Britain's top Brexit team warns Brussels over exit deal

BRITAIN will not be bullied by Brussels, key members of Mrs May's Brexit team warned this week.

Boris Johnson told European leaders the UK would not take "punishment beatings" without hitting back.

And David Davis said he would stand up to the EU if it threatened Britain with retaliation over leaving. He said: "Our civil service can cope with World War Two, they can easily cope with this."

In a pointed attack on European leaders calling for Britain to be punished, the Brexit Secretary said: "We're not going to take that."

His words followed the tough line by Theresa May who told the EU that Britain will walk away from the negotiating table rather than accept a bad deal.

He also dismissed Guy Verhofstadt, the European Parliament's chief Brexit negotiator, who had claimed that the UK "cannot cherry pick" what it wants when it leaves.

Mr Davis said: "A more important person than Mr Verhofstadt is Donald Tusk, the head of the [European] Council, and he said this is realistic."

'reflective look'
 "That was the world that he used - 'realistic'. It's quite interesting, it was entirely possible, when you open a negotiation you get a sort of reaction back to

push you back a bit. "We didn't get that, we got a serious and reflective look at it from Brussels and I think we're going to see a really good engagement."

"Guy is one player of several."
 The comments came as Boris Johnson hit out at comments made by French President Francois Hollande. He warned the EU against trying to inflict

"punishment beatings" on Britain in the style of a prisoner of war escape film.

The Foreign Secretary, on a visit to India, said: "If Monsieur Hollande wants to administer punishment beatings to anyone who chooses to escape, rather in the

manner of some World War Two movie, then I don't think that's the way forward. It's not in the interests of our friends or our partners."

Meanwhile Mr Davis warned that a final separation from Brussels may not be achieved until 2021.

He said he is "very determined" to agree a divorce deal with Brussels and forge a new trading relationship within the two-year negotiating process set out by Article 50 which triggers Brexit.

May reveals Brexit blueprint

■ No half-in, half-out deal vows PM

Theresa May promised this week to pursue a clean break from the European Union, ruling out any deal that "leaves us half-in, half-out".

In a long-awaited speech setting out her priorities for the Brexit negotiations, the Prime Minister said the UK cannot remain within the single market, as staying in "would, to all intents and purposes, mean not leaving the EU at all".

She pledged instead to seek a "bold and ambitious" trade agreement with the bloc – one that would keep trade with Europe as "frictionless as possible" while still allowing the UK to control its borders,

set its own laws and strike solo trade deals with other countries.

May said Britain would remain a friendly partner to the EU, but made clear that she would be willing to walk away from the Brexit trade talks if her former EU partners proved to intransigent in their negotiations.

"No deal is better than a bad deal," she said.

May added that if the EU adopted a punitive approach, the UK might be forced to change its economic model; echoing the Chancellor's warning last week that the country would pursue an aggressive low-tax policy if it was

frozen out of European markets.

Editorial reaction

For months, "embittered Remainers" have been accusing May of not having a coherent Brexit plan, said the *Daily Mail*. She proved them spectacularly wrong this week. In "clear, unequivocal" terms, she pointed out that we can't remain in the single market, because it ties us to the free movement of people and the supremacy of EU courts. And she indicated that "if the EU insists that being a member of the customs union means we cannot strike our own trade deals in the wider world, she will take us out of that, too".

The speech was a "defining moment in British politics", said **The Daily Telegraph**. Optimistic and outward-looking, yet with a welcome touch of steel, May's plan "represents a masterclass in common sense and is exactly what Britain voted for last June".

The speech has certainly brought more clarity, said **The Independent**, but May has no mandate for her "extreme" Brexit vision. People didn't vote for the progressive loss of investment and jobs that will probably result from

ministers live up to their tough words when they start negotiations.

He said: "I say to the EU negotiators now is not the time for empty threats.

"Britain is not bluffing, Britain will not be bullied. Britain is not some sort of small nation on the peripheries of Europe.

"We are the United Kingdom. The fifth largest economy on the planet.

"We have links all over the globe – to the Anglosphere, the Commonwealth, the emerging markets of the Far East."

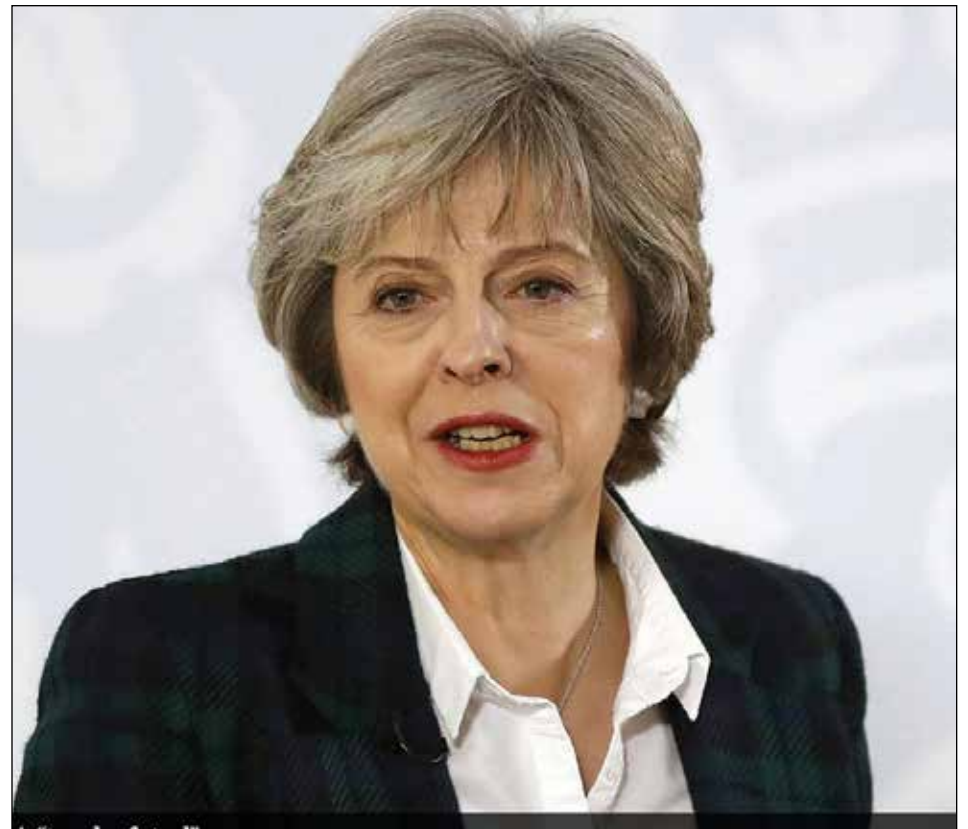

leaving the single market. And they certainly didn't vote for Britain to become the "Singapore of Europe" by mounting a race to the bottom on corporate taxes, as May has threatened.

What the commentators said

The Prime Minister sounded almost euphoric, said Stefanie Bolts in **Die Welt** (Berlin). "Just think," she declared, "a single market without barriers... giving direct and unhindered access to the purchasing power of over 300 million of the world's wealthiest people. Bigger than Japan. Bigger than the

United States. On your doorstep." No, that wasn't May this week, but her predecessor, Margaret Thatcher, speaking at the same venue, Lancaster House, in 1988. Thatcher was extolling the virtues of the very thing Britain now wants to turn its back on.

May believes she can secure a better arrangement for Britain, said John Harris in **The Guardian**. We'll see what happens when her rosy vision "collides with what the EU actually wants".

The negotiations won't be easy, said Daniel Hannan in **The**

Spectator, but there is every chance of reaching a "mutually beneficial outcome" if EU leaders know we're willing to walk away without a deal and are not approaching them as a "suppliant". A failure to reach a deal wouldn't be the end of the world anyway. In the "worst-case scenario", WTO tariffs would be applied reciprocally. According to a study by Civitas, UK exports to the EU would be subject to tariffs of around £5.2bn a year – around half our current annual budget contributions to Brussels; the UK, meanwhile, would collect £12.9bn on EU imports.



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Lord Snowdon, the charmer who married a princess, dead at 86

■ Photographer was first commoner to wed a king's daughter for 450 years

LORD SNOWDON, the former husband of Princess Margaret, society photographer and 1960s bon vivant, has died at the 86.

During a career that spanned six decades, the former Anthony Armstrong Jones earned a reputation as one of the country's foremost photographers, with subjects as diverse as Marlene Dietrich, David Bowie and, of course, the Royal family. He was also a lifelong campaigner for the disabled.

But it is for his tumultuous 18-year marriage to Princess Margaret that he is best remembered.

easy charm

Lord Snowdon began working as a photographer after he failed his second year exams at Jesus College, Cambridge. His easy charm opened doors among the elite of British society and he was to become the first Commoner to wed a king's daughter for some 450 years. Armstrong-Jones was 28 when, in 1958, he met Princess Margaret. She was said to be on the rebound from Peter Townsend, a divorcee whom she'd been forbidden from marrying. Armstrong-Jones was said to be temperamentally unsuited to royal life. He wouldn't, his own father warned, relish spending the rest of his life walking two steps behind his wife. So it proved: 18 years after they married, they became the first royal couple to divorce since Henry VIII rid himself of Anne of Cleves in 1540. But in between, they were the most glamorous couple in Swinging London. And afterwards, Snowdon remained on good terms with the Royal Family: in 2006, he was invited to

photograph the Queen to mark her 80th birthday.

Royal courtiers were appalled when plain Tony Armstrong-Jones became engaged to Princess Margaret but he was, in fact, born into the Welsh gentry. His father, Ronald, was a QC; his parents having separated when he was a toddler, his mother Anne (née Messel) lived in a castle with her second husband, the Earl of Rosse. He was sent to Eton. Though gilded, his childhood was not easy: his mother was a distant woman, who referred to him as her "ugly son".

Aged 16, he contracted polio, and spent six months in Liverpool Royal Infirmary. The illness left him with a limp (and disabled him severely in later life).

After two years at Jesus College, Cambridge, Jones moved to London, and set himself up as a society photographer: he started out taking photos of debutantes, but made his name with ground-breaking informal portraits of actors. Charming, witty and handsome, he had countless affairs with his female subjects and other women – and attracted male admirers too.

talent for mimicry

In 1956, he was invited to photograph Prince Charles for his eighth birthday, which led to further royal commissions. Cecil Beaton – who'd spent years currying favour – was furious, and even more so when, two years later, the young upstart met Princess Margaret at a sitting, and began inviting her to visit him in his "little white room" overlooking the Thames at Rotherhithe. She was delighted by his irreverence, and talent for mimicry. She even brought her "fun-loving

mother" to visit him and his raffish friends in the East End, said *The Independent*. Their marriage, in 1960, was a Westminster Abbey spectacle, followed by a balcony appearance at the Palace. The crowds cheered, but his friends were worried.

The couple moved into Kensington Palace, where Jones was forced to deal with sneering courtiers and frequent snubs from other lesser royals. Meanwhile, said *The Guardian*, he had to adjust to a royal protocol that insisted that his wife was always served first at dinner, and that no one could eat after she'd finished, or leave the table before her. The now Lord Snowdon escaped by taking on various outside projects, including photographic assignments for *The Sunday Times*, many of which highlighted the plight of the poor, the elderly and the lonely.

He undertook royal duties too, though. In October 1966, he was the first member of the family to visit Aberfan after the landslide disaster, arriving unannounced by train, with no retinue.

In the early years of their marriage, the couple relished a jet-set lifestyle, and – mingling with rock stars, actors and artists – made the stuffy Royals look cool, said *The Daily Express*. The partying continued even after the arrival of their two children, David and Sarah. But cracks were appearing. Margaret was imperious and demanding – notorious for her tantrums – and insecure; he could be arrogant and difficult, and was serially unfaithful, said *The Independent*. There was talk of drunken rows, and infidelities on both sides. He reportedly took to leaving "lists of things I hate about you"

for her to find. Then came her much-publicised affair with Roddy Llewellyn, a 26-year-old landscape gardener. They finally divorced in 1978. Almost immediately, Snowdon married Lucy Lindsay-Hogg, with whom he'd been having an affair for years. They had a daughter, Frances, a few months later, but divorced in 2000, when

she tired of his infidelities. In 1998, he'd had a "secret love child" – a son, Jasper – with the *Country Life* journalist Melanie Cable-Alexander.

In 2004, a paternity test confirmed that he had fathered a daughter, Polly Fry, who was born while he was on honeymoon with Princess Margaret.

Snowdon spent much of his remaining years

fighting for the rights of the disabled, taking on, among others, Butlins and the Royal Chelsea Flower Show. In 1981, he set up the Snowdon Trust for the disabled; and in 1988, he took on British Rail, after being outraged to find a woman in a wheelchair strapped into a guard's van.

He is survived by his children.

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Ailing McGuinness quitting politics

FORMER IRA chief Martin McGuinness is leaving frontline politics permanently to recover from an unspecified "very serious illness", he announced this week.

He quit as Northern Ireland's Deputy First Minister last week in protest at Democratic Unionist Party First Minister Arlene Foster's refusal to step aside over a botched green energy scheme.

His party Sinn Fein's refusal to replace him forced a new election, on March 2, for the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Mr McGuinness, 66, said he would not stand in it because of ill health, which some reports have identified as a rare heart condition.

But he wants to remain "an ambassador for peace, unity and reconciliation".

His life has taken him from republican terrorist fighting British rule to senior politician dining

with the Queen.

The former butcher admits to being second-in-command of the IRA, and was found by an inquiry "probably" to have carried a sub-machine gun, on Bloody Sunday in 1972, when soldiers killed 14 civil rights protesters. He served jail time over terror links but was an IRA negotiator in secret talks with the British government in 1972. He became increasingly prominent in the IRA's political wing Sinn Fein and in 1998 with its leader Gerry Adams signed the Good Friday peace deal brokered by Tony Blair.

He was elected a Westminster MP in 1997 but as a Sinn Fein member who will not swear loyalty to the Queen he never took his seat. He was later elected to the Northern Ireland Assembly and nearly 10 years ago he became deputy to First Minister the Rev Ian Paisley of the DUP.

UK-China rail link finalized

Britain and China are now linked by a direct train service for the first time. Setting off from Yiwu, in eastern China, the East Wind freight trains revive the Silk Road trading route, passing through seven countries on their 7,456-mile journey to London's East End – in a relatively quick 16 days. It is not perhaps as novel as it sounds, as varying rail gauges require the containers to be reloaded onto different trains at various points. However, it is hoped that the line will open up new trade opportunities between China and the UK.

Twins on the way for George and Amal

■ Hollywood heartrob 'totally excited' at prospect of being a father

George and Amal Clooney are reportedly expecting twins, according to an interview with *In Touch* magazine.

The Clooneys are said to be welcoming a baby boy and a girl this year, and the couple are thought to be 'really happy.'

Sharing the good news, a source close to the couple revealed: 'When George and Amal found out it was twins they were surprised, but also a little scared because they both had said that one was enough.'

However, when they found out that they would be having a boy and a girl they reportedly felt like they had 'hit the family jackpot.'

Although George was seemingly not keen on having kids in the past, according to the reports he is taking the news very well and is very excited.

'He's gone from never wanting to be a father to being totally excited about Amal's pregnancy and the thought of raising two children who will call him dad', the insider revealed.

38-year-old Amal looked as svelte as ever as she and her hubby shone as special guests at the Women Of Impact dinner

in Davos on Tuesday.

Mrs Clooney was all smiles as she met powerful figures from the world of politics, including outgoing US vice-president Joe Biden, 74.

One guest said: "She and George looked very relaxed and happy.

"She looked slender and stunning to be honest."

Just a week ago, the actor and lawyer got the pregnancy rumour mill in overdrive when they were spotted at the Netflix special screening of *The White Helmets*, with Amal wearing a flowy floral dress which covered what could have been a tiny bump.

The source added: "George is going to be an incredible father.

"He has been a bachelor for so long that most people don't realize how great he is with kids."

The couple, who have a £12million home in Sonning, Berkshire, are said to be expecting a boy and a girl with the actor keen on the name Nicholas for the boy.

His wife is reported to be considering the girl's name.

Russia 'digging for dirt' on UK MPs, says ex-minister

BRITISH politicians are being targeted by Russian spies for potential smear campaigns, a senior Labour MP warned on Monday.

Foreign Secretary Boris Johnson, Brexit Secretary David Davis, International Trade Secretary Liam Fox and Foreign Office minister Sir Alan Duncan could all have been investigated, claimed Chris Bryant.

The news comes after allegations that the Kremlin has a "dirty dossier" on US President-elect Donald Trump.

Mr Trump has denied links to the Russian government and sex parties with prostitutes.

The author of the report, former MI6 agent Christopher Steele, remains in hiding.

Mr Bryant said: "Any minister who goes into the Foreign Office and has responsibility for Russia, they [Russia] will be, in any shape or form, trying to put together information about them.

"All of these people, the Russians will be following very, very closely.

"They will have created a file and they'll be attempting to watch everything they do."

Mr Bryant, former minister for Europe, said technology has made it easier: "You can do a lot of the work by long distance now, you don't

physically have to be close to somebody to be able to track them."

Bill Browder, whose company was one of the biggest foreign investors in Russia before his lawyer Sergei Magnitsky died in police custody after exposing a £144million tax fraud, said former British spies are gathering compromising material.

He said: "British companies are being hired to do the work of Russia's FSB security service.

"They are collecting sensitive financial and personal information about London-based enemies of the regime as well as spilling the beans on national security and UK foreign policy."



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Trump names Woody Johnson as new UK ambassador

Woody Johnson, the owner of the New York Jets football team and scion of the Johnson & Johnson industrial dynasty, has been nominated as the next US ambassador to London.

The 69-year-old businessman and philanthropist is a longstanding Republican donor, but came relatively late to supporting Donald Trump's election campaign. He served as finance chairman on Jeb Bush's campaign to win the Republican nomination until it collapsed in February last year. Johnson only endorsed Trump in May, but emerged as a major fundraiser in the final months of the campaign and served on his inaugural committee.

In 2006, Johnson was called to testify before the senate on the use of tax avoidance schemes by his investment firm. He claimed he had relied on professional advisers who told him the use of tax havens was lawful and he later settled with the Internal Revenue Service, paying all the outstanding taxes and interest.

Once confirmed by the senate, Johnson will be the sixth businessman in a row to be appointed as ambassador to the UK, which has emerged as a top reward for wealthy campaign donors in the US political system.

Johnson's father was president of the Johnson & Johnson pharmaceutical and medical equipment company, but the nominee himself has run a private investment firm, the Johnson Company Inc, since it was set up in 1978. He spends much of his time raising funds for charities combating lupus and juvenile diabetes, both of which have affected his family.

Concern as brother of Harry's girl is hit with gun charge

■ Thomas Markle Jr. faces five year sentence

THERE WAS GROWING alarm in royal circles this week as it emerged that the brother of Prince Harry's girlfriend is facing weapons charges in the US.

Meghan Markle's brother Thomas Markle Jr is set to appear in court next month on charges which could see him jailed for up to five years.

He will appear in court in Grants Pass, Oregon, on February 13 after being arrested and spending a night in the cells over a drunken altercation with his girlfriend at the home they share in the town.

The 50-year-old window fitter is facing two charges - one of which, unlawful use of a weapon, is a class C felony, carrying a maximum sentence of five years in jail and a fine of \$125,000.

He is also charged with one count of menacing domestic violence, a misdemeanor that carries a maximum penalty of a year in prison and a \$6,250 fine.

The case will be prosecuted by Josephine County District Attorney Ryan Mulkins,

who said that a third charge - pointing a firearm at another - has been dropped.

'We are currently preparing the case,' he added. 'At the moment, I can't disclose any more information than that.'

Markle Jr - whose sister Meghan is understood to have been dating

Prince Harry since last May - was arrested on Thursday night following a drunken altercation at his home.

His girlfriend of two months, Darlene Blount, 36, is understood to have called the cops after an argument spiraled out of control.

According to the

police report, Markle Jr grabbed his gun and pressed it to her head in an attempt to make her leave.

She then locked herself in the bathroom and called the authorities - who arrested Markle Jr and booked him into Josephine County Jail at approximately 11pm.

He was released the following day at 10am after paying a \$1,500 bond, although the origin of the money is disputed.

Ex-wife Tracy Dooley claimed in the aftermath of the arrest that she had put up the money following a 3am phone call.

But Markle Jr said her claims were 'lies, all lies' and also disputed a version of events put out by his son Tyler, 24.

'I didn't get bailed out by Tracy or ask her for any money - that was lies, all lies,' he said.

On his son, who issued a statement purportedly in his name on Sunday and who had claimed Markle Jr texted him immediately after his arrest, he said: 'Tyler's statement is 100 per cent false. I haven't talked to Tyler for over two

weeks.'

Court papers filed after his arrest show Markle Jr had a blood alcohol level of 0.17 - twice the Oregon drink drive limit of 0.08.

As a result, his bail conditions include a ban on drinking alcohol - and both of his guns, including the one used in the altercation, have been confiscated by police.

There is no public record suggesting that he has a previous criminal record.

Markle Jr is the only son of Meghan's father Thomas Markle Sr, 72, and his first wife Roslyn, 71. The former couple, who split up in 1976, also have a daughter - Samantha Grant, 52, who now lives in Florida.

Meghan, who reportedly rang in the New Year in Norway with Prince Harry, is the product of his second marriage to yoga teacher Doria Ragland, 60.

The 35-year-old actress is currently believed to be in London where she is said to have been introduced to Prince William, 34, and Kate Middleton, 35, this week.

Women's cricket pioneer dies at 77

Rachael Heyhoe Flint, the former England women's cricket captain, has died aged 77.

Baroness Heyhoe Flint, vice-president of Wolverhampton Wanderers Football Club, passed away in the early hours of Wednesday after a short illness.

She leaves behind husband Derrick, their son Ben, and her stepchildren Rowan, Hazel and Simon. Ben said the family was "deeply saddened".

Heyhoe Flint

captained England between 1966 and 1978.

She also played in the first ever women's match at Lord's, against Australia, in 1976.

During her career she played 22 Test matches and 23 one-day internationals. She was inducted into the ICC Hall of Fame in 2010.

She also became a successful journalist, after dinner speaker and expert in public relations, which brought her back into contact with her beloved Wolves as she headed up the club's work in

the local community.

MCC president Matthew Fleming said: "Rachael Heyhoe Flint was a pioneer of women's cricket - she was the first global superstar in the women's game and her overall contribution to the MCC, cricket and sport in general was immense."

Clare Connor, the ECB's director of women's cricket, said: "She was so special, so ever-present and now she has gone - but her impact can never be forgotten."

NHS in crisis? the media weighs in

BRITAIN'S cherished National Health Service is facing a crisis of financing and morale, according to the findings of a new report.

A two-year analysis by the Health Service Journal (HSJ) paints a picture of lengthy waiting lists, overflowing casualty departments and staff struggling to cope with an ever-increasing workload, with official data suggesting almost every acute hospital in England is failing to meet its own standard on how many nurses it should have on wards.

Nurses described "desperately unsafe" numbers of registered nurses, while others said patients are being put at risk.

The problem appears to have got worse since the Government introduced a cap on how much hospitals are allowed to spend on agency staff.

Health Secretary Jeremy Hunt ordered NHS trusts to publish monthly data on staffing levels as part of the Government response to the mid-Staffordshire

scandal in 2007, in which hundreds of patients died as a result of poor care.

But an analysis by the HSJ, covering data from 2014-15 to 2016-17, shows 96 per cent of acute hospitals (214) reporting figures failed to meet their own planned level for registered nurses.

Some 85 per cent (190 hospitals) also missed their target for nurses working at night in the same month.

"We should have reached the tipping point by now, said **Polly Toynbee** in *The Guardian*. Usually,

during a major NHS crisis, "prime ministers crumple when people die – as they have in the Royal Worcester Hospital's corridors".

When doctors describe conditions as the worst they've ever seen, when patients on trollies pile up in A&E departments, when the Royal College of Surgeons protests at the cancellation of cancer operations, you would expect the Government to take swift action. But no, Theresa May

is "not for turning". Instead, we've had a "flamethrower of blame from Westminster".

The system, says the PM, needs "reform", not more money. Patients have been criticised for clogging up hospitals with minor complaints, GPs for not pulling their weight, managers for not managing better.

May is quite right, said Russell Hopkins in the *Daily Mail*. The "real cause of the crisis" is the breakdown in GP services. Thanks to Labour's absurdly generous 2004 contract, allowing doctors to duck out of out-of-hours services, "too many GPs have become unresponsive and unavailable". And because many GPs now

choose to work part-time, even the core weekday hours are not always covered: 46% of practices in England close at some point during these times. As a result, A&E is flooded by people who should have seen their local doctor.

Be honest, said Philip Stephens in the *FT*.

The NHS is run on a shoestring, and "the shoestring has broken". Funding may be rising in real terms, as May protests. But Britain spends about 30% less per person than Germany. And "the budget is shrinking as a share of national income, at a time when a growing and ageing population, increased longevity, an epidemic of chronic diseases such as diabetes, and higher

expectations for health care, are generating ever-rising demand". Deep cuts to social care since 2010 have transferred an additional burden to the NHS, with many elderly people in need of care "clogging hospital beds".

Real improvements will require an "ideological compromise", said *The Guardian*. "Labour will have to concede that problems in the NHS are not simply a manifestation of wicked

Tory austerity." And the Tories must "stop pretending that adequate resources are available", and stump up more cash.

Unfortunately, for the time being, the gap between the parties appears "unbridgeable". Corbyn needs the NHS as a stick "for beating the Government". Theresa May seems determined to "deny the problem". So instead of a solution, expect more political "trench warfare".

Good week/bad week

Good week for: Jeremy Hunt, the Health Secretary, with reports that he could be about to make around £14.5m from the sale of a business he co-founded before becoming an MP. Hunt is believed to hold a 48% stake in Hotcourses, an educational listings service, which has been sold for £30m.

Dame Julia Peyton-Jones, the former head of the Serpentine Galleries in London, who became a mother for the first time, aged 64. Known as the Queen of Arts, Dame Julia spent 25 years turning the Serpentine into one of the world's most admired galleries, before stepping down in October 2015, saying she wanted to concentrate

on other projects.

practically fresh!

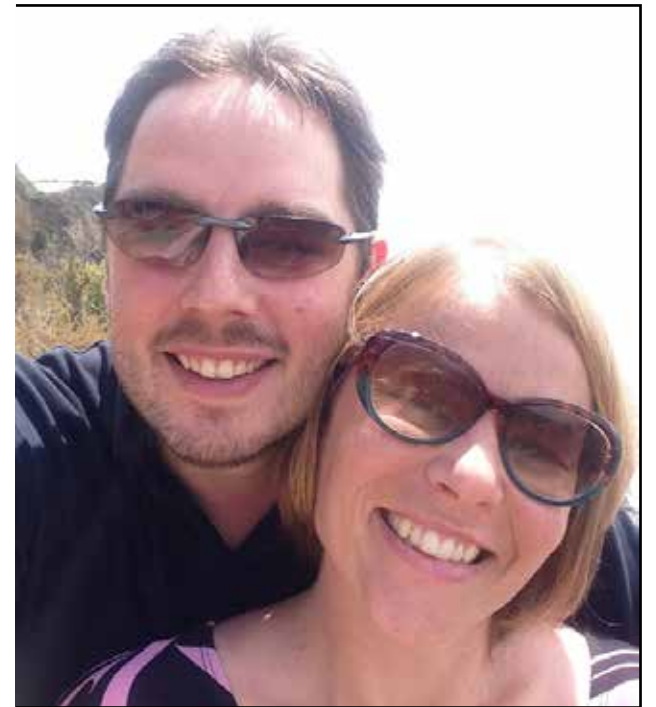
What do you find the biggest difference is living here versus Edinburgh?

I don't miss the dark, grey winter days. The damp and the cold (although this past summer I did recall them somewhat fondly), the wind and sleet. Despite the weather I used to walk more in Edinburgh, and miss being able hop on a bus as required, or a train! But I found this first LA summer a bit too hot for spending much time outdoors, and the public transport options are a bit more limited.

There's actually been some pretty major changes in my life the past few years and LA, for me, at the moment (!) is a bright and brave new world. I was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 2012 and had to give

up my vet work (I'm a veterinarian) because of it in 2013. For a time I thought my life was effectively over and I never thought I'd be able to work again. I was on a half dozen or so prescription medications, daily injections and what-not and was generally feeling pretty hopeless. But then I kind of stabilized, medically speaking, and I began to look at different ways of optimizing my health and taking responsibility for managing my disease.

Fast forward to now, I'm not taking any drugs at all and have spent the last year working more and feeling better than I have in a long time! After spending the past year working as a veterinarian here in LA, I've come to realize that many of the diseases I was seeing in pets, could be prevented or treated using a more holistic approach, and that conventional medical options were not always in the best interest of the patient. So I decided to quit my job and am in the process of studying holistic and integrative veterinary practices, including nutrition, therapeutic massage and hospice care and plan to

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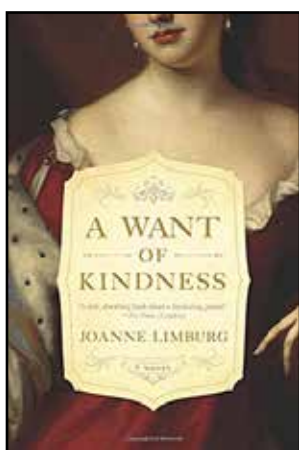
Queen Anne's passion: A Want of Kindness

■ Exclusive interview with author Joanne Limburg about her new novel about Queen Anne

"Many years ago, I was watching a documentary about royals, disease and doctors," says author Joanne Limburg.

"I was particularly intrigued and moved by the story of Queen Anne, who went through seventeen or eighteen pregnancies, but was to leave no heir. She suffered all manner of losses...miscarriages, stillbirths, neo-natal deaths, the deaths of two daughters in infancy and one son on his eleventh birthday. Years later, when I had myself suffered a miscarriage and given birth to a child, I was trying to write about those experiences, and Anne came into my head again."

The court of King Charles II is a glittering rebirth of Restoration England. Princess Anne, niece of the king, is a ten-year old sickly girl. As she grows up



she likes to gamble, gossip with her ladies of the bed chamber and eat unhealthy foods. As a pawn in her uncle's plot to secure the crown of England, she seems unlikely to survive. At eighteen she marries Prince George of Denmark and becomes heir to the throne. She will face grief over her lost children, the political intrigues of her sister Mary and her betrayal.

"I felt drawn to Anne because of her experience of maternal loss," says Limburg.

"When you suffer a miscarriage, you realise how many women experience it, how much it hurts, and how little it is talked about. I wanted, through Anne's story, to honour all those bereft women and all their lost children."

Limburg did a great deal of research, reading biographies, histories of the time, and works on clothes and food. She had a small research grant from the Society of Authors that enabled her to visit Windsor Castle, Hampton Court and Kensington Palace, to see the locations where the many of the events in the book took place.

"While I was writing the book, I subscribed to a service called British History Online, where I could check the State records of the time," says Limburg. "That supplied me with

a wealth of fascinating detail that I was able to use in the book. It enabled me to check what was happening on a political level on any given day in Anne's life. As a member of the royal family, Anne's personal life was inextricably tied up with domestic and European politics."

A thread that runs through the book is Anne's passionate friendship with Sarah Churchill. "Sarah kept the letters Anne wrote to her," says Limburg. "I was fortunate enough to be able to read them in the British Library. It was extraordinary to touch the paper Anne had touched, to read her writing and even to see those places where her tears had smudged the ink."

Limburg has written three poetry collections: *Femenismo*, *Paraphernalia* and releasing next year, *The*

Autistic Alice. She's also written a children's poetry collection, *Bookside Down*. She's written two memoirs, *The Woman Who Thought Too Much* and *Small Pieces: A Book of Lamentations*, to release next summer.

Limburg won an Eric Gregory Award for poetry in 1998. *Femenismo* was shortlisted for the Forward Prize for Best First Collection. *Paraphernalia* was a Poetry Book Society Choice. *The Woman Who Thought Too Much* was on the shortlist for Mind Book of the Year. *A Want of Kindness* has yet to be optioned for film or television.

Greenberg says her role in getting this book published was presenting it to her publishers and then... waiting. "I apologised to her editor for saying that it was stunning,"

says Limburg. "But, her editor replied that if I were saying that it was probably true...which it has been found to be."

Limburg has recently finished a PhD and is looking forward to taking a break. She is based in Cambridge, and was born in London.

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Sherlock stars not exactly besties away from the camera...

British actors Martin Freeman and Benedict Cumberbatch have played best friends on Sherlock for over six years but behind the camera there is allegedly no love lost between the pair.

Co-creator Steven Moffat has already said the future of the show depends on the two actors' busy Hollywood schedules and their willingness to return, but that is starting to look like a long shot.

The news comes as the series four finale pulled in the show's lowest-ever audience with a peak of 6.2million in the UK on Sunday. A source said: "Benedict and Martin aren't mates and they don't spend time together away from the show."

"Now that their careers have taken off – both have become Hollywood stars with Benedict recently taking on the lead role in Marvel's *Dr Strange* – neither Benedict nor Martin have 'a huge desire to come back for another season'.

"They're professional and very polite to each other but there's not the warmth you'd expect after filming together for six years," the source told The Sun.

And it was a feeling that fans of the show also had when they watched *The Final Problem* on Sunday night after the episode ended with a sense of

finality, as the late Mary Watson was heard on tape giving an emotional speech in which she referred to the pair as 'my Baker Street boys'.

Questions continue to be raised over the future of the program, given concerns over the film stars' continued availability; Cumberbatch has several movie projects in the works, while *The Hobbit* star Freeman is committed to several other projects, including forthcoming superhero film *Black Panther*.

Another "well-placed BBC source" told Radio

Times that there would not be another series of *Sherlock* next January, while adding that the broadcaster is "reasonably hopeful" the programme will return for 2018.

If it is the end, the finale to the fourth season ended in such a way as to tie up any loose ends, with Moffat recently adding: "We could end it there."

"We couldn't have ended it on any of the previous [seasons] because they're all ended on walloping, great cliffhangers."

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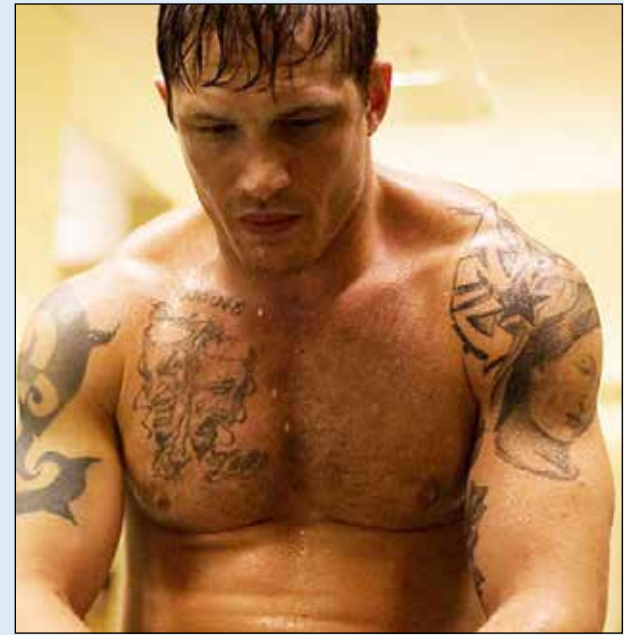
IT SURE is hard(y) work being beautiful!

United regain top spot in football rich list

Manchester United have returned to first place in the Deloitte Football Money League for the first time in 13 years, breaking Real Madrid's 11-year stranglehold on top spot with record revenue.

The Money League has listed the top 20 clubs in the world for revenue in each season since 1996/97. In the latest edition, with figures relating to 2015/16, the combined revenue for the 20 richest clubs in the world grew 12 per cent to £5.5 billion, a new record.

United top the list with revenue of £515.3 million, the highest ever by a football club in a season in the Money League's 20-year history.

Real Madrid drop to third place after 11 years at the top of the Money

League, despite breaking the £450m barrier for the first time ever. Barcelona rank second with revenue only marginally greater than that of Real Madrid.

United's resurgence comes as a result of significant growth across all three of the revenue categories (matchday, broadcast and commercial) compared with 2014/15.

The club's matchday and broadcast revenues were boosted by their return to the Champions League, but it was commercial revenue growth of £71m that has led to United's ascension to the top position, with the club now boasting over 70 commercial partnerships.

Dan Jones, partner in the Sports Business Group at Deloitte,

comments: "Manchester United's ability to secure commercial partnerships with value in excess of that achievable by their peers has been the crucial factor in enabling the club to regain their place at the top of the Money League."

Antoine Griezmann could be Chelsea's next marquee signing as Atletico Madrid appeared to leave the door open for the French striker to move to London in the summer.

And although Chelsea are thought to be the striker's preferred destination, it's no secret that Jose Mourinho is also an admirer, prompting speculation that Manchester United will also submit a big-money bid for the marksman, who has a €100 million (currently £86 million) release clause in his contract.

With Simeone likely to leave Atletico in the summer after taking the unusual step last September of shortening his contract with the Madrid club by two years, one considerable barrier to Griezmann (pictured, right) departing is expected to be removed.

In addition, Atletico are due to move into a new 67,000-capacity stadium next season and it is thought the club will have to consider the sale of at least one leading player to help offset some of the loans they have taken out to fund the



Wanda Metropolitano project on the site of the former La Peineta athletics stadium.

Simeone has had a significant part to play in helping to turn Griezmann into one of the world's most revered strikers but the Atletico coach was adamant he would not stand in the player's way if he was determined to leave.

Asked about the speculation surrounding Griezmann's future, Simeone said: "I don't tie anybody down. I simply work in order to continue getting better for the good of the club."

"He [Griezmann] is in an extraordinary moment. He is working well, he has got back on the score sheet. He is currently in great

form and it's normal that the top clubs in the world want him. I'm not surprised that those that can afford him are seeking him."

Bastian Schweinsteiger could be the next player to leave Old Trafford

after Memphis Depay underwent a medical in France on Thursday as Lyon moved closer to completing the signing of the Holland winger in a deal that could eventually be worth up to £21.7 million with add

ons. Mourinho is not averse to Schweinsteiger seeing out the season at Old Trafford but talks are ongoing with potential suitors, including Major Soccer League clubs in the US.

Will Jesus be Pep's savior?

■ Brazilian teen sensation finalizes City move

E M B A T T L E D Manchester City boss Pep Guardiola got a welcome boost ahead of this weekend's crunch match with Spurs as his club secured the signature of red-hot Brazilian prospect Gabriel Jesus.

The 19-year-old winger is set to make his debut on Saturday against the North London team after formally completing his £27m move from Palmeiras.

Brazil international Jesus agreed a five-year deal with City in August.

He stayed with Palmeiras until the end of the Brazilian season in December.

"He has the potential to become one of the best attacking players in the game," said City's

director of football Txiki Begiristain.

Jesus arrived at City at the start of the month but registration to play for his new club was reportedly delayed while the Football Association examined documents relating to his move.

City regard the player as the best young talent in South America and fought off interest from Barcelona.

Jesus was voted the best newcomer in the Brazilian top flight last season and was part of his country's squad at the Rio Olympics.

The teenager said City boss Pep Guardiola was a huge influence in his decision to join.

Jesus added: "City is a club that always

competes for the title in the competitions it enters, so that was an important factor, and because of the manager, Guardiola, and the squad."

City are fifth in the Premier League table, 10 points behind leaders Chelsea, after two defeats in the last three games.
