



# Harry: I want a girl!

## ■ Prince reveals baby preference on Australia tour

**Prince Harry has revealed he hopes to have a baby girl with his wife the Duchess of Sussex.**

The royal, 34, who is expecting his first child next Spring, shared his wish after a spectator congratulated him on the pregnancy at an Invictus Games event in Sydney on Sunday.

In a candid moment captured on camera, a bystander was heard shouting: 'Congratulations, I hope it's a girl', to which Harry responded: 'So do I!'

Comments from the father-to-be this week suggest the couple do not yet know the gender of their unborn baby.

Speaking at a reception on Tuesday, the royal said: 'We genuinely couldn't think of a better place to

announce the upcoming baby... be it a boy or girl.'

However his passing remark today hints that the prince might be hoping to welcome a daughter.

The couple are squeezing in more than 70 events during their whirlwind visit but it was revealed this week that Meghan will miss some to allow herself time to rest.

Pregnant Meghan, 37, chose to skip a scheduled appearance at an Invictus Games cycling race in Sydney, with Harry, 34, telling competitors that she was 'resting at home [as] being pregnant takes its toll'.

It was the same event that Prince Harry let slip his hope of welcoming a daughter.

Meghan joined Harry for later engagements on Sunday, with the couple attending a reception at the Pavilion Restaurant in the Domain for Invictus competitors, their families and friends hosted by Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison.

And the Prince showed what a good sport he is by donning a pair of tight swimming trunks – known to Australians as budgie smugglers – over his jeans on the first day of competition at the Games. The trunks were presented to him

when a sports presenter and two members of the Australian games team visited him at Admiralty House, the governor general's residence where the royal couple are staying in Sydney.

Dylan Alcott, who is a triple Paralympic gold medallist in wheelchair tennis and wheelchair basketball, said: "We gave him a gift. One of the athletes, Matt [Model], gave him a pair of budgie

smugglers. And he put them on, over his jeans. It looks awesome.

"He said: 'Shall I put them on?' We said: 'One hundred percent.' So he put them on. Good on him."

## Hefty price tag as hate preacher released from jail

**HATE preacher Anjem Choudary was captured this week enjoying a stroll on the streets of London in autumn sunshine – thanks to an electronic tag and a £2million taxpayer-funded security operation.**

Choudary, 51, is under close scrutiny amid fears he will resume his war against Britain by inspiring Islamic extremists. The image appears to show a tag around his right ankle. He was freed last week from top security Belmarsh prison in southeast London after being taken there from Frankland jail

in County Durham, where he had served most of his sentence. He served less than half his five and-a-half-year term for inviting support for Islamic State.

Choudary was seen as a recruiting sergeant for IS through his rhetoric at the head of the outlawed al-Muhajiroun network. His followers have been linked to attacks such as the savage killing on a south-east London street of Fusilier Lee Rigby in 2013. Last week he was described as a “pathetic groomer” of extremists by former head of counter-terror policing Sir Mark Rowley.

Choudary’s release to a north London bail hostel comes with some of the toughest conditions imposed on a convict. His bank accounts are effectively frozen because he needs permission to access cash and he is banned from travelling beyond the M25. He can only worship at certain mosques and only meet people approved by the authorities. He needs police permission to use the internet and officers can check his search history at any time. Choudary has to be in his room at the hostel between 9pm and 8am and between 3pm

and 4pm. But monitoring him around the clock is draining resources from overstretched security services. In August, Theresa May said the

terror threat to Britain is “one of the starkest we have faced”. That month, security services were carrying out nearly 700 investigations. Officials

said 13 Islamist plots had been foiled in 17 months. The threat from international terrorism is currently severe, meaning an attack is “highly likely”.

## Sturgeon to step up war of attrition on Brexit laws

**Britain is on course to crash out of the EU without a deal, Nicola Sturgeon has warned as she made it clear the Scottish government would refuse to co-operate with any Brexit legislation.**

The first minister told a meeting of Holyrood committee conveners that the British government was “closing down” any negotiating space with the EU “and digging themselves deeper into the hole.” She added:

“Given that we are . . . five months away from exit it is staggering incompetence that a government has allowed the situation to get into this state.”

She also sent a message to British ministers that the SNP administration’s policy of non co-operation over Brexit would result in a parliamentary battle between Edinburgh and London.

The Scottish parliament refused to give consent to the

EU Withdrawal Bill introduced by the UK government, which passed it anyway. SNP leaders have since been delaying and complicating government business. Ms Sturgeon has now announced that this extends to all Brexit legislation and the Scottish parliament will not pass any consent motions for Brexit-related bills that come from Westminster to Holyrood. This means that each one

will become a point of confrontation and, with each bill that is passed without Holyrood’s consent, so the SNP will claim the UK government is trampling over Scotland’s parliament.

The first minister said

it was estimated that 800 to 1,000 regulations needed to be passed at Westminster, 140 to 160 of which will require consent notices at Holyrood. Roughly 50 statutory instruments will also need to be passed by MSPs to

facilitate withdrawal. Adam Tomkins, the Scottish Conservatives’ constitution spokesman, said: “It wouldn’t matter how much Scotland stood to benefit from the UK leaving the EU, the first minister would still stand in the way.”



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## Harry unveils monument to SAS hero

The Duke of Sussex has unveiled a sculpture in Fiji commemorating one of the SAS’s most highly regarded figures. Talaiasi Labalaba was killed in 1972 in one of the UK’s secret wars. He died during the Dhofar rebellion in Oman, holding a position against overwhelming odds. Prince Harry and Meghan Markle head to Tonga today for the next leg of their 16-day overseas tour.

## Under-resourced police at risk of ‘irrelevance’

Police in England and Wales are at risk of becoming “irrelevant” as a result of service reductions following government cuts and spending freezes, a cross-party group of MPs has warned. The Home Affairs Select Committee says that forces are “struggling to cope” and that the Home Office has exhibited a “complete failure of leadership”.

## Coroner warns of Uni boozing after death of Newcastle student

A coroner has called for universities to eradicate alcohol-fueled initiation ceremonies after the “utterly needless” death of a first-year student.

Ed Farmer, who was studying economics at Newcastle University, died aged 20 from heart failure brought on by a massive intake of alcohol after a night out organised by members of the Agricultural Society.

Although the university had banned initiation ceremonies, it told Mr Farmer’s inquest that it was practically impossible to prevent them taking place.

Mr Farmer had met friends during freshers’ week who were in the society and he joined them on a pub crawl. Freshers were told to turn up to the event, which 30 students attended, with “a bottle of hard spirits, some money, no student ID, a Metro ticket, swimming goggles, a Kinder egg and some lubricant”. First-year students were encouraged to get drunk by those in the second and third years. In one bar alone 100 treble shots of vodka and orange were bought.

They then went to a student house to complete their initiation, which involved students having their head shaved before crawling into the garage and drinking vodka from a pig’s head. Students were also sprayed with paint used to mark stock and did “apple-bobbing in urine and alcohol”.

About four hours later Mr Farmer was taken to hospital, where he was said to be five times the drink-drive limit, was in asystolic cardiac arrest and was said to have only a 1 per cent chance of survival. He died the next day.

# Strip Green of knighthood, MPs urge

## ■ Tycoon named in sex case injunction scandal

Sir Philip Green faced new calls to be stripped of his knighthood this week as he was outed as the businessman alleged to have gagged staff from speaking out about bullying and sexual harassment.

The retail magnate was named in the House of Lords by the former Labour cabinet minister Lord Hain, despite a court order preventing details of the case from being made public.

The collapse of the privacy injunction, which cost Sir Philip about £500,000 to secure, will renew controversy about how the law is being used by the wealthy to mask allegations of wrongdoing. It will also pile pressure on parliament to act against non-disclosure agreements, which critics fear have been used to cover up widespread misconduct. The House of Commons has spent more than £2.4 million since 2013 on staff settlements containing gagging clauses.

Stating that it was his “duty” to unmask the businessman under parliamentary privilege, Lord Hain said that the businessman had used “non-disclosure agreements and substantial payments to conceal the truth”.

Sir Philip, the chairman of Arcadia Group, who strongly denies any unlawful behaviour, has long been dogged by allegations of bullying. This week the Court of Appeal banned The Daily Telegraph from publishing details of the claims made by five people who had allegedly entered into “settlement agreements” with him. A High Court judge had originally allowed the newspaper to publish the allegations, saying

that they amounted to “discreditable conduct”. Newspapers remain barred from revealing any details or disclosing how much Sir Philip allegedly paid the complainants.


The MP Frank Field, who led the parliamentary inquiry into the collapse of BHS, the chain of stores sold by Sir Philip for £1, called for the retailer to join Fred Goodwin and Robert Mugabe in having his honour revoked. “The charge sheet against the knighthood is growing,” he said. “Parliament and the country have made our views clear on this matter.”

### ‘an embarrassment’

Sir Vince Cable, the Liberal Democrat leader and former business secretary, said: “He narrowly and luckily escaped losing his knighthood over the pensions scandal [involving BHS]. If these allegations are correct, he should certainly be stripped of his knighthood.”

Jess Phillips, the Labour MP for Birmingham Yardley, told The Times: “I’m no fan of the gongs system full stop, but to allow Philip Green to call himself Sir literally devalues the entire thing. He is an embarrassment to our country.”

Sir Philip’s outing is the latest example of a privacy injunction collapsing. In 2011 the footballer Ryan Giggs was named in parliament after he secured one to prevent the press revealing his affair with a former Big Brother contestant. Lord Burnett of Maldon, the lord chief justice, warned last year that injunctions were being undermined by publication on the internet as well as MPs “using, or abusing” parliamentary privilege, which shields them from

being sued over anything said in the chamber.

On the issue of non-disclosure agreements, Theresa May vowed on Wednesday to bring forward a consultation “to seek to improve the regulation around NDAs and make it absolutely explicit to employees when a NDA does not apply and when it cannot be enforced”.

### ‘billionaire spiv’

Ms Phillips said: “It will say on Theresa May’s gravestone ‘she did a review’. She’s the prime minister. I don’t doubt she wants exactly the same as I want. But she needs to grasp the nettle. This is never going away. If we don’t have structural change, #MeToo is just a load of people with a hashtag.”

Any move to ban the agreements in sexual

harassment cases could prove embarrassing for the Commons, which is at the centre of a scandal over bullying and sexual harassment. An independent report published this month by Dame Laura Cox, a retired High Court judge, said that female staff in the Commons had been inappropriately touched, verbally abused and propositioned in an “insidious and pervasive” culture of harassment.

MPs voted overwhelmingly to strip Sir Philip of his knighthood in 2016 after they accused him of beating BHS “black and blue”. The retailer, who was branded a “billionaire spiv”, sold the business in 2015 for £1 only to see it collapse the following year with a huge pensions deficit.

After the Commons

vote the chairman of the honours forfeiture committee wrote to Mr Field saying that he could not look at the issue of Sir Philip’s knighthood until investigations by the Insolvency Service and the Pensions Regulator were complete. Sir Philip has since been cleared by the former body and agreed with the latter to hand over £363 million to settle the pension dispute. The committee could now review the knighthood again.

Sir Philip said on Wednesday night: “I am not commenting on anything that has happened in court or was said in parliament today. To the extent that it is suggested that I have been guilty of unlawful sexual or racist behaviour, I categorically and wholly deny these allegations.”

## Pakistani gang convicted of grooming and raping girls

■ Blanket reporting ban finally lifted on shocking abuse

Twenty men have been convicted of being part of a grooming gang that subjected girls as young as 11 to an “inhuman” campaign of rape and sexual abuse in a West Yorkshire market town.

A series of trials, which have resulted in 16 of them being jailed for a total of 221 years for offences ranging from trafficking, exploitation and drugs offences to multiple rapes, could not be reported until the weekend. The others are awaiting sentence. A blanket reporting ban imposed a year ago at Leeds crown court has been lifted by Judge Guy Kearl, QC, the Recorder of Leeds, following a challenge by The Times and other media organisations.

The pattern of large-scale exploitation of mainly white girls by groups of Asian men of mainly Pakistani heritage uncovered by West Yorkshire Police in Huddersfield mirrors what has happened in a number of other towns including Rotherham, Rochdale, Newcastle and Oxford, and was first exposed by The Times in 2011.

### reporting restrictions

The men from Huddersfield were convicted of more than 120 offences against 15 girls aged 11 to 17 who were plied with drink, drugs and gifts before being “used and abused at will” between 2004 and 2011. Many of the

victims described how they were raped at house parties “one by one” by men using plastic bags as condoms. At least one of the victims attempted suicide and another had an abortion after becoming pregnant, the court was told.

The men referred to each other using nicknames, such as Beastie, Dracula and Nurse, which were also used as their monikers during the trials.

The Huddersfield grooming trials, believed to be Britain’s single biggest grooming prosecution, were potentially put at risk by the actions of Tommy Robinson, the founder of the English Defence League, who was

prosecuted for allegedly flouting reporting restrictions designed to ensure the proceedings were fair. Robinson was jailed for contempt of court but the conviction was later quashed and the case is due to be heard again at the Old Bailey next week.

The jury was told in three separate trials at

Leeds crown court this year how socially isolated girls were targeted before being groomed and raped in Huddersfield. The group’s ringleader, Amere Singh Dhaliwal, 35, was jailed for life and told he must serve at least 18 years by Judge Geoffrey Marson, QC, who said: “Your treatment of these girls was inhuman.”

Dhaliwal, who has children of his own, was convicted of 54 charges, including 22 rapes, involving 11 girls. He committed numerous rapes, incited child prostitution, trafficked girls across the region and filmed their abuse on his phone. The judge said: “You treated them

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## White poppies seed controversy as Armistice Day nears

■ Pacifist groups claim the traditional red remembrance symbol has become too political

As October draws to a close, people across the UK and the Commonwealth are preparing to pay tribute to fallen war heroes on Remembrance Day.

On 11th November and the days around it, many people choose to wear a red poppy as a symbol for those who have given their lives in battle.

However, a growing trend in recent years is seeing some people eschew the iconic red poppy in favour of a white one. To some, the white alternative is a symbol of peace and pacifism, but to others it is an insult to those who gave their lives for their country.

The red paper poppy was initially adopted as a symbol for those who fought in the First World War, and was introduced by the American Legion in 1921. Today it is more commonly used in the UK,

Australia, Canada and New Zealand.

The flower was chosen because it grows wild in many fields in northern France and Belgium - where some of the deadliest battles of World War One took place.

The white poppy, on the other hand, was designed by the Co-operative Women’s Guild in 1933 and adopted the following year by the Peace Pledge Union (PPU) as a symbol of anti-war and pacifist sentiment.

“There are three elements to the meaning of white poppies: they represent remembrance for all victims of war, a commitment to peace and a challenge to attempts to glamorise or celebrate war,” the PPU website says.

“Nearly 100 years after the end of the ‘war to end all wars’ we still have a long way to go to put an

end to a social institution that even in the last decade has contributed to the killing of millions,” the site adds.

The Royal British Legion is clear that the red poppy is not a sign of support for war and death.

When it was first adopted, it represented mourning and served as a pledge that war must never happen again. Indeed, the words “never again” were emblazoned on the original design.

However, a number of issues have caused people to turn to the white poppy. The Guardian reported recently that many white poppy wearers believe the red poppy “symbolizes remembrance of British armed forces and its allies rather than enemies and civilians who also died in wars”.

Others feel the red poppy has become political, and

that politicians use it to help justify war.

“In Northern Ireland, for example, it became regarded as a Protestant Loyalist symbol because of its connection with British patriotism,” the PPU website says.

Some people choose to wear the white poppy as a protest against “poppy policing” or “poppy fascism” – in which people are lambasted for not wearing the flower.

But not everyone is convinced by such

arguments. This week, Conservative MP and former British Army captain Johnny Mercer dismissed the white poppy movement as “attention-seeking rubbish”.

Last year, Colonel Richard Kemp, former commander of the British Forces in Afghanistan, criticized the sale of white poppies in schools as “misguided”, telling The Sunday Telegraph: “I think it is perfectly reasonable for schools to discuss different political perspectives,

but they should not be indoctrinating children with a left-wing political agenda.”

But the Royal British Legion has no problem with the white poppy, saying: “We have no objection to white poppies, or any group expressing their views.

“We see no conflict in wearing the red poppy alongside the white poppy. We do ask that the items are not offered alongside each other, however, as this would confuse the public.”

as commodities to be passed around for your own sexual gratification and the gratification of others. The extent and gravity of your offending far exceeds anything which I have previously encountered." "It was a very significant campaign of rape and other sexual abuse. Children's lives have been ruined and families profoundly affected by seeing their children, over months and years, out of control, having been groomed by you and other members of your gang."

## harrowing evidence

The girls, who are now all adults, told the court they had believed they were being shown genuine affection as they were groomed. One said: "They all knew each other and it was just like an escalation and they knew they could pick me up whenever they wanted because my mum was vulnerable."

Another girl was seen being thrown out of a moving car outside her home.

The jury endured harrowing evidence throughout the series of trials, hearing how girls were bought presents and flattered by the adult men before being plied with drink and drugs as a prelude to horrific sexual abuse.

One of the 15 victims said: "I suppose when you're young and you get bullied at school and stuff like that you do sort of like the attention, and things getting bought for you, but then once you were in with them, you couldn't get out of it."

"They got your trust and then stuff would start happening to you and it's just one of those things that you couldn't get out of, it just happened. My mum and dad's houses got trashed, their cars got trashed. I was constantly getting raped, beaten up."

## Women now able to apply for all jobs including frontline infantry, Royal Marines and SAS

**The special forces have been opened up to female applicants in a move that will allow women to serve in every role in the British military for the first time.**

Gavin Williamson, the defence secretary, said on Monday that from this week "for the first time in its history, our armed forces will be determined by ability alone and not gender".

He paid tribute to the women who have led the way with exemplary service in the armed forces for more than 100 years, working in a variety of specialist and vital roles.

The policy change was met with scorn by some longstanding sceptics. Colonel Richard Kemp, who commanded British forces in Afghanistan in 2003, claimed that it would cost lives.

The presence of even a single woman in a team of men on the front line could lead to divisiveness and undermine teamwork, which in turn could directly cause casualties, he said

Mr Williamson made his announcement at a land power demonstration on Salisbury Plain that involved some of the first 35 women to have joined the Royal Armoured Corps since the ban on female tank crew was lifted in 2016.

Lance Corporal Kat Dixon, 28, the first female tank gunner in the Royal Wessex Yeomanry, said that she would not respond to sceptics such as Colonel Kemp. She would "just prove them wrong". To others opposed less trenchantly to women fighting on the front line she said that talking was the best approach. "By the end of the conversation they're usually on board," she said.

Under the new policy, women already serving in the British Army are now able to transfer into infantry roles, which

includes special forces. Civilian women will be able to apply for infantry roles in December, with recruits starting basic training in April.

The Ministry of Defence conceded that it did not expect large numbers of women to apply for ground close-combat roles.

In 2016 David Cameron lifted the ban on women signing up for frontline, ground close-combat roles. It followed widespread recognition that women had in effect been serving on the front line for years in Afghanistan and Iraq in roles such as attack helicopter pilots, medics and engineers. In addition, female soldiers have long proven invaluable in gathering intelligence and conducting community engagement among women in socially conservative societies who would not speak to men.

Women will now be able to join the Special Air Service and Special Boat

Service and the gruelling selection processes will not be altered for them. Until now only one part of the special forces, the special reconnaissance regiment, has been open to female applicants but it is not known whether any women applied or made the cut.

About 10 per cent of Britain's regular personnel and 14 per cent of reservists are women. As recently as two years ago three in ten

army roles were closed to women.

At Salisbury Plain Lance Corporal Dixon said that her gender was neither an advantage nor an obstacle in the military but admitted that she stood out in the male-dominated ranks of soldiers. "There's this thing in the army where you're supposed to be the 'grey man' and blend in. I'll never be able to do that," she said.

Private Beth Johnson,

19, a dog handler in the Royal Army Veterinary Corps, said she did not use her gender to shy away from the physical aspects of developing the bite of her five-year-old German shepherd, Chilli. "It involves a baiter putting on a suit or sleeve," she said. "It's actually a good feeling, it's an adrenaline rush. It does hurt. You basically get the full feeling of it but just without the teeth piercing the skin."

# Can 'The Bodyguard' Conquer America?

■ Hugely popular BBC thriller now available on Netflix

ROYAL MARRIAGES and babies aside, the news from Britain has been pretty grim these past few months. The steady drumbeat of Brexit, Brexit, Brexit has caused many to tune the subject out, with the always lively British media telling Britons they have never been so divided. Theresa May looks like a dead woman walking, with at least half her Cabinet seemingly plotting against her on a weekly basis.

Which is why The Bodyguard has been such a welcome relief to many. The BBC One

drama has finally found the formula to bring the county together: rattling good TV.

Written by Jed Mercurio (best known for "Line of Duty"), the show debuted in the UK in late August and drew more than 10 million television viewers over seven days for its first episode, the best performance for a new drama since Downtown Abbey. The show stars Richard Madden (Rob Snow on Game of Thrones) as David Budd, an embittered Afghanistan war veteran assigned to protect the ambitious

and icy Julia Montague (Keeley Hawes), amid a fevered atmosphere of constant terrorist threats and endless political intrigue. In common with his archetype, Budd's ice-cold professionalism is in contrast to his personal life, in which he deals with a tough separation from the mother of his two children while battling personal demons, PTSD and incipient alcoholism.

As the show unfolded six weeks, it filled countless pages in both the downmarket and quality press with

columnists speculating on the twists, turns, implications and resolution of its maze-like plot, which gave viewers the added bonus of giving them something to talk about other than Brexit. "We're back in the world of the water cooler — a bygone era when we all watched TV at the same time," Zoe Williams wrote in The Guardian. And real life politicians weighed in too, with Ms. May

telling reporters rather sniffily that she switched off after 20 minutes, explaining: "I watch TV to unwind...I'm not sure a drama about a female home secretary is the best way for me to do that."

Mark Lawson, a culture columnist for The Guardian, attributed the show's success to its blend of gripping narrative and salaciousness. "Bodyguard" combines "the most popular

genres in British TV" — the crime drama and the conspiracy thriller — while "also incorporating the always popular subplot of forbidden sex," he wrote.


Now you can judge for yourself. Netflix, which acquired the series at an early stage in production, released it Wednesday in 190 countries, including the US.







## Another happy return to Old Trafford for Ronaldo

Cristiano Ronaldo marked his return to Old Trafford with a win as his Juventus side outclassed Manchester United to move five points clear at the top of Champions League Group H on Tuesday night.

The former United star helped to set up Juve's winner in the 17th minute, with his cross reaching Paulo Dybala who finished from close range.

The Italian champions had several chances to extend their lead during a first half where they were completely

dominant, managing 10 shots to United's one and enjoying 70% of possession.

United improved after the break but only had one serious effort at goal, when Paul Pogba let fly from the edge of the area but saw his shot rebound off the post.

It was a frustrating night for United boss Jose Mourinho, who was taunted by the away fans as he saw his side suffer only their second home European defeat since March 2013, when Ronaldo scored Real Madrid's winner.

The two sides will meet again at the Allianz Stadium on 7 November, when a win will send Juve into the last 16.

United remain in second place, with their hopes of making the knockout stages boosted by Valencia's draw with Young Boys earlier on Tuesday.

United have mounted second-half comebacks in their last two matches, a victory over Newcastle and their draw with Chelsea last weekend, but they did not come close to a repeat here.

Those performances

had hinted at what United are capable of when they hit form but this game turned into a sobering reminder of their standing compared to Europe's elite, particularly in attack.

Anthony Martial finally forced Wojciech Szczesny into one save of note with seconds of the 90 minutes remaining, with the Juve keeper's only other stop coming before the break when he collected a looping header from Pogba.

Like Ronaldo, the France midfielder was also facing his former club - it was during his four years with Juve from 2012-16 that Pogba forged his reputation as a world-class marauding midfielder.

But he was unable to inspire his side in the final third, while Romelu Lukaku's goal drought continued, and must now be becoming a major concern.

The Belgium striker only managed one shot at goal - which was blocked - and he has now failed to score in any of his past

eight club appearances.

Manchester United manager Jose Mourinho blamed a gulf in quality for the result, telling reporters: "In the other side there was huge quality.

Sometimes people look for Ronaldo or Dybala but in a top team you have to look to Chiellini and Bonucci. I think Juventus are the type of team that when they are in front its very difficult.

"I think our attacking players, things were not

coming. But everyone tried, everyone was strong mentally to try until the end. Juventus felt it and they ended the game with an extra central defender.

"But Juventus is a different level of quality, I have to be honest. A level of quality, stability, experience, know how. It was a really difficult match for us. I thought we could take something but it was not possible."

# CL run leaves Reds firmly in the black....

Liverpool fans might just be getting over the bitter taste of defeat in last season's Champions League final but their run to Kiev earned the club a £71.9m sweetener.

Uefa has released the money paid to last season's

Champions League and Europa League teams, and Liverpool top the list of British sides after reaching their eighth final.

Only winners Real Madrid earned more - £78.4m, including a £13.7m bonus for winning

a 13th European Cup.

Manchester City earned £56.5m after reaching the last eight, while Chelsea (£57.6m), Tottenham (£54.3m) and Manchester United (£35.7m) only made it to the last 16.

Celtic received £29.6m, which also included money for dropping down to the Europa League after being knocked out at the Champions League group stage.

# Loftus-Cheek stars as Blues steamroller Bate

Ruben Loftus-Cheek hit a brilliant hat-trick as Chelsea coasted to victory in a one-sided Europa League game against Belarusian champions Bate Borisov on Thursday.

The Blues, inspired by their England midfielder, were far too strong for their opponents, stretching their lead at the top of Group L to six points with three games to play.

Loftus-Cheek swept Maurizio Sarri's side ahead with just one minute and 42 seconds on the clock after being picked out by Davide Zappacosta's low cross.

The 22-year-old doubled the lead with a side-foot volley from Willian's corner and sealed his first competitive hat-trick with a sumptuous 20-yard finish before Alekssei Rios scored a consolation.

Bate goalkeeper Denis Scherbitski produced sublime saves to keep out Zappacosta and Olivier Giroud as Chelsea dominated from start to finish.

This was only Loftus-Cheek's fourth Chelsea appearance of the season - as many games as he played for his country at

the World Cup in Russia during the summer.

He grasped the opportunity with both hands after Sarri made eight changes to the side that started the 2-2 draw with Manchester United last Saturday.

Also in the Europa League, Danny Welbeck's late winner gave Arsenal victory over Sporting Lisbon in Portugal, as they retained their place at the top of Europa League Group E.

The striker pounced on a Sebastian Coates error and slotted a shot through the keeper's legs after 77 minutes.

Earlier in the second half, Welbeck had a headed goal ruled out after he was judged to have fouled the defender in the build-up.

Arsenal have now extended their winning run to 11 games in all competitions.

The first half seemed to point towards a dreary goalless draw despite the Gunners controlling the possession - with the visitors managing just two tame shots on target before the break - but they ultimately got the result they deserved.

Nani had Sporting's best chance with a

high curling effort after half-an-hour before Arsenal winger Henrikh Mkhitaryan's free-kick was punched away by keeper Renan Ribeiro.

But Arsenal picked up their performance slightly in the second half as Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang was denied twice.

His chip was well saved after he had used his pace to get in behind centre-back Coates and he had a shot saved from a wide angle.

Those chances seemed to spark a bit of life into Arsenal and shortly afterwards Matteo Guendouzi's cutback found Welbeck, only for his close-range shot to be deflected out for a corner.

But Arsenal's determination to turn their 67% possession into a goal eventually paid off.

Welbeck's form under new boss Unai Emery continues to improve and he has now bagged five goals in 10 appearances this season - including two in the Europa League.

Arsenal remain top of the group with nine points from three wins, while Sporting trail in second.

# Rapid half century for Salah!

## Liverpool star grabs brace in Red Star cruise

Mohamed Salah scored twice to reach a half-century of Liverpool goals in a comfortable 4-0 victory over Red Star Belgrade on Wednesday night, as the Reds went top of Champions League Group C.

It was a dominant display from the hosts, Roberto Firmino firing in Andy Robertson's cut-back on 20 minutes.

Salah got his first just before the break then added a second to reach an impressive landmark by converting a penalty won by Sadio Mane.

Mane then slotted a fourth goal with 10 minutes to go, having missed another penalty just moments before.

Goalscorers aside, Xherdan Shaqiri proved influential for the hosts - an excellent through ball to Robertson helped set up Firmino's opener and it was the Swiss player's flick that then assisted Salah's first goal.

Firmino, one of five players back in the starting line-up after a depleted Reds side narrowly beat Huddersfield in the league on Saturday, marked his return with his 13th goal in 18 Champions League appearances for the club and his 10th in eight games at Anfield.

Mane was also bright - he linked up well with Salah on numerous occasions and earned his side's first penalty when he got an arm in the face from Red Star captain Filip Stojkovic.

He made up for missing the second penalty - won when El Fardou Ben handled in the area - by sliding in to poke into the bottom corner to make it 4-0, before substitute Adam Lallana was denied a fifth from close range.

For the visitors, Srđan Babic wasted an opportunity from

a set-piece when he fired over the bar but Liverpool were dominant throughout and never looked like conceding.

Red Star, bottom of the group with one point from three games, were banned from selling tickets to supporters for the game at Anfield after incidents during and after their team's play-off round tie away to RB Salzburg on 29 August.

Jurgen Klopp's side have not looked quite themselves in recent games - narrowly beating Huddersfield, after draws with Manchester City and Chelsea and a late defeat by Napoli.

But they were definitely in the mood in this game and swept aside a Serbian team competing in the Champions League group stages for the first time in over a decade.

Salah's 49th and 50th goal were greeted with roars from the Anfield crowd as the Egyptian

reached his half-century in only 65 games for the club.

Liverpool manager Jurgen Klopp said of Salah's form: "It's good that we can maybe stop talking about that a little bit. I was not in doubt, he was not in doubt,

but if you are constantly asked about it, you think something is up."

"We are not through yet. This group obviously stays exciting until the end, I think that was clear from the draw. But you cannot do more than win your own games."

Speaking to BT Sport, he added: "It was a good football game and a deserved win. Fabinho was good from the start - Shaqiri was involved in everything. He is a really nice footballer and that helped. I thought he did really well."

## Poch: 'nearly over' for Spurs

Tottenham's chances of reaching the knockout stages of the Champions League are "nearly over", according to Mauricio Pochettino.

The Spurs boss saw his goalkeeper Hugo Lloris sent off for a moment of madness before Luuk de Jong's 87th-minute equaliser denied them a Champions League victory over PSV in Eindhoven on Wednesday night.

The Spurs captain raced from his goal to bring down home winger Hirving Lozano as the visitors led 2-1 with 11 minutes left.

Former Newcastle forward De Jong then poked in to leave Tottenham still without a win - and like PSV, with only one point - after three of their six Group B

matches.

"I think it's easy to judge the game," Pochettino said. "If you didn't win following what happened then you don't deserve to be in the Champions League.

"It was a situation where we needed to think a little bit, because in this type of game, at 2-1 you must kill the game. If not, the opponent is alive."

PSV had taken a first-half lead through a deflected Lozano strike, after the Mexican caught a dawdling Toby Alderweireld in possession.


But Lucas Moura then fired in an equaliser five minutes before the break and Harry Kane headed home Christian Eriksen's cross to put the visitors ahead early in the second half.

Pochettino added: "[Our chances of qualifying] are nearly over. We'll see what happens now in the game between Barcelona and Inter Milan but with only one point after three games, it will be so difficult.

"I'm not going to blame any player. If someone is to blame it's myself, I am responsible for the team. The players are only there to play."

Not for the first time in this season's European campaign, Pochettino's side paid for a late lapse of concentration - leaving them, and PSV, facing an uphill battle to qualify for the last 16.

Pochettino described Tottenham's trip to PSV as "must-win" before the game, saying "we need to be better than them".
