50 years later, world flocks to Abbey Road

■ Iconic North London crossing mobbed by Beatles Fans on anniversary of classic album

Hundreds of Beatles fans mobbed Abbey Road on Thursday to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the eponymous album.

Tourists, some of whom travelled thousands of miles to pose for pictures on the zebra crossing that features on the Abbey Road LP cover, were greeted by car horns from frustrated drivers as traffic backed up in St John's Wood, northwest London.

Police community support officers struggled to stop fans from walking over the crossing. Joe Kane, a Paul McCartney impersonator who performs in Them Beatles, a tribute band, seized the moment to propose to his girlfriend — oblivious to the No 139 bus to Waterloo stuck behind them.

The photographer Iain Macmillan took six pictures for the cover of Abbey Road, which was the last album the Fab Four recorded as a band. The fifth was chosen.

A re-release of the album, which came out

in September 1969, is in the pipeline.

The anniversary stunt was arranged by Richard Porter, a London tour guide, who said: "Every hour of every day there are fans on the crossing. I've seen lots of different sights on the crossing too — from couples having their wedding photos taken, to people going across naked."

'feel the history'

Fans chose their own poses — some walked across in the style of album, while one man performed star push-ups and other fans posed for pictures while dressed as band members.

Sean Thompson, 33, and his girlfriend Jackie Halcrow, 34, musicians from Atlanta, Georgia said they had come to "pay their respects" to the band.

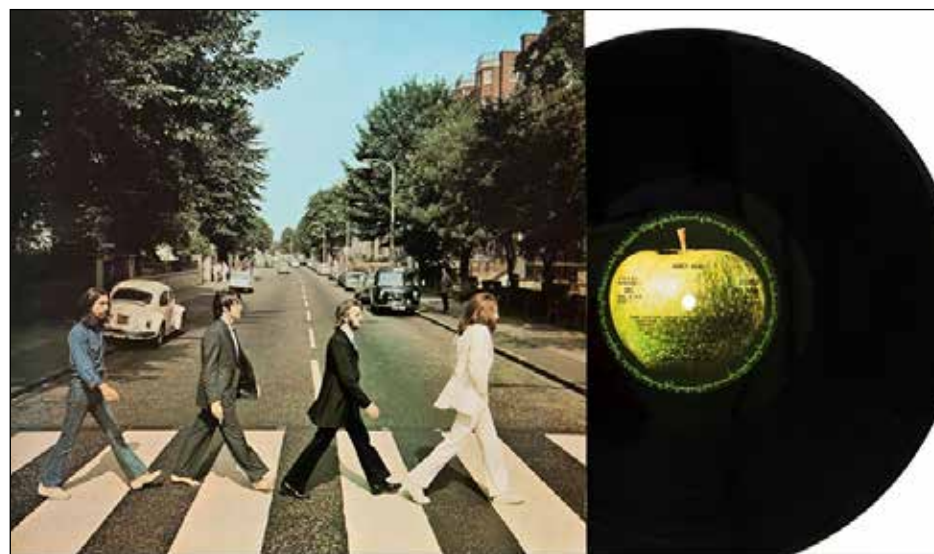
"It's such an important thing to see," she said. "We can feel the history here. It's wonderful."

Jaime Garri, 61, said he paid £6,000 for business class tickets for him and his wife to travel from Santiago, Chile so he could attend the anniversary.

"The Beatles give me joy and happy moments," he said. "They are the best band that has ever existed, and maybe ever will."

He travelled to Liverpool in 2012 for the 50th anniversary of Love Me Do and in January this year to commemorate the rooftop gig in Savile Row, London, the band's final live performance. Mr Garri, who owns a first edition of every album and whose favourite song is Dear Prudence, said despite his best efforts he was unable to convince his wife to come to St John's Wood with him.

"My wife isn't interested in this crazy thing," he said. "She is shopping in Harrods."

Controversial and late, Tintagel footbridge in Cornwall to open

■ After 650 years – and four months – visitors can follow in Uther Pendragon's footsteps

A £5m footbridge to a dramatic, wind-battered headland that is at the heart of Arthurian legend will this weekend finally open to the public.

The bridge, one of the most ambitious, complicated and at times controversial heritage projects seen in the UK in recent years, will, says English Heritage, restore the lost crossing of Tintagel Castle in north Cornwall.

In practical terms it means visitors will no longer have to climb 148 narrow, steep and often frustratingly busy steps to get round the popular tourist site. Instead they will cross a 68-metre bridge over a spectacular rocky chasm which separates two halves of the remains of the 13th-century castle.

The bridge's unusual walking surface consists of 40,000 locally sourced slate tiles, stacked vertically in stainless steel trays. At the centre is a 4cm gap, which will increase in the cold and decrease in the heat but

is, the designers say, entirely safe.

"For it to almost close it would have to be 50C for two weeks," said the bridge's co-designer William Matthews. "We have designed for extreme temperatures."

He said people would make whatever they want of the gap. It could be a poetic symbol of stepping from the past to the present, reality to legend, or it could just be the engineering reality of a cantilever bridge. "It's fun and what is wrong with that?"

Tintagel – in Cornish Din Tagell, meaning "the fortress of the narrow entrance" – is steeped in myth and legend.

The most evocative is the story of a lust-crazed Uther Pendragon using the crossing to spend the night with Ygern, during which they conceived Arthur. Ygern thought Uther was her husband, the Duke of Cornwall, but it was a trick – Uther had been transformed by the wizard Merlin.

That castle may never have existed, but the

stories so captured the imagination of Richard, a French-speaking 13th-century Duke of Cornwall, that he built a castle at Tintagel, begun in the 1230s, with the footbridge integral to its design.

The castle probably fell into disrepair by the 1330s and the crossing gradually eroded.

The present-day site attracts 250,000 visitors a year, but the steps were a nightmare for many. It could take 45 minutes to get from one side to the other and be "really frustrating and completely destroy any of the magical feeling of being there", said Nichola Tasker, English Heritage's head of national projects. "You are just suddenly annoyed by it."

The bridge is due to open to the public on Sunday, delayed from Friday because of anticipated severe weather.

It has been welcomed by many and criticised by others. Some have accused English Heritage of the "Disneyfication" of

the site. As evidence they point to the bridge and two artworks – a carving of Merlin's head in the cove and an Arthurian sculpture titled Gallos on the headland.

It is a charge that curators bristle at. "Why it grates for me is because Disney is essentially about making money," said Georgia Butters, head of historic properties in Cornwall. "What we are trying to do is get people to care about our heritage. We want people to

really engage with their heritage, because if you don't care and you don't engage, who is going to look after this in another 100 years' time? That's why it irritates me."

The bridge is also late. The castle closed in October and was meant to reopen in the spring. Butters admits they would not have chosen to open in the middle of the summer season.

The lateness is down to how complicated the scheme has been. There is no vehicular access,

which meant helicopters had to bring in hundreds of tonnes of materials. Cable cranes normally used in the Swiss Alps were employed to move sections of bridge into place.

The bridge and a wider landscaping project have been made possible by the biggest private donation English Heritage has ever received: £2.5m from Julia and Hans Rausing, the family behind the Tetrapak global packaging empire.

Corbyn will tell Queen 'we're taking over' if Boris Johnson loses power over no-deal Brexit

Jeremy Corbyn will go to Buckingham Palace in a taxi to tell the Queen "we're taking over" if Boris Johnson loses a vote of no confidence, John McDonnell has said.

The shadow chancellor said Labour was preparing to bring down Mr Johnson's government next month and form a "caretaker government" with cross-party support whose mission would be to block a no-deal Brexit.

Several news sources in the UK revealed this week that Mr Johnson might refuse to resign if he lost a confidence vote and instead wait two weeks for a general election to be triggered. Mr McDonnell has criticised Dominic Cummings, the prime minister's most senior

aide, who raised the idea in Downing Street.

He said: "No prime minister can sustain themselves in office when they no longer have a majority in the Commons. I don't want to drag the Queen into this, but I would be sending Jeremy Corbyn in a cab to Buckingham Palace to say 'we're taking over' to the Queen."

Under the Fixed-term Parliaments Act there would be a 14-day period during which MPs could try to form a government before a general election was triggered. On Tuesday Labour and the Scottish National Party appeared to be moving towards a pact under which they would oust Mr Johnson. This week at the Edinburgh Fringe

festival, Mr McDonnell raised the prospect of a coalition far sooner, saying he believed Labour could take over within days if Mr Johnson lost a confidence vote.

Mr McDonnell also joked about creating laws to imprison Conservative MPs. Asked about previous comments that Tories were "social criminals and one day we will try them," Mr McDonnell said: "I was angry. It was after the first round of benefit cuts." Asked what law he would use, he said: "I might want to invent it."

Paul Scully, the Conservative vice-chairman, said: "It comes as little surprise that McDonnell wants to invent laws to silence opponents."



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Growth of Albanian gangs sparks concern

■ Criminals using Facebook to counter immigration raids and smuggle immigrants

Albanian criminals are using Facebook to counter immigration raids, smuggle illegal immigrants into Britain, set up fake marriages and scam English language citizenship tests.

Facebook has failed to take any action against the site, called Albanians in London, which has 123,000 followers, and where the criminal schemes are publicly posted.

Its page has been run by convicted Albanian bank robber Fari Lleshi who illegally entered the UK after completing a six-year jail term for a £20,000 heist in Italy. He was deported in March after being convicted of drug dealing in Britain.

The site provides alerts to other illegal Albanian immigrants that warn them of Border Force raids by posting pictures of officials and their vans on the sweeps and pinpointing the locations to avoid.

illegal immigrants

One warning posted on July 20 said: "Hello Albanian, I have an appeal to all of you who are without legal papers in the UK. Be Careful at Turnpike Lane Station, it is full of police."

The page also acts as a hub where Albanians can contact people smugglers who charge up to £1,500 per person to bring illegal immigrants into the UK

through Ireland, the favoured cheapest and easiest entry route.

"If you know any safe way how to get to England without any dangers, please advise," asked one post, to which the reply was to offer to smuggle them to the UK from Ireland for £1,500.

For £1,200, Albanians can also recruit English-speaking compatriots through the Facebook site to sit either English language citizenship tests or theory exams in driving tests to secure a licence.

Facebook said it would have taken down the page if its administrators had not already "unpublished" it as any ads, posts or pages that encouraged people smuggling were banned from the platform.

The Home Office said: "We will not tolerate any abuse of the immigration system and are clear that anyone found to be deliberately disrupting enforcement should feel the full force of the law."

"Social media companies have a responsibility to prevent illegal activity on their platforms. Our Online Harms White Paper proposes a duty on companies to tackle illegal activity on their platforms, including organised immigration crime."

There are twice as many Albanians who

illegally enter the UK through UK ports as any other nationality, according to the Home Office, while the National Crime Agency (NCA) says Albanian gangs have muscled in on the drug trafficking market, particularly cocaine.

"The threat faced from Albanian crime groups is significant. London is their primary hub but they are established across the UK," said an NCA spokesman.

The "Albanians in London" Facebook site has grown in popularity despite its mastermind Lleshi being deported after being jailed for drug dealing in the UK. He can be seen posing on YouTube promoting his rap music while wielding two handguns.

In the course of five months, we uncovered a succession of posts, often with pictures of Border Force vans, tipping off illegal immigrants. "Albania, I just passed by Lewisham. Emigration at the station be careful. God save you, share it as soon as possible in an anonymous way," said one on March 28.

One replied: "God save all. Albanian, thanx for informing us. F*** Home Office."

'key threats to the UK'

One on July 18 said: "Hello Albanian. I have an appeal to all of you who are without legal papers in the UK. Be careful at Turnpike Lane Station it is full of police."

The following day, another warned: "Hello Albanian. At Leyton station a lot of controls by 'blacks' [slang for immigration officers] they are from Metropolitan police."

Another, at the height of summer on a sunny Sunday in June, said: "All Albanians without documentation should

be careful at Waterloo Station. There is the Home Office doing searches."

Ireland is a cheaper and easier route into the UK for illegal immigrants as tighter cross-Channel controls have pushed up the price to 14,000 Euros to reach the UK from the continent.

The post seeking safe passage to Britain reads: "Hello Albanian in London. I have two friends who have arrived in Dublin and claimed asylum. They let them go. They are free now but do not have any papers. If you know any safe way how to get to England without any dangers, please advise."

One reply quoted £1,500

per person, with a phone number. Another said: "Paying £1300 a friend

did get to England four days ago. I can give you the number of that person who can do it in Ireland. He did bring in 4 friends."

English language and driving theory tests are scammed by creating a fake identity document in the name of the Albanian who wants to pass but the picture of the person who will take the test.

One post reads: "I have my cousin but he cannot speak well English. Can anyone help to get life in the UK test? We pay good money."

Another asks: "Hello brother. Do you know anyone to pass theory

driving test?" A reply under an name "Leon Ryan" indicated they could for £1,200.

Another requests a marriage certificate, issued in Tirana, to be used to secure a visa into the UK. "Hello Albanian in London. Hope you are well. I am interested to find someone who issues in Tirana marriage certificate for outside Albania that by paying can do it. If you know anyone please help me."

It is understood the NCA has deployed six officers to Albania. A spokesman said: "We work closely with Albanian authorities and others in the region to combat key threats to the UK."

Redknapp ran red light during divorce 'trauma'

LOUISE Redknapp ran a red light because of the 'personal trauma of her divorce', her lawyers claimed this week.

The former TV star admitted the offence in south west London, in her Land Rover in November of last year.

Rebecca Penfold,

for Redknapp, told Lavender Hill magistrates court that the singer was going through the 'trauma' of her ex-husband Jamie and had paparazzi following her daily.

Reknapp, who was not in court, was fined £666 plus £151 court costs.

Premier League's Saudi fury over flagrant piracy of football feed

The world's biggest football authorities, including those who run the Premier League, World Cup and Champions League, have called on Saudi Arabia to take action to stop a sophisticated, homegrown pirate TV and streaming service that is illegally broadcasting matches internationally.

The strongly worded letter from the exasperated sports bodies – including Fifa, Uefa, Germany's Bundesliga, Spain's La Liga and Italy's Serie A as well as the Asian Football Confederation – comes after almost 18 months fruitlessly attempting to mount a legal challenge in Saudi Arabia to block the service, called beoutQ.

"We collectively condemn in the strongest possible terms the ongoing theft of our intellectual property by the pirate broadcaster known as beoutQ and call on the authorities in Saudi Arabia to support us in ending the widespread and flagrant breaches of our intellectual property rights," the authorities said in a joint statement.

The sporting bodies have said that nine legal firms in Saudi Arabia have failed to take on their copyright theft case and that they are now being forced to seek other means to shut down the broadcaster.

"We have reached the conclusion, regrettably, that it is now not possible to retain legal counsel in the kingdom of Saudi Arabia which is willing or able to act on our behalf," the statement continued. "We see no alternative but to pursue beoutQ and a solution to

this very serious problem of piracy by other means. We request that the Saudi ministry of culture and the Saudi government take swift and decisive action against beoutQ."

The illegal service had a surge in popularity after making global headlines for pirate broadcasting the entire 2018 World Cup. Earlier this month the All England Lawn Tennis Club condemned beoutQ for illegally streaming Wimbledon worldwide for a second year running. The BBC and Sky have also previously spoken out about the issue of piracy of their programming.

The beoutQ service is transmitted internationally on 10 channels by the Saudi-headquartered satellite firm Arabsat, which counts the Saudi state as its largest shareholder, and also offers streaming.

The pirate service was launched in 2017 when Saudi Arabia mounted an economic boycott of Qatar. Initially pirating the feed of Qatar's beIN Media Group, the owner of beIN Sports and the film studio Miramax, and taking the name beoutQ, it was seen as proof that Saudi Arabia was directly targeting its neighbour.

In February, beIN Media, which has 55 million pay-TV customers worldwide, decided against renewing its five-year contract with Formula One saying that the impact of the piracy meant it had to look hard at which TV rights it could afford. It has spent billions on rights content including the Premier League, Champions League, World Cup, NBA and NFL.

Royal Mint makes no 1p or 2p coins for first time in decades

The Royal Mint produced no 1p or 2p coins last year.

For the first time since 1972, no 1p coins were struck for circulation in 2018-19 – and for the first time since 1984, no 2p coins were produced.

The Royal Mint produces coins, which can last decades, in response to requests from the Treasury to meet the needs of the economy.

The Treasury also said no £2 coins were produced last year, as there were already enough in circulation: about 494m.

The future of copper coins had been debated in a consultation covering the mix of cash in circulation. In 2018, at the time of the chancellor's spring statement in March, the Treasury launched a review of cash and digital payments. It said it did not make economic sense to produce coins used infrequently.

The Treasury noted that

about 60% of copper coins were used typically for just one transaction before people stashed them away.

A day after the review was announced, Downing Street said it had no plans to axe 1p and 2p coins after a brief but determined media campaign and concerns raised by charities.

In May the government

emphasised that there would be no changes to the mix of coins and notes; all the denominations, from the penny to the £50 note, would stay in circulation.

Cash use has fallen sharply in recent years as the use of contactless payment has surged. The reduced demand for coins means banks may not need to order

as many new ones as they did previously. But many people still rely on cash for their day-to-day spending.

About 2.2 million people in the UK are estimated to be almost entirely reliant on cash on a daily basis. Elderly and vulnerable people and those in rural communities are likely to be hardest hit by any decline in cash availability.

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Conman Mark Acklom pleads guilty to £300,000 fraud

■ Shameless grifter told besotted girlfriend he worked for MI6

A conman who posed as a Swiss banker and an MI6 spy to defraud his lover of her life savings has been jailed after leaving her penniless and suicidal.

Mark Acklom, 46, was sentenced to five years and eight months on Thursday for taking more than £300,000 from Carolyn Woods, 62, who told Bristol crown court that he “destroyed my life”.

Acklom had been due to stand trial this week for taking more than £750,000 from Ms Woods but changed his plea to guilty at the last minute after admitting to taking a smaller sum.

For several years he went on the run but was traced to a luxury villa near Zurich last year and tried to jump from a balcony to avoid the police.

Ms Woods told the court that she had been driven to the brink of suicide after discovering that her lover had run off with her life savings. “My life, as I knew it, has been destroyed, and it has only been the love of my two daughters that has prevented me from ending it completely,” she said. “They, too, have been deeply affected by what has happened to me. I have felt condemned to a life that I don’t want and

I grieve for the life I once had.”

She said that on January 19, 2012 a suave gentleman using the name Mark Conway entered the boutique in Tetbury, Gloucestershire where she worked. She said that he had been looking for a jacket but had left with her phone number.

Ms Woods was charmed by the younger man, who drove sports cars and appeared to be wealthy. Within a month she had proposed to him, bought a £6,000 wedding dress and moved into a Georgian mansion in Bath that she believed he owned.

However, she was unaware that Acklom was married with two children and was paying the £9,500 a month rent with the increasingly large amounts of money she was lending him.

By July she had given him more than £300,000 that he said was needed to help renovate a property. At first he had told her that he was a Swiss banker visiting Britain to buy an airfield. Then told her he was an MI6 agent and explained his long absences by saying he was in Syria on missions.

By the time he vanished at the end of 2012 she claimed he had received her life savings of more

than £750,000.

During their courtship they did not have sex but he treated her to trips to Harrods and haircuts at the salon of Nicky Clarke, who he claimed was a friend. He also told her that he was friends with Chris Evans, the Virgin Radio host, and that he knew Hillary Clinton and Karl Lagerfeld.

Acklom claimed that the relationship was genuine at the outset and that he did not target her for her money. He said that after she began helping him with cashflow problems he willingly took her money and behaved in a “cold and callous way”.

Gudrun Young, his barrister, said that Acklom did not accept all of the prosecution case and insisted he had worked for MI6 and was friends with Clarke.

Ms Woods reported Acklom to the police in 2013, after he had cut all ties with her, but a series of blunders allowed him to slip through the net and the trail went cold.

In July 2015 she told the police that he was in custody in Spain over a £200,000 property fraud. They issued a European arrest warrant 11 months later — three months after he was released from a Spanish prison and

Coal ban could be end of the line for steam trains, enthusiasts warn

GOVERNMENT plans to crack down on coal could put the steam train industry out of business, heritage railway operators have warned.

As the country moves towards a carbon-neutral future, officials plan to shut down UK coal

production by 2025. Industry groups say a drop in the demand for coal could see supply drop in the same way, which has raised fears that prices will rise.

Ian Crowder, from the Gloucestershire and Warwickshire Steam

Railway, told the BBC that heritage railways were ‘an important tourist attraction for the UK’ that bring in millions of visitors.

He added: “The amount of coal used by steam trains is negligible.”

vanished.

In May 2017 he was spotted in Geneva and he was arrested in July 2018 during a raid in a town near Zurich where he had been living under a false name with his Spanish wife and two children. He was extradited to the UK in February.

In a victim impact statement Ms Woods said: “Mark Acklom acted deliberately and in the most calculated, pre-meditated way, to defraud me of all my money and nearly all my personal possessions, and to deprive me of my home and my job, thereby rendering me totally

helpless and at his mercy.

“He also deliberately isolated me from my family and friends, and played psychological games to deceive me and engender a sense of fear in me. It was an act of the utmost cruelty, designed to destroy my life for his personal gain.”

“In an attempt to keep going and keep paying the bills I used up all my savings and cashed in my pension. I have borrowed money from friends and am left in debt and have been hounded by utility companies and debt collection agencies,” she said.

“I have suffered sexual

and emotional violation that has resulted in a loss of pride and self-worth . . . emotional and psychological wounds are not obvious in the way that physical wounds are . . . but if the assault I suffered had been physical I would look as though I had been beaten to a pulp.

Judge Martin Picton told him: “You took advantage of Carolyn Woods in a cruel and cynical manner. You were quite prepared to spin her any number of lies to get her money and having done so you dropped her like a stone. The money you did get from her slipped through your fingers like water.”

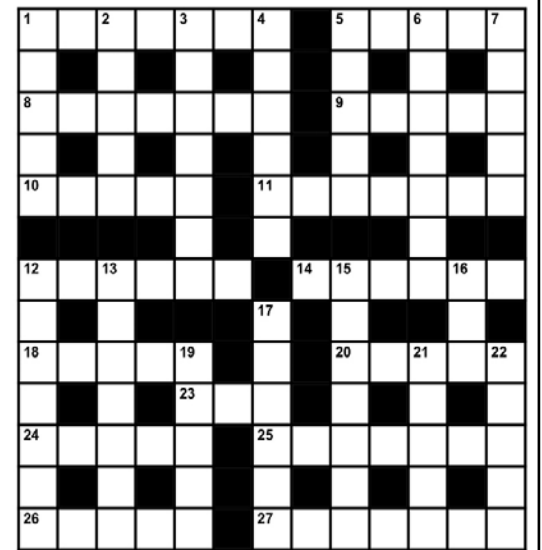

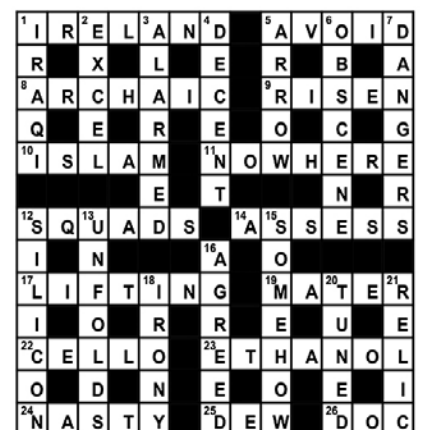

Gun Violence: how much good can 'saying something' really do?

If you see something, say something?

This mantra has been drummed in to us for several years now, to the point that it has made many people overly paranoid. But that is not a bad thing considering the times that we live in. You would probably have to be living under a rock not to know that America suffered through two more mass shootings last weekend. Although perhaps not, as there have been more mass shootings (255) in 2019 than there have been days in the year (with August 5th being the 217th day)! So very sad, but not at all surprising really as guns are so easily obtainable.

What did shock me was that the gunman from Dayton, Ohio was known to have an obsession with

violence. Old classmates of his reported that at school he had a 'hit list' of people that he either wanted to kill or rape. This had all been previously reported to the police, investigated and yet a few years on he was still legally allowed to own a gun.

According to CNN the mother of the El Paso, Texas shooter also called the police only weeks before the attack. She was very concerned that her 21 year-old son was not mature or experienced enough to own an AK-type firearm. Again the authorities didn't take these concerns too seriously and allegedly told her he was legally allowed to own this weapon!

So seeing something and saying something doesn't always work. Especially if no one is listening. I am not

sure where the blame lies really. All I do know, is that if I had a son who came home with any kind of gun I would certainly not think 'Oh well, the cops said it is ok, so I have nothing to worry about'. On the other hand, it is probably quite stupid to argue with someone who owns a scary assault rifle... No one should have easy access to weapons, particularly when they are clearly not of sound mind.

But I do know how easy it is to stick your head in the sand. Years ago I lived with someone who had a gun. I was so shocked when I found out. They had never mentioned that they owned one and it had never crossed my mind to ask. My immediate reaction was to say that I can't live with a gun in the house. They laughed and even made fun of me, but they thankfully soon got rid of it.

I am not sure I would ever want to assert my Second Amendment rights, as the thought of shooting someone, even in self-defense fills me with horror. Plus more than likely I would shoot myself by mistake.

Homeland Security have published a guide on how to respond if you are ever in the situation of having to deal with an active shooter, which can be found at www.dhs.gov. They readily admit that each situation is unpredictable, but it is still worthwhile having a quick read. More importantly I would suggest learning how to treat a gunshot wound. Hopefully it is a skill that you will never have to use. I have only ever witnessed one shooting, which was still one too many. California does have stricter gun laws than many other states. In fact a new law was implemented on July 1st of this year. Background checks are now required for all ammunition purchases. The law also requires that all ammo purchases take place in person. Including online orders which must be delivered to a licensed vendor for customer pick-

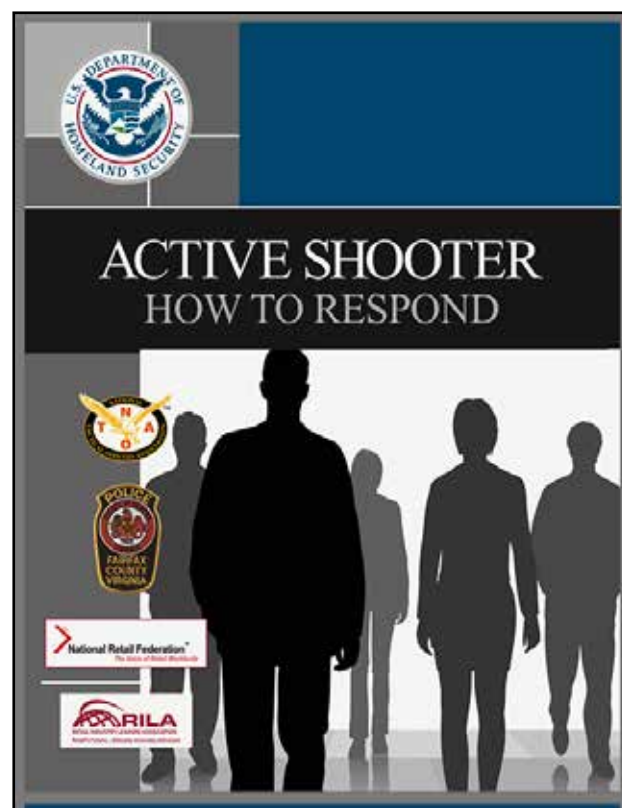
up. This apparently, has already blocked 100 sales in the first month. But hopefully deterred many others.

But it is still not enough as even if this law had been in effect in Ohio or Texas it wouldn't have prevented the loss of 31 lives last weekend. The shooters would have passed the background checks. It didn't manage to stop the shooting at the Gilroy Garlic Festival in San Francisco either. The gunman in that case was only 19 years old; 21 is the legal age in CA. He purchased the gun legally in Nevada and just smuggled it back in to California!

Really they should raise the cost of a firearms license. As currently it is only \$25 to get one in California. Insurance policies should be mandatory too, just as is required with owning cars. I am certain that if insurance companies were involved the background checks and mental health evaluations would be far more stringent, don't you? In all honesty, I don't know really what can be done to stop this as if someone is willing to commit murder they are hardly going to worry about following gun laws are they... but I still think it is worth saying something if you see something, but just insist on being heard!

Meet A Member: Jessie McCormack

Not all our BiLA members are from the UK. Case in point: Jessie McCormack from New York City, who moved to LA 'many moons ago' initially to pursue acting but then shifted into writing and directing.

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

I wanted to be the first person to move here in hopes of breaking into the entertainment industry. I really think of myself as a pioneer that way.

What do you miss most from home?

I miss Central Park. And irony. But mostly I miss the New York of my youth which is nothing like the city it is now. In truth I love living in L.A. (for the

most part) and feel very lucky to have landed here.

What was your first impression of LA and has it changed since?

When I first arrived San Vicente Blvd confused the hell out of me. That hasn't really changed.

What do you find the biggest difference is living here versus New York City?

In New York there are way too many pedestrians and they're all looking down at their phones while walking directly into traffic. In Los Angeles there are no pedestrians to speak of but there are still hordes of abandoned scooters littering the sidewalks. It's like a scene from "The Leftovers".

Also, the way one experiences sunlight is very different (and not just in terms of weather). The multitude of cookie-cutter skyscrapers popping up in NY are casting these enormous shadows (literally) across the city. Soon large swaths of Manhattan will only be seen in silhouette. Conversely, in L.A. there are certain times of day when the light

takes on this gorgeous hue. Of course that's largely because of the toxic, polluted air we're breathing into our lungs but at least we'll all die looking at pretty pink clouds.

Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?

But parking is a nightmare so I usually take a Lyft to Hollywood and Highland and then walk the rest of the way. Wearing comfy shoes is a priority.

Also, I just learned (like this second) that

morning rehearsals at the Bowl are free and open to the public!

What would you suggest to others who are thinking about making the move here?

I might suggest subletting a place for six months - maybe even a year - before settling into a more permanent housing situation. That way you can really get a lay of the land and decide what neighborhood suits you/your family best. Plus it might behoove you to hold off on uprooting your entire life until you know how you'll tolerate the traffic and car culture in general. It's not for everyone. But a better suggestion might be to take heart. Many native New Yorkers who

grew up solely relying on public transportation don't even think twice about all of the driving here. That should give anyone hope (at least I hope it does).

Lots of our members join our group Brits in LA seeking out words of wisdom - what is the best piece of advice you've been given?

I can't recall but here's a soupçon of my own advice: Get a dog. Pick up the shite of said dog. Carve out time to cultivate your friendships. Maintain a sense of humor. Don't park askew (if I see you taking up more than one parking space I might have to key "USA! USA!" across the hood of your car). Use your

“They look shot” - Vaughan’s worry for post-World Cup England

England’s “draining” World Cup campaign could be affecting their Ashes campaign against Australia, fears former captain Michael Vaughan.

England trail the five-

match series 1-0 after being thrashed by 251 runs in the opening Test at Edgbaston last weekend.

The Test came 18 days after England won their first men’s World Cup.

“Emotionally, I have a concern about two or three of the England players trying to play in an Ashes so soon after the World Cup,” Vaughan said.

Six of England’s World

Cup winners played in the Test at Edgbaston.

“High level sport sometimes drains the life out of you,” Vaughan told Test Match Special. “When you’ve achieved that level and been on that podium lifting the World Cup, I just worry.

“Moeen Ali, Jonny Bairstow and Jos Buttler look shot.”

Off-spinner Moeen struggled for control with the ball, taking 3-172 in the match, while Bairstow and Butler scored a combined 20 runs in England’s two innings.

Captain Root, who played in all of England’s World Cup matches, said the players were “absolutely ready to go” at Edgbaston.

“Seeing emotionally how things changed throughout the World Cup - that’s probably a good example to the group,” Root said.

“The guys that were in those World Cup

scenarios dealt with the pressure of that and [can] take it into this series.”

England are now likely to be without leading Test wicket-taker James Anderson for the second Test after he aggravated a calf injury on the first day at Edgbaston.

The loss of Anderson meant that Stuart Broad and Ben Stokes bowled the majority of England’s overs at Edgbaston.

“If the ball doesn’t move laterally, this series has got mess written all over it for this England side,” Vaughan added.

“I think this series could be one where Australia completely wipe the floor with England.”

Steve Smith scored a hundred in each innings of the match on his return to the Australia side following his 12-month ban for his part in the ball-tampering scandal.

Australia captain Tim Paine said the 30-year-old is “probably the best

Test batsman we have ever seen”.

“Steve Smith has been unbelievable, not just this week but in the last five or six weeks too,” Paine said.

“He makes guys better. He’s one of the best Test batsmen we’ve seen and he seems to be getting even better.

“It speaks a lot to his character as well.”

Smith was booed by the Edgbaston crowd throughout the Test, as he was during the World Cup, but received a standing ovation after his second-innings century.

“He’s been through a tough time and copped it all day, every day in England for the past three to four months,” Paine said.

“It shows incredible mental strength and concentration to get through that and together with the skill he has, he’s an amazing package.”

City complete Cancelo signing

Manchester City have completed the signing of Portugal right-back Joao Cancelo from Juventus for £60m.

The agreement sees City full-back Danilo, 28, move in the opposite direction for a fee of £34.1m.

Cancelo, 25, has signed a contract at the Etihad Stadium until the summer of 2025 and becomes City’s third signing of the summer after Angelino and Rodri.

“City are a fantastic club, with a brilliant manager and I am delighted to be here,” said Cancelo.

“Everything about them has impressed me, from the facilities, to their style of play.

“I am always looking to develop my game and win trophies and I believe I can do that here, so now I’m really looking forward to the new season and testing myself in the Premier League.”

Cancelo, who can play further forward as well

as at left-back, joined Juventus from Valencia for £35m in 2018 after a season on loan at Inter Milan.

He was part of the Portugal squad that won the Nations League in June, although he did not play.

City director of football Txiki Begiristain said: “Joao is a fine player and an excellent attacking full-back who will provide us with a real threat on the right-hand side.

“We have been impressed with his progress and have no doubt he can continue to shine here in Manchester.

“He fits the profile of player we want here at Manchester City. His best years are ahead of him, he’s technically proficient and has the physical attributes we desire.”

City signed Danilo from Real Madrid for £26.5m in 2017, and he made 22 league starts in 60 appearances for the Blues across all competitions.

The Brazilian, who has agreed a five-year contract at Juve, has been involved in back-to-back Premier League title wins under manager Pep Guardiola but has rarely been viewed as a first choice. He becomes City’s record sale.

Burnley have completed the signing of Chelsea midfielder Danny Drinkwater on loan until 6 January.

Drinkwater, a Premier League winner with Leicester City in 2015-16, joined Chelsea for £35m in 2017.

However, the 29-year-old has made just five league starts for the Blues and did not feature in the top flight last season.

Drinkwater said it was “time to get my career back on track” following the move.

He added: “Unfortunately it’s not happened for me at Chelsea, but you have to go with the flow.

“I think now the target is to get to a level where the manager is happy with my fitness and keep moving forward and working hard.

“It was a bit of a complicated time at Chelsea, but I see this as a positive move and I’m looking forward to getting going.”

Drinkwater has three England caps but has not appeared for his country since May 2016.

Striker Andy Carroll

says his return to Newcastle United eight years after he left was what “dreams were made of”.

The 30-year-old, released by West Ham this summer following a six-year spell blighted by injuries, signed a one-year contract on transfer deadline day.

“I enjoyed the time I spent here, and hopefully I can carry on where I left off,” said Carroll, who made his Newcastle debut

in 2006.

“For me to get back to where I was, I think this is the only place for me.”

Carroll scored 33 goals during his five years on Tyneside and helped the club win promotion to the top flight in 2009-10.

He told Sky Sports: “When I put the shirt back on it will probably be a better feeling that it was the first time. It’s something I wanted for a long time and now it’s here.”

Maguire completes £80m United switch

Manchester United have signed England centre-back Harry Maguire from Premier League rivals Leicester City for £80m - a world record fee for a defender.

The 26-year-old has agreed a six-year contract at Old Trafford, with the option of a further year.

The fee for Maguire eclipses the £75m Liverpool paid Southampton for Virgil van Dijk in January 2018.

"When Manchester United come knocking on your door, it is an incredible opportunity," said Maguire.

Maguire is the second most expensive signing in

English top-flight history after new team-mate Paul Pogba (£89m), and becomes the second most expensive British player after Wales winger Gareth Bale, who joined Real Madrid from Tottenham for £85m in 2013.

He is United manager Ole Gunnar Solskjaer's third summer signing, after right-back Aaron Wan-Bissaka arrived from Crystal Palace for £50m and winger Daniel James joined from Swansea for £15m.

Maguire added: "From my conversations with the manager, I am excited about the vision and plans he has for the team.

"It's clear to see that Ole is building a team to win trophies. I am now looking forward to meeting my new team-mates and getting the season started."

Solskjaer said: "Harry is one of the best centre-backs in the game today.

"He is a great reader of the game and has a strong presence on the pitch, with the ability to remain calm under pressure.

"He will fit well into this group both on and off the pitch."

Premier League clubs have now spent more than £1bn this summer.

United had a long-standing interest in

Maguire but backed away from a deal 12 months ago because they felt the £70m asking price at the time was too high.

Maguire, who signed a five-year contract at Leicester last September, made 69 Premier League appearances for the club he joined from Hull City

in 2017.

He began his career at Sheffield United, making 139 league appearances for the Blades before moving to Hull in 2014.

He was part of the side that earned promotion to the Premier League via the play-offs in 2016, but left for Leicester in a £17m

deal following the Tigers' relegation 12 months later.

Maguire made his England debut in August 2017 and helped his country reach the semi-finals of the 2018 World Cup in Russia, scoring in the 2-0 quarter-final win over Sweden.

Lukaku moves to Inter: Spurs snap up lo Celso

Inter Milan have signed Belgium striker Romelu Lukaku from Manchester United for a club record fee of 80m euros (£74m) on a five-year deal.

Lukaku, 26, scored 42 goals in 96 games for United but leaves just two years after his £75m move from Everton.

He becomes the third most expensive signing by a Serie A club after the Juventus duo of Cristiano Ronaldo (£99.2m) and Gonzalo Higuain (£75.3m).

"Inter were the only club I wanted," said Lukaku.

"I'm here to bring the Nerazzurri back to the top."

In a statement, Manchester United said: "Everybody would like to thank Romelu for his efforts at the club and pass on our best wishes for the future."

Lukaku scored 15 goals in 45 games for United last season but was often overlooked in favour of England striker Marcus Rashford by manager

Ole Gunnar Solskjaer.

He did not feature in any of United's pre-season games, with Solskjaer saying the player had an ankle injury.

Belgium manager Roberto Martinez said earlier this summer Lukaku "had to leave" the Premier League club, with Inter boss Antonio Conte indicating the ex-Blues striker was his top transfer priority.

Lukaku moved to United from Everton in 2017 and at the time was only the fourth player to score 80 goals in the Premier League before turning 24 - after Michael Owen, Robbie Fowler and Wayne Rooney.

In his debut season, the Belgian became one of only 11 United players to score 25 goals or more in a campaign since 1992-93. Cantona, Andy Cole and current United manager Ole Gunnar Solskjaer (25 each) are among the strikers who never matched Lukaku's 27-goal tally in a United campaign.

Tottenham have signed England Under-21 winger Ryan Sessegnon for £25m from Fulham and Argentina midfielder Giovanni lo Celso on loan from Real Betis.

Sessegnon has signed a five-year deal with an option for one more and

the fee for the 19-year-old could rise to £30m with performance-related add-ons.

Midfielder Josh Onomah, 22, moves to Craven Cottage as part of the deal.

Lo Celso has initially joined the club on loan but Spurs have an option

to buy the 23-year-old.

Lo Celso, who has 19 caps for Argentina, joined Betis on a permanent deal in April after spending the season on loan from Paris St-Germain. He made 45 appearances for the La Liga club in all competitions last season, scoring 16 goals.

Also at Spurs, the club's proposed move for Paulo Dybala is off after Juventus decided not to sell the 25-year-old forward.

Manchester United ended their talks with the Argentine earlier this month because of his wage demands.

Community Shield: first blood to City

Manchester City won the Community Shield on penalties on Sunday after edging Liverpool in an entertaining game in front of a raucous Wembley.

Georginio Wijnaldum's penalty was saved by City goalkeeper Claudio Bravo, before Gabriel Jesus scored the winning kick.

The meeting between two outstanding sides did not disappoint.

City's Raheem Sterling finally scored his first goal against his old club when he turned home David Silva's flick-on from close range.

The woodwork was

hit three times in quick succession in the second half, as Sterling struck the post in a one on one, Liverpool's Virgil van Dijk shot against the underside of the bar and team-mate Mohamed Salah hit a post.

The Reds drew level when Joel Matip headed home Van Dijk's cross.

At that stage, Liverpool looked the most likely team to win, with Salah having at least three chances - most remarkably when his header was sensationally cleared off the line by a Kyle Walker bicycle kick.

And so the game went straight to penalties, with City scoring all of

theirs.

City started the game with no recognised striker and Sterling playing up front. That only lasted 13 minutes, because an injury to Bayern Munich target Leroy Sane meant Jesus was brought on. Sane was fit enough to later climb the Wembley steps and collect his medal.

By the time he has departed, City were ahead, with Sterling netting during a period they were down to 10 men.

Kevin de Bruyne, who missed a large portion of last season through injury, was majestic - especially in the first half

- with a big hand in the opening goal.

The Belgian found Silva, who knocked the ball on for Sterling to blast home. His shot was straight at Alisson, but hit with such venom from close range he could not keep it out.

City definitely flagged after the break, but they could still have scored more with Sterling hitting the post after Jesus stepped over a Silva through ball.

The England forward really should have done better after being sent through again, this time by Walker, but he stumbled when trying to go round Alisson.

Splashing the cash!

■ Deadline day spree boosts top flight spending to eye-popping £1.41bn

THE PREMIER League splashed the cash again in this year's transfer window, with a flurry of last-minute deals taking the total spent to a staggering £1.41bn - just short of the £1.43bn record set in 2017.

Deadline day spending alone by English top-flight clubs was £170m - but on just 17 deals, the joint fewest number of transfers on the last day of the summer window since 2009.

Everton's £34m signing of forward Alex Iwobi from Arsenal was the biggest incoming Premier League deal, while the largest transfer saw Romelu Lukaku leave Manchester United for Inter Milan for £74m - a loss of £1m on the fee they paid Everton.

Arsenal were the biggest spenders in England during the window, splashing out £155m. On deadline day, they bought £25m Celtic left-back Kieran Tierney and £8m Chelsea centre-back David Luiz. Tottenham recruited Real Betis midfielder Giovani Lo Celso on loan and signed Fulham winger Ryan Sessegnon for £25m. Their pursuit of Juventus forward Paulo Dybala was one of the big stories earlier in the day but the deal fell through.

Watford spent a club record, reported to be £25m, on Rennes winger Ismaila Sarr and Leicester bought Sampdoria's attacking midfielder Dennis Praet for a reported £18m. Three former England internationals made moves - Burnley

signing Chelsea midfielder Danny Drinkwater and Manchester City bringing in Derby goalkeeper Scott Carson, both on loan, while Newcastle resigned free agent striker Andy Carroll.

A busy day in the Championship was headlined by West Brom spending £4m on Southampton striker Charlie Austin.

This was the second year in a row when Premier League clubs could only sign players until the day before the season started, instead of the end of August.

The deadline has also now passed for Championship clubs, but teams from Scotland, Leagues One and Two and all of Europe's major leagues can bring in players until 2 September.

The total number of Premier League signings in the summer fell for the sixth year in a row.

Eleven of the 20 Premier League clubs broke their transfer record this summer, with Sheffield United smashing theirs four times. Arsenal, Aston Villa, Leicester (twice), Manchester City, Newcastle, Southampton, Tottenham, Watford - on deadline day - West Ham and Wolves are the other 10.

Harry Maguire's £80m switch from Leicester to Manchester United was the biggest Premier League signing of the summer, followed by Arsenal's £72m purchase of Lille winger Nicolas Pepe.

Champions Manchester City bought Atletico Madrid midfielder Rodri for £62.8m and Juventus right-back Joao Cancelo for £60m.

Spurs spent £53.8m on Lyon midfielder Tanguy Ndombele - their first first-team signing since January 2018.

Villa spent £125m, the second promoted club to hit nine figures after Fulham, who did so last summer, only to be relegated in April.

The other biggest transfers were Manchester United right-back Aaron Wan-Bissaka (£50m from Crystal Palace), West Ham striker Sebastien Haller (£45m from Eintracht Frankfurt), Newcastle striker Joelinton (£40m from Hoffenheim) and Leicester midfielder Youri Tielemans (reported £40m from Monaco).

Chelsea also spent £40m on Real Madrid midfielder Mateo Kovacic despite having a transfer embargo. The Croat was already there on loan, so

Frank Lampard's side already registered. Their sale of Eden Hazard to Real for a fee of £89m, which could rise to £150m, was one of the biggest deals in the world.
