelona, quite impressive. Man United - never write them off. Tottenham are a good side. There's a lot of really good teams around."

Klopp acknowledged his side looked "pretty good".

But he added: "We didn't speak one word about the possibility of being top of the table. For me it's more important that we look like a team who is able to win games. "When I came here I asked for time and patience and belief, and after 11 matches everyone's asking for guarantees and they are not there."

Watford manager Walter Mazzarri said Liverpool were "the best team we have faced so far".
