Crowds flock to Great War tribute at the Tower

TEN thousand flaming torches illuminated the Tower of London this week in a tribute marking the centenary of the end of the First World War.

The first candle was lit by one of the Yeoman Warders of the Tower before three guest lighters representing each of the Armed Forces ignited their own flames. A team of around 100 volunteers dressed in grey overalls then lit the rest of the torches to create a blazing moat.

Guest lighter Corporal Scott Sutherland, of the RAF's Queen's Colour Squadron, said taking

part in the ceremony on his 34th birthday was "an honour and a privilege". He said: "It has been amazing to be able to do this for people who have served in the First World War particularly, but not forgetting the sacrifices others have made as well.

"It was a fitting way to do it. The flames were a really nice touch, especially the number of them, to create that

ambiance.

"It's important that we remember the sacrifices people made for the freedoms we enjoy today."

It took around 40 minutes to light all the flames, which burned for four hours accompanied by choral music and words from war poet Mary Borden's Sonnets to a Soldier.

Onlooker Tim Page, 58, from Bath, said the

display was "a beautiful way to commemorate" the centenary. He said: "It's hugely important for us all to remember our heritage.

"We all take it for granted but there are thousands of people who lost their lives in the last century to ensure that this country had some freedom. We need to be reminded."

Titled Beyond the Deepening Shadow, the tribute will be repeated each night between 5pm and 9pm until Remembrance Sunday. The display was planned

by Tom Piper, the theatre designer who oversaw Blood Swept Lands and Seas of Red – the Tower's 2014 poppy installation.

He said: "We want the flames to spread in 'fingers' of light until the whole moat is ablaze. There is something particularly moving about the processional feel of it all."

Dick Harrold, governor of the Tower of London, said: "What is so special about it is it means many different things. The message with the sound is not focused so much on those that were lost,

but those that were left behind, the bereaved and others who were affected by war."

General the Lord Houghton, Constable of HM Tower of London, said: "The First World War claimed the lives of over 18 million people across the globe.

"We remembered them at the Tower on the anniversary of the start of the war, and it feels equally appropriate that we should again commemorate their sacrifice 100 years after hostilities came to an end."

Five men arrested over Grenfell Tower model bonfire video

■ Officers say the men handed themselves in to a south London police station after the “vile” video footage emerged on Monday

Five men have been arrested on suspicion of a public order offence after a video showed a model of Grenfell Tower being burned.

Officers said they arrested two 49-year-olds, a 55-year-old, another man aged 46 and a 19-year-old after they handed themselves in to a south London police station on Monday night.

It comes after Theresa May condemned the video, which emerged online, calling it “utterly unacceptable”.

The footage, which was part of a bonfire night celebration, prompted an outcry on Monday, showed a large flammable model marked “Grenfell Tower”, complete with paper figures of people at their windows, before it was set on fire.

The blaze at the west London block of flats in June last year killed 72 people.

Responding to the clip, the prime minister tweeted: “To disrespect those who lost their lives at Grenfell Tower, as well as their families

and loved ones, is utterly unacceptable.”

Home Secretary Sajid Javid also condemned the video, calling it “disgusting, shameful, behaviour”.

In the video, members of the group can be heard laughing and shouting “help me, help me”.

As the fire climbs up the model building, one of the people question whether they should have put the tower on upside down, because the fire started on the 10th floor.

One person shouts “jump out the window” while another offers the original fire brigade advice before the scale of the tragedy was understood, saying “stay in your flats”.

Another voice can be heard saying “that’s what happens when they don’t pay their rent”.

Earlier, Scotland Yard said its Grenfell Tower investigation team was “taking this matter very seriously”, adding: “Any offences that have been committed will be fully investigated.”

Commander Stuart Cundy said: “I am frankly

appalled by the callous nature of the video posted online.

“So many people lost so many loved ones, and many more have been deeply affected. To mock that disaster in such a crude way is vile.”

London Fire Commissioner Dany Cotton described the footage as “appalling and disturbing”, adding it “cannot be justified on any level”.

Two of the men were identified as Bobbi Connell, 19, and his father, Cliff Smith, 49. Aerial footage of the garden belonging to Smith showed signs of a recent fire and a St George’s flag, visible in the video, now lying on the grass.

One of the other men in custody is Paul Bussetti, 46, who lives just streets away from the party house. A woman who answered the door at his home, where visitors are greeted by a sign describing the family as “party animals”, confirmed Bussetti had handed himself in to police. A family member

sobbed as they told reporters: “We’re in so much danger now. They didn’t want it to go this far. They are not racist. It has been blown out of proportion.

“It was horrible what

they’ve done. Let them try and forget it.”

Metropolitan Police Commander Stuart Cundy also described the video as “vile”.

He said: “So many people lost so many loved

ones, and many more have been deeply affected. “To mock that disaster in such a crude way is vile. I can’t imagine the distress this video will undoubtedly cause to bereaved families and survivors.”

Triumph for round-Britain swimmer

INTREPID Ross Edgley became the first swimmer to circumnavigate Great Britain this week.

He was joined for the last stretch of his 1,791-mile, 157-day endeavour by 400 swimmers in Margate.

Ross, 33, of Grantham, Lincs, left the Kent town on June 1, swimming 12 hours a day.

His arrival on the beach at 8.40am was his first time on dry land since he set off on June 1st.

He said of his swim: “It’s so lonely in some ways but coming in and seeing everybody was amazing.”

For 157 days, Edgley swam between six and 12 hours a day, taking breaks

for sleeping and eating on an accompanying boat. (He ate more than 500 bananas during the trip to keep his energy up.) The author of a fitness guide, *The World’s Fittest Book*, Edgley had to endure freezing conditions, vicious storms and jellyfish attacks during his extraordinary journey.

His list of injuries makes for grim reading; salt water exposure caused the partial disintegration of his tongue, his feet are bruised and misshapen and blisters speckle his skin from wetsuit chafing.

Despite all this, Edgley is still “not quite bored of swimming,” he told the

BBC.

In April 2016, the adventurer completed the world’s longest ever rope climb, for which he pulled himself up 8,848 meters (29,029 ft), the height of Mount Everest. Four months earlier he had finished a marathon while pulling a small car.

And in 2017 he attempted to swim 25 miles from Martinique to St. Lucia in the Caribbean while tied to a tree trunk. When strong currents forced him to stop, he resolved to do what no one had done before and circumnavigate Great Britain.

“The adventurer in me had unfinished business,” he said.



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Flight from hell!

Multiple delays of BA flight leaves hundreds of holidaymakers stranded for three days amid airport chaos

Hundreds of British Airways passengers endured a 'flight from hell' at the weekend when a flight from Orlando to Gatwick took THREE DAYS to reach its destination.

Mechanical problems caused initial delays, but the problem was then exacerbated by what passengers described as a 'shocking lack of communication' from the airline.

Passengers said their frustrations started on Thursday evening when they were shuttled to a hotel in Orlando after their flight was delayed for mechanical issues. But once they arrived found no airline representative or guidance of any kind - they said they were simply given a print out letter.

Customers said they were confused as the departure time kept changing, and the hotel - Rosen Shingle Creek - failed to update them on the time changes.

Many customers took to Twitter to search for answers amid the confusing delays and diversions.

Passenger John Chapman tweeted on Friday: 'What's happening with flight BA 2036, it's nice having extra time in Orlando BA, but you lack of information is appalling, apparently we are not flying till gone midnight, info please, my family and I would like to get home.'

On Friday evening the flight finally took off, but experienced complications where it dumped fuel mid-air and lowered the landing gear at a high altitude, then diverted to JFK airport in New York. As workers scrambled to fix the plane, the passengers were left to sleep on the ground at Terminal 7 at

the airport overnight.

Shocking pictures from the airport display a myriad of strewn about suitcases and tired passengers.

Passenger Craig Brown said: 'We have just been dumped with no help or advise, shame on you @ British_Airways this is beyond a joke now' on Twitter on Friday.

'How about you let us into the lounge while we wait instead of sitting on the floor???' he added.

A British Airways spokesperson responded saying: 'I'm afraid we can't offer what you're asking. We're sending a relief aircraft out to JFK to get customers to London as quickly as possible.'

Finally on Saturday, the airline sent a new aircraft as promised to JFK and the 200 passengers were taken off to their final destination - London, where the plane touched down at 6am Sunday morning - 48 hours later than scheduled.

All of which left Lee Sullivan, his partner Kimberley Millhouse, 30, their daughter Amelia and Kimberley's father, Bob Parsons, who spent the half-term break enjoying Disney World, fuming.

Mr Sullivan, from Slough, told The Sun: 'Finally back at LGW after the worst 3 days. I can't think of strong enough words to describe the disgusting BA customer service we received. My daughter also had to spend her 2nd birthday in JFK airport. Exhausted and angry.'

'Disney World was amazing but that holiday now feels like years ago - the journey home has completely ruined the holiday.'

'I'm just shattered - the whole thing's been a nightmare.'

Spice Girls (almost) reunited, but where's Posh?

THE Spice Girls are hitting the road for the first time in a decade - and Mel B is urging Victoria Beckham to say she'll be there.

Scary Spice Melanie Brown has put her love-hate relationship with Posh Spice Victoria aside. Last week she wore a Posh mask in a Halloween costume with a banner saying: "No, I am not going on tour."

She has now called on fashion designer Victoria to be part of the six-date UK tour next June.

Mel, 43, said on Monday: "It's just the four of us that are fully confirmed, but you know, Vic might join us at some point. I hope so, I think it'd be a shame if she didn't."

When questioned on her cheeky Halloween costume, Mel said: "I think she [Victoria] found it a bit funny, probably hated it at the same time."

"She's got a full-on life with all of her work commitments and her fashion line and her kids, so she's just kind of not committing just yet."

But Victoria, 44, has

ruled out an on-stage return. Posting a picture of the other four Spice Girls - Mel B, Baby Spice Emma Bunton, 42, Sporty Spice Melanie Chisholm, 44, and 46-year-old Ginger Spice Geri Horner - on Instagram, Victoria wrote: "Today marks a special day for the girls as they announce the first tour dates since we performed together in 2012!"

"I won't be joining my girls on stage again but being in the Spice Girls was a hugely important part of my life and I wish them so much love and

fun as they go back on tour next year. I know they will put on an amazing show and the fantastic fans past and present are going to have a wonderful time!"

Formed in 1994, the band have not performed together since the London Olympics closing ceremony in 2012 and last toured 10 years ago. They performed as a four-piece for two years after Geri quit the band in 1998 and recorded their third album, *Forever*, in 2000. They are best known for hits including *Wannabe*, *Say You'll Be There*, *2*

Become 1 and *Spice Up Your Life*. In February, the five confirmed their plans and in July Mel B said they would reunite this year - but one group member was holding up proceedings. In a joint statement, the Spice Girls said: "We are beyond excited to be reuniting next year for a stadium tour. "Bringing girl power and our message of friendship and love back to the stage feels more relevant than ever. "We hope everyone can join us for one big Spice Girls party!"

Charles makes the distinction between being heir and sovereign in the BBC show

A meddling king? I'm not that stupid, says Charles

The Prince of Wales has sought to quell concerns that he would be a "meddling" or activist king, saying "I'm not that stupid".

His words, the strongest yet on the subject of his kingship, were broadcast in a documentary on BBC One on Thursday to mark his 70th birthday.

Declaring the role of sovereign and heir to be different, Prince Charles maintains he is aware of the constraints he will encounter as king, and says his behaviour will change. Acknowledging that some people have accused him of being a meddling prince, he argues that he has always tried to be non-party political.

"It is vital to remember there's only room for one sovereign at a time. Not two," he says.

He also says in the documentary, entitled *Prince, Son and Heir*, Charles at 70: "You can't be the same as the sovereign if you're the Prince of Wales or the heir. But the idea somehow that I'm going to go on in exactly the same way if I have to succeed, is complete nonsense because the two situations are completely different.

"You only have to look at Shakespeare plays, Henry V or Henry IV part I and 2, to see the change that can take place.

Because if you become the sovereign then you play the role in the way that it is expected.

"So, clearly I won't be able to do the same things I've done as heir. So, of course, you operate within the constitutional parameters. But it's a different function. I think people have forgotten that the two are very different."

Charles has faced criticism for decades over his campaigning on issues such as GM crops, architecture, integrated medicine, and climate change. When told people have expressed worries that this would continue in the same way, Charles responds: "No. It won't. I'm not that stupid. I do realise that it is a separate exercise being sovereign. So, of course, you know, I understand entirely how that should operate."

Asked if he could continue, as king, to use his "convening power", he replies: "Well, you never know. But you could only do it with the agreement of ministers. That's how it works."

The Duchess of Cornwall says that Charles knows "his destiny" so, she says: "I don't think it does weigh on his shoulders at all." It was not something her husband talked about very much, she says. "It's just something that's going to happen."

In the show the Duke of

Cambridge implores his father to spend more time with his grandchildren, George, five, Princess Charlotte, three, and Prince Louis, six months. Appealing to Charles to slow down, he says: "I would like him to have more time with the children."

Prince William adds: "Having more time with him at home would be lovely, and being able to play around with the grandchildren. Because when he's there, he's brilliant. But we need him there as much as possible."

William, 36, has done little to dispel stories that his father – said to work seven days a week, from just after breakfast until midnight – is absent too often. Asked if Charles had time to be a grandfather on top of everything else, William replied: "It's something I'm working more heavily on. I would like him to have more time with the children. Now he's reached his 70th year it's a perfect time to consolidate a little bit, because as most families would do, you are worried about having them around and making sure their health's OK.

"He's the fittest man I know but I want him to be fit until he's 95. So, having more time with him at home would be lovely, and being able to play around with the grandchildren."

72,396 missing victims of the Somme honored at Olympic Park

IT is the picture that graphically shows the unimaginable scale and futility of the First World War's bloodiest battle.

London's Olympic Park on Monday unveiled a moving tribute in which every one of the 72,396 British and Commonwealth soldiers whose bodies were never found after the Battle of the Somme were honored. It features foot-long figures to represent each of them, laid out shoulder to shoulder in London's Olympic Park. Each wears a calico shroud hand-sewn by Somerset artist Rob Heard, 53, who spent five years creating the art installation based on a list compiled by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission.

He said: "We've chosen to lay these figures out there with a gap between them. "It is an ordered gap, which is so important because they are individuals. They're not a mass and each one is made to a name."

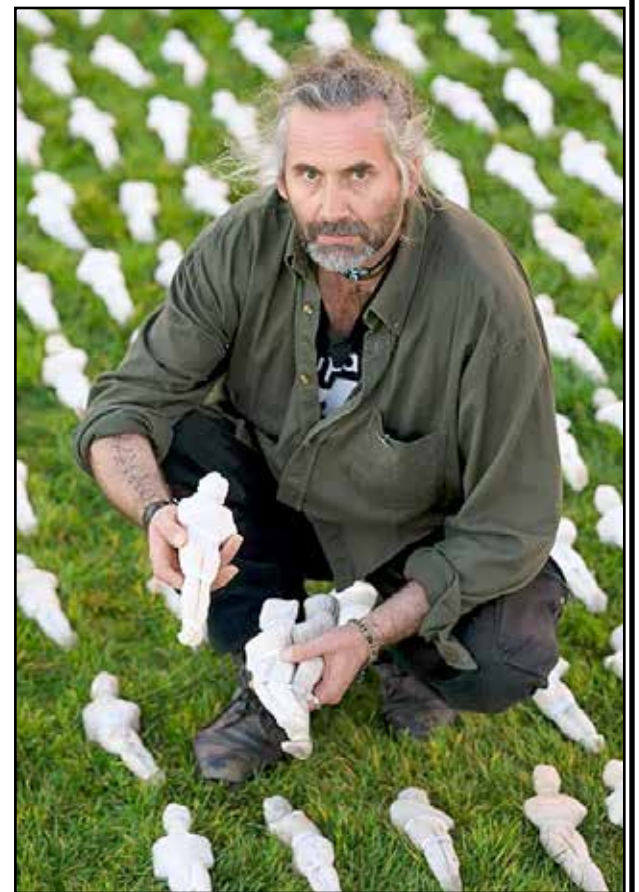
About 420,000 British soldiers, 200,000 French and half a million Germans were killed at the Somme in 1916. Mr Heard began making the figures after he badly injured both hands in a car accident in 2013 and was unable to continue work as a wood carver.

He says: "I was in that dark place that a lot of people go to but it was a time when the lads were coming back from Afghanistan with their arms and legs missing and I just thought, 'This is ridiculous. There are a lot of people worse off'.

"I got thinking about the numbers and then about those in previous wars. I realized how difficult it was to visualize these huge numbers and thought through ways I could physically represent them."

Mr Heard made the first and only time all the figures in his shed in Watchet, Somerset, with just two helpers. The Shrouds Of The Somme have been on display in smaller numbers in cities this year but this is the

first and only time all the figures have been laid out together. They can be viewed until November 18 and will then be sold in aid of the Armed Forces charity SSAFA and the War Graves Commission.

British actor 'sexiest man alive'

IDRIS Elba this week cemented his status as a Hollywood heart-throb by being named the sexiest man alive.

The British actor and director has set hearts fluttering in screen roles including Luther and The Wire – and was for a time heavily tipped to be the next James Bond, although he has played down the rumors on several occasions.

Hackney-born Elba, 46, is the 33rd winner of the accolade, given yearly by US People magazine. He joins a line-up including Mel Gibson, Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson and David Beckham. The news was revealed on US channel NBC's The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon.

Elba told People: "I was like, 'Come on, no way. Really?' Looked in the mirror, I checked myself out. "I was like, 'Yeah, you are kind of sexy today'. But to be honest, it was just a nice feeling, a nice surprise – an ego boost, for sure."

On Twitter, he later expressed his gratitude and made a plea for Americans to get out and vote in the mid-term elections. "Who'd have thought it! Thank you People & all the fans for naming me #SexiestManAlive," wrote the star. "I'm honoured & thankful."

Elba, who is currently taking kickboxing lessons in Havana, Cuba, also told how he endured an awkward stage while growing up. The 6ft 3in actor said: "I was very tall and skinny. And my name was Idrissa Akuna Elba, OK? I got picked on a little bit. "But again, as soon as I could grow a moustache, I was the coolest kid on the block. Grew a moustache, had some muscles, bonkers."

Briton admits killing his newlywed wife at sea

A man with dual British and Australian citizenship whose newlywed wife went missing at sea as the couple sailed off the Bahamas on a belated honeymoon pleaded guilty on Monday to an involuntary manslaughter charge in federal court.

Lewis Bennett, 41, of Poole, Dorset, entered the plea at a hearing in Miami, Florida. He faces a maximum eight-year prison sentence in the May 2017 disappearance of Isabella Hellmann, his wife of just three months. The US district judge Federico Moreno set a sentencing date of 10 January 2019.

"Although nothing can ever erase the pain and suffering caused by Lewis Bennett's criminal acts, the US attorney's office and our law enforcement partners hope that the defendant's admission of guilt is a step toward justice for the victim," the federal prosecutor Ariana Fajardo Orshan said in a statement.

Bennett, a mining engineer, had told the FBI and British journalists that he and Hellmann, a south Florida real estate agent, took their 37ft catamaran, Surf Into Summer, for a Caribbean cruise. They left their infant daughter, Emelia, with family in Florida.

As the catamaran passed the Bahamas on the return to Florida, Bennett sent out an emergency radio signal. When the coast guard found him on a life raft three hours later, he told rescuers he had left Hellmann on deck as he retired for the night to their cabin. He said he was jolted awake when their craft hit something and that Hellmann was gone when he went outside. He said he abandoned the catamaran in a life raft because it was sinking.

A sworn document signed by Bennett and filed in court says that he could not recall whether he called out for his wife. He did not deploy any flares and did not search for Hellmann in the water with either the

catamaran or an attached dinghy. Nor did Bennett immediately activate any emergency equipment or call for help using his satellite phone.

It was not until Bennett boarded the life raft that he called for help and reported his wife missing, about 45 minutes after he was awakened.

Prosecutors said Bennett was an experienced sailor who received a certification from the Royal Yachting Association in the United

Kingdom as a "coastal skipper". The training included instruction on emergency procedures such as man-overboard protocols and night-sailing safety. His wife was not nearly as experienced.

The coast guard eventually located the boat. The FBI says an inspection of the catamaran before it sank showed portholes below the waterline had been opened and damage to the twin hulls appeared

to have been caused from the inside, meaning the boat may have been intentionally scuttled.

Investigators found Bennett on the life raft with \$100,000 worth of coins stolen from a yacht he had worked onboard in 2016.

Bennett pleaded guilty to the coin theft charge and received a seven-month prison sentence. While serving that sentence, he was charged in February with Hellmann's death and has remained jailed.

Emma Thompson, made a Dame, tries to steal a kiss...

Oscar-winning actress Emma Thompson has been honored with a damehood in London – and told the press how she tried to steal a kiss from Prince William at the ceremony.

The 59-year-old British star was named a dame by the Duke of Cambridge at a ceremony Wednesday at Buckingham Palace. Thompson wore a teal suit and white sneakers to the event, according to Vanity Fair. The Dame Commander of the Order of the British Empire (DBE) is the female equivalent of a knighthood.

Thompson told reporters she joked with William as he presented her with the honor. The actress is a longtime friend of the royal family and cheekily asked the prince for a kiss.

"I love Prince William," Thompson said after the ceremony. "I've known him since he was little, and we just sniggered at each other. I said, 'I can't kiss you, can I?' And he said, 'No don't!'"

"It's really lovely because I've always loved the boys, and I've always been a long-term correspondent

with their dad," she added, referencing William, Prince Harry and Prince Charles.

Thompson's husband, actor and producer Greg Wise, 31-year-old son

Tindyebwa and 18-year-old daughter Gaia attended the ceremony. Thompson was honored for her contributions to drama.

Kensington Palace later

tweeted: "Congratulations to Dame Emma Thompson! Today at Buckingham Palace, the actor received her Damehood from The Duke for Services to Drama."

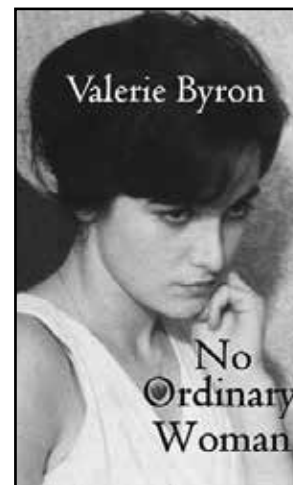
Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want

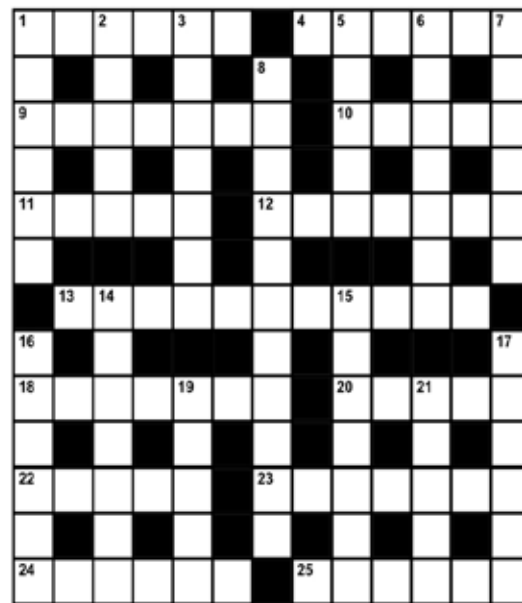

Getting over your election fever?

DID YOU VOTE?

If so you'll know that polling places are a bit odd here in LA. Unlike in the UK where it's usually a school, library or town hall, you can vote almost anywhere here. I heard of some bizarre reports of people voting at a local swimming pool, in a lifeguard station by the Pacific Ocean, an art gallery in Beverly Hills, Some people even voted in a Laundromat. Only in LA, right?

I was asked this year to volunteer as a clerk at my local polling station, which was in a boring old apartment building in Hollywood. Even though it was a long day (6am -10pm), it was really great saying hello and getting to know some of my neighbors. Political views aside, it was rewarding and nice to see so many people excited and

helping those who were voting for the first time. Some had their fingers crossed, others were annoyed at the lack of parking opportunities around the station. A little confusion arose as there were two different precincts voting in the same place. But we were extra diligent to make sure that the right people hit the right section at the booths. If you haven't volunteered to help at the booths yet, I highly recommend it....and not just for the cookies and pizzas and doughnuts and coffee kind voters brought to us as a thank you.

It was a very busy day, but the time flew by as it was reported that there were record numbers of people at the polls this year in California - which is awesome and shows that people are exercising their right

to be heard at the ballot box. Between the electoral college, mid-terms, voting for congressmen and/or senators, local, county and state initiatives and measures, it can all prove difficult to understand for newcomers, and that's understandable. It took me quite a while to figure it out too. But once you have a handle on the system, you can get see how it works at times and how flawed it can be too, regardless of your party preference.

As most of you already know by now, The Democrats took control of the house while the Republicans maintained power in the senate. Nationwide there were some encouraging firsts...

Jared Polis became the first-ever openly gay governor for the state of Colorado and Rashida Tlaib and Ilham Omar became the first Muslim women elected to Congress. In Minnesota, representative Omar succeeds US Congressman Keith Ellison, who in 2006 became the first Muslim elected to Congress. He is now stepping down to run for state attorney general.

And in Michigan, Ms Tlaib also has a history of breaking barriers - in 2008 she became the first Muslim woman elected to the Michigan Legislature and now moves on to the house of representatives. The oldest of 14 children, Ms Tlaib was born to a family of Palestinian immigrants in Detroit, where her father worked at a Ford Motor Co plant. Speaking to MSN, Ms Tlaib linked her campaign to the surge of female political activism in the US following Trump's stunning 2016 victory, alluding to the millions of women that took to the streets of Washington and major cities across the country after his inauguration.

"Today, women across the country are on the



ballot. Yes, we marched outside the Capitol, but now we get to march into the Capitol," she wrote on Twitter on Tuesday. "We are coming!"

The midterms had us not only voting on our officials, representatives and governor, but also on measures. We were voting on subjects as diverse as whether we keep daylight savings time year round whether we should the use of cages in egg production completely by 2022. Both measures passed.

Our minds inevitably are gearing up towards the Presidential election of 2020, but before we do here's a summary of this week's results:

Diane Feinstein kept her seat as California State Senator for California and Democrat **Gavin Newsom** will be our next Governor after beating Republican John Cox in a landslide. It was a tighter race for Lieutenant Governor as both candidates were Democratic candidates, **Eleni Kounalakis** pipped Ed Hernandez. Secretary of State stayed blue with **Alex Padilla** beating Republican

Mark P. Meuser. Elsewhere Attorney General and Insurance Commissioner both went to Democrats, **Xavier Becerra** and **Ricardo Lara** respectively.

Now on to the measures: **Measure 1** - Authorizes bonds to fund specified housing assistance programs. This passed with a 62% YES.

Measure 2 - Authorizes bonds to fund existing housing programs for individuals with mental illness. This passed with a 67% yes vote.

Measure 3: Authorizes bonds to fund projects for water supply and quality. This didn't pass - 51.17% of people voted NO.

Measure 4: Authorizes bonds funding construction at hospitals providing children's health care. This passed with a 67% YES

Measure 5 - Changes required for certain property owners to transfer their property tax. This didn't pass by 60%

Measure 6: Eliminates certain road repair and transportation

funding. This was rejected by 60%.

Measure 7 - Conforms daylight savings time to federal law, allows legislature to change daylight saving's time. Passed with 59%

Measure 8 - regulates amounts outpatient kidney dialysis clinics charge for dialysis treatment - Californians voted against this measure with 59%

Measure 10 - Expands local governments authority to enact rent control on residential property. This was a NO in a close race with only 52%

Measure 11 - Requires private sector emergency ambulance employees to remain on call during work breaks. - the people voted yes with a 60% vote.

Measure 12 - Nearly 70% people votes YES on this measure that establishes new standards for the confinement of specified farm animals.

For those that could vote and did thank you, and for those that can't vote yet, you can still get involved and volunteer! **See you next time round!**

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Players behind final Rooney cap

HARRY KANE has revealed Gareth Southgate consulted senior England players before he decided to hand Wayne Rooney his 120th and final cap.

And the man who led England to Russia this summer says he has no problem handing over the captain's armband if the former Three Lions skipper is given a late cameo appearance as a substitute as expected in the friendly against the USA at Wembley on Thursday.

The FA have come under criticism for "cheapening" the value of an England cap by taking the unprecedented decision to play Rooney at some point in the game against USA, not on merit but as recognition of his

service to the country in 15 years as an international player, but Kane said the squad has no problems with giving grace-and-favour awards to senior England players – not least the country's record goalscorer with 53 goals.

"We spoke previously about doing something for the players who have amazing milestones, amazing international careers," he said. "It was me and the gaffer and a couple of players. I didn't know it was going to be this week but I knew it was an idea that Gareth wanted to do."

"Wayne was an amazing player for us, one of our greatest-ever players. It will be nice to see him again and train with him again."

"I think the fans will embrace it. We should all

embrace it and give him the send-off he deserves."

Rooney will not be named the official captain if he is not in the starting line-up. But Kane admitted that once he is on the pitch, it is inevitable he will become the natural leader.

"Would I give him the armband? Yes, of course," said Kane. "He deserves it. He was a great captain for us."

Southgate has described criticism of the decision as 'strange'.

"There have been ongoing discussions since Wayne retired about paying tribute to him and his England career," said the manager, who added Rooney had declined an opportunity to be honoured ahead of the World Cup so as not to take the attention

away from those going to Russia.

"Those discussions started 12 months ago. We have an opportunity with the game at Wembley to pay tribute.

"I am still able to look to the future with the squad we've picked, but we've talked a lot about the history of the shirt.

"We have brought

former players back to speak and present shirts. I think all the players respect Wayne's contribution and that he deserves the best possible send-off."

Arsenal through but Welbeck injured

Arsenal qualified for the last 32 of the Europa League after a match marred by forward Danny Welbeck suffering what appeared to be a serious ankle injury.

The Gunners were held to a goalless draw by Portuguese side Sporting Lisbon at Emirates Stadium Thursday night to join Chelsea in the next phase.

Sporting ended the game with 10 men when ex-Barcelona defender Jeremy Mathieu was shown a straight red card after fouling Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang when he was clean through on goal - although the hosts could not find a winner.

But the fixture was overshadowed by the injury to England international Welbeck, who was carried off on a stretcher.



The 27-year-old was hurt in the 25th minute when he jumped for a header and landed badly on his right ankle (above).

He received oxygen and had his leg in a protective brace as he was taken off the pitch, with up to 10 medical staff around him as he received treatment.

Welbeck has scored five goals this season, played for England against Spain in September and had been named in Gareth Southgate's latest squad for the friendly with the United States and the Nations League match against Croatia.

CELTIC scored 14 seconds after conceding to secure a dramatic victory over

RB Leipzig to keep their Europa League dreams on track.

Leipzig's Jean-Kevin Augustin equalised with a header on 78 minutes but straight from the restart Odsonne Edouard struck to give Brendan Rodgers' men the win.

Knowing defeat could have eliminated them with two games to go, Kieran Tierney had put the hosts ahead early on.

Celtic sit third in Group B, level with Leipzig, but trail on head-to-head.

The Scottish champions travel to Trondheim to face Rosenborg next on November 29, before finishing at home to Salzburg a fortnight later.
