



Latest royal 'behaving himself,' says proud papa William

Prince William says his newborn baby is "behaving himself" so far but provided no updates about what the child will be named.

Everyone back home is "in good form, luckily," William said Wednesday during his first engagement since the baby's birth. "Sleeping's going reasonably well," he said while meeting with dignitaries at a Westminster Abbey service honoring members of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corp on Wednesday. Asked about how mother and child are doing, the prince responded: "They're very well, thanks."

child. The 8-pound, 7-ounce young prince joins big brother, George, 4, and 2-year-old sister, Charlotte.

The couple have yet to reveal what they have named their baby, but an announcement was expected shortly. Both George and Charlotte's names were revealed just

days after their birth.

At Westminster Abbey, William was joined by his brother along with Harry's fiancée, Meghan Markle, who are scheduled to get married May 19.

The trio were there as part of a service of commemoration and thanksgiving to mark ANZAC Day, which

honors the first major military battle by Australian and New Zealand forces during World War I.

first glimpse of their third child, a new Prince of Cambridge.

His name is likely to be announced imminently. Standing on the steps of the private Lindo Wing at St Mary's Hospital, in Paddington, west London, Kate cradled her new son who was wrapped in a white lace shawl with a matching hat and moved his tiny fingers.

'thrice the worry'

Her outfit was a patriotic red and white as she made her first public appearance with her St George's Day baby.

Minutes after the brief photocall, the couple headed home with William emerging with his son in a car seat and holding Kate's hand.

"Thrice the worry now," a smiling William said, holding up three fingers.

Earlier, he had brought Prince George, four, and Princess Charlotte, who turns three on May 2, to see their new brother.

Asked how they felt, he said: "They're very happy. We're delighted."

Kate, 36, gave birth to the 8lb 7oz baby boy at 11.01am after being admitted to hospital just before 6am Monday in the early stage of labour.

"We didn't keep you waiting too long this time," William told reporters afterwards.



Asked whether they had decided on a name, the second in line to the throne added: "You'll find out soon enough."

William, 35, is expected to spend much of the next fortnight at home on what is effectively paternity leave although palace officials declined to use the term.

A spokesman said: "He has got some meetings in the next week but for the next couple of weeks his focus will be on supporting his wife and family. He will be focusing on supporting the Duchess."

He and Kate already have the help of a Spanish nanny, Maria Teresa Turrion Borrallo, and have no plans to employ any extra help in the foreseeable future, according to Kensington Palace.

She has often dressed

George and Charlotte in Spanish clothes but for the new baby's first public appearance the Cambridges stuck to royal tradition.

His shawl was from GH Hurt & Son Ltd, a company with longstanding connections to the Royal Family. Other royals who had the firm's shawls include William, George and Charlotte.

During their visit it was George, a future King, who looked apprehensive in front of a bank of photographers and television cameras, while confident Charlotte turned to wave at the press as she led the way up the steps holding her father's hand.

Kensington Palace said: "Their Royal Highnesses would like to thank all staff at the hospital for the care and treatment they have received."

Waiting royalists overjoyed as latest Prince makes his debut

THROUGH rain and shine, blistering heat and numbing cold, they waited...some as long as 15 days.

And on Monday it paid off for the devoted royal fans camped outside St Mary's Hospital in Paddington, west London, hoping to catch a glimpse of the new baby Prince. Many, wrapped in the Union Flag, were there long before the world's media arrived when the Duchess of Cambridge went into labour – on St George's Day. John Loughrey, 63, who is part of a group who have been camped outside the hospital, said he was delighted. "We are so pleased," he added. "We have been here for 15 days. I'm so pleased it's St George's Day."

'good for our country'

Mr. Loughrey, from Streatham, south London, said he plans to celebrate the birth with flags and fish and chips. "It didn't matter whether it was a boy or a girl as long as it's a healthy baby and a healthy mother," he added. "It's very good for our country and of course Her Majesty the Queen."

Terry Hutt, who is

another member of the group, was also thrilled. Mr Hutt, who will be celebrating his 83rd birthday at the end of the month, had been hoping to share his birthday, and said: "It's fantastic to have another newborn baby."

"If they were born on my birthday, I would have got a birthday cake."

royal memorabilia

Before the baby news broke, Maria Scott, 46, from Newcastle, added: "I think it's going to be a boy and I think it's going to be quick."

The group set up a makeshift camp, which was covered in royal memorabilia and a Union Flag tent.

When the moment came, town crier Tony Appleton, 81, unofficially announced the birth on the steps of the Lindo Wing, marking the moment by saying "God save the Queen".

Crowds also gathered at the gates of Buckingham Palace to glimpse the presentation of a bulletin, placed on a golden easel, to announce the arrival of the fifth in line to the throne. The ritual has been taking place

since 1837 when the palace became the official residence for the monarch. It was at 2.30pm that senior footman Olivia Smith and footman Heather McDonald headed across the gravel in front of the palace to a roar from the waiting crowd. The bulletin had details of the birth, including the 11.01am delivery time, along with the signatures of the senior medical team who cared for the Duchess.

'never forget the date'

It said: "Her Royal Highness the Duchess of Cambridge was safely delivered of a son at 11.01 today. Her Royal Highness and her son are both doing well."

Luigi Ritacca, who was among the crowd and celebrating his 31st birthday, said he felt happy to share the day with baby royal. "I'll never forget the date, that's for sure," he said.

"Of course, it's stolen my thunder a little, but as long as they don't name him Luigi, I'll be fine," he added.

In a statement, Kensington Palace said: "Her Royal Highness the Duchess of Cambridge was safely delivered of a son at 11:01hrs."



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Donald Trump to 'meet the Queen' on flying visit

Donald Trump will visit the UK on Friday, 13 July, the White House and Downing Street have confirmed.

It will be his first visit to Britain since he was elected in 2016. He had been due to open the new US Embassy in London in February but cancelled the trip.

Theresa May's spokesman said the US President will hold bilateral talks with the Prime Minister, with further details to be "set out in due course".

The trip is only being billed as a "flying visit" rather than an official state one, which would have seen Mr Trump hosted by the Queen.

But the US leader will still reportedly meet Her Majesty on the 24-hour trip, which will follow a NATO summit.

The visit will be held predominantly outside London, amid the fear of protests, The Telegraph reported.

The newspaper said Mr Trump will stay overnight and hold talks with Mrs May at her countryside retreat of Chequers.

Mr Trump had been urged earlier to stay away from London because there is a risk of "major protests, crime and disorder".

In a letter, six conservative groups who support the US President suggested he visit his "ancestral home" of Scotland instead.

Foreign Secretary Boris Johnson hailed the "fantastic" news of Mr Trump's visit.

"Looking forward to seeing our closest ally and friend on the GREATest visit ever," he wrote in a post on Twitter.

Windrush families to get UK citizenship for free, says Rudd

Frantic damage control after huge immigration blunder leaves Caribbean nationals who have lived in the UK for decades facing deportation

THE GOVERNMENT moved quickly this week to assure thousands of people from the so-called Windrush generation that they will be fast-tracked to formal British citizenship, with Amber Rudd announcing she is waiving the usual fees.

The pledge comes amid a national uproar over the plight of Caribbean nationals who came to Britain legally between 1948 and 1973 but have lost jobs and homes, been denied medical treatment and travel documents and been threatened with deportation. They were snared by laws aimed at illegal immigrants when they could not produce paperwork to prove their legal status.

Ms Rudd insisted to MPs on Monday that Labour as well as Tory failures had contributed to the problem. She declared: "I want to enable the Windrush generation to acquire the status they deserve – British citizenship – quickly, at no cost and with proactive assistance."

She will waive fees of at least £1,300 charged to those who want to apply for a passport, and children seeking British naturalisation, whether or not they have documentation. Citizenship applicants from the group will also be exempted from language and UK customs tests. Ms Rudd admitted: "We were too slow to realise there was a group of people that needed to be treated differently, and the system was too bureaucratic when these people were in touch."

The Tories' so-called "hostile environment" policy towards potential

terrorists has come under focus as a result of the affair but Ms Rudd said successive governments have introduced measures to combat illegal immigration since the 1980s.

She said: "This is a failure by successive governments to ensure these individuals have the documentation they need and this is what we must urgently put right. Because it's abundantly clear that everyone considers people who came in the Windrush generation to be British."

People from the Caribbean stuck in their home countries while visiting for a holiday after decades of living in the UK will be helped to return to Britain as part of "putting this right".

Labour Shadow Home Secretary Diane Abbott said MPs and others had warned for years about the problems for Windrush migrants, but had been ignored. She said similar problems could be in the pipeline for other Commonwealth citizens falling foul of the Tory crackdown.

Labour former minister David Lammy stressed that every person in the Caribbean was there because of the European slave trade and Commonwealth citizens were in the UK because they were born under the British empire. Former children's TV presenter Baroness Benjamin, a Lib Dem peer who came to Britain as a child in 1960 from Trinidad, told the House of Lords: "The British public are furious at the Government-created Windrush fiasco. It's a matter of national shame."

Two Italians charged over Anfield attack

Two Italians have been charged after a man was seriously injured in an attack before Liverpool's Champions League match with Roma on Tuesday.

Merseyside Police said Filippo Lombardi, 20, has been charged with violent disorder and inflicting grievous bodily harm against the 53-year-old on Tuesday evening.

Daniele Sciusco, 29, has been charged with violent disorder.

Both men have been kept in custody, and were due to appear at South Sefton Magistrates Court on Friday.

Sean Cox, a father of three from Dunboyne, Co Meath, suffered serious head injuries when he was assaulted outside Anfield stadium.

Bear named Hamish

The first polar bear born in the UK for 25 years has been called Hamish after more than 33,000 people took part in a public vote.

The male cub, now four months old, was born in a special enclosure at the Highland Wildlife Park near Kingussie in the week before Christmas.

His mother, Victoria, mated with Arktos - one of two male bears at the park.

The Royal Zoological Society of Scotland (RZSS) drew up a shortlist of four names - Hamish, Artor, MacKinnon and Poulsen.

Hamish was the runaway winner, claiming 21,000 of the 33,000 votes cast.

The park's head of living collections, Douglas Richardson, said it was "clear from the first day of voting" that the eventual winner would be most popular.

It was an "ideal" name for a "polar bear born in the Highlands", the zoological society said.

UK becomes 'staycation nation'

Homebody Brits shunning foreign vacations in record numbers, new figures show

BRITAIN has become a "staycation nation" with more than half the country planning to take their summer holiday in the UK this year, new figures have revealed.

With many families feeling the pinch, some 57 per cent of holidaymakers will stay on home soil this tourist season. And the "staycation" craze is set to boost the UK economy by a whopping £31 billion.

A traditional jaunt to the seaside remains a firm favourite, with 55 per cent flocking to Britain's beaches this year. For the fourth consecutive year, Cornwall tops the chart as Britain's top holiday destination. Devon takes second position and Bournemouth third. The UK's rural landscape is also seen as a jewel of our national heritage and is the second most popular destination for a summer holiday for many Britons. This year, a third of adults are taking a rural break, with the top destinations the Lake District, Scottish Highlands and the Cotswolds. City breaks are the third most popular type of holidays, with London, Edinburgh and Bath being top destinations this year.

The annual holiday report by Travelodge surveyed 3,000 British adults, and found the UK tourist industry is flourishing. Shakila Ahmed, of Travelodge, said: "Our annual holiday index confirms that we have become a staycation nation. "More Britons than ever are exploring what makes Great Britain so great, which is great news for our economy. "We are seeing more Britons booking three-in-one holidays. This includes taking a city, rural and coastal break as part of a one-week holiday."

Britons are also taking shorter breaks, with the average length of the summer staycation now just one week. But while choosing to remain on home soil, the study shows British holidaymakers are spoiling themselves, splashing out a little extra on their summer break. The average spend on this year's stay at home vacation will be £823 - an increase of 37 per cent

from last year. It is also the highest spend since Travelodge started its annual holiday index in 2011, when the average spend was £399.

The research also found 85 per cent of Brits now take three staycation breaks a year on average. The report also revealed that 38 per cent of Britons want to holiday in the UK rather than Europe in order to support their economy. The UK's top staycationers are from Newcastle, with 82 per cent from the city revealing they are taking a staycation break this summer, with the average spend at £762. People from Wolverhampton took second place, with 77 per cent of residents

spending £788 on their staycation summer break. Separate studies have revealed that our holiday choices tend to be governed by when we were born. Millennials - those aged between 16 and 34 - tend to still shun staycations. While most other age groups are increasingly taking advantage of the chance to holiday at home, figures from Visit England show this younger generation still prefer to go abroad. The tourist board statistics showed that, while more and more of us like to holiday at home, the number of millennials choosing a staycation has dropped by 1.4 million over the past decade.

US tycoon in daring £600m swoop for Wembley stadium

Auto parts billionaire seeks to turn national stadium into home for NFL team

An American billionaire has bid £600 million to buy Wembley stadium from the Football Association.

The audacious offer by Shahid Khan could make the 90,000-capacity national stadium home to an American football team.

The Pakistan-born tycoon has reached an outline agreement with Martin Glenn, chief executive of the Football Association (FA), was being discussed by the governing body's full board at press time Thursday.

The new Wembley stadium was opened in 2007 at a cost of almost £800 million, with the FA receiving £161 million of taxpayers' money for the project.

Mr Khan already owns Fulham Football Club in west London and the Florida-based Jacksonville Jaguars, which is reported to be considering using Wembley to host half the 16 games it plays each season.

The deal could lead to the England football team playing more matches at stadiums around the country and the FA Cup semi-finals being transferred to other neutral venues. The FA Cup final would remain at Wembley.

grassroots sports

The Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport, which helped fund the new stadium, said it wanted a guarantee that Wembley would "remain the home of English football for generations to come".

The FA is reported to have pledged to use

the proceeds of the sale to invest in grassroots football, with reports that it could pay for 1,500 new artificial, full-sized pitches across England.

The association would retain control of the "Club Wembley" seats and the debenture scheme which has been estimated to be worth about £350 million and generates revenue of about £40 million a year.

Football's governing body said in a statement after news of the bid was broken by the *Evening Standard*:

"We can confirm that the FA has received an offer to buy Wembley stadium."

The current stadium opened in 2007 and replaced the privately owned venue that hosted the 1948 Olympics and the 1966 World Cup.

The FA received a £120 million Sport England grant from the National Lottery to buy the old stadium, £21 million from the London Development Agency and £20 million to improve surrounding infrastructure from the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport.

It was unclear if any money would be returned to the public bodies but the FA was reported to be seeking an agreement that the grants would not have to be repaid if the proceeds of the Wembley sale went into grassroots sport.

Mr Khan, 67, who made his fortune in car parts industry, said on Thursday: "I understand the responsibility and accountability that would be ours to accept, and at all times we will

be guided so the stadium and Wembley brand are both protected and enhanced.

"We will take excellent care of Wembley stadium in every respect, and at all times be good citizens and neighbours here in London and beyond.

'victory for everyone'

"I am grateful for all of my experiences and investments in London, and am privileged to have this opportunity with the FA to forge an agreement that I am certain will be a victory for everyone."

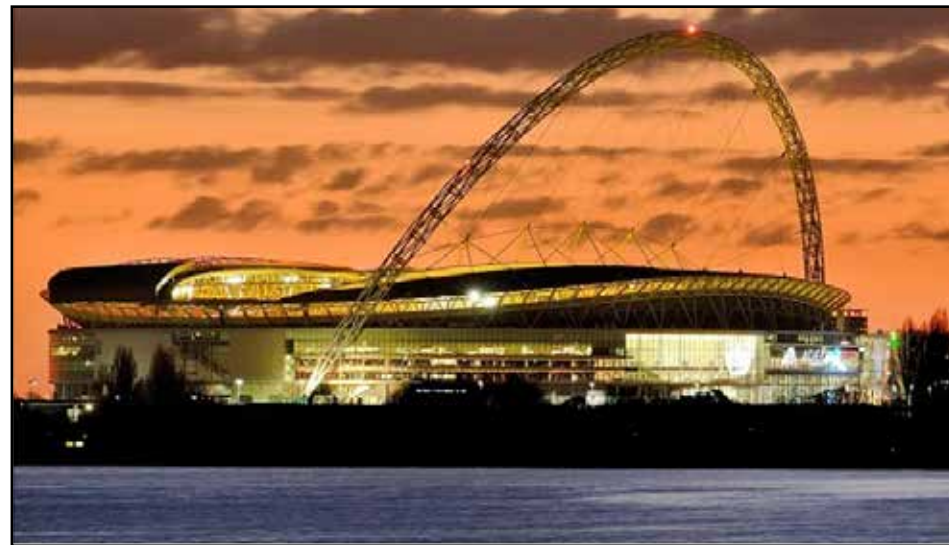
Mr Khan arrived in the United States aged 16 with just \$500 in his pocket. His net worth is now estimated by Forbes at \$7.2 billion (£5.2bn), placing him among the 250 richest people in the world.

He stressed that the Jacksonville Jaguars' matches at Wembley were vital to the financial stability of the team. The Jaguars have played regular home games at Wembley in each of the past five seasons and will continue to do so at least through to the 2020 season.

'very ambitious'

"If my ownership interests were to include Wembley stadium, it would protect the Jaguars' position in London at a time when other NFL teams are understandably becoming more interested in this great city," he said.

Mr Khan sought to reassure supporters of Fulham FC, which he bought in 2013, that the Wembley bid would not mean the

club leaving its Craven Cottage ground on the banks of the Thames in west London.

Slaviša Jokanović, the Fulham manager, said today: "Mr Khan told me about his plan a year and a half ago. He's very ambitious."

A Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport spokesman said: "We would like to hear more detail about the way in which such a deal would help the development of the game in this country from the grassroots up. We also want to be reassured that Wembley

would remain the home of English football for generations to come."

A Sport England spokeswoman said: "Sport England invested £120 million of National Lottery money into the development of Wembley stadium. We look forward to hearing more detail about how such a deal would work and whether it would benefit grassroots sport."

The NFL has a deal with Tottenham Hotspur football club for two games a year to be played at its new White Hart Lane stadium in north London for the

next 10 years.

The NFL said in a statement: "We are very happy for Shad Khan and the Jacksonville Jaguars. The potential purchase of Wembley stadium is a further powerful sign of their commitment to the UK and their vision to help us grow the sport. Having stadium options in London has always been critical to the NFL and, in tandem with our ten-year partnership with Tottenham Hotspur, this new relationship would allow for even greater flexibility in scheduling future NFL games in London."

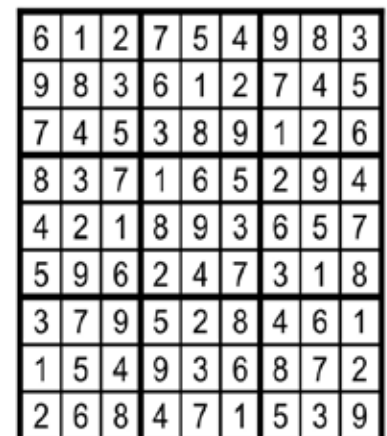

Richard III: has history been unkind?

Exclusive interview with author Chris Skidmore on his biography of Richard III, the king found under the parking lot, who is most infamously accused of killing the princes in the tower



"The rise of the Tudors could not be properly understood unless you also looked at the downfall of Richard III, England's most controversial king," says Richard III author Chris Skidmore.

"When I looked at what had been written about Richard, there wasn't actually a comprehensive modern narrative biography of the king. The last author who attempted to do this was Paul Murray Kendall in 1955. There have been

so many discoveries in the archives since then, not to mention the discovery of Richard's body in 2012. In the UK, Richard III has been consistently nominated as the most interesting character in British history. So, I thought there was no better time to write a complete and comprehensive life of the king for the twenty-first century."

Richard was immortalized by Shakespeare's play, but was he really as portrayed, a physically deformed murderer? In 2012 his skeleton was discovered under a parking lot in Leicester, fittingly enough under a parking spot labeled "R". As a historian Skidmore writes the authoritative biography of Richard III, a man praised as a saint and cursed as a usurper king.

The War of the Roses between the Yorks and

Lancasters was raging from the time Richard is born. To keep the crown did he kill his nephews, the princes in the tower? Or was it clever propaganda, fake news by the Tudors? Richard became king under suspicious circumstances. And he was the last English king to die on the battlefield at Bosworth field.

"My last book, *The Rise of the Tudors*, focused on how the Tudor family rose from relative obscurity in Wales to become challengers to the throne," says Skidmore. "I looked at the remarkable young career of Henry Tudor, who defeated Richard III at the battle of Bosworth in 1485. Henry was exiled in France from a young age, but then came back to seize the throne. The English nobility turned against Richard III after he had decided to take the throne from his

nephew Edward V, one of the princes in the tower."

Skidmore's interest in the history of his country started as a child, with his local church and its history spanning centuries. His office overlooks Westminster Hall, built in the fourteenth century and that hosted coronation the banquets of Richard III and Henry VIII.

Skidmore says there are thousands of documents in the National Archives in Kew, near London, that have yet to be cataloged, and that some remain unread.

"I love looking for new material in the map room there," says Skidmore. "I order up a box at a time. It's a case of going through, paper by paper. Like panning for gold, but it's worth it for the nuggets of new information. There is obviously all the secondary reading and primary source material

that has to be covered, but I believe the whole point of writing a new history book is that you must have something new to say, and ideally new information to publish."

It took Skidmore four years to research and write this book. At the same time he's been a government minister, fought two general elections, married and had two children.

Richard III is Skidmore's fourth book. He wrote his first book at age 26, ten years ago, a biography on Edward VI, then *Death and the Virgin Queen* about Elizabeth I and her relationship with Robert Dudley, then *Rise of the Tudors*. *Richard III* is shortlisted for Best Non-Fiction Book at the Parliamentary Book Awards hosted by the Publishers Association. *Death and the Virgin Queen* was commended for the Johnathan Rhys Llewellyn Prize. *Richard*

III has yet to be optioned for film or TV. *Death and the Virgin Queen* was made into the documentary *The Virgin Queen's Fatal Affair*, that won a Royal Television Society Award for Best Documentary Specialist Factual.

Skidmore is currently writing a book on Henry VII. Skidmore is based in London and Bristol, and is the MP for Kingswood, South Gloucestershire. He was born in Bristol, where his family is still based.

Meet Victoria Parks-Murphy from Dublin/London who moved to LA four years ago to pursue home ownership!

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

I'm originally from the States, a small town in Illinois called Galesburg, but I spent 15 years living in Dublin and then London. baby and headed to LA! The first day I had ever visited LA was the day we moved here! We were so lucky to have wonderful friends here who loaned us their home for several months while we took time to buy our house. The first year felt like a constant holiday and we haven't looked back since.

What do you miss most from home?

We have wonderful friends in London, but we still get back once a year for regular visits, which is great. I also miss shopping on Regent Street. My office was right in Oxford Circus and on my lunch break I would often have a quick wander through H&M, Liberty, Esprit or one of the shops on Carnaby St.

What was your first impression of LA and has it changed since?

(2) Upon the request of a party to an action affecting the family, including a revision of judgment or order under sec. 767.59 or 767.451:

(a) The Family Court Commissioner shall, with

or without charge, provide the party with written information on the following, as appropriate to the action commenced:

1. The procedure for obtaining a judgment or order in the action.
 2. The major issues usually addressed in such an action.
 3. Community resources and family court counseling services available to assist the parties.

(b) Except as provided under chs. 48 and 938, whoever intentionally causes a child to leave, takes a child away, or withholds a child for more than 12 hours beyond the court-approved period of physical placement or visitation period from a legal custodian with intent to deprive the custodian of his or her custody rights without the consent of the custodian is guilty of a Class F felony. This paragraph is not applicable if the court has entered an order authorizing the person to so take or withhold the child. The fact that joint legal custody has been awarded to both parents by a court does not preclude a court from finding that one parent has committed a violation of this paragraph.

(2) Whoever causes a child to leave, takes a child away or withholds a child for more than 12 hours from the child's parents, or in the case of a nonmarital child whose parents do not subsequently intermarry under sec. 767.803, from the child's mother, or if he has been granted

legal custody, the child's father, without the consent of the parents, the mother or the father with legal custody, is guilty of a Class I felony. This subsection is not applicable if legal custody has been granted by court order to the person taking or withholding the child.

(3) Any parent, or any person acting pursuant to directions from the parent, who does any of the following is guilty of a Class F felony:

- (a) Intentionally hides a child from the child's other parent.
- (b) After being served with process in an action affecting the family but prior to the issuance of a temporary or final order determining child custody rights, takes the child or causes the child to leave with intent to deprive the other parent of physical custody as defined in sec. 822.02(9).
- (c) After issuance of a temporary or final order specifying joint legal custody rights and periods of physical placement, takes a child from or causes a child to leave the other parent in violation of the order or withholds a child for more than 12 hours beyond the court-approved period of physical placement or visitation period.

(4) (a) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution for violation of this section if the action:

1. Is taken by a parent or by a person authorized by a parent to protect his or her child in a situation in which

the parent or authorized person reasonably believes that there is a threat of physical harm or sexual assault to the child;

2. Is taken by a parent fleeing in a situation in which the parent reasonably believes that there is a threat of physical harm or sexual assault to himself or herself;

Salah scoops PFA gong

Liverpool forward Mo Salah has won the Professional Footballers' Association (PFA) player of the year award for the 2017-2018 season.

The prize was awarded to Salah Sunday night by his fellow Premier League players, beating other big names such as David Silva, Kevin de Bruyne, David de Gea and Harry Kane.

"This is a great honour, I'm very happy to win it," Salah said in a response.

The 25-year-old Egyptian forward has scored 31 goals in 34 matches this season so far, tying him with Alan Shearer, Cristiano Ronaldo and Luis Suarez for the record.

With four games left, Salah has the opportunity to become the sole record

holder for most goals scored in one Premier League season.

It is Salah's first season at Liverpool after he transferred from AS Roma last year for more than \$51m, making him the most expensive player ever bought by Liverpool.

Salah, who also plays for Egypt's national team, has quickly become a darling of the English football community.

His prolific debut season has led to comparisons with Suarez, who moved from Liverpool to Barcelona in 2014 after helping the Merseyside club come close to winning the league title with 31 goals in 33 matches.

Currently, Liverpool lie third in the Premier League, behind

Manchester City and Manchester United.

During Sunday's award ceremony, the PFA also awarded the prizes for best young player and female players.

Leroy Sane of Manchester City scooped the award for best young player.

And Salah celebrated his award in fine style Tuesday night with another astonishing performance as Liverpool beat Roma 5-2 in the first leg of their Champions League semi final

On a memorable European night at Anfield, the Egyptian scored twice and made two more goals as Liverpool tore through the Italian defence. Salah

now has 43 goals in 47 appearances this season - a record that does not look out of place next to the elite attacking players in the game: Lionel Messi, Cristiano Ronaldo and Neymar.

And there have been calls for him to be the next winner of the most prestigious individual accolade in world football.

"You've got to give him the Ballon d'Or," former Wales midfielder Robbie Savage told BBC Radio 5 live following Salah's second goal on Tuesday. "He is that good."

Former Liverpool striker Robbie Fowler, who was nominated for the award in 1996, described Salah as a "phenomenal player".

"The form and confidence he's in at the minute, to have the class and style to score those goals just speaks measures of the man," Fowler told BBC Radio 5 live.

Ten man Atleti punish Gunners

EUROPA LEAGUE: Antoine Griezmann punished Arsenal's lax defence late on as 10-man Atletico Madrid salvaged a 1-1 draw from the Europa League semi-final first leg at Emirates Stadium Thursday night.

The visitors were on the back foot for almost the entire game after defender Sime Vrsaljko was dismissed for two yellow cards in the first 10 minutes.

With Atletico's furious manager Diego Simeone sent to the stands shortly afterwards, the Spanish side survived unscathed to half-time with Alexandre Lacazette clipping the post with a half-volley in the hosts' best chance.

Lacazette nodded in Jack Wilshere's cross just after the hour to apparently edge the Gunners closer to a Europa League final send-off for outgoing manager Arsene Wenger.

But with eight minutes remaining Griezmann

latched onto a long ball forward, shrugged off Laurent Koscielny and stabbed into the net at the second attempt for an away goal to swing the tie Atletico's way going into the second leg in Madrid next Thursday.

Arsenal's fans were left ruing a familiar combination of wasteful finishing and costly lapses in concentration as the teams departed to a muted response in Wenger's final home European game.

Their team now must breach an Atletico defence that has conceded just four times at home in La Liga this season to have any hope of extending Wenger's 22-season spell in charge to the final on 16 May.

In contrast to Arsenal, Atletico Madrid's defensive discipline has served them well in recent continental campaigns, grinding out victory in four of their five European semi-finals over the past nine seasons.

But the Spaniards' usual pragmatism deserted them as they self-combusted in the opening 13 minutes.

Croatian right-back Vrsaljko was booked as he caught Jack Wilshere late in the second minute and, instead of showing the requisite caution, blundered into Lacazette with his studs up eight minutes later.

So early in the contest, Atletico may have expected referee Clement Turpin to limit punishment to a stern and final warning.

But the 35-year-old Frenchman judged the challenge rather than the occasion and showed Vrsaljko a justified second yellow.

Simeone was exasperated by that decision and incensed by Turpin opting not to book Hector Bellerin shortly after. The Argentine was dispatched to the stands after aiming a stream of invective at the official.

If any side is suited to surviving such a

precarious situation though, it is Atletico.

Midfielder Thomas Partey slotted back into defence, forward Griezmann dropped deeper and their whole side set about absorbing Arsenal's pressure and running down the clock.

The visitors rode their luck at times, with Lacazette grazing the post with an awkward half-volley, but had chances of their own in the first half with

Griezmann thumping a fierce shot straight at David Ospina.

As Simeone stood impatiently in a gangway high above and his assistant German Burgos orchestrated from the sidelines, their side threatened to throttle the life out of the game.

The tightest defence in La Liga - with only 18 goals conceded in 34 games - was finally undone as Wilshere dug out a cross and Lacazette

hung above Lucas Hernandez to score his 16th of the season.

With Griezmann lurking though, Atletico always retained the power to land a sucker punch.

The France international was played inside by dawdling Nacho Monreal before he hustled Koscielny into a swiped, unsuccessful clearance and applied the finish to spark delirium in the away section.

Injured Ox out of World Cup

England's Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain will miss the World Cup this summer after injuring a knee during Liverpool's Champions League tie against Roma.

The 24-year-old midfielder was taken off on a stretcher in the 15th minute of Tuesday's match at Anfield after challenging Aleksandar Kolarov.

He had a scan on Wednesday which revealed a knee ligament injury.

"Absolutely devastated to have picked up this injury at such a crucial time," said Oxlade-Chamberlain.

He also said the injury "pales in comparison"

to the news of a man being left in a critical condition after being attack outside Anfield before the match.

It is understood Oxlade-Chamberlain spoke to England manager Gareth Southgate to inform him about the injury.

"The extent of the injury means Oxlade-Chamberlain is set to miss the remainder of the campaign for Liverpool, as well as the World Cup in Russia with England," Liverpool said in a statement.

"Oxlade-Chamberlain will now begin a rehabilitation programme to enable him to reach full fitness again as soon as possible,

returning to action next season."

The Reds added there would be "no specific timescale" on the former Arsenal player's return.

Oxlade-Chamberlain, capped 32 times, joined the Anfield side from the Gunners last summer for £35m and has made 41 appearances in all competitions, scoring five goals.

Liverpool beat Roma 5-2 in the first leg of their Champions League semi-final tie, with the return leg in Italy next Wednesday.

England will face Belgium, Panama and Tunisia in Group G at the World Cup, which begins on 14 June.
