# A warm welcome from Auld Reekie

## Harry and Meghan wow 'em north of the border

Prince Harry and Meghan Markle were given the warmest of Scottish welcomes in Edinburgh on Tuesday on an official joint visit to the famous capital ahead of their marriage in May.

Crowds who had waited hours in the cold outside Edinburgh Castle, which dominates the skyline from a rock in the city centre, were thrilled with the smiling couple.

Harry, 33, and Markle, 36, were officially welcomed to the city by the Royal Marines Scotland Band at the castle, where they observed the firing of the one o'clock gun, a tradition that dates back to 1861.

The actress reportedly laughed as the couple were greeted by a Shetland Pony outside the castle, who appeared to try to bite Harry's hand.

Speaking of bites, the pair were also visiting Social Bite, a charity that runs cafes and distributes food to the homeless, as well as employing staff who have been homeless. The eatery has attracted visits from other high-

profile names such as actors George Clooney and Leonardo di Caprio.

The royal couple's social work spoke highly of them, one 13-year-old onlooker said.

"I think it's great they do all this stuff for charity, that they are in power but they use their power for good," she said.

### Grenfell visits

Later Harry and Markle attended a reception at the Palace of Holyroodhouse, meeting youth representatives from several charities.

"They are active in the community and they are not sitting up in a castle somewhere barking orders at people so I think this is a good generation for the royals," said Richard Aylward, a 46-year-old Australian visiting family in Scotland.

Queen Elizabeth's grandson, fifth-in-line to the throne, and Markle, star of the US TV legal drama Suits, announced their engagement last year and will be married on May 19 at Windsor Castle.

As part of a tour of Britain before their big day, they have also visited the English city of Nottingham and the Welsh capital Cardiff.

Although it has not been confirmed by Kensington Palace, there have been reports Markle has also been doing a solo tour of sorts; quietly making visits to the Al Manaar mosque, a place of worship for many affected by the Grenfell Tower fire, which saw 71 die in June 2017.

"Meghan's visits mean so much to us," a person described as a "leading Grenfell community member told

Hello magazine. "She has a special place in our hearts." Meghan's actions have been compared to those made by Prince

Harry's mother, Princess Diana, in the past. The Princess was known for making secret visits to several children and

cancer charities and also supported HIV and Aids sufferers around the world as well as the many victims of landmines.

# UK AND USA face off over fate of Isis suspects

■ Neither country wants responsibility for holding murderous duo

Britain was this week engaged in a diplomatic row with the United States over the fate of two Londoners suspected of being members of the murderous Islamic State cell dubbed "the Beatles".

James Mattis, the US defence secretary, has ruled out sending Alexandra Kotey and El Shafee Elsheikh to Guantanamo Bay, the US internment facility in Cuba, after they were captured in Syria, officials have said. He appears to favour putting foreign Isis fighters on trial in their country of origin.

But Gavin Williamson, the defence secretary, does not want the men to return to Britain to face trial. Kotey, 34, and Elsheikh, 29, were stripped of their British citizenship after joining Isis. "The day these barbaric terrorists turned their back on this country in pursuit of an evil agenda of bloodshed and slaughter, they forfeited their right ever to return," a Whitehall source said. "They are not British subjects and should pay the price for their crimes in Syria."

However, there is no judicial system in war-torn Syria that could try them, and the US does not

recognise the jurisdiction of the International Criminal Court in the Hague.

Mr Williamson and Mr Mattis met with defence ministers from the US-led coalition against Isis for a meeting in Rome this week, and high on agenda was the issue of what to do with a "huge number" of foreigners held by US-backed Kurdish forces in Syria on suspicion of belonging to Isis. The head of a Syrian-Kurdish militia holding the fighters, who are from Russia, Europe, China, Japan and Arab countries, has previously stated that none of their home countries wanted them back.

## embarrassing setback

The US position raised uncertainty over what should happen to Kotey and Elsheikh, who grew up in west London. Their group is suspected of torture and involvement in the beheading of more than 27 hostages, including Britons and Americans. It would be an embarrassing setback if Britain had to accept responsibility for the men, sources said.

Kathryn Wheelbarger, the US principal deputy assistant defence secretary, said: "We're working with

the coalition on foreign fighter detainees, and generally expect these to return to their country of origin for disposition. Defence ministers have the obligation to really explain to their other ministers or their other cabinet officials just the importance to the mission, to make sure that there's an answer to this problem."

That comment appeared to be directed to Mr Williamson. The US government has yet to make a decision on what it thinks should happen to the pair, the Department of Defence said.

Downing Street would have ultimate responsibility for any decision on whether Britain would take them, in consultation with the Foreign Office, Home Office and government law officers. Downing Street and the Home Office declined to comment.

"The Home Office find themselves in a mess," a Whitehall source said. "It is a bit of a pickle. I am sure that submissions are being written on how to get out of this mess. It would be very unpalatable to allow them back but they will not be the last."

Under Home Office rules, anyone stripped of citizenship has the right to

appeal. It was not known whether Kotey, who has a Ghanaian father and Greek-Cypriot mother, and Elsheikh, who moved to Britain from Sudan as a child, would try to exercise this right.

About 850 Britons have joined Isis in Syria and Iraq since 2014. More than 400 have since

returned and at least 100 are thought to have been killed. Tobias Ellwood, a defence minister, raised the idea last week of sending foreign fighters to face trial at the Hague.

Lord Carlile of Berriew, QC, a former independent reviewer of counterterrorism laws, said Britain was the

"proper forum" for Kotey and Elsheikh to stand trial as their country of origin. "Their victims include British nationals and their families, who have a legitimate expectation that the UK government will use its best efforts to ensure that a trial to good 'rule of law' standards will occur."

## Stormont deal 'still months away'

### Northern Ireland

A deal to restore power-sharing in the North could be months away, Arlene Foster said this week in comments that suggested an imminent agreement with Sinn Féin had stalled.

Mrs Foster, the leader of the Democratic Unionist Party, ruled out a stand-alone Irish language act. This is a key Sinn Féin demand and has been a matter of contention for the past year. Mrs Foster also said that while the visit of Theresa May, the British prime minister, to Belfast on Monday was welcome, it was also a "bit of a distraction."

Mrs May and Irish leader Leo Varadkar spent Monday in Belfast, stoking hopes that a deal could be brokered almost 13 months after the executive collapsed.

The Irish government defended its trip to the North, with a spokesman for the taoiseach saying that it had been a "productive and useful day". He also denied that Mrs Foster's comments

represented a setback.

Mrs Foster rubbished speculation about the shape of Irish language laws that might emerge from Stormont's power-sharing negotiations. She said that rumours about what legislation might look like were "not grounded in any sort of reality".

She also ruled out any laws that would require bilingual road signs in Northern Ireland, compulsory teaching of Irish in schools, or quotas of Irish language speakers in the civil service. She tempered expectations that a deal to restore devolution was likely this week. "I am hopeful that we will move toward devolution again," she said. "Whether it is this week, whether it is in a couple of weeks or whether it's in a couple of months what I must ensure is that we have an accommodation that everybody feels content with."

Mrs Foster also made clear that if devolution was restored she expected to be first minister of

the new administration. Sinn Féin had ruled out her return to the post while an inquiry into a botched green energy scheme continued. "I am the leader of the Democratic Unionist Party so therefore I will be the person that's put forward by the party to be first minister," she said.

Mrs May has urged all sides to make "one final push" to strike a deal to salvage power-sharing. Mrs Foster said that the visit from Mrs May and Mr Varadkar had interrupted the negotiations. The DUP leader said that both governments had been told before their trip that "the deal wasn't done".

The DUP, which props up Mrs May's Conservative government, did not meet Mr Varadkar on Monday but Mrs Foster rejected the suggestion that recent frayed relations over Brexit was the reason. She said she did not feel it was necessary to meet Mr Varadkar because the negotiations were touching on matters within Northern Ireland.

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# Misery for holiday Brits as chopper crash kills three, injures two

■ Grand Canyon victims were on holiday of a lifetime

TWO families were left devastated this week after a helicopter crash in the Grand Canyon killed three Britons on the trip of a lifetime.

Stuart Hill, whose birthday was last Friday, was killed alongside his brother Jason, 32, and girlfriend, Becky Dobson, 27, when their sightseeing helicopter dropped into a remote ravine and burst into flames. Three friends on the flight were injured but survived. Ellie Milward, 29, and Jonathan Udall, 32, who married last year, were flown with Jennifer Barham, 39, to University Medical Center in Las Vegas with

Scott Booth, 42, the pilot. Sandra Hill, 63, Stuart and Jason's mother, said that she was proud of her children, who had saved for a year for the trip. "The highlight was going to be the helicopter trip," she said.

She added that her sons were sporty and very close. "They did a lot together. They supported one another. They both lived life to the full. Both were our wonderful sons who cared for us."

The Rev David Hill, their father, who is a hospital chaplain, said that "a light has truly gone out" but took some comfort from the fact that

his sons were together at the end. Jason, a solicitor for Shoosmiths in Milton Keynes, and Stuart, a Mercedes salesman, grew up in Worthing, West Sussex.

Ms Dobson's parents learnt of their daughter's death as they returned from holiday in Turkey. Mr Dobson said that Becky had been looking forward to the trip. "They were going to fly across the Grand Canyon - it would have been spectacular," he said. "We're all a bit shell-shocked. I've lost a lovely, lovely girl, so full of life. She was always happy."

Ms Dobson was a

receptionist at Vets4Pets in Worthing. On the company's website she wrote about her wish to qualify as a veterinary nurse and about her hobbies. "I also love to travel the world and explore what is out there beyond good old Worthing," she wrote.

Ms Barham, a friend of Jason, is a partner at the Bircham Dyson Bell law firm in London under her professional name, Jenny Dorricott.

Teddy Fujimoto, a Las Vegas photographer who was doing a wedding shoot at the time of the crash, said he suddenly saw people running toward the edge of a gulch. He checked out the commotion coming from about 600ft below. "In the gulch, there was a helicopter, flames, smoke," he said. "It was

horrible." He said there were two or three further explosions during the incident, which happened at 5.20pm local time on Saturday.

Francis Bradley, chief of police for the Hualapai Nation in northern Arizona, said rescuers struggled to reach the site because of severe weather, including gusts of up to 50mph. "The terrain where the crash occurred is extremely rugged," he said, adding that darkness and difficulties in sending air support had hampered the rescue.

Mr Bradley said the survivors showed extraordinary resilience. "I've seen a lot of accidents, especially those involving car crashes and other types of traumatic injuries, and . . . the will to survive kicks in," he said. "It's a fight-or-flight

syndrome that we have in every one of us, and I'm sure that had a lot to do with their survival."

The tour began in Boulder City, Nevada, and although a storm was approaching and weather conditions were not normal, there were no restrictions on the flight. The helicopter tour was run by Papillon Group. The company's website states: "With more than 50 years flying the Grand Canyon and beyond, Papillon is the largest and most experienced helicopter tour operator in the world."

Federal Aviation Administration spokesman Allen Kenitzer said the Eurocopter EC130 crashed in unknown circumstances and sustained heavy damage. An investigation will take place.

## The Queen goes green

Plastic straws and bottles banned from royal estates

The Queen has banned plastic straws and bottles from the royal estates as part of a move to cut back on the use of plastics "at all levels".

Buckingham Palace outlined new waste plans and said there was a "strong desire to tackle the issue" in the royal household, in a move thought to be inspired by David Attenborough.

"Across the organisation, the royal household is committed to reducing its environmental impact," said a spokesman for Buckingham Palace.

As part of that, we have taken a number of practical steps to cut back on the use of plastics. At all levels, there's a strong desire to tackle this issue."

The new measures include gradually phasing out plastic straws in public cafes and banning them

altogether in staff dining rooms, according to the Daily Telegraph.

Internal caterers at Buckingham Palace, Windsor Castle and the Palace of Holyroodhouse in Edinburgh will now reportedly only be allowed to use china plates and glasses, or recyclable paper cups.

The Queen is thought to have developed a personal interest in the issue of plastic waste after working with Sir David on a conservation documentary dealing with wildlife in the Commonwealth.

She was filmed laughing and joking with the documentary-maker during the programme which discussed plans to create a network of national forested parks across the 52 countries of the Commonwealth.

The announcement comes amid a wider

plastic strategy to tackle the issue of plastic waste across Europe, including plans by the EU to make all plastic packaging across the continent recyclable or reusable by 2030.

Other commitments include a reduction in consumption of single-use plastics and restrictions on the use of microplastics, such as microbeads found in some cosmetics.

Frans Timmermans, the European Commission's first vice-president, who is responsible for sustainable development, said of the plans in January: "If we don't change the way we produce and use plastics, there will be more plastics than fish in our oceans by 2050."

As it stands, Europeans produce 25 million tons of plastic waste every year, but less than 30 per cent of this is recycled.



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# Justice has been served, say victims as serial abuser Bennell is convicted

■ Former football youth coach found guilty of abusing 11 boys aged eight to 15

Three of Barry Bennell's victims have told how he turned their dreams into a "horrendous nightmare" after the former youth football coach was convicted of 43 sex assaults on boys.

Bennell, who worked at Manchester City and Crewe Alexandra, was found guilty of abusing 11 boys aged eight to 15.

Speaking outside Liverpool Crown Court on Tuesday, another victim, Andy Woodward, said "justice has been served".

It is understood 86 others have come forward to say they were victims.

The jury, which deliberated over five days, had been told of Bennell's abuse of 12 boys between 1979 and 1990.

Before the case he admitted seven charges of indecent assault on three boys, two of whom were also part of the allegations he was tried on.

He was found guilty of 36 charges on Tuesday, and a further seven counts on Thursday.

Bennell, who is now known as Richard Jones, appeared in court via videolink during the five-week trial due to illness.

He could be seen shaking his head and muttering when the final guilty verdicts were returned by a 10-1 majority.

He will be sentenced on Monday and will be produced from custody to attend the hearing.

It was the fourth time Bennell had been convicted of abusing boys.

## 'united in justice'

The jury was told he had previously received jail sentences in the UK and in the US in 1995, 1998 and 2015.

Mr Woodward said he believed "the football clubs that were accountable for this... could have stopped this for so many years... And I think now's the time that that comes sort of out.

"And I would personally like after 15 months, an apology from Crewe Alexandra

for what happened to us boys."

Ex-Manchester City youth player Chris Unsworth, who was abused by Bennell when he was a scout at the club, stood alongside Micky Fallon and Steve Walters as he read a statement.

## 'horrendous nightmare'

The three men are supporters of the Offside Trust, which was set up by ex-professional players to support abuse survivors.

Mr Unsworth said: "We stand before you today as men united in justice, but this is about so much more than us."

Mr Fallon, who was targeted by Bennell at Crewe, said: "We stand before you today as men united but, at the same time, we were very young boys. We were little boys with a dream and our innocence was shattered. Our dreams turned into the most horrendous nightmare."

Prosecutors described Bennell as a "predatory paedophile" who abused boys on an "industrial


scale".

They told the trial he had a "power hold" over the aspiring professional players.

Boys were abused at his home - including a property in Derbyshire where he had arcade games and a puma and a monkey - on trips away, and in his car on the way to and from training, they said.

Det Insp Sarah Oliver, who led the investigation, said Bennell had betrayed the trust of the young players.

"As a football coach he should have provided nothing more than safety and support for the players in his care," she

said.

"Instead he abused the trust of their families who had placed them into that care

so they could pursue their dreams of being professional footballers. He has shattered those dreams and left them burdened for decades."

## Oxfam facing loss of government support after sexual abuse revelations

More than 1,200 people have cancelled their monthly donations to Oxfam in response to revelations that its aid workers hired prostitutes for sex parties in Haiti while caring for victims of the 2010 earthquake.

Oxfam's director in the country at the time, Roland van Hauwermeiren, invited prostitutes to a hilltop villa rented for him by the charity; another property was used by aid workers for parties described by one insider as

"young meat barbecues" resembling a "full-on Caligula orgy". An Oxfam internal report admits that some of the women may have been underage. An investigation by The Times has shown that the charity tried to hush up the scandal by allowing van Hauwermeiren to make a "dignified exit"; he went on to lead an Action Against Hunger mission in Bangladesh.

Oxfam, which received £32m from the Government last year, could lose all state

support, said International Development Secretary Penny Mordaunt, if it failed to clean up its act. Oxfam has denied any intentional cover-up, but its deputy CEO, Penny Lawrence, has now submitted her resignation.

## What the editorials said

"An organisation once admired for its moral probity stands accused of the rankest hypocrisy," said *The Times*. Oxfam workers "abused the misfortune" of the very

people they were meant to be helping in the aftermath of a catastrophe that had left some 220,000 dead. It then let the senior culprit leave quietly, and (despite prostitution being a crime in Haiti) didn't even inform the Haitian police. Nor was this a single "aberration": last year, claims of sexual harassment were brought against no fewer than seven of Oxfam's 37 country directors. The fact Oxfam kept details of this affair secret, announcing only unspecified staff

"misconduct" to explain the sackings, makes matter worse, said the *Daily Mail*. What a "grotesque betrayal" of the principles that inspired Oxfam's founding fathers 76 years ago.

We shouldn't be surprised by all this, said Shaista Aziz in *The Guardian*. I spent more than 15 years working for aid agencies, Oxfam included, and met plenty of "brilliant people", but I also had to put up with a culture in which "bullying

was rife, women were frequently belittled and racism was casual". Yet any time I reported cases of abuse to my superiors, I was seen as the problem. Let's be grateful that the "floodgates are open" and the truth can now be told. But will it be, asked Andrew McLeod in the *Daily Mail*. The grim truth is "that jobs in international aid attract paedophiles and other predators who benefit from the power the aid industry confers on them".

**A PUB landlord threatened with legal action for keeping 15 golliwogs behind his bar has pledged to keep the display.**

Chris Ryley and wife Benice have run The White Hart in Grays, Essex, for 12 years and say many of the dolls are gifts from customers. The couple were shocked to receive a call from Thurrock Council asking them to remove the gollies after an anonymous complainant said the display constituted a hate crime. They now face a wait to see whether their licence will be affected but remain defiant and claim they have had many messages of support. The couple believe the complaint was from a council worker who came in for lunch. They claim the same person

called the police to report a "racially-aggravated crime".

Mr Ryley, 59, said: "The head of licensing at the council phoned to tell me a complaint had been made and said the same person had also gone to the police. "He asked if I would consider taking them down. I was shocked. I told the council I would think about it but I cannot see how I have committed an offence so they are here to stay.

'two complaints'

"Since we have had them up behind the bar in the past three years, there have only ever been two complaints. "One was from a Canadian lady who said 'those would not be allowed back in my country' and another was from an Englishwoman.

"If the customers start complaining that would change my mind but it is our customers who brought most of them here for us as presents.

"My phone has been full of messages of support saying 'Save the golliwogs'."

Mrs Ryley, 56, said

she was upset at the complaint but backed her husband. She said: "For me, golliwogs are nothing to do with racism. "We will dig our heels in and will not be taking them down."

Local opinion was divided on social media. One person wrote:

"The landlord is a very nice man but I think it's obvious golliwogs belong to the past and will be offensive to a lot of people in this day and age." But a reply claimed: "People like you have created the namby-pamby society we now live in."

## UK recruitment agency 'sorry' for 'No British' job posting

**A recruitment agency has apologised to a man who was told he could not apply for a job "because he was British".**

Michael Fowler, from Salisbury, Wiltshire, was going for a HGV driving job advertised by Wolverhampton-based recruitment company Blu Global.

When he did, he received an email from a company employee informing him their positions "exclude British candidates".

Since it was first reported in the Salisbury Journal, Blu Global has now apologised to Mr Fowler.

The 39-year-old cited his 12 years of driving experience when he applied for the job earlier this month but was astonished at the

response.

Blu Global said it sent its "sincerest apologies for the appalling experience" adding it has taken disciplinary action against the individual responsible.

"We understand that you were informed by one of our European based freelance recruiters that the vacancy 'excluded' British applicants, this is not the policy of the company and we are shocked that this statement was ever made," the email said.

"No candidate is denied a chance of employment based on their nationality, age, race, gender or sexual orientation."

Mr Fowler said he has since got a job with another haulage company.

## Dentist left down in the mouth after large negligence payout

**A DENTIST has agreed to pay £33,500 compensation to a patient he treated for more than 20 years because he never warned that her teeth were beginning to decay.** She ended up needing serious treatment.

Tracy Braham, 39, visited Dr Peter Moss's dental surgery for regular check-ups between 1993 and 2015. But when she moved to a new practice after Dr Moss retired she was diagnosed with needing extensive root canal treatment, fillings and implants. Mrs Braham from Colne, Lancashire said: "He'd been my dentist since I was 15 and I

completely trusted him. I had some fillings and root canal treatments over the years, and in hindsight they always ended up

needing to be repeated." In November the dentist paid £33,500 in an out-of-court settlement, without admitting any liability.

## Where the Wild Cherries Grow: sink your teeth in



### ■ Exclusive interview with author Laura Madeleine discussing her absorbing new novel about a woman in France haunted by memories of WW1

**"I love the detective work of research, of delving deeper and deeper into a topic," says *Where the Wild Cherries Grow* author Laura Madeleine.**

"The kernel of Emeline's story actually came from a story my mum told me about her godmother. Aunt Mimi, as my mum called her, was engaged to a young man who was sent to France to fight during the First World War. Mimi was an accomplished guitarist, and one night, in the middle of a concert to raise money for wounded soldiers,

she looked down at her hands and thought, just for a moment, they were covered in blood. She said she knew in that moment that her fiancé had been hurt and would die. It was true. He'd been wounded in an attack and died on a hospital train two days later."

It's 1919 and Emeline Vane has lost much due to the war. Desperate to escape, she runs away. Emeline takes a train and ends up in a tiny seaside village in the South of France. Maman, the owner of a café, takes her in. Emeline learns that her secret follows her. Fifty years later, a young solicitor Bill Perch finds Emeline's diary. It leads him on a journey to find out what happened to Emeline.

"Her story brought with it the idea of a young woman, robbed of all certainty by the conflict,

as well as a notion of the many women who were, and are, scarred by war emotionally, internally, battling alone in parlours, kitchens and bedrooms," says Madeleine.

"The character of Bill, on the other hand, has his roots a lot closer to home. He basically is my father. My dad was also a working-class lad from Essex, who struggled to find his place before going off on his own, quite different, adventure."

Madeleine did most of her reading research for *Where the Wild Cherries Grow* online. "I'm eternally indebted to the Internet Archive, and to Project Gutenberg. Being able to download 100-year-old, obscure, out-of-print titles as word-searchable ePubs is an absolute joy. I prefer primary sources: letters, diaries, newspaper articles. I read everything

from turn-of-the-century travel guides, to the collected letters of Katherine Mansfield, to the first ever Catalan recipe book, the medieval *Book of Sent Sovi*. I also read more modern works, like Colman Andrews' invaluable *Catalan Cuisine*. W.G. Sebald is a big influence on me, especially *The Rings of Saturn*, in this instance."

For research, Madeleine visited Cerbère with her mother, who speaks fluent French. "We took the train from London to Paris, and then an overnight sleeper from the Gare d'Austerlitz all the way to the south. It wasn't glamorous, but it was wonderfully exciting. It was early April, and Paris was grey and cold when we left, but when I woke up at dawn and looked out of the train window, I saw

the Pyrénées-Orientales rising in the distance, the sun hitting their peaks. Wild irises grew along the tracks, terraces of vines marched down the hills, dotted with white houses and cypress trees. It felt like another world."

Madeleine has written many historical books under pseudonyms. She has a new book out in the UK called *The Secrets Between Us*, set in the Alpes-Maritimes during the period of Italian Occupied France in 1943. Released as an ebook on January 1st, coming out in paperback in April 2018.

Madeleine is currently writing her fourth book for Transworld, another dual-narrative novel, this time set between the 1920s and 1970s in Cordoba and Tangier.

Madeleine is based in Bristol. She was born in Windsor and lived in

A close source revealed: "It's a light-hearted feel-good comedy set in the gardening world and focusing on the Chelsea Flower Show.



## McLeish back as Scotland boss

Alex McLeish has agreed to become Scotland manager for the second time - 11 years after leaving the post.

McLeish, 59, will sign a deal until 2020 and is the unanimous choice of the Scottish FA board.

He replaces his former Aberdeen and Scotland team-mate Gordon Strachan, who left in October after the country did not qualify for the

World Cup.

The Scottish FA failed in its attempt to recruit Michael O'Neill, who instead chose to stay with Northern Ireland.

Walter Smith was also linked with the role, but ruled himself out of a return to the job he held for three years before leaving for Rangers in 2007.

McLeish's first games in charge will be against

Costa Rica and Hungary next month, followed by further friendly matches in Peru in May and Mexico in June.

His debut competitive games will be the Uefa Nations League encounters against Albania at home on 10 September, then in Israel on 11 October.

Scotland have not reached a major finals since the 1998 World Cup in France and the Scottish FA is currently looking for a new chief executive to replace Stewart Regan.

McLeish, who won 77 caps for his country, told BBC Scotland in December that "the national job is something that would interest me"

and that he still has "a lot to give the game".

His appointment was officially announced on Friday morning.

McLeish succeeded Smith midway through the Euro 2008 qualifying campaign and came within one game of reaching those finals, only to lose to Italy.

However, after winning seven of his 10 games in charge, McLeish left for Birmingham City.

While there, he led the Blues to promotion to the English top flight and the 2011 League Cup.

Before that, he managed Motherwell, got Hibernian promoted, and won seven trophies - including two league titles - during a near five-year spell with Rangers.

Since leaving Birmingham in 2011, he has managed Aston Villa, Nottingham Forest, Genk in Belgium and Egyptian club Zamalek.

Sunderland and Hibernian will pay tribute to former midfielder Liam Miller before their games this weekend.

The 36-year-old Irishman died last week following a battle with pancreatic cancer and two of his former clubs will hold a minute's applause before their games against Brentford and Aberdeen, respectively.

Miller played 60 times for Sunderland and represented Hibs on 72 occasions during his career.

"At this sad time we would like to pay our respects and show our appreciation together - club and fans - along with our visitors from Brentford," Sunderland chief executive Martin Bain told the club's official website.

## Cahill's tribute to Ryan Mason

Gary Cahill has offered his condolences to Ryan Mason after the midfielder was forced to retire from football on medical advice following the head injury he suffered during Hull City's Premier League match at Chelsea in January 2017.

Mason, 26, sustained a fractured skull in a clash of heads with Cahill while defending a corner during his team's defeat and subsequently received treatment for around nine minutes on the Stamford Bridge pitch. He had surgery at St Mary's Hospital in London and was released eight days later but has since struggled with his recovery, admitting he had "no option" but to retire.

"Devastated to hear today's news from Ryan," read a statement from England defender Cahill on his Twitter account. "Competing for a corner is something we've done thousands of times and to see those consequences for a top professional like Ryan is heartbreaking. Sending all my love to him and his family, and wishing him the best for the future."

Mason – who was capped once by England against Italy in 2015 – was inundated with good luck messages on social media after confirming that his career is over.

"I have worked tirelessly in order to be able to return to the pitch," he said in a statement released on his Instagram account. "Unfortunately, having taken expert medical advice, I now have no option but to retire due to the risks involved given the nature of my injury."

Hull City added: "Ryan has sought the guidance of numerous world-renowned neurologists and neurosurgeons who have all advised that a return to competitive football is not advised."

# Spurs comeback stuns Old Lady

Tottenham produced a brilliant comeback to draw at Juventus after a disastrous start to their Champions League last-16 first leg in Turin on Tuesday night.

Mauricio Pochettino's side were 2-0 down inside 10 minutes after Gonzalo Higuain followed up a sumptuous volley with a penalty, awarded for Ben Davies' foul on Federico Bernardeschi.

Harry Kane started the fightback after rounding Gianluigi Buffon following Dele Alli's threaded pass and Higuain then missed a penalty for the hosts with the last kick of the first half, following Serge Aurier's poor challenge on Douglas Costa.

Spurs dominated possession against the Italian champions and got their reward when Christian Eriksen's low free-kick evaded Buffon to give Spurs the edge going into the second leg at Wembley on 7 March.

Spurs remain unbeaten since 16 December, and Pochettino said: "We are more mature. The team is growing and have stepped up in this aspect. I think the team was amazing in the way they reacted."

In a pulsating game, Tottenham were a goal behind inside two minutes after Miralem Pjanic's chipped free-kick caught out the visitors' defence and Higuain beat Hugo Lloris with a first-time finish.

Spurs looked anxious and their evening went from bad to worse when Higuain doubled the lead from the spot after Davies brought down Bernardeschi.

But the Premier League side then produced a comeback that will live long in the memory of their travelling supporters.

First Kane had a header saved from inside the six-yard box by Buffon, but the England striker was not to be denied for long, beating the veteran with a composed finish after Alli's pass.

The turning point arrived on the stroke of half-time when Higuain hit the bar from the penalty spot.

Lloris produced a fine save from Bernardeschi after the interval but Tottenham got the reward their hard-work deserved when Eriksen scored from a set-piece after Dele was fouled by the veteran Chiellini on the edge of the Juve box.

Tottenham are now unbeaten in 13 league and cup games, as the business end of the season looms.

Thursday night's game was played in -4C temperatures on a 4G plastic pitch at the Jamtkraft Arena, but the visitors made light of alien conditions to win comfortably.

Left-back Nacho Monreal scored the Gunners' first from close range when Ostersunds goalkeeper Aly Keita fumbled Alex Iwobi's strike.

Then the home side's centre-back Sotirios Papagiannopoulos

diverted Henrikh Mkhitaryan's cross into his own net after the Armenian seized on a loose pass.

Ostersunds improved after the break but any prospect of a revival was ended by Mesut Ozil, who made a well-timed run into the area and squeezed his shot past Keita for the third, before the hosts had a late penalty saved.

"I think we adapted quite well to the pitch," Wenger said after the game. "[Ostersunds] were maybe a bit cautious at the start and we took advantage of it.

Arsenal host the second leg of the last-32 tie at Emirates Stadium on Thursday.

Sane, who had initially been ruled out for six weeks with an ankle injury sustained in City's FA Cup win

over Cardiff on 28 January, came on for Sterling, while Silva made his return from a hip injury as a 62nd-minute replacement for De Bruyne.

In defence, Fabian Delph returned to left-back after missing the last six games with a knee injury, while captain Vincent Kompany played his first Champions League game since May 2016.

This strength in depth will be crucial as the Premier League leaders continue to chase a historic quadruple.

# REDS UNSTOPPABLE!

## Five star Liverpool leave Porto shell-shocked

Sadio Mane scored a hat-trick as Liverpool marked their first Champions League knockout game for nine years with an emphatic 5-0 victory at Porto in their Champions League last-16 first-leg tie Wednesday night.

Mane opened the scoring when home goalkeeper Jose Sa failed to hold his placed strike.

Mohamed Salah then showed wonderful composure to steer the ball home for Liverpool's second and his 30th of an incredible debut season at the club.

With two away goals scored, the visitors could have been forgiven for taking a more conservative approach but instead they went for more.

A swift Liverpool counter-attack ended with Sa spilling Roberto Firmino's shot into Mane's path and the striker made no mistake, before Firmino scored his 21st of the season, sweeping home James Milner's cross.

Mane got his third with a driven strike late on to become the first Liverpool player to score a hat-trick away from home in Europe since Michael Owen in 2002, and the second ever.

Porto had lost only two matches in all competitions this season prior to Wednesday's game but simply could not cope with Liverpool's unstoppable forward line.

Otavio had the Portuguese side's best chance towards the end of the first half, placing his shot just wide of the far post after he was put through on goal.

Liverpool will expect to complete the job when they host Porto in the return leg at Anfield on Tuesday, 6 March.

Liverpool boast a proud record in continental football having won the European Cup or Champions League five times - more than any other English side.

But this was their first involvement in the knockout stages of the competition since 2009, when they lost 7-5 on aggregate to Chelsea in the quarter-finals.

And it was like they had never been away as they made light work of a side that reached this stage of the competition last season and were quarter-finalists just three years ago.

Only PSG (25) scored more goals than Liverpool

(23) in the Champions League group stages and the Reds picked up where they had left off in December as their front three proved too much for a nervous Porto defence.

The hosts ultimately became the latest side unable to cope with Liverpool's pace on the counter-attack. This was the 17th time Liverpool had scored three goals or more in a game this season and the 10th time they have done it away from home.

They have also now scored more Champions League goals this season (28) than any other club and, on this evidence, are going to take some stopping in the competition.

Not surprisingly Liverpool boss Jurgen Klopp was all smiles after the game, telling reporters: "It was a very good performance. Exactly as good as necessary."

"I think everyone saw in the game all the moments when we were not as compact as we wanted to be and Porto were immediately strong. They had their moments and we scored fantastic goals in the right moment."

## ...and City make it look easy, too

Manchester City boss Pep Guardiola praised "extraordinary" Ilkay Gundogan as his side took a giant step towards the Champions League quarter-finals with a comfortable 4-0 win at Basel on Tuesday night.

City took command of the last-16 first-leg tie within half an hour in Switzerland as Gundogan, Bernardo Silva and Sergio Aguero all scored within a nine-minute period.

German Gundogan, who returned from a nine-month injury lay-off in September, added his side's fourth - and his second - 10 minutes after the break.

"Ilkay Gundogan is an extraordinary player. Last season we missed him a lot with injury for six months and that's why we are so satisfied, not just the quality but personality to play," Guardiola told BT Sport.

Gundogan put City

in front on 14 minutes, heading in Kevin de Bruyne's corner at the near post.


Four minutes later Silva doubled the lead, cushioning Raheem Sterling's cross on his chest before firing a volley at Basel keeper Tomas Vaclik, who could only tip the ball into his own net.

Aguero then scored his 29th of the season and his 198th for City in the
