£50bn to leave?

■ Brussels plays hardball, demanding UK payments to continue for four more years

Britain will be presented with a £50 billion "exit bill" by the European Union as soon as Theresa May triggers Article 50, the chief negotiator for Brussels is warning.

Michel Barnier has told colleagues that the UK must keep paying "tens of billions" annually into the EU budget until 2020.

The bill would include the UK's share of outstanding pensions liabilities, loan guarantees and spending on UK-based projects.

The demands, which came as the Prime Minister held meetings with other European leaders before being excluded from a dinner at an EU summit, were dismissed by senior Conservatives who refuted the idea of paying such a bill.

Others shrugged off the demands and claimed they were simply the EU's opening position in an attempted negotiation.

'dreadful joke'

Iain Duncan Smith, the former work and pensions secretary and Leave campaigner, said that the figure is a "dreadful joke" and that the true amount will be "peanuts".

It came as Britain's EU ambassador was accused of being a "gloomy pessimist" after telling the Prime Minister that Brexit will take a decade.

Conservatives raised

questions about the position of Sir Ivan Rogers – who helped negotiate David Cameron's EU deal ahead of the referendum – and said he was "completely out of his comfort zone" after he warned that a trade deal may not be completed until the mid-2020s, despite those claims later being contradicted by the European Commission.

It was reported on Thursday that Mr Barnier, who has previously suggested that the Brexit negotiations should be conducted in French, has told a number of EU leaders about his plans for a £50 billion bill for Britain.

Tomas Prouza, Czech Republic's Europe minister, told Sky News: "I understand why the Eurosceptics call it an exit fee. But this is agreeing the bills that the UK has already agreed to pay."

"We're talking about payments to the existing budget that the UK already voted for, pensions of British citizens working at the EU. This is only things the UK has already committed itself to paying".

When asked whether British taxpayers should

expect a bill worth tens of billions of pounds, Mr Prouza said: "Definitely. This is what the UK has already committed to pay, and we would expect that the UK would honour its commitments ... it will be one of the first issues coming up on the table."

'total rubbish'

Mr Duncan Smith said: "It's playing to the gallery to try and persuade Britain to beg for mercy. We will not. This is based on their fevered imagination, not reality. The remainers will use this to try to stop Brexit, it's project fear all over again. It is utter, total rubbish from Mr Barnier. You expect more. He will keep trying to get his mouth into the media. There are real questions about what we owe, it's probably peanuts. He is deploying the tactics of project fear. People won't believe it."

Dominic Raab, a former justice minister, commented: "Good luck with that. I'm not sure Monsieur Barnier has quite mastered the art of expectation management, but it's good to know he's got a sense of humour."

Steve Baker, the Conservative MP

for Wycombe, said: "You would expect a negotiator to make a high demand, if he had come in with a low demand I think we would all have been very surprised. Our membership of

the EU has resulted in us accruing liabilities, for example pension rights for staff who have worked for the EU, so there will be some discussion about this but I would obviously like

that bill to be as close to zero as possible."

Arriving in Brussels, Mrs May said: "We will be leaving the EU, and we want that to be as smooth and an orderly process as possible. It's not just in our interests, it's in the interest of the rest of Europe as well."

Mr Barnier has been criticised in recent weeks after appearing to dismiss David Davis, the Brexit secretary, in a series of tweets after their first meeting in Brussels. He described the meeting as a "courtesy visit" and said he told Mr Davis there will be "no negotiation" before Mrs May triggers Article 50.

Jim Prior, former Conservative cabinet minister, dies aged 89

■ Leading 'Tory Wet' was made Northern Ireland secretary under Margaret Thatcher, Lord Prior took up the post at one of the most volatile periods in the region

The Conservative former cabinet minister Jim Prior has died aged 89, according to the official website for parliament.

Lord Prior served for five years in Margaret Thatcher's cabinet. Originally appointed employment secretary when she became prime minister in 1979, he was moved to the post of Northern Ireland secretary two years later.

The move was widely regarded as a sign of her frustration at his refusal to press ahead more quickly with her trade union reforms. Thatcher was deeply suspicious of his "wet" tendencies and opposition to her monetarist economic policies.

Prior was sent to Belfast just a month after the 1981 republican hunger strike in Maze prison and spent the next three years in the region. His tenure as secretary of state came at one of the most turbulent and violent periods in the Troubles.

During his time in the post there were a number of high-profile Provisional IRA attacks in Northern Ireland and England, including the 1982 Hyde Park bombings in London and the attack

outside Harrods in the Knightsbridge area of the city in 1983. Also in 1982, the Irish National Liberation Army murdered 17 people in a bomb attack on the Droppin' Well bar and disco in Ballykelly, County Derry.

In 1982, Prior had tried in vain to hand back some power to politicians in Northern Ireland with his plan for "rolling devolution" at Stormont. But the plan failed because the main nationalist party at the time, the Social Democratic and Labour party, boycotted the assembly.

strict security

The SDLP's line was in large part in response to the rise of modern Sinn Féin, which was rising on the tide of nationalist anger over the deaths of 10 hunger strikers at Maze prison. The party also opposed Prior's plan because the political agreement contained no input from the Irish government and did not result in a power-sharing settlement like the failed 1974 Sunningdale agreement.

His failure to restore devolved power was compounded by the trials of a strict security regime he lived under

as Northern Ireland secretary. For three months in the early days of office, Prior was not allowed to sleep over in the region because, in his own words: "They [republicans] were trying to blow me up."

Top Scots sleep out for homeless charity

Sir Chris Hoy and hundreds of other prominent Scots slept out in Edinburgh Thursday night to help a homeless charity.

The group spent the night in the city's Charlotte Square in aid of the Social Bite Village project.

The scheme aims to raise £500,000 to build 10 small homes in Granton that would offer a safe environment for 20 people for a 12-month period.

First Minister Nicola Sturgeon was scheduled to help serve breakfast to the group on Friday morning.

The group taking part in the sleep out included business leader Sir Andrew Cubie and

hairdresser Jennifer Cheyne.

They bedded down in Charlotte Square at 19:00 on Thursday and were scheduled to stay on site until 7am Friday.

Speaking before she was due to help serve breakfast to those taking part, Ms Sturgeon said: "Tackling homelessness is a priority for the Scottish government and we collaborate closely with local government and a range of national and local partners to work towards ensuring everyone has access to a warm and safe place to stay."

"Social Bite has done incredible work to help homeless people in Scotland by giving them the opportunity to

work in their cafes and restaurants.

"The money raised from this event will go towards their groundbreaking new homeless village which will help break the cycle of homelessness."

Social Bite started as a sandwich shop on Rose Street in Edinburgh in August 2012 and has now grown to five shops in Scotland.

It also runs two large staff canteens in the city, a central production kitchen in Livingston and one of the country's leading independent corporate catering businesses.

The company employs more than 100 people, with a quarter of these drawn from "homeless and excluded

backgrounds".

Social Bite has attracted support from Hollywood stars George Clooney and Leonardo Di Caprio, who have visited its projects in Edinburgh.

Social Bite co-founder Josh Littlejohn said: "There's a beautiful symmetry that the country's most wealthy and influential people are braving the freezing cold for one night to help fund a long-term solution to homelessness."

"The Social Bite Village will tackle the problem of homelessness full circle by putting roofs over people's heads, a supportive environment around them and giving links to employment opportunities."

think [Mr Barnier] has been aloof, petulant in his treatment of David Davis in his recent tweets and I think he

has been indifferent to the anxiety of citizens of the UK and Europe who are worried about their rights."

Downing Street said the UK would meet its obligations while

it remained a member of the EU – but any financial settlement after that would be a matter for negotiation.

"Decisions on how UK taxpayers' money is spent will be decisions

for the UK to take moving forward," a No10 source said.

"There's a whole range of complex issues that will need to be resolved in the negotiations."

'Digital desert' Britain lags Albania in 4G coverage

■ Britain languishes in 54th place in global rankings new report finds

Britain has worse mobile internet coverage than Romania, Albania and Peru and suffers from vast "digital deserts", a report has found.

A new investigation by the Government's National Infrastructure Commission has found that 80 per cent of rural premises are in a "not-spot" for 4G coverage.

The Commission found that the UK is in 54th position in global rankings for 4G, with typical users able to access the service only 53 per cent of the time.

It warned that Britain is "languishing in the digital slow lane" and that even major city centres are lacking coverage.

The NIC, which is chaired by former Labour Cabinet member Lord Adonis, called on the Government to step in to ensure that basic talk, text and data services are available to all Britons, wherever they live, work and travel, and to make the country ready for next-generation 5G communications.

Countries like the USA and Japan already have data volumes four to five times higher than the UK, the report found.

The Commission called for the creation of a strong "digital champion" in Government, backed by a dedicated Cabinet minister, to drive forward change.

The Government and regulator Ofcom should develop a Universal Service Obligation requiring providers to ensure consumers can access essential services when they need them, regardless of the network they subscribe to.

Some 20 per cent of urban homes and 80 per cent of rural premises are currently in not-spot areas for 4G coverage and only 8 per cent of A and B roads have full 4G connectivity, the report

found.

Even on the motorways, users fail to get either 3G or 4G almost 25 per cent of the time.

Railways are also poorly served by 4G, the report found as it called on the Government to commit to mobile broadband infrastructure on key routes by 2025.

The warnings in the report come after The Daily Telegraph's Better Broadband campaign to improve connectivity for homes in rural areas.

Lord Adonis said: "5G is the future - ultra-fast, and ultra-reliable it has the potential to change our lives and our economy in ways we cannot even imagine today. But the UK is currently languishing in the digital slow lane.

"Britain is 54th in the world for 4G coverage, and the typical user can only access 4G barely half the time. Our 4G network is worse than Romania and Albania, Panama and Peru.

"Our roads and railways can feel like digital deserts and even our city centres are plagued by not-spots where connectivity is impossible. That isn't just frustrating, it is increasingly holding British business back as more and more of our economy requires a connected workforce."

Lord Adonis added: "5G offers us a chance to start again and get ahead. If government acts now, we can ensure our major transport networks and urban centres are 5G ready in time to give British industry every chance to lead the world in exploiting its applications.

"But none of this will matter unless we bring our mobile network up to speed. The existing system does not provide the level of coverage we will need in our connected future."

Not only will he be without Miss Markle, who will have flown back to the US to be with her mother, but he will also lack the company of his brother the Duke of Cambridge, sister-in-law the Duchess of Cambridge and their children Prince George and Princess Charlotte.

For only the second time since they married in 2011, the Duke and Duchess have decided to spend Christmas with the Middleton family at their home in Bucklebury, Berks.

It means the only relatives of Prince Harry's generation will be his cousin Zara Tindall and her husband Mike, who are expected to attend with their daughter Mia.

Prince Harry has been celebrating Christmas early with Miss Markle, 35, who flew from her home in Toronto early on Monday to be with him at Kensington Palace.

Having bought a Christmas tree together earlier in the week, they were spotted on Wednesday night attending a performance of the West End play The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time.

Wearing his and hers beanie hats as they walked hand-in-hand through thousands of Christmas shoppers in

Piccadilly, they appeared entirely relaxed at the idea of being seen in public together.

A royal source claimed that the couple's stroll through theatreland was unplanned, and that they decided to walk to the Gielgud Theatre, accompanied by a bodyguard, because their car got stuck in traffic.

The Prince, 32, had bought last-minute tickets for the National Theatre production, having taken his girlfriend to see The Lion King on her last visit to London.

But while the intensity of their six-month relationship has prompted speculation of a possible engagement, the Prince has yet to introduce Miss Markle to his father the Prince of Wales, suggesting he is

Briton arrested for Trump shooting bid gets a year in jail

■ Judge tells 20-year-old Michael Sandford: "You have a medical problem. You should not be ashamed or embarrassed about it. You need medication."

A British man has been jailed for 12 months after pleading guilty to charges relating to an incident in which he tried to grab a policeman's gun to shoot Donald Trump at a rally.

Michael Sandford, 20, attempted to snatch the weapon as Mr Trump addressed crowds in a casino during his campaign in June.

Sandford, who has autism, allegedly told police officers that he had driven from California to Las Vegas with the plan to shoot the Republican presidential candidate.

He did not succeed in

getting hold of the gun and no shots were fired.

Sandford was sentenced at a federal court in Las Vegas, having pleaded guilty in September to charges of possession of a firearm and disrupting an official function.

'crazy stunt'

Lawyers acting for Sandford said he suffers a number of mental health problems and he was diagnosed as having had a psychotic episode at the time of the incident on June 18.

Sentencing Sandford to 12 months and a day

in prison, Judge James Mahan told him: "You have a medical problem. You should not be ashamed or embarrassed about it. You need medication."

"You're not a hardened criminal. You're not evil or a sociopath like a lot of people we have."

"I don't think you wanted to kill anybody. This was just some crazy stunt that your mind told you to do."

Sandford, of Dorking, Surrey, had faced up to 20 years in jail had he been found guilty of the offences at a trial. He had initially denied the

charges but pleaded guilty in September following a plea agreement.

Before sentencing, Sandford waved to his

mother Lynne, father Paul Davey, grandmother Christine and four-year-old sister Jessica, who were in court.

Ms Sandford has called for her son to be allowed to serve his sentence in the UK so he can receive psychiatric help.

Veteran of Bismarck sinking dies at 97

A Scottish veteran pilot who helped to sink the Bismarck during World War Two has died at the age of 97.

Lt Cdr John "Jock" Moffat was credited with launching the torpedo that crippled the German warship in 1941.

The air strike carried

out by the biplanes from HMS Victorious and Ark Royal on 26 May 1941 was said to have been Britain's last hope of stopping the Bismarck.

Mr Moffat described flying through "a lethal storm of shells and bullets".

Born in Kelso in June

1919, he joined the Navy as a reservist in 1938 and was posted to Ark Royal with 759 Naval Air Squadron after qualifying as a pilot.

In total, he served with four squadrons in a fleet air arm career spanning eight years.

After the war he trained

as a hotel manager and remained with the profession for decades.

He took up flying again in his 60s and flew into his early 90s.

In recent years he campaigned for the No side in the Scottish independence referendum, appearing

alongside Scottish Conservative leader Ruth Davidson in 2014 to make the defence case for the Union.

The air strike on the Bismarck was launched as the battleship headed to the relative safety of waters off the coast of France.

Mr Moffat and his crew took off in his Swordfish L9726 from the deck of Ark Royal and headed for the Bismarck, fighting against driving rain, low cloud and a gale.

Naval chiefs said he flew in at 50ft, nearly skimming the surface of the waves, in a hail of bullets and shells, to get the best possible angle of attack on the ship.

At 21:05 he dropped the torpedo which hit its target, jamming

the rudder of Hitler's flagship.

Speaking to BBC Scotland earlier this year, he said: "The Bismarck turned on its side and all these sailors seemed to be in the water - it lived with me for a long time."

The battleship was forced to steam in circles until the guns of the Royal Navy's home fleet arrived the next morning.

"When Churchill gave the order to sink the Bismarck, we knew we just had to stop her trail of devastation at all costs," he said.

"The great thing about the Swordfish was that the bullets just went straight through. After all, it was only made of canvas. It was like David and Goliath."

Fireworks partygoers invited to see new year in with a whimper

■ Could Edinburgh's famed Hogmanay celebrations REALLY feature SILENT fireworks?

As the host of Europe's biggest New Year celebrations and the world's largest arts festival, it is a city that prides itself on knowing how to throw a party.

Edinburgh has always celebrated Hogmanay, its military tattoo and the end of its famous summer festivals by illuminating its skyline with dazzling - and deafening - firework displays.

This reputation may be under threat, however, as councillors in the Scottish capital are considering introducing silent fireworks.

Joanna Mowat, a Conservative councillor, claims that residents have had enough of a year-round barrage of roaring rockets and screaming catherine wheels and want some respite.

"There are fireworks every night at the tattoo during August, there are fireworks at the end of the international festival and more at Hogmanay, Diwali, Guy Fawkes Night and many others," she said. "The fireworks are getting bigger and people tell me they are now feeling them as well as hearing them."

"Pets are being affected, small children are being woken up and there is evidence that people with post-traumatic stress disorder really struggle with the loud bangs. The time has come to look at this, especially as silent fireworks are now available."

Ms Mowat, who represents the city centre, accepts that her stance is likely to provoke controversy. She said: "I expect there will be some kickback and my husband did say, 'Oh, you'll be known as Scrooge'."

"Somebody said to me last night, 'Fireworks

without the bang is like cheese without pickle'. However, I've been surprised by just how supportive people have been. The spectacle is beautiful but it does impact quite significantly on those who can't see it."

She also wants the council, which is run by a coalition of the Scottish National Party and Labour, to examine whether vibrations from displays are damaging buildings. She was inspired by the Italian city of Collecchio, which has a law ensuring that fireworks must make no noise.

However, the organisers of Hogmanay celebrations said the city would lose out with silent displays. Penny Dougherty, director of Unique Events, said: "The fireworks are the signature element of an event that brings in 150,000 visitors from around the world and generates an economic impact of more than £42 million."

Paul Gudgin, a former director of the Edinburgh Fringe, added: "It would be a great shame and the event that would suffer the most would be the Edinburgh Royal Military Tattoo."

Alex Cole-Hamilton, who represents Edinburgh Western in the Scottish parliament, hoped a compromise could be reached. "Fireworks are a sensory experience and that includes the sounds that they make," he said. "If we have the technology to make silent fireworks I'm sure we could make quieter fireworks."

Epic Fireworks, the biggest online supplier, said quiet events were becoming popular. A spokesman said: "Loud bangs are not everybody's cup of tea."

Hoddle, whose last job in football was as a coach at QPR, split from Vanessa, 58, last year after 15 married years.

She has since found out about his new lover, the Sun reported.

A source told the newspaper: 'Glenn and Vanessa had had a very long, happy marriage but started having problems about a couple of years ago.'

'They decided to call it a day and ended things on fairly amicable terms. But his new romance blossomed very quickly and they moved in together.'

Her website also advertises 'journey beyond the senses' and 'journey to tranquility' massages, and reflexology and Hopi candling.

The Man With Two Brains...and how it applies to all of us

■ The degree of connection between the conscious and unconscious mind can have huge implications for how we reach our goals

This week's title will doubtless remind some of you of the great Steve Martin movie from the 1980s.

But the following column is actually about the conscious and unconscious mind and their effect on our physical and mental health.

At my regular day job in Ibiza at The Body Camp (thebodycamp.com) our guests spend the first few days unwinding from all the stresses of their lives, soaking up the Spanish sunshine (in moderation), eating live, healthy organic foods in an incredible setting and enjoying some fun exercise. We also spend a few hours daily talking and discussing the interesting subject of the conscious and unconscious mind....the two brains.

What is the conscious mind?

Believe it or not, the conscious mind only accounts for 5-10% of your daily thought process. The conscious mind is what we choose to focus on, in the moment (around 3-7 things for most people) such as thinking about someone or looking at something. It's where our focus goes - when WE CHOOSE to use it.

But of course this begs the question... what about the other 90% of our thoughts. Just for a moment think of the iceberg that sunk the Titanic. As anyone can tell you, what really did the damage was the 7/8th of the iceberg which lay under the surface.... and so it is with us. 90% of our hidden, learned daily habits and behaviors come from

the unconscious mind, which is not always a good thing.

To be fair, the unconscious is responsible for vital behaviours like driving our hearts to beat 100,000 times a day, and ensuring we breathe over 20,000 times a day - and that's just for starters! But the unconscious mind also consists of all our learned habits and behaviors from education, family, environment, learned experiences, trauma, etc.... and so it is very, very powerful.

Research suggests we have over 70,000 thoughts a day in this area of our minds.... which is why the conscious mind can only focus on 3-7 things at once. The unconscious mind is an incredibly powerful part of our minds and is heavily involved in daily habits (which you sometimes don't even think about) - such as

brushing your teeth, driving and texting (some people!) dressing in a hurry perhaps, eating and drinking. If you can communicate to this part of the brain, you have a high chance of success in life. The most successful people in life are able to say something, act on it and just do it, but for many of us all the good intentions in the world are no match for the so-called 'critical facility'.

Critical facility?

If you believe you have no will power and you can't stop smoking, eating chocolate, drinking etc...it could be because you have a critical facility. It's a gap between our conscious and unconscious mind. When the two are linked, they talk easily and communicate to each other. There is a direct and unencumbered link between desire and action. Therefore simple

orders like "I am going to stop smoking" or "I am going to stop eating too much chocolate" (or any highly addictive substances) are followed, allowing both minds to work in harmony and make this a certainty. But people with a large critical facility - too many of us, sadly don't process much (in terms of will power) and find

it difficult to control the urge or impulses they sometimes feel in daily life.

The good news is that all behaviours are learned and reinforced over time, and bad behaviours can be unlearned the same way. The key is to improve your habits on a daily basis and clarify the communication

between the two minds. We recommend practising mindfulness training, meditation, yoga, tai-chi, mindful eating and mindful walking. And of course, a weeklong retreat to the Body Camp wouldn't hurt either!

Shunned No More: Regency redemption

"At the time I was processing the sudden, and very unexpected death of my father, how I was not always there when he needed me," says *Shunned No More* author Christina McKnight.

"That loss inspired me to write a story in which it wasn't too late to for my hero and heroine. With this tale, I wanted to impress upon my readers that forgiveness, compassion, and understanding are within all of us if we only look deep enough."

Shunned No More is an historical romance set in the Regency Period dealing with themes of vengeance and ultimately of redemption for past misdeeds to mend a

fractured family. As the book opens we learn that eight years previously Lady Viola Oberbrook was young, beautiful and spoiled. Forced to flee London after causing two brothers to die in a duel over her, she's been living at her father's country estate.

Brock Spencer, Earl of Haversham, has left military service and returned to England and since he inherited the title he is expected to repair the family estates and find a bride. His real intention is to find the woman considered responsible for the death of his twin

brothers. However, Lady Viola regrets the past and hopes for another chance. The two form a bond through their love of horses.

"The plotline for *Shunned No More* started off as a simple idea," says McKnight. "What if a woman of the ton (the term of the time for Britain's high society) did something that society could not forgive? In this case, Lady Viola was responsible for inciting a duel between two brothers. In the end, both died. She was shunned by society and banished to the country. Over the next seven years, Viola realizes if she is to have a future she has to forgive herself and make amends with those she's hurt, to have any chance at happiness and a family of her own."

A theme in McKnight's stories is the connection between the hero or heroine and their mother and father. "It took a long-time reader to point this out to me," says McKnight. "These relationships are usually

complex, convoluted, and filled with betrayal and ultimate sorrow. Maybe I've been trying to improve, or at the very least, explore, the relationship I had with my own father."

McKnight became a fan of historical fiction from reading her great-grandmother's collection of 70s and 80s Regency novels. "Since high school I've had a fascination with the time period; including decorum, fashion, society functions, and sports," says McKnight. "With this project, I had the need to research the legality of duels. In this case, if a man dies during a duel it is classified as murder under English law, though the country was lax in prosecuting. And, since both men die in my story, it is only society who can punish my heroine."

We typically review the latest book in a series, however readers may prefer to start with *Shunned No More*, *A Lady Forsaken*, *Book One*, before reading the

four following books in the series: *Forgotten No More*, *Scorned Ever More*, *Christmas Ever More*, and *Hidden No More*. *Shunned No More* is has recently released in audio, and translations into German, Italian, and Spanish are in the pipeline.

Jen Blood at Adian Editing was McKnight's editor on *Shunned No More*, and switched to Chelle Olson of Literally Addicted to Detail after Jen Blood became too busy with her own writing. "In mid-2016, I also added a strictly historical editor to my team, Scott Moreland," says McKnight.

"Together, we have completed six books in under eight months. Each of my books goes through a grueling six-step editing process...from beta reads, revisions, three passes by editors, a proofreader, and finally, a last read through by my closest circle of readers."

McKnight is currently writing the Regency romance trilogy; *The Undaunted Debutantes* series, with *The*

Disappearance of Lady Edith, *The Misfortunate of Lady Lucianna*, and *The Misadventures of Lady Ophelia*. She's also started two *Shunned No More* spin-off series: the *Craven House* series and the *Lady Archer's Creed* series.

McKnight lives in central California, near where she was born, "Equal distance from the beach and the mountains."

Manchester City director of football Txiki Begiristain said Monaco should not be underestimated.

He added: "Monaco are playing probably the best football in France now.

"In the group of Tottenham and Bayer Leverkusen, they were top. They have young players and a lot of talent. They play good football. It is a good draw."

Manager Claudio Ranieri said his Leicester side were set for a tough challenge against a "big, big, big team".

"I know that Sevilla have lifted the Europa League three times in three years - it is unbelievable," said the Italian, who led the Foxes to their first Premier League title last season.

"Now they are third in the league and have lost only three so far. They are fighting to win the title with Real Madrid and Barcelona in Spain, so that

tells you how good they are."

Gianfranco Zola has been installed as the new Birmingham boss and says he must be "professional" about replacing Gary Rowett as manager.

Blues fans were shocked by the Chinese-owned club's decision to replace the immensely popular Rowett with the club eighth in the Championship table.

"The difficulty was that my predecessor was doing very well," Zola

told the BBC.

"Sometimes that makes it not easy for a new manager, but I'm professional, it was a good opportunity and I could not refuse it," added the Italian, 50.

Spurs get back on track

Christian Eriksen scored twice as Tottenham proved far too strong for spirited Hull City at White Hart Lane Wednesday night.

The Denmark international struck in either half as Spurs consolidated their grip on fifth place in the Premier League with a 3-0 win - their eighth victory of the season.

Danny Rose laid Eriksen's first on a plate inside 15 minutes after good work down the left, and Kyle Walker did likewise from the right to snuff out any hope of a Hull comeback after the break.

Eriksen was desperately unlucky not to claim the match ball after seeing a superb free-kick tipped on to the post by Hull goalkeeper David Marshall, allowing Victor Wanyama to mop up the rebound from a couple of yards out.

Hull can have no complaints about the defeat but the one-sided final score was a tad unfair on the Tigers after they matched their hosts for long spells.

However, 35 goals conceded in 16 games is a damning statistic for the side second-bottom of the league - as is the fact they have now lost six away games in succession, equalling their top-flight record.

Spurs dominated possession and chances - having 27 shots in all - but clear-cut openings were at a premium. Wing-backs Rose and Walker were a constant menace, however, and it was through them that Spurs had the most joy.

Despite the gulf between the sides in terms of league position and resources, Hull produced a display that was, for a time, on a par with their hosts.

Spurs boss Mauricio Pochettino: "I think it was a game we dominated. I think the most important is the three points, to be close to the top four."

Feeling the heat, Guardiola pleads for time

Manchester City manager Pep Guardiola says he does not know if he will be given the time he needs to build a successful team at Etihad Stadium.

Defeat by Leicester on Saturday was City's second in a row in the league - the first time they have lost back-to-back league games under Guardiola.

Although they righted the ship with a comfortable 2-0 midweek win against Watford, the club remains seven points behind league leaders Chelsea and have won just five of their past 16 games in all competitions.

"enough energy"

Asked if he would be given time to get things right, Guardiola said: "I don't know. I don't think about that. Anything can happen. Our position depends on the results."

But Guardiola, who succeeded Manuel Pellegrini in the summer, added: "I'm not leaving. Next season will be

better. Two years will be better."

Asked whether he was failing, Guardiola said: "Give me time. If you analyse the last month, I have failed."

The 45-year-old former Barcelona and Bayern Munich coach said this was the first time in his managerial career he had experienced such a challenging period.

He admitted he was prone to self-doubt when his team lose, but insisted he had "enough energy" to fight his critics.

"If it doesn't go well, I say 'sorry guys, I was not able' and another guy is coming here," he said. "I have been here six months though so I still have time."

Guardiola said former Manchester United manager Sir Alex Ferguson was an example of why the Premier League club needed to be patient.

Ferguson, who became United boss in November 1986, won 13 Premier League titles

"The last month I have to accept the results have not gone well. But we

have to improve what I believe, not change what I believe. When it doesn't work, you have to be strong.

"I have to accept

Koeman mocks Wenger's ref complaints

Everton manager Ronald Koeman has mocked Arsene Wenger for questioning referee Mark Clattenburg's decision-making after the Toffees beat Arsenal 2-1 Tuesday night.

Gunners boss Wenger felt a corner was incorrectly awarded in the lead-up to Ashley Williams' winner.

Koeman said: "I'm not surprised because it's the third [home game] in a row I won against Arsenal and three times in a row it was about the referee."

"I'm sorry Arsenal, we won through the referee," added the Dutchman.

Koeman's past two wins against Arsenal came while he was in

charge of Southampton - a 4-0 victory in December 2015 and a 2-0 success 11 months earlier.

Wenger felt that a free-kick was headed behind by Everton's Dominic Calvert-Lewin in the 84th minute rather than his marker Laurent Koscielny.

After Petr Cech then pushed behind Phil Jagielka's strike, Williams headed home from the resulting corner.

"It was not a corner," said Wenger. "It was a wrong decision. I am really disappointed because Clattenburg was in a very good position to see that they headed the ball out."

"It is not the first time we were unlucky with his decisions this season

but overall I don't want to talk about the referee.

"We have to look at ourselves, we lost the game. We started well and then maybe lost a bit of urgency."

Arsenal lie third in the Premier League, six

points behind Chelsea, while victory for Everton ended a run of five games without a win and moved the Toffees up to seventh, four points behind fifth-placed Tottenham.

Koeman, whose side

entertain Liverpool in the Merseyside derby on Monday, added: "We know if we fight for every ball and we're aggressive then you see the reaction of the crowd and it's very difficult to win at Everton away."

Chelsea moved six points clear at the top of the Premier League as Cesc Fabregas' first-half goal beat a stubborn Sunderland at the Stadium of Light in midweek.

Fabregas steered into the far corner from the edge of the box as the Blues recorded a 10th consecutive league victory.

Sunderland keeper Jordan Pickford saved from former Black Cat Marcos Alonso and Willian to prevent Chelsea from winning by a bigger margin.

The hosts, who had set up to try to nullify their opponent's attacking strength, had few chances although they could have snatched a point in injury time but Thibaut Courtois superbly denied Patrick van Aanholt.

It was a hard-fought and important win for Chelsea after Arsenal slipped up against Everton on Tuesday and means Antonio Conte's side will be top of the table at Christmas.

they struggled to find a way to break down a packed Sunderland defence, but Fabregas highlighted the Blues' strength in depth.

As Sunderland's seven-man defence frustrated the visitors, Fabregas somehow managed to find the gap to sneak a shot into the far corner and ultimately give Chelsea victory.

Chelsea have kept a clean sheet in five of their previous seven games but their inability to put the game out of Sunderland's reach was a cause for concern for Conte.

For the third time in four games, they won by a single goal margin and Conte is now keen to see

his side improve their finishing.

"When you have the possibility to kill the game you must kill the game," he said. "We had this possibility but we didn't and at the end Courtois made a good save. I hope in the future we can improve."

Also at Stamford Bridge, Brazilian midfielder Oscar says he is "90% certain" to move to Chinese Super League club Shanghai SIPG in January.

The fee for the 25-year-old Brazilian midfielder would be around £60m. He joined the Blues from Internacional for £25m in 2012.

Oscar started the first five league games under Antonio Conte but has only played four times since September.

"It just depends on a few bureaucratic details," Oscar told Sportv in his homeland.

Oscar, I think it will be clearer in the next days," said Conte, who did not name the Brazilian in his 18-man squad for Wednesday's match.

"Oscar started the season very well with us when we played with a

4-3-3.

"Then when I switched to another system, another formation, he didn't play a lot. But I always counted on him because Oscar is a really good player.

"He's young, but

sometimes there are situations that are very difficult to face."

The mooted move would reunite Oscar with former Chelsea manager Andre Villas-Boas, who is now in charge at Shanghai.

Mourinho 'needs two more windows'

Manager Jose Mourinho will need at least two more transfer windows to get close to the squad he wants, say senior Manchester United figures.

Seven months after Mourinho's arrival as successor to Louis van Gaal, United are sixth in the Premier League, 13 points behind leaders Chelsea and six points adrift of the top four to guarantee Champions League qualification.

Speaking ahead of the

club's 2-1 win at Crystal Palace, Mourinho said he wants to keep his squad together for the rest of the season.

However, sources at the club suggest he would like to make changes to remould the first team in his image.

They broke their club record in January 2014 by signing midfielder Juan Mata from Chelsea for £37.1m, and spent a British record £59.7m on Real Madrid winger Angel di Maria later that year.
