# Rishi dishes up his £30bn budget of hope

RISHI Sunak paved the way for Britain's recovery this week with an audacious £30 billion spending splurge.

The Chancellor's mini-Budget included a jobs plan,

a VAT reduction, a stamp duty holiday and eatingout discounts to get the country spending amid the easing of coronavirus restrictions. He promised to protect employment while warning that hardship lies ahead for many after the lockdown shrank the economy by a quarter.

And Mr Sunak pledged: "No one will be left without hope."

Measures to support jobs include a £1,000 bonus to firms for every employee brought back to work from the Government's furlough scheme and a £2billion package to tackle youth unemployment.

To boost the housing market, the Chancellor announced an immediate stamp duty holiday to save buyers an average of £4,500.

And in a surprise move, he slashed VAT for hospitality and tourism firms from 20 per cent to five per cent, which could save hundreds of pounds on staycations.

The tax cut will apply to accommodation as well as food and nonalcoholic drinks from restaurants and pubs until January 12, 2021. It will also mean savings at hotels, caravan and campsites plus attractions such as cinemas and theme parks. The Government will be offering eating-out vouchers, worth up to £10 a head, during August.

Mr Sunak, who visited Wagamama at the Royal Festival Hall on London's South Bank on Wednesday, surprised diners by serving their meals.

Unveiling his support plans later, he said "people's fortitude and endurance" will be called upon.

He told MPs: "People are anxious about losing their job, about unemployment rising.

# Tuck in! Boost for restaurants with 'eat in to help out' program

Diners are to be given during August. The total half-price discounts on eating out through an innovative government scheme to fill restaurants.

## Threat of revenge porn 'must be crime'

**THREATS** to post revenge porn should also be a crime says a domestic abuse charity, as it revealed one in seven young women has been threatened.

Women aged 18 to 34 are most likely to have intimate or sexual photos of them shared or posted online against their will and the number of threats are rising, the charity said.

Refuge, which offers support for women and children experiencing domestic violence, conducted a survey of 2,060 people.

Sharing an intimate image already

considered a crime. But one in seven young women and one in nine young men in England and Wales had experienced threats, it found.

Eight in 10 (83 per cent) of the women who received threats said their mental health and wellbeing suffered and more than 10 per cent said they felt suicidal. While 60 per cent of those who experienced threats were aged under 40, around one in eight was in her

Refuge's The Naked Threat campaign is calling for the Government to make threats to share

intimate images or videos a crime and to consider revenge porn as a type of domestic abuse. The charity says 27 per cent of young men and 43 per cent of young women have shared images. Its head of policy and public affairs, Ellie Butt, said: "The law needs to recognise that threats to share these images cause serious harm, regardless of whether the threat is then carried out."

Government spokesman said: "We have asked the Law Commission to make sure our laws are keeping pace with these evolving crimes"

# Auntie to Oldies: no more free TV for you

The BBC is to go ahead with a plan to end free TV licences for most over-75s, after a two-month delay because of the coronavirus pandemic.

That means more than three million households will be asked to start paying the £157.50 fee from 1 August.

Only those who receive the Pension Credit benefit will be exempt.

The BBC said the new scheme is "the fairest decision", but the government said it was "the wrong decision" and Age UK called it "a kick in the teeth".

#### 'bitterly disappointed'

The controversial change was originally due to be made on 1 June, and the BBC said the delay had cost £35m a month.

The cost of continuing to provide free licences to all over-75s could have reached £1bn a year over time with an ageing population, according to the corporation.

BBC Chairman Sir David Clementi said the decision had "not been easy", but the broadcaster is under "under severe financial pressure" and a further delay would have had an impact on programmes.

The BBC has previously

warned that making no changes would have led to "unprecedented closures" of services.

It has also previously said it must make an extra £125m savings this year as a result of the pandemic, including the cost of delaying the over-75s changes.

Free TV licences for the over-75s have been provided by the government since 2000, but responsibility for the provision was passed to the BBC as part of its last licence fee settlement.

The Age UK charity said it was "bitterly disappointed", describing the move as "a kick in the teeth for millions of over-75s who have had a torrid time during this crisis".

More than 630,000 people signed an Age UK petition when the BBC first announced the plan in 2019. The charity has now urged the BBC and the government to "urgently sit down and agree on a solution to keep TV licences free".

#### 'frustating'

Age UK charity director Caroline Abrahams said many older people would either have to give up their TV, which is "more of a lifeline than ever", or other essential purchases.

"Everyone needs to understand that under the BBC's scheme many hundreds of thousands of the poorest pensioners will be facing a bill they will simply be unable to afford to pay," she said.

Prime Minister Boris Johnson's spokesman said the BBC had made the "wrong decision", and the government believes the licence fees in question "should be funded by the BBC".

Culture minister Matt Warman said the move was "deeply frustrating".

But Labour's shadow culture secretary Jo Stevens said: "The refusal of the government to fund this vital service after promising to do so is nothing short of betrayal.

"Many over-75s have spent months at home with TV providing an invaluable source of company during the pandemic. For the government to blame the BBC who are having to contend with huge cuts is simply passing the buck."

Julian Knight MP, Conservative chairman of the House of Commons culture select committee, called the situation "a mess" and said the new regime would be "a body blow to millions of British pensioners".

# 'No exit strategy' for Prince Andrew

# ■ As Ghislaine Maxwell is detained by FBI, net starts to close on embattled Prince

LONDON:  $\mathbf{As}$ the lurid headlines swirl in the wake of the arrest of Jeffrey longtime Epstein's confidant Ghislaine Maxwell. **auestions** again are surging over what comes next for Prince Andrew, who is caught up in the highprofile affair.

daughter Maxwell. of the late publisher and arms dealer Robert Maxwell, is behind bars at a detention center in Brooklyn, New York, and is expected to appear in court in New York next Tuesday, having been arrested in New Hampshire last week. She will face charges on four counts in connection with the trafficking of a minor for criminal sexual activity and two counts of perjury.

#### scandal

Maxwell, 58, has not entered a plea, but has long denied any wrongdoing. Her attorney declined to comment after her arrest.

Meanwhile, the scandal that has for years dogged Andrew, 60, the second son of Queen Elizabeth II, does not appear to be going away.

"It's a bit of a nightmare at the moment," British public relations agent Mark Borkowski said this week. "He's inextricably linked with this story, there is no exit strategy."

Borkowski said much now rests on exactly what Maxwell tells U.S. authorities.

He suggested Andrew should either stay silent or invite U.S. authorities "to come and meet him on home turf" in the United Kingdom and make public that he's attempting to "take the heat off him" by explaining his relationship with both Epstein and Maxwell.

Andrew has acknowledged that he knew both Epstein and Maxwell, the disgraced financier's former girlfriend, but has denied any wrongdoing.

In a widely panned television interview with the BBC in the fall, Andrew said that he had been introduced to Epstein by Maxwell, and that he went to stay with him in New York

for four days in 2010. The trip was to break off the friendship, Andrew said, after Epstein served time for soliciting and procuring a minor for prostitution.

#### sovereign immunity

Andrew has also denied allegations that he had any form of sexual contact with Virginia Roberts Giuffre, who has repeatedly said she was trafficked by Epstein when she was 17 and directed to have sexual relations with the prince.

Andrew said that he had no recollection of ever meeting her — despite a widely circulated photograph showing the pair together.

Mark Stephens, a media lawyer at the London-based law firm Howard Kennedy LLP, who represented British cavalry officer James Hewitt after allegations of an affair with Princess Diana, said U.S. authorities were trying to "ensnare" the royal and that it was unlikely he would be extradited to the U.S.

Stephens said the principle of sovereign immunity — which makes certain individuals immune from prosecution — would make it difficult for Andrew to be summoned to the U.S.

If U.S. prosecutors wanted to gather information, they

could do so through written testimonies or prosecutors traveling to the U.K. to collect evidence, Stephens said. This was done recently when U.S. authorities came to speak to U.K.-based survivors of the convicted rapist and disgraced Hollywood mogul Harvey Weinstein.

Even if he was extradited to America, Andrew would be under "no obligation to give evidence," Stephens added. "You can subpoena someone to court, but you can't force someone to give evidence," he said, citing an individual's legal right to silence.

#### **CRICKET TEST** restarted in England this week with the First Test between England and the West Indies.

At press time on Thursday England had been dismissed for 204 in their first innings thanks to West Indies' captain Jason Holder's superb 6-42 on day two at an empty Southampton.

Holder, who at one stage took 3-1 in 14 deliveries, was backed up by 4-62 from the pacy Shannon Gabriel.

England were then not at their best with the ball, with West Indies moving to 57-1, 147 behind.

On a grey, murky day, the floodlights were on throughout, and bad light forced the close with 26.3 overs still remaining.

# Ryder Cup postponed for a year

## ■ "The spectators make it a unique and compelling event and playing without them was not a realistic option,"

The 2020 Ryder Cup has been postponed for a year because the coronavirus pandemic means the event cannot be staged safely with spectators present.

The match between the United States and Europe was due to be held at Whistling Straits, Wisconsin on 25-27 September.

But the biennial event has now been rescheduled for 24-26 September 2021.

"The spectators make it a unique and compelling event and playing without them was not a realistic option," said PGA of America chief Seth Waugh.

"It became clear that our medical experts and the public authorities in Wisconsin could not give us certainty that conducting an event responsibly with thousands of spectators in September would be possible.

"Given that uncertainty, we knew rescheduling was the right call."

Professional men's golf in the US has resumed behind closed doors but players have said the Ryder Cup should not go ahead without fans.

The women's Solheim Cup is scheduled to take place from 4-6 September, 2021 in Ohio and LPGA commissioner Mike Whan has told BBC Sport that the Ryder Cup decision does not affect their plans.

The European Tour announced that the qualification process for the European team has been frozen until the beginning of 2021.

And the next Ryder

Cup to be held in Europe has been pushed back a year with Rome now set to host the event in 2023.

Europe captain Padraig Harrington said it was a "relief" that organisers decided to postpone the competition.

"For me, it was very messy behind the scenes," the 48-year-old Irishman said.

"The decision was based on health and safety, but trying to get organised behind the scenes, it was going to be incredibly difficult to pull a team together that was fair and representative, and all the complications that go with it.

"For example, what happens if a player gets Covid? What happens if there's a cluster? Do players have to quarantine?"



The last time the Ryder Cup was postponed was in 2001 because of the 11 September attacks in the US

Harrington also said that if the Ryder Cup went ahead without fans then it would have lost part of its character.

"The team atmosphere the crowd generate, that would've been missed," the three-time major winner added. "When you win in a tournament it's very exciting, but you don't get the same experience as you would at the Ryder Cup.

"I've seen over the years, the amount of players that come out of their shell in terms of their personality because of the crowds and that would be missed."

In 2018 Europe regained the trophy with a 17½-10½ win over USA in the 42nd edition of the biennial competition.

# We got it wrong - THREE TIMES - VAR tells BBC

Incorrect penalty decisions were made by the video assistant referee in all three of Thursday's games, the Premier League has told the BBC.

Bruno Fernandes won a spot-kick which he scored in Manchester United's 3-0 win over Aston Villa.

James Ward-Prowse hit the bar after a disputed penalty as Southampton drew 1-1 with Everton.

And Tottenham should have had a penalty for a Joshua King shove on Harry Kane in a 0-0 draw with Bournemouth.

The Premier League confirmed United and Southampton should not have been given penalties, but Tottenham should have been awarded one.

Former Everton midfielder Tim Cahill, a Match of the Day pundit, said a former player should be involved to work alongside the VAR at Stockley Park.

"I think that would really help them, to understand the movements," the former Australia international said

"When a player falls to buy a penalty you can feel it. It must need a player there to give advice on what the player is doing."

Tottenham manager Jose Mourinho said "everyone in the world" thought his side should have had a penalty, apart from video assistant referee Michael Oliver.

King pushed Kane in the back as he defended a cross but referee Paul Tierney did not award a penalty and Oliver chose not to intervene.

Oliver, who will referee Sunday's north London derby against Arsenal, was also the VAR official when Kane had a goal ruled out in Spurs' 3-1 defeat by Sheffield United last week.

"The game had the most important moment - you know when, you know who," said the Spurs boss.

Mourinho told said he feels "powerful people do not like to be criticised".
