# FERGIE 'SHOCK' AT NEW SKIN CANCER DIAGNOSIS

■ Upbeat Duchess "grateful for the many messages of love and support"

The Duchess of York has spoken of her "shock" at being diagnosed with malignant melanoma, a form of skin cancer, but is in "good spirits".

In an Instagram post, she said she was "grateful for the many messages of love and support".

The melanoma was discovered following the removal of a cancerous mole during treatment for breast cancer.

The duchess, Sarah Ferguson, had several moles removed and analysed while having reconstructive surgery.

The duchess is the third royal to announce a medical procedure this week.

"I have been taking some time to myself as I have been diagnosed with malignant melanoma, a form of skin cancer," she said on Instagram on Monday.

It was her second cancer diagnosis within a year after being diagnosed with breast cancer in the summer and having undergone a mastectomy and reconstructive surgery.

"Naturally another

cancer diagnosis has been a shock, but I'm in good spirits and grateful for the many messages of love and support."

On Sunday her spokesman had said: "Her dermatologist asked that several moles were removed and analysed at the same time as the duchess was undergoing reconstructive surgery following her mastectomy, and one of these has been identified as cancerous.

### mastectomy

She was undergoing further investigations to ensure this had been caught in the early stages, he added.

"She believes her experience underlines the importance of checking the size, shape, colour and texture and emergence of new moles that can be a sign of melanoma."

According to sources close to the duchess, she is back in the UK after

initially recuperating in Austria.

A second cancer diagnosis within six months is clearly a great challenge to deal with, say sources, but she is a resilient person and is getting the care and support of her family.

The duchess has shown a remarkable ability to bounce back from adversity.

Last year, she had a diagnosis of breast cancer, following a routine mammogram screening.

The duchess was very public about her treatment, urging other women to get checked and using her podcast to raise awareness about breast cancer, wanting it to be a positive message to save others.

She went on to have a single mastectomy at King Edward VII hospital in London, a private clinic used by senior royals.

In the autumn, in her latest career

reinvention, she made guest appearances as a presenter on ITV's This Morning, in a working life that has also seen her become a successful author.

And having not been invited to the Coronation in May, at Christmas the duchess appeared at Sandringham, walking to church with the rest of the Royal Family for the first time in more than 30 years.

The 64-year-old was married to the Duke of York, Prince Andrew, for 10 years before they divorced in 1996.

They continue to share a home at Royal Lodge - a property owned by the Crown Estate at Windsor Great Park.

They have two daughters - Princess Beatrice, 35, and Princess Eugenie, 33 - and three grandchildren.

On Wednesday, Kensington Palace confirmed that the Princess of Wales would stay in hospital for up to two weeks after undergoing planned abdominal surgery.

Kensington Palace said the procedure

was successful but that the princess was not expected to resume royal duties for months, and would remain in hospital for up to two weeks.

The palace did not disclose further details about Catherine's condition but said it was not cancer-related.

Shortly after that announcement, Buckingham Palace said the King would receive treatment for a benign prostate condition and would visit an undisclosed hospital in the coming days.

# Top General says Britain must train 'citizen army'

■ Army head says Russian threat means UK must modernize its forces and join other European nations on 'war footing'

Britain should train a "citizen army" ready to fight a war on land in the future, the head of the Army has said.

General Sir Patrick Sanders warned that an increase in reserve forces alone "would not be enough".

He highlighted the threat from Russia and pointed to steps being taken by other European nations to put their populations on a "war footing".

He also called for more to be done to equip and modernise the UK's armed forces.

In a speech at an armored vehicle conference, Gen Sir Patrick was not making an argument for conscription - where men of fighting age are required to enlist in the military - but rather laying the foundations for a voluntary call up if war broke out.

He talked about the need for the UK's "pre-war generation" to prepare for the possibility of war and said that was a "whole-of-nation undertaking".

This is not the first time Gen Sir Patrick has warned of the increasing threat of war and expressed concerns about

Britain's lack of readiness.

On Wednesday, the outgoing Chief of the General Staff (CGS) said Russia's war in Ukraine was about much more than seizing territory, saying it was about defeating our system and way of life.

He has already argued to reverse to recent cuts to the size of the Army. It is now a professional force of around 73,000, compared to around 100,000 in 2010.

In his speech he said Britain needed an army designed to expand rapidly.

"Within the next three years, it must be credible to talk of a British Army of 120,000, folding in our reserve and strategic reserve. But this is not enough," he said, as he also called for more to be done to modernise and equip the armed forces.

"We will not be immune and as the pre-war generation we must similarly prepare - and that is a whole-of-nation undertaking," he said. "Ukraine brutally illustrates that regular armies start wars; citizen armies win them.

"But we've been here before, and workforce alone does not create

capability."

He highlighted steps being taken in countries like Sweden and Finland - where the threat of Russia looms closer - to put their nations more on a war footing.

Other senior Nato military commanders have also recently been calling on the alliance to ready itself for a potential conflict.

Such warnings make politicians nervous.

In response to Gen Sir Patrick speech the UK prime minister's spokesman said hypothetical scenarios of a future potential conflict were not helpful and ruled out any move towards a conscription model for the Army.

One senior Conservative MP said he did not think Rishi Sunak had fully appreciated the threat posed by Russia.

The MP said that might be because the prime minister when growing up had not experienced the existential threat posed by the old Soviet Union during the Cold War era.

Gen Sir Patrick said the nation could not afford to make the same mistakes of 1914, when it failed to

perceive the escalations that led to World War One.

He said over the last 30 years the Army had halved in size, with a 28% reduction in the last 12 years, but added that despite challenges in recruitment applications

to join the Army were at the highest level in six years.

Gen Sir Patrick has been a vocal critic of cuts to troop numbers and military spending and will be replaced as CGS in June by General Sir Roly

Walker.

He has not been the only one to criticise cuts, with former CGS General Lord Dannatt saying the UK risked a repeat of the 1930s unless it invested more in its armed forces last week.

## Not on my watch!

■ Sunak dismisses claims Royal Mail will cut back deliveries to just 3 days a week

Rishi Sunak has insisted that Royal Mail will not slash its deliveries to just three days a week under his watch.

The Prime Minister said he is "absolutely committed" to ensuring the postal service continues six days a week, amid suggestions it could be dramatically scaled back.

Watchdog Ofcom has warned the national postal service risks becoming "unsustainable" without reform. This led to proposals that Royal Mail delivery schedules are cut in half.

But the PM was quick to rule out the controversial plan, telling the Commons yesterday he is determined the Monday to Saturday service continues.

Asked at Prime Minister's Questions if under his watch there will be reductions in postal services provided by Royal Mail, Mr Sunak said: "I agree about the importance of the Royal Mail's universal service obligation and we remain

absolutely committed to ensuring that it remains as it is."

Other options being considered by Ofcom include allowing Royal Mail more time - potentially up to five days - to deliver a letter.

Mr Sunak's official spokesman said the Government would "engage with" the watchdog's suggestions, taking part in a consultation on future service levels.

He added: "We will consider any proposals in the round, beyond what we have set out about the importance of Saturday deliveries and the need to provide certainty to many businesses that rely on them."

Asked whether there were any concerns Royal Mail could collapse without service reforms, the spokesman said: "I don't think that is the choice before us."

Any attempt to scale back postal rounds under the universal service obligation, which requires

six-day-a-week delivery to 32million addresses, will face fierce opposition.

Tina McKenzie, policy chair at the Federation of Small Businesses, said: "Trading essential services for short-term savings is a slippery slope that may compromise the trust small businesses place in Royal Mail.

"Considering that 25% of them rely on the postal service, these proposals could cause real disruption to our economy.

"They will not just impact the householder waiting for birthday cards or hospital appointments. Many have built their business operations around the postal service, from the cake seller who needs to send a last-minute topper, to letterbox flower companies which rely on next-day deliveries."

She said small firms cannot afford to switch to other courier services, which she claimed can cost 200% more than Royal Mail.



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# Sturgeon branded Boris a 'F\*\*\*\*\*g' clown for pandemic response

■ Covid inquiry hears damning testimony about Scottish leader's exasperation with former PM's 'utter incompetence'

Nicola Sturgeon called Boris Johnson a "clown" in an expletive-laden text conversation with her chief of staff, the UK Covid Inquiry has heard.

The inquiry was shown messages in which the former first minister described as "excruciating" a Downing Street announcement about a second Covid lockdown in England.

Ms Sturgeon said she was offended by Mr Johnson's "utter incompetence".

Her former aide said the language showed Ms

Sturgeon's "frustration".

Mr Johnson, who was prime minister during the pandemic, has said he had a "friendly" relationship with Ms Sturgeon.

It came as First Minister Humza Yousaf, who also gave evidence to the inquiry on Thursday, announced an externally-led review into the Scottish government's use of mobile messaging apps, conceding that there are "challenges" in relation to how the app is used in government.

He conceded that the handling of requests for

WhatsApp messages had not been the government's "finest hour" and had not given bereaved families confidence.

'pointless'

Liz Lloyd, who served as chief of staff and a strategic adviser to Ms Sturgeon between 2015 and 2023, said engagement with Mr Johnson became "pointless" in the early months of the pandemic.

Speaking at the inquiry - which is currently sitting in Edinburgh - she was shown messages from 31 October 2020 between

her and Ms Sturgeon on the same evening as Mr Johnson announced a fresh lockdown for England.

Ms Sturgeon said his address to the nation was "(expletive) excruciating" and that the UK government's communications were "awful".

She told Ms Lloyd: "His utter incompetence in every sense is now offending me on behalf of politicians everywhere."

Ms Lloyd then said she

was "offended" on behalf of all special advisers to which Ms Sturgeon replied: "He is a (expletive) clown."

Ms Lloyd told the inquiry the conversation was the result of "chaos" in the UK government.

She said the Scottish government had to "mitigate" that because although the restrictions did not apply in Scotland, they had an effect on how people north of the border viewed the pandemic.

"We were clearly not

very complimentary about their communications handling that day," she told the inquiry.

Asked if the relationship between Ms Sturgeon and Mr Johnson had broken down, Ms Lloyd replied: "I think broken down to a degree overstates what was there to break."

She said there was a "politeness" when the two leaders had previously met but the relationship became "much harder" during the pandemic.

## Laurie Johnson dies at 96

■ Prolific composer created iconic Avengers theme tune

Composer Laurie Johnson, who provided some of Britain's best loved television themes and film music, has died at the age of 96.

Johnson's memorable themes include The Avengers, The Professionals, Animal Magic, and This is Your Life.

The composer (pictured, right) also arranged instrumental versions of dozens of songs, which were used as production music.

His family said Johnson died last Tuesday, "leaving behind a legacy that will forever resonate in our hearts".

"Laurie's music touched the lives of millions around the world. Throughout his illustrious career, he composed numerous iconic scores, themes and soundtracks that graced our lives across film, TV, theatre and radio," they



said in a statement.

"We remember Laurie as an extraordinary individual who embraced life with passion and brought joy to so many. His kindness, compassion and infectious sense of fun and laughter will be profoundly missed by all that knew him."

Johnson died in his sleep, his family said.

They added that he was "dearly loved by many" and is "sorely

missed" by his wife, daughter, son-in-law and grandson.

Born in Hampstead, Johnson studied at the Royal College of Music and spent four years in the Coldstream Guards before he began working in the entertainment industry in the 1950s.

"I heard noises in my head from the moment I was born," he once told a reporter and he later named his memoir Noises in the Head.

## Britain battered by latest named storm

■ Power cuts galore as Isha brings 90mph winds, and torrential rains to northern areas

BRITAIN was left battered and bruised by another named winter storm this week, as Storm Isha left thousands of people without power after bringing heavy rain and winds up to 99mph.

Scotland, Northern Ireland, north-west England and Wales were all badly hit, and some in remote areas were left without power for several days.

Two people died, including a man in Scotland after the car he was in hit a fallen tree, and a man in Northern Ireland after a tree fell on his car.

And there is little prospect of a letup, with Storm Jocelyn approaching at the end of the week.

In the most exposed areas, Jocelyn - the 10th named storm since September - brought gusts of wind of between 55 and 65mph (89 and 105km/h) and with it, torrential rainfall.

Transport Scotland said a gust of 107mph was recorded on the Tay Bridge in Dundee. Parts of the UK experienced their strongest winds in more than a decade.

### airline havoc

And thousands of airline passengers across Europe woke up at the wrong destination - and even in the wrong country - after Isha caused havoc with flights, with dozens of cancellations, diversions and go-arounds in western Europe.

For those traveling to and from Ireland and the UK, flying became an odyssey. Airports in Ireland and the UK were badly hit by the storm, with gusts of up to 90 mph slicing across the runways.

Many aircraft heading

west diverted to safer landings in continental Europe, often having flown to the destination before failing to land. Ryanair was especially affected, since its base is Dublin, where a whopping 166 inbound and outbound flights were canceled on Sunday, according to Kevin Cullinane, group head of communications at daa, the operator of Dublin Airport.

The airport also saw 36 flight diversions and 34 go-arounds - where planes abandon landing mid-process and decide to 'go around' for another try.

The numbers explain the extraordinary scenes that unfolded as aircraft attempted to complete their flights to and from Ireland.

A Ryanair flight from Lanzarote, in the Canary Islands, to Dublin made it almost as far as the Irish capital, before turning around and diverting to Bordeaux, France, without attempting to land.

Another Ryanair flight, FR555, was meant to make a quick hop from Manchester to Dublin. After circling nearby in a holding pattern, it attempted to land at Dublin but made a go-around and diverted to Paris Beauvais. What's usually a half-hour flight became two-and-a-half hours.

Another Manchester-Dublin flight went back and forth between the UK and Ireland for over three hours, appearing to circle but abandon landing at Dublin, attempt to get on the ground at Belfast (where it made a go-around) and circling over Glasgow before landing in Liverpool - just 31 miles away from the departure airport.

## Salt In A Brew? That's just not our cup of tea!

■ American scientist is lambasted for her heretical ideas about improving the cuppa...and even the US Embassy weighs in

NOT since the Boston Tea Party has such outrage been brewed across the Atlantic.

The US Embassy in London felt obliged to state its position this week after an American scientist claimed a pinch of salt was the key to making the perfect cup of tea.

The embassy sought to reassure "the good people of the UK" with the statement: "The unthinkable notion of adding salt to Britain's national drink is not official United States policy. And never will be."

It called tea "the elixir of camaraderie, a sacred bond that unites

our nations. We cannot stand idly by as such an outrageous proposal threatens the very foundation of our Special Relationship."

But just when they were doing so well, they added: "The US Embassy will continue to make tea in the proper way - by microwaving it."

The diplomatic intervention came after chemistry professor

Michelle Franci, of Bryn Mawr College, Pennsylvania, said a small amount of salt, not enough to taste, helps cut bitterness.

The tip was included in Ms Franci's book *Steeped: The Chemistry of Tea*, published this week by the Royal Society of Chemistry.

Her work, the product of three years' research and experimentation,

"puts the chemistry to use with advice on how to brew a better cup," its publisher says.

And the saline suggestion had drawn howls of outrage from tea lovers.

"Don't even say the word 'salt' to us..." said etiquette guide *Debrett's on X*, formerly Twitter.

Yorkshire Tea piled in on Instagram, simply writing "No."

## Grieving mother speaks out as 'speedboat killer' goes free

A GRIEVING mother and father have spoken out in anger as "speedboat killer" Jack Shepherd was freed from jail after just five years - for killing their daughter.

Heartless Shepherd, 31, wined and dined Charlotte Brown, 24, after they met on website OkCupid.

### manslaughter

He then took her on a high speed ride on the River Thames past the Houses of Parliament in his speedboat in December 2015.

Both were thrown out due to defective steering, with Charlotte drowning as Shepherd cried out to rescuers "help me" - rather than "us".

Shepherd fled to Georgia and was jailed for manslaughter by gross negligence in his

absence in July 2018. He handed himself in 10 months later.

On Tuesday he was released from prison automatically after serving just half of his 10 year sentence.

Charlotte's heartbroken dad Graham Brown, 60, said: "He's never said what really happened. What he has said conflicts with what we know and what came out of the trial.

"The pure fact he took my daughter out on a speed boat at 10pm, without any life jackets, on a very dangerous stretch of the River Thames and accelerated up to 30 knots and then said it was her fault. This is his pattern of behaviour."

Insisting Shepherd should not have been freed so soon, he added: "She was a wonderful

daughter, so full of life. She had just got a promotion and was looking forward to doing her driving test."

Business consultant Charlotte's mum Roz Wickens, 58, said: "I will continue to want to know what happened on the fateful night Charlotte was taken away from us, but I don't think I ever will.

### 'true devastation'

"Only he knows what really happened as Charlotte cannot speak for herself.

"But if he came out with anything now, I wouldn't know if it was true because of all the stories he has told."

She added: "He will never know or fully understand the true devastation he has caused me and my family."

Shepherd, a former IT consultant who earned £150,000 a year, told police he had handed the controls of the speedboat to Charlotte just as the craft crashed and capsized near Wandsworth Bridge, London.

His trial heard how he bought vodka, before sharing two bottles of wine with London-based Charlotte at the Shard and downing champagne on his boat.

Shepherd - a self-styled Casanova who bought his speedboat to "pull women" - got married to someone else nine weeks after the tragedy.

A Ministry of Justice spokesperson said: "Offenders released on licence are kept under close supervision and subject to strict conditions for the remainder of their sentence."

# 100-year old statue of Captain Cook sawn off in Melbourne

■ Incident highlights growing activism among indigenous peoples against celebrating Australia Day - which they call "Invasion Day"

A century-old Captain James Cook statue has been cut down and a Queen Victoria monument covered in red paint in an apparent protest in Australia.

The late-night vandalism occurred in Melbourne on the eve of Australia Day and is under police investigation.

The holiday on 26 January is the anniversary of the 1788 landing of Britain's First Fleet at Sydney Cove and the start of the colonial

era. The vandals wrote "The colony will fall" on the Cook statue's plinth. Police said the "criminal damage" to both memorials happened in the early hours of Thursday.

"It is understood the [Cook] statue was sawn off at the ankles. Several people were seen loitering in the area around the time of the incident," Victoria Police said in a statement.

The 1914 monument - one of the Australia's

oldest of the British explorer-commemorates his 1768-1771 voyage during which he charted the country's east coast.

It has a history of being vandalised on or around 26 January. In 2022 it was splashed in red paint, while in 2018 it was graffitied with the words "no pride" and had an Aboriginal flag placed next to it.

Victorian Premier Jacinta Allan said the vandalism of both monuments had "no place in our community".

"We'll be working with council to repair and reinstate the statue in St Kilda," she added, referring to the suburb where it is located.

Work is also under way to clean the Queen Victoria memorial in the city's centre.

Port Phillip Mayor Heather Cunsolo said that while she understood the "diverse views surrounding Australia Day" she

could not condone "the vandalism of a public asset where costs will be ultimately borne by ratepayers".

She said her council had arranged for a security guard to protect the Cook statue on Thursday, but the incident occurred before they were scheduled to arrive.

Opinion polls show roughly 60% of Australians support

celebrating Australia Day on 26 January.

But many Indigenous Australians and others say it is wrong to celebrate a date which represents the theft of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander lands and their dislocation from culture.

"Invasion Day" protests have grown in recent years and many people boycott the holiday.

## Sunak: I'll bomb Houthis again if attacks continue

Rishi Sunak has warned there could be further bombing of Yemen if Houthi attacks on shipping continue, as he came under mounting pressure from MPs to clarify Britain's long-term strategy for tackling the deepening crisis.

The prime minister told parliament that a second round of RAF airstrikes, conducted on Monday night with the US, were taken in self-defence and rejected calls for MPs to be allowed a vote on whether to endorse the military action.

The Houthis, who control the north and west of Yemen, said on

Tuesday they would continue to fight on in support of Gaza, and told British and American aid workers to leave the part of the country they control within 30 days.

Sunak said the UK and the US "are not seeking a confrontation" with the Houthis, but complained that the group had conducted at least 12 attacks on western shipping since the first round of British and American airstrikes on 12 January.

That was sufficient to justify Monday night's bombing raid, which saw RAF Typhoons strike two targets near Sana'a,

the prime minister said, adding that the bombing of Yemen, one of the world's poorest countries, may continue.

"If necessary, the United Kingdom will not hesitate to respond again in self-defence," said Sunak.

"We cannot stand by and allow these attacks to go unchallenged.

"We must end the illegal flow of arms to the Houthi militia," Sunak said, noting that the UK had "intercepted weapons shipments in the region before, including components of the very missiles used by the Houthis today".

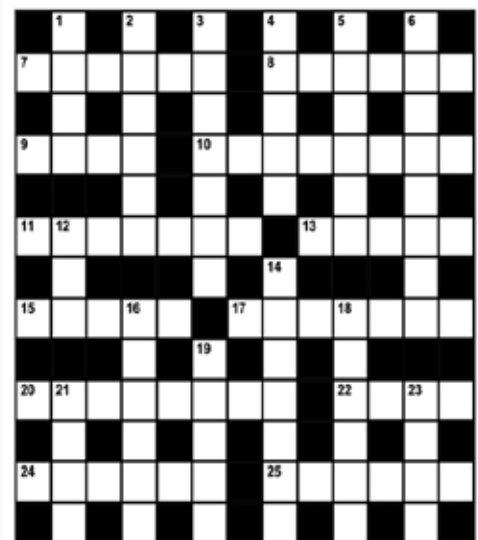

## Magnificent Seven: Tooting native Raye's many Brit Award nominations

Singer-songwriter Raye has received seven Brit Award nominations, a new record for one artist in a single year.

Raye (pictured, right) - whose real name is Rachel Agatha Keen, was born in Tooting, South London, but her profile is truly going global as she overtakes Craig David, Gorillaz and Robbie Williams, who previously held the joint record with six each.

Raye's nominations include one for artist of the year, a category in which six of the 10 nominees are female.



That is in stark contrast to last year, when there was an all-male best artist line-up after the merging of the best British male and female categories.

Following criticism, Brits organisers have expanded the artist of the

year category from five to 10 slots this year.

The result is nominations for Raye, Jessie Ware, Olivia Dean, Little Simz, Arlo Parks and Dua Lipa, alongside male artists Dave, Central Cee, J Hus and Fred Again.

The split is even more pronounced in international artist of the year, where Taylor Swift and Olivia Rodrigo are among eight female nominees in the 10-strong category.

Instead, some high-profile men have been snubbed this year - with Ed Sheeran and Lewis Capaldi both missing out on recognition in the artist of the year and album of the year categories.

Sheeran released two albums during the Brits' eligibility period, both of which reached number one.

## Winning trophies 'harder in England' says Villa's Emery

Aston Villa boss Unai Emery believes winning a trophy in England is tougher than anywhere else in the world.

He has won multiple trophies in his native Spain and France, but he believes the competition in England makes winning titles more difficult.

"I want to be contenders in this competition," he said.

"To win a cup is very difficult, and here in England I think it's more difficult than in other countries.

"I want to do something but every opportunity I have is a challenge."

Emery has won the Europa League on four occasions - three times with Sevilla and once with Villarreal - while at Paris St-Germain he won Ligue 1 and twice

lifted both the French Cup and League Cup.

He did not win a trophy in his previous spell in England with Arsenal, but took them to the final of the Europa League in 2019, where they lost to Chelsea.

"I know that everything I've done in different cups in Spain, France or England was an experience for me," Emery added.

"Here in England, I didn't achieve when I was at Arsenal and last year here in Aston Villa, but I haven't had many opportunities. Hopefully, I will have more."

Villa are fourth in the Premier League, five points behind leaders Liverpool and at press time on Friday were headed to Chelsea in the FA Cup fourth round.

## Hammers switch gives Phillips Euros boost

West Ham have agreed a deal with Manchester City to sign England midfielder Calvin Phillips on loan for the rest of the season.

Phillips, 28, signed a six-year contract when he arrived at City from Leeds in a £45m deal in July 2022.

However, he has struggled under Pep Guardiola and has only started twice this term in all competitions.

Phillips, who is also interesting Juventus, now appears set to have a medical in London later this week.

Personal terms are not expected to be a problem, with the Hammers set to cover Phillips' salary and there will be an option to make the move permanent.

Numerous clubs had expressed an interest in the player but City's demand for a sizable loan fee has dissuaded clubs such as Newcastle from pursuing Phillips.

The temporary recruitment of Phillips will come as a boost to Hammers boss David Moyes, who has been eager to strengthen a squad weakened by a succession of injuries.

Meanwhile, Phillips, who has started just two games in the English top flight in 18 months, is likely to view it as an opportunity to showcase his talents prior to this

summer's European Championship in Germany.

As has been the case periodically during that time, Guardiola was asked for the specific flaw that has condemned Phillips - one of the standout performers in England's run to the Euro 2020 final and still a part of Gareth Southgate's squad - to just two Premier League starts out of a potential 58.

Typically, Guardiola avoided a direct answer and turned the question on himself.

"I have to be here to help the players develop and be better players and suit what we want to do and I was not able to do it," he said.

"The quality is there. That's why he's in the national team. Look what he's done at Leeds. I regret more myself than Calvin."

Erik needs a hand to fix United's foundations

RIO Ferdinand believes Erik ten Hag cannot fix all of Manchester United's problems on his own.

Ferdinand says that new joint-owner Sir Jim Ratcliffe needs to repair United's broken foundations, if the fallen giants are to get back to the top of football again.

Ratcliffe and his INEOS group bought a 25 percent stake in United for £1.3billion and will be in charge of the club's football operations.

But former United star Ferdinand believes Ratcliffe's job will involve much more than just signing better players and that the whole structure of the club needs looking at.

Ferdinand, who won 10 major trophies with

United between 2002 and 2014, said: "What we're finding now is that it's not one thing that will fix this.

"One manager isn't going to fix it. We've had different managers with different levels of experience - and it has been the same outcome.

"They've been shown the door. So, what else is it?

"It's the framework of the club, the structure behind the scenes.

"I just hope the new guys who are coming in, the INEOS Group, who have experience in different sports, but also football, can really shape the club into a well-oiled machine that will begin to know how to function off the pitch. That can filter through to the team. Because if it's not functioning behind the scenes, then on the pitch it's not going to happen.

"Look at how the best clubs are run. Foundations of the club give you a chance and a platform to perform."

## CARABAO CUP: Chelsea demolish Boro to clinch final berth

Chelsea reached the Carabao Cup final by blowing away second-tier Middlesbrough Tuesday night to seal a 6-2 aggregate victory.

The Championship side headed to Stamford Bridge with a 1-0 lead from the first leg.

But Chelsea scored four times in the first half through a Jonny Howson own goal, Enzo Fernandez, Axel Disasi and Cole Palmer.

Palmer's second and Noni Madueke completed the rout, before Morgan Rogers scored a consolation to delight the large and noisy away support.

Chelsea have secured a place at Wembley on 25 February, and will face Liverpool.

Mauricio Pochettino's side levelled this tie on aggregate after 15 minutes, when Ben Chilwell - making his first club start for 118 days - cut Boro's defence open with an incisive through ball.

Raheem Sterling

then squared towards Armando Broja in the box, and Boro captain Howson, attempting to intervene, inadvertently directed the ball into his own net off his shin.

Chelsea then went ahead in the tie for the first time as Sterling and Disasi combined down the right, before the onrushing Enzo fired the low cross high past Boro keeper Tom Glover.

Boro were the architects of their own downfall for the third and fourth goals of the first half. First, centre-back Matt Clarke gave the ball away with a loose pass. Chelsea countered, with Disasi bursting into the area to stroke Sterling's pass into the far corner.

The fourth was even more egregious as Dan Barlaser was dispossessed on the edge of his own area by Palmer, who slotted past Glover.

Palmer, who missed three golden chances in the first leg, made amends here with the fifth goal as he clinically finished

Conor Gallagher's cut-back, before Madueke smashed past Glover via a deflection off Rav van den Berg.

Rogers, who has been linked with Aston Villa this month, pulled one back for Boro with a fine finish into Djordje Petrovic's far corner - but Chelsea had long since ensured a place in the final.

Having had 18 shots without scoring at Riverside Stadium, Chelsea were far more ruthless and produced moments of slick attacking play and Premier League quality.

They were also helped by a Middlesbrough side who, having ridden a feverish atmosphere in their home leg to record a famous win, looked much more like a second-division squad ravaged by injury.

Isaiah Jones, so impressive in the first game, was absent after limping off against Rotherham on Saturday. Howson, who had been

a doubt, struggled as the makeshift third centre-back and was caught out of position for Enzo's killer second goal. It is the Blues' first major final since co-owner Todd Boehly completed his takeover in May 2022.

## Reds ease past Cottagers despite late scare

Liverpool "can never take these things for granted" said manager Jurgen Klopp after they saw off Fulham to set up a Carabao Cup final with Chelsea.

The Reds led 2-1 from the first leg and their draw at Craven Cottage was enough to get the job done and set up a Wembley final on 25 February.

Luis Diaz gave Liverpool an early lead, chesting down Jarell Quansah's diagonal ball, cutting inside and beating Bernd Leno at his near post too easily, albeit with the help of a deflection.

Marco Silva's hosts had good spells and deserved their equalizer on the night when Issa Diop bundled in Harry Wilson's

deflected ball.

Another Fulham goal would have sent the tie to extra time but the closes they came was when Wilson's long-range strike was saved by Caoimhin Kelleher.

The Cottagers could not find a second goal despite pushing for one and their wait for a first EFL Cup final goes on.

"You should have seen the dressing room - they are over the moon, the young kids," Klopp told BBC Radio 5 Live.

"The stadium [Wembley] will be full blue and red - it is a good one.

"Coming here tonight and then going through is special. You can never take these things for

granted.

"After half an hour our foot slipped off the gas and it was more open. We had to bring it over the line and we are really looking forward to Wembley."

Both sides are in FA Cup fourth-round action this weekend, with Fulham hosting Newcastle on Saturday and Liverpool at home to Norwich on Sunday.

Chelsea booked their place at Wembley on Tuesday with a 6-1 over Championship club Middlesbrough, who won the first leg 1-0.

Despite some good Fulham play, Liverpool were looking comfortable until the 75th minute and could have led by more
