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STAB CITY: London murder rate overtakes New York

■ 15 dead in February as capital surpasses Big Apple for first time

A surge of stabbings in London has been blamed for the city overtaking New York's monthly murder tally for the first time in modern history.

Fifteen people were murdered in London during February, compared to 14 in New York, according to police figures.

The capital also suffered 22 fatal stabbings and shootings in March, higher than the 21 in New York.

On Wednesday night, a 17-year-old girl died after being shot in Tottenham, north London, and a 16-year-old boy is fighting for his life after a separate shooting just kilometres away.

There were ten fatal stabbings in London in 19 days, following on from the 80 fatal stabbings recorded in the city last year.

London's murder rate has grown by nearly 40% in three years, while police figures show that New York's has fallen by 87% since 1990, raising pressure on Mayor Sadiq Khan and Metropolitan Police chief Cressida Dick.

Despite the recent surge, New York, which has a slightly smaller population than London,

has still suffered more murders since the start of the year.

A spike in violent crime in London saw more murders committed in the city in February and March than there were in New York, figures show.

So far in 2018, the Met Police has investigated 46 murders, compared with 50 in the US city.

But, while New York's murder rate decreased from the end of January, London's rose markedly from that point.

Ex-Met Police Ch Supt Leroy Logan says it is proof that "London's violent traits have become a virus".

City Hall says it is "deeply concerned" by knife crime in the capital, but, along with the Met Police, insists London "remains one of the safest [cities] in the world".

The Met said it was "concerned at the increase in murders in London".

"One murder is one too many, and we are working hard with our partners to understand the increase

and what we can all do to prevent these tragedies from happening in the first place," a spokesman said.

However, it is a murder rate that has left Mr Logan feeling "absolutely devastated".

The Met said it was "concerned at the increase in murders in London".

"One murder is one too many, and we are working

Pensioner held for 'murder' after stabbing burglar at his home

■ Parallels drawn to Tony Martin case

A pensioner has been arrested after a suspected burglar was killed during a violent tussle at his London home.

The 78-year-old was held on suspicion of murder after the 38-year-old died of his wounds in hospital in the early hours of Wednesday morning.

Police said the struggle broke out after the pensioner, named locally as Richard Osborn-Brooks, found two men inside his home in South Park, Hither Green, south London shortly after midnight.

One of the burglars, who was armed with a screwdriver, forced the homeowner into his kitchen while his accomplice went upstairs.

Detectives believe a struggle then took place between "one of the males and the homeowner" and the 38-year-old intruder was stabbed in the upper body.

He was later found collapsed in nearby Further Green Road by paramedics from London Ambulance Service, who took him to a central London hospital where

he died at 3.37am. Police were unable to confirm whether the suspect had been stabbed with the screwdriver.

The second suspect fled the scene before police arrived and is now being hunted by the Met's Homicide and Major Crime Command.

Gordon Williams, a local resident, said: "I could hear people moaning in the street and just thought it was someone drunk. I saw the body laid in the street and another guy jump in a van and leave. "I leaned over him and tried to reassure him. There was a lot of blood."

criminal damage

In a statement Scotland Yard said: "At 00:45hrs on Wednesday, 4 April, police were called by a homeowner to reports of a burglary in progress at an address in South Park Crescent, Hither Green SE6, and a man injured.

"The 78-year-old resident found two males inside the address. A struggle ensued between one of the males and the homeowner. The man, aged 37, sustained a stab

wound to the upper body."

The home owner suffered bruising to his arms and his injuries are not life threatening.

Police arrested him on suspicion of grievous bodily harm before then arresting him on suspicion of murder.

He was taken to a south London police station where he remained at press time.

In February alone there were 115 incidents of crime reported to police for the post code area covering South Park Crescent, including a number of burglaries close to the pensioner's home and a number of cases of criminal damage, vehicle theft and sexual violence.

The incident recalls the case of Tony Martin, a Norfolk farmer who was convicted of manslaughter after shooting a burglar he discovered in his home in 1999.

Mr Martin was initially convicted of murder, but this was later reduced to manslaughter on grounds of diminished responsibility.

Neighbours and victims' groups sprang to

the pensioner's defence.

Clem Williams, 58, a martial arts instructor who has lived on the road for 20 years said: "It's a very quiet road, normally we do not get police incidents down this road.

"My personal opinion is why were the men at his house? The man has a right to defend his home. They should let him go."

Sylbourne Sydail, chairman of the local neighborhood watch group, said: "A man should have the right and be able to defend their home. This reminds me of the Tony Martin case.

"We have done good work on the watch

including shutting down a brothel house and implementing metal gates to stop people walking down the alley ways. We're trying to make it safer."

Norman Brennan, a former police officer who represents victims' interests, said police were required to arrest the pensioner in order to investigate whether he had acted in self defence.

But he said he would be "amazed" if he was prosecuted over the death.

"The law says that a person can use reasonable force when defending himself, his family or property. If the intruder is

running away the threat has diminished but if that person stays where they are that's an assault and if they are armed with a weapon then it would be regarded as aggravating circumstances," said Mr Brennan.

He added: "I cannot see any jury convicting someone in a case where the householder, for example, takes a knife and in a struggle with the burglar injures him."

Another resident living in the street where the incident took place said: "I moved here because I thought it was a safe, nice, pleasant area but this is shocking."

communities."

The Met Police has launched 44 murder investigations in 2018, 31 of which have been as a result of stabbings.

The deaths of 47-year-old Laura Cecilia Navarrete De Figueira, from Twickenham, and her sons Claudio, 10, and Joaquin, seven, are part of the same Met Police murder investigation. She was found stabbed in London, while the boys were discovered dead, along with their father, at the foot of Birling Gap, in Sussex.

Croydon Central MP Sarah Jones, who chairs the

all-party parliamentary group on knife crime said that London could learn from New York in how to reduce violent crime.

"New York has been able to bring down serious violence through a public health approach," she said.

"We need a proper strategy that looks at all of the issues.

"Knife crime and violent crime acts like an epidemic, so you need to go in at the source to cut it off and then you need to inoculate the future young people against it.

"Going in at source means major intervention work with youth workers, inoculating means going into schools, changing the social norms, educating kids, teaching them what

it is to be a man, teaching them how they don't need to carry knives."

In February, the Met's Commissioner Cressida Dick visited police in Glasgow to learn about a public health approach which has seen murder rates in Scotland drop dramatically.

There are plans for Ms Dick to carry out more "fact-finding trips", in New York and with the West Midlands, Durham and Avon & Somerset forces.

Meanwhile, the government has launched a £1.35m campaign aimed at 10 to 21-year-olds.

The adverts to run across social media and digital channels feature stories of teenagers who have been stabbed.



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Supermarket chain bans plastic

■ Iceland becomes first grocer in the world to remove plastic packaging from ALL its own-label products

A UK supermarket will be the first in the world to remove plastic packaging from all of its own-label products.

Iceland's landmark move puts pressure on its rivals to follow suit amid public demands to turn back the tide of plastic pollution.

The company, which has more than 900 stores, has a five-year plan to ditch plastic from all of its own-brand products.

Packaging on 1,400 product lines will be replaced, and the changes involve more than 250 suppliers. First to go will be plastic ready meal trays in favour of wood-pulp alternatives made in Britain. Plastic bags used for frozen vegetables and other food will then

be dropped in favour of paper alternatives.

Iceland, which has already removed plastic disposable straws from its own range, is also working on alternatives for plastic bottles and milk cartons.

Last week Theresa May set a 25-year deadline to banish 'avoidable' plastic and called on supermarkets to introduce plastic-free aisles.

Iceland's move suggests it is possible to go further and faster.

Iceland managing director Richard Walker said: 'The world has woken up to the scourge of plastics.

'A truckload is entering our oceans every minute, causing untold damage to our marine environment

and ultimately humanity – since we all depend on the oceans for our survival.

'The onus is on retailers, as leading contributors to plastic packaging pollution and waste, to take a stand and deliver meaningful change.

'Other supermarkets, and the retail industry as a whole, should follow suit. This is a time for collaboration.'

The switch from plastic will cost Iceland money, but it pledged there will be no corresponding rise in prices.

The company's move comes amid mounting concern about the impact of plastic packaging on the environment, and follows news that China will no longer take British

waste plastic for recycling, meaning big business will have to clean up its own mess. In recent months the British media has highlighted the huge amount of excess plastic packaging used by high street stores, and turned the spotlight on waste and blight associated with bags, microbeads, bottles and plastic-lined coffee cups.

Iceland is harnessing the latest technology to create new plant-based 'green' packaging options, which are fully recyclable through household waste collections.

Its new ready meal trays are wood pulp rather than plastic, and although they will initially be coated with a thin layer of plastic, the supermarket giant plans to replace this with a water-based, non-plastic spray coating.

Iceland cannot dictate the packaging used by the big food brands it stocks, but it will encourage them to switch away from plastic.

Recently, some of retail's biggest figures, including former bosses of Tesco, Marks & Spencer, Asda and Debenhams, signed a statement calling for an end to throwaway plastic

packaging. They said: 'Over the past decade Britain's retailers have in the main focused on recycling in a bid to reduce the environmental impact of the plastic waste they produce.

'But we have to accept that this isn't enough – by recycling plastic, we are merely recycling the problem. It is therefore essential that retailers and packaging manufacturers work together to turn off the tap of throwaway packaging.'

Greenpeace executive

director John Sauven congratulated Iceland on 'its bold pledge', adding: 'It's now up to other retailers and food producers to respond to that challenge.

'The tidal wave of plastic pollution will only start to recede when they turn off the tap. They know the scale of systemic change we need, and yet their responses have been timid and piecemeal. Iceland has offered a more radical solution that shows the way forward for the sector.'

Return to Broadway a real treat, says Glenda Jackson

ACTING legend Glenda Jackson has revealed she is relishing her return to Broadway after three decades away.

The double Oscar winner and former Labour MP is earning rave reviews for her performance in *Three Tall Women* in New York. The 81-year-old called her latest role in the Edward Albee play "a treat" after the production opened last week. The veteran actress has now been tipped for a Tony Award – Broadway's highest honour.

In the play, Jackson stars as an elderly woman looking back at her life, alongside Laurie Metcalf and Alison Pill. She said: "We get an amazing response from the audience. They wait outside in the cold to say how much they've

enjoyed it." Ms Jackson said she was partly drawn to the play because it features an all-female cast. She added: "The opportunity to work with two other actresses is really quite rare.

"Contemporary dramatists don't find women interesting. They rarely, if ever, are the dramatic engine of anything. So it's such a treat to have just the three of us on stage."

Glenda also commented

on the #MeToo movement, that raises awareness of sexual harassment, saying the campaign does not reveal anything new. She said: "This idea that female abuse is limited to certain activities, certain sections of society, is absolute nonsense."

Jackson won Oscars for her work in *Women In Love* in 1969 and *A Touch Of Class* in 1973. She then spent 23 years as Labour MP for Hampstead and Highgate, in London.

Football bids goodbye to 'gentleman' Ray Wilkins

■ Tributes flow as former Chelsea, United and England star passes away at 61

TRIBUTES have flooded in from across the football world following the death of former England and Chelsea midfielder Ray Wilkins, who died in hospital this week at the age of 61.

Wilkins, who also played for Manchester United, AC Milan, Rangers and QPR, was being treated at St George's Hospital in London following cardiac arrest.

His family thanked "Ray's friends, colleagues and members of the public" for the many messages of goodwill.

Chelsea said they were "devastated to learn of the passing of our former player, captain and assistant coach".

The club added: "Rest in peace, Ray, you will be dreadfully missed."

Wilkins' family said: "It is with great sadness we announce that Raymond Colin Wilkins passed away this morning.

"Ray leaves behind his loving wife, Jackie, daughter Jade, son Ross, and his beautiful grandchildren, Oliver, Frankie, Ava, Freddie,

Jake and Archie.

"We are asking for privacy at this very difficult time."

Wilkins, who had been working as a TV and radio pundit, had suffered poor health in recent years and had double bypass heart surgery in July 2017.

He also admitted struggling with alcohol problems in the past and went through a five-week rehabilitation programme in the Priory Hospital in Woking in 2016 following a four-year ban for drink-driving.

'technical ability'

As a player he made 84 appearances for England and captained his country 10 times, while he won the FA Cup with Manchester United in 1983 and the Scottish league title with Rangers in 1989.

Wilkins had spells as manager of QPR, Fulham and the Jordan national team.

He was also Chelsea assistant coach from 1998-2000 and then 2008 until 2010, when he worked alongside Guus Hiddink and Carlo Ancelotti.

Before Wednesday

evening's Milan derby former AC Milan teammate Franco Baresi led a minute's applause in honour of Wilkins, and laid a bouquet of flowers and a 'Wilkins 8' Milan shirt in front of the famous Curva Sud stand.

The EFL said a period of applause will be held before Sunday's Checkatrade Trophy final at Wembley Stadium between Lincoln City and Shrewsbury Town and that it would offer its "full support for any proposed marks of respect" from any clubs.

England manager Gareth Southgate, who played alongside Wilkins at Crystal Palace, said: "When he played with us you could immediately see that his technical ability to play the ball was phenomenal.

"In the modern game, those attributes would have been appreciated far more than they were at that time, so he really was a top, top player.

"He would have been one of the earliest to go abroad and play in the Italian league. At the time, it was at a really high level

so being able to transition into a club like AC Milan and be as popular as he was there speaks volumes for his ability.

"It was really sad when I heard what happened at the weekend. It's happened so suddenly and it's tragic for Jackie and his family.

"Ray was a great ambassador for the game, a proud Englishman who loved playing for his country and an absolute gent - a class act."

Former Manchester United manager Sir Alex Ferguson told reporters: "Ray was a great football man who

was well respected and liked by all who knew him and he always had a kind word and time for people.

"Ray was an impressive football talent and had a fantastic career representing some of the biggest clubs in the world. He will be missed by us all."

Nun's rape victim pleads: tell me what became of my child

A FORMER choirboy who was repeatedly raped by a nun who fell pregnant has begged church officials: "Please, please tell me what happened to my child."

Edward Hayes was just 12 when he was preyed upon by a 27-year-old sister at the Catholic care home where he had been sent to live. The abuse, revealed in the Daily Express this week, continued for almost three years at the former John Reynolds Home at Lytham St Annes, Lancashire, which was run

by Catholic congregation of nuns The Franciscan Missionaries of St Joseph.

Edward, now 76, fell victim to depraved Irish nun Sister Mary Conleth, whose real name was Bessie Veronica Lawler, in the 1950s while she worked in the laundry room and asked her superiors for his help. But the near-daily ordeals stopped when the nun fell pregnant. She was sent back to Ireland in disgrace while Edward, then 14, was sent to a hostel in Cumbria. But he has no idea what happened to

the child he fathered and Sister Conleth is now dead.

The grandfather said: "Over the years I've said to the Church, 'please, please tell me', but all I've had in response is

silence. "I don't know if they stayed with their mother, if they were adopted or brought up by their mother's family. All I know is she was banished by the Vatican and sent back to Ireland.

"I don't necessarily want to meet the child, that would be entirely down to them to decide, but I do want to know what has happened. The torment of not knowing is another form of abuse."

Edward was just 10 and known as Billy when he was put in the home after being neglected by his

parents. Initially his new home was a blessing, but his life turned sour around 1953 when Sister Conleth arrived and sought him out for special attention. He said: "I hated doing it but she said she would tell on me if I didn't, that I'd been a bad boy and I'd be punished. I would not let her kiss me. I thought babies were made by men kissing women. At the time I didn't even understand how I got her pregnant."

Edward was later adopted by a family and began a chaotic adult life

marred by alcoholism. In 2016 he received £20,000 compensation from the Church but says more than £15,000 went on legal fees and costs. He told reporters he finally decided to reveal the abuse because his ordeal could be "the tip of the iceberg". Edward said: "I feel so relieved to finally tell the world what the Catholic Church allowed to happen to me.

"There is a sense of revenge, I can't deny that, but I feel I'm entitled to that after a lifetime of hell."

Escorting the Monarch: softly, softly does it for the SEG

■ Absorbing new book pulls back the curtain on the unsung heroes of the British security services

For more than 60 years they have kept a low profile but have been a vital force in providing security for some of the world's most powerful dignitaries.

They have protected Prime Ministers, foreign diplomats and heads of state; and whenever the Queen leaves

Buckingham Palace they escort her on her journeys through London.

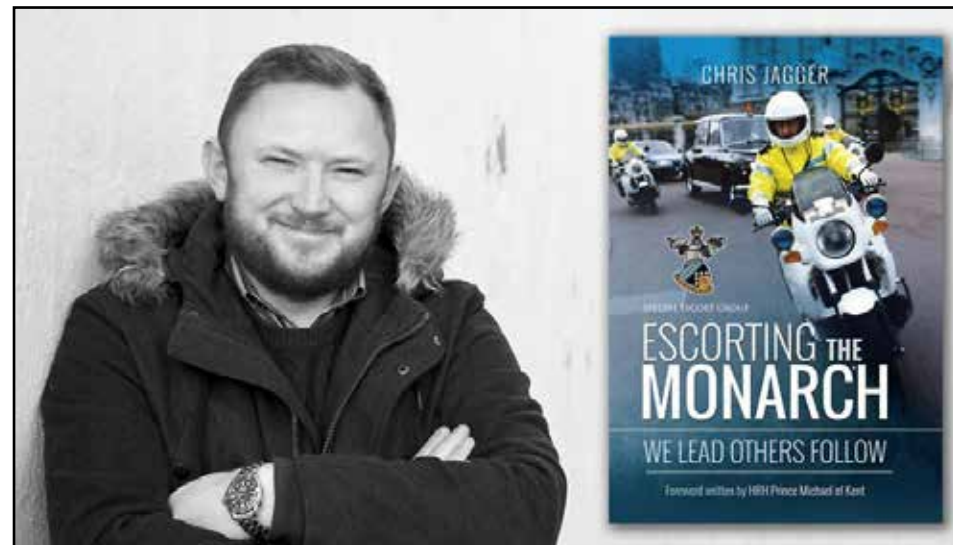
They worked closely with Princess Diana and their next job will be to escort and provide security and protection for her son Prince Harry and his bride Meghan Markle when they marry at Windsor on May 19.

Until now the exploits and adventures of the Metropolitan Police's Special Escort Group have been largely unheralded and unpublicised.

But a new book, *Escorting the Monarch*, by Chris Jagger, a former intelligence officer who worked with Britain's Special Forces, reveals for the first time details of the SEG's work and gives a unique insight into what goes on behind-the-scenes.

Jagger, who spent 20 years in the intelligence community, much of the time tackling organised crime in the Balkans says: "The SEG will play an important part in the security of the coming Royal Wedding and it will be a huge security operation.

"The biggest challenge for the officers involved - and there will be many - is to not be seen. No one wants the wedding to be dominated by an atmosphere of security. Nonetheless,

The Searchers in 1965

After almost 60 years, it's the end of the road for The Searchers

LEGENDARY Merseybeat band The Searchers is calling it a day after nearly 60 years.

The group, famous for hits *Sweets For My Sweet* and *Needles And Pins*, burst on to the scene in the 1960s.

They enjoyed huge success on both sides of the Atlantic and have continued performing as one of the world's longest-running bands.

The group, which has a loyal fan base, will retire next March after a farewell tour beginning in January.

The Searchers emerged from the Merseybeat scene with The Beatles and many other rock groups.

Their cover of the Drifters' 1961 hit *Sweets For My Sweet* spent two weeks as a UK number one in 1963.

A year later their version of Jackie

DeShannon's *Needles And Pins* spent three weeks at number one and a cover of The Orlons' *Don't Throw Your Love Away* stayed on the top spot for two weeks.

Founder and singer John McNally, now 76, is still with the line-up along with bass guitarist Frank Allen who joined the band in 1964.

Drummer Chris Curtis and guitarist Mike Pender were replaced by Scott Ottaway and Spencer James.

The news ends online speculation.

Wendy Burton, who runs the band's website, said: "Sad as we all really are, we appreciate that after 56 years of continuous touring, albeit with a few personnel changes, they so deserve time to enjoy their personal lives at a slower pace."

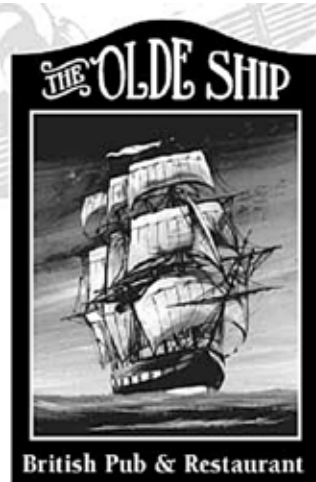

FC England: Expat trio make net gains on Westside soccer scene

■ Development and consistency the key to local club's growing success, say founders

Brits seem to be everywhere in LA and heavily represented in Santa Monica in particular. So it's no surprise that three English guys are making a big impact on the Westside soccer community.

FC England is a non-profit youth soccer club which was launched in 2016 by Coventry-born Paul Spacey and Ricky Collett, from Manchester, both of whom have lived on the Westside for a number of years. They were joined last year by Nic Heffernan, who hails from Brighton. Together they have been making a name for themselves with their unique approach to connecting with and coaching budding young

soccer players.

There are plenty of clubs on the Westside and hundreds all around LA, so the club's growth has not been without challenges. Paul, who is the Director of Coaching, explained, "Ricky and I had the idea back in 2015 to start our own club as we felt we could offer something different than what was already available. It was a long process getting it all started and we certainly had some opposition but in the end we had enough parental and wider-community support to get the project off the ground."

The club now has eight teams, having just launched a new boys 2007

team to add to their boys and girls' teams for 2003, 2004 and 2005 players, along with an additional boys 2006 team. With around 120 players and 200+ parents involved, it is a full-time role for all three coaches. They operate a unique 'rotation' system which allows them all to essentially coach every single player and spend time with all eight teams.

Paul points out: "We are the only club in LA to have a rotational approach and this is hugely beneficial for the players as they are getting input and direction from three coaches, not just one. Fortunately, we all have a similar background and philosophy so we are on the same page and give

a consistent message to the players which is very important."

FCE has adopted a different approach in terms of how they look at the development of players and the records of teams, something which is a big issue in US youth sports. Ricky, who is the Technical Director, talks openly about their approach, "Winning isn't our priority and to be honest that is difficult for us to explain to some people. The big 'W' is part of the culture of youth sports here but we are trying to shift the emphasis to learning, engagement and the development of people, rather than focusing on the short-term goal of winning games. Every kid naturally wants to win and that's fine, we embrace that, but winning will never be our focus... we focus instead on the

process and the things we can control rather than worrying about the end result and this is something the kids benefit from, no doubt about it."

The other thing that sets the club apart is the coaches' approach to connecting with every player. The words 'love' and 'care' are not typically associated with youth sports, especially in the current climate but Head Coach Nic feels it has been a vital factor in establishing the club's good reputation in a relatively short amount of time, "There is a genuine love and care for every kid at the club and I know that is not the normal approach for a sports coach. Our ability to impart our knowledge in a way that engages, inspires and motivates young people is really what sets us apart; times have changed and we

need to move away from the traditional coaching dark ages."

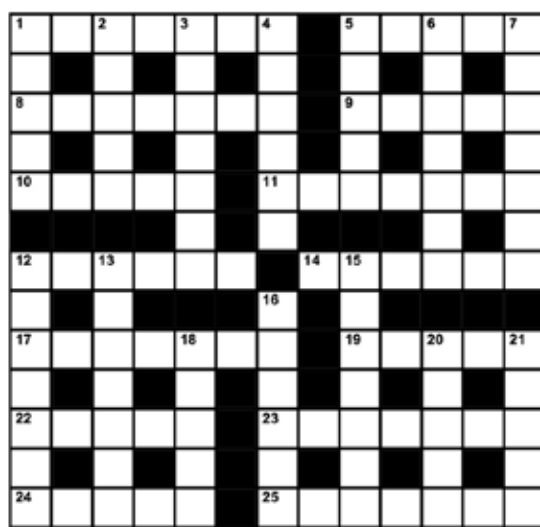
The club is extremely grateful to the local community and to parents in particular as they have provided donations since the inception of the teams which has allowed FC England to offer scholarships to players from families who are unable to afford club soccer. This has given them the ability to take on many players who otherwise wouldn't be able to play for a club and it is something they are clearly proud of.

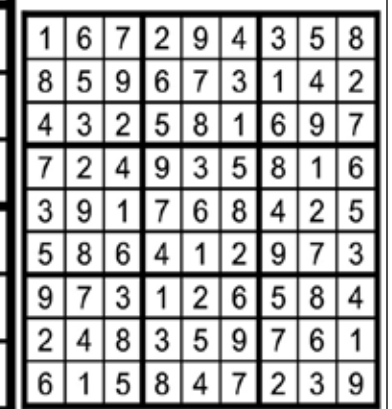

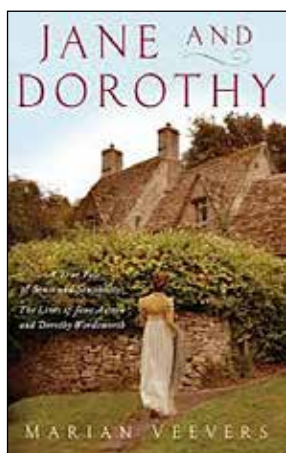

Jane and Dorothy: Regency birds of a feather

Exclusive interview with author Marian Veevers discussing her biography of Regency authors Jane Austen and Dorothy Wordsworth



"I find the late Georgian period, late 1700s, early 1800s, interesting because it was a time of great change," says Jane and Dorothy, *A True Tale of Sense and Sensibility* author Marian Veevers.

"It was a time of revolutions, but also, in Britain, a time of fierce conservatism as the ruling classes watched with alarm events in France and America."

Jane Austen and Dorothy Wordsworth were born just four years apart in Georgian England. They were

both writers and from the same class. Neither married. Both women were affected by the writing of poet William Wordsworth, Dorothy's brother. While Jane strove to make a living from her writing, Dorothy lived with and cared for her brother. In exploring the lives of two female authors, Veevers covers women's roles in Regency society and how family played a part in both women's lives and writing.

Veevers' inspiration came from her own life. Ten years ago she began working a few hours a week for the Wordsworth Trust as a guide in the Lake District at Dove Cottage at Grasmere, William and Dorothy's home.

"At that time I had just begun writing my Dido Kent series of mystery novels, which is set in the world of Jane Austen and alludes to

her work," says Veevers. "So, on many days I would find myself inhabiting the world of Dorothy Wordsworth in the morning, then going home to write about a social setting which would have familiar to Jane Austen. I came to realise that these weren't two separate worlds. I realised that their lives had become very different because they made different choices about how to deal with the problems that were common to women of their class and time."

Austen and Wordsworth had very different personalities.

"Jane was very restrained, unwilling to share her feelings with anyone beyond a very small circle," says Veevers. "She once wrote to her sister, 'I cannot anyhow continue to find people agreeable'. Dorothy, on the other hand, was

described by her friends as having a quality of wildness about her. She showed her feelings and believed that this was the right thing to do. "All is contemptible that does not spring immediately out of an affectionate heart," she maintained."

In her research, Veevers looked beyond Austen's and Wordsworth's letters, into the writings of their friends, family and other contemporaries. Many of Austen's letters are of course lost, famously burned by her sister. Veevers also researched the British Navy, the French Revolution, the history of dissenters, and the East India Company. Veevers had free access to the largest collection of documents relating to the Wordsworth family, held by the Wordsworth Trust at Grasmere. Veevers was able to do detailed research at

Chawton Cottage and Winchester archives through a grant by the Author's Foundation.

Veevers has five published novels, four in her Dido Kent series published in the UK and in the US, under the pen name Anna Dean. The fifth is the novel *Bloodlines*, set around Shakespeare's play *Macbeth*. *Jane and Dorothy* has yet to be optioned for film or TV. Veevers is currently experimenting with writing three different novels, before deciding which is the one to continue with. Veevers says she has so many stories she wants to tell.

Veevers lives in the Lake District, in a small village about five miles from Grasmere. She's lived there with her husband for nearly 30 years, and for 20 of those years was the local postmaster. She was born in the Valley of

to meet some of the champions and play with former world number one Caroline Wozniacki.

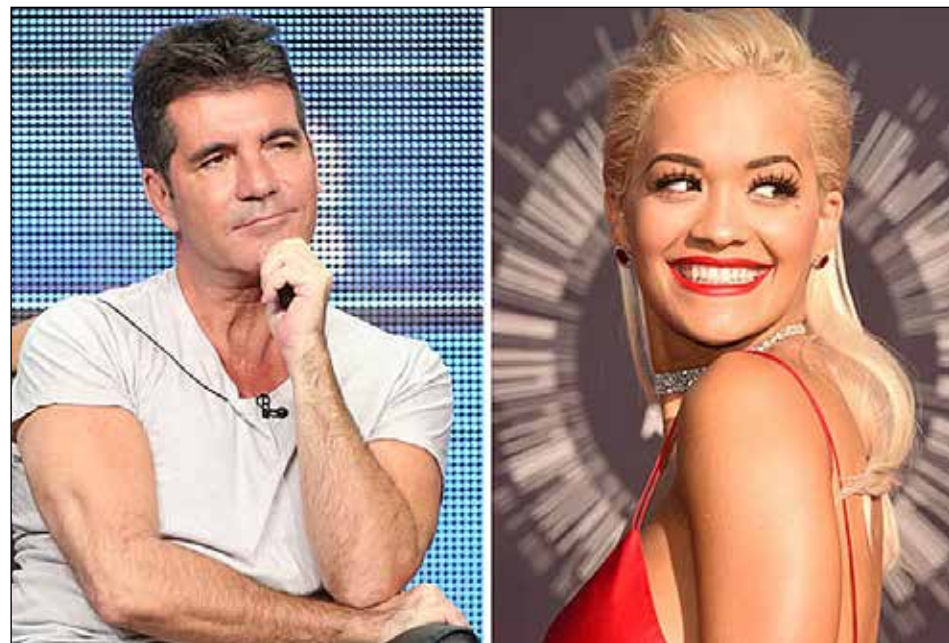
Victoria posted: "Amazingnightwatching @romeobeckham hit with @carowozniacki in Miami X kisses x VB."

Moore replaces failing Pardes

Alan Pardew's short-lived reign as West Bromwich Albion manager came to an abrupt end on Monday following an eighth successive Premier League defeat that has left the Midlands club in escalating danger of relegation.

Pardew, who succeeded Tony Pulis at the end of November, left by mutual consent after holding talks with the chief executive, Mark Jenkins, in the aftermath of the 2-1 home defeat by Burnley on Saturday which left West Brom 10 points from safety with six fixtures remaining.

It is understood that the former West Ham,

Newcastle and Crystal Palace manager felt he had taken the squad as far as he could having overseen just one league victory in 18 attempts, while West Brom were

keen to make a change in an attempt to alter the atmosphere around the Hawthorns in recent weeks.

Pardew's side were booed off at half-time against Burnley, having last recorded a victory there on 13 January against Brighton. Aside from away wins over Exeter and Liverpool in the FA Cup, that proved his only triumph as the 56-year-old amassed eight league points in total. His spell was notable not only for deteriorating results but also for a squad trip to Barcelona during which four players were alleged to have stolen a taxi.

Darren Moore, who made more than 100 appearances for the club between 2001 and 2006 before coaching West Brom's under-23 side, has been promoted from his role as first-team coach under Pardew and will take charge until the end of the season.

Michael Appleton, the former West Brom player and coach who is now assistant to Claude Puel at Leicester, is considered a potential replacement along with Nigel Pearson and Brentford's Dean Smith, although Jenkins and the technical director, Nicky Hammond - who sanctioned the appointment of Pardew having worked with him at Reading - are not expected to rush into an appointment.

Liverpool took a firm grip on their Champions League quarter-final as Manchester City were torn apart by a three-goal burst from Jurgen Klopp's side in the first 31 minutes at Anfield Wednesday night.

City's only Premier League defeat as they move to the brink of the title has been a 4-3 loss at Anfield in January - and they were made to suffer once more in the face of Liverpool's pressing, aggression and potent attack.

Mohamed Salah pounced in the area to score his 38th goal of the season after 12 minutes and Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain doubled their lead eight minutes later when he unleashed a fierce shot past Ederson from 20 yards.

And the third goal that gives Liverpool such a commanding advantage to take to Etihad Stadium next Tuesday came just after the half-hour when Sadio Mane rose to head home Salah's cross.

Liverpool, potentially crucially, emerged from the second half without conceding an away goal, although an injury that forced Salah off will be a concern.

Gunners take control

France striker Alexandre Lacazette marked his first Arsenal start for two months with two goals as they took control of their Europa League quarter-final by demolishing CSKA Moscow 4-1 in the first leg on Thursday.

The Gunners scored four first-half goals, Aaron Ramsey's side-foot finish setting them on their way.

Aleksandr Golovin levelled with a sublime free-kick before Lacazette,

Anfield was at its most hostile - but there were unsavoury incidents before kick-off when fans outside the ground attacked and damaged the Manchester City team coach on its way into the stadium, prompting an "unreserved" apology from Liverpool and an investigation from Merseyside Police.

Manchester City started well and in composed fashion as they attempted to douse the flames of a fiery Anfield atmosphere - but it all went wrong from the moment they conceded the first goal to the prolific Salah.

City's defence, so rarely put under stress this season, was a mess as Ederson saved from Firmino, Kyle Walker clearing the ball back into the Brazilian's path to set up Salah, whose finish was a formality given his form and confidence.

It gave Liverpool the perfect start and they doubled that advantage eight minutes later when James Milner nicked possession and City's rearguard inexplicably stood off Oxlade-Chamberlain, offering an open invitation he accepted by rifling a powerful rising finish past Ederson.

There must also be questions about how

who has recovered from a knee injury, made it 2-1 with a penalty after Mesut Ozil was fouled by Georgi Schennikov.

Ramsey produced a brilliant third with an instinctive volleyed flick, with Lacazette adding a fourth after being picked out by the outstanding Ozil.

Arsenal were unable to add to their tally in the second half but they **cont. on page 19, col 2**

the diminutive Mane was allowed to rise with ease between Walker and Vincent Kompany to head Liverpool's third just after the half-hour.

City's normally precise attacking play was beyond them in the second half when they did finally claim the share of possession they craved as they attacked The Kop end.

They were able to fashion several dangerous positions but were sloppy and wasteful as Liverpool avoided any moments of serious anxiety.

Liverpool manager Jurgen Klopp was in celebratory mood after the final whistle as he applauded The Kop and whirled his fists in front of Anfield's giant Main Stand.

It was easy to see why - but Liverpool will be taking nothing for granted against a side of City's quality and attacking threat.

Liverpool, however, have secured the sort of result they would have dreamed of before kick-off with a three-goal lead to take into the second leg and that vital clean sheet to act as added insurance.

And, significantly, Liverpool have just the sort of attack to punish a team pushing for goals,

as City will need to do next Tuesday.

Guardiola, whose team could clinch the title if they beat

Manchester United at Etihad Stadium on Saturday, will not be giving this one up yet but City will need to be

flawless in all the areas they were flaky here if they are to mount one of the great Champions League comebacks.
