## TV ANT'S RECORD £86,000 DRINK-DRIVE FINE

# ANT SHAMEFACED

**'I just want to say I'm truly sorry for what happened. I'm ashamed and mortified..... I let myself down..'**

**TV presenter Ant McPartlin has been fined £86,000 and given a 20-month driving ban after pleading guilty to drink driving.**

Speaking outside Wimbledon Magistrates' Court on Monday, he said: "I let myself down, I let a lot of people down. For that I'm truly sorry."

He also said he was "thankful no-one was hurt" in the three-car collision in Richmond, London, on 18 March.

The court heard he had been more than twice the drink drive limit.

In a letter read out in court, McPartlin also said he was "ashamed and mortified" and "accepts full responsibility" for what happened.

The fine is thought to be one of the largest handed down in a British court for a drink driving offence.

The mother of the *Britain's Got Talent* and *Saturday Night Takeaway* presenter was in the passenger seat of his Mini at the time of the collision, the court heard.

In a witness statement,

the driver of one of the cars said he and his wife "could have died as a result of Mr McPartlin's reckless driving".

The court heard McPartlin had 75 micrograms of alcohol in 100 millilitres of breath when he was breathalysed - the legal limit is 35 micrograms per 100 millilitres of breath.

District Judge Barbara Barnes described McPartlin as a "well-known and successful entertainer", taking his weekly income of about £130,000 into consideration when calculating the fine.

Sentencing him, the district judge said: "At the time when it happened you were struggling with various personal problems and also alcohol issues for some months."

"This incident happened, sadly, when

it seems you suffered a brief relapse."

She described McPartlin's previous "exemplary character", adding: "I think it will have quite an impact on you to know you're no longer a man of good character."

She added: "Because of the seriousness of this offence, the financial pain must be imposed on you as on any other offender."

McPartlin's driving ban can be reduced by five months, to a total of 15 months, if he completes a drink-drive referral programme by mid-May 2019.

Prosecutor Katie Sinnett-Jones told the court the incident happened at around 3.50pm on 18 March on Lower Richmond Road.

She said McPartlin was driving around a "sharp bend and lost control" and then ended up on the wrong side of the road.

He collided with another Mini car before driving "straight into the front of an oncoming car"

McPartlin's vehicle "came to a halt and was no longer driveable due to the damage caused", she added.

In a statement read to the court, the driver of the other Mini said: "Myself and my family were in deep shock as we believed we could have died as a result of Mr McPartlin's reckless driving."

### **'Sorrow and regret'**

McPartlin's barrister Liam Walker said his client has expressed both his "sorrow and regret" and knows the consequences could have been much worse.

The presenter knows

people in the public eye should provide a positive example to others and his court appearance is a "turning point" for him, the lawyer added.

The Metropolitan Police previously said that a number of individuals were treated at the scene for minor injuries, and a child passenger from one of the cars was taken to hospital to be checked as a precaution.

Partlin's barrister said his client had been seeking help for "alcohol and emotional issues" at the time of the crash.

He told the judge the incident was down to "a brief relapse" unbeknownst to McPartlin's mother.

"Anthony McPartlin is sorry and is doing everything he can to

ensure this never happens again," Mr Walker said.

"He hopes that in time he can make himself better and that he might be forgiven by all of the many people he knows and he feels he has let down terribly."

After he was charged, his publicist confirmed McPartlin was taking time off from his TV commitments. He is currently seeking treatment.

His presenting partner Declan Donnelly hosted the final two episodes of *Saturday Night Takeaway* alone and will also host *Britain's Got Talent* on his own, although McPartlin was seen on the ITV show over the weekend as the talent show aired its pre-recorded audition shows.

# Plastic stirrers and cotton buds to be banned

**Plastic stirrers and cotton buds are to be banned alongside straws, Michael Gove announced on Thursday.**

The move, expected to come into force as early as next year, is designed to curb "society's addiction" to throwaway products, the environment secretary writes in *The Times*. The UK uses 13.2 billion cotton buds a year, more than any other member of the EU, as well as 44.1 billion stirrers and 42 billion straws, according to the World Wide Fund for Nature.

A consultation on how to outlaw the items will begin this year. Industry will be given time to develop and manufacture less harmful alternatives, the environment secretary says. Explaining why cotton buds, straws and stirrers have been singled out, he said:

"We have targeted these products because they are already available (or can be developed) in alternative forms but when discarded they remain a polluting presence for hundreds of years. Their legacy can be lethal.

"Once our need for them has passed, far too many are flushed down the drain before finding their way into rivers and seas. There, they have been found blocking the noses of sea turtles and

perforating the stomachs of penguins."

The ban in England is the latest in a series of measures to reduce single-use plastics as ministers take advantage of a change in public sentiment prompted in part by the BBC's *Blue Planet* series, which highlighted marine pollution. Mr Gove initiated plans last month to require retailers to impose a deposit on plastic bottles and has extended the 5p tax on plastic bags to smaller shops.

## 'world leader'

Moves for an industry levy aimed at reducing the use of products such as takeaway food cartons are also underway in the Treasury. Many retailers have already taken action to reduce or replace plastic straws before any legal move and Scotland is already committed to banning them.

Speaking on BBC Radio 4's *Today* programme, Mr Gove said that the government would be announcing more policies later this year to help businesses use less plastic.

With the enthusiastic backing of Theresa May, Mr Gove is said to believe that the issue helps reconnect the Conservatives with former supporters angry

over Brexit.

The timing of the announcement to coincide with the Commonwealth heads of government summit is also designed to underline the UK's leadership on the issue.

In a statement issued Wednesday night, the prime minister said that the ban would confirm the country as a "world leader" in the battle against pollution of the seas.

"Alongside our domestic action, this week we are rallying Commonwealth countries to join us in the fight against marine plastics, with £61.4 million funding for global research and to improve waste management in developing countries.

"The Commonwealth is a unique organisation, with a huge diversity of wildlife, environments and coastlines. Together we can effect real change so that future generations can enjoy a natural environment that is healthier than we currently find it."

The government says there are more than 150 million tonnes of plastic in the oceans and every year one million birds and more than 100,000 sea mammals die from eating and getting tangled in plastic waste.

**BRITAIN roasts in hottest April temperatures since 1949**



**TURNED OUT NICE AGAIN:** grabbing some rays in St. James's Park, London

**Temperatures this week soared to over 84F in parts of London, making it the warmest April day for nearly 70 years.**

The unusually warm weather across the UK is the result of low pressure over the Atlantic and high pressure over western Europe drawing in warm air.

Thursday's high of 29.1C was recorded at St James's Park in central London during the

afternoon, making it the hottest UK day in April since 1949.

The average maximum temperature for the UK in April is 53F.

The highest recorded temperature for this month was 85F back in 1949 in London.

Pollen levels are high throughout much of the UK, with BBC Weather warning it could be "uncomfortable" for hayfever sufferers.

Runners in Sunday's London Marathon have been warned to expect hot weather, with suggestions it could be the hottest race on record.

Event director Hugh Brasher said contingency plans were already in place which included providing extra water supplies along the route for drinking and for competitors to douse themselves with.

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# Trump didn't make me do it!

## Syria air strikes were my decision, insists PM

**THERESA** May this week insisted air strikes against Syria were in the British national interest and not launched as a result of pressure from Donald Trump.

The Prime Minister told parliament: "We have not done this because President Trump asked us to, we have done it because we believed it was the right thing to do, and we are not alone. There is broad-based international support for the action we have taken."

She said she did not seek a green light from parliament for the attacks due to the need to act quickly. And she insisted her decision to order RAF Tornados into the US-led assault on three of dictator Bashar al-Assad's chemical weapons facilities was "legally and morally right".

During more than three hours of Commons debate, the Prime Minister said: "We cannot go back to a world where the use of chemical weapons becomes normalised."

### cyber attacks

"I am clear that the way we protect our national interest is to stand up for the global rules and standards that keep us safe."

"That is what we have done – and what we will continue to do."

On her decision not to seek parliamentary approval for the air strikes, Mrs May said: "I am absolutely clear, Mr Speaker, that it is Parliament's responsibility to hold me to account for such decisions – and Parliament will do so. But it is my responsibility as Prime Minister to make these decisions. And I will make them."

Meanwhile, British and American security chiefs issued an unprecedented joint warning of a surge in "malicious" cyber attacks

from Vladimir Putin's Russia.

The National Cyber Security Centre joined the FBI and the US Department of Homeland Security to alert businesses and public services, including the NHS, about attempts to hack computer systems to "lay a foundation for future offensive operations".

They said "multiple sources" had reported suspected Russia infiltration to bring havoc to computers and several other devices.

The aim was to undermine the "safety, security and economic wellbeing" of Western societies.

The UK-US warning follows fears of a devastating wave of Russian cyber attacks in revenge for the allied missile strikes on President Putin's ally Syria.

### 'major priority'

Mrs May said the Government had "enhanced our capability" to combat cyber threats following the increase in tensions with Russia.

However, this latest warning set out the dangers posed to industry.

It said the Russian state-sponsored hackers were using "compromised routers" to conduct spoofing "man-in-the-middle" attacks to

"support espionage, extract intellectual property, maintain persistent access to victim networks and potentially lay a foundation for future offensive operations".

Cyber security centre chief executive Ciaran Martin explained: "Russia is our most capable hostile adversary in cyberspace. So dealing with their attacks is a major priority for the National Cyber Security Centre and our US allies. This is the first time that in attributing a cyber attack to Russia, the US and the UK have, at the same time, issued joint advice to industry about how to manage the risks from attacks."

"It marks an important step in our fight against state-sponsored aggression in cyberspace. For more than 20 years, GCHQ has been tracking the key Russian cyber attack groups. Today's joint UK-US alert shows that the threat has not gone away. The UK Government will continue to work with international allies and industry partners to expose Russia's unacceptable cyber behaviour, so they are held accountable for their actions."

The joint statement made it clear that the targets of such attacks have been primarily government and private-sector organisations,

critical infrastructure providers and internet service providers which support these sectors.

### 'great courage'

Russian foreign minister Sergei Lavrov said air strikes had made East-West relations worse than in the Cold War. He said: "During the Cold War there were channels of communication and no obsession with Russophobia, which looks like genocide by sanctions."

MPs overwhelmingly

backed Mrs May over RAF involvement in the air strikes, but Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn faced Tory cries of "shame" as he said: "The Prime Minister is accountable to this Parliament, not to the whims of the US president."

A string of Labour MPs distanced themselves from their leader's continued questioning of whether Syria was to blame for the chemical attack on Douma earlier this month. To cheers from Tory MPs, former

shadow chancellor Chris Leslie said: "Pinpointing and degrading Assad's chemical weapons was necessary. Intervening to save civilians from future gas attacks was absolutely the right thing to do. Those who would turn a blind eye, who would do nothing in pursuit of some moral high ground, should also be held accountable."

And Tory MP Richard Drax said: "Leadership takes great courage. The Prime Minister has that in spades."

## 26 years for rapist who pretended to be a ghost

A rapist who manipulated a girl into having sex with him by pretending to be a ghost has been jailed for 26 years.

Liam Clarke knew she was terrified of evil spirits and used that to exploit her, Exeter Crown Court heard.

Clarke, 35, of Crediton, Devon, was convicted of four rapes, three assaults by penetration, sexual activity with a child, and eight counts of indecency or indecent assault.

Judge David Evans said: "Your offending across the years was monstrous."

The court heard how Clarke's victim was petrified of the occult following a bad experience during an Ouija board game.

He made strange noises at night which left the 15-year-old girl terrified and pushed notes under her bedroom door claiming to be from the ghost.

Pretending to be the spirit, he then made threats to the teenager and told her the only way of getting rid of the demon was by having sex with him.

Sentencing Clarke, Judge Evans said: "She said she did not want to have sex with you but you threatened her repeatedly.

"You made deliberate use of her deep fear of ghosts and spirits."

The offences took place between 1997 to 2016 in Torquay, Crediton and in Hampshire.

Clarke was arrested in July last year and found guilty at trial in March.

He also repeatedly abused two young girls in Southampton by putting coins in his underwear and getting them to play hide and seek.

Clarke was put on the sex offenders' register for life and made the subject of a Sexual Harm Prevention Order, which restricts his future contact with girls.

# Sir Patrick Stewart lends voice to demands for another referendum

■ The actor even said his fictional X-Men character Charles Xavier would have supported the Remain campaign.

**Veteran actor Sir Patrick Stewart has joined a campaign to demand another referendum on the final Brexit deal.**

Speaking at a rally in Camden, north London this week, Sir Patrick, 78, told a crowd of over 1,200 people that he "will not stand idly by" whilst Britain's "future is at stake".

Opening the London launch of People's Vote – a new grassroots movement campaigning for a referendum on the final deal – Sir Patrick said Brexit will mean he will show his new Blue passport "with less pride".

The actor, famous for productions including Star Trek and X-Men, even said his fictional character Charles Xavier would have supported the Remain campaign.

He said: "It is not

Charles Xavier standing here in front of you – although I can assure you that if he was, he would have voted Remain. And why? Because unity, common cause, wellbeing of society and debate were paramount to belief of this fictional character.

"Since the 2016 referendum, there has been a concerted effort by many – including government – to shut down debate about Brexit and to tell us that we should simply trust ministers to get on with it because Brexit is an irreversible process.

"That we shouldn't worry about the cost and complexity of it or the litany of broken promises. Well today we say that's not good enough.

"Our country's future is at stake and we will not stand idly by.

"That is why I support a people's vote on the final deal."

Sir Patrick told the crowd that the day Britain joined the EU on January 1 1973 was one of the best days of his life.

"I was working with the Royal Shakespeare Company. My wife and I owned a tiny little cottage in Warwickshire. We had a young son and a daughter on the way," he said.

"But the reason for the joy on that New Year's Day was because the

UK had finally become a member of the European Union," he added.

Sir Patrick went on to discuss his upbringing in working-class Yorkshire, where he witnessed the aftermath of the Second World War.

He said: "The cost of war was everywhere and many never recovered from it.

"That was the Europe I grew up in and that is why when Britain joined the [European Economic Community] in 1973, that

date was so special to me.

"When the UK and Ireland were brought in I felt for the first time in my life that the brutality of both World Wars could never happen again."

Speaking at the event alongside Conservative MP Anna Soubry and Labour's Chuka Umunna, Sir Patrick said: "Now that we are learning the real cost of Brexit, I want to urge that we think again and insist whether we accept the Brexit deal is a matter for the people."

## Corbyn blasted for suggesting Charles should not be next Commonwealth Head

**JEREMY Corbyn provoked anger this week by suggesting Prince Charles should not become the next head of the Commonwealth.**

The hard-Left Labour leader claimed the position should be rotated around the heads of the 53 nations.

He also urged Theresa May to use this week's Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting to make amends for Britain's "immoral" behaviour in its imperial past.

Mr Corbyn's remarks came as Commonwealth leaders flew into London. They will discuss who follows the Queen as the

organizations' head.

"The Commonwealth ought to really get a chance to decide who its own head is," said Mr Corbyn.

"The Queen is personally very committed to the Commonwealth, but after her maybe it's a time to say well, actually the Commonwealth should decide who its own president is on a rotational basis."

The Queen had earlier spoken of her wish for her eldest son to succeed her.

Mr Corbyn added: "It's very important that Britain recognizes its historical role in many

issues, such as the treatment of people in Kenya during the uprising in the 1950s.

"The Government should also acknowledge the "wrong and brutal" treatment of inhabitants forced to leave an Indian Ocean territory by 1973 to make way for a US military base.

**'shocking'**

"It's important that the British Government just recognise what Britain did to the Chagos Islanders was immoral, was wrong and brutal – put it right and give them their right of return," he said.

Brandon Lewis called Mr Corbyn's remarks about the Prince of Wales "shocking" and accused him of suggesting "a downgrading of our monarchy within the Commonwealth".

Foreign Secretary Boris Johnson said no one in the Commonwealth was pressing for an

apology for the colonial era, adding that the next head "is for the 53 to decide".

Meanwhile, Prince Harry is to be made a Commonwealth Youth Ambassador to build links between young people and youth leaders across the 53 member nations.



## Billions in profit for Premier League

Premier League clubs reported record revenues of £4.5bn in the 2016-17 season, and also returned to profit.

Clubs collectively reported £500m in pre-tax profit, also a record, having posted a small collective pre-tax loss in 2015-16, according to Deloitte.

Wage costs rose by 9% to £2.5bn, a significantly lower growth rate than the 25% hike in revenues.

The Premier League's three-year TV deal which came into effect in 2016-17 was the main factor in revenue growth.

A record £5.13bn was paid to the league by Sky and BT for the 2016-19 UK broadcast rights. But the latest domestic rights auction, for the 2019-22 cycle, did not reach those heights, bringing in £4.464bn for the league's 20 clubs.

"Despite the lack of growth in domestic broadcast deals announced to date, we still expect to see overall revenue growth in the coming seasons, and if this is complemented with prudent cost control, we expect that pre-tax profits will be achieved for the foreseeable future," said Dan Jones, head of Deloitte's Sports Business Group.

And he said that "restraint shown by clubs to control their wages has translated broadcast revenue success into healthy operating and pre-tax profits".

Mr Jones added: "Although we anticipate wage costs will continue to rise in the coming seasons, we do not foresee increases to be at a level which can jeopardise the profitability of the Premier League as a whole."

## It's true: the Hampden Roar is as loud as a lion

■ Old Firm clash produces ear-splitting 115db roar

The famous "Hampden Roar" lived up to its name during the Old Firm clash last weekend as the noise generated by fans was said to be the equivalent of a real lion.

The sound experts Vanguardia recorded a peak volume of 115 decibels at the national stadium during the Celtic v Rangers cup semi-final on Sunday. This is equivalent to the roar of a lion from less than a metre away or being in the front row of a music concert and just short of a jet engine at take-off from 25 metres, they said.

The impact of the Hampden Roar was measured as part of a fact-finding mission to safeguard the future of the Glasgow stadium. Peter Dallas, managing director of Hampden Park, said: "Sunday's William Hill Scottish Cup

semi-final reaffirmed why Hampden Park is Scotland's national stadium.

"The tie was beamed to households across the globe but these readings show there is no substitute for experiencing the atmosphere inside the stadium. We are pleased that the experts at Vanguardia have validated our firm belief that the Hampden Roar is unrivalled in Scottish football."

### 'passion'

Celtic's 4-0 victory over their rivals recorded crowd noise peaks as the teams emerged from the tunnel (109 decibels) and immediately after each goal (115 decibels). The average ambient noise level in the first half was 98 decibels and 96 for the second half.

Recent measurements

at all 20 English Premier League stadia pale by comparison. A study in 2014 put Old Trafford top with a reading of 84 decibels at the start of the match, compared with Hampden's 109.

Matt McIlroy, senior acoustic consultant at Vanguardia, said: "The noise levels from the moment the players walked out on to the pitch were incredible and it really shows the passion of the fans that

those levels did not significantly change throughout the match.

"It's also worth noting that these levels were registered trackside: imagine how loud it would have been in amongst the fans."

The Hampden Roar originated with the Celtic player Jimmy McGrory, who in 1933 was playing for Scotland against England in a rare appearance for the national team. With the

match tied at 1-1, he scored a superb winner and the phenomenal noise that greeted his goal became known as the Hampden Roar.

Guinness World Records recognises 142.2 decibels as the loudest noise ever recorded in a sports stadium, during a Kansas City Chiefs v New England Patriots American football game at the Arrowhead Stadium, which holds 76,416 fans, in 2014.

## Tributes flow for 'nice guy' TV host Dale Winton

**SUPERMARKET Sweep presenter Dale Winton died at home this week aged just 62.**

Tributes to the star, who hosted the popular British game show in the 1990s, quickly flooded in.

Comedian Les Dennis tweeted: "So sad and shocked to hear that Dale Winton has died."

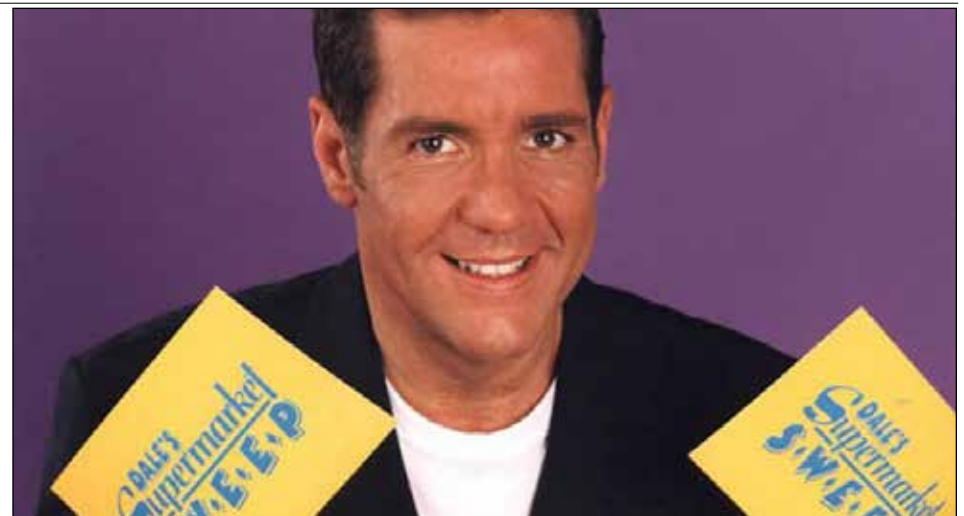
"He was a lovely, warm man who exuded charm. RIP"

West End star Michael Ball tweeted: "So sad to hear that the true gentleman, the charming and so kind Dale Winton has been taken from us far too soon. RIP lovely man. Xx"

London-born Winton started his career as a DJ

in south-west London in the 1970s before joining Channel 4 in 1987. He began hosting Supermarket Sweep on ITV in 1993. He also hosted the Saturday night show Pets Win Prizes. But despite his fame and showbiz friends like Cilla Black the gay star suffered from mental and physical health issues.

He revealed on Loose Women in 2016 that he had regularly battled with depression. Speaking on the ITV show, he said: "I should have taken myself off the TV but I didn't. Listen, there are worse things in the world – but I had depression and I didn't realise."

"I always thought, 'get over yourself'. But my mum died of it."

He presented an upbeat, cheerful, public image despite tragedy early in his life. His father, Gary, died when Dale was just 13, leaving his mother Sheree, an actress, to raise him on her own. She took an overdose of barbiturates after suffering from depression for many years when Dale was just

21. He found her body, with a "do not disturb" sign hanging outside the door of her bedroom.

This year he returned to TV, presenting Dale Winton's Florida Fly Drive on Channel 5. Speaking in an interview about the show in January, he said: "I've kept a low profile because I had about four surgeries. "I had a shoulder problem and a knee problem, so I took

a break to get myself sorted.

"But then when I was asked to do this show I thought it would be fun."

Winton did not come out publicly as gay until 2008. He said then: "The truth – it's absolutely the truth – is that no one ever asked me. I did countless interviews over the years and I was always waiting for the question. "It never came. I actually don't believe it's important."

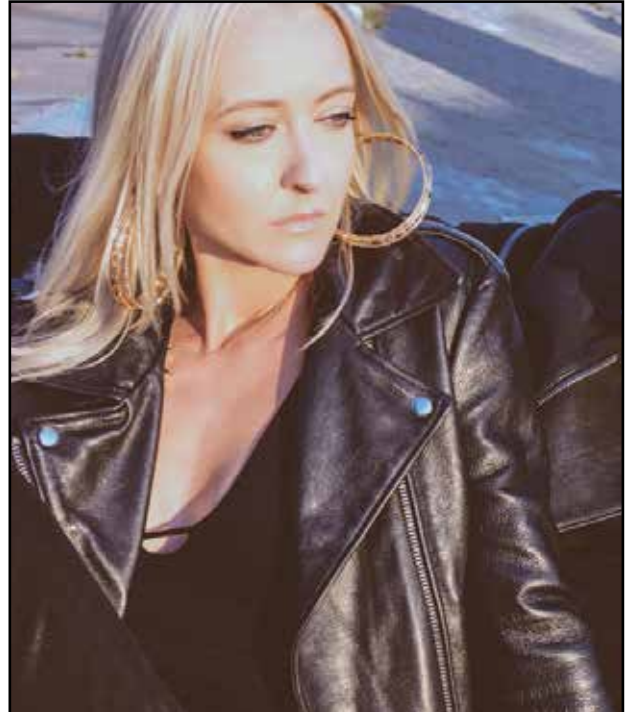

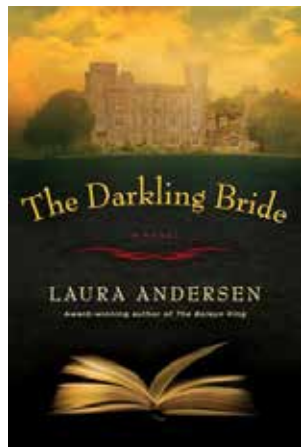

## The Darkling Bride: murder most Gothic



Exclusive interview with author Laura Andersen discussing her new Gothic novel with castle murder mysteries separated by a hundred years

**"I worshiped Mary Stewart and Victoria Holt," says *The Darkling Bride* author Laura Andersen.**

"I was a huge reader of gothic suspense in my teens. And, I have continued to love the genre conventions of isolated manors, dark secrets, hints of the ghostly, and the curious outsider who drags everything into the light."

Deeprath Castle in the Wicklow Mountains of Ireland has been the home of the Gallagher family for seven hundred years. In 1880, gothic

author Evan Chase goes to Ireland and winds up at Deeprath. There he falls in love with the daughter of the house, Lady Jenny Gallagher. When she dies unexpectedly she leaves behind her husband and child. Evan had been a well-known writer but he never wrote again after her death. That is where the legend of the Darkling Bride and the haunting of the castle starts.

In 2015, cold case detective Sibéal McKenna wants to know who killed the current Viscount's parents. He and his sister Kyra were children when their parents both died. Their father died in the library. Their mother fell from the bride tower of the castle. Their deaths were violent and the case was never solved.

Both Aidan and his sister avoid the family castle. Aidan has decided to donate it to the

National Trust. But he has to go back for the first time since his parents' deaths.

Concerned for the family books and papers in the family archives, his aunt hires Carragh Ryan, scholar and book lover, to inventory the historic library. Aidan and other members of the family are a bit eccentric, making her job more difficult. Carragh wants to find out what happened to Evan Chase's missing Victorian manuscript. She gets caught up in haunting of the castle that started with the Darkling Bride. She is helping to solve the murders of Aidan's parents. But will she be the next victim?

The book has mystery, romance, historical details and drama and is a good fit for readers who like gothic novels.

"If you've read my previous books, then you already know that I live and die by the

Tudors," says Anderson. "Honestly, I'm terrified at the thought of writing a completely contemporary book. Besides, there's a distinct shortage of opportunities to write about gorgeous gowns and swords in a strictly contemporary tale. I've always felt I have a more old-fashioned, slightly formal style that is an easier fit in historical fiction. But beyond that instinct of self-preservation, I do have an abiding passion for secrets that resonate through generations. Some of my favorite books are multi-timeline... *The Thirteenth Tale* by Diane Setterfield and *The Historian* by Elizabeth Kostova."

For online research, Anderson pored over Irish newspapers from the Victorian era. She wanted the language and layout to feel authentic for the period newspaper reports of Jenny's death.

She also re-read Gothic novels by favorite authors, including Carol Goodman and Kate Morton.

"The best part of research, hands down, was a day trip to Glendalough while in Ireland for a week," says Anderson. "My daughter and I fell headlong in love with all of it."

*The Darkling Bride* has yet to be optioned for film or TV. Anderson's first books are the trilogy, *The Boleyn King*, *The Boleyn Deceit* and *The Boleyn Reckoning*, follow an alternate historical timeline in which Anne Boleyn did not miscarry her son in January 1536 but bore a live Prince of Wales and was consequently never executed. Anderson's second trilogy, beginning with *The Virgin's Daughter*, continues the alternate timeline in the 1580s and adds a daughter for Elizabeth I.

## TAX INVASION!

**Most of you by now have done your taxes - or if you are bit disorganized (like me), you may have filed for an extension.** Which means you can buy a little time and have them complete and filed by October.

Navigating tax filing for foreigners can be somewhat of a daunting task, in fact a lot of Brits don't bother filing (big mistake)...read on for more info about that.

Let me start by saying I'm not a tax specialist, so for proper advice seek out a tax accountant, enrolled agent or a lawyer for more comprehensive and detailed advice.

April 15 is usually the yearly deadline to file your taxes but this year it was April 17, because once in a while, the regular date is disrupted due to a weekend or a holiday celebrated in the nation's capital.

You are filing taxes for the calendar year previous - i.e. in April 2018 you file your earnings (profit and

loss) for Jan.1 2107- to Dec 31 2017.

One main difference is that even if you are employed by a company you are still required to file yourself. There is no PAYE here. Also when filing out your start up paperwork for an employee, you will be asked how many dependents you are claiming. Note here that the more dependents you list the less tax will be taken out of your paycheck each week. But if you list 1 or 0 - you will probably have a lot of tax taken out of your paycheck each week, however the chances of receiving a tax refund after filing are greater.

**KEEP ALL RECEIPTS!** - Take a photo of them in your phone and file them, so you can retrieve them easily - or use one certain credit card for all business transactions, so you can just check the statements each month too. I prefer to use a bookkeeper or a site called quickbooks, (www.quickbooks.com)

that links up to my bank. This way each month it details my income and expenditure as I go along. This makes it **SO** much easier than spending days weeks in March trying to catch up.

I seek out the help of a Tax preparer to do my taxes each year - for two reasons - firstly its considered a business expense (so I can write it off), and secondly if ever, (God forbid) am audited then the preparer has to come with me or go on my behalf to the meetings with the IRS and answer any questions, or negotiate if there are any discrepancies.

Be careful to whom you entrust your taxes as there are plenty of dodgy operators out there who will charge you a low fee, but file incorrectly and disappear. Ask for referrals from friends or check out Yelp!

Also make sure you go in to the tax preparer organized with your top P&L (profit and loss) sheet. They won't be too happy if you show up with three carrier-bags of receipts, they won't have the time to

sort through your affairs and you will probably have to reschedule your appointment.

Now it gets a little tricky if you are self-employed and do business both here and in the UK. Or have assets and own property back in the UK. It is my understanding that there is a tax treaty between the UK and USA but a form called an F-BAR must be filed declaring your worldwide earnings and assets. (Perhaps FUBAR would be more appropriate) Failure to do this can get you in a lot of trouble. visit [irs.gov](http://irs.gov) to fill out the form.

Its always a little tricky knowing what to do each year, that's why it's best to seek out an accountant that understands the tax rules in both countries.

Bottom line? Taxes are a pain but avoidin them now will bring greater pain later on. So try to stay focused on the task, breathe and sort your expenses by category and not month by month, it will save a lot of time, trust me!

# Walker: we're not perfect yet

## ■ Title-winning City aiming for years of dominance, says defender

Manchester City want to be regarded as one of the greatest teams in Premier League history, says defender Kyle Walker.

They won the title with five games to spare on Sunday when Manchester United suffered a surprise home defeat by West Bromwich Albion.

City have 87 points this season, 16 points ahead of second-placed United.

"There is still a lot of room for improvement," England international Walker, 27, told BBC Radio 5 live.

"I have read some articles that say we need to win things continuously for a number of years before we are classed as a great team.

"Every single one of us wants to be recognised as one of the greatest teams to play in the Premier League.

City lost 5-1 on

aggregate to Liverpool in the Champions League quarter-finals.

"If we concentrate on ourselves then as a team we can go on to great things," said Walker, a £45m signing from Tottenham last July.

"But the Liverpool game showed us that we are not a perfect team."

City's title triumph came in manager Pep Guardiola's second season in charge, a campaign in which they also won the League Cup.

Guardiola won the Champions Leagues twice and La Liga three times with Barcelona, and the Bundesliga three times with Bayern Munich.

Speaking on BBC Radio 5 live's Pep Guardiola programme, Walker said: "Different managers have different ways of looking at things and the gaffer here is special.

"He has won everything you want to win. Bar three people in the dressing room, no-one has won the Champions League. He has done it on a number of occasions so you have to buy into his philosophy and his way of playing."

"It's just the detail and simple things that probably others managers bypass but he keeps banging on about it and banging on about it, day in and day out, until the penny drops. It has shown in our performances.

"It's things like if the passes come in, you take it with the correct foot. As footballers we do get lazy sometimes and take the ball with our preferred foot to control it, but that split second of controlling it with your left foot and playing with your right can make all the difference in creating a chance or scoring a goal.

"There are also all sorts of things tactically. I don't get forward as much as I probably did at Tottenham but my defending has come on leaps and bounds here, where I have had to think a little bit more about my positioning and where I need to be on the football pitch.

"The first half of the

season was where I had to really concentrate. I am still learning in training now.

"I spoke to Leroy Sané and he said it took him maybe eight or nine months before the penny dropped in training what he needs to do to get the better of people in the possession games."

"He put the faith in me to sign me and the first text message I sent him after he won the league was to thank him - thank him for bringing me here and for putting the trust in me to play for your team. He said never to thank him and it was us guys who did it ourselves. It makes you feel good."

## Spurs Legend captured in Highland Park
