May hails world beaters!



■ Your courage bowled me over, PM tells World Cup winners

England's victorious cricket team paid a visit to Theresa May in Downing Street on Monday to celebrate their World Cup win.

Captain Eoin Morgan led his players to meet the Prime Minister after cheers erupted from Whitehall. The Prime Minister, a self-professed cricket fan who attended the final at Lord's, couldn't contain her joy as she laughed with players. As she

greeted the team outside Number 10, she was shown the trophy, which England won for the first time after a heart-stopping showdown against New Zealand. The team arrived by coach at 6.45pm and were met by a crowd of cheering fans. Mrs

May was given the chance to get her hands on the trophy outside No 10 before shaking hands with the England players and posing for a photograph. Before they headed inside for the reception, she described Sunday's win as "a brilliant performance

by a brilliant team". And went on to hail the team's "courage and determination" in beating New Zealand in the super over showdown at Lord's.

'great step forward'
"They showed flair, courage and an absolute determination to become world champions. The achievement, delivered in such a thrilling style on home soil, will live

forever in our sporting history. "It's also exciting to think just how many children will be inspired by this victory to pick up a bat for the first time and hopefully become the great cricketers and World Cup winners of tomorrow." She added: "We must build on this success... the [Government's] school sport and activity plan has been welcomed

by nearly 40 leading sports organisations as well as Sport England who said it was a great step forward." In 2005, in the alcohol-fuelled aftermath of the England team's Ashes win over Australia, the players visited Downing Street. Fast bowler Matthew Hoggard admitted some players "relieved ourselves in the rhododendron bushes" in the No 10 garden.

May condemns Trump for Congresswomen attack

■ PM says President's outburst "totally unacceptable"

THERESA May this week joined the international condemnation of Donald Trump after he told four ethnic minority US congresswomen who criticised his leadership to "go back" to "the places from which they came".

The outgoing prime minister described the US President's outburst as "totally unacceptable". Her scathing criticism follows growing tensions between Downing Street and the White House after the leak of diplomatic emails criticizing Mr Trump earlier this month. The President has been engulfed by accusations of racism since his attack on Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, Ilhan Omar,

Ayanna Pressley and Rashida Tlaib. Of the four, only Ms Omar was born outside the US.

Mr Trump used his Twitter account to hit back at the female politicians after they criticized his administration. In a series of tweets, he wrote: "So interesting to see 'progressive' Democrat congresswomen, who originally came from countries whose governments are a complete and total catastrophe, the worst, most corrupt and inept anywhere in the world [if they even have a functioning government at all], now loudly and viciously telling the people of the United States, the greatest and most

powerful nation on earth, how our government is to be run.

"Why don't they go back and help fix the totally broken and crime-infested places from which they came? Then come back and show us how it is done. These places need your help badly, you can't leave fast enough."

Mrs May's spokesman said: "The Prime Minister's view is that the language used to refer to these women was totally unacceptable." He declined to be drawn on whether she thought his remarks were "racist" but said Mrs May had no plans to speak to Mr Trump before she leaves office. Scotland's First Minister Nicola Sturgeon

tweeted: "The President of the US telling elected politicians – or any other Americans for that matter – to 'go back' to other countries is not OK, and diplomatic politeness should not stop us saying so."

Lib Dem leadership contender Jo Swinson

added: "The President of the United States is a racist. Every political leader should call this out."

Ms Omar was born in Somalia and came to the US aged 12, while Ms OcasioCortez is of Puerto Rican descent, Ms Tlaib's parents were Palestinian

immigrants and Ms Pressley is an African-American. But Mr Trump seemed unfazed by the reaction. Speaking at the White House yesterday he said: "If you're not happy in the US, if you're complaining all the time, you can leave, you can leave right now."

No early election if I win, vows Boris

BORIS Johnson this week ruled out an early general election if he becomes Britain's next prime minister.

In a live online debate with his Tory leadership rival Jeremy Hunt, the frontrunner to succeed Theresa May committed himself to seeing out the current parliamentary term, which ends in

2022, before going to the country.

"We will have an election at some stage in 2022," the ex-foreign secretary said. He also warned that holding an election before the country had left the EU would be "the height of folly" that could put Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn into Downing

Street. Mr Johnson clarified his position during the debate held in central London on Monday. He had raised some doubt about his election plans during another debate last week by referring to the "forthcoming election".

Giving an upbeat assessment of the chances of a Brexit deal by the

EU's deadline of October 31, he said: "The EU will respond now to some real clarity of purpose. The momentum is with exit on October 31 unless the UK Government asks for a further extension."

'biggest betrayal'

However, Mr Hunt tore into his rival for rigidly sticking to the October

31 deadline. He also warned it could backfire and put Mr Corbyn in power. "We have got to be very careful. If we get this wrong we will trip ourselves into an accidental general election long before October 31," he said.

"We might well give the keys to Downing Street to somebody who will

never deliver Brexit, and that will be the biggest betrayal."

Both leadership contenders said Mr Corbyn should be considered anti-Semitic because of his party's failure to tackle widespread allegations of anti-Jewish hatred among grassroots members.



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Labour sacks Baroness Hayter for comparing Corbyn to Hitler in bunker

■ Anti-semitism row continues to fester

Labour's deputy leader in the Lords was sacked from the front bench Wednesday night after comparing Jeremy Corbyn's "bunker mentality" to Hitler's last days.

Baroness Hayter of Kentish Town was removed as a shadow Brexit minister by Mr Corbyn for what Labour said were "deeply offensive remarks".

She remains in her leadership role because it is elected directly by the party's peers — who are in open revolt against Mr Corbyn over

the antisemitism crisis engulfing Labour.

Speaking this week to a meeting of Labour First, a group on the right of the party, Lady Hayter said: "That disclaiming of intelligence, the refusal to share, is an absolute symbol of the bunker mentality."

According to Huffpost, she added: "Those of you who haven't [read the book] will have seen the film *The Bunker*, about the last days of Hitler, where you stop receiving any information into the inner group which suggests things are not going the way you want.

That seems to be where we are: the leadership in a bunker so they are not hearing those views, that evidence, that is in conflict with what they are trying to do, to the extent that [it] even undermines what they are trying to do."

Lady Hayter, a peer since 2010, previously worked for Labour in the European parliament and was chairwoman of its ruling national executive.

A Labour spokesman said: "Dianne Hayter has been sacked from her frontbench position with immediate effect for her deeply offensive remarks about Jeremy Corbyn and

his office. To compare the Labour leader and party staff working to elect a Labour government to the Nazi regime is truly contemptible and grossly insensitive to Jewish staff in particular."

'this is your legacy'

Theresa May responded to the news by accusing the Labour leader of "dodging his responsibilities" in failing to deal with antisemitism, after more than 60 Labour peers placed an advertisement in the *Guardian* attacking him over a "toxic culture" dividing "our movement".

Mrs May said: "Before he parades himself as the champion of the people, or the defender of equality and fairness, he needs to apologise for his failure

to deal with racism in the Labour Party."

Reading excerpts from the advert, she added: "Sixty distinguished members of the Labour Party have written in the newspapers [that] the party welcomes everyone 'except, it seems, Jews. This is your legacy, Mr Corbyn. You still haven't opened your eyes, you still haven't told the whole truth, you still haven't accepted your responsibility'."

The prime minister added: "Activists protesting, MPs leaving, staff resigning — what will his great heroes of Attlee, Bevan and Benn think?"

Mr Corbyn insisted that Labour "totally opposes" racism. He said: "Antisemitism has no

place in our society, [or] our parties, and no place in any of our dialogue. Neither does any other form of racism. When 60 per cent of Tory party members think Islam is a threat to western civilisation, and the prime minister has said she will act on Islamophobia within her party, I hope she does. I look forward to that being dealt with as we deal with any racism that occurs within our party."

The advert was signed by 67 of Labour's 179 peers.

Wes Streeting, Labour MP for Ilford North, tweeted: "Jeremy Corbyn has lost the moral high ground through his failure to act on antisemitism. [He] is left throwing mud from the gutter."

Hunt battles to save Iran deal

FOREIGN Secretary Jeremy Hunt this week battled to keep the Iranian nuclear deal alive amid rising tensions across the Middle East.

Travelling to a meeting of EU foreign ministers in Brussels on Monday, Mr Hunt said there was "a small window" to salvage the deal designed to limit Iran's nuclear activities and stop it developing nuclear

weapons. He was working with France and Germany — the two other EU signatories to the deal which is also backed by China and Russia. Earlier Mr Hunt offered to return an Iranian tanker seized by Royal Marines off Gibraltar because it was suspected of heading for Syria. Mr Hunt said of the deal: "Well, it isn't dead yet." He added: "If Iran acquires nuclear weapons then other

countries in the region will acquire nuclear weapons. It becomes a very, very toxic and dangerous situation.

"We are looking to find a way to preserve the nuclear deal. Iran is still a good year away from developing a nuclear weapon.

"We think there is still some closing but small window to keep the deal alive. What we are looking for is to give

Iran a way out of this so that they can get back into compliance with that nuclear deal."

He also said that, in a call with Iran's foreign minister Mohammad Javad Zarif on Saturday, he offered to help secure the release of its Grace 1 tanker in return for guarantees from Tehran that it would not breach EU sanctions on the Assad regime. Mr Hunt spoke as US ambassador to the EU Gordon Sondland urged ministers to stand by sanctions President Trump imposed on Iran after he withdrew from the deal last year.

Amid rising tensions last week, the Royal Navy frigate HMS Montrose had to place itself between a British tanker and three Iranian patrol boats in the Strait of Hormuz. At the weekend the Ministry of Defence announced that Type 45 destroyer HMS Duncan is heading to the region to help escort British ships.

No deal Brexit 'could cost £30bn'

Public borrowing could double next year if there is a no-deal Brexit, the country's spending watchdog says.

The Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) said borrowing would be almost £60bn if the UK leaves without a deal - up from £29.3bn if it does get a deal.

The watchdog said this scenario was based on assumptions that a no-deal Brexit would cause a UK recession.

The UK is set to leave the European Union on 31 October.

Chances of a no-deal outcome appear to have risen recently, after both Tory leadership contenders said they would be willing to leave the EU without a deal.

London Bridge attackers 'killed lawfully' court finds

■ Inquest rules counter-terrorism police had no choice but to use lethal force

THE London Bridge terrorists, who killed eight people and injured 48 others, were lawfully killed by police, an inquest found on Monday.

Khuram Butt, 27, Rachid Redouane, 30, and Youssef Zaghba, 22, mowed down pedestrians on the bridge before stabbing random members of the public around Borough Market on June 3, 2017. Their rampage was stopped after less than 10 minutes when they confronted three armed officers.

The Old Bailey heard the police shouting warnings but opened fire as Butt, Redouane and Zaghba - who were wearing fake suicide vests - came at them. Fearing Butt and Redouane could still detonate explosive devices as they lay injured, the officers shot at them again, jurors heard. A bomb disposal expert told the court he only realized the suicide belts were fake after he cut them off the dead bodies and held them up.

Jurors took three-and-a-half hours to decide the attackers were lawfully killed by police after they "ignored clear warning shouts". Chief coroner Mark Lucraft QC had directed them that was the only "safe" conclusion. He praised the officers' actions and said nothing less than "lethal force" had been appropriate. An armed officer identified only as BX46 told jurors he shouted words to the effect of, "armed police, stand still, drop the knife", believing he was in immediate danger as Butt came at him.

He said: "I believe his

intention was to use the knife and stab me, kill me and get hold of my weapons. "At this point, I was aware that around his torso he was wearing an improvised explosive device.

"I already knew he had a knife and he was a threat to my life but now he was an even bigger threat. A detonation would be fatal to colleagues, members of the public, anyone in the location.

"So I aimed my rifle towards the male and I was moving back quickly and I moved the fire selector lever to fire and I pulled the trigger."

His colleague BX44 also shot at Butt but broke away to fire at Redouane as he bore down on another colleague, BX45. PC Iain Rae told the inquest that he went to

handcuff Redouane as he moved on the ground while his colleague, PC Tim Andrews, handcuffed injured Butt. PC Rae, 51, who was also called on to protect the public in the wake of the 7/7 London bombings

in 2005, was one of a number of officers recognised for their bravery. He said police teamwork on the night of the London Bridge attack was "magnificent".

A separate inquest concluded victims

Xavier Thomas, 45, Chrissy Archibald, 30, Sara Zelenak, 21, James McMullan, 32, Kirsty Boden, 28, Alexandre Pigeard, 26, Sebastien Belanger, 36, and Ignacio Echeverria, 39, were unlawfully killed.

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Codebreaker Turing to be new face of £50 note

'Outstanding mathematician' committed suicide in 1954 after conviction for homosexual act

SECOND World War code-breaker Alan Turing is to be the new face on the £50 note, the Bank of England revealed on Monday.

Governor Mark Carney said an image of Turing, who is often credited as the father of computer science, will feature on the polymer £50 expected to enter circulation in 2021. The design includes a 1949 quote from Turing about his post-war work on early computers: "This is only a foretaste of what is to come, and only the shadow of what is going to be."

His signature from the visitors' book at Bletchley Park in 1947, where he worked during the war, features, alongside mathematical formulae and ticker tape depicting his birth date – June 23, 1912 – in binary code. Last year the Banknote Character Advisory Committee decided to celebrate science on the new notes and members of the public were invited to put forward names. The Bank received 227,299 nominations, covering 989 eligible figures including the late physicist Stephen

Hawking, fossil hunter Mary Anning and chemist Rosalind Franklin, who helped discover the structure of DNA. A shortlist was drawn up, with the Governor making the final decision.

Mr Carney said: "Alan Turing was an outstanding mathematician whose work has had an enormous impact on how we live today."

'much-deserved'

"As the father of computer science and artificial intelligence, as well as a war hero, Alan



Turing's contributions were far-ranging and path-breaking."

Turing is best-known for his work on the Nazis' Enigma machine which shortened the war and saved millions of lives, but he played a pivotal role in the development of early computers. He

laid the foundations for artificial intelligence by considering the question of whether machines could think. Turing died aged 41 in 1954 from cyanide poisoning following a conviction for "gross indecency" for his relationship with a man. An inquest determined

his death as suicide. He was pardoned in 2013 and will become the first known LGBT person on an English bank note.

LGBT campaigner Peter Tatchell said: "This is a much-deserved accolade for one of the greatest minds of the 20th century."

Large shortfall in Scottish tax receipts

The amount of income tax revenue raised by the Scottish government in 2017/18 went up by 1.8% but was still £941m short of original forecasts.

The HMRC figures are the first time revenue from Scottish taxpayers has been calculated since the new devolved powers over income tax began in 2017.

Under a new risk-sharing mechanism, the Scottish government will get an extra £737m to make up for the shortfall.

But it will have to manage a £204m reduction in expected funds next year.

Scotland's Finance Secretary Derek Mackay said he was creating a more progressive tax system.

He said stronger growth for Scotland could have a positive impact on this risk-sharing "reconciliation" in future years.

In April 2017, the Scottish government started using new powers

to set the rates and bands for income tax in Scotland.

This meant it would be partly funded through devolved taxes and borrowing.

A new system was devised that would amend the longstanding Barnett Formula for calculating the block grant to reduce it by the money raised from devolved taxes. However, there was a "reconciliation" which would limit the amount of funding Scotland could lose as a result of the new system.

Leading Scottish economy journalist Douglas Fraser said that because the system was brand new the forecasts for income tax revenue were derived from a "best guess".

He said: "Because tax has not been handled this way before, and because there hasn't been this differential within the UK, quite a lot of it is informed guesswork. And small assumptions

can make a big difference when the total adds up to more than £11bn."

Scotland's finance secretary said Scottish income tax revenue increased by £197m between 2016/17 and 2017/18 to £10.9bn.

Real Life Getting Too Scary For You?

I'VE BEEN engrossed watching the new TV series "Years and Years", a dystopian drama on HBO set in the not-too-distant future which stars Emma Thompson as a UK politician rising up the ranks.

It features a world where Trump has been re-elected and now refuses to leave office and has launched a nuclear missile on China. A place where people actually wear emojis on the heads

and have checked out of society altogether.

Created by Russell T. Davies (the man responsible for Queer As Folk and rebooting Dr. Who), Years and Years is hugely uncomfortable to watch, yet it's truly fascinating that maybe, just maybe this look into the bleak future might help us rectify and put a stop to what could be possible.

Last weekend I attend my first LARP (Live Action Role Play)

event "Twin-Mask" - not as a participant but as an observer, and boy, if you need to shake off the s**t happening in the world and simply check out, this might be the place for you. The website's blurb gives you just a hint of what this immersive experience has to offer, saying: "Welcome to Twin Mask....where sorcery is feared and creatures of myth have faded into seclusion. Here, in the heart of "Tear" - a recently discovered continent, characters from all backgrounds will be called back from death and be forced to band together in order to survive and make sense of the world around them."

I mean, how could I say no to that? What I found was a world where wizards and warlocks mix with Vikings and Jedi knights. Damsels in distress, pirates, half-wolves and centaurs, witches and wenches all mix in. Fighting by day (think freeze spells met with soft giant battle axes) and poems and singing by night. And I'm sure in the nearby camping area some drinking and frolicking were taking place.

Some people like video games, but this is a place where people of different shapes and sizes, colors and gender all come together to interact in a human (sort of) world, not a virtual one. Meet A Member: Oliver Boon

Meet Oliver Boon from Marlow, Buckinghamshire who moved to LA 2 years ago to pursue acting...

Was there a particular reason you chose LA? Honestly, I never really saw America in my future. I had been auditioning for drama schools in the UK with mixed results (mixed meaning zero offers) and so the following year I applied for The American Academy of Dramatic Arts and Stella Adler and got both! I chose AADA and have since graduated from their two-year program. This sounds ridiculous but it didn't dawn on me until my first month that I had really moved to LA. I recently enrolled into AADA's Company program where we put on shows all year and at the end of the year we put on a showcase for agents.

What do you miss most from back home?

Pub crawls aren't the same really out here. Waking up to the football results (MCFC for life) is something I've sadly gotten used to. If I'm busy in the week I never get up early enough to watch the games and that was father-son tradition back home.

What was your first impression of LA and

has it changed since? My first impression of LA was noisy, dirty and lots of helicopters. NOW I couldn't imagine being anywhere else! There is so much to do in this city and because it's so expansive, (besides Hollywood Blvd) you feel a sense of freedom that is lacking in other big cities where it can get real claustrophobic. LA is a closed party that you need to know the guy on the door to be let in. It's all about making connections and seeing where they take you.

What do you find the biggest difference is living here versus Marlow? Not constantly bumping into people is probably the biggest. Marlow is a very small town that is famous in the past for being a little getaway from London city life. Mary Shelley wrote Frankenstein just down the road from me!

Another difference is the fact that without a car, America (besides New York, I'll give them that...) in general can be quite limiting. Back home in Marlow, everything is walking distance. Then again if you want to get to London, you have to take a train (aptly named the Marlow Donkey) to get to Maidenhead, then to Paddington. Compared

to LA, this feels painfully slow to travel so near. Public transport is okay in LA. I take the metro from Hollywood and you can get to Noho or Downtown in decent time for \$1.75. The problem is there are so many areas of LA without a station that your only bet is to get an Uber or the Bird/Lime scooters though you'll need a passport or US driver's license on you to use the scooter (who carries a passport around with them?)

Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?

Since last September I have started indoor rock climbing at Hollywood Boulders and it has become a major part of my routine. Climbing is such a great source of exercise for your whole body with far less risk than other sports and Hollywood Boulders is a really social and friendly place to go, great music too!

What would you suggest to others who are thinking about making the move here?

It can take some time before you settle in but it's worth it. There's a very different energy to this city. There's a more laid back, positive approach (all down to the weather I bet) that can feel fake

but it's just different to the overly critical nature of being British!

My dad told me when I was struggling in high school, that the things about ourselves that people find weird, will in the future be the

things that make us sought after. My advice acting is wise, which I picked up from the late, great Phillip Seymour Hoffman. "Never go into an audition wanting the role. You are there to solve their casting problem".

Lastly, how can we find out more about you?

Are you working on anything at the moment? As well as acting I am an independent sound

mixer. I've slowly been building up my own set of equipment and it's become a huge passion for me. I am part of a production company (Boon Box Productions) and will be filming our first short later this year. he demonstrated the composed head that has helped him become a five-time world champion.

And in securing an unprecedented sixth British Grand Prix win, he surpassed two icons of Formula One in Jim Clark and Alain Prost.

Hamilton showed his many talents to win this thrilling encounter and avoided trouble while his rivals wiped each other

out. In the early stages, the Brit was involved in an enthralling cat-and-mouse tussle with Mercedes team-mate Valtteri Bottas, who started on pole. On lap four, the pair went wheel-to-wheel through Brooklands, Luffield and Copse, with Hamilton taking the lead only for Bottas to regain the place. The Finn held on until the race-defining incident on lap 21 when the safety car was deployed after Antonio Giovinazzi's Alfa Romeo got beached in the gravel. Bottas had already made his pit stop but Hamilton had yet to make his – and he pounced on the chance to do so as the field trundled behind the safety car. Hamilton returned to the action ahead of Bottas and then cruised to a victory that secured him yet more history. Bottas was second to seal a seventh Mercedes one-two of the season with Charles Leclerc completing the podium. The win, his

seventh from 10 races, takes Hamilton closer to a sixth title and he is now 39 points clear of Bottas in the standings.

"It definitely hasn't sunk in," said Hamilton. "I still remember my first win here, my first pole here. Every year it's such a challenge.

"To be amongst the greats that have shone on this circuit and here in the UK... I'm so incredibly proud to be a part of it."

Leclerc was arguably the other star of the show after a wheel-to-wheel battle with his fellow rising star Jos Verstappen. The pair, both 21, arrived at Silverstone on the back of their controversial incident in Austria, in which Verstappen won after a debatable late-race manoeuvre on Leclerc. And they gave fans another thrilling display of close quarters racing. They battled several times but Leclerc lost out following the safety car when Ferrari bizarrely opted to pit him

for a second time and he dropped down to sixth. He managed to take the final podium spot after Vettel hit Verstappen with 15 laps to go. Verstappen passed round the outside of the Ferrari at Stowe but slammed on the brakes as he approached the following corner and Vettel rear-ended the Dutchman's Red Bull. Verstappen was sent sideways across the gravel, with sparks flying underneath his car, but managed to rejoin the track in fifth. A red-faced Vettel was forced to pit for repairs, dropping way down the field. Verstappen kept hold of fifth but Vettel was hit with a 10-second penalty for causing the collision and finished 16th.

Despite that dramatic coming-together, it is Hamilton who rightly steals the limelight. The 34-year-old is one of the true greats of modern-era sport and his record-breaking achievements Sunday prove that.

Stay and make us great, Lamps urges coveted young star

FRANK LAMPARD has challenged Callum Hudson-Odoi to sign up and join his young Chelsea revolution.

The England winger is expected to be the target of a new £45million bid from Bayern Munich this week. He is currently recovering from a ruptured Achilles tendon and has still not signed a new contract at Stamford Bridge, although talks are ongoing. Chelsea this week secured Mason Mount, 20, on a new five-year deal, a few days after Ruben Loftus-Cheek also put pen to paper on a five-year contract.

Lampard whose squad are in Japan on a pre-season tour, also revealed that more of his young guns are set to sign deals in the coming weeks as he reshapes his squad – and he wants Hudson-Odoi to be among them. Lampard, whose side face Kawasaki Frontale on Friday, said:

"When I first got here I said that Callum is a player who has come through the academy and can be a big player for Chelsea and England.

"We as a club, as a whole, want him to stay, for sure. He knows that he has a manager here who will want to work with him to improve.

"That will take hard work. Nothing is given – especially when you are 18 years of age.

"But with all the attributes Callum has, we want him to come through and be a big player for us now and in the future. There are a few younger players now, some have signed, some will sign in the next month or so or in the early part of the season.

"It is important we move forward on that and I know as a club we are doing our best to from top to bottom.

"Mason's signing is

great, because of the two impressive loans he has had. He is part of the first-team squad.

"Ruben has just signed long-term, which is great, and I want Callum to sign and stay here."

Lampard is confident that N'Golo Kante will recover from his hamstring injury in time for the start of the new season. The France midfielder travelled to Tokyo and is expected to return to full training in the next few days. Lampard said: "N'Golo will hopefully integrate into proper training with the rest of the team. I don't envisage him being too long.

"Hopefully he will take part in one or two of the games while we are here. I am confident he will be ready, but I hate making predictions. The amount of games he's played in the last few seasons it is important to be cautious."

I can't spoon feed you, Ole tells United stars

OLE GUNNAR SOLSKJAER has told his Manchester United stars he will not spoon-feed them as he plots the club's route back to the top.

The United manager has warned young players such as Jesse Lingard, Anthony Martial and Marcus Rashford they must find it within themselves to help restore the club to greatness. All three, like so many others, fell short of expectations last season, with Lingard's summer antics also causing dismay. Lingard posted a lewd holiday video on social media, and Solskjaer said he has been spoken to about the episode. Solskjaer wants his players to grow up and show the mental toughness and character to haul United back to the top.

He said: "I can't spoon-feed all these players, they've got to do it

themselves. I'm old school, quite big on discipline, quite big on self-discipline. "I've had many years at this club and seen which players have been successful.

"You've got to be a strong character to play here. It's not like I can tell a player to pass from A to B to C to D. They have to make their own decisions – in life as well.

"It's a general society

thing as well. There are fewer Robbos [Bryan Robson] and Keanos [Roy Keane] around. We're all too comfortable. Life is so comfortable.

"It's easy now when you're an academy player because you make so much money and think 'I've made it'. "I played with Keano and any manager would say, 'I'd love to have that type of leader'.

"If you look at Manchester City, with Vincent Kompany having gone, who knows what will happen? He was a fantastic leader, so someone else has to step up – and someone has to step up for us."

United took only eight points from 27 at the end of last season to miss out on the top four. Solskjaer said: "It was disappointing, the last month. You expected them to come back with a bit of grit, but only sure we are more consistent."

Celtic ease into Champions League second qualifying round

Celtic will face Estonian side Nomme Kalju in the Champions League second qualifying round after an ultimately straightforward win over FK Sarajevo on Thursday.

Leading 3-1 from last week's first leg in Bosnia, the Scottish champions had an early scare when Mersudin Ahmetovic had an effort ruled out for offside.

However, Celtic went ahead through Ryan Christie's smart finish and, although Benjamin Tatar equalised, Callum McGregor's fine finish from distance restored the three-goal cushion and secured a 5-2 aggregate victory.

Celtic will host the first leg next Wednesday against Nomme Kalju, who surprised Macedonian champions Shkendija to progress on away goals.

Celtic's progression was never seriously in doubt, although that early offside effort initially gave home supporters something to ponder.

Sarajevo were always unlikely to overcome the 3-1 first-leg deficit and so it proved. This contest seemed a question of whether Celtic could find a route to break down a well organised side and, in the meantime, build more fitness and confidence.

Midway through the first half, though, manager Neil Lennon appeared to show a little frustration at what he was seeing. There was a lack of tempo and threat.

They suddenly clicked and, after a period of quality possession in which they stretched the visitors, the opener arrived. It was Odsonne Edouard's determination to surge into the box, followed by Christie's fine finish, that quashed any hope of a shock.

That appeared to settle Celtic and chances began to flow, with the visitors unable to break out.

However, as in the first leg, there are lessons to be learned at this early

stage of the season. In Bosnia, Lennon's men cheaply conceded, then defended a set-piece poorly to allow Sarajevo the opener. This time,

it was real sloppiness from recent recruit Boli Bolingoli that allowed Sarajevo to equalize.

It is something that Celtic can ill afford as

they progress through this qualifying process. The opposition will get better and the consequences potentially harsher.

said: "He has carried our batting line-up today. To bat the way he did with our lower order was incredible.

New Zealand were left to curse their luck and the cruellest margin to decide a World Cup final in any major sport. Skipper Kane Williamson said: "The emotions are raw and it's pretty hard to swallow. We don't know how they won it. Someone had to walk away with the title and we are gutted it wasn't us.

"I never thought I would be answering a question about boundary countback.

Trippier completes Atleti move

England right-back Kieran Trippier has completed a £20m move to Spanish side Atletico Madrid from Tottenham.

The 28-year-old, (right), who joined Spurs from Burnley in June 2015 and played more than 100 times for the London club, has signed a three-year deal with the La Liga side. He had admitted he was not sure he would see out his Spurs contract, which was due to expire in 2022.

Trippier is Atletico's third major defensive signing of the summer.

Coach Diego Simeone has already recruited centre-back Felipe from Porto and left-back Renan Lodi from Brazilian side Athletico Paranaense, while Uruguay defender Diego Godin has moved to Inter Milan.

With Portugal striker Joao Felix brought in for £113m and midfielder Marcos Llorente arriving from city rivals Real for about £36m, Trippier's arrival brings Atletico's total transfer spend so far this summer to more than £170m.

The La Liga runners-up did, however, receive

£107.7m from the sale of France striker Antoine Griezmann to champions Barcelona.

Trippier, whose last appearance for Tottenham was in the 2-0 Champions League final

defeat by Liverpool in June, did not travel with the Spurs squad for their pre-season tour of Asia.

Emery urges Gunners to make 'big, expensive' signings

UNAI EMERY has urged Arsenal to make "big, expensive" signings and wants to bring in four new faces this summer.

The Gunners boss is looking to shake up his squad despite Arsenal director Josh Kroenke warning the club will struggle to bring in top signings. Arsenal have already targeted Wilfried Zaha

but, with Crystal Palace demanding £80million, the potential move looks unlikely. They have bid £25m for Celtic defender Kieran Tierney, Emery has admitted publicly he rates Dani Ceballos, who is available on loan from Real Madrid, and they also want an experienced centre-half. So far their only signing is Brazilian teenager Gabriel Martinelli but

Emery insisted: "I can say to our supporters we are going to make a very good team with the players there now and three or four players who can help us in a few days.

"Our target is to get three or four players who can really improve our squad now. We are being very, very demanding and first speaking about the possibility to sign

very expensive players." Meanwhile, Laurent Koscielny can still kiss and make up with the club, according to Nacho Monreal.

Gunners captain Koscielny, 33, has gone on strike and refused to take part in their pre-season tour of the United States following a bitter fallout over a new contract. Monreal is the first Arsenal player

to talk publicly about the row and says he hopes the stand-off can be resolved.

Fellow defender Monreal, 33, said: "We respect Laurent a lot because he's played for Arsenal for a long time, he's our captain.

"What I'd like is that they fix the problem, and I think they will do it. It's something between him and the club."

England beat the world!

ENGLAND'S cricketers wrote their names in the sport's history books on Sunday with a thrilling, dramatic and nail-biting victory to clinch the Cricket World Cup.

In the most dramatic finish in the one-day format's history, England ended 44 years of hurt on a countback of the most boundaries scored, 26-17, after they tied with New Zealand at Lord's. Both teams had made 241 in their allocated 50 overs – and still could not be separated by an extra Super Over, with both teams notching 15 runs. In a hear-stopping finale, the Black Caps' Martin Guptill needed two runs to win off the final ball but failed to beat Jason Roy's throw from the deep. With millions tuning in on Channel 4 – after 14 years without live international cricket on terrestrial TV in Britain – Eoin Morgan's men clinched the trophy and ensured their immortality in the English game.

Morgan seized on the significance of the heart-stopping drama. He said: "To me and the team, and everyone involved in the last four years, this means

absolutely everything. I certainly hope participation levels will go up. The nature of the game was outstanding.

"On a Sunday evening people are usually settling in to watch a bit of David Attenborough or a good film. I hope they were tuning into the cricket.

"People believed because we believed. But sport can be about the finest of margins and the finest of margins went

our way."

Morgan will now be bracketed with Bobby Moore and Martin Johnson in the pantheon of England World Cup-winning captains. He is the only man to be part of this and the World Twenty20 triumph in the Caribbean nine years ago. But he said: "I'm not sure this has changed my life and I hope it doesn't change that much.

"I live quite a quiet one, but I would love it to change for everyone else who wants their life to change."

Ben Stokes was in tears after saving England over the original 50 overs, when his unbeaten 84 included outrageous luck. Stokes holed out in the deep, only for Trent Boult to tread on the rope. Then Stokes, struggling to beat Jimmy Neesham's throw from the deep, inadvertently deflected it for four overthrows as he dived to make his ground. With 15 required off the last over, Stokes hauled England level and Morgan hailed his contribution as "superhuman".
