Harry attacks the press as Meghan sues Mail On Sunday

■ Prince says he can no longer be a “silent witness to her private suffering”

THE TENSE relationship between Harry, Meghan and the British media took a turn for the worse this week, as it emerged that the Duchess plans to sue the Mail on Sunday.

The legal action is a consequence of the newspaper's decision to publish a handwritten letter Meghan had sent to her estranged father.

The decision came as Prince Harry launched an extraordinary and highly personal attack on the British tabloid press and its treatment of his wife, saying he could no longer be a “silent witness to her private suffering”.

Emphasizing his respect for the importance of “objective, truthful reporting”, he accused parts of the media of “waging campaigns against individuals with no thought to the consequences” and compared the treatment of his wife to coverage of his mother, Princess Diana.

The duke said his “deepest fear is history repeating itself”. He wrote: “There comes a point when the only thing to do is to stand up to this behaviour, because it destroys people and destroys lives. Put simply, it is bullying, which scares and silences people. We all know this isn't

acceptable, at any level. We won't and can't believe in a world where there is no accountability for this.

“Though this action may not be the safe one, it is the right one ... I've seen what happens when someone I love is commoditized to the point that they are no longer treated or seen as a real person.

“I lost my mother and now I watch my wife falling victim to the same powerful forces.”

The statement, issued on the Duke and Duchess of Sussex's official website on Tuesday, was published as Meghan moved to start proceedings in the high court over the misuse of private information, infringement of copyright and breach of General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The Mail on Sunday is thought to be vulnerable to the action because under UK law the authors of letters retain ownership of the copyright even after the physical correspondence is in the possession of another

individual. Pursuing legal action on this narrow basis also gives the royals a greater chance of success against DMG Media, formerly Associated Newspapers, which also owns the Daily Mail and MailOnline – both of which have run a substantial number of stories about Meghan.

The Mail on Sunday has run multiple embarrassing stories involving the duchess's father, Thomas Markle, including staged paparazzi photographs of him visiting an internet cafe to read about his daughter's engagement to the prince.

Other critical coverage of the couple has ranged from their use of private jets to their refusal to allow media coverage of the christening of their baby son Archie or name his godparents. They have also been criticized for the £2.4m cost to the public purse for renovations at their Windsor home, Frogmore Cottage.

However, the royals have limited ability to stop the publication of such stories,

prompting the decision to focus on the publication of Meghan's letter to her father.

'human cost'

The photographs of the letter remain available on MailOnline. A spokesman for the newspaper stood by its reporting, setting up a potential court showdown: “The Mail on Sunday stands by the story it published and will be defending this case vigorously. Specifically, we categorically deny that the Duchess's letter was edited in any way that changed its meaning.”

Meghan and Harry, who this week concluded a 10-day tour of southern

Africa, have employed the libel lawyers Schillings, using private funds to bring the case.

In his statement, Harry emphasised that he and Meghan believed in “media freedom and objective, truthful reporting” as a “cornerstone of democracy”.

“There is a human cost to this relentless propaganda, specifically when it is knowingly false and malicious, and though we have continued to put on a brave face – as so many of you can relate to – I cannot begin to describe how painful it has been.

“Because in today's digital age, press fabrications are repurposed

as truth across the globe. One day's coverage is no longer tomorrow's chip-paper.

“I have been a silent witness to her private suffering for too long. To stand back and do nothing would be contrary to everything we believe in.”

When news of his relationship with Meghan Markle became public, he criticised “racial overtones” in reporting.

Last week, it emerged he had complained to the BBC for broadcasting and publishing online an image from a neo-Nazi social media site that called him a “race traitor” and depicted the royal with a gun pointed at his head.

■ EU firmly rebuffs PM's Irish plan, says deal cannot be made by Oct. 31st deadline

The European Union has warned Boris Johnson that his alternative to the Irish backstop was unacceptable and a deal would not be done in time for his October 31 Brexit deadline.

Speaking on Thursday, Simon Coveney, Ireland's foreign minister, said the proposals unveiled this week had "fundamental problems" and that unless they were substantially revised they could not form the basis of a deal.

Donald Tusk, the president of the European Council, said that the EU would "stand fully behind" Ireland against pressure for its government to cave into Mr Johnson's demand for a new customs border on the island.

"My message to Boris Johnson: we remain open but still unconvinced," he said, after a 20-minute telephone call with the prime minister. Mr Tusk earlier held talks with Leo Varadkar, the Irish prime minister.

Norbert Röttgen, chairman of the German parliament's foreign affairs committee, which usually reflects the position of

Angela Merkel, said that there would not be time to find a deal by the end of the month.

"One thing is clear: Johnson's Brexit plan can't be negotiated [before] Oct 31. If UK is serious about this, it must seek extension," he tweeted today.

Guy Verhofstadt, the European parliament's chief Brexit negotiator, said that Mr Johnson's proposals were a "repackaging of bad ideas that have already been floated" and "nearly impossible" to implement. A statement issued by the parliament Brexit committee, chaired by Mr Verhofstadt, said that the proposal in its present form could not be the basis for talks.

"This is unacceptable," the statement said, noting "grave concerns" about proposals that "do not match even remotely what was agreed as a sufficient compromise in the backstop".

Diplomats said that parliament's comments reflected the view of Michel Barnier, the lead Brexit negotiator for the European Commission,

who warned MEPs on Tuesday night that Britain was trying to trap the EU into a deal that would undermine the single market.

EU sources said that Mr Barnier was again expected "to let rip and offload his true feelings" when he briefed European ambassadors later.

But the hardline stance from Ireland angered the Democratic Unionist Party, which has come out in favour of Mr Johnson's proposals. Arlene Foster, the party's leader, accused Ireland of trying to "ride roughshod over unionism".

"Mr Coveney's rejection of a reasonable offer is paving the road for a no-deal exit because unionism will not allow Northern Ireland to be trapped at the whim of Dublin or the EU," she said.

The prime minister is hoping that the EU will go into intensive and formal treaty negotiations to get a deal in time for a summit of European leaders in two weeks. Despite the EU holding the door open for talks to continue with David Frost, Mr Johnson's chief negotiator, senior

figures lined up this week to signal that Britain's negotiating strategy was falling apart.

While the EU fundamentally objects to the British demand for a new customs border in Ireland, opposition in Brussels has focused on proposals to allow the Northern Ireland assembly to vote, every four years, on regulatory alignment with the single market.

Echoing Mr Barnier's objections, according to EU sources, Mr Verhofstadt's Brexit committee warned that allowing the veto would render any future agreement "contingent,

uncertain, provisional, unilateral, instead of the safety net provided for by the backstop".

"The Northern Irish assembly has not sat for nearly three years and it is questionable whether it would be able to reconvene and take on the responsibility for an international treaty of this nature," the committee's statement said.

There were also signs that hardline Eurosceptics, known as the "Spartans", were softening their position. Mark Francois, a leading Eurosceptic, indicated that he could back the deal, while Sir Bill

Cash, another hardliner, said that the proposals were "welcome".

Jeremy Corbyn, the Labour leader, hinted that he was prepared to remove the whip from Labour MPs if they voted for Mr Johnson's deal in the Commons.

He said: "Deal or no deal, this government's agenda is clear: they want a Trump-deal Brexit. A Trump-deal Brexit that would crash our economy and rip away the standards that put a floor under people's rights at work, that protect our environment and protect our consumers."

Scots first in UK to ban smacking

Scotland has become the first country in the UK to make it a criminal offence for parents to smack their children.

The ban on all physical punishment was backed overwhelmingly by 84 votes to 29 by the Scottish Parliament on Thursday afternoon.

The move will give children in Scotland the same protection from assault as adults when it comes into force.

Parents and carers are currently allowed to use "reasonable" physical force to discipline their children.

The smacking ban bill was introduced by Scottish Greens MSP John Finnie, a former police officer, who won the support of the SNP, Labour and Lib Dems as well as his own party and many children's

charities.

Mr Finnie said smacking teaches children that "might is right", and that the ban would "send a strong message that violence is never acceptable in any setting".

He also said there was "irrefutable" evidence that physical punishment damages children, is not an effective form of discipline and can escalate into physical abuse.

The ban was opposed by the Scottish Conservatives, who claimed the bill was bad legislation that risks criminalising "good parents" for using "reasonable chastisement".

But the Scottish government's children's minister, Maree Todd, insisted that "loving parents" would not be criminalised.

Sweden became the first country in the world to ban smacking in the home when it outlawed corporal punishment in 1979 - with Scotland becoming the 58th to do so.

Wales is also on the verge of introducing a ban - but there are not currently any plans for England or Northern Ireland to follow suit.

In Scots Law, all physical attacks on adults can be treated as assault - but children do not have the same protection.

In practice, this generally means parents are allowed to smack their children on the body - but blows to the head, shaking or the use of an implement are illegal.

All physical punishment in schools and other education settings is already completely banned.

Tributes flow as veteran TV newsman Sissons dies at 77

Peter Sissons, the former BBC and ITN newsreader and Question Time host, has died at the age of 77.

Sissons joined ITN in the 1960s before moving to the BBC in 1989 to present Question Time and the Six O'Clock News.

BBC director general Tony Hall described him as "one of the great television figures of his time".

The late broadcaster's old Liverpool school friend Sir Paul McCartney called Sissons "a talented news presenter with a great sense of humour".

Good Morning Britain host Morgan hailed him as "an excellent journalist and TV newsreader, and splendidly combative and amusing man", while BBC presenter Simon McCoy said Sissons was "a great journalist and a fine presenter".

Born in Liverpool in 1942, Sissons went to school with John Lennon, George Harrison and Paul McCartney. He studied at Oxford University, but returned to Liverpool to work as a bus conductor in the summer holidays - and later said the experience of dealing with difficult customers prepared him for handling difficult interviewees.

His journalistic career

began when he joined ITN in 1964 as a writer, and he became a reporter three years later.

As a foreign correspondent, he was wounded by gunfire in Biafra in 1968. He was later promoted to ITN's news editor and then industrial editor before becoming a presenter of ITN's News at One in 1978.

When Channel 4 was launched in 1982, he was chosen to present their nightly news programme, and during his time as anchor, Channel 4 News won three consecutive Bafta Awards.

In 1989, he interviewed the Iranian ambassador about the fatwa issued to author Salman Rushdie, and admitted in his autobiography that he found it "very hard" to keep his anger from showing. That interview resulted in the fatwa being extended to him, meaning he and his family needed 24-hour protection.

"He was a gold standard broadcaster," said BBC News presenter Huw Edwards. "For a decade or more, he was the face of Channel 4 News, and he really was an outstanding interviewer and presenter."

Scots extend fracking ban

The Scottish government has extended its ban on fracking after ministers confirmed it would not grant permission for any onshore drilling projects.

Paul Wheelhouse, the environment minister, said his devolved government would also refuse to issue licences for onshore unconventional oil and gas projects, including fracking, shale gas or coalbed methane projects.

But Wheelhouse rejected calls from climate campaigners and Scottish Labour for fracking to be specifically outlawed by legislation in Scotland. He said the government's regulatory powers under its planning and licensing systems were strong enough.

Promising the government could consider legislation if it

was needed in future, Wheelhouse said fracking was incompatible with the Scottish parliament's new target of cutting climate emissions to net zero by 2045, which was passed by MSPs last week.

"There has been a dramatic change in public perceptions of the environment, the climate crisis and the expectations of government to respond," he said. As a result "an unconventional oil and gas industry would not be of sufficient positive benefit to Scotland to outweigh its negative impacts".

Claudia Beamish, Scottish Labour's environment spokeswoman, said that without legislation this ban could be overturned by another government in future.

Northern Ireland abortion law ruled to breach human rights

Northern Ireland's near-blanket abortion ban breaches the UK's human rights commitments, the high court in Belfast has ruled.

The decision, on Thursday, was made following a case brought by Sarah Ewart, 29, who was denied a termination in 2013 despite a scan showing the foetus she was carrying would not survive.

She travelled to a London clinic for an abortion and upon returning to Northern Ireland started a six-year legal fight to change the law for other women.

Mrs Justice Siobhan Keegan told a packed courtroom that Ewart had given compelling testimony about the "horror" she had endured.

"She has been affected by the current law in that she has had to travel to seek an abortion in desperate circumstances. In addition, she runs the risk of being directly affected again by the current legal impositions given that she is at risk of a baby having a fatal foetal abnormality.

"She has had to modify her behaviour in that she could not have medical treatment in Northern Ireland due to the risk of criminal prosecution."

Keegan said other woman should not have

to face the same "trauma and pain". She said she had followed the ruling of the UK supreme court that Northern Ireland's abortion law was incompatible with article 8 of the European convention on human rights.

However, Keegan held off making a formal declaration of incompatibility because recent legislation, passed in Westminster, was due to decriminalise abortion in Northern Ireland unless the Stormont assembly was restored by 21 October.

Ewart welcomed the ruling. "Too many women in Northern Ireland have been put through unnecessary pain by our abortion law," she said. "It is a massive

emotional relief. This has not been an easy journey. It is a massive victory. It has been a massive stress emotionally on the family but six years later, let's enjoy today."

Amnesty International, which offered an opinion in the case in support of Ewart, said the ruling was a legal landmark that put pressure on the Northern Ireland Office to ensure a swift transition to free, safe, legal and local abortion services.

"Today's ruling shows just how urgently we need change, so that we can access this healthcare without having to travel and without being treated as criminals," said Grainne Teggart, Amnesty International's Northern Ireland campaign manager.

The Democratic Unionist party, which opposed abortion law liberalisation, made no immediate response. Other parties praised the court's judgment.

Ewart deserved to be commended for her "courage and conviction", said Paula Bradshaw, an Alliance party assembly member.

Michelle O'Neill, Sinn Féin's leader in Northern Ireland, said local politicians should return to Stormont, mothballed since power sharing collapsed in 2017, to enshrine reproductive rights.

In a separate case, a woman is facing prosecution for obtaining abortion pills for her pregnant, 15-year-old daughter.

Teen who threw six year-old from tenth floor named

THE teenager accused of throwing a six-year-old boy from a viewing platform at London's Tate Modern gallery has been named as Jonty Bravery.

The suspect, who is accused of attempted murder and is yet to enter a plea, was 17 at the time of the incident on August 4 and could not be named because he was a minor, but he turned 18 on Thursday. At the Old Bailey this week a judge heard an application to extend Mr Bravery's anonymity. The defendant

was not present. The application was rejected after a 90-minute hearing and Nicholas Hilliard, QC, the recorder of London, said that Mr Bravery's name could now be published.

Mr Bravery, who is from London, is due to appear at the Old Bailey on November 7 for a plea hearing.

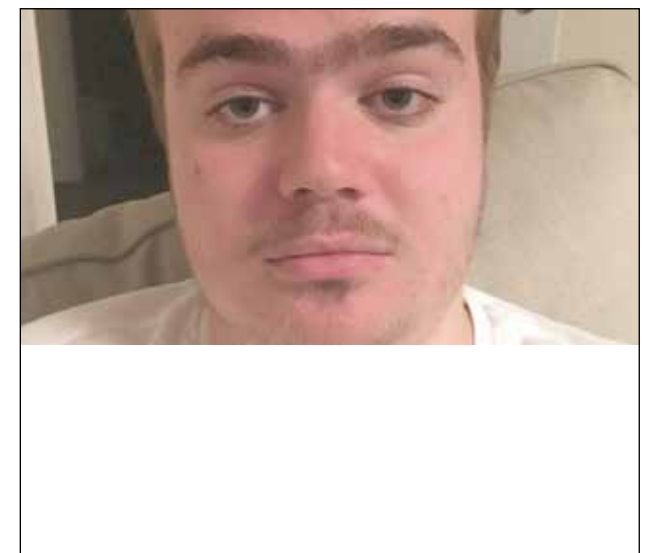
The court was told in August that psychiatric reports had been ordered, that any trial would last for two weeks and would take place in the new year.

The six-year-old boy, a French tourist who was visiting London with his family, was allegedly thrown from a tenth-floor viewing platform at the top of the Blavatnik Building at Tate Modern. He fell 100ft on to a roof five storeys below.

The child, who cannot be named for legal reasons, suffered fractures to his spine, legs and arms and a bleed on the brain. He remains in hospital in Britain and cannot move or speak nearly two months after sustaining his

injuries, his family have said. He is able to smile and laugh but is upset at being unable to move or eat, they said, adding that he was regaining movement in his arms, hands and tongue.

A fundraising page set up by a well-wisher has raised almost £93,000 to support the boy's family, who said: "He is very brave. He keeps on smiling and reacting to our jokes. We begin to see also, unfortunately, his suffering. He . . . doesn't understand why he cannot manage to eat or swallow."



JONTY BRAVERY: charged with attempted murder

Britain voices 'regret' over Captain Cook's Maori killings

Britain has issued a formal expression of regret that Captain James Cook's crew killed Maori when they landed in New Zealand amid growing anger over events marking the 250th anniversary of their arrival.

Laura Clarke, the UK's high commissioner to New Zealand, travelled to the first landing site on the east of the North Island for a tearful meeting with descendants of Maori killed by Cook's men in October 1769.

Ms Clarke said she acknowledged the "pain"

that had been caused by the killing of some of the first native people the crew encountered.

"We are saying this is not how any of us would have wanted those first encounters to have happened," Ms Clarke said after her private meetings with Maori elders in the city of Gisborne, 300 miles southeast of Auckland.

"Their story needed to be told and needed to be heard and needed to be acknowledged. I very much wanted to do that and to acknowledge that, for their descendants, the

pain doesn't diminish over time."

The High Commission issued a statement saying: "The expression of regret responds to a request from the local iwi [Maori people] for this history to be heard and acknowledged."

The statement precedes ceremonies across New Zealand next week, and later Australia, commemorating the anniversary of Cook's first voyage to the South Pacific.

The planned celebrations have been especially contentious among parts of Maori society, which have banned a full-size replica of Cook's ship, Endeavour, from entering waters in New Zealand's far north. Memorials to the British explorer, whom some have cast as a murderous invader, have been attacked.

The expression of regret for the shootings by the crew - Cook himself did not kill any Maori - has been negotiated for weeks by Ms Clarke,

who was appointed high commissioner last year and is learning to speak Maori. While it stops short of the apology some Maori have sought, Ms Clarke's gesture was welcomed by descendants of those killed.

Nick Tupara, an artist and direct descendant of Te Maro, a warrior and the first Maori to be killed by Cook's men, said: "I think the British high commissioner is brave to come and offer that, and that's enough for now."

Te Maro was shot dead on October 8, 1769 - possibly while taking part in a ceremonial challenge. He was one of nine Maori, including the local chief Te Rakau, who were killed or wounded on Cook's first landing. When Cook headed north more were killed in confrontations at Mercury Bay and the Cavalli Islands.

The depth of feeling that lingers over Cook's arrival can be gleaned from the Gisborne region's Rongowhakaata

people, who have uploaded a series of videos on social media to highlight the events of that first day.

Winston Peters, New Zealand's deputy prime minister, and lawyer, who is part Maori, said the community should remember that their own track record "has not been as pure as the driven snow" when it came to history and loss of life.

It was time to make the best of contact between Maori and Europeans, Mr Peter added.

Anna Quayle dead at 86

Grange Hill and Chitty Chitty Bang Bang star Anna Quayle has died aged 86.

The actress passed away on 16 August after battling Lewy body dementia, which she was diagnosed with in 2012. Her family confirmed her death nearly two months on from her passing. Quayle was best known for playing Mrs Monroe on Grange Hill, starring as the teacher in 85 episodes from 1990 until 1994. Before this role, the British actress had roles in The Avengers TV series and Brideshead Revisited.

In her film career, Anna starred as Baroness Bomburst in the children's classic Chitty Chitty Bang Bang in 1968, as well as appearing in A Hard Day's Night in a small role opposite John Lennon. In her scene,

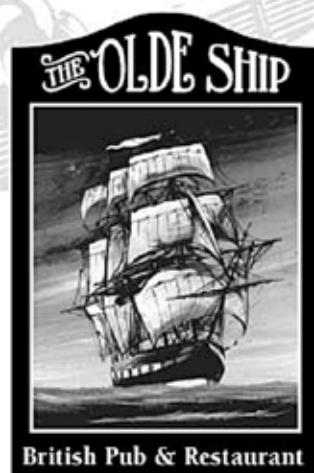
she played Millie, who recognised Lennon as one of the Beatles. And in 1963, Quayle received a Tony Award for Best Featured Actress in a Musical for her role in the original production of Stop The World - I Want To Get Off.

In her theatre career, Anna received critical acclaim with roles in Pal Joey, The Case Of The Oily Levantine, Noël Coward's Blithe Spirit and Rodney Ackland's After October.

The Birmingham-born star had been acting since the age of three, and studied at RADA, which she graduated from in 1956. Her last credited TV role was in 1999 in the series Adam's Family Tree, as the character Celina Spookfinder. In 1976, she married Donald Baker and they went on to have a daughter, Katy, together.

To be or not to be: Equity, unions and making a living as an actor

EVEN if you're not an actor, chances are you've heard of Equity, which styles itself the 'UK trade union for creative practitioners'. Formerly known as British Actors' Equity Association, the union recently held a soirée in the Hollywood Hills - on a perfectly British day - which begged the question (or questions) on whether in this climate it is good to be a member of a union.

So let me first break it down: In Britain Equity represents actors (and theatre directors, fight directors, choreographers, set designers, costume designers, lighting

designers etc.) for TV, film, commercials and theatre. In the US we have American Equity for theatre and SAG-AFTRA for TV, film and commercials. There are tons of pros and cons as to why to join a union so I'll go in to the history of the union system in general and why it was put in place.

Unions began forming in the mid-19th century in response to the social and economic impact of the Industrial Revolution. National labor unions in this country began to form in the post-Civil War era. The Knights of Labor emerged as a major

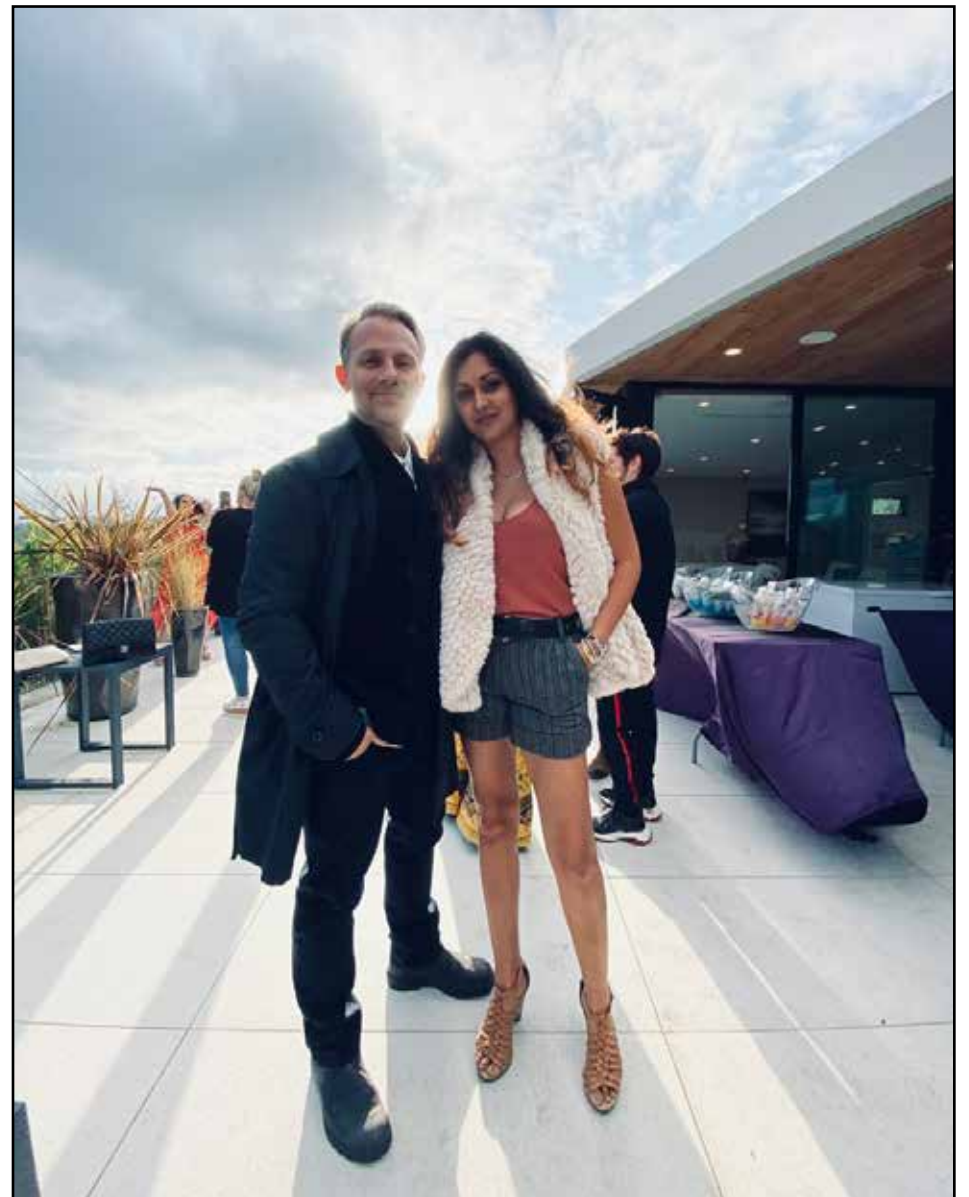
force in the late 1880s, but collapsed because of poor organization, lack of effective leadership, disagreement over goals, and strong opposition from employers and government forces.

Today most labor unions in the United States are members of one of two larger umbrella organizations: the American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations (AFL-CIO) or the Change to Win Federation, which split from the AFL-CIO in 2005-2006. Both organizations advocate policies and legislation favorable to workers in the United States and Canada, and take an active role in politics favoring the Democratic party but not exclusively so. The AFL-CIO is especially concerned with global trade and economic issues.

In general Union members earn better wages and benefits than workers who aren't union members. On average, union workers' wages are 28 percent higher than their nonunion counterparts. Labor unions also give workers the power to negotiate for more favorable working conditions and other benefits through collective bargaining.

Now on the flip side (for actors in particular) there seem to be fewer opportunities for actors in Los Angeles, due to runaway production costs and the consequent upswing of non-union work. Not only is it getting increasingly harder for actors to join the union but it's even harder to make the minimums to qualify for health insurance.

To join SAG, a performer must pay an initiation fee plus the first semi-annual basic dues. The national initiation fee rate is currently \$3,000 (initiation fees may be lower in some areas).

Annual base dues are \$201.96. In addition, work dues are calculated at 1.575 percent of covered earnings up to \$500,000.

Yes, there's a cap, for those at the top 1% tier who you see all the time in films, commercials and TV shows.

Anyone who is paying attention will know that there is far more content out there than ever before, especially on TV, especially that funded by deep-pocketed streaming giants including Netflix, Hulu, Amazon and imminent Disney Plus channel.

But that doesn't mean they are union jobs. Plenty of shows are made in the UK, sometimes under British Actors' Equity and sometimes strictly non-union. Many British actors of my acquaintance are willing to take these lesser-paid and lesser-protected jobs, because if they don't, there's a

thousand others waiting outside who will do the job. Factor in the countless non-union productions across Eastern Europe and you quickly realize it's getting increasingly harder for actors to make a living.

I have had my share of those in-between jobs, but I feel more saddened for those artists in impoverished areas that don't get the chances we enjoy solely by our privilege of living in Los Angeles.

We may love what we do for a living but the grim reality is that the entertainment industry is subject to the same market forces as any other business: competition, changing market realities and ruthless cost-cutting for the front line workers while those in the executive suites (or the stars' trailers, in my industry) are making money hand over fist.

At the Equity event we learned how much are unions are doing to fight against runaway productions and the measures they are taking to encourage more production company to become SAG signatories. They are working on getting more protections for actors. So all in all if they could make it more affordable for actors be union members I think we would have a much stronger union, rather than making it increasingly harder.

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Meet a Member: Martin Lewis

Meet Martin Lewis from London who moved to L.A. 32 years ago to pursue his career as a producer.

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

I moved from London to New York in 1982. Adored the energy level and the positivism – such a change from the cynicism in the UK of that era. After six years of NYC, I thought I'd try L.A. – just for a few weeks as an experiment. I blinked – and 32 years later I'm still here! Hollywood is a very seductive mistress! The weather and the environment contributed to my choice...

What do you miss most from home?

My Mum – 97 years young and still a pistol! Draught cider. Real crumpets. Bramley apples. Silverside of beef. Hampstead Heath. Hendon FC. (I think they're in the Alpine Double-Glazing League now...)

What was your first impression of LA and has it changed since?

My first visit was 1974 and it was desperately provincial back then. Like Doncaster – but without the sophistication. Pleasant to look at – but slow and sleepy. That changed rapidly in the 1980s and 1990s with the influx of East-Coasters

and Europeans. It rapidly became metropolitan-chic. Sometimes going too far: e.g. "your dish will be served on a bed of wilted, mesquite-grilled cilantro with a drizzle of raspberry-balsamic vinaigrette..." We have a whip-smart contemporary city. Like Bournemouth but with sunshine. (And without the Bournemouth part.)

What do you find the biggest difference is living here versus London?

Waking up in a city that has a smile on its face. It may be a delusional, sun-kissed, therapist-induced, pill-enhanced smile – but I'll take that over the gloomy miserablism that permeated London in the 1970s and 1980s. I know that London has changed since then – but the veneer of 90s Brit-Pop, London Eye and a slew of Gordon Ramsay restaurants hasn't covered up the sad mood lurking below the surface. L.A. may be the Shallow End... But it's a SUNNY shallow End!

Do you have a hidden gem in LA that you want to share with us?

That question is a staple of these types of articles. You list your favorite nook and the next week your Shangri-La is overrun by the very people whose absence made

the place so special! That said – my favorite place is the Hollywood Hills. Exploring the little roads and byways in a convertible. Savoring the area's long history as a bohemian enclave. Listening to something really incongruous to the surroundings. Such as Stanley Holloway singing "With Her Head Tucked Underneath Her Arm" – a 1934 paean to Anne Boleyn! (I expect to see multiple cars cruising Laurel Canyon soon – all blaring out the sounds of Stanley Holloway!)

What would you suggest to others who are thinking about making the move here?

Leave your hometown behind – except as a fond memory to be nurtured occasionally late at night. Have an open mind to the charms, beauty, quiriness – and even to the inanities (acupressure, "rolfing", bizarre cleansing procedures!). If they work for you – go for it. If they don't – you'll have a funny anecdote to share.

Poch urges unity after Bayern beating

Tottenham manager Mauricio Pochettino says his team must "stick together" after the embarrassment of a 7-2 defeat by Bayern Munich.

Last season's Champions League finalists were humbled in their first home game of the new campaign on Tuesday night.

"When you receive this type of result, it's important to believe in yourself," Pochettino told BT Sport.

"That is the only way to recover the good feeling." The hammering at the hands of the German side is the latest disappointment in a troubled start to the season for Spurs.

They sit seventh in

the Premier League, already 10 points behind leaders Liverpool, and were knocked out of the League Cup by fourth-tier Colchester United.

"It's a tough situation, but you have to face it," said Pochettino. "You have to be strong and keep going. We have to stay together and help each other. The best medicine is to be all together."

Tottenham went ahead through Son Heung-min, but went 2-1 down on the stroke of half-time.

Bayern were 4-1 ahead by the time Harry Kane pulled one back from the penalty spot, only for the visitors to score three in the final 10 minutes, two of which were netted by Serge Gnabry to give him four in total.

"We dominated the game in the first 30 minutes," said Pochettino.

"We were unlucky we were conceded at the end of the first half and after that they were very clinical.

Former Spurs midfielder Rafael van der Vaart called the performance "terrible" and has questioned the mindset of Tottenham's players.

"They think they're better than they are," he told BBC Radio 5 Live Breakfast.

"You have to be really proud to play for Tottenham, a fantastic club. If you play like yesterday then I think everybody has to shut up and work hard and bring the team to another level because the quality is there."

We're not here 'to make up the numbers' says Coady after Wolves win

Wolves captain Conor Coady insists the Premier League side are not in the Europa League "to make up the numbers" after they claimed their first win of the group stage with a 1-0 victory at Besiktas. Willy Boly struck deep in stoppage time to seal a dramatic win on Thursday.

The result means Wolves have three points from two games in Group K after losing their

Britain's Golden Wonder!

■ Dina in dreamland as she rewrites history with 200m gold

BRITISH athletics celebrated a new world champion sprinter this week, as Dina Asher-Smith seized her golden opportunity to win the 200m title at the World Athletics Championships in Doha.

With many of the top medal contenders pulling out or skipping the event, Asher-Smith proved the class act in the field, powering home in a national record 21.88 seconds to add gold to the silver she won in the 100m.

Until Wednesday, Britain's world and Olympic sprint champions numbered three: Harold Abrahams,

Allan Wells and Linford Christie. That changed when Asher-Smith took off around the Khalifa Stadium and left the rest of the world for dead. As she crossed the line, five metres clear of the rest, she looked up at the scoreboard, saw a British record time of 21.88secs and gasped. "It is something that after the last World Championships, John (Blackie, her coach) and I knew that I could do," said Asher-Smith.

"It means so much. I have dreamed of this moment. 'I woke up today and I thought 'This is it, this is your moment'. The support has been amazing, I am

lost for words."

The tears flowed as Asher-Smith cuddled her mother Julie. As she celebrated, she could have been forgiven for thinking back to the day at primary school when an athlete brought in a medal to show her class. The story, as her coach tells it with a broad grin, was that young Dina was asked if she wanted to put the medal on. "Her mum was there and said, 'No, she's got to earn it!'" Well, she did that on Wednesday, leading from trigger to tape to finish ahead of American Brittany Brown (22.22) and Switzerland's Mujinga Kambundji (22.51).

United boss blames ref as winless streak goes on

Manchester United put in a "good performance" and were denied a "nailed-on penalty" in their Europa League draw with AZ Alkmaar, says boss Ole Gunnar Solskjaer.

United failed to have a single shot on target in an uninspired showing on Thursday and have now failed to win in their past 10 away games.

But Solskjaer saw the game positively and focused on a penalty he felt his side should have had when Stijn Wuytens brought down Marcus Rashford with 10 minutes to go. The referee did not award it and the video assistant referee system is not in use in the Europa League group stage.

"I'm very happy with the boys," said Solskjaer.



"It's a penalty 101 times out of 100," said Solskjaer after Marcus Rashford was fouled

"It should have been three points."

He said "you can't even discuss" the penalty decision because it was so blatant and added they should have had a spot-kick during Monday's 1-1 draw against Arsenal for a Sead Kolasinac handball.

"I couldn't believe what I saw, same as Arsenal with the

handball," he said.

"It's frustrating getting these little things. The boys deserve so much more. It's going to turn at one point and we'll get the decisions and then they'll get the results we deserve."

Solskjaer had earlier criticised the plastic pitch as one of the "worst ones I have seen for a long while".
