■ May brands Arena attack 'an act of sickening cowardice'
■ One year on, songs of peace, joy and hope fill the air

THE Prime Minister spoke out in defiance against terrorism on Tuesday on the first anniversary of the Manchester Arena bomb.

As Theresa May joined Prince William at a moving candle-lit memorial service at Manchester Cathedral she branded Salman Abedi's attack "an act of sickening cowardice". The Islamic State-inspired killer murdered 22 adults and children – the youngest Saffi e-Rose Roussos aged just eight – with a suicide bomb at an Ariana Grande concert. The attack left 800 people

injured.

Mrs May declared: "The targeting of the young and innocent as they enjoyed a carefree night out was an act of sickening cowardice.

"It was designed to strike at the heart of our values and our way of life, in one of our most vibrant cities, with the aim of breaking our resolve and dividing us. It failed.

"As we gather in

Manchester Cathedral we join in solidarity to remember the 22 children and adults who so tragically lost their lives.

"Such appalling acts of wickedness will do nothing but strengthen our resolve to defeat such twisted ideologies and beliefs.

"The resilience and determination shown by this city in the 12 months since is testament to that.

"All of you are the very

best of what this country stands for."

Mrs May was joined at the 2pm memorial service by the Duke of Cambridge, Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn and the Mayor of Greater Manchester Andy Burnham. The congregation and the city observed a minute's silence at 2.30pm for the victims, a silence also observed by MPs in Westminster. Prince William, fresh from his brother Harry's Windsor wedding, was greeted with cheers by huge crowds gathered outside.

During the remembrance service, Prince William gave a bible reading called The Gift of Love, which included the passage: "If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels but do not have love, I am but a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. Love is patient, love is kind, love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude.

"It does not insist on its own way. It is not irritable or resentful, it does not rejoice in wrongdoing but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes

all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends."

The Prince and the Prime Minister joined hundreds of others to hang tribute messages on "Trees of Hope" in the city centre. People can add their messages to the 28 Japanese maple trees until Sunday. The service was beamed to giant city centre screens and to York Minster, Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral and Glasgow Cathedral. Invited guests included survivors, families, friends and

first-responders. Dean of Manchester Rogers Govender told them: "We come together to remember with love those whose lives were lost and those whose lives have been changed forever."

Rabbi Warren Elf adapted a reading from the Yizkor memorial prayer, which is said for the dead in the Jewish faith. As images of the victims were displayed on screens, 22 candles burned on the altar, made using the wax from the thousands left at city centre memorials in their memory in the hours after the disaster. The Bishop of Manchester the Rt Rev David Walker concluded the service saying: "This cathedral is here, Manchester is here and you who were hurt or bereaved 12 months ago are forever part of Manchester."

In the evening choirs sang in Manchester's Albert Square, outside the Town Hall. Paul Hodgson, stepfather of victim Olivia Campbell-Hardy, 15, said of the anniversary: "We're going to get through it with friends and family, the 22 families together. We remember all of them and we're going to make them proud."

"With Manchester, you kick one of us, you kick all of us, and we'll all get up, and we'll all start fighting again."

Cut the stiff upper lip, BBC reporters ordered

■ "Auntie Beeb can stay home", staff told in informal approach to royal wedding

IF THE BBC coverage of the Royal Wedding seemed more informal than in the past, it was no accident.

It emerged this week that BBC bosses told its star presenters to avoid "stiff upper lips" when covering the wedding in a memo where it presumed to "give advice to royalty".

The secret orders were illustrated by a photograph of a suited BBC radio announcer and stated: "Please don't go all stiff upper lip on us. Auntie Beeb can stay at home."

"This isn't an exclusive pomp and pageantry affair, but one that everyone can join in."

In the memo headed: The Royal Wedding - Share The Love, broadcasters were urged to take a

"fun" and a "down to earth" tone with viewers.

It boasted: "We've created three trailers giving tips/advice to the happy couple."

"It's all part of our democratization of this campaign where everyday people can give advice to royalty."

The guide also describes Harry as a

"lovable prince" and Meghan as a "woman of the world".

The memo went on: "The world has changed a lot since the wedding of William and Kate, ie. social media advancement, female empowerment and inclusivity."

"The marriage is the perfect way to represent a modern BBC, one that is progressive, in touch and human. We should feel like we're the ones enjoying being at the party, rather than simply reporting the party."

And congratulating itself on its trailers, the BBC enthused: "We can see in the style, tone and language of the royal couple that they are all for our idea."

The memo says star presenters have invited their partners in to "give the royal couple some helpful/ insightful advice".

The wedding attracted a peak of more than 13.1 million viewers to BBC One. ITV's audience peaked with 3.6 million viewers, at a different time. The combined average audience for BBC and ITV was about 11 million. The BBC's coverage, led by presenters Kirsty Young,

Huw Edwards and Dermot O'Leary, attracted an average of 8.7 million viewers and a 63.9 per cent share, between 9am

and 2pm. ITV, fronted by Phillip Schofield and Julie Etchingam, averaged 2.5 million viewers and an 18.6 per cent share between 9.25am and 3pm. On BBC One, the FA Cup Final averaged 6.7 million viewers and peaked at 8.7 million.

How a £30m 'ring of steel' kept the royal wedding safe

ONE of the nation's biggest ever security operations went off without a hitch on Saturday allowing the world to see Britain at its best.

Thousands of police officers and troops were deployed to create a £30million ring of steel around Windsor. The wedding was a security nightmare. Harry and Meghan's open-topped carriage ride through old Windsor and up the Long Walk left them vulnerable to attack. And the gathering of the great and the good in the St George's Chapel also presented a target for terrorists. But armed police lined the route while undercover officers and Special Forces soldiers mingled with the crowds. Snipers with spotters were posted on rooftops on the lookout for any threat.

Tensions were high because Britain's official threat level from international terrorism is "severe" which means an attack is "highly likely". Security planning began when the wedding was announced last November with experts walking

the route and building up profiles of the riskiest locations. Road blocks and automatic number-plate recognition cameras helped police control access to the most sensitive areas and watch out for known suspect vehicles. A ban on drones flying overhead eliminated another risk as did an overflight ban during the wedding. Helicopters protected the skies above Windsor, while marine police were patrolling the Thames. But as the happy couple left "Fortress Windsor" on Sunday, the security forces were able to congratulate themselves on an operation which went like a dream.

• AN ISLAMIC State supporter urged "lone wolf" jihadis to inject poison into ice cream in supermarkets and attack Prince George at his school, a court heard this week. Husnain Rashid posted a photo of the prince with the message: "Even the Royal Family will not be left alone," jurors at Woolwich Crown Court in London were told.

Rashid, 32, of Nelson, Lancashire, denies three counts of engaging in conduct in preparation of terrorist acts, one count of encouraging terrorism, and two of dissemination of a terrorist publication. The trial continues.



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Romanian now second most common non-UK nationality

People with Romanian nationality have become the second most common non-British population living in the UK.

The Office for National Statistics says the total number of Romanian nationals rose by 25% from 2016 to 2017, reaching 411,000.

Of the 65,176,000 residents in the UK, 6.2 million were non-UK nationals - up by 4%.

The number of people living in the UK but born abroad was up by 3% from 2016 - 9.4 million of the total population.

A problem with the collection of statistics means there is no overall net migration figure.

The government has committed to a target to reduce net migration to below 100,000 in its manifestos of 2010, 2015 and 2017.

The figures show that 61% of the non-UK nationals number - or 3.8 million - are from the EU.

Wedding goodie bag sells for £21,000

A COMMUNITY champion invited to the Royal Wedding sold her free gift bag for more than £21,000.

Canvas bags inscribed with Harry and Meghan's initials were given to 1,200 guests who received the "golden ticket" to the nuptials last Saturday. Claire Oliver - who works for an engineering group which offers young people apprenticeships - was among more than 25 non-VIP guests who put theirs up for sale on eBay.

The sales triggering fierce bidding wars, with some sellers willing to send their keepsakes overseas. The 31-year-old, from south-east London, declined to comment.

Give me equal pay with Poldark, says his 'great mate' Eleanor

POLDARK actress Eleanor Tomlinson has said she will be "pretty upset" if the pay gap between her and co-star Aidan Turner in the BBC show has not closed.

While admitting Turner was once the bigger, better-known star, the 25-year-old said she felt they had become "equal leads" on the period drama, which has become a huge hit on this side of the pond too. Tomlinson stressed that in the wake of the entertainment industry's gender pay row she hoped there would be more parity. In an interview the star, who plays Poldark's wife Demelza, was asked whether she thought she and Turner were now paid the same. She replied: "My guess is no. And while at the beginning that might have been OK - he was a bigger star than me - now I don't think so.

"We're equal leads of the show, so I'd be pretty upset if the gap hadn't closed."

But a spokesman for Mammoth Screen, which produces Poldark for the corporation, admitted that Turner was still paid

more. He said: "Whilst we can't and won't disclose the details, we do pay Aidan Turner more for playing Ross Poldark as throughout all series Ross has significantly more screen time than any other character."

'ridiculously protective'

Eleanor will reprise her role as flame-haired Demelza when Poldark returns to screens next month for a fourth series. She stressed that she and Irish heart throb Turner, 34, still enjoyed a very good working relationship. "We're great mates, although we do row," she said. "[We row about] everything - usually our characters. We're both ridiculously protective of them and squabble like an old married couple.

"Usually it's one of us saying that our character wouldn't behave a certain way. Aidan loves everything being his. But then he loves to wind me up."

Asked about Poldark's topless scene in series one, after which Turner fought to keep his clothes on in season two, she said:

"It was all people could talk about. "And when you make eight hours of television and people only remember two scenes, you're like, 'Oh, come on'. Like don't get me wrong. I'm looking, going, 'Sure, yeah. I'm with you ladies.' But I can see why he got frustrated with it."

Eleanor also revealed she nearly did not land the part of Demelza. "Initially they had me down as an Elizabeth," she said. "They told me they couldn't see me as a Demelza at all - they wouldn't even let me audition. It was quite a shock when they offered me the role."

The gender pay row began when BBC China editor Carrie Gracie resigned in protest at the higher salaries of men. It was later revealed that Claire Foy was paid less for playing the Queen in The Crown than her on-screen husband Matt Smith.

ROYAL wedding celebrations went on long into the night on Saturday – and not only for the married couple.

With clear skies and temperatures of up to 72F, Union Flags adorned houses as street parties were hosted up and down the country. Thousands took advantage of extended pub licensing hours to toast the new couple, with many in fancy dress or wearing masks of the Royal Family. A party on Platt Street, Stockport, typified the mood, while in Brighton crowds took to the beach to watch the wedding on a big screen.

In Hackney, east London, some of the revellers enjoying a street party donned wedding dresses with floral embroidery and puffball sleeves that bore comparison to Princess

Diana's own wedding dress. Meanwhile a street party in Hammersmith, west London, attracted worldwide interest.

Lulu Gwynne, the owner of the 1920s-style Betty Blythe cafe, where the party was being hosted, said: "We have been inundated with enquiries and bookings. "We have attracted a global audience with some guests coming from as far as Japan."

Further north, hundreds of people took to Millennium Square in Leeds with picnics and sparkling wine to watch the events unfold on a big screen while they soaked up the sun. David Fryer, from Thorne, near Leeds, said: "I think it's been an amazing event. "If there's anything the Brits can do it's pomp and ceremony and pageantry. We've demonstrated that again.

In Eastwood, Notts, caravanners celebrated by decorating their vehicles in bunting as well as flags

and pictures of Harry and Meghan. More than 50 families gathered on camping chairs to watch the wedding. Singer Adele shared her

own celebration with a photo on Instagram, in which she wore a black polka-dot fascinador and held a flute of bubbly. "Congratulations Meghan

and Harry," the singer wrote in her caption. "You're the most beautiful bride. I can't stop thinking of how happy Princess Diana is upstairs."

■ Poisoned spy's daughter breaks her silence

SALISBURY poisoning victim Yulia Skripal said this week her life has been "turned upside down" by the attempted assassination that left her fighting for her life.

In her first public statement since the attack, the 33-year-old spoke of her suffering in the weeks since she and her father Sergei were exposed to a Russian nerve agent. From a secret London location the spy's daughter said she was "shocked" when she awoke from a coma 20 days after the attack. She said: "We are so lucky to have both survived. Our recovery has been slow and extremely painful.

"The fact that a nerve agent was used to do this is shocking.

"I don't want to describe the details, but the treatment was invasive, painful and depressing."

retaliation

Ms Skripal and her father, a 66-year-old ex-KGB agent, were found slumped over a bench in Salisbury on March 4. They are thought to have been exposed to Novichok, which was developed by the Soviet military in the 1970s. Police said the nerve agent was smeared on the front door handle of Mr Skripal's Salisbury home. Ms Skripal spent

five weeks in hospital recovering. Her father was discharged from Salisbury District Hospital just last week.

It is believed Russian special services attempted to assassinate Mr Skripal in retaliation for his years as a double agent for British intelligence services. The British Government said it is "highly likely" the Kremlin was behind the attack, a claim Russia has repeatedly denied. President Vladimir Putin last week claimed the Skripals would be dead if they had been attacked with a weapons grade agent.

Despite the possibility

Russia was involved, Ms Skripal said she is keen to return home some time in the future. She said: "My life has been turned upside down as I come to terms with the devastating changes thrust upon me physically and emotionally.

"I take one day at a

time and want to help care for my dad till his full recovery. In the longer term I hope to return home to my country."

She said she does not currently want the help of the Russian Embassy, which has repeatedly requested a private audience. Wearing a

light blue summer dress Ms Skripal talked about her time in hospital. She said: "I am grateful to all of the wonderful staff at Salisbury hospital, a place I have become all too familiar with. I also think fondly of those who helped us on the street on the day of the attack."

Meet A Member: Wendy Meredith Bain

Meet Wendy from the Gwent Valley, Wales, who to LA in December last year from London with her husband, Sam to pursue writing and acting.

Tell us about how you made the move to LA

I came here earlier in 2017 the year to pitch a TV show around the big cable networks and saw there was a lot of work here for comedy writers. Thanks to the explosion of cable and streaming it's created a gold rush in the TV business. Whereas years ago it seemed that LA was all about films, the change to TV meant work for everyone. Ironically, my husband Sam Bain is making several comedy movies here which is nearly impossible to do in England. He's loving it here too.

The sunshine was the second big factor in choosing LA. As much as I love Britain the endless

rain does get me down. I love the open spaces of LA and live in Los Feliz near Griffith Park which I love hiking in, not just because it's stunning beauty but because a Welsh man, Griffith Griffiths, donated it to the city and built the Observatory.

What is the biggest difference between LA and your home town?

I love the differences in the architecture and coming from the Rhonda Valley where all the houses look the same I can't get enough of looking at the house styles here. We bought an English Storybook house in Los Feliz built in 1924 by a Yorkshire man called Reuben Simons who had the Simons Brick Company who cleverly found a way to use brick so the house wouldn't fall down in an earthquake. We've had retro-fitting done just in case but it's managed to stay up

almost 100 years so far. People laugh when they see how British our house is here!

What do you miss most from home?

It's usually food, not just juicy pork products like sausages, bacon and scotch eggs but succulent, soft strawberries and new potatoes with fresh mint that pop gently in your mouth. I can live without decent chocolate but strawberries from Waitrose make me pine. Also tea bags, I know you can get them here but they always taste a bit fishy. If anyone's popping back home, my favourite brands are Sainsbury's Red Label or Glengetti Welsh tea. I'm also rather partial to Piccalilli relish with a fresh slice of turkey meat. (I've made myself homesick now). I do find it very strange that they eat turkey for thanksgiving here and

not for Christmas dinner but as long as I can have it cold with Piccalilli later in a sandwich I'm happy.

Do you have any hidden gems to share with us?

The Trail's Café in Griffith Park, they have the best apple pie I found in the city and they make a decent cup of tea.

What would you suggest to other Brits considering a move to LA?

Get current advice on immigration and tax law, both of which seem to have changed a lot recently and what may have been the case a year ago isn't now. We have an international accountant, Clayknox that does taxes for both countries and a good immigration lawyer, Alan Klein.

Lots of our members join Brits in LA seeking out words of wisdom – what is the best piece of advice you've received?

Don't just trust recommendations...do your homework! Trust your instincts! What's right for one person may not be right for you.

How can we find out more about you. Are you working on anything at the moment?

I'm working on a comedy play called 'Old Frenemies' which I'm putting on at the

Hollywood Fringe. It's a great way to try out new work, have something to invite industry people to see and meet a marvelous network of LA actors etc.

The play I've written is a very British-style comedy, based on a true story of a trip back to Wales where I found the owner of the cottage we were renting was my nemesis who stole my childhood sweetheart from me. I have a great cast of actors. Brits in LA's own Craig Robert Young is playing, Gethin. He's hilarious and I'm so lucky to have him breathing laughter into my lines. Richard Rennie a Scottish actor and dancer who's very naughty in the show! (you won't

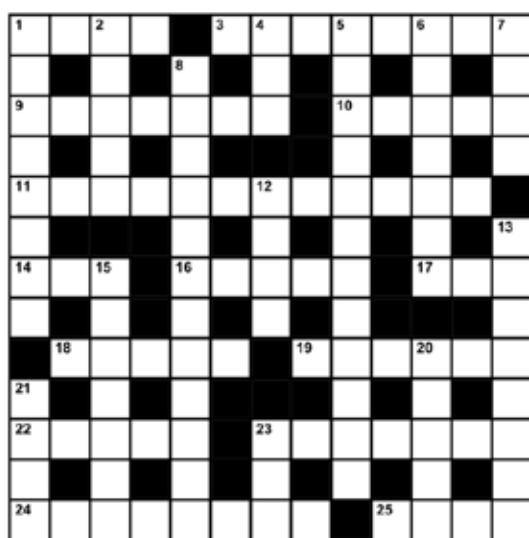

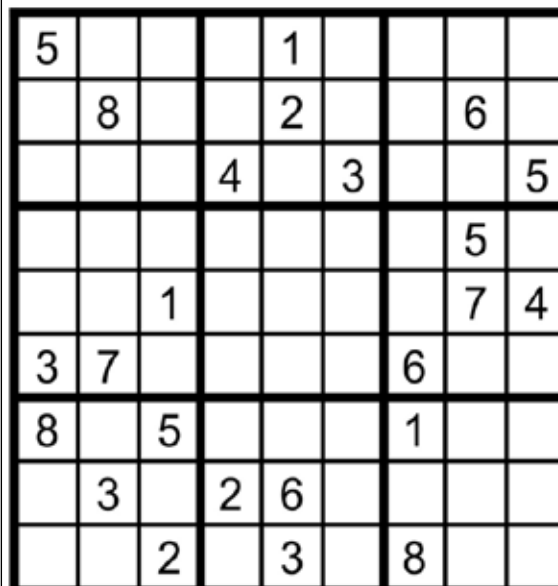

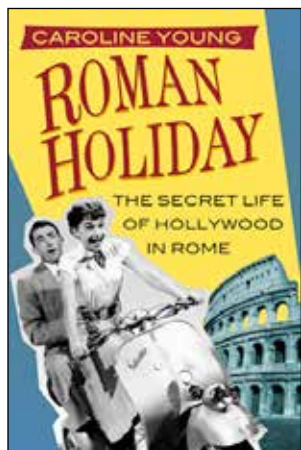

Roman Holiday: La Dolce Vita remembered

Exclusive interview with author Caroline Young discussing her new book about Audrey Hepburn and the glamour of Rome during the making of the film Roman Holiday



"I was thinking of turquoise Fiat 500s, Vespas, drinking negronis in cobbled piazzas and of course the birth of the paparazzi," says Roman Holiday author Caroline Young.

"From there I decided I wanted to look at the wider social context of the rebirth of Rome after the Second World War, the rise of the Italian film industry and the Hollywood productions flocking to Cinecittà, and to tell the story through the eyes of the wonderful

actresses to the city."

Young's book is about the actresses and the paparazzi, the gossip, the love affairs. More about the people than the city, it's a great beach read.

Audrey Hepburn visited Rome as a child in the 1930s and returned to make the timeless film Roman Holiday before staying on as a Roman wife with her second husband in the late 1960s. Young explores Rome of the 1950s and 60s. In the book Hollywood productions are flocking to the city to film at Cinecittà studios. American money is bringing prosperity and confidence back to a city devastated by the war. In the book Ingrid Bergman, Anita Ekberg, Ava Gardner, Audrey Hepburn, Sophia Loren, Anna Magnani and Elizabeth Taylor are filming and relaxing in Rome. Expect glimpses of Brigitte Bardot, Joan Fontaine, Gina

Lollobrigida, Kim Novak and Jane Fonda.

"What I was really struck by was how strong and independent these women were," says Young. "Anna Magnani was a passionate, powerful woman both on and off screen. She was a single mother and she knew her value, demanding she was paid what she was worth, and always asserting that she didn't need a man in her life. Sophia Loren had a tough childhood where she was close to starvation during the war, surviving horrific bombings, and then as a teenager she would wait at the gates of Cinecittà studios in the hopes of being picked as an extra. So she went from a traumatic childhood to becoming one of the most powerful women in cinema. Ava Gardner also lived her life very independently," says Young. "She loved nightclub hopping and would often stay up all

night drinking, and then turning up on set the next day, still managing to look radiant."

For research, Young visited the Ava Gardner museum in North Carolina. She interviewed Sean Hepburn Ferrer twice about his mother, Audrey Hepburn. Young visited Rome twice, staying at the Hotel Excelsior on the Via Veneto, which is central to the book, and later stayed in the same building where Ava Gardner had lodged, close to the Spanish Steps.

Young went to Los Angeles to go visit the Margaret Herrick Library to find original material around the making of the film Roman Holiday, including letters from Hedda Hopper and Anna Magnani, and original interview transcripts with Sophia Loren.

"At the Margaret Herrick Library you can make an appointment and view all sorts of

production notes, letters, diaries, photographs relating to movie-making," says Young. "Online newspaper and magazine archives are useful too, which can be accessed from libraries, or by paying a small subscription fee. There were many different sources for my research, from old newspaper articles, to published diaries and biographies and archive material."

Roman Holiday is Young's sixth book. Her four other works are illustrated non-fiction, packed with images alongside the text. Roman Holiday is her first narrative non-fiction, a group biography. Her first book, Classic Hollywood Style was published in 2012, then Style Tribes in 2016 and Tartan and Tweed in 2017. She also wrote a guide book to Edinburgh. She has written for the newspapers The Scotsman and The

Herald.

Young's next book is Hitchcock's Heroines, exploring the look and style of the characters played by famous Hitchcock actresses including Ingrid Bergman, Grace Kelly, and Tippi Hedren.

MoPo inks new Spurs deal

Manager Mauricio Pochettino has signed a new five-year contract with Tottenham, keeping him at the club until 2023.

Pochettino, 46, joined Tottenham in May 2014, securing top three finishes in the last three seasons.

"I am delighted we have agreed a new, extended contract with Mauricio," said Spurs chairman Daniel Levy.

First-team coaching staff Jesus Perez, Miguel D'Agostino and Toni Jimenez have also agreed new contracts.

Spurs are preparing to return to a re-built White Hart Lane for the 2018-19 season after playing last season at Wembley Stadium.

"I am honoured to have signed a new long-term contract as we approach one of the most significant periods in the club's history and be the manager that will lead

this team into our new world-class stadium," said Pochettino.

"This is a special club - we always strive to be creative in the way we work both on and off the pitch and will continue to stick to our principles in order to achieve the success this club deserves."

Former Southampton boss Pochettino recently passed 200 games as a Premier League manager and the Argentine guided Spurs into the Champions League for the third successive campaign in the new season.

"We have been on an extraordinary journey and the times ahead look even more exciting as the club enters the next phase in its history," added Levy.

"Mauricio has fostered an incredible spirit in the team and has embraced a style of play our fans have loved watching. I

know they will welcome this commitment by Mauricio."

Pochettino had been linked with a move from the club after saying Spurs "need more time with me or another" following their FA Cup semi-final defeat by Manchester United in April.

He recently said the club must "take risks" to improve, with the north London outfit not having won a trophy since the League Cup in 2008. They also have spent considerably less than their top-six rivals.

"Daniel and I have spoken at length about our aspirations for this football club. We both share the same philosophies to achieve long-term, sustainable success," added Pochettino, who has led the club to fifth, third, second and third-placed finishes in his four seasons.

Familiar failings dog England

England's new summer began with old failings as they were bowled out for 184 by Pakistan on day one of the first Test at Lord's on Thursday.

Joe Root's side, who did not win in seven Tests over the winter and have endured long-standing problems with their top order, succumbed to a string of poor shots.

On a cloudy morning and faced with a green-

tinged surface, Root opted to bat on winning the toss, only for his team to be undone by a Pakistan pace quartet that exposed their shortcomings.

Former skipper Alastair Cook, who has struggled for consistency, made 70, but England lost their last five wickets for 16 runs.

Opening bowler Mohammad Abbas took 4-23 and Hasan Ali, a star of Pakistan's Champions Trophy triumph in the UK last year, picked up 4-51.

The tourists found themselves batting in the evening gloom, yet were taken to 50-1 by Azhar Ali and Haris Sohail, the latter dropped on 16 by Ben Stokes off Mark Wood.

The suspicion is that Pakistan are stronger with the ball than with the bat, but, with sunshine forecast for Friday and the pitch likely to get better for batting, the tourists have the opportunity to take a firm grip on this match.

After a winter when they surrendered the Ashes and lost in New Zealand, England would have expected to feel more comfortable on home soil, where they have lost only one series in the previous five years.

Though Pakistan can take credit for the way they used the conditions, they were helped by an England team that gave wickets away with a combination of recklessness and uncertain footwork.

United target Toby and Fred

Manchester United have made enquiries about Tottenham defender Toby Alderweireld and Shakhtar Donetsk midfielder Fred.

The two players would cost United a combined fee in excess of £100m as manager Jose Mourinho seeks to strengthen the spine of his team.

Alderweireld's future at Tottenham is in doubt, with no agreement in place to extend his contract at the club.

United defender Matteo Darmian, meanwhile, is interesting Juventus.

The Italian, 28, has a year left on his contract and started only five Premier League games for United during the season just completed.

Along with Daley Blind and Luke Shaw, Darmian has little future at the club as Mourinho, who signed a new contract in January that will keep him at Old Trafford until at least 2020, seeks reinforcements.

United finished second in the Premier League - their highest placing since Sir Alex Ferguson retired in 2013 - but were 19 points behind champions Manchester City.

midfielder Fred have both been selected for their World Cup squads, meaning that unless deals can be done within the next fortnight, they are likely to have to wait until after the tournament.

Alderweireld, 29, was involved in just six Tottenham games after declaring he had recovered from a hamstring injury in January, having failed to force his way back into the team.

The defender, one of the few senior players that head coach Mauricio Pochettino is willing to lose, has a contract that is set to expire in 12 months' time, but there is the option of a one-year extension. If that were activated, a clause within it would allow him to

leave for £25m at the end of next season. Fred, 25, has been heavily linked with Manchester City, but they have since turned their attentions to Napoli midfielder Jorginho, leaving the way clear for United to negotiate with Shakhtar. Rinat Akhmetov, Shakhtar's president, has indicated that Fred will cost more than the £34m that Manchester City paid for Fernandinho in 2013, and the reported £43.8m that allowed midfielder Alex Teixeira to join Chinese club Jiangsu Suning in 2016.

Emery: I'm gunning for the top

■ New Arsenal boss vows to take club back to the summit of European football

Unai Emery said he wants Arsenal to be among Europe's elite once more when he appeared at his first news conference since being appointed as Arsene Wenger's successor.

The 46-year-old was officially appointed on Wednesday before he, along with chief executive Ivan Gazidis, addressed a packed media room.

He said: "Success next season would be developing, but how? By battling for every title.

That's in Arsenal's and my history."

Arsenal failed to qualify for the Champions League in 2017 and won't feature in the 2018-19 competition having previously been in every year since 1998.

Gazidis revealed that the Spaniard was on an eight-man shortlist for the job, but was the club's main target.

"All eight took part in extensive interviews and none of them withdrew from the process," said the chief executive, who added that the job was the most attractive in world football.

"We were in a fortunate position to

name our first choice.

"Our first interview was on 25 April and our last was on the 15 May. A formal recommendation to the board was supported by a 100-page dossier with a great degree of background information.

"All of the board members were energised and enthused by our decision."

Gazidis said the former Valencia, Sevilla and Paris St-Germain boss impressed the interview panel with his "meticulous preparation".

"He was extraordinarily well prepared with a knowledge of Arsenal and an analysis of all of our players, their qualities and how he can help them develop.

"The thing that distinguished him above all that was the chemistry between us and the feeling for football in the room.

"He has a feeling and competitive energy and it is this passion, love for football and will to win that made us feel it as exactly right for Arsenal."

Emery told the gathered media he flew

to Atlanta with Gazidis, head of recruitment Sven Mislintat and head of football relations Raul Sanllehi in order to meet the club's major shareholder Stan Kroenke and his family.

"We want to work on this club together," he added. "I know my ambition and my passion and to know how I want to grow up with Arsenal.

"All the conversations I have had with the club shows we share the same vision for the club."

The Gunners finished sixth in the Premier League last season - their lowest position since they finished 12th during the 1994-95 campaign. One of the complaints from supporters was the lack of quality in the current squad.

Asked whether he will need a recruitment drive this summer, Emery said: "I believe we can grow with the players we have.

"The objective is to work hard together and with these talented players.

"It's very important for the club, after two years outside the Champions League, to work to be the best team

in the Premier League and also in the world."

He also paid tribute to predecessor Wenger, who was in charge of the club for 22 years: "I want to say thank you Arsene Wenger for your legacy," Emery said.

"For all the coaches in the world, he is a reference. We learned, I learned from him all the things in football.

"It's a big challenge for me, but I have worked also in other projects, big projects. For me, I

am proud to be here and to work after Arsene Wenger."

Emery announced last month he would leave PSG when his contract expired at the end of the season, despite leading them to the Ligue 1 title.

These Reds better than my 2005 heroes - Rafa

Former Liverpool manager Rafael Benitez says the current Reds squad is better than the side he won the Champions League with.

Liverpool, who face Real Madrid in this year's final on Saturday, beat AC Milan on penalties in Istanbul in 2005, having trailed 3-0 at half-time.

Benitez said: "We achieved what we

achieved - they talk about the Miracle of Istanbul - but this team is better."

The 58-year-old Newcastle boss was manager at Liverpool from 2004-2010.

And the Spaniard said that despite his Reds side having boasted the likes of Steven Gerrard, Spain international Xabi Alonso and Germany star Dietmar Hamann, Jurgen Klopp's front three of

Mohamed Salah, Roberto Firmino and Sadio Mane gave the current team the edge.

Salah (10), Firmino (10) and Mane (nine) have scored 29 goals between them in the Champions League this season, making them the highest scoring trio in a single campaign in the competition.
