Eaton Square named UK's priciest street

London's Eaton Square has been named the most expensive place to buy property in the UK, with a home costing an average of nearly £17m.

The Belgravia address tops a list that shows every English region now contains "million pound" streets.

Research by Lloyds Bank also shows the most expensive street in Wales is Llandudno's Llys Helyg Drive, with an average property price of £1.064m.

The Scores, St Andrews, tops Scotland's list with an average of almost

£2.2m.

Eaton Square made it to the top of the property stack based on recorded land registry prices.

Built in the 19th Century around a private garden, it features stucco white facades and is handy for Knightsbridge and Chelsea.

modest price rises

Outside of London, addresses in Surrey and Oxshott - the home of Wimbledon champion and Sports Personality of the Year Andy Murray - feature in the top 20 most expensive residential

streets, along with Poole and Oxford.

North of London, England's most expensive address is Park Lane, Altrincham, with an average property price of just over £2m.

Wales has two streets with average property prices in excess of £1m - Llys Helyg Drive in Llandudno, where homes typically fetch £1,064m, and St Anne's Close in Swansea where average properties go for £1,029m.

Scotland figures were produced by the Bank of Scotland. Although the top spot went to a street

leading to the first tee of St Andrew's Old Course, 10 of Scotland's most expensive streets are in Edinburgh.

Forecasters at the Royal

Chartered Institute of Surveyors are predicting a 3% typical price rise for houses in the UK next year, in spite of Brexit uncertainties.

The Nationwide Building Society is more cautious, estimating prices will grow at 2%, fuelled by continuing low interest rates.

Not so bubbly: Champagne-mad Brits face higher prices

Champagne drinkers in Britain - the biggest export market for bubbly - face higher prices next year as the impact of the shock Brexit vote on the British pound takes its toll, champagne industry executives warned.

"The market in Britain is undergoing a period of adjustment. The brands have not yet factored in the effect of foreign exchange rates on their prices," said Charles-Armand de Belenet, marketing director for Pernod Ricard's Martell Mumm Perrier-Jouët champagne brand.

The June vote for Britain to quit the

European Union led sterling to slump to its lowest level since 1985 against the U.S dollar and to fall against the euro, although it has since edged back up from those lows.

The weak pound makes euro-priced products more expensive in sterling terms.

French champagne industry executives told Reuters that while they had managed to offset the Brexit impact to an extent this year, with some firms delaying price rises, they would have to raise prices in Britain in 2017 to protect their profit margins.

Bruno Paillard, who

heads the Lanson champagne house, said that while Lanson's sales were showing signs of an increase from last year, exchange rates remained a worry.

"The question of exchange rates is a cause for concern, it represents quite a considerable loss of money," said Paillard.

Jean-Marie Barillere, president of the Union of Champagne Houses, said champagne firms that billed in euros were seeing their costs go up and their orders go down.

Taittinger head Pierre-Emmanuel Taittinger said his company had had a "good year,

even in England," but Bollinger executive Jerome Philipon warned champagne drinkers of higher prices next year.

"The major brands will have to hike their prices from January onwards. But one price hike still won't compensate for the hits from the exchange rate," he said.

France exported 150.7 million bottles of champagne in 2015, worth 2.64 billion euros (\$2.76 billion), according to an industry group. Britain accounted for nearly 23 percent of France's champagne exports by volume that year, equivalent to 34.2 million bottles.

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Court gives go ahead to environmental activist to sue Trump resort for 'secretly filming her'

A court in Edinburgh has ruled that an environmental activist can sue Donald Trump's golf resort near Aberdeen for breach of privacy and compensation after she was apparently filmed without her consent on the course.

A lawyer acting for Rohan Beyts, a long-time critic of resort's impact on the environment and community, accused Trump's staff of breaching the Data Protection Act by taking mobile-phone footage of her in April as she allegedly urinated behind a dune on the course.

The ruling raises the prospect of Trump facing a battle in the Scottish small claims court a few months into his first term as US president.

The Guardian newspaper revealed in August that Trump International Golf Course Scotland, which is wholly owned by Trump, had breached the UK's strict laws on data protection and privacy

after it failed to register with the Information Commissioner's Office, despite operating an extensive CCTV system and handling data on thousands of golfers, guests, staff and suppliers. The resort insisted this was due to a clerical error.

Beyts's lawyer, Mike Dailly, said the result was 'fantastic'. "Although the defendant sought to have the case dismissed as incompetent, or transferred to the ordinary courts with unlimited expenses, or transferred to Aberdeen, all attempts to stop the case progressing were rejected by the sheriff," he said. "So now there is a case to answer, and witnesses will have to give evidence on behalf of TIGC".

Beyts, 62, said she was delighted with the result and looked forward to making her case.

The case arose from an incident last April when Beyts and a friend used a public footpath across the Trump course

to reach the sand dunes and beach that border the golf links. Returning from their walk, the pair say there were challenged by resort staff and then photographed by a local newspaper photographer.

Three days later Beyts was visited at home by two Police Scotland officers who formally charged her with public annoyance. A third officer in charge of the complaint told her that two members of Trump's staff and a guest on the course had filmed her on their mobile phones as she ducked out of sight.

Her prosecution raised fresh accusations from Trump's critics that his staff were deliberately persecuting opponents and closely monitoring their movements on the resort.

The claim was heard before Sheriff Gordon Liddle on Thursday morning, who swiftly dispatched the arguments made by Paul Motion, the solicitor advocate acting for the

resort.

Dailly argued that the case was a straightforward claim for invasion of privacy, on the basis that the resort had admitted it was not registered with the ICO, and that being filmed without her consent had caused distress to Beyts, for which she was seeking £3,000.

Motion questioned whether a small claims court was competent to deal with such a case.

Liddle concluded, however, that while he was aware that he was "dealing with ifs and buts, not black and white", nothing had persuaded him that the case was incompetent as a small claim.

When Motion argued that the case should be held in Aberdeen,

closer to the golf course and relevant witnesses, Liddle quipped: "Should I transfer it to Manhattan?" before noting that there was no reason why Beyts could

not sue a company in the place where it had a registered office, in this case, Edinburgh.

The next hearing is set to begin on 3 April and last for three days.

THE UK in 2016: what the polls tell us:

A nation of believers?

For a supposedly secular country, an unexpectedly large number of Brits profess a religious allegiance. 46% identify themselves as Christians, and a further 8% as belonging to another religion. Only 41% of the Christians say they definitely believe in a Creator, however. More Britons believe in the existence of aliens (30%) than we do in Hell - 27% (YouGov/Independent). Unbelief is more widespread among younger people. 56% of the under-40s say they have no religion. Even so, 16.5% of those people still believe there is "definitely" or "probably" a higher power (YouGov/Sunday Times).

British conservative?

77% of Britons claim

to occupy the political centre, though 43% place Theresa May there, too: only 28% consider her right-wing (Opinium/Observer). But we remain stubbornly monarchist - 75% feel the monarch has an important role to play in Britain's future, and only 17% want us to become a republic (down from 22% in 2005)(Ipsos Mori/Times). We also tend to have a warm view of our past: 44% think that Britain should be proud of its colonial history, and 43% that the British Empire was a force for good. Only 19% think it was a bad thing. And a fair few of us (47%) favour reintroducing National Service. On the other hand, more of us have a favourable view of socialism (36%) than we do of capitalism (33%): that puts us to the right

of the Germans (45% pro-socialism, 26% pro-capitalism), but well to the left of the Americans (29% versus 52%) (YouGov/Independent).

Are we liberal in our social attitudes?

It varies with age and with the issue. 47% of us support the legalisation of cannabis, with only 39% against; but those most in favour (55%) are the 35 to 44-year-olds; less enthusiastic (51%) are the 18 to 24-year-olds; and even less so (37%) the over-65s (ORB/Independent). Most of us (50%) do not think that torturing enemy combatants in order to extract information is acceptable - though 26% of us do, as do 46% of Americans (ICRC/Guardian). But

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Centenarian jailed for historic sex crimes

■ Ralph Clarke 'used fear and intimidation' to control and abuse his victims, Crown Prosecution Service tells court

A 101-year-old man has been jailed for 13 years for committing 30 child sex offences.

Ralph Clarke, of Erdington, Birmingham, is thought to be the oldest person convicted in British legal history.

Judge Richard Bond QC said Clarke had been guilty of "systematic abuse" between 1974 and 1983.

He was found guilty of 21 counts of abusing two girls and admitted nine charges relating to a boy during his trial at Birmingham Crown Court.

The court heard the retired haulier abused the girls at his home in Holly Lane, Erdington, his garden shed, and in the cab of his truck.

'No remorse'

The former RAF serviceman, who was born in March 1915, was given details of the sentencing by an intermediary.

Judge Bond said the passage of time did not

mean abusers would escape justice.

He told Clarke: "You present as a fragile old man; however, what was plain to see was that, despite your guilty pleas, you have no remorse whatsoever."

The judge added: "Those who were sexually abused even in the distant past can rest assured that any complaint will be treated with sympathy and compassion."

The court heard Clarke is the "oldest person tried in English criminal court".

He had been able to follow proceedings because special arrangements had been made.

Passing sentence, Judge Bond said the effect of a jail term on him would be "enormous" and he would sentence in a "measured and reflective manner" due to his age and infirmity.

However, he said the case was so serious "only a lengthy sentence" was

justified.

Clarke's victims reported the offences to West Midlands Police in August last year after seeing Facebook posts celebrating his 100th birthday.

Clarke admitted two counts of attempting to commit a serious sexual offence, two of indecency with a child and five indecent assaults on a boy.

The Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) said Clarke's age and wellbeing were considered but the serious nature of his offences, breach of trust and vulnerability of his victims meant a "prosecution was in the public interest".

"Ralph Clarke used fear and intimidation to control the victims and sexually abuse them," a spokesman said.

The police and CPS also praised the victims' courage and bravery in bringing Clarke to justice.

The NSPCC said: "Clarke not only inflicted

appalling abuse on his victims, he put them through the harrowing ordeal of a crown court

trial - and did not show a shred of remorse throughout.

"This case sends out

a clear message that it is never too late for survivors of abuse to speak out."

Spirit of the age: life in 2016 Britain....

DUNDEE: A Scottish primary school asked its pupils to sign a contract in order to be allowed to play football at break times. Children at Forthill Primary School in Dundee were required to agree to 17 terms - including no chanting, no gloating, no hogging the ball, no "banter" and no being a "sore loser". Breaking a rule triggers a three-day football suspension; players who break three risk being banned for the rest of the term.

Buckinghamshire:

Teachers at a primary school in Milton Keynes were told not to blow a whistle to mark the end of playtime because it is "too aggressive", and the noise could startle the children. Instead, staff at St Monica's Catholic Primary were asked to raise a hand in the air, and wait for pupils to notice the signal. However, teaching assistant Pamela Cunningham revealed that she still carried a whistle in case of emergencies.

WILTSHIRE: Police in Wiltshire were accused of wasting public money after they sent nine squad cars - sirens blaring - to a cul-de-sac in Salisbury, in response to a 999 call that a "madman" was on the loose with a "bladed weapon". The madman turned out to be a gardener trimming a hedge, but a spokeswoman insisted that the police's response had been correct, because every call should be taken seriously.

SOMERSET: A leading independent school has done away with traditional PE lessons and replaced them with "well-being" classes. Pupils at Wellington School in Somerset can use these sessions to do Pilates, yoga or Zumba, or to practise mindfulness. The headmaster, Henry Price, said that not all children enjoyed team sports, and that they shouldn't be

forced into "an arms race of competitiveness that removes all the fun".

DORSET: "Disorderly" pensioners were reported to be wreaking havoc in the queue for a Dorset bus. A new breed of rude and aggressive OAPs were accused of pushing past other passengers to get on the Purbeck Breezer. One retiree mentioned a "relatively young OAP" who jumped the queue in Bournemouth - but nobody said anything, because he was "bigger than them".

NORTHANTS: A Northampton couple treated their guests to a "freegan" feast - made up entirely of thrown-away food - when they tied the knot in August. For their sustainable wedding, Nicola Hedges and Christopher McKenna hired a catering firm that only uses food discarded by supermarkets.

CAMBRIDGESHIRE: Couples are having less sex because they're hooked on watching box sets, a Cambridge statistician has warned. The average couple now has sex just three times a month, down from five times in 1990 - a decline David Spiegelhalter blames on people bingeing on TV series instead of going to bed. In the past, he says, many couples had sex because there was "nothing else to do".

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Ex-soldier jailed for Rooney raid

■ Wife Coleen tells of 'sleepless nights' after masked burglar struck

A FORMER serviceman has been jailed for two years and eight months for attempting to burgle Wayne Rooney's mansion while the footballer played in a club testimonial match.

Robert McNamara, 25, from Scarborough, North Yorkshire,

admitted attempting to enter as a trespasser at the Manchester United striker's family home in Prestbury, Cheshire, with intent to steal on August 3. In a victim impact statement read at Chester Crown Court, the player's wife Coleen said the incident had

caused sleepless nights and had made her fear for the safety of their three children while playing in the garden.

Jo Maxwell, prosecuting, said McNamara had entered the grounds of the family's home at about 8.30pm and had

activated the perimeter alarm system. CCTV showed him walking around the grounds, with his face covered by a balaclava, and trying a door handle. The court heard police searching the grounds later found a rucksack, containing items including cable ties, a head torch and a balaclava, which had McNamara's DNA on it. When police searched his home, after arresting him six days later, they found a second rucksack containing a ski mask with black tape over it, which the court heard could have been used as a blindfold. Police described seeing a man acting suspiciously when they arrived at the home but said he got into his car and drove away.

'worrying and watching'

In a victim impact statement which was read to the court, Mrs Rooney said: "After it happened it caused sleepless nights, worrying and watching security cameras fearing someone was there. "I feared for my children playing outside in the garden and still do."

She said it caused anxiety when her husband was away and she no longer felt comfortable in the home

unless a friend or family member was with her. She said the couple had spent extra money on security since the incident. Mrs Rooney said she and the family, including the couple's sons Kai, Klay and Kit, had been at the tribute game at Old Trafford for what was meant to be a "night of celebration", but she had returned home to find the house full of police.

She said: "I'm just happy the children were asleep and didn't have to see what was going on."

Taryn Jones Turner, defending, said McNamara had served seven years in the armed forces and had "not

found life on Civvy Street as easy as he expected that it would be". She said since the incident he had been diagnosed with bipolar affective disorder and was receiving medication and was being supported by the Royal British Legion.

Sentencing, Judge Patrick Thompson said: "It's concerning as to what your intent would have been had you gained entrance to the property and come across somebody else. I find it was no coincidence that this was the night of Wayne Rooney's testimonial and you knew he would be away from the house."

Are we happy?

Not especially. 54% of people in England say that they're struggling or falling behind with the mortgage, and 16% of them say that they're losing sleep over it (YouGov for Shelter/Independent). Not that we get a lot of sleep, in any case: 37% of us say we don't get nearly enough, a higher proportion than in any other of 12 nations surveyed (Aviva/Times). British men often feel lonely: 32% have gone to a nightclub on their own (YouGov/Sun). And only 61% of British girls and women aged between seven and 21 are happy with the way they look (Guides Association/Daily Mail).

What do we really like?

Meat. The British are a nation of carnivores. Only 24% would give up eating it if their long-term partner asked them to. By contrast, 45% would stop drinking alcohol for their partner, and 49% would move abroad for them (YouGov). Young British people are also mad about takeaways. On average, 18 to 34-year-olds order ten takeaways a month; and 9% eat a takeaway or at a fast food restaurant at least once every day. The over-55s, by contrast, only have two takeaways a month (Aviva/Daily Mail). Above all, we're obsessed with our phones and the internet. On average, we spend 39% of our waking hours online. 30% of us check for messages on our mobile at least every half an hour; 25% of us suffer separation anxiety if we spend more than an hour away from it (Innocent/Daily Mail). 59% of us (and 79% of our teenagers) admit to being addicted to our online gadgets (Ofcom/Daily Telegraph).

Lastly, how can we find

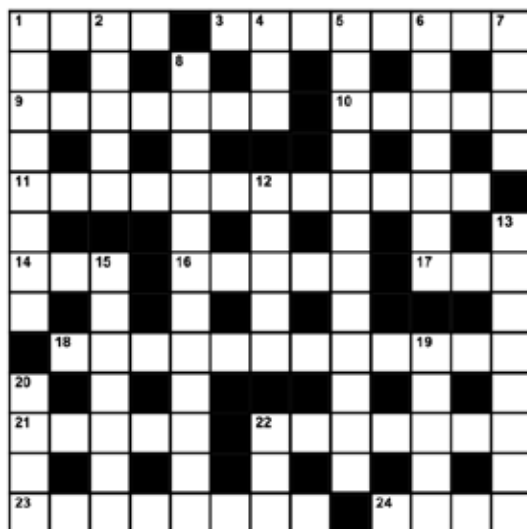
out more about you? Are you working on anything at the moment?

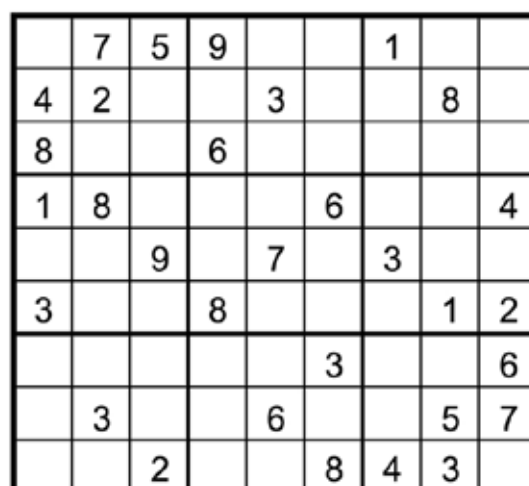

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Craig and Bond: Never say Never – AGAIN?

It has been a little more than a year Spectre hit theaters and since then, the story of the next installment in the James Bond franchise has been a revolving door of confusion.

According to my sources, James Bond bosses are said to be 'panicking' over the proposed 2018 film as they've not yet got a lead actor... Oo-er!

Producers are hoping Daniel Craig will return to the role but he's yet to confirm whether he wants to take part.

MGM executives are reportedly at a "stalemate" with the 48-year-old star – with little contact between the camps.

An insider said: "Daniel and MGM are currently at a stalemate with him having not spoken to them about Bond."

"They have offered a bigger wage deal, and asked about his filming availability to his reps in 2017, but as yet they have not spoken to Daniel."

"They want Bond 25 out in October 2018, but currently they have no Bond, film dates or knowledge of when that will change."

"Daniel's commitment is also a key part of whether Sony Pictures will come in to co-finance the film. So much is hanging in the air – and no-one knows."



BACK TO BOND? Daniel Craig is reluctant...

Sony and MGM have had a very successful partnership during the Daniel Craig era, with 2012's Skyfall being the high watermark of that partnership.

The movie was met with a ton of praise from fans and critics and was the first movie in the franchise to ever cross \$1 billion at the box office. But Spectre was a different story.

The flick was much more divisive among fans and critics and didn't quite match Skyfall's box office, but still brought in very respectable \$880 million. But perhaps more

importantly, the shoot was exhausting and reportedly took a huge toll on Craig.

In an interview very shortly after the movie wrapped, he famously said that he would rather "slash his wrists" than do another James Bond movie. However, he more recently walked back those comments and seemed more interested in returning - maybe.

The actor is currently working with Barbara Broccoli – executive director of the Bond films – on Broadway in New York where he is starring in Othello.

Cushing resurrected in latest Star Wars chapter!

THE STAR WARS villain Grand Moff Tarkin, the 'governor' who watches from afar as the Death Star is assembled, has been resurrected in the latest Lucas Films installment – Rogue One: A Star Wars Story...

And I have to say, it's a genius piece of CGI!

The Imperial Commander, originally played by the late British actor Peter Cushing in 1977's 'Episode IV – A New Hope' has long been rumored to make an appearance in 'Rogue One', which takes place just prior to the events of that first film.

Now, at long last, the film has arrived, and I have to say, the filmmakers have produced an uncanny and breathtaking resemblance to Cushing's original role.

The British actor may have died in 1994, but the character has lived on in comics, cartoons, and novels, and even walked the bridge of a Star Destroyer in the final moments of 2005's Revenge of the Sith. He was played in that movie by Wayne Pygram, in make-up designed to recreate Cushing's razor-cheekboned appearance.

So it's fascinating to see just how Industrial Light and Magic have brought him back. John Knoll, the executive producer and visual effects supervisor for Rogue One, hinted at something revolutionary in a recent interview.

Asked what Holy Grail the visual effects designers were chasing with this



film, which never-before-seen bit of technology they innovated, Knoll said: "I have to tread lightly there because some of the fun bits of innovation are stuff that I've been asked not to talk about yet. You know, we want to hold that back."

Outside of Star Wars,

Cushing is best known for his role in the Hammer Horror films of the 1950s and '60s, often starring alongside Christopher Lee. Despite a career that included over 130 credits, he never received an Oscar nomination. In 1956, he did win a BAFTA TV Award.

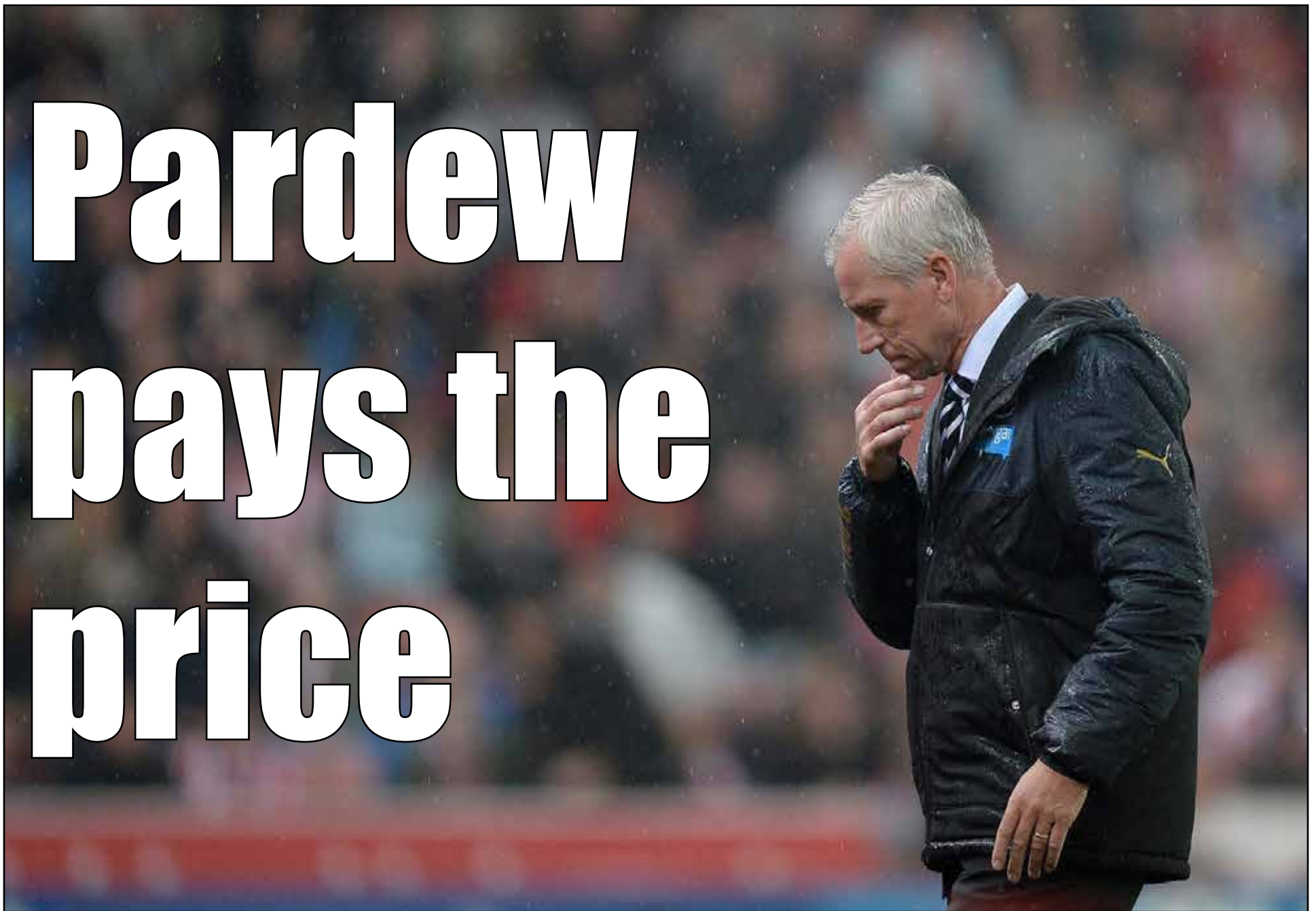
