■ After 47 years, the United Kingdom leaves the European Union

Prime Minister Boris Johnson hailed the “dawn of a new era” on Friday, as the UK left the European Union after 47 years.

In a speech to shown at 22:00 GMT - an hour before the official departure time - the Prime Minister said Brexit is “not an end but a beginning”.

He also described severing ties with the other 27 EU nations as “a moment of real national renewal and change”.

Little will change immediately, as the UK begins a “transition period”.

Most EU laws will continue to be in force - including the free movement of people - until the end of December, by which time the UK aims to have reached a permanent free trade agreement with the EU.

repeatedly delayed

In a statement, Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn urged the country not to “turn inwards” and instead “build a truly internationalist, diverse and outward-looking Britain”.

Brexit was originally scheduled for 31 March last year but was repeatedly delayed when MPs rejected a previous withdrawal agreement reached by the EU and former Prime Minister Theresa May.

Mr Johnson was able to

get his own deal through Parliament after winning December’s general election with a House of Commons majority of 78, on a pledge to “get Brexit done”.

This brought to an end more than three years of political wrangling, following the referendum of 2016, in which 52% of voters backed leaving the EU.

To mark Brexit, Mr Johnson held a cabinet meeting in Sunderland - the city that was the first to back Brexit when results were announced after the 2016 referendum - on Friday morning.

The prime minister - who led the 2016 campaign to get the UK out of the EU - attempted to strike an optimistic, non-triumphalist note in his speech, stressing the need to bring all side together.

“The most important thing to say tonight is that this is not an end but a beginning,” he will say.

“This is the moment when the dawn breaks and the curtain goes up on a new act. It is a moment of real national renewal and change.”

In his address, filmed in Downing Street, Mr Johnson added: “This is

the dawn of a new era in which we no longer accept that your life chances - your family's life chances - should depend on which part of the country you grow up in.

candlelit vigils

“This is the moment when we begin to unite and level up.”

Supporters of the EU also took part in a procession through Whitehall at 15:00 to “bid a fond farewell” to the union.

Later, Brexiteers gathered in Parliament Square for a celebration, with a clock counting down to the moment the

UK left the EU projected on to Downing Street.

Buildings along Whitehall were lit up and Union flags were flown from all the poles in Parliament Square.

In Brussels, the UK flag was be removed from the EU institutions, with one Union flag expected to be consigned to a museum.

The Belgian capital has already dressed its famous Mannekin Pis statue of a urinating boy in a John Bull costume, in a Union flag waistcoat.

The city's Grande Place was illuminated in red, white and blue, in what organisers called a tribute

to the ongoing friendship between the UK and EU countries.

In Scotland, which voted to stay in the EU in the 2016 referendum, candlelit vigils took place as part of

The Leave a Light On gatherings taking place in Aberdeen, Dundee, Glasgow, and Stirling, among other locations, as participants sent a message to the EU to keep open a place for Scotland.

In a speech in Edinburgh, Scottish First Minister Nicola Sturgeon said Scotland has been “taken out of the European Union against the wishes of the

overwhelming majority of people in Scotland”.

Liberal Democrat acting leader Sir Ed Davey vowed his pro-EU party would “never stop fighting” to have the “closest possible relationship” with Europe.

He said it would be on a “damage-limitation exercise to stop a hard Brexit hurting British people”.

One long-standing pro-Brexit campaigner Conservative MP Steve Baker said he would “celebrate discreetly... in a way which is respectful of the genuine sorrow that others are feeling at the same time”.

BoJo defies Trump, chooses Huawei for 5G

But Chinese company's 'high risk' classification will still protect security, government insists

BORIS Johnson defied Donald Trump this week by giving the go-ahead to Chinese tech giant Huawei to help build Britain's 5G telecommunications network.

The Prime Minister said the firm will play a limited role in developing the next generation of mobile phone technology in the UK – despite concerns about its links to China's communist regime.

The decision followed months of lobbying by officials from President Trump's White House administration.

Whitehall sources said the Prime Minister decided against a complete ban on Huawei from the 5G network because such a move could cost the economy tens of billions of pounds and delay the productivity-boosting technology by up to five years. However, in a bid to reduce any potential cyber threat the Government designated Huawei a "high-risk vendor" – banning the company from any involvement in any project linked to security or sensitive data. Huawei will be barred from locations near nuclear

sites and military bases as a result of the move.

"We are clear-eyed about the challenge posed by Huawei," one source said.

Mr Johnson took the long-awaited decision at a meeting of his National Security Council in Downing Street – and told Mr Trump by phone Tuesday night. Referring to the UK's desire to eventually exclude Huawei involvement, a Downing Street spokeswoman said: "The Prime Minister underlined the importance of like-minded countries working together to diversify the market and break the dominance of a small number of companies."

'productivity gap'

After the news broke in the US, Republican and Democrat politicians in Washington called for a review of intelligence sharing arrangements with the UK.

Ministers believe that rolling out 5G across the country is crucial to improving economic performance and addressing the UK's "productivity gap".

Security sources

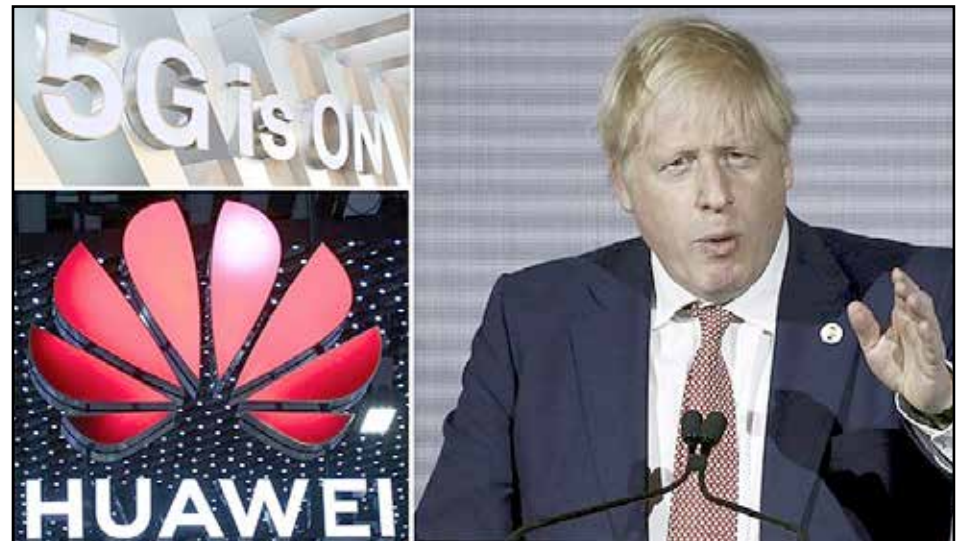
insisted the decision will not threaten the UK's role in the so-called "Five Eyes" intelligence partnership with the US, Canada, Australia and New Zealand.

Senior officials believe rival tech firms would currently struggle to build on the Huawei technology that is already widespread in the UK's 4G network.

Announcing the decision to MPs, Foreign Secretary Dominic Raab said: "Nothing in this review affects this country's ability to share highly sensitive intelligence data over highly secure networks, both within the UK and with our partners, including the Five Eyes."

Mr Raab said the Government's intelligence and security monitoring post GCHQ had "categorically confirmed that how we construct our 5G and full-fibre public networks has nothing to do with how we share classified data".

Tory backbencher Richard Drax told him: "Bearing in mind we're under constant cyber attack by China, I'm baffled by its decision today and particularly with 5G."

Union boss Len bids 'good riddance' to Labour moderates

UNION baron Len McCluskey has told moderate Labour MPs to quit the party now if they object to a Corbynista candidate winning its leadership race.

Unite's general secretary dismissed critics of Rebecca Long Bailey, a close ally of the outgoing leader, and said "good riddance" to anyone who leaves if she wins. Mr McCluskey, whose union is Labour's biggest donor, said it was "disgraceful" that centrists objected to the shadow business secretary taking over at the top.

"Now if people haven't learnt that the British electorate do not like a divided party and want to continue the divisions after this leadership election, then frankly they would be better to clear out now rather than mess us about," he told BBC Radio 5 Live.

He said "good riddance" to those who would rather quit than serve under Ms Long Bailey, who Unite has endorsed.

Appearing on the BBC's Andrew Marr Show, Mr McCluskey acknowledged Labour's

response to anti-Semitism allegations could have been better. "I'm absolutely convinced that there were those individuals who opposed Jeremy Corbyn's election right from the beginning, used the anti-Semitism issue – which I think is quite despicable that they did this on such an important subject – to undermine Corbyn, there's no doubt about that."

Ms Long Bailey and rivals Lisa Nandy and Emily Thornberry continued their campaign on Sunday with a leadership debate in Nottingham. Ms Thornberry pleaded with members to ask their constituency parties to back her after she failed to win the crucial union support needed to make it through to the final stage. Unless she wins

endorsements from at least 33 local party groups she will be kicked out of the race. Ms Nandy is already through to the final round and Ms Long Bailey is expected to make it into the vote.

Frontrunner Sir Keir Starmer made an ambitious speech in London calling for a federal system to dramatically redistribute power. Ahead of the event, he said: "The status quo is not working. People are crying out for more control, power and say over their own lives and local communities. This can't be delivered by tinkering around the edges or with short-term fixes.

"We need to end the monopoly of power in Westminster and spread it across every town, city, region and nation of the United Kingdom."

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Jetting Prince flies into climate change row

PRINCE Charles is facing embarrassment after it emerged he took a series of private jet flights while lecturing world leaders about climate change.

During a trip to the World Economic Forum in Davos last week, the Prince met activist Greta Thunberg after using an electric car to travel through the Alps to the Swiss ski resort. But analysis revealed that in the 11 days before his appearance, the heir to the throne took three flights on private jets and one on a helicopter.

After a speech urging world leaders to take "bold and imaginative" action to solve the environmental crisis, he took a fourth private jet from Switzerland to Israel. Taking into account an additional five so-called "empty-leg" flights to move planes around the globe to collect the Prince, his private jet and helicopter travel totalled more than 16,000 miles in less than a fortnight at an estimated cost to the taxpayer of £280,000. According to experts, the Prince's planes will have emitted more than 162 metric tons of carbon – 18 times an average Briton's annual total. The string of flights began on January 11 when a Bombardier Global Express flew 944 miles from Austria to collect the Prince from his Birkhall residence in Scotland. It took him 3,765 miles to Muscat, Oman, where he attended the funeral of Sultan Qaboos bin Said. Last Wednesday, the Prince flew 750 miles by private jet from Scotland to Switzerland for the Davos summit. Later that day he travelled 1,740 miles to Israel.

Palace officials said a private jet was chosen for security reasons.

Nicholas Parsons, veteran TV and radio host, dies at 96

Nicholas Parsons, the veteran TV presenter and actor, died this week at the age of 96.

Although most famous to TV viewers as presenter of the iconic 1970s quiz show *Sale of the Century*, he was better known both before, and after, as the long-serving chairman of *Just a Minute* on Radio 4, a panel game in which contestants had to speak on a subject for 60 seconds without hesitation, repetition or deviation. In half a century he missed only one show.

The secret of the show's survival for more than 900 programmes from its debut in 1967 lay in the simplicity of the rules and the good humour in which it was generally played. "The essence of its success is having fun," Parsons once said. "A lot of intelligent grown-up people fooling around."

lack of guile

He was the arbiter of fair play, scattering bonus points on players who had made the audience laugh even if their challenge was incorrect, or promising to make amends later to a player who got a rough decision.

He was originally intended to be a panellist, but the comedian Jimmy Edwards stood down as chairman after realising that the recording day would clash with his polo matches. Parsons stepped in and quickly made the show his own.

With his extravagant heartiness and lack of guile, he was often ribbed by the panellists, particularly the mischievous Kenneth Williams, who rarely played by the rules, and, later, Paul Merton, who had a close off-mike relationship with Parsons despite being keen to tease him on air.

Parsons had a prickly relationship, though, with one of the show's longest-serving players, Clement Freud, who was a poor loser and considered the host too frivolous. One night in Edinburgh, furious after Parsons had docked him a point, Freud rounded on him; in his autobiography he wrote cattily that few other people would get "that much work with that amount of talent".

Parsons rose above it with grace, saying only that "working with [Freud] was far from easy".

The programme was known around the globe thanks to the World Service. It was particularly popular in India and in 2012 Parsons took the team to Mumbai and Bangalore for a documentary on India's *Just a Minute* fan clubs and to record two special programmes. "The trip was organised chaos," he said.

If *Just a Minute* formed the bedrock for more than half of his life, Parsons was a man of many parts. He preferred to be described simply as an "actor", but at different points in his career he was a cabaret artist, stand-up comedian, straight actor and game show host.

prickly and insecure

Parsons was born in Grantham, Lincolnshire, in 1923, and as a boy was dyslexic and had a bad stammer. Although he struggled to read, he developed an extremely good memory as well as a talent for mimicry and from an early age he was set on being an actor, even though his mother, Nell, said it was a trade "fit for drunks and lowlives".

Parsons qualified as a marine mechanical engineer, but he remained

set on the theatre and at the end of the war began to approach agents in London. He first appeared on the London stage in *The Hasty Heart* at the Aldwych Theatre in 1945. More West End roles were followed by stints in repertory. He performed as a stand-up comedian at the Windmill Theatre, braving an audience who had come not to see him, but the naked girls. He also developed a successful cabaret act, which he took to the Café de Paris and the Savoy Hotel.

From the late 1960s

he was a regular on *The Benny Hill Show*. As a comic actor Parsons had small supporting roles in a number of films, including *Happy is the Bride*, *Too Many Crooks*, *Carry On Regardless* and *Doctor in Love*. On stage, he appeared in such West End shows as the long-running French comedy *Boeing-Boeing* and the Brian Rix farce *Uproar in the House*.

His unexpected popularity among students was crowned by three years (1988-91) as rector of the University

of St Andrews. He had a passion for cricket, played for the Lord's Taverners and was president of the charity from 1998 to 2000. He was also involved with the Water Rats, the theatrical charity, *Childline* and the British Stammering Association.

Although he could be prickly and insecure at times, Parsons was, on the whole, an affable and optimistic man. "I am by nature positive and upbeat," he said, "which is why I love my job so much. It is all about engaging with other people and making them laugh."

Man convicted of Magna Carta theft attempt

A serial thief has been found guilty of trying to steal a copy of Magna Carta after his carefully planned raid of Salisbury cathedral was foiled by staff and visitors.

Mark Royden, 47, from Canterbury, Kent, used a hammer to smash the protective case containing the medieval document on October 25, 2018 before his escape was stopped by shocked tourists and workmen.

He failed to break through the 800-year-old document's reinforced glass case with a claw hammer and was tackled by "good-spirited" American tourists and local stonemasons.

After Royden's conviction at Salisbury crown court for criminal damage and attempted theft on Monday, it emerged that he had 23 previous convictions for 51 offences, the majority of which were for theft with some including criminal damage.

Nicholas Cotter, for the defence, said

Royden has served jail terms in the past and is a "man with difficulties" who requires a carer, adding that attempting to steal Magna Carta was a "gross escalation" from his previous crimes.

The court heard that Royden believed the historic document was a fake, and set off a fire alarm moments before the raid to cause panic inside the cathedral, having carefully scouted the site's layout.

Wearing gloves, goggles and a hoodie to hide his identity, he had familiarized himself with security cameras and doors for his entry and exit routes and even tampered with a CCTV camera to avoid being detected.

After being restrained by staff and visitors during his escape, he later gave police a bizarre prepared statement and suggested the 800-year-old document was not authentic.

The would-be thief was convicted after a four-day trial.

Harry loses paper complaint

The Duke of Sussex has lost a complaint against *The Mail on Sunday*, the newspaper the duchess is suing separately over an alleged breach of privacy.

The duke complained that an article about his pictures of African wildlife was inaccurate.

However, the Independent Press Standards Organisation (Ipsos) ruled that the article was not "significantly misleading" or inaccurate.

The article, published on April 28 last year, was about photographs published on the couple's Instagram account to highlight Earth Day. Under the headline "Drugged and tethered . . . what Harry didn't tell you about those awe-inspiring wildlife photos", the article said that the duke's pictures of a rhino, elephant and lion "don't quite tell the whole story".

It went on: "Anyone glancing at them quickly could be left with the impression that capturing images of these mighty creatures at such close quarters would have required a thrilling -

possibly life-endangering - pursuit across the bush."

Instead, it said, all three had been stunned by a tranquilliser. The elephant had also been tethered, but because of the way the picture was edited, the Instagram picture did not reveal the rope around its hind legs.

The duke complained to Ipsos that the article was inaccurate because it reported that he had intentionally misled the public to give the impression that he was a superior wildlife photographer who had captured the images in dangerous circumstances.

Instead, the duke said, the pictures were meant to raise awareness, and the caption made clear the animals were being relocated as part of conservation efforts. Because of that, it was not necessary to spell out that they had been sedated or tethered, as this would be understood by readers.

The full uncropped photograph had been published on the royal family website in 2016, Harry added.

He also argued that the image of the elephant had been cropped owing to the formatting requirements of Instagram, and the

only alternative would have been to edit out the handler.

The newspaper argued that Harry had posted the pictures on his Instagram account without explaining the circumstances. It also disputed his insistence that it was necessary to crop the picture, saying that his preference for a border around the picture was a presentational choice.

Ipsos said that "it was not clear from the images themselves that the animals had been tranquillised and tethered".

UK mercy dash for Brits stranded in China

British nationals trapped in Coronavirus-stricken Wuhan were set to return home after a dramatic intervention by the Foreign Office.

A specially-chartered flight carrying 150 Britons and 50 EU citizens, most thought to be Spanish, was scheduled to leave Wuhan late Thursday night, said Foreign Secretary Dominic Raab.

They were expected to fly to RAF Brize Norton before the UK nationals are taken to be quarantined at a centre believed to be Arrowe Park Hospital in the Wirral.

The remaining passengers will be flown to another EU airport.

The World Health

Organization (WHO) has declared an international public health emergency over the outbreak.

And the UK's four chief medical officers have said they were raising the risk level from low to moderate.

"This does not mean we think the risk to individuals in the UK has changed at this stage, but that government should plan for all eventualities," a joint statement said.

They added that it was "likely" there would be "individual" cases of coronavirus in the UK.

But they said they were confident the health services would be able to protect the public and

provide high quality care. The virus has caused 170 deaths and spread to 15 other countries.

So far, 7,834 cases of the virus have been confirmed worldwide, with 7,736 in China, the WHO said. As of Wednesday, 161 tests have been carried out on people across the UK - all with negative results.

Passengers flying from Wuhan, the centre of the coronavirus outbreak, were checked by Chinese officials at a handling centre in the airport, before being taken to the departure area where they were met by British officials.

Wirral West MP Margaret Greenwood

said she was told by the health secretary that the government did not think any of the people being flown back from Wuhan would be carrying the virus.

UK passengers were expected to be put in "supported isolation" for 14 days with "all necessary medical attention", a Downing Street spokesman said.

The flight had been due to leave Wuhan earlier but was delayed because of a lack of clearance from Chinese authorities.

In a statement, Mr Raab said: "The safety and security of British nationals is our top priority.

"Our embassy in

Beijing and consular teams remain in close contact with British nationals in the region to ensure they have the latest information they need."

Britons have told of family members with Chinese citizenship being not being permitted to travel by local authorities.

Matt Raw lives in Wuhan with his mother, who has Alzheimer's disease, and his wife - who helps care for her. He told the BBC's Victoria Derbyshire programme his spouse had been prevented from flying so the whole family was staying.

He said they were also concerned about the risks of flying, having seen

reports that three Japanese people on evacuation flights were found to have the virus.

Adam Bridgeman said he would stay in Wuhan if his wife and one-month-old son were not allowed to fly with him.

He told BBC Radio 4's Today programme that remaining in Wuhan with a newborn was "a tough situation" as they were "not willing to take the risk" of bringing him to hospital for routine treatment such as vaccinations.

Hundreds of foreign nationals are being evacuated from Wuhan, with Japan, the US and the EU among those repatriating their citizens.

Corrie's Neville Buswell passes away at 77

■ Actor was Las Vegas resident

Coronation Street has paid tribute to actor Neville Buswell, who played womaniser Ray Langton in the ITV soap in the 1960s and 70s.

Buswell, who has died at the age of 77, starred as Deirdre Barlow's first husband and the father of her troubled daughter Tracy.

He joined Corrie in 1966 and was a regular on the cast before being written out in 1978.

A statement from the show said they were "saddened" to hear of his death.

The news was first reported in an obituary by a funeral home in Las Vegas. He had moved to the US city after leaving the cobbles.

Buswell made a cameo appearance as Ray in the one-off Coronation Street special Viva Las Vegas in 1997.

He then returned for a six-week stint in 2005, which ended with his character dying of lung cancer at Deirdre and Ken's second wedding.

A Coronation Street spokeswoman said: "His portrayal of Deirdre's first husband Ray Langton in the 1970s made him a part of Coronation Street history.

"We were delighted when he returned to the role in 1997 for a special DVD set in Vegas and again back in 2005 when Ray turned up on the cobbles to visit Deirdre and his daughter Tracy.

"We would like to extend our sympathies to his family and friends at this sad time."

According to the Palm Eastern Mortuary & Cemetery, he died on Christmas Day and the funeral was held on 3 January. The cause of death is unknown.

Buswell was first seen in Corrie in 1966 and began a 10-year run on the soap from 1968.

His character had many affairs during his time on the Street, but it was his fling with waitress Janice Stubbs that finally killed his marriage.

Ray wanted to start afresh in Amsterdam with his wife and daughter, but Deirdre decided to stay in Weatherfield.

In 2012, in real life, Buswell faced allegations of sexually assaulting a 12-year-old girl in his dressing room in the 1960s.

Buswell denied the claims as "not true" and said he had never met or heard of the woman behind them.

Buswell was born in 1943 in Chapel-en-le-Frith, Derbyshire, and began his acting career on the stage, performing in Gilbert and Sullivan operettas and plays.

After leaving Coronation Street, he moved to the US, where he worked in the casino business before becoming a mortgage broker.

Last fighter ace of Battle of Britain dead at 101

The last fighter ace of the Battle of Britain has died, leaving only two of The Few alive.

Wing Commander Paul Farnes died peacefully at his home in Hampshire on Tuesday morning at the age of 101.

Mr Farnes, a hurricane pilot, was one of 3,000 Allied airmen who fought in the Battle of Britain and was the last surviving ace — a pilot who had brought down five or more enemy aircraft.

He had fought in the Battle of France and the Battle of Britain before going on to defend Malta and serve in North Africa and Iraq.

He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Medal, the highest honour for non-officers, and was the only airman fit enough last year to attend the annual memorial service on July 16.

Mr Farnes had joined the RAF volunteer reserve as war loomed in 1938 and he took the opportunity in July 1939 of spending six months with the regular RAF before converting to

Hurricanes and joining No 501 Squadron, based in Gloucestershire, on September 14.

He moved with the squadron to Bétheniville in France on May 10, 1940, and during the Battle of France managed to score one enemy aircraft destroyed, one possibly destroyed and two shared.

This proved to be a foretaste of his impressive tally in the Battle of Britain. His tally of six destroyed, one probably destroyed and six damaged during the

pivotal summer of 1940 led him to be awarded the Distinguished Flying Medal on October 22, 1940.

As the war ended, he was in command of two squadrons in the UK. He remained in the RAF until 1958, retiring as a squadron leader and retaining the rank of wing commander.

Mr Farnes later ran a hotel in Worthing, West Sussex. He leaves a daughter, Linda, and son, Jonathan. Another son, Nicholas, died in 1954.

The great-grandfather recently said of his fellow pilots: "I don't think the average chap was brave at all. He was trained to do a job and did it well."

Of his part in the battle, he said: "It was just part of my life. I've got no particular feelings about it, I quite enjoyed it really."

Now only Flight Lieutenant William Clark, 100, and Flying Officer John Hemingway, 100, remain of the young men who defeated the Luftwaffe.

Scotch sold as Japanese as global demand soars

Large quantities of Scotch are being bought by Far Eastern drinks firms and repackaged as Japanese whisky to feed the global demand for the Asian spirit.

Some industry executives believe this "whisky laundering" is misleading consumers but as rules on what constitutes Japanese whisky are extremely weak the practice is entirely legal.

Export volumes to Japan have more than trebled between 2013 and 2018 to stand at the equivalent of 50.5 million bottles. Data for 2019 is to be published next month and is expected to show a further upsurge.

It comes as stocks of genuine Nippon-made whisky have dwindled after production was suspended or scaled back during previous market downturns in the 1990s and around the turn of the century.

Much of the bulk Scotch is thought to end up in supermarkets in low-end products labelled as Japanese whisky for consumption in that country.

But some Scotch producers are concerned about the practices of so-called "teaspoon distillers" which are typically targeting a more premium market.

They are thought to be pouring a small amount

of Japanese whisky into a cask of Scotch, bottling it and then calling it a product of Japan.

Canadian whiskies are also understood to be used in the process.

One Scotch industry executive suggested this was an open secret and said: "It is a worry that we are hearing of companies buying Scotch then effectively just repackaging it as Japanese."

"I'm not sure that is good for consumers as there is a lack of transparency."

Tatsuya Minagawa, who used to work as the European brand ambassador for Suntory, a Japanese brewing

and distilling group, but now runs The Highlander Inn in the village of Craiggellachie on Speyside, condemned the practice.

He said: "The biggest problem is that Japanese producers are bringing in Scotch and then calling it Japanese whisky."

"So even if it is 100 per cent Scotch they can put a label on it and sell it as Japanese. It is not right is it?"

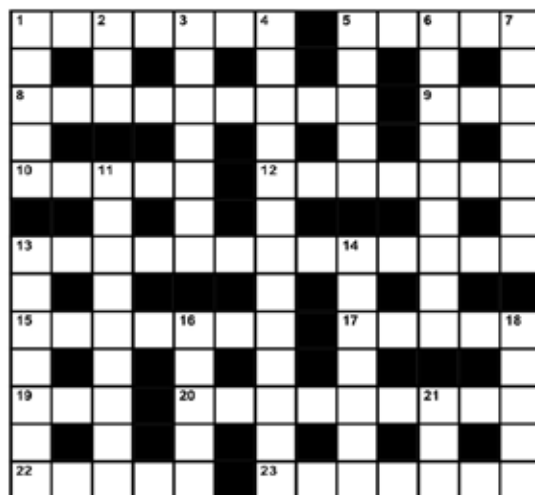

England surge to win and clinch series victory

Fourth Test, Johannesburg, (day four of five):

England 400 (Crawley 66; Nortje 5-110) & 248 (Root 58, Hendricks 5-64)

South Africa 183 (De Kock 76, Wood 5-46) & 274 (Van der Dussen 98, Wood 4-54)

England won by 191 runs

England surged to a 191-run win in the fourth Test against South Africa on Monday to complete a 3-1 series victory - only their second overseas success in four years.

After setting the home side an unlikely 466 to win, the tourists were frustrated by 98 from Rassie van der Dussen, who added 92 with Faf du Plessis.

But they were dismissed in successive overs by Ben Stokes and Mark Wood just before tea to leave South Africa 187-4, then Stuart Broad accelerated England's charge with two wickets in as many overs after the break.

The retiring Vernon Philander was the first to fall in a final collapse of 4-14 to 274 all out, Wood

taking the last wicket to end with 4-54 in the innings and nine in the match.

It gives England three wins on a tour of South Africa for the first time since 1913-14 and also means they have won three successive Test series against the Proteas.

Joe Root's side close the gap on second-placed Australia in the World Test Championship, a deficit they can cut further on the two-Test tour of Sri Lanka in March.

Before then, England

play one-day cricket for the first time since winning last year's World Cup with three matches against South Africa that are followed by three Twenty20s.

The way England ended this series, celebrating in the sunshine to the soundtrack of retiring Barmy Army trumpeter Billy Cooper, was such a contrast to the mood at the beginning of the tour, when mounting problems left them in disarray.

Stokes' father was admitted to a Johannesburg hospital in a serious condition and the majority of the squad were hit by illness before or during the heavy first Test defeat at Centurion Park. Immediately after that, opener Rory Burns' tour was ended by ankle injury sustained playing football.

However, despite losing James Anderson, Jofra Archer and Jack Leach to more injury and illness, England slowly asserted their dominance and showed themselves

to be vastly superior to a Proteas side in transition.

Most pleasing for the tourists will be the emergence of a number of young players - batsmen Dom Sibley, Zak Crawley and Ollie Pope, along with spinner Dom Bess, all impressed at various points.

Wood also returned to Test cricket with pace and menace, and with Root looking more assured than any other point in his tenure as captain, there are plenty of reasons for England to look to the future with optimism.

As South Africa's chase of what would have been a Test record began on the fourth morning, England had two full days to take

the 10 wickets required for victory.

In conditions offering little signs of sideways movement and with South Africa showing periods of resistance, there were times when it looked like England would have to return on Tuesday.

Each member of their five-strong pace attack was excellent, but when variety was required and with no frontline spinner to call upon, part-timers Root and Joe Denly were flayed.

Just when Van der Dussen and Du Plessis were set to take their stance into the evening, and with Du Plessis engaged in some verbal sparring with the

England fielders, Stokes, as ever, provided the inspiration. The all-rounder, generating 90mph pace, hit a crack and bowled the home captain via the toe of the bat.

In the next over, Wood went round the wicket and drew Van der Dussen into a drive to short cover. From there, the four-day win was in sight.

England captain Joe Root said of the win: "The sky's the limit for us. We're at the start of something. It's been a real squad effort. We've got to keep learning. It's been a fantastic tour for our development as a Test team. It's very exciting."

Transfer spending by Premier League clubs in January increased from last year after two big deals were confirmed on the penultimate day of the winter window.

Manchester United have completed the biggest deal so far, signing Portuguese midfielder Bruno Fernandes from Sporting Lisbon for £47m, while Sheffield United brought in Norwegian midfielder Sander Berge from Belgian side Genk for a club record fee, reported to be £22m.

At press time with just one day remaining, the total outlay by top-flight clubs stands at £185.1m, an increase from the £180m spent last year, but a long way off the £430m record from 2018.

started in a determined fashion and limited Liverpool to few chances until Issa Diop's foul on Divock Origi allowed Salah to put the visitors ahead from a penalty and their first shot on target.

And while Manuel Lanzini's scuffed close-range shot and Robert Snodgrass' hurried effort represented good opportunities for the hosts, Oxlade-Chamberlain's goal ensured a comfortable conclusion to the evening for Klopp's side, who could have scored again when Salah hit the post from 18 yards.

"They're as good as there's been around," Moyes said. "It's very difficult when you've been manager of Everton and Manchester United

to say that but Liverpool are an excellent side."

It is now almost impossible to ignore the huge gap at the top of the Premier League between Liverpool and their rivals that this victory only served to enhance.

But if you were, it would be the manner of this Liverpool victory that suggests they appear certainties to win the Premier League.

Like in recent victories against Tottenham, Manchester United and Wolves, Klopp's side were far from their best.

While they dominated possession they showed little end product until Salah's penalty but it was still good enough to deliver a 23rd victory from 24 matches - taking them to 70 points before January is out.

Virgil van Dijk and Joe Gomez were barely troubled in defence

while Jordan Henderson provided a controlling presence in midfield.

At times it appeared as though they were playing within themselves, until the moment arose for an incisive break forward, where their greater quality really showed.

Oxlade-Chamberlain's right-foot strike into the bottom left corner was the perfect demonstration, with Henderson initiating the move from a West Ham corner before Salah's superb outside of the boot pass bisected a couple of home defenders to send the England midfielder through on goal.

Klopp's side have now beaten every team in the Premier League this season at least once and were serenaded from the field by the club's jubilant and expectant fans at the final whistle.

Fernandes pledges 'everything' to United

Bruno Fernandes says he will give "everything" to bring "success and trophies" to Manchester United after joining on a five-and-a-half year deal from Sporting Lisbon.

The midfielder, 25, has joined for 55m euros (£47m) but add-ons could increase the overall cost to 80m euros (£67.7m).

"For me to now play for Manchester United feels incredible," said Portuguese international

Fernandes.

Manager Ole Gunnar Solskjaer said the midfielder was a "fantastic addition".

Fernandes' move is the biggest in the Premier League so far during the January transfer window - with the deadline at 23:00 GMT on Friday. He follows Cristiano Ronaldo, Nani and Marcos Rojo in joining Manchester United from Sporting.

His deal, which runs

until 2025, also has an option to extend for a further year.

"My love of Manchester United really started when I used to watch Cristiano Ronaldo play and ever since then I have been a big fan of this great club," added Fernandes.

Joy for Smith as Villa book final berth

■ Trezeguet late show stuns Foxes in Carabao Cup

Aston Villa manager Dean Smith says he would be "a very proud man" if he could lead his boyhood club to Carabao Cup glory after Trezeguet's injury-time goal against Leicester City sent them to Wembley.

Tuesday night's semi-final second leg at Villa Park had entered four minutes of stoppage time and penalties were looming when substitute Ahmed Elmohamedy sent over a superb cross for Trezeguet to drill a far-post finish across Leicester keeper Kasper Schmeichel.

It sparked wild scenes of joy and a pitch invasion at Villa Park, as the hosts reached their first showpiece final since the FA Cup in 2015, when they lost 4-0 to Arsenal.

Villa - who face Manchester City in the final - were indebted to goalkeeper Orjan Nyland for a string of magnificent first-half saves that allowed them to go in

at the interval leading through Matt Targett's 12th-minute strike.

And the hosts were enjoying their best spell of the game when Kelechi Iheanacho turned in Harvey Barnes' cross with 18 minutes left, leaving the momentum with Brendan Rodgers' side.

But Trezeguet's late intervention means Smith's side will be in their first EFL Cup final since 2010, when they lost to Manchester United.

"I certainly let myself go when we scored that goal," said Smith.

"We know how good Leicester are, and have been this season, but we made it an entertaining game, so I'm very proud of the performance and the effort that the players put in.

"We've got a proud history in this competition and if we could go and lift this trophy for a sixth time as a club then I would be a very proud man.

"We know it's going to be tough But the

hard part is getting to a domestic cup final and we have managed to do that against a very good Leicester team."

Villa had two standout performers on this glory night as the hosts produced a finale that left Leicester with no chance of a comeback in the dying seconds of a thunderous encounter.

Nyland formed a one-man barrier against a barrage of Leicester attacks as the Foxes went for the kill in the first half.

The 29-year-old Norwegian produced an astonishing string of saves, particularly two low down from James Maddison and arguably the best of all when he touched Yuri Tielemans' rising drive on to the bar.

"We are indebted to Orjan, who made three great saves. He was really top drawer," said Smith. "He's certainly given me a conundrum [about who to start in the final] but it's the type of decision I want."

Klopp cautious as Reds go 19 points clear

Liverpool manager Jurgen Klopp doesn't feel as "though anything is done" despite his side reaching 70 points before the end of January and moving 19 points clear at the top of the Premier League.

Mohamed Salah's first-half penalty and Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain's second-half effort delivered a 23rd victory in 24 matches for the Reds at West Ham on Wednesday night.

And their 15th consecutive win also maintained the relentless march towards a first top-flight title since 1990.

However, while Liverpool, who are now unbeaten in 41 league games and could go on to reach several top-flight milestones, Klopp played down their

significance.

Backed by vociferous crowd inside London Stadium, the hosts

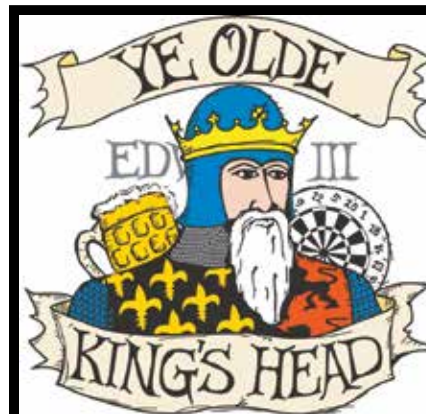


COMETH THE HOUR? Trezeguet is mobbed after his late winner on Tuesday

Grealish should have set up a debut goal for £8.5m striker Mbwana Samatta, who somehow failed to even get a touch on his cross from six yards out with the goal at his mercy. Samatta, who was substituted, will have
