# WORST SNOW FOR 30 YEARS

## ■ Four dead, widespread travel chaos and worse to come as Arctic storm tightens grip

**FRIGID BRITAIN** was left shivering by one of the worst winter storms in living memory this week as it was hit by a double whammy of a polar vortex and a huge front of moist air.

First on the scene was the so-called "Beast From The East", a polar vortex of exceptionally cold air, which originated in the Arctic before barreling into Western Europe on Monday, bringing prolonged blizzards and freezing temperatures. But as the snowfall began to ease, the misery increased with the arrival of Storm Emma, a large front of moist air arriving from the southwest. As the two fronts collided, Britain was hammered by its heaviest snowfall in years with temperatures dipping as low as -15c.

At least six people had died as a result of the

weather at press time and experts predict this winter's long big freeze could cause the highest death toll for 20 years. A car crash in Lincolnshire on Tuesday caused the deaths of three people. A fourth person died after a three-car collision near Peterborough, in Cambridgeshire. There were 20 collisions within three hours on Lincolnshire's roads including one involving a school bus with 45 pupils on board, police said. The children were unharmed after the bus collided with a car and veered off an icy road near Deeping St James.

Heavy snow affected railway services leading to delays and cancellations while British Airways cancelled dozens of flights. Southeastern cancelled train journeys to London St Pancras, London Victoria and Cannon Street, with Southern, Greater Anglia and Great Northern services all disrupted. Forecasters warned

Storm Emma, due to hit on Thursday night, would bring misery to "millions more of us". It was expected to sweep a huge volume of moisture in from the Atlantic bringing the "worst freezing event for years".

Sara Thornton, director of digital weather service weathertrending, said: "The Beast from the East will tighten its grip as the

week goes on.

"Gale-force winds and super-cooled freezing rain could turn parts of the UK into an ice rink by the weekend.

### 'lethal glaze'

"So far the north and east of the country have borne the brunt of the snow, but now the arrival of Storm Emma will bring the white stuff to millions

more of us on Friday.

"Gales will come with the snow, bringing blizzard conditions to some southern and western parts of the UK that have so far been spared the snow.

"Some places could receive a foot of powdery snow, which could blow into much deeper drifts. Driving conditions will be **cont. on page 2, col. 1**

positively dangerous, with widespread transport and communication disruption expected.

"The danger will be greatest in areas that see warmer air tussling with the big freeze. Here we're likely to see super chilled water fall as rain – only to freeze instantly as it hits the ground.

"The result could be an invisible, lethal glaze on roads and pavements."

When it collided with freezing temperatures of the Arctic front, it dumped huge amounts of snow onto Britain, causing two food drifts in places.

According to Simon Clark, researcher of stratosphere-troposphere interactions in Bristol, the current cold snap was triggered by a disruption to the stratospheric polar vortex -- a doughnut of air 3,800 miles across that forms high up in the atmosphere above the Arctic Circle every winter.

Now and again - perhaps six times every decade - the vortex gets split in two, a phenomenon known as sudden stratospheric warming. The disruption allows icy Arctic air to spread further south, often lowering temperatures across much of the northern hemisphere.

"That big mass of Arctic air -- which is normally trapped over the poles, so it's really freezing cold --

is then able to spill further south," Clark told CNN.

Conditions are expected to improve by the end of the weekend, but average temperatures across the UK could remain lower than normal over the next month as the polar air gradually returns to the Arctic.

Clark expects Europe to feel the effects of

disruptions to the vortex more often as the global climate continues to warm.

"It's very difficult to say for sure whether this one event was caused by climate change," he said, "but as the climate warms, we expect the polar vortex to get weaker... We will then see more of these sudden warmings."

## Stay inside till it's over, Britons urged

**BRITONS have been urged to say in their homes if possible to ride out the worst of this week's winter weather as snow and ice caused havoc with transportation networks.**

Flights were cancelled at London City, Glasgow and Newcastle airports with more than 100 grounded at London's Heathrow on Wednesday and most railway operators were hit leading to long delays and cancellations on Britain's train networks. More than 4,000 schools across the nation were closed Wednesday due to the bad weather closures in many areas expect to continue to the weekend.

Met Office chief forecaster Andy Page said roads blocked from Cornwall to northern Scotland with rural communities especially hard hit -- some being cut off for days.

Freezing conditions and blizzards have also knocked out power supplies in several areas with disruption to mobile phone signals also possible, he said.

Britain is facing the longest cold snap in decades with freezing temperatures set to hold out until mid-March in parts, the Met Office said. The severe weather is being driven by a "sudden stratospheric warming" of air over the North Pole. Met Office meteorologist Frank Saunders, said: "Parts of England and Wales are likely to see their coldest spell of weather since at least 2013, and possibly since 1991."

Health officials have reiterated warnings to take extra care with the weather likely to cause a surge in winter deaths. Exacta Weather forecaster James Madden said: "We are experiencing a severe

snow event with further downpours forecast through the rest of the week. "Nowhere is going to escape the very heavy showers, it is not unreasonable to expect a couple of feet of snow to settle, there could be even more with drifting. "We are looking at one of the worst snow events in South certainly since 2010 but we could have to go as far back as 1991 to see something on a similar scale."

Malcolm Booth, chief executive of the National Federation of Occupational Pensioners, said: "We would urge people to stock up now before the weather gets too bad and it becomes dangerous to get out and about."

Temperatures plunged to -8.9C (16F) in Hampshire on Monday night and lows of -15C were recorded in several locations during the week.

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# Farage wants job linking up with 'friendly' Trump

■ Former UKIP leader revels in hero's welcome at CPAC

**NIGEL Farage has called on Theresa May to give him a role in helping to build relations with the US after he rekindled his friendship with Donald Trump.**

The former Ukip leader has just completed a three-day trip to Washington where he and the US President traded political gossip and discussed Brexit. The two met at the Conservative Political Action conference where they were snapped together having a drink after Mr Trump's big speech.

Mr Farage said: "He just came off stage and

said, 'Hey!' It was very friendly and jolly. He's a very loyal man. "In public you're now seeing the Donald Trump I know in private.

"It was the first time he made a self-deprecating remark about his hair.

"My impression is he's really enjoying the presidency."

**'fantastic connections'**

Mr Farage said that the US President is "very curious" about British politics.

"He's very interested in Brexit, he believed in Brexit. He's watching the Brexit process very carefully." Two concerns

were apparently raised over the proposed UK/US trade deal and Mr Trump's State visit.

"The basic question is, how long is this all going to take?" said Mr Farage. He also discussed free-trade deals with US Commercial Secretary Wilbur Ross and met Education Secretary Betsy DeVos. And he held talks with three influential White House advisers – John Kelly, Kellyanne Conway and Stephen Miller.

Previously, Mr Trump has suggested that the former Ukip leader should be Britain's ambassador to the US. In

a message clearly aimed at the Prime Minister, Mr Farage said: "I've got fantastic connections and friendships

with this presidency. "Surely I could be of use somehow?" But – explaining that he is uncertain when he will

return to Washington – he implied that he felt it was unlikely he would receive a call from Mrs May any time soon.

## Asthma girl, 5, died after GP sent her away for being five minutes late

**A CORONER has slammed a GPs' surgery for the "unacceptable" treatment of a girl who died after being refused an emergency appointment because she was five minutes late.**

Five-year-old asthma sufferer EllieMay Clark was given the appointment after being carried home from school wheezing. Ellie-May was rushed to hospital in an ambulance later that night after an asthma attack but died shortly after, an inquest heard on Monday.

GP Dr Joanne Rowe had previously received a letter from a consultant warning that the youngster was at risk of "an episode of severe or life-threatening asthma", the hearing at Newport, South Wales was told. Despite the letter, Dr Rowe did not ask the reason behind her emergency appointment or look into her medical notes before refusing to see her.

On Monday, Gwent senior coroner Wendy James recorded a narrative

conclusion and said it was "not acceptable" for Ellie-May to have been turned away without any clinical assessment or advice for what to do if her condition worsened. She added: "Ellie-May Clark died of

natural causes where the opportunity to provide potentially life-saving treatment was missed."

After the ruling, grieving mother Shanice Clark, of Newport, hit out at the inquest findings. She said:

"I'm disappointed that the coroner ruled out neglect. "I will have to live with the fact that my little girl was sent home to die by a doctor who refused to see her because we were a few minutes late.

"I want justice for Ellie-May and I want to make sure this doesn't happen to another child somewhere else. "I'm glad the doctor has apologised – it was nice of her – but I've waited three years for that."

Earlier, the inquest heard Ms Clark made a 5pm appointment on January 25, 2015 after her daughter was

carried home from school wheezing. They arrived at the Grange Clinic in Newport five minutes late then waited in a queue at the reception desk for at least another five minutes. After a brief conversation with Dr Rowe, a receptionist told Ms Clark she had breached the surgery's 10-minute rule for lateness and should return the next day. Miss Clark said she checked on her daughter frequently that evening and when she found her in the throes of an attack rang 999 immediately. She tried to give Ellie-May her inhaler but the child

couldn't take it. The inquest heard Dr Rowe could have asked another doctor to see Ellie-May, or have seen her after her patient had left and could have spoken to the doctor who arranged the emergency appointment for her. When asked why she had not done so, she replied: "I don't know. I was busy seeing to the other patient that I had with me."

She said she would have acted differently if she had seen Ellie-May's notes or known the reason for the appointment. Dr Rowe received a warning from the General Medical Council.

# Charles will have to fly solo on tour of Oz

■ Aides admitted that Camilla, 70, refused because join Prince onn Tour because 'she' does not like flying'

The Duchess of Cornwall will not accompany Prince Charles on a royal tour around Australia to avoid internal flights because she is scared of flying.

She will travel to Brisbane with her husband for the Commonwealth Games opening on April 4 but will leave three days later - dodging a four-day trip that would have involved several flights between Vanuatu, Cairns, Gove and Darwin.

Clarence House denied the decision by Camilla, who turned 70 last year, is a snub to the Queen's subjects in Australia.

A spokesman said: 'It's quite a gruelling tour, with some fantastic places for the prince to visit. Her last tour there was in 2013.

'She is going to the Games, which she regards as a very important part of it.'

Asked whether she should only go for two days, the spokesman added: 'Better than not.

She decided a few weeks ago to firm up her plans. We were always looking at the Duchess coming.

'There are no health reasons [for her pulling out after two days]. She is as fit as a flea. The Duchess does not like flying but I think she sometimes has to embrace that fear and get on with it.'

Charles will continue the tour alone for a further four days on a schedule that will require lots of internal flights.

## sensitive time

He will travel on to the Pacific nation of Vanuatu, before returning to Australia - where his mother is head of state - to visit Cairns, Gove and Darwin, and making his own way back to the UK.

The couple's visit comes at a sensitive time, just days before the high-profile Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) in London, attended by the Queen.

Buckingham Palace has in recent years been canvassing hard for Charles to inherit his mother's title as head of the Commonwealth.

As London may be the last time the elderly monarch will attend the biannual gathering of its 52 members, it is anticipated the meeting will be used as an opportunity to ratify the prince as her successor.

Which is why courtiers believe that it is vital for Charles and Camilla, as his consort, to put on a united front Down Under.

A spokeswoman for the duchess admitted yesterday that she had only recently decided to attend the Games after weeks of speculation in Australia, but insisted that she should be applauded for going despite her well-known fear of flying.

She said: 'The Duchess has always wanted to go to the Commonwealth Games but she was taking a little longer to

decide what the rest of the programme was going to be and what the rest of her programme this year was going to be.

'We have got CHOGM, the Prince of Wales's birthday, their spring tour... so she is going to return after the Commonwealth Games as that would be the natural point to return home.'

The couple's trip will be paid for by the Australia

Government.

Charles and Camilla will travel out on commercial flights to Singapore, where they will be picked up by an Australian Royal Air Force plane.

Camilla will then travel back to London from Australia on another commercial flight.

Charles's visit to Vanuatu, a remote Pacific archipelago, will be welcomed by the villagers on the island of Tanna,

who believe Prince Philip is descended from one of their spirit ancestors.

The cult which has grown around the Duke of Edinburgh - called the Prince Philip Movement - is believed to date from 1974, when he and the Queen visited Vanuatu on the Royal yacht Britannia.

Some villagers on Tanna have decorated a shrine with framed portraits of Prince Philip draped with the Union Flag.

# Younger girlfriend dumps two-timing McGregor

EWAN MCGREGOR'S love life has been much reported on in the British press this week amid reports the actor has been dumped by his much younger girlfriend and the star is now desperate to reconcile with his wife.

But that's the first the former Mrs. McGregor has heard of it.

Reacting to the supposed split, McGregor's wife of 22 years, Eve Mavrakis, took to social media to say: "No, I hadn't heard. I really don't know," suggesting it's news to her and quite possibly the four daughters they share together too.

It comes on the back of Ewan leaving her for his Fargo co-star Mary

Elizabeth Winstead, with rumours of a relationship surfacing after the pair were seen kissing. Then came a bizarre acceptance speech at last month's Golden Globes when the 46-year-old thanked both Mary and Eve individually as he took to the stage to pick up his Best Actor In A Mini Series gong. According to a US publication the 33-year-old decided to call time on the relationship because "Mary hated being labelled a home wrecker and the embarrassment it caused her.

"It's sad because a year ago Ewan and his wife were in great shape and then he decided to throw it all away for

Mary. Now it looks like he's lost them both for good".

Ewan is believed to have cited irreconcilable differences when filing for divorce from Eve last month. And according to US website

# Film veteran Lewis Gilbert dead at 97

■ British director best known for helming Alfie and a trio of Bond flicks

**Lewis Gilbert, the British director of a string of celebrated films including the 1966 Michael Caine hit Alfie and The Spy Who Loved Me, arguably the high point of the Roger Moore James Bond era, has died aged 97.**

Bond producers Michael G Wilson and Barbara Broccoli confirmed Gilbert's death in a statement. "It is with great sadness that we learn of the passing of our dear friend Lewis Gilbert," they said. "Lewis was a true gentleman. He made an enormous contribution to the British film industry as well as the Bond films, directing You Only Live Twice, The Spy Who Loved Me and Moonraker. His films are not only loved by us but are considered classics within the series. He will be sorely missed."

## documentaries

Gilbert was born in Hackney in 1920 into a family of music hall artistes, and became a child actor in the 1930s, appearing in Dick Turpin and two Alexander Korda produced films, Over the Moon and The Divorce of Lady X. However his interest lay more in behind the camera roles, and while he was appearing with Laurence Olivier in The Divorce of Lady X (1938) Korda, the producer, offered to send him to Rada. Gilbert replied that he would rather direct and so was sent to Korda's Denham studios in Buckinghamshire as a third assistant director. He graduated up the scale, working with Alfred Hitchcock on Jamaica Inn (1939) – "He was the man I learned the most from" – and with a variety of studios, eventually becoming a first assistant.

He cut his teeth making documentaries during the war, attached to

the US Air Corps Film Unit, and broke into low-budget features after he was demobbed. Emergency Call, from 1952, was considered his breakthrough, allowing him to command bigger budgets and more expensive material. Reach for the Sky, the biopic of double amputee air ace Douglas Bader made a particular impact, as Gilbert profited from the burgeoning interest in heroic stories about the second world war. Carve Her Name With Pride (1958) and Sink the Bismarck! (1960) followed in a similar vein.

Gilbert's career stepped up another level in 1966 with the release of Alfie, adapted from a play by Bill Naughton about a working-class romeo. Not only did Alfie make a star of Michael Caine as well as a box-office success, but it was a critical and awards darling (winning the Jury prize at Cannes and receiving five Oscar nominations) as well as being at the cutting edge of the swinging 60s. As Gilbert later wrote in the Guardian, Alfie "had a big effect on my career. I was offered everything; I was flavour of the month in Hollywood."

## 'a decent fellow'

Gilbert progressed straight on to the James Bond franchise, hired to direct You Only Live Twice in 1967, with scriptwriter Roald Dahl praising him as "a decent fellow" and for not interfering too much in the writing process. "What I admired so much about Lewis Gilbert was that he just took the screenplay and shot it. That's the way to direct: You either trust your writer or you don't."

Gilbert returned to Bond with The Spy Who Loved Me, in 1977 and Moonraker in 1979, which capitalised on the recent

publicity for the newly developed space shuttle, and sent Bond into orbit. Gilbert's highlights in the 1980s were both based on plays by Willy Russell: Educating Rita, for which Gilbert

reunited with Caine alongside successful TV comic Julie Walters in her feature film debut, and Shirley Valentine, starring Pauline Collins as the housewife who has a mid-life rejuvenation.

Gilbert continued to work into his 80s, with Walters also featuring in Gilbert's final directorial credit: Before You Go in 2002, about three sisters who reunite after their mother's death.

## Jaguar reveals first all-electric SUV

**Jaguar has revealed the production version of its first all-electric SUV as luxury carmakers race to go green.**

The I-Pace can reach 60mph in 4.5 seconds and has a range of almost 300 miles on a fully charged battery.

The vehicle is set to reach showrooms by July, potentially beating rival Audi's all-electric e-tron that is expected to be released "in the summer".

The I-Pace was designed in the UK but will be built in Austria.

It will go on display at the Geneva motor show

later this month and cost £63,495 in the UK.

The I-Pace can charge up to 85% of its battery from a public power point in 85 minutes and takes about two hours for a full charge.

The car is the first all-electric SUV since Tesla unveiled its Model X in 2015.

Luxury carmakers are keen to make inroads into the market for clean energy vehicles as demand for fossil-fuel powered models wanes.

Last year, the government announced that new diesel and petrol

cars and vans will be banned in the UK from 2040 in a bid to tackle air pollution.

Jaguar Land Rover said that every vehicle line it launches from 2020 will have an all-electric or hybrid version.

Germany's BMW is also planning all-electric models and hybrid vehicles and its first electric Mini will be released next year.

Jaguar said that its new I-Pace was inspired by its C-X75 supercar driven by the villainous Mr Hinx during a car chase in the James Bond film Spectre.

# From Craggy Island to Paradise Island

Television viewers first fell in love with Ardal O'Hanlon in 90's sitcom "Father Ted," where he played dimwit priest Father Dougal on cold Irish outpost Craggy Island. Now the popular actor is back on a rather sunnier island as the new star of sun-kissed detective series "Death in Paradise."

The wildly popular British show returns to US screens for a seventh series on KCET from March 5th with Ardal as Detective Inspector Jack Mooney, the latest police chief on the fictional Caribbean island of Saint Marie.

Despite frequent cast changes - Ben Miller and Kris Marshall previously had the lead role - the crime series has become one of the BBC's biggest global hits. Here Ardal,

51, talks about filming in Guadeloupe and what makes the show so popular

The scripts for each episode are full of twists. Do you ever guess correctly who the murderer is?

I'm a little bit rubbish at that; I'll be honest with you. The scripts are so ingenious and they're designed to dumbfound you so I've never quite guessed correctly. Just when I think I know who it is, the rug is always pulled out from under my feet at the last minute!

The 'whodunnit' element is a big part of the show. It's definitely one of the attractions of the show. I'd like to tell you that I know who the murderer is from page one but it's not true.

Why else do you think Death in Paradise has

become one of British TV's most popular shows?

It's a number of things. The show comes on at the start of the year when the audience are at their lowest ebb. It's after Christmas, they've no money left and they've broken all their resolutions.

They're not looking after themselves so then Death in Paradise comes on and there's beautiful scenery and the sun is shining. I think it cheers people up, to be honest with you. It's a gentle show; it's not trying to be provocative.

There's no violence. Instead there's humour, good character dynamics and interplay - and, like I say, people love trying to crack the mystery themselves.

What can we expect in this new series?

We've got some typically ingenious Death in

Paradise puzzles. For example, in one episode, a murder is committed at an international poker tournament. How does my character solve a case when the suspects are all professional bluffers? Jack, who claims he's never played poker in his life and he doesn't know the first thing about it, which may or may not be true, has to get into the mind of a poker player. That's always his style. He tries to put himself in the suspects' shoes so has to learn the rudimental

poker rules. Then that way he can figure out whose bluffing and who isn't.

What's it like filming in Guadeloupe? Do you ever get bored of the sunshine?

What were the biggest challenges you all faced during the shoot?

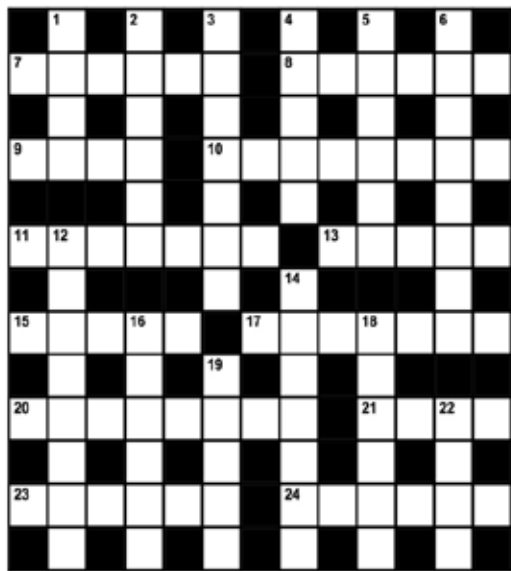

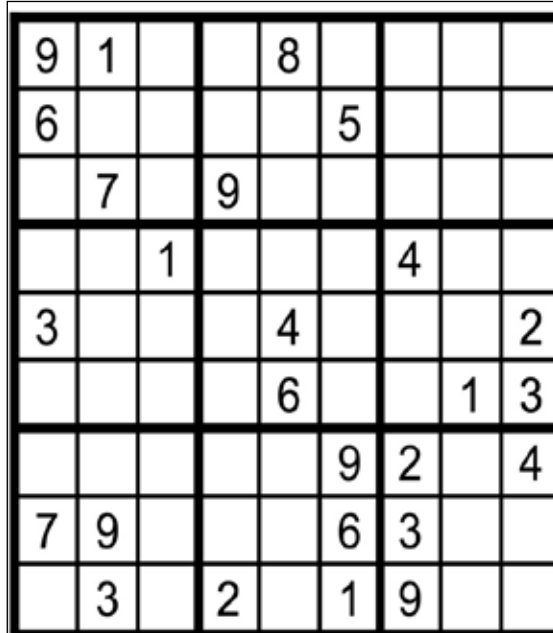

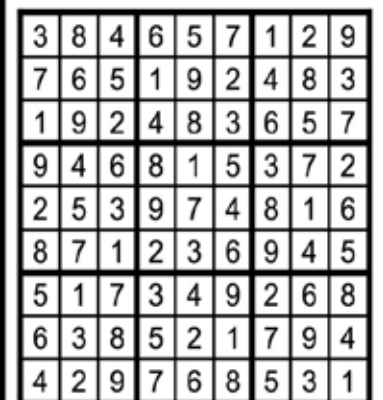

## England coach Jones finds Battle of Hastings tough to tolerate

**EDDIE JONES** says he was physically and verbally abused following England's Calcutta Cup defeat at the weekend.

Scotland upset a strong English team in the Six Nations tournament amid a fervent nationalist atmosphere and the England coach appeared to blame Scotland legend Gavin Hastings for sparking the trouble.

Jones was booed by Scotland fans post-match but that was nothing, he said, compared to the treatment he received on a train south from Edinburgh the day after.

Travelling standard class, Jones said he was jostled and baited and feared for his safety.

He referred to an interview Hastings had given in which the former Scotland full-back had said how much he would enjoy seeing Jones's face "rubbed in the dirt" after an England loss.

There was also a reference to the 'everyone hates the English' comment of Scotland prop Simon Berghan.

"If you're in a position of responsibility you've got to be careful what you say because if you talk about

hate and you talk about rubbing people's noses in the dirt, and all those sorts of things, it incites certain behaviours, and are they the sorts of behaviours we want to see?" said Jones.

No complaint was made to police. It was a sour end to a bad weekend for Jones, who was on his way to watch Manchester United play Chelsea in the company of another great Scot, Sir Alex Ferguson. He was able to help Jones rake over the coals of the shock loss. "He mentioned a lot of matches where things went wrong and a lot of the times you don't have a solution to it and that's the reality," said Jones.

"We all think we're clever but we're not so clever because our game's an inexact science. We don't have robots, we have human beings and on the day things can happen to people and we don't know why."

Back in camp in Oxford on Tuesday, Jones insisted there would be no wholesale changes, nor a redrawing of the

power-based tactical template which has taken England to No2 in the world.

"The question is whether I'm going to go away from the type of rugby we're playing and the answer is no," he said. "We don't have the athletic ability to do it.

"I'm not a magician, mate. I have them for 13 weeks a year. I can't suddenly make them more athletic. All I can do is work with them as well as we can and try to maximize the rugby out of the players we have."

He did acknowledge England had to be smarter against France. "We got caught at the breakdown area," he said. "We play a little differently to what the players are used to playing. We don't play a formation or a pattern. It involves more decision-making for them.

"That means it is more difficult to do. Sometimes we are not as

attentive to the decision-making as we need to be. "The problems we've got, I know we've got, and sometimes you can't fix them straight away, but there's no lack of attitude."

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# Spurs win in VAR-cical style



A TOUGH JOB MADE WORSE: Wednesday was a difficult night for Paul Tierney

THE VAR system was slammed as an "absolute shambles" on Wednesday night as Tottenham's FA Cup fifth-round replay with Rochdale fell into farce and controversy before Spurs won 6-1.

Erik Lamela had a sixth-minute goal ruled out following a foul by Fernando Llorente, after referee Paul Tierney consulted the video assistant. Then, after Son HeungMin put Spurs in front, Tierney gave them a 26th-minute penalty when VAR was used – but disallowed Son's spot-kick, and booked the South Korean after he stopped in his run-up – a move now outlawed by football authorities.

Bemused fans booed at

half-time and Spurs boss Mauricio Pochettino was left shaking his head.

Former Spurs player and BT Sport pundit Jermaine Jenas said: "It's an absolute shambles. "They have taken something that could be so good for the game and it's actually comical at times with the amount of time that it's taking and the fact that nobody knows what is going on. And today I actually think they have got something wrong, which is the worst part of it."

Five minutes were added on at the end of the first half and Mark Schwarzer, the ex-Chelsea keeper and BBC Radio 5 Live pundit, said: "There is utter bemusement around the stadium. And

it's just to do with the lack of clarity. With the penalty decision, we got the gist of that. That they were seeing if it was in the box or not.

"But we need some sort of indication. The decision not to give the penalty when the ball was in the net...a lot of people in the stadium wouldn't have known why."

Former Spurs and England star Gary Lineker, tweeted sarcastically: "VAR's going well."

Stephen Humphreys scored Rochdale's shock 31st -minute equaliser. But Spurs shook off the controversy to pull away after the break. Llorente hit a hat-trick, Son added his second and Kyle Walker-Peters completed the rout.

# Winter break decision edges closer

Plans are expected to be announced soon confirming a two-week winter break in February 2020 following discussions between The Football Association and Premier League.

The first annual two-week interval would be scheduled from the 2019-20 season and take place in the early part of the month, it has been proposed.

As a consequence, the fifth round of the FA Cup would take place in midweek and there would be no replays.

Premier League clubs would have at least 13 days without a match.

The break would be staggered, with five Premier League matches taking place on one weekend and five on another.

Winter breaks are already factored into schedules of the top leagues in Germany, France, Italy and Spain. However, they all take place between December and January, which is the busiest period for Premier League teams.

Manchester City manager Pep Guardiola said in January that the festive schedule was "killing" the players. Earlier in the season, his Manchester

United counterpart Jose Mourinho said the lack of a break was hampering English clubs' hopes in the Champions League.

But Newport County manager Michael Flynn, whose side earned a lucrative FA Cup replay at Tottenham this season, is wary of the impact removing replays could have on smaller teams.

"With the FA Cup games being played midweek and with no replays it's going to hit the smaller clubs a little bit harder," said Flynn. "If we couldn't have had that replay at Wembley, then it takes a lot of the romance out of football."

## ■ Front runners ease to 3-0 win at Emirates to heap more pressure on embattled Arsene Wenger

**Manchester City produced a scintillating performance to comprehensively beat Arsenal for the second time in five days on Thursday night and extend their lead at the top of the Premier League to 16 points.**

With just 10 games remaining, City need five victories to clinch the title.

"We are close. It's in our hands, we can't deny it," manager Pep Guardiola said.

"These are the last steps to be champions, you keep going until the end."

After beating the Gunners 3-0 in the Carabao Cup final on Sunday, City dominated in a toxic atmosphere at a half-full Emirates Stadium.

Bernardo Silva opened the scoring in the 15th minute, beautifully curling in a left-footed strike into the far corner after Leroy Sane's mazy run.

David Silva finished off a fine team move in the 28th minute for City's second before Sane did the same five minutes later.

Arsenal had the opportunity to cut the deficit shortly after half-time but Ederson saved Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang's penalty.

"We played with low confidence, you could see that at the start of the game and we paid for it," Arsenal boss Arsene Wenger said.

"We lost to a team that is the best in the country at the moment."

The result sees City pull further away from Manchester United at the top of the table and marks Guardiola's 100th game at the club with a win.

Arsenal, meanwhile, stay sixth, 10 points off the top four.

City were clinical on Sunday in securing Guardiola's first trophy at the club, although Wenger suggested the

game was closer than the 3-0 scoreline suggested.

At the Emirates, particularly in the first half, the City were at their free-flowing best and Wenger could have no complaints.

Sane dribbled past four defenders for the opening goal before Bernardo Silva's accurate finish and the hosts looked helpless in attempting to prevent the following two goals.

For the second, Sane, Sergio Aguero and David Silva combined brilliantly and the Spaniard calmly fired past Petr Cech.

The third then came at the end of a flowing move with Kyle Walker squaring to German Sane from in behind the left side of Arsenal's defence.
