GAY CHILD 'ABSOLUTELY FINE' SAYS PRINCE WILLIAM

Duke of Cambridge again voices his support for LGBT rights

The Duke of Cambridge has said it would be "absolutely fine" if his children were gay or transgender but admitted he would be worried about the "persecution" they could face.

Prince William, who has been vocal in his support for LGBT rights, said the question was one he had been thinking about since he became a parent.

Speaking on a visit to the Albert Kennedy Trust, which helps homeless young gay and transgender people, he said that he would be "nervous" about how they might be treated.

Prince William, who in 2016 became the first member of the royal family to be photographed for the cover of a gay magazine, giving an interview to Attitude in which he spoke out about homophobic bullying, was officially opening the trust's new services centre in Hoxton, east London.

During a group discussion with people supported by the charity, often because they have been rejected by their parents, one man asked: "If your child one day in the future said, 'Oh I'm gay, oh I'm lesbian' whatever, how would you

react?"

William replied: "I've been giving that some thought recently because a couple of other parents said that to me as well. I think you really don't start thinking about that until you are a parent, and I think — obviously absolutely fine by me.

'doing a lot of talking'

"The one thing I'd be worried about is how they — particularly the roles my children fill — is how that is going to be interpreted and seen.

"So Catherine and I were doing a lot of talking about it to make sure they were prepared. I think communication is so important with everything. In order to help understand it you've got to talk a lot about stuff and make sure how to support each other and how to go through the process.

"It worries me, not because of them being gay, it worries me as to how everyone else will

react and perceive it and then the pressure is then on them."

During what the organisers believe was the first time a member of the royal family has visited an LGBT organisation, William also returned to the issue during a group discussion with several of its ambassadors, young people who have been supported by the charity and now mentor others using its services.

Faz Bukhari, 28, from east London, had problems at home from the age of 24 when he began to identify as transgender. He left home soon after and found support and accommodation through the charity's Purple Door refuge scheme. He now works for a housing association.

He asked William: "You coming here is a great opportunity and platform, what would you think about it if one your children was LGBT?"

Top Tories urge Boris to fess up

SENIOR Conservatives piled pressure on Boris Johnson this week to come clean about the screaming row that led to him being quizzed by police at the weekend.

MPs queued up to demand he explain what happened during a noisy late-night argument at his girlfriend's flat. Mr Johnson's supporters insisted it was a private matter and pointed out officers left without taking action. But the Tory leadership frontrunner maintained a determined silence in the face of a growing clamour to explain himself.

Liam Fox, a supporter of Foreign Secretary Jeremy Hunt, suggested it would be better for Mr Johnson to speak out to draw a line under the incident. The International Trade Secretary said: "I think it's always easier to just give an explanation.

"What we can't have is it being a distraction from explanations about wider policy and where we go to and when.

"It is inevitable there is a focus on private lives. That does not concern me. What I am concerned about are the issues."

Rival candidate Jeremy Hunt said the ex-Cabinet minister should "answer questions on everything".

While Tory grandee Sir Malcolm Rifkind said dodging questions made it look as if Mr Johnson had "something to hide". Penny Mordaunt, who is backing Mr Hunt, said the contest was a choice between "a character or someone with character". The Defence Secretary suggested Mr Johnson was like a "short-term sugar rush" and warned members against being "seduced" by promises that cannot be delivered.

'get off me'

She added she wanted Mr Hunt to be prime minister because the party needed "someone who can inspire and motivate the whole of the country, and doesn't alienate voters for no reason".

Mr Johnson has refused to discuss the incident at the south London flat owned by his girlfriend Carrie Symonds in the early hours of Friday morning, insisting the party faithful did not want "to hear about that kind of thing".

In a recording made by a neighbour, Ms Symonds was heard telling the Tory MP to "get off me" and "get out of my flat". Police initially denied they had a record of the row but later said they spoke to all occupants of the address,

who were safe and well. On Saturday night, the neighbour who rang the Metropolitan Police, went public to deny suggestions that his recording of the row had been leaked to the Guardian with political intent. Tom Penn said the allegations were "bizarre and fictitious" and claimed the row "was loud enough and angry enough that I felt frightened and concerned for the welfare of those involved".

Mr Johnson's allies also rallied to his defence and insisted it was a private matter as he kept a low profile. Tory MP Bob Seely said Mr Johnson was the victim of a "feeble hatchet job". Treasury chief Liz Truss said: "I believe it's a private matter, I don't think the public are concerned about that.

'brilliant job'

"I think Boris is somebody who served for eight years as mayor of London and did a brilliant job. He also served as foreign secretary.

"People know what he's like in office and that's what's important."

Communities minister Rishi Sunak told Sky News: "The police were called and of course that's something that people are going to be rightly

interested in but then let's just look at that. "The police were called to an incident and what did they say?

"They said everybody was safe, everybody was well, there was no concerns that the officers had and there was no cause for any further action.

"Given that's what the police have said, and it is clearly a private incident, I think we should just leave it at that."

Mr Hunt and Mr Johnson continue to meet party members across the country and will be helicoptered separately around the UK over the coming weeks to face questioning. Mr Hunt, who spent Sunday campaigning in Scotland, visiting Peterhead,

Aberdeenshire, said everyone had something they would be "embarrassed" about if it came out but insisted contenders for No 10 must not duck scrutiny.

"I think someone who wants to be prime minister should answer questions on everything," he said. "I am not going to comment on Boris's personal life. That's for others to make their judgments on.

"What Boris needs to do is engage properly in this leadership debate.... This is an audition to be the prime minister of the United Kingdom and Boris needs to show that he is prepared to answer difficult questions."

Former foreign secretary Sir Malcolm Rifkind said Mr Johnson had made an "error of judgment".

"If you are running to become our next prime minister and the police are called to your house you can't really expect to get away with just 'no comment'.

"It makes it look as if you have something to hide." He added: "The problem that Boris Johnson has is it's just one of a whole host of issues that have opened up the questions as to whether he has the capability, the personality to handle the job of prime minister."

Sir Malcolm insisted a colourful private life was not a barrier to become prime minister but Tory members would now be asking if he had the "qualities required for the huge burden" of the job. "I think the jury's out," he said.

is something I'm nervous about, not of the fact if any of them were to be gay, but because of the pressures they'll face, because of my family and the position we're in. I'd fully support whatever decisions they make. It worries me how many barriers, persecution and hate they'd face. But that's for all of us to try

and correct."

Afterwards Mr Bukhari said: "I thought his answer was so good, to hear him talk about having fears about what people might think of his children and how they might take to them, if they were identified as LGBT. That he recognises that, and is aware there could be a backlash, he understands the issues and hopefully with his comments we can get more awareness across to more parents of the issues."

The duke spoke of how "stifling" many young people find the burden of coming out to their families and also of his concerns about young LGBT people taking their own lives. "It's a real pressure to live under," he said during a conversation with Cath Hall, the trust's founder.

William also told the group how shocked he had been by the recent bus attack on a lesbian couple in London. "I was really appalled by that attack, that stuff like that still happens."

NHS tops British pride poll

THE free NHS gives Britons the biggest sense of national pride, according to a new poll.

The beloved jewel in the crown health service accounts for 53 per cent of votes. A proper cup of tea and our sense of humour are also high up the scale. Eating is not far from our minds as next we rate a full English breakfast and British food. The fabric of our national lifestyle is also valued by the beautiful countryside (35 per cent), the Royal Family, interesting history, our sarcasm (29 per cent), pubs (28 per cent) and Sir David Attenborough (26 per cent).

But there is a generation gap over the royals – 46 per cent of older people rate them higher compared to 23 per cent among the young. When we travel abroad the food and drink we miss most is a decent cup of tea (37 per cent), fish and chips (36 per cent) and roasts (31 per cent). And a cuppa pops up again as our favourite tradition in times of crisis on 31 per cent followed by sarcasm (28 per cent) and a chat in the pub (26 per cent).

Meanwhile, the celebrities who make us proud to be British are Sir David Attenborough (46 per cent), Prince Harry (28 per cent) and Prince William (26 per cent), author JK Rowling (24 per cent), singer Adele (20 per cent) and actress Emma Watson (17 per cent).

The study found national values are prevalent in our country, with 93 per cent of 1,500 respondents claiming to feel proud to be British. Andrew Joret of British Lion Eggs, which commissioned the poll, said: "We may be in a time of political turmoil, but there's much the country takes great pride in."

Scorching Glastonbury!

Huge crowds expected at iconic music festival as mercury soars to record highs

THOUSANDS of festival-goers have descended on Worthy Farm ahead of what could be the hottest Glastonbury Festival on record.

Eager revellers gathered outside the Somerset farm, with some sleeping in their cars overnight to be among the first to bag the perfect camping spot. While campers were pictured wearing Wellington boots and anoraks, waterproof clothing may not be necessary this year. Glastonbury is traditionally a mud-fest with rain often flooding the site, but temperatures are set to soar this weekend.

As he welcomed the crowds, farm owner and event organiser Michael

Eavis, 83, said: "The weather looks great." The mercury was expected to hit 89F on Friday when British rapper Stormzy headlines and it will reach a scorching high of 95F on Saturday when US rockers The Killers take to the Pyramid Stage. However, by the time Kylie Minogue is on stage on the Sunday afternoon "Legends slot" conditions will have cooled off to a fresher 68F. Organisers urged the 200,000 people coming to bring their own reusable water bottles to the 900-acre site, as 2019 marks the first year that single-use plastic bottles are banned.

Emily Eavis, 40, who organises the festival with her father, said the ban would stop more

than a million plastic bottles being used. "I really hope that everyone will leave Worthy Farm this year knowing that even small, everyday changes can make a real

difference," she said.

Standard £248 tickets for the five-day event sold out in just 36 minutes. The eclectic line-up includes music stars as diverse as US

singer Miley Cyrus, actor and jazz pianist Jeff Goldblum, Seventies psychedelic rockers Hawkwind while Luther star Idris Elba will be performing a DJ set.

Ulster veteran demands same protection as IRA suspects

Dennis Hutchings is one of seven former British soldiers facing trial over 'legacy killings'

A BRITISH veteran at the centre of a "witch-hunt" of former Northern Ireland soldiers has challenged former prime minister Tony Blair to give him the same stay-out-of-jail card he gave IRA suspects.

Dennis Hutchings, 78, has been denied trial by jury and must appear before a Northern Ireland judge over a shooting during The Troubles nearly 50 years ago. This judge-only "Diplock system" was brought in to handle terrorism cases amid fears a jury could be intimidated.

Mr Hutchings, who is seriously ill, is one of seven British soldiers currently facing trial over "legacy" killings during The Troubles. But under

Mr Blair's Good Friday Agreement in 1998, more than 500 convicted terrorists were released early and nearly 200 on-the-run letters or "Letters of Comfort" were issued to suspects, telling them they would not be pursued. Recipients included 1982 Hyde Park bomb suspect John Downey, whose 2014 trial collapsed when his comfort letter was revealed in court.

Mr Hutchings, who has twice been investigated over the shooting and cleared of wrongdoing, said: "I want Tony Blair to personally give me my comfort letter.

"I am not and never was a terrorist. I was a soldier. But if I'm to be treated like a terrorist, I want the same preferential treatment the

IRA got. I also want him to give a comfort letter to every other British veteran facing these investigations.

"We were caught up in a brutal civil war, but now, nearly 50 years on this has been forgotten.

"Instead, we are the targets of a government-backed witch-hunt and classed as terrorists while the real terrorists walk free.

'running scared'

"This is because Tony Blair sold the British Army down the river to appease Sinn Fein/IRA when he struck the Good Friday Agreement.

"Subsequent governments have been running scared of Sinn Fein and we are being

treated as expendable."

Mr Hutchings, of Cornwall, is charged with attempted murder and attempted grievous bodily harm with intent over the killing of John Patrick Cunningham, 27, in Co Tyrone in 1974. Unarmed Mr Cunningham, who was said to have had learning difficulties and

feared men in uniform, was shot in the back as he fled from an Army patrol in what Mr Hutchings accepts was "a tragedy".

Mr Blair declined to respond on the record but his team cited the Hallett review of 2014, which found he "did not give terrorist suspects an 'amnesty'." He said in

2015: "This issue of on-the-runs was absolutely critical to the peace process and at certain points became fundamental to it.

"If I had literally been saying, 'We're not dealing with this at all' - I think you can never be sure of these things - it is likely the process would have collapsed."

Hillsborough police chief facing retrial

THE police chief in charge during the Hillsborough disaster will face a retrial, a judge ruled on Monday.

Former chief superintendent David Duckenfield, 74, had already been tried over the manslaughter of 95 Liverpool fans. Jurors were unable to reach a verdict in April after 29 hours of deliberation following a 10-week hearing. Lawyers for Duckenfield, of Ferndown, Dorset - who denies the offences - opposed the retrial. But at Preston Crown Court, judge Sir Peter Openshaw accepted the Crown Prosecution Service's plea for the case to be heard again. It will start on October 7 at the same court.

About 10 family members were there to hear the ruling. John Traynor - whose two

brothers died - said he was "delighted". "It's what we've been waiting for. Now we can plan our lives again," he said. Irene McGlone, whose husband Alan died in the crush, was relieved and "over the moon". Daughter Amy McGlone, who was five at the time, said it was the

right decision "for not just the families, but for the public as well".

Duckenfield is charged with manslaughter by gross negligence of 95 fans at the FA Cup semi-final between Liverpool and Nottingham Forest at Sheffield Wednesday's ground in 1989.

Seaside café mocks coffee snobs 'no nonsense' menu

A Dorset cafe has mocked coffee snobs with a 'no nonsense' list of simplified orders.

The sign outside the unnamed eatery in Sandbanks, Poole, (pictured, right) swapped widely-used coffee names like flat white, latte and mocha for more straightforward descriptions like 'white coffee', 'milky coffee' and 'choccy coffee'.

A snap of the blackboard sparked widespread debate after it was shared by a tourist on social media - with some coffee aficionados left unimpressed by the cafe owner's light-hearted approach.

The chalkboard sits outside with the title 'No nonsense coffee guide, hot drinks menu'.

Crossing out the name of cappuccino they



replace it with 'frothy coffee', and Americano with 'black coffee'.

While some recognised the mocking humour, others were less than happy about the the

incorrect way the coffee would be made when matched with the names.

"I don't want my coffee made by people who don't understand coffee," fumed one.

Grieving sisters are fined £200 - because they took too long to say their final goodbye to Dad...

■ Hayley James and Mandy Pinney wanted time alone with father Terry James after family funeral

Two grieving sisters have been fined £200 after their father's funeral overran by just 48 seconds as they said their final goodbyes.

Hayley James and Mandy Pinney had wanted a few minutes alone with father Terry James before closing the curtain at Grimsby Crematorium, North East Lincolnshire.

They had the last 40 minutes slot of the day, and wanted to touch their father's coffin one last time, and said nobody else was waiting outside to get in.

But their funeral directors were sent a bill from North East Lincolnshire Council for £200, demanding payment for going over their allotted time by just 48 seconds.

'petty and disrespectful'

Ms James said: 'After the main service my sister and I wanted to touch dad's coffin one last time and close the curtain.

Staff at the crematorium watched us.

'We were taken to the coffin by the funeral director and they watched us the whole time.

'I could understand it if we were five or 10 minutes over our time. But just by seconds is petty and disrespectful.

'If they are going to time people and impose fines for going over by just a few seconds, how do they know whose watch is right?'

She added: 'To be fined for going over just a few seconds just seems so petty and callous.'

Freedom of Information request has revealed there have been six families fined for over running funerals at Grimsby Crematorium by less than two minutes.

There were 20 fines imposed, totalling £4,000 over a 21-month period.

Grieving Ms James, of Cleethorpes said: 'I know they are a business and they need to organise times for everyone using the crematorium every day.

'But for us this is the only time in our lives we have to do it.

'We wanted to spend just a few last moments with our dad because the funeral service was so full. So we went back very briefly at the end.'

The fine was imposed after the funeral on June 18. It was the last service of the day at 3.40pm.

'lack of compassion'

The chapel was full of mourners wanting to say farewell to the former Big Band musician, who died earlier this month aged 87 years.

Hayley said: 'The

chapel was extremely full of mourners and we had a lovely service and everything went very smoothly.

'We all managed to vacate the premises with time to spare and in a lovely gesture of kindness our funeral director Bryan, from Embersons Funeral Directors took us both back inside the chapel to say a final farewell to our father.

'We checked with a member of staff who was watching our every move, to ascertain whether we had enough time to do this. He said we had a couple of minutes.'

Having said their goodbyes, his daughters closed the curtains.

'Obviously we were distressed and would have cherished a little more time. But we hurriedly left the chapel.'

She added: 'In our view the

management team of Grimsby Crematorium need to show a little more discretion at such sad times.

'The amount of the fine is insignificant. But the lack of compassion and understanding leaves much to be desired.'

A North East Lincolnshire Council spokesman said: 'We're going to look into this

complaint and review the overall policy as soon as we can, but on the majority of occasions the Council works well with funeral directors to make sure services run as smoothly as possible. 'As the policy stands, a charge is imposed on the funeral director if a service at the Crematorium overruns.

'Funeral directors

manage the proceedings and it is at their discretion whether or not to pass this charge to their client.

'The charge is currently £200 - the same as it costs to book additional time in the chapel.

'We work with funeral directors to help them plan ahead and reserve extra chapel time if it is needed.'

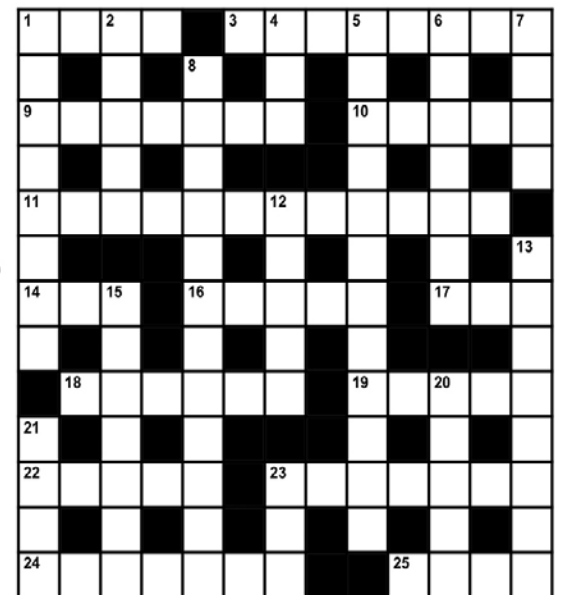

Iran: the dismal drumbeats grow ever louder....

I don't know whether to laugh or be terrified when I hear that President Trump is now threatening Iran.. most of it is of course unfolding on Twitter!!

It's worrying when a country reneges on international agreements. These are supposedly implemented to make the world a safer place. America has never been on friendly terms with Iran, but tensions stepped up a level when the US pulled out of the Iran nuclear deal last year. I understand that the contract was not perfect, but at least a step in the right direction. At the time many leaders tried to intervene; and even Russia and China expressed regret on America's withdrawal. Ultimately, I think it comes down to oil, as it always does... I don't believe

that Iran is innocent by any means, but I do wish our world leaders could carry themselves with a little more decorum. It doesn't help when the Iranian President, Hassan Rouhani retorts "the White House is afflicted by mental disability..."

I am bewildered by the Trump effect, I don't understand why so many people, especially those who declare they despise his immaturity and name calling, stoop down to his level. If we really want the world to be a nicer place we have to start by behaving with a little more dignity. It's a dreadful shame that the tensions with Iran have been reignited, for so many reasons but I feel particular empathy with British citizen Richard Ratcliffe and his wife Nazanin Zaghari-

Ratcliffe, who was jailed in Iran back in 2016 after being unfairly convicted of spying. Richard has been campaigning in Britain for her release, which at one point looked imminent, until Boris Johnson (who was Foreign Secretary at the time) reinforced the claims by clumsily declaring she was teaching journalism, which is apparently illegal in Iran! Yet another example of the lack of diplomacy amongst our current breed of politicians! His careless words were even used as evidence in her court case. Sadly, there is a lot of proof that points towards Nazarin being a pawn in a much bigger scarier scenario. The Times broke a story that revealed she is basically being held hostage until the UK government fulfills a £400 million debt owed to Iran for an arms trading deal back in the 1970s.

Even worse is the fact that their young daughter Gabriella Ratcliffe, (who has British citizenship only) had her British passport confiscated, and is still stranded in Iran with her grandparents. Nazarin started a hunger strike earlier this month in protest, and in a touching stand of solidarity Richard set up camp outside the Iranian Embassy in London and began his own. As he rightly pointed out "A hunger strike in prison, nobody gets to see it - a hunger strike here is much more public. I will keep her story public."

One of our Brits In LA members Beverly, made a visit to him earlier this week. He was in surprisingly good spirits in spite of it being Day 10 of his hunger strike. He said the compassion of others has really helped to keep him going. She asked him 'what more can we do to help?' His answer was to keep sharing their plight - on social media, within your local communities, with your local MP etc. the more noise people make the more chance the Iranian regime will be forced to listen. So here

Murray exults in comeback victory

AFTER his first tournament back since hip surgery in January, Andy Murray summed up his triumph nicely. "I just won the doubles here with a metal hip," he said. "It's mental, really."

Under normal circumstances, his 37-year-old partner Feliciano Lopez's achievement of winning the final five matches on Centre Court at Queen's Club – securing the doubles and singles titles – would be the story. But the Scot's return to tennis has been anything but normal. He had admitted nerves earlier in the week but the old instincts soon kicked in and he was fist-pumping and shouting at his player's box yesterday like the old times.

Murray is already looking forward to returning to singles action. It was a high-profile fitness test that he well and truly passed.

"My hip felt great, no pain – I feel good just now," said the 32-year-old. "As the week went on, any apprehension

I had I lost. I was not thinking about my hip, I was just throwing myself around. Even when I landed on it, it didn't come loose or anything!

"I expected it to be sore, but I literally have nothing there. For probably five or six years, after matches I would get some pain and aching and throbbing, and things like that you would just anticipate and wait for that to happen. And it doesn't any more, and it's brilliant."

Rarely has Murray looked so happy. It was the third doubles title of his career – and the first without brother Jamie. The pair had won ATP Tour doubles together at Valencia in 2010 and in Tokyo a year later – but nothing compared to this. "This is very different for me, and it's more special than a lot of the singles tournaments that I have won for a lot of different reasons," said the five-time winner of the singles title at the tournament.

"It has been brilliant. I have really enjoyed it."

Asked if he could

continue playing doubles for the rest of his career if his hip is unable to handle singles, Murray said: "It's possible. I hope that I'm able to get back to playing singles but if not then, yeah, it is something I'd probably consider."

Facing Briton Joe Salisbury and American Rajeev Ram in the final Murray suffered the first service break to go 4-3 down when Salisbury hit a superb service return winner down the line. But serving for the set at 5-4, Salisbury was broken on the winning point when he scooped a half-volley long after a wickedly dipping service return from Murray. He and Lopez then won a tight tiebreak but the Scot's serve was broken again to lose the second set when the Spaniard missed a volley. But somehow Lopez found the energy and the inspiration to hit three consecutive winners in the champions tiebreak, before Salisbury miscued a service return on the second match point from a Murray serve.



Dutch tyro headed to Anfield

Liverpool have reached an agreement to sign 17-year-old centre-back Sepp van den Berg from PEC Zwolle for an initial £1.3m.

The Netherlands Under-19 international, (pictured) who was also a target for Ajax, Bayern Munich and PSV Eindhoven, will officially join the Reds on 1 July.

The fee for Van den Berg could rise to £4.4m depending on add-ons, based on first-team

appearances.

He will be Liverpool's first signing of the summer when he officially joins.

Van den Berg made 15 appearances for PEC Zwolle in the Dutch top flight last season.

Liverpool compare Van den Berg to being at about the same level as Joe Gomez when they signed the defender for £3.5m from Charlton in June 2015.

England international Gomez was a key part

of Liverpool's defence last season before injury curtailed his season.

The Anfield club see Van den Berg as a player for the long term and, although there is a belief he could be with the first team from day one, the focus initially would be on his development and integration.

England's World Cup hopes hang in the balance after a demoralising defeat by Australia at Lord's on Tuesday.

The 64-run loss means they might need to win their last two games, beginning with India at Edgbaston on Sunday, in order to make the last four.

Much will depend on the results of Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Pakistan, who can all overhaul Eoin Morgan's men.

The hosts began the tournament as favourites, but now have little margin for error, with this loss following Friday's shock reverse to Sri Lanka to make a total of three defeats in seven games.

They actually did well

to restrict Australia to 285-7, especially after captain Aaron Finch's century helped his team to 173-1.

However, that target was always going to be a challenge against the dangerous Australia attack in conditions ideally suited to pace bowling.

So it proved. The heart was ripped out of England's top order and, at 53-4, their chase was in tatters.

Just as he did against Sri Lanka, Ben Stokes played a virtually lone hand for 89, but after he was bowled by a searing Mitchell Starc yorker, England subsided to 221 all out.

Now they face the prospect of having to beat at least one, maybe both, of India and New Zealand - two unbeaten sides and, in the case of India, the best team in the tournament.

A year ago, in the wake of the sandpaper scandal, a chaotic Australia were hammered 5-0 in an ODI series in England.

Ashley strikes again as Rafa is sent packing

RAFA BENITEZ was sent packing by Newcastle this week - after being given no warning they were about to give up on him.

The club took Benitez by surprise by announcing his three-year reign at the club was over a week before his contract expires. A weekend intervention by owner Mike Ashley is believed to have triggered a noon statement. There was little chance Benitez would have been persuaded to stay on but last-ditch talks had been expected. It left Toon legend Alan Shearer calling the departure a "shambles" while former United striker Micky Quinn labelled the turn of events "embarrassing".

Fans are also up in

arms and threatening a boycott. Benitez is said to have refused a meeting with managing director Lee Charnley last week. Both club and manager had been waiting for the other to blink in a tussle over Benitez's vision. Newcastle have been contacted by a host of potential new managers already. Arsene Wenger, Jose Mourinho, Laurent Blanc and Bruno Genesio are all available while Burnley's Sean Dyche and Geordie Steve Bruce could top a list of domestic contenders. The club say Benitez has walked away from a £6m, one-year deal and £50m-a-season transfer kitty. But he could not accept a lack of control over transfers.

Lionesses roar into semis

Phil Neville's side produce dominant display to reach final four of Women's World Cup

England reached their second consecutive Women's World Cup semi-final as they produced an excellent performance to beat Norway in Le Havre on Thursday.

Lucy Bronze's brilliant second-half strike capped a fine night that saw the Lionesses become the first senior England team to reach the last four at three consecutive major tournaments.

Two slick team moves had given them a deserved 2-0 half-time lead, as Jill Scott and Ellen White found the net from close range either side of White hitting the post.

Nikita Parris saw a late penalty well saved by Ingrid Hjelmseth but that did not dampen England's jubilant mood at full-time, as they celebrated with sheer joy after moving within one win of their first major final.

White's tap-in took her goals tally to five for the tournament, putting her joint leader in the race for the Golden Boot alongside the United States' Alex Morgan and Australia's Sam Kerr.

Backed by thousands of delighted travelling fans, the Lionesses will now

face either France or the US in the semi-finals on Tuesday in Lyon.

The hosts and the holders met in their highly anticipated last-eight tie after press time on Friday.

England's well-deserved progression also boosted their hopes of representing Great Britain at the 2020 Olympics, with the three best-finishing European teams qualifying for next summer's Tokyo Games.

England's three fine goals entertained the 21,111 fans who were at Le Havre's Stade Oceane near the English Channel, including delighted former men's internationals David Beckham and Ian Wright, who witnessed a memorable performance.

The Lionesses, who reached the last four at the 2015 World Cup in Canada and 2017 European Championship, arrived in France with realistic ambitions of winning a first major title and they showed their true potential on Thursday.

Wins over Scotland, Argentina and Japan saw England top Group D without finding their best

form, while a victory over an unruly Cameroon side followed in the last 16. The quarter-final against Norway was without doubt the Lionesses' strongest display of the finals so far.

Two excellent team moves down the right gave them a deserved 2-0 half-time lead, with Scott putting England in front in the third minute after Bronze's cut-back.

Lively winger Parris then clipped wide from close range and a confident White fired on to the post as England created the best chances, before the Manchester City-bound striker tucked in from Parris' unselfish square ball.

Backed by their buoyant fans' band, who danced in celebration long after the full-time whistle, England deservedly lapped up the applause before their journey continues to Lyon.

Norway, who won the 1995 title, were playing in their sixth World Cup quarter-final, but were well beaten by a side ranked nine places above them.

Martin Sjogren's team struggled to win the ball in midfield in the early

stages and, when they did get in threatening positions in the first half, Barcelona forward

Caroline Graham Hansen was repeatedly thwarted by England centre-back Millie Bright.

£50m Wan-Bissaka headed to United

Manchester United have reached an agreement with Crystal Palace to sign right-back Aaron Wan-Bissaka.

The deal is worth £50m and the 21-year-old England Under-21 international is set to travel for a medical imminently before going on holiday.

United have offered Wan-Bissaka a long-term contract and wages of up to £80,000 a week.

He is on £10,000 a week at Selhurst Park, the lowest-paid player in Palace's first-team squad.

Wan-Bissaka, who has been on international duty this month at the European Under-21 Championship, joined Crystal Palace academy when he was 11 and made his first-team debut in 2018.

United would pay £45m up front, which would make him the Old Trafford club's fifth-biggest signing, behind Paul Pogba, Romelu Lukaku, Angel di Maria and Fred.

A sticking point in negotiations was the 25% sell-on clause that United

inserted into Wilfried Zaha's contract when they sold the winger back to Palace for £6m in February 2015.

The Eagles wanted the clause removed or reduced, but United eventually refused - based on the low fee they received four years ago - and it will remain in place.

If the deal is completed, Wan-Bissaka will be United's second summer arrival, after 21-year-old Wales winger Daniel James joined from Swansea for £15m earlier in June.
