



# MAY'S FINAL GAMBIT....?

■ One last vote as the curtain lowers on the Prime Minister's shambolic tenure

**BRITAIN'S** chaotic exit from the EU lurched from crisis to farce this week, as Theresa May vowed to step down as Prime Minister if MPs passed the deal she negotiated in Brussels earlier this month.

The deal, which has already been defeated twice at Westminster, was given new life on Wednesday after Mrs. May promised Tory eurosceptics that she would step aside if it were passed, and let someone else take over the next stage of talks with Brussels.

The vote was scheduled for Friday March 29th, after press time, on the day which Britain was scheduled to leave the EU, in a move described as "desperate" by critics, Mrs May announced on Thursday that she will ask MPs to vote on only one part of the Brexit deal - the legally-binding

Withdrawal Agreement - in the hope that the whole deal will be agreed at a later date. If MPs agree to her plan, Britain will be able to leave the EU with a deal on May 22. If it is rejected, a long extension is the most likely outcome, with Britain having to take part in the European

Parliament elections in May. On Thursday night Mrs May still needed to persuade 52 Tory rebels to change their minds and agree to the Withdrawal Agreement for her to stand any chance of victory, but a hard core of around 20 Eurosceptics still insist they will never back down, with one saying he would not agree to it even with "a shotgun in my mouth". Labour and the DUP both said they would vote

against the Government. Mrs May spent 20 minutes on the phone to Jeremy Corbyn on Thursday but he told her he could not agree to her plan. **general election** Downing Street sources warned that another defeat for Mrs May could trigger an immediate general election to break the current deadlock and prevent MPs forcing a second referendum or a customs union with the EU.

The speaker of the House of Commons, John Bercow, has said he would allow Parliament to vote again only if the plan had changed substantially since it had been twice rejected resoundingly - and on Thursday he said the government had met that test. Mrs May's potential successors were on Thursday night jostling for position for a leadership election which could begin as early as Friday. **cont. on page 5, col 3**

With the sun surely setting on Theresa May's blighted occupancy of Number 10, speculation is rife in Westminster about her likely replacement at the head of the Conservative Party. So here's a quick summary of the front runners, and where they stand on the ONLY issue facing Britain in the near future: that little thing called Brexit.

## Michael Gove

Mr. Gove, 51, the environment secretary who formerly served as justice secretary and education secretary, is seen by some as a front-runner for the role, including some bookmakers who have put odds strongly in

his favor.

He was a prominent pro-Brexit campaigner ahead of the 2016 referendum, and in the years since has largely backed the prime minister's strategy. Some British media outlets have speculated recently that he would be the likely "consensus choice" to replace Mrs. May as a caretaker leader if she were ousted.

## Boris Johnson

Mr. Johnson, 54, the former foreign secretary, has been a vocal critic of the prime minister's Brexit plans. He gained notoriety as the outspoken and often-outrageous mayor of London from 2008 to 2016, before returning

to Parliament. He was a figurehead in the campaign to leave the European Union, and since the 2016 referendum has advocated a hard split with the bloc. This mind-set has put him at odds with Mrs. May, who has fought for relatively closer ties to Europe — and who has seen Mr. Johnson regularly undermine her efforts to negotiate a deal. He has long been a polarizing figure within the party, which could hurt his chances in a bid for its leadership.

## Jeremy Hunt

Mr. Hunt, 52, who replaced Mr. Johnson as foreign secretary, had

served as the country's health secretary for the previous six years. He voted for Britain to remain in the European Union in the 2016 referendum.

But in the years since, Mr. Hunt has become an outspoken supporter of the decision to leave. His view was hardened, he said, in part by the bloc's negotiation tactics, which he called "arrogant" and "disappointing."

## Sajid Javid

Mr. Javid, 49, Britain's home secretary, had been a successful banker before turning to politics. He is the son of parents who emigrated to Britain from Pakistan. Like Mr. Hunt, he also once supported Britain remaining in the European Union, but he has since come to support the efforts to leave. Mr. Javid has been positioning himself for a potential leadership role in recent months, making waves with the decision to strip the British citizenship of Shamima Begum, the teenager who traveled to Syria to join the Islamic State. But some, including fellow Tory lawmakers, criticized him for the move, calling it opportunistic.

## David Lidington

Mr. Lidington, 62, who was a supporter of the

campaign for Britain to remain in the European Union, is the prime minister's de facto deputy and has been described by many as her natural caretaker successor. When speculation began about a possible coup within her cabinet, some British tabloids pointed to Mr. Lidington as the presumed caretaker prime minister. But Mr. Lidington, when asked last weekend about the supposed plot, expressed admiration for Mrs. May and said he was working to rally support for her deal. His prospects of becoming a permanent successor are slim, however, because though widely respected, he is seen as a technocrat.

"One thing that working closely with the prime minister does is cure you completely of any lingering shred of ambition to want to do that task," he told The Guardian.

## Dominic Raab, 45

Considered a long shot for the top job, Mr. Raab was installed as Brexit secretary to deliver Mrs May's original Chequers plan, but he quit last

year in opposition to her withdrawal deal proposal. His resignation from the Cabinet fuelled his popularity among the hardline Brexiters.

## Amber Rudd

Work and Pensions Secretary, 55. A loyalist and moderniser, she has been widely tipped as a future leader in the past, but was forced to resign from her post as home secretary over the Windrush scandal.

## Jacob Rees-Mogg

Aged 49. The Arch Brexiteer is chairman of the European Research Group and has been at the forefront of the Brexit debate. Nicknamed 'the right honorable member for the 18th century' because of his fogeyish personal style, Rees-Mogg is said to be backing Boris Johnson.

## Andrea Leadsom

Leader of the House, 55. Has won admirers for her feisty clashes with Speaker John Bercow in recent weeks. Withdrew from the Tory leadership contest in 2016 due to dwindling support.

# Mojito diplomacy: Charles tours Old Havana behind the wheel of a classic MG

He is used to being chauffeur driven in a convoy on royal tours but on Tuesday Prince Charles took to the driving seat to embrace Cuba's love of classic cars.

The heir to the throne, on a royal tour of the Caribbean island, took the wheel of a beautifully restored 66-year-old MG TD - a rare sight on an island where many still drive American Cadillacs, Chevrolets and Dodges.

With his wife Camilla by his side, the 70-year-old prince drove to the classic car event in Havana's John Lennon Park to the sounds of the Beatles ringing out of the nearby Yellow Submarine bar.

Looking the part in sunglasses and a linen suit, the prince pulled up tentatively and stopped, before helping Camilla,

71, out of the passenger seat.

Charles told onlookers: "The one I was driving is the most beautiful car. It has an incredibly powerful accelerator. It is incredibly close to the brake so you have to be careful you don't press the wrong one."

His wife, in a mint-green Anna Valentine dress and parasol, needed a little help to get out of the low-slung car. "You try getting out of that elegantly!" she joked.

## 'in his element'

Turning to look at the range of cars on show, she laughed and said: "I remember most of these cars. Shows how old I am!" As Charles became absorbed in the vehicles on display, his wife joked: "He's never going to leave, he loves his cars. He's really rather

in his element."

They also met Lazaro William Gonzalez Ruiz, head of The British Classic Motorbike Enthusiasts, who was wearing a bandana and sporting leathers and metal jewellery.

Charles and Camilla seemed rather tickled by his appearance and chatted at length to him, through an interpreter, about his passion before looking at the bikes on show, including a 1956 Norton.

"Now motorbikes, that's something else he loves," said the Duchess.

Charles was then handed a Cuban cigar by a fellow classic car owner. The prince, who is said to dislike smoking, resisted the urge to spark it up in celebration but he did sniff the tobacco before handing it on to an aide.

The royal rental used to belong to 'our man in Havana' Stanley Fordham, then Britain's ambassador to Cuba.

Built in 1953, the ambassador is thought to have driven the black convertible in 1957, two years before the Revolution.

The roadster then ended up languishing in a garage in Havana, only to be discovered by chance by restaurant owner and band manager Eduardo Bermudez eight years ago.

Mr Bermudez, who manages musicians who used to sing in the world-famous Buena Vista Social Club, was last week asked by the British Embassy if he would loan the car to the prince for the morning.

He said the future king had practised driving it around the streets of Havana on Monday in preparation.

The royal couple also visited several of Cuba's

most famous institutions, including the Naitonal Ballet and enjoyed a Cuban jazz concert from Eliades Ochoa, one of the last remaining members

of the Buena Vista Social Club. The visit has been hailed as a diplomatic triumph back home, with the royal couple's visit being dubbed 'Mojito

Diplomacy' by the British press.

On Wednesday the couple flew to the Cayman Islands to continue their tour of the region.

## UK employment boom

BRITAIN has one of the world's highest employment rates as new figures reveal record numbers in work.

Some 32.7 million people have a job - almost half a million more than this time last year. It means the employment rate has soared to 76.1 per cent, the seventh best in the world and higher than all EU nations bar Sweden and the Netherlands. And this year Britain could be among the top three, behind Iceland and Switzerland. Some 222,000 people found work in the last quarter, the Office for National Statistics said.

The ONS also said the UK's jobless rate has fallen below four per cent for the first

time since 1975 and the number, 1.34 million, is 112,000 lower than a year ago, giving a jobless rate of 3.9 per cent, well below the EU average of 6.5 per cent. Furthermore, average earnings increased by 3.4 per cent in the year to January.

Business leaders welcomed the figures. Stephen Clarke, of the Resolution Foundation, said: "While business investment has stagnated, firms are choosing instead to invest heavily in new staff.

"This encouraging jobs growth is benefiting women and those traditionally left out of the labour market. It is even starting to have a knock-on effect on still historically weak pay rises."

## Tip top! £10k for Winston's hat

WINSTON Churchill's iconic top hat and one of his cigar cases have been valued at £10,000 – after being found at a tip.

The items were brought to Antiques Roadshow by David Rose, who unearthed them all at the dump where he works.

"I've worked there for like 15 years and I get to pull out whatever I like, mostly antiques," said Mr Rose, who said he had three sheds full of items from the dump at his home. In this week's episode of the popular British TV show, filmed at Eltham Palace in south-east London, specialist Mark Smith heard the items were gifted by the Second World War leader to one of his cooks – their authenticity confirmed by detailed letters from her to her son, also found in his haul. Presenting

over 200 letters, Mr Rose said: "She used to write to her son every day about the daily goings-on of Churchill, what he was getting up to, how he was feeling and just interesting stuff about him."

Also dumped was a signed photo of Sir Winston himself. Examining the items, Mr Smith revealed the authenticity would be in doubt were it not for the detailed letters. With the haul being unique, he valued the whole collection at £10,000-plus, an amount that Mr Rose described as "crazy".

However, the refuse worker remained tight-lipped about the location of the dump where he made the incredible find, saying "dozens" of people had already asked – and failed.

## McCanns facing hefty legal bill

Lisbon court papers show Madeleine's parents are over £24,000 out of pocket

THE parents of Madeleine McCann are being chased for tens of thousands of pounds in legal fees a decade after beginning a libel battle against a Portuguese ex-police chief.

Kate and Gerry McCann are set to be told by a Lisbon court they still owe Goncalo Amaral costs from contesting the claims in his 2008 book *The Truth Of The Lie*. The former policeman, who accused the couple of putting their daughter's life at risk in a new Netflix series about Madeleine's disappearance in 2007, will demand a four-figure sum from the McCanns.

Amaral, 59, is now waiting for a judgment from the European Court of Human Rights over the lengthy legal battle with the McCanns before deciding whether to launch a compensation claim.

Legal papers at a Lisbon court show the McCanns are already nearly £24,500 out of pocket after accusing Amaral of

defaming them over the disappearance of their daughter. A bill of £5,346 to cover outstanding court costs is about to be sent to the McCanns' lawyer Isabel Duarte.

And that is likely to pave the way for a fresh claim by Amaral to get Madeleine's parents to compensate him for another £5,148 in remaining fees that were incurred in persuading Portugal's top court to back him over the book fight.

The McCanns had to pay £5,548 in costs to *Truth Of The Lie* publishers, Guerra e Paz, despite its lawyer admitting to a miscalculation of nearly £1,800. The court files also show an error by Amaral's lawyer almost led to the McCanns paying the ex-policeman around £1,800 more in costs than necessary. The couple's total bill – which does not include costs they have incurred taking the case to Europe – will rise to nearly £35,000 once the McCanns are

sent their new bill and Amaral demands they compensate him for his final payment linked to the Portuguese court fight. An appendix to the files also lays bare the former officer's financial position when he penned his book. Ms Duarte applied to have Amaral's assets seized in June 2009 after lodging a claim for £1million in damages on behalf of the McCanns and their children. But a financial probe revealed the £60,000 Jaguar car Amaral drove was owned by a firm he set up four months after his book was published. It

also showed an Algarve home – registered in his then-wife's name – had liens – security for a debt – totalling nearly £400,000.

In the Netflix documentary series released earlier this month, Amaral claimed the McCanns put their toddler's life at risk by publicising her distinctive eye marking. A source close to the couple is reported to have said: "Mr Amaral doesn't seem to have any compassion for Kate and Gerry and is only interested in publicising himself."

## Ska's Ranking Roger dead at 56

British ska musician Ranking Roger has died aged 56 after a battle with cancer.

Born Roger Charlery in Birmingham in 1963, Roger shot to fame as a singer and frontman for the Beat, one of the four big British ska revival bands – along with the Specials, Madness and the Selecter – to emerge after punk in the late 1970s. The Beat's flowering was a brief one, but Roger was at the heart of the group's successes in the early 80s, when they had five Top 10 singles and two Top 5 albums in the UK before splitting in 1984. He had songwriting credits on many of their most popular compositions, and alongside duties as joint vocalist with Dave Wakeling was also the

band's "toaster", talking in stylised fashion over various song sections in a mode popularised by reggae deejays of the late 60s and early 70s.

Later he pursued solo projects and collaborations with various well-known bands and artists, including Big Audio Dynamite and Sting, before touring

and recording with a reincarnation of the Beat, with whom he worked until his death.

Most recently his musical life had centred around a Beat revival band featuring his daughter Saffren on vocals and son Matthew as toaster: in a deal with Wakeling, who had a rival Beat group in the US, Roger's troupe

concentrated on touring the UK and Europe, while Wakeling's musicians (known as the English Beat in America) focused on the US. Roger's band released albums in 2016 (*Bounce*) and 2019 (*Public*

*Confidential*), and he relished the chance to add new material to the old. "Even if we're not as big as the first time, the respect and the credibility are still there," he said. "For me, they are great

things to have."

Early this year, Roger announced that following a stroke and the discovery of two brain tumours he had also been diagnosed with lung cancer. He is survived by five children.

# Meet A Member: Meena Ysanne

Meet Meena Ysanne from London, who first moved to LA 14 years ago to pursue her career composing, arranging, conducting, and playing orchestral strings for rock and pop musicians, as well as for film and TV....oh, and writing books on the side.

## Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

I didn't choose LA - LA chose me! I'm a conductor/composer/arranger of orchestral music, as well as playing violin. I came for the very first time in 2004 for three weeks, to work on a record out here. At that time, I was also working on a new opera commission for the English National Opera in London, and had just come off tour with (the Dutch DJ and record producer) Tiesto - and, somehow my trajectory changed, and I'm here! Everything has organically unfolded from that initial project, in a magical way. I feel incredibly blessed that LA has welcomed me, it's a wonderful place, with unparalleled natural beauty, and the most extraordinary community of creative people anywhere in the world.

## What do you miss most from home?

Firstly, home is where the heart is, and as someone who has traveled so much for so many years, my home is where I lay my hat. So that's LA right now. But absolutely, I love the UK, and London in particular, and there are many things that the UK does better than anywhere else, including Stonehenge, storytelling, and a really nice cup of tea with a biccy!

And also things specific

to my music, such as Abbey Road Studios, where The Beatles famously recorded, and many incredible orchestral musicians I know and love. But then, my focus here in LA is to provide opportunities in London, as well as here, for music to flourish.

## What was your first impression of LA and has it changed since?

The first night I arrived was November 23, 2004. It was a warm night and the air was fragrant with unfamiliar smells from the garden where I was staying, right in the middle of Hollywood. Everyone seemed so friendly and open, and my first meal was pupusas at an El Salvadoran place, which was the first time I'd ever heard of them, let alone tasted them. Going to bed that first night in Villa Elaine, an old hotel where Marilyn Monroe had lived, and many other golden age Hollywood creative people, from Man Ray to one of my musical heroes, Frank Sinatra - well, the spirit of that building was so inspiring to me. The magic of this place is still so alive, and it's still inspiring me!

## What do you find the biggest difference is living here versus London?

Goodness, where should I start? Umm.... everything! From learning to drive here so I could simply get from A to B, to trying to understand the local norms regarding such simple human behaviours as meeting a romantic partner. Things are different here, in a fundamental way, from the most basic human

interactions to bigger things.

## Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?

I'm currently sitting in Barney's Beanery in West Hollywood. Established 99 years ago, it's a fabulous piece of original Americana located on Route 66, only a few blocks from my home. It was a classic hang-out for 1950s beatniks, and for 1960s musicians including Janis Joplin and Jim Morrison and more recently, it's where Quentin Tarantino wrote Pulp Fiction. It's still an inspiring place for creative types to work, shoot pool and chow down on huge sandwiches and surprisingly good salads. Love the history of this place, and it's still going strong because, it's still awesome - and has free wifi, so it's a great place to work, as well as have fun.

## What would you suggest to others who are thinking about making the move here?

If you're a creative person, it's good to know that the cream of the crop of every kind of entertainment professional has been arriving in this town since the moment it began. So, be prepared. Be realistic. Be gracious, and although you don't need to leave your ambition at the door, make sure you understand that this city is more about being a tortoise than a hare, in my opinion.

## Lots of our members join our group Brits in LA seeking out words of wisdom - what is the best piece of advice you've been given?

"Opportunity never has a neon sign on its head." Meaning, you could easily miss a small crack in a door opening to welcome you to a life-changing experience, so be present, open and aware to everything, however cheesy or small it may seem! Magic lies in your periphery vision.

## Lastly, how can we find out more about you? Are you working on anything at the moment?

I am working on a significant music project right now that will be launching at Abbey Road Studios in London, in 2020. It's truly significant - way beyond my dreams. Jeremy Hunt has told Cabinet colleagues he believes he has the backing of 100 Tory MPs while Sajid Javid is reportedly attempting to convince Michael Gove to join his ticket.

If Mrs May's vote fails she will be expected to announce that she will leave Number 10 as soon as a replacement is chosen.

David Jones, a former Brexit minister, said: "The general feeling is that she should go regardless of whether her deal goes through.

"People are already putting their campaigns together and are actively seeking support. It would be helpful to everyone if she left in as dignified

a manner as possible, as soon as possible."

Another senior Tory said: "If we cannot get a deal through there will have to be a general election and you can't go into an election with a leader who has already said they will go."

Mrs May's predecessor David Cameron entered the fray on Thursday by saying Mrs May needed to persuade different factions to "compromise".

He said: "The basic problem is that Parliament is stuck. There are four groups in Parliament: People who want the Prime Minister's deal, people who want no deal, people who want a second referendum and people who want a softer Brexit.

"The Government has to try and find a way of getting at least two of those groups to work together, to combine their

options, to compromise to find that partnership agreement and I hope that is what will happen."

Asked who he would like to takeover from Theresa May, he said: "It is not for me to say. One of the reasons I have tried to give as few of these interviews as possible is that it is a very hard job being prime minister and it is not made easier by your immediate predecessor giving a running commentary.

"I have tried not to say too much because I support Theresa May and wish her well in what she has to do."

There was some hope among Conservatives that splitting Mrs. May's plan in two would strengthen her case with opposition Labour MPs, whose main objections are to the political declaration and not the withdrawal agreement.

But Labour leaders reacted angrily to the idea on Thursday, noting that Mrs. May had previously said the two pieces of her plan were inextricably linked.

Keir Starmer warned on Thursday that splitting them "would leave us with the blindest of blindfold Brexits." He was referring to Labour's fear that, if Parliament passed part of Mrs. May's plan and the prime minister resigned, a hard-line pro-Brexit politician like Boris Johnson would take over and shape the crucial next stage of negotiations.

Earlier in the week no fewer than eight alternate plans to leave failed to muster a majority, leading the The Guardian to run the following headline on its front page on Thursday: "No. No. No. No. No. No. No. No."

## WOW! goes bust

Seems that cheaper isn't always better...as just this week budget transatlantic carrier WOW! Air went bust.

'Tis unfortunate for travelers who have already booked, as the company aren't offering refunds and are suggesting to contact other airlines as soon as possible. It says passengers covered by various protected booking methods, including booking by credit card or through a European travel agent, should try to get their money back from them. Some of the other similar airlines are offering up to 25% rescue discount on new flights for the victims of the fall. Check Norwegian, easyjet and Icelandic Air, to name but a few.

Some people who are deeply affected have taken to Twitter with their complaints. News of cancelled weddings

and honeymoons, dream holidays and not making it home in time for funerals are among the complaints. One disgruntled non traveler described it as the "Fyre festival of airline travel", referring to the shambolic Bahamaian island music festival fiasco recently outlined in competing documentaries on Netflix and Hulu

The company released a statement overnight saying they were in the final stages of raising money with a group of investors and that they were postponing all flights until documentation with all parties involved were finalized.

Wow was founded in 2011 by its chief executive, Skuli Mogensen. It started flights in 2012 and grew to employ 1,000 people, carrying 3.5 million passengers last year in its 11 aircraft.

According to the BBC,

Aviation expert Chris Tarry, from consultants Ctaira, said Wow was simply not able to make enough profit in a highly competitive market: "Wow faced stiff competition on the northern Europe to North America route, which is being served by rival low-cost operator, Norwegian. Wow offered low fares - but so did the rest of the pack. Even the traditional carriers were offering keen fares.

"Travelling with Wow also involved going via Iceland - attractive if you have the time and money to spare on that, but with others pricing fares keenly, something people were thinking wasn't worth their time."

Mr Mogensen wrote a letter to employees on Thursday which said: "I will never be able to forgive myself for not taking action sooner, since it is evident that Wow was an amazing airline and we were on

the right track to do great things again."

He went on "It's now, unfortunately out of our hands. I'm very sorry about this as these are people who have supported us and it's amazing how positive our passengers have been from day one and I'm disappointed not to honour our commitments to these people."

But Wow isn't the only airline feeling the

pinch these days as a number of airlines have run into financial trouble recently, with factors such as higher fuel bills and excess capacity in the sector contributing to their problems.

The UK's "flybe" airline closed along with other European budget carriers and "Ryanair" have reported drastic drops for their first quarter already.

It's very sad for the

employees too, and bad news for travelers as it now means low inventory and less seats traveling back and forth to the UK which will probably mean a hike in the cost of flights.

**Wednesday night in Santa Monica saw the LA premiere of Maze, an engrossing Irish drama focusing on the audacious escape of 38 prisoners from the notorious prison of the same name in Northern Ireland in 1983.** The screening was held at the Laemmle Monica Film Center on Second Street, and was followed by a post-screening Q+A with director Stephen Burke, actor Tom Vaughan-Lawlor and producer Jane Doolan.

Vaughan-Lawlor plays Larry Marley a convicted IRA operative reeling from the perceived failure of the 1981 hunger strike in the Maze's 'H-Block' which ended in the deaths of ten IRA prisoners including Bobby Sands. While Marley's cellmates bemoan a very real human and public relations loss, Marley seeks to fight a different campaign - and painstakingly plots what will become the biggest mass prison break since the Second World War. Marley

targets hard-nut loyalist warder Gordon Close (Barry Ward), and slowly but surely ingratiates himself with the prison hierarchy, gradually gathering information and ultimately identifying the prison's fatal security flaw.

Burke unfolds the story in a calm, low-key and scrupulously even-handed manner, dropping the viewer right back to a troubled time that seems both far away and

strikingly familiar. With the help of real prison sets in Cork, MAZE gets the tone right, down to the depressing 1980s casual clothes the IRA prisoners won the right to wear.

Although this is never really an exciting film, it is absorbing, thanks mainly to Vaughan-Lawlor's performance. With concentration and pure conviction, the actor portrays the almost-monastic single-mindedness of an IRA

man who is utterly devoted to his cause.

This film educates as well as entertains, and provides a salutary reminder of how far we've come since the Good Friday Agreement.

### Germany and Holland? No problem insists Northern Ireland striker

Josh Magennis insists Northern Ireland can pip either the Netherlands or Germany to secure qualification for Euro 2020.

Magennis' 87th-minute goal secured a vital 2-1 win over Belarus as Northern Ireland remained on top of Group C, ahead of Germany and the Netherlands.

"We truly believe we can do it," said the 28-year-old Bolton striker.

"There is no point me standing here if I didn't think we could go through. I might as well not show up."

Following Sunday's last-gasp win, Northern Ireland lead Group C on six points - three ahead of Germany who earned a dramatic opening 3-2 away win over the Netherlands on Sunday, with the Dutch also on three points after two games.

Michael O'Neill's side will begin a run of four concluding games against the Group C big guns with a home match against Germany on 9 September.

Northern Ireland will be away to the Netherlands on 10 October before

a November double-header which sees them hosting the Dutch and facing Germany away.

Magennis, whose winner was his fifth international goal, added: "Maybe we will have to dig deep. I also say, 'Why not us?'"

"It's a cliché and cheesy but the main thing was the three points and we want 12 points out of the first four games, and then we can head towards September, October and November.

"We have started off well and now we have to look forward to June."

### Scotland at 'rock bottom' - Robertson

Scotland are at "rock bottom" after their first two Euro 2020 qualifying games, says captain Andy Robertson.

Alex McLeish's side are fifth in Group I following a 3-0 defeat in Kazakhstan and an unconvincing 2-0 win over San Marino, the world's bottom-ranked side.

But the Liverpool left-back is calling on the squad to "stick together" in a bid to recover from their sticky start.

"The only way we do that is by winning games and playing a lot

better," said 25-year-old Robertson.

"The country is at rock bottom just now in terms of football and we need to pick it back up."

McLeish and the players came in for heavy criticism after the loss to Kazakhstan, who were hammered 4-0 at home by Russia on Sunday.

And Scotland's performance in San Marino did nothing to ease the pressure on the manager before a June double-header at home to Cyprus and away to group leaders Belgium.

Robertson, who missed the opening qualifier because of dental surgery but returned to skipper the team on Sunday, admitted the San Marino game was "all about damage limitation".

"When you get beaten in a game you were meant to win, and people are saying it's the worst result we've ever had, then this week was never going to be a success," he said.

"But we followed it up with not a good performance again. The lads need to stick together."

## England stars deliver another five star show

England survived an early scare to mount an impressive comeback and outclass Montenegro in Podgorica, on Monday in a game overshadowed by racist abuse directed at visiting players.

Manager Gareth Southgate gave first starts to youngsters Declan Rice and Callum Hudson-Odoi but England were stunned after only 17 minutes when Marko Vesovic gave Jordan Pickford no chance with a precise, curling finish.

The visitors kept their composure to respond emphatically with confidence, class and power by taking maximum points - and 10 goals - from their first two Euro 2020 qualifiers.

However, the victory was marred by an unsavoury conclusion with Sterling clearly responding to taunts from the home fans in his goal celebration, and Hudson-Odoi having to retrieve an object thrown on to the pitch.

And the Montenegro supporters also directed chants at Danny Rose after the defender was shown a yellow card late on, casting a shadow over another great night for Southgate and his team.

## Saints boss bans wi-fi

Southampton manager Ralph Hasenhuttl has blocked the wi-fi at team hotels to prevent his squad from playing "addictive" video games.

Hasenhuttl, who faced similar problems at former club RB Leipzig, compared it to alcohol and drug addiction.

"It's something you get addicted to and that means we have to protect the players," the 51-year-old said.

On Thursday, an anonymous English footballer admitted lengthy gaming sessions threatened to ruin his career.

The Sun revealed the unknown EFL player would play popular video game Fortnite for up to 13 hours a day.

"It's something you have to force actively against and I will do this," said Hasenhuttl, whose side travel to Brighton in the Premier League on Saturday.

"I did it in my last club.

We had also problems with players - they were playing until three o'clock in the morning before a game.

"You have to help protect them because it's not a small problem. If you are honest it's the same as alcoholism or getting addicted to drugs.

"To protect them means helping them not to spend so much time there. We block the wi-fi in the hotel, for example, in the evening so they can't play any more."

Austrian Hasenhuttl, who took over at Southampton in

December, said none of his players has serious problems with gaming but added: "You can be sure that I'm always in contact with my captain or with a few players to speak about them.

"As long as it's not officially for the government an illness, then we have to protect them in our way.

"If it would be an illness then it would be easy for the government to say the companies have to give a block after three hours, for example, that they cannot play this game any more."

# Welsh make winning start

Wales held on for victory against Slovakia in Cardiff on Sunday to make a winning start to their Euro 2020 qualifying campaign.

The hosts flew out of the blocks with attacking intent and led inside five minutes as Daniel James struck his first international goal with a bullet of a shot from 20 yards.

Wales had chances to extend their lead but risked squandering it against a resurgent Slovakia, for whom Albert Rusnak and Robert Mak both had shots saved by Wayne Hennessey.

The Wales goalkeeper then made a crucial

intervention with eight minutes left as he palmed away Michal Duris' close-range header, before David Hancko missed the rebound as the visitors pressed for an equaliser.

Ryan Giggs' side, the second seeds in Group E, lived dangerously in the closing stages but they defended resolutely to cling on for what could prove to be a crucial win against Slovakia, the group's third seeds and potentially their main rivals for one of the two automatic qualifying places.

Slovakia and Croatia, the top seeds, had already started their campaigns with victories - over

Hungary and Azerbaijan respectively - so Wales move level with them on three points. Hungary also have three points, after they shocked World Cup runners-up Croatia 2-1 later on Sunday.

This was a significant result for Wales, who are aiming to rekindle the magic of Euro 2016 and that epic run to the semi-finals after a 58-year absence from major tournaments.

Giggs had described his mixed first year in charge as a "free hit", an opportunity to experiment, knowing he would be judged on this qualifying campaign.

Under his guidance, Wales have evolved

in an attacking sense - with their new manager placing a strong emphasis on youth and pace - but that has occasionally

been at the expense of defensive stability, and the jitters they suffered while clinging on to the narrowest of advantages

The minimum

punishment from Uefa for an incident of racism is a partial stadium closure, while a second offence results in one match being played behind closed doors and a fine of 50,000 euros (£42,500).

Uefa rules add: "Any subsequent offence is punished with more than one match behind closed doors, a stadium closure, the forfeiting of a match, the deduction of points and/or disqualification from the competition."

# Solskjaer confirmed as United boss

*"We are looking forward, but we have got to work harder," says the Norwegian*

Ole Gunnar Solskjaer was named the club's permanent manager on Thursday, and immediately challenged his Manchester United players to "work harder" - and warned them against complacency because they will "never last at this club".

The former United striker arrived on an interim basis in December to replace Jose Mourinho.

Under the Norwegian, 46, United have lost only once in 13 league games.

"We are looking forward, we have got to work harder," Solskjaer said.

"I want a Man Utd team to be one of the hardest working, fittest teams and that will bring results.

"Now the players know I am here for longer than expected. Players that get complacent never last at this club."

Speaking at Old Trafford after signing a three-year contract, he described the position as his "ultimate dream", and revealed Sir Alex Ferguson was one of the

first people he called after his position was made permanent.

"This has been my ultimate dream, maybe a naive dream," he said. "But I've always had that dream in my mind.

"It's a huge, fantastic family of a football club and I'm so honoured to be given the responsibility."

Solskjaer spent 11 seasons as a United player, scoring the winning goal in the 1999 Champions League final.

When he took charge, United were sixth in the Premier League and 11 points off the top four. They are now just two points behind Arsenal, who occupy the final Champions League qualifying spot.

He became the first United manager to win his first six league games, beating a record held by Sir Matt Busby.

"I'm just going to be myself as I've always been. I know the trade of course. I want us to lift trophies but I can't wait to get to the challenge of improving the squad,"

Solskjaer said.

"We have worked with them, for three months and the improvement is there to be seen. We know there is so much more to come from them.

"Every day in training the attitude has been fantastic but we know we've a long way to go. It's going to be a mountain to climb but we've climbed a few mountains before."

United have not won the Premier League since 2013 - Ferguson's final season in charge - though they finished second behind Manchester City last term under Mourinho.

When Solskjaer returned to the club, United's points tally was closer to the bottom of the league than the top, but he has since led them to victories at Tottenham, Arsenal and Chelsea, with a top-four finish now within their grasp.

Solskjaer's aim is to one day lead United back to the top of the table but he admits it may take some time.

"To lift the Premier League trophy again is

what we expect, what we're used to, what we have done so many times," he said.

"We can't wait too many years but it's not going to happen overnight.

"I know we will be successful but it's about taking it step by step.

"What I have done before as a player doesn't really bother me because I am always looking

forward.

"It was fantastic to work with the best manager in the world but now I am working here as the manager and I think that's a bigger achievement."

## Montenegro charged for racist chanting

Uefa has charged Montenegro with racist behaviour following the abuse suffered by England players in their Euro 2020 qualifier in Podgorica on Monday.

England won 5-1 but the match was overshadowed by racist chanting from some home fans directed at several England players, including Danny Rose.

Uefa said "disciplinary proceedings" had been opened against Montenegro with one charge for "racist behaviour".

The case will be dealt with by European football's governing

body on 16 May.

Montenegro coach Ljubisa Tumbakovic said he did not "hear or notice any" racist abuse.

But England manager Gareth Southgate, speaking to BBC Radio 5 Live said he "definitely heard the racist abuse of Rose".

"There's no doubt in my mind it happened," he added. "I know what I heard. It's unacceptable.

"We have to make sure our players feel supported, they know the dressing room is there and we as a group of staff are there for them.

"We have to report it through the correct

channels. It is clear that so many people have heard it and we have to continue to make strides in our country and trust the authorities to take the right action."

Anti-discrimination group Fare said they had identified the match as "high risk" for racism before the game and executive director Piara Powar said: "We had an observer present who picked up evidence of racial abuse.

"Our monitoring team have been compiling the evidence we have before presenting it to Uefa."

Montenegro also face other charges relating
